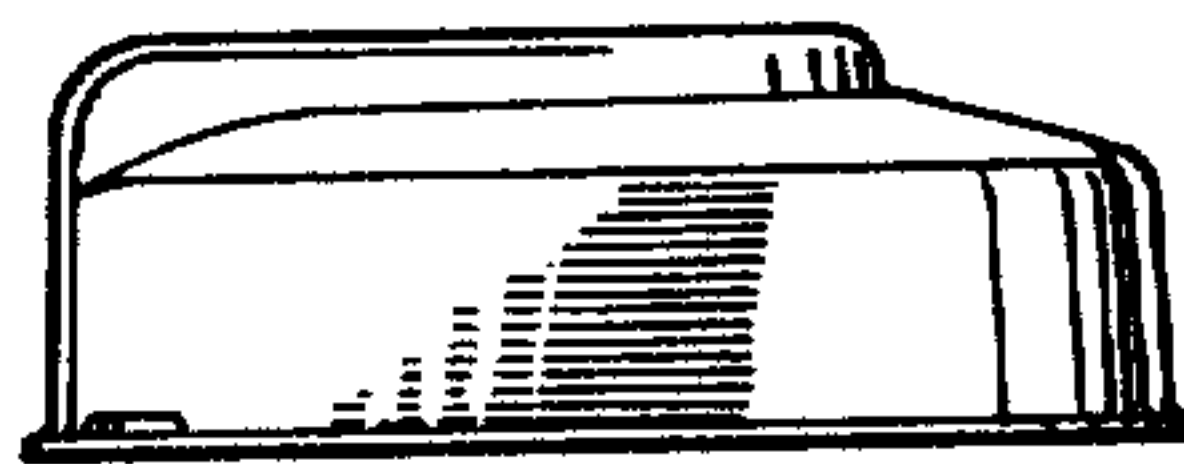
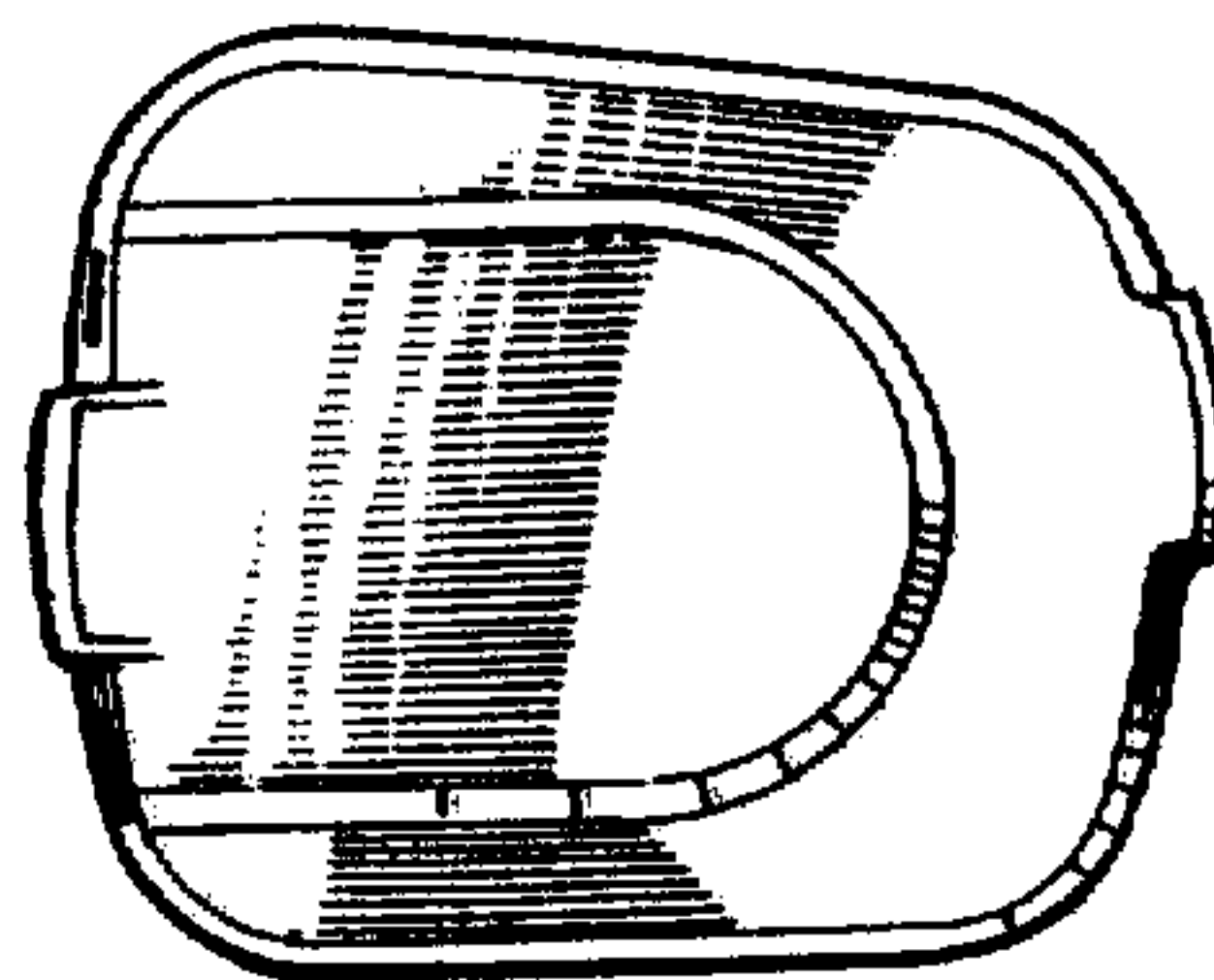

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cover for a vehicle brake