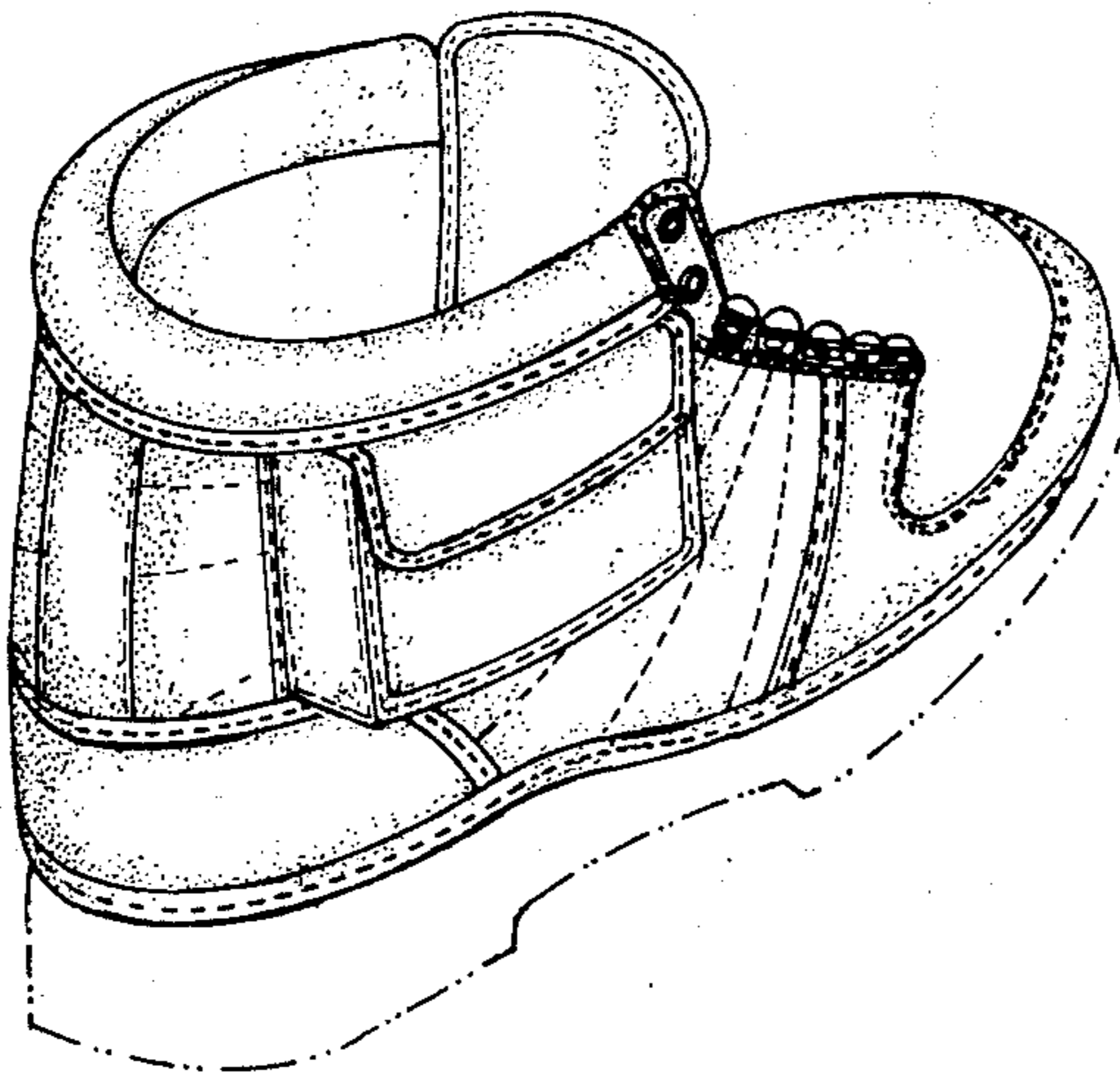

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the pocketed boot upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and left rear perspective view of a pocketed boot upper showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of another embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1-6 wherein the sole difference is a non-padded ankle top ring and a stitch line thereon;
 The broken-line showings of a sole in FIGS. 1-7 are environmental only and form no part of the claimed designs.

