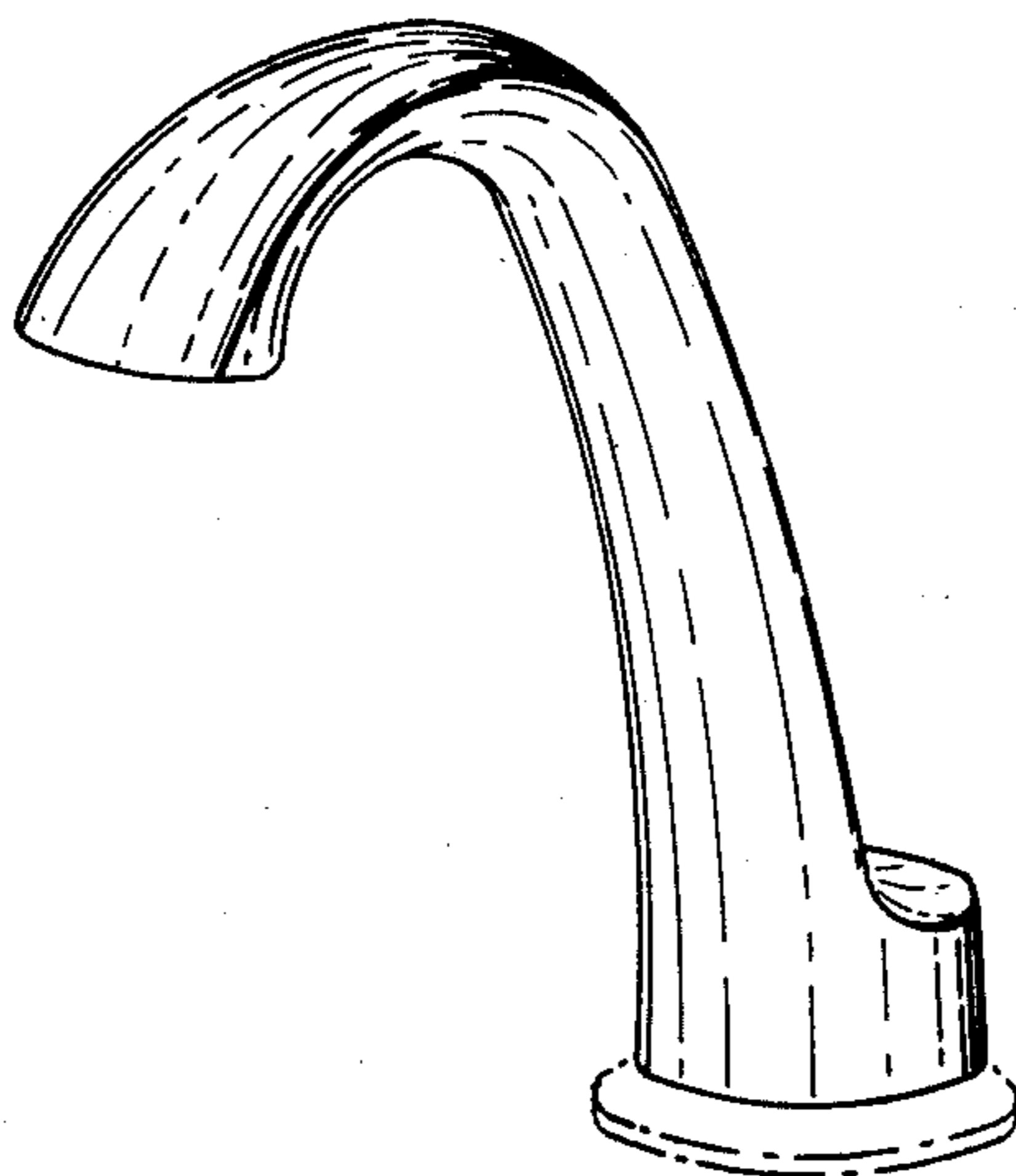

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a faucet spout, substantially
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a faucet spout showing
my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right
side being a mirror image of the left side shown;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line representation of a base for the faucet
spout shown in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration
only and forms no part of the claimed design.