fluid reservoir, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a cover for a vehicle brake fluid reservoir showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view looking from the front;
FIG. 3 is an end elevation view looking from the left side;
FIG. 4 is an end elevation view looking from the right side;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 6 is an inverted side elevation view looking from the back.



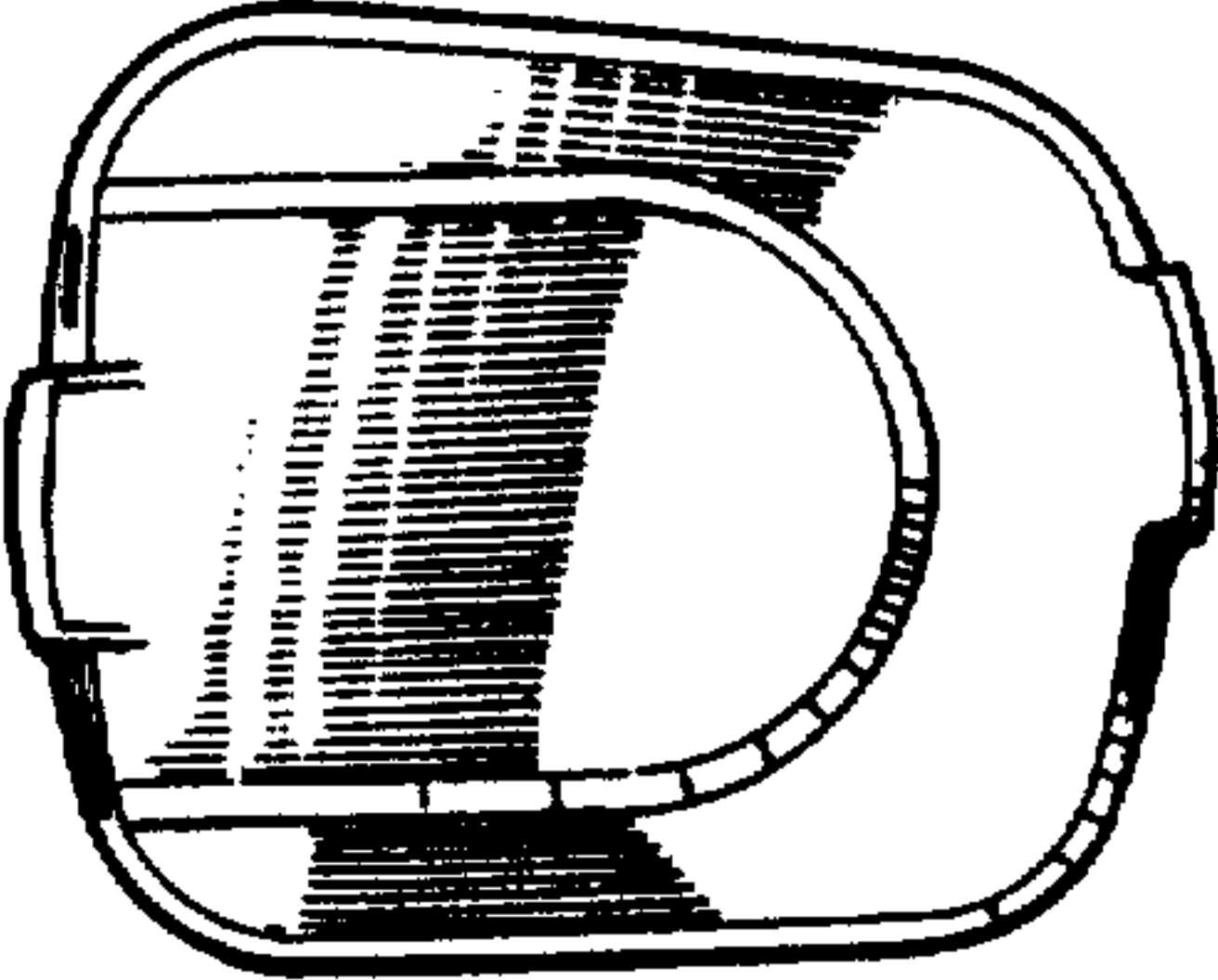