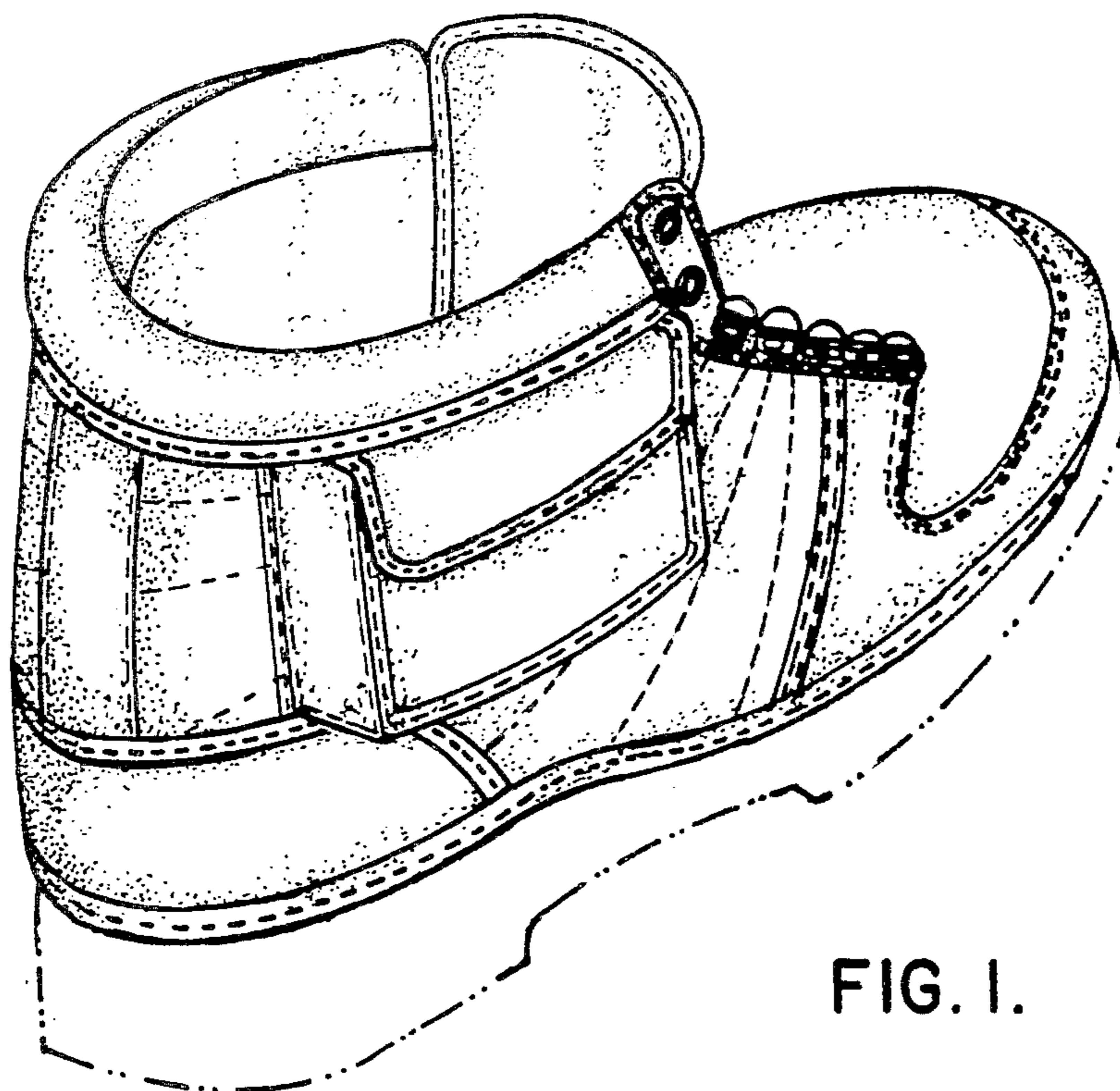

