[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spoon or similar article showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed side being substantially identical with the side shown in FIG. 3;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged perspective view in cross-section taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

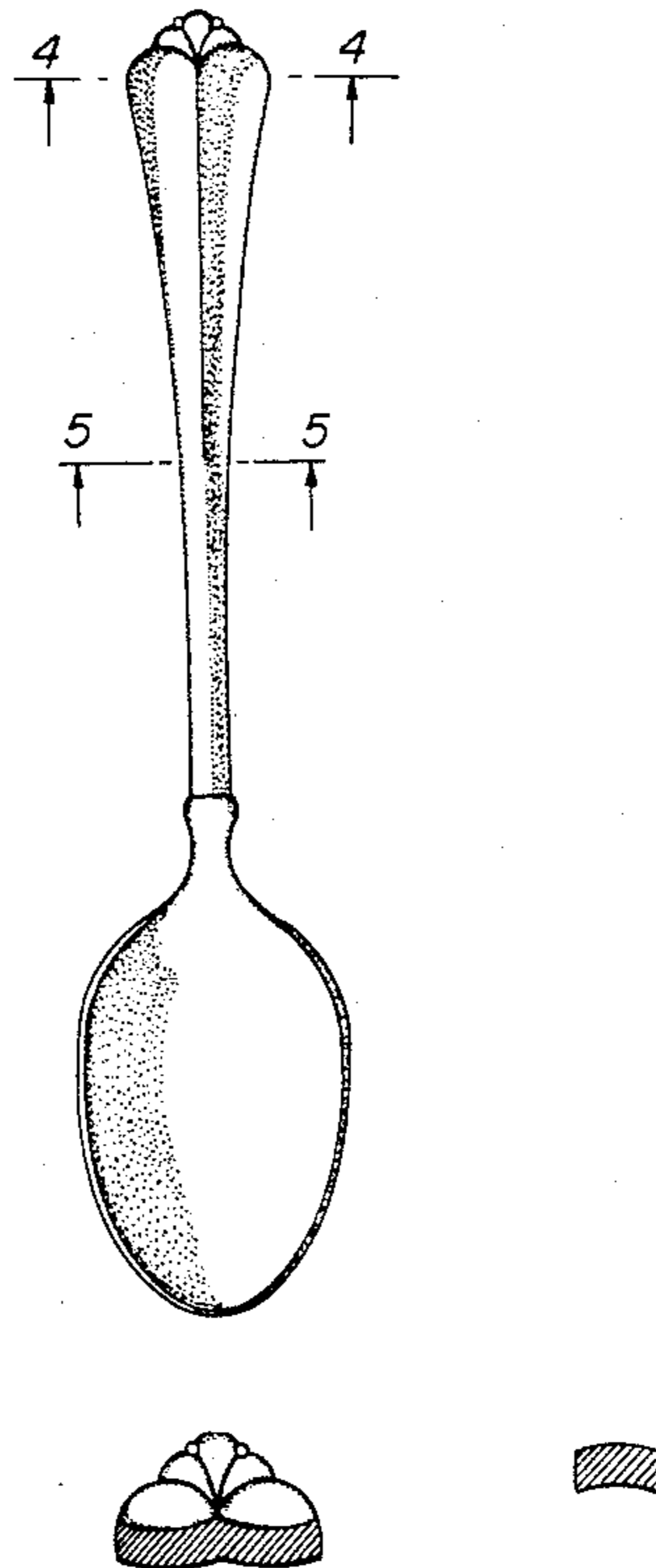

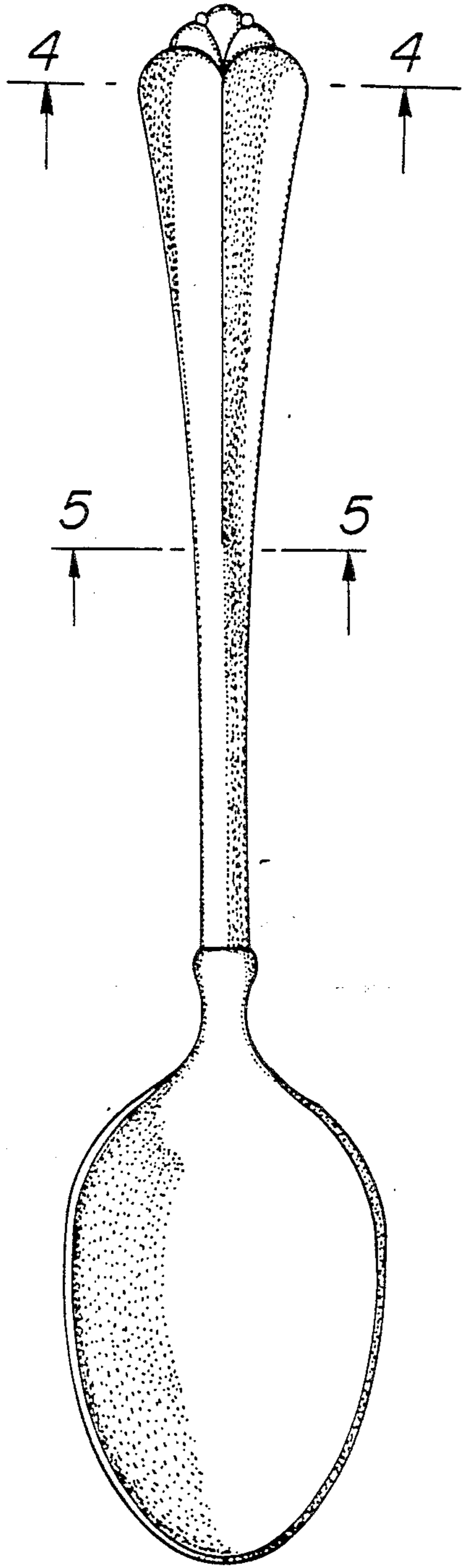

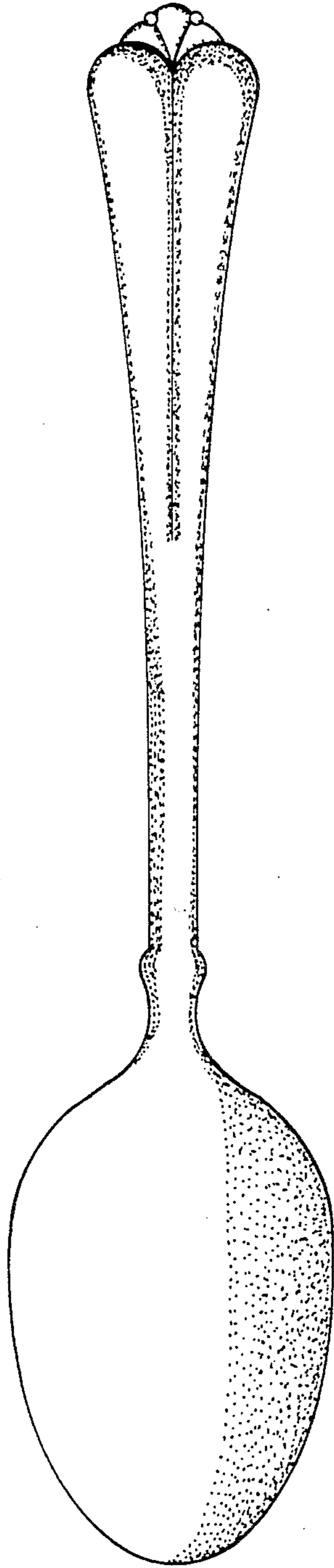

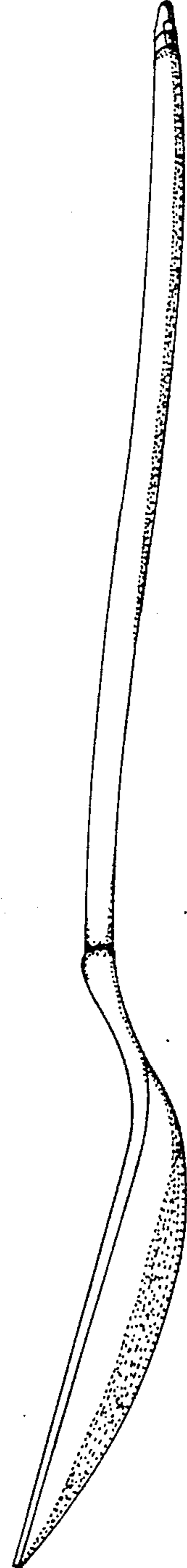

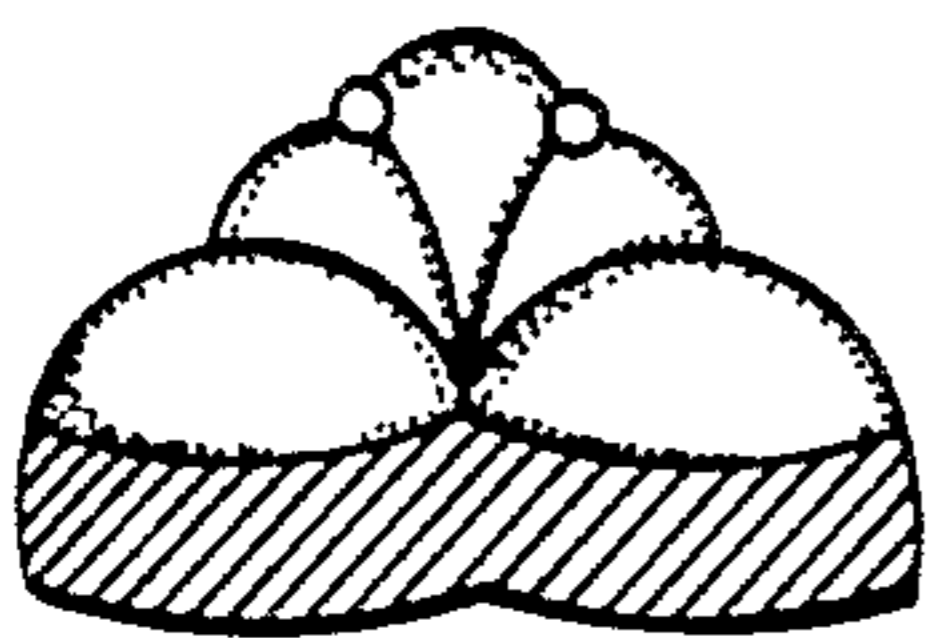