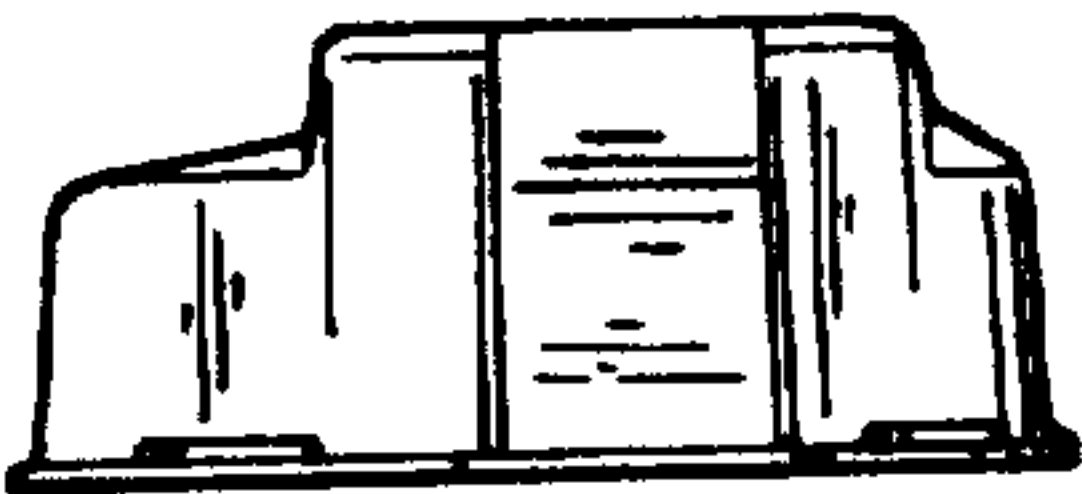

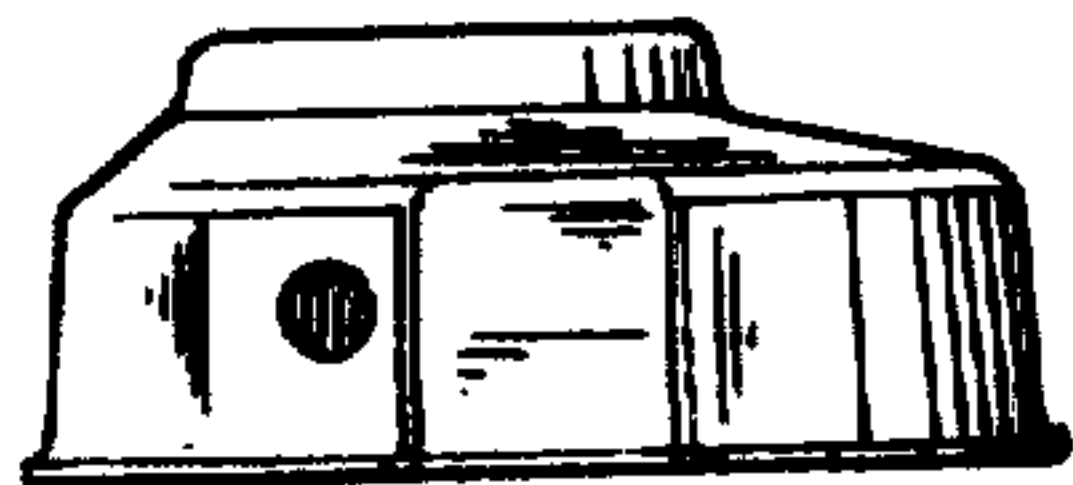

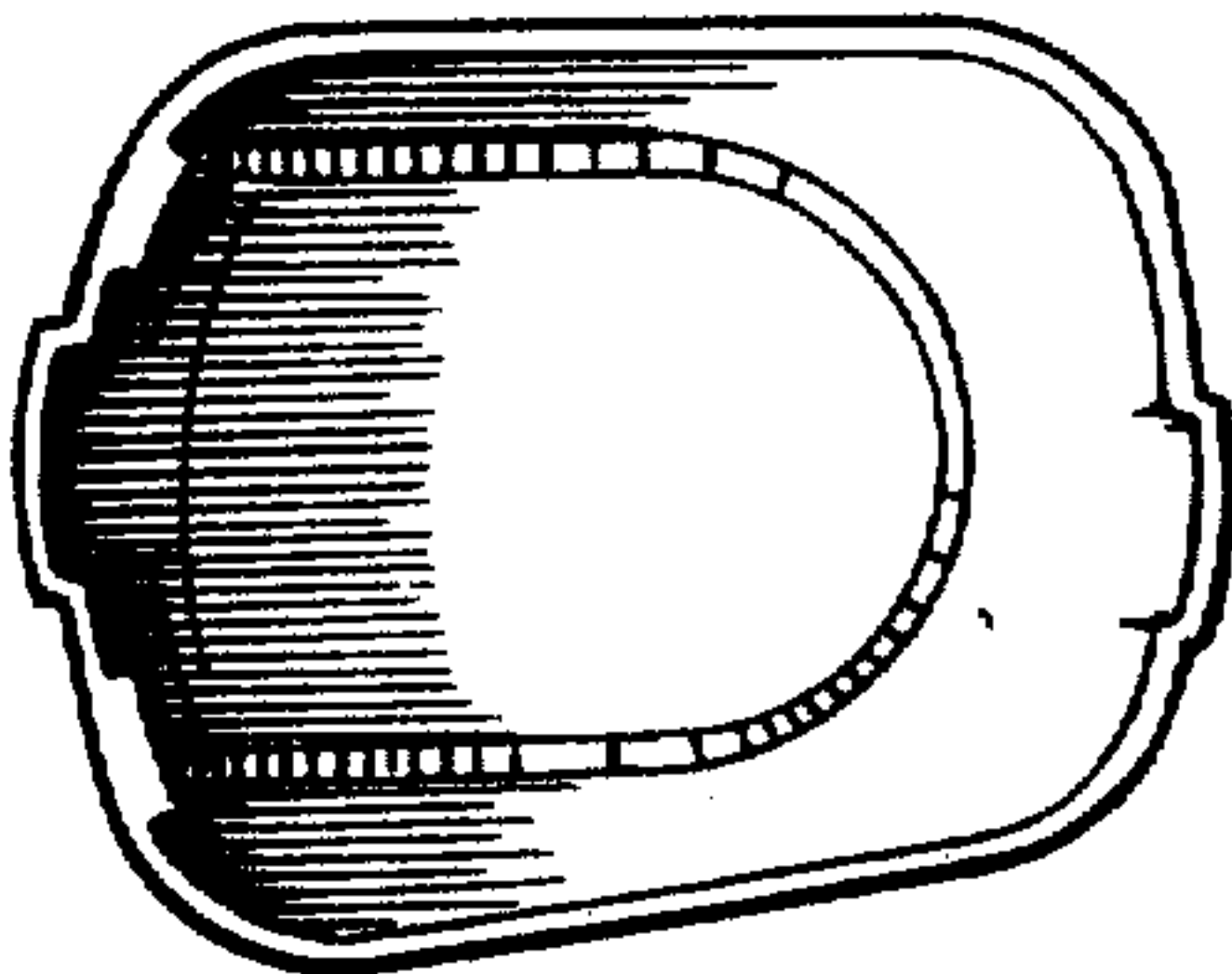

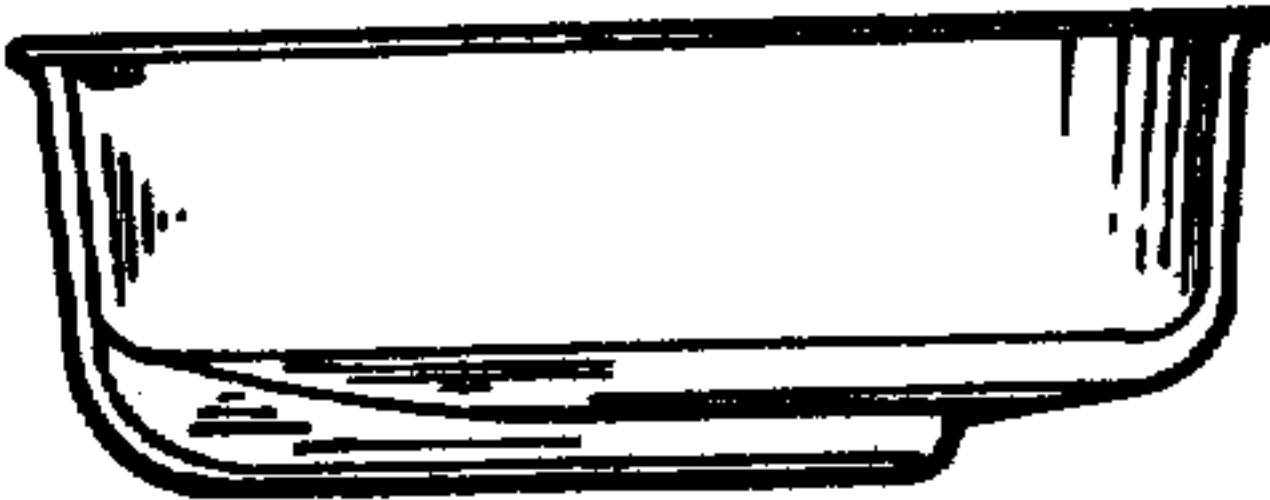