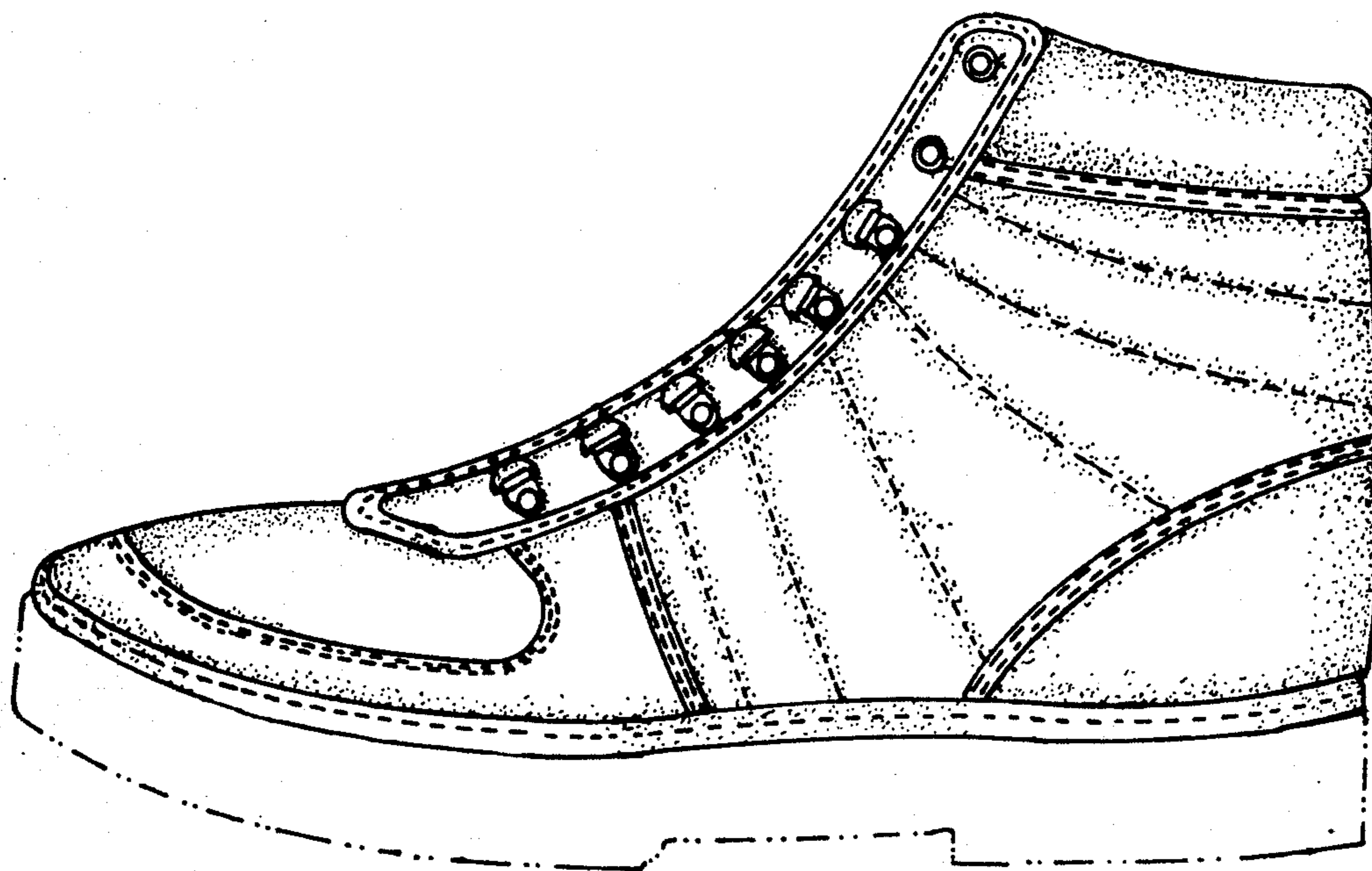