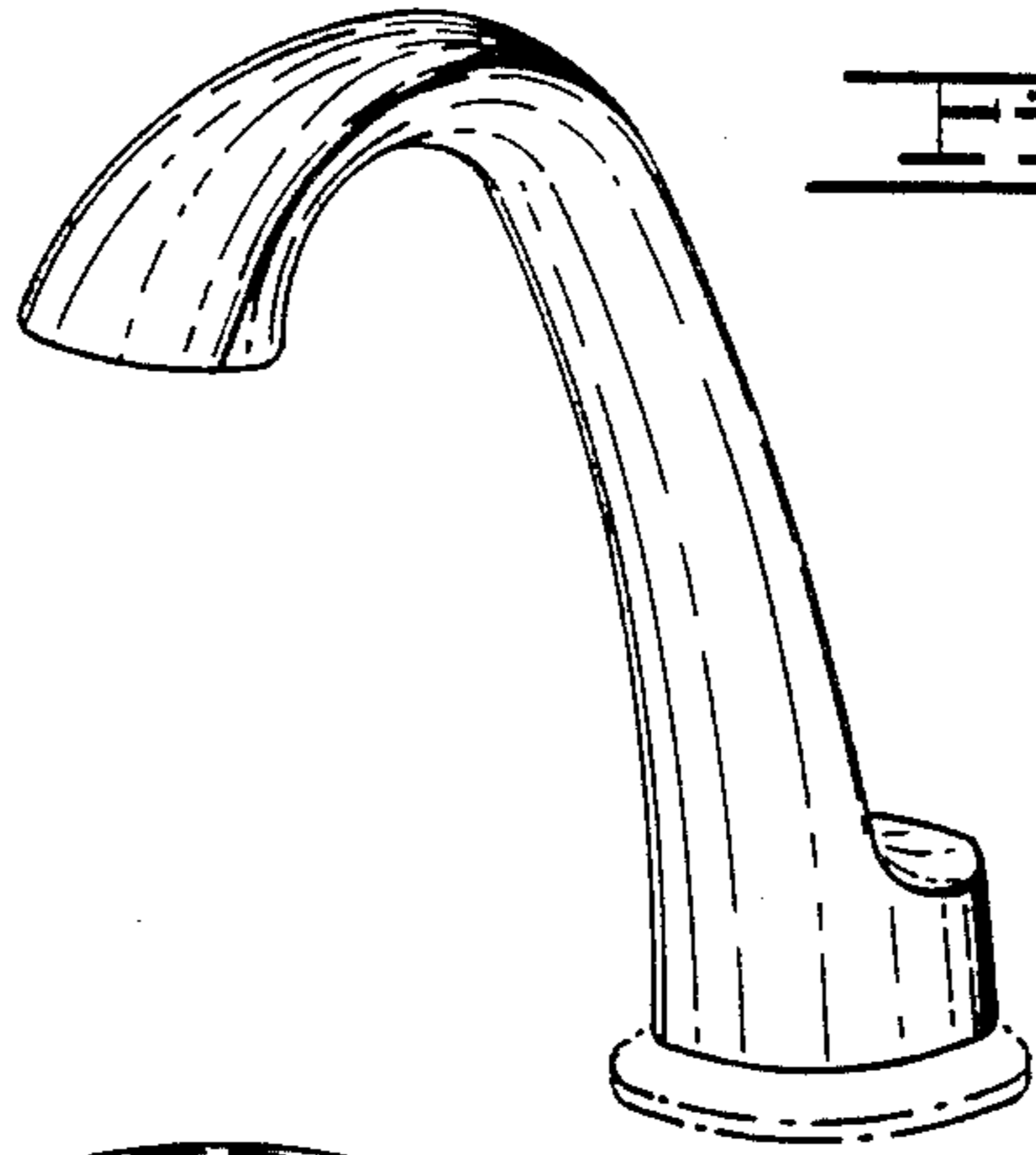