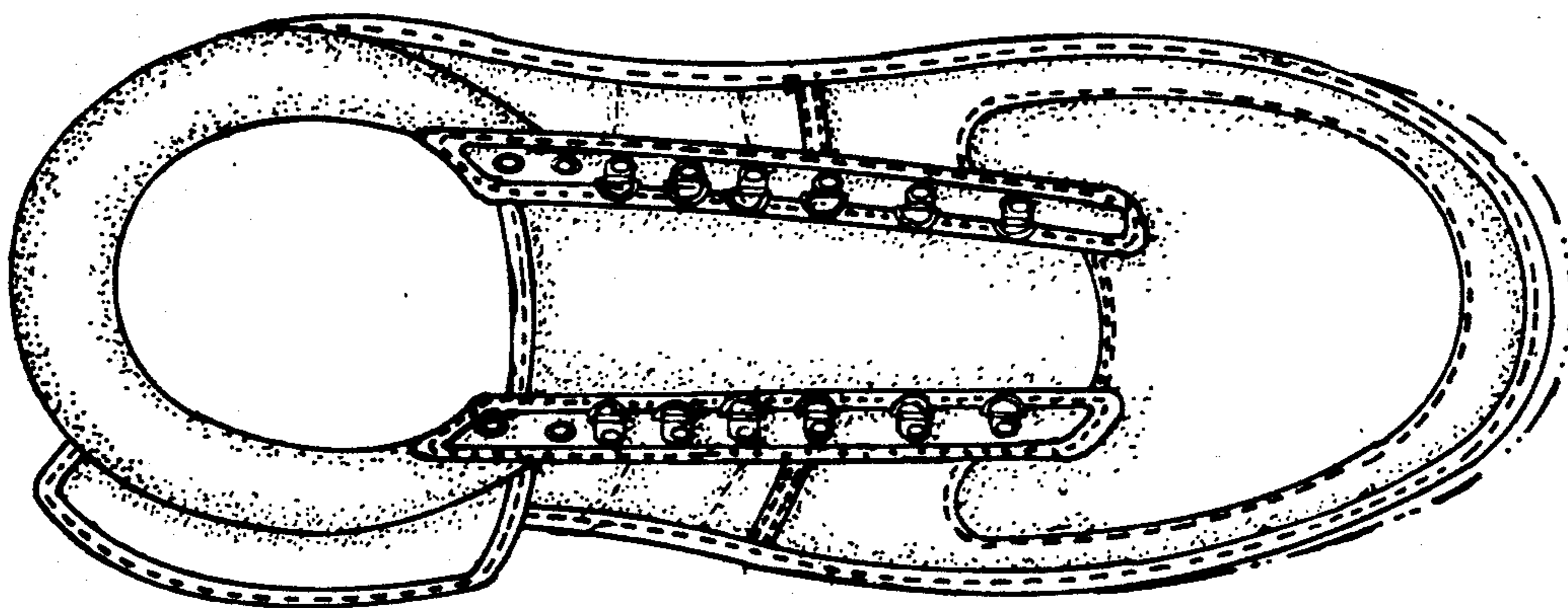

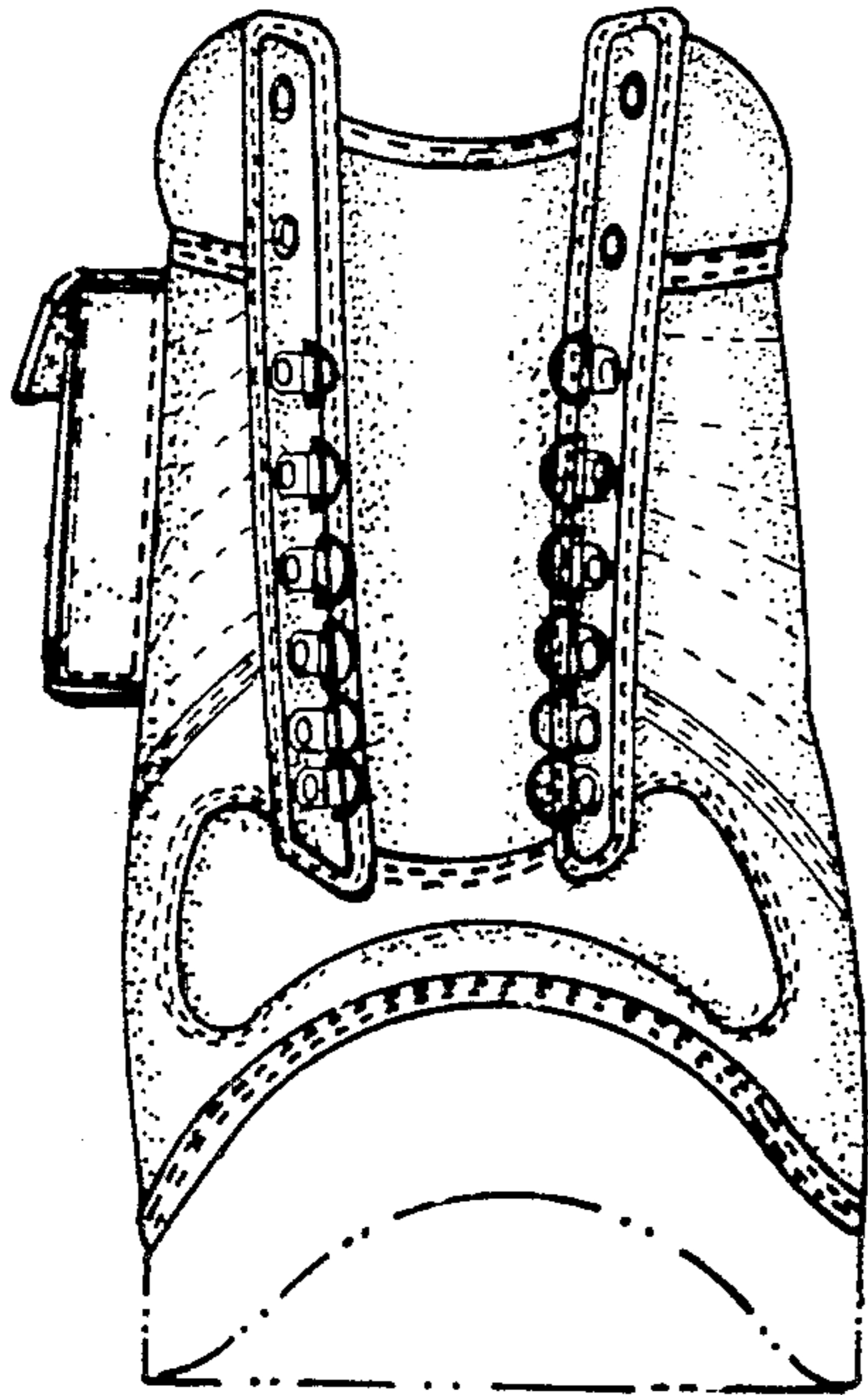

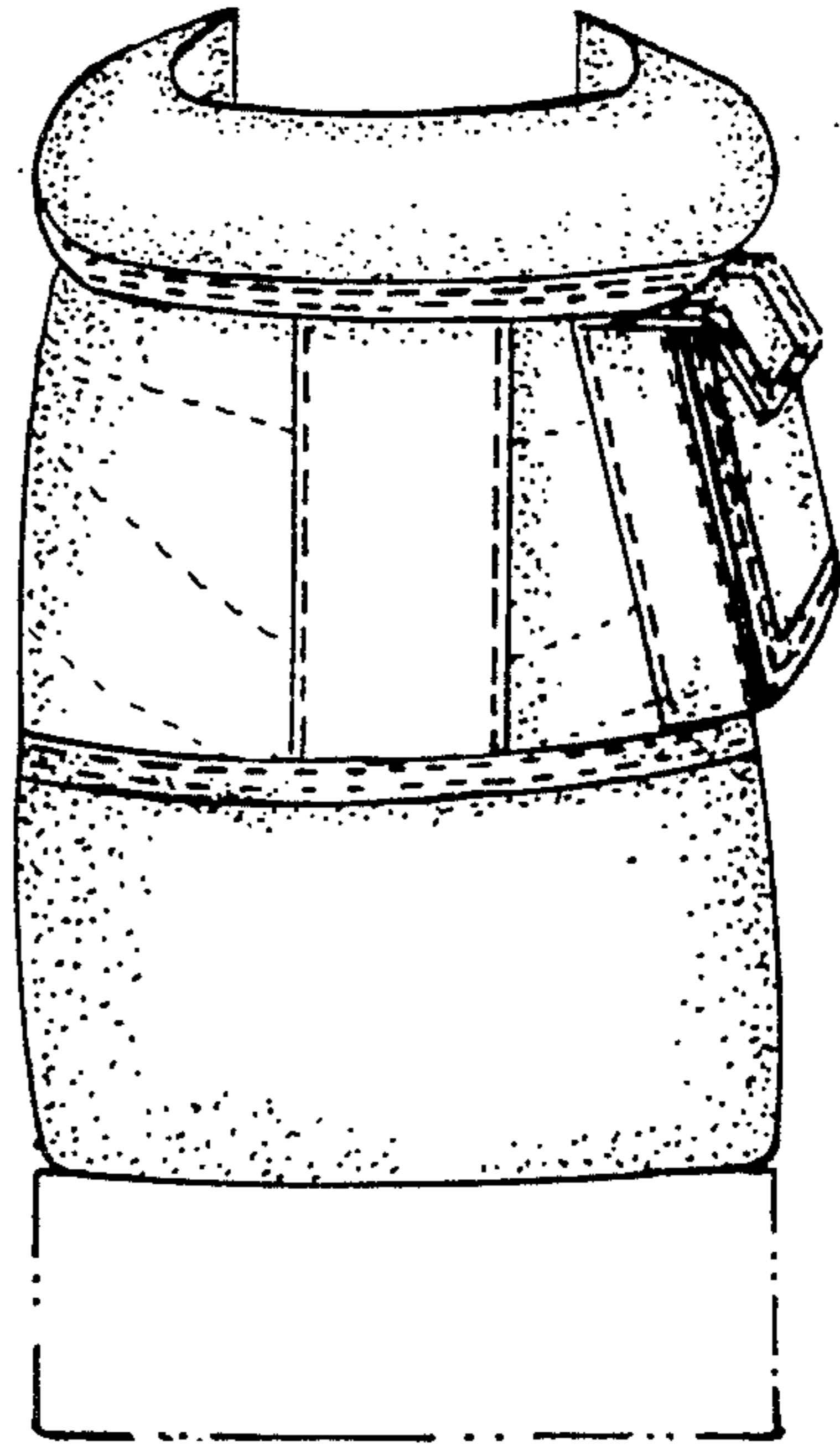

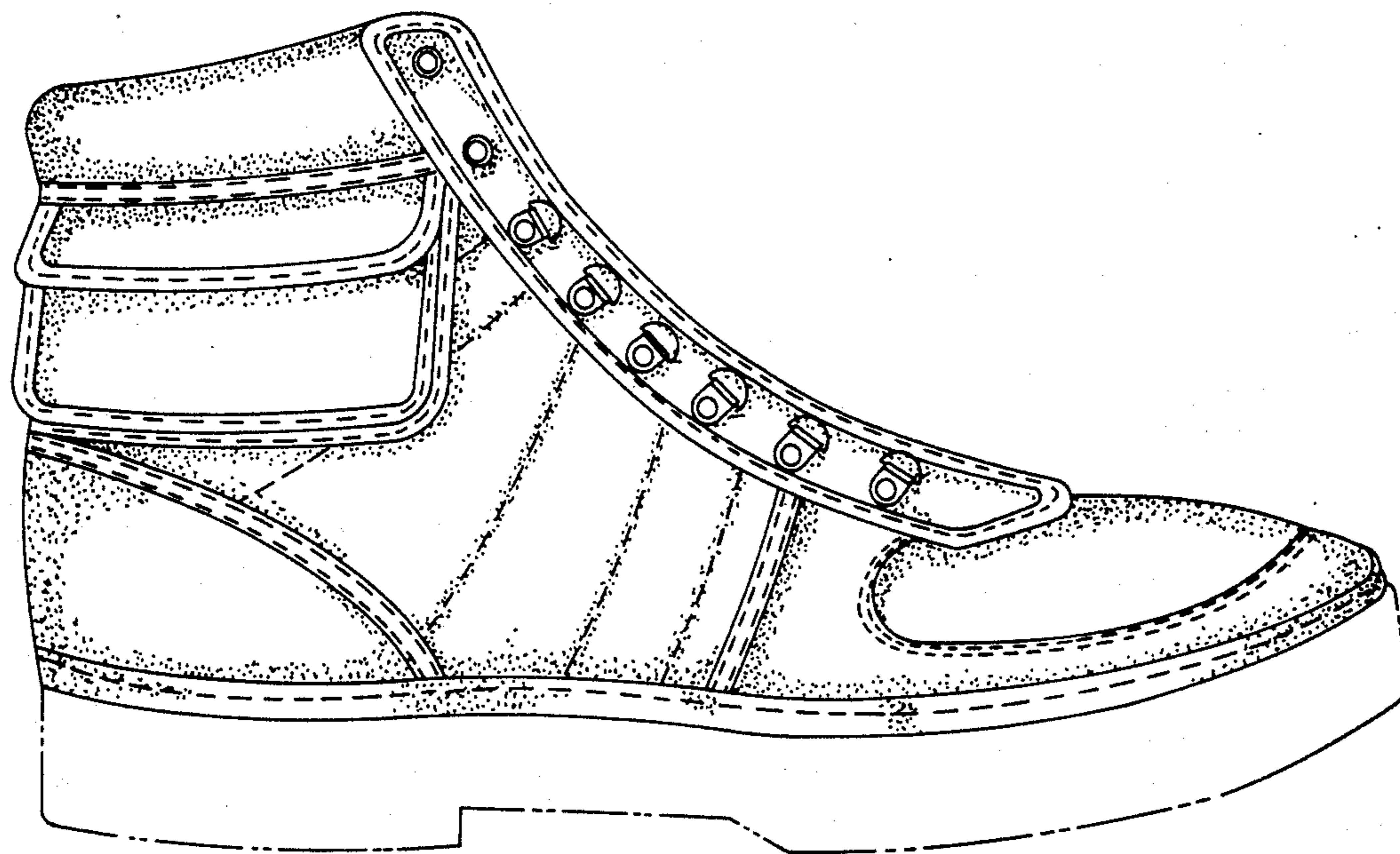