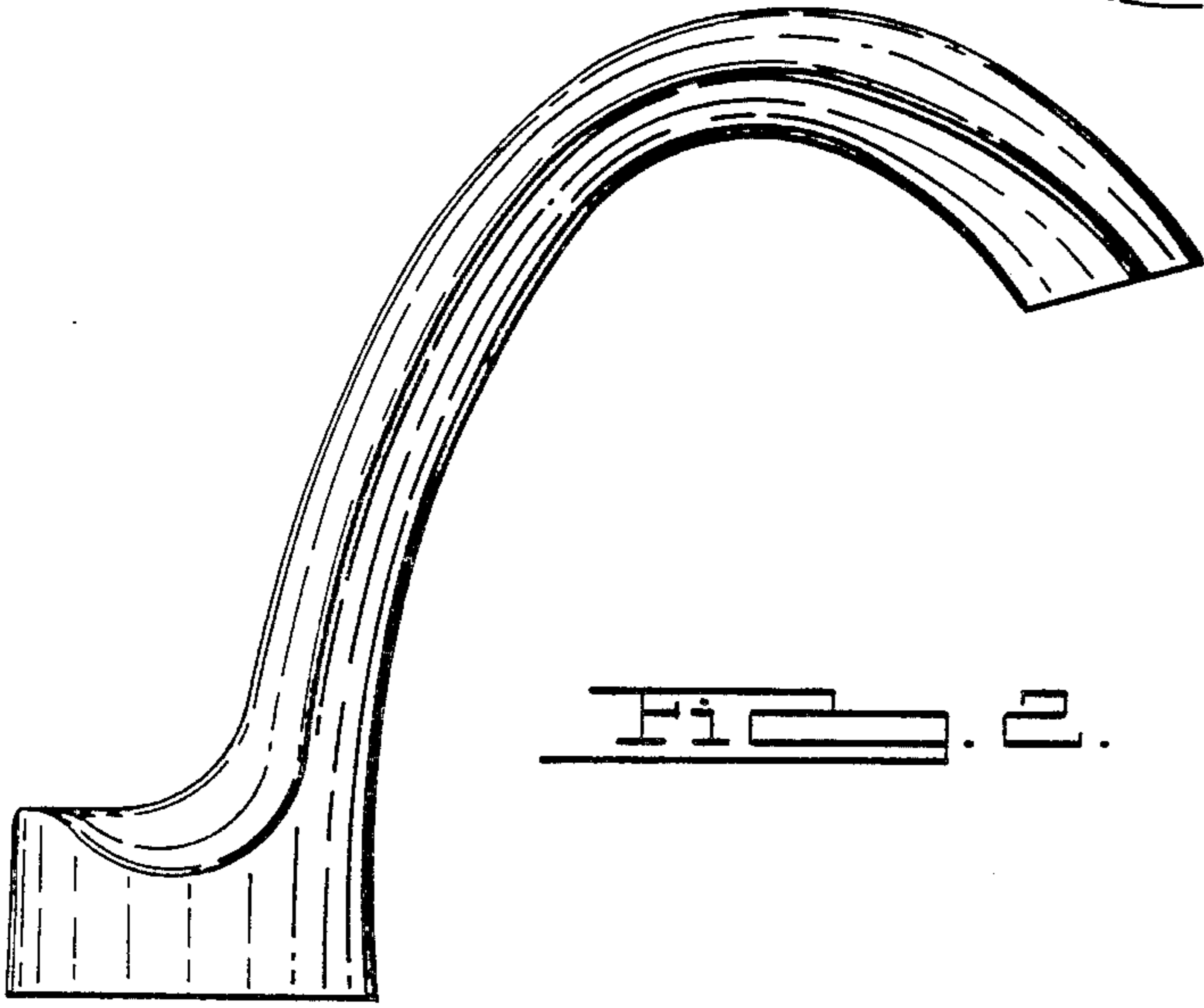

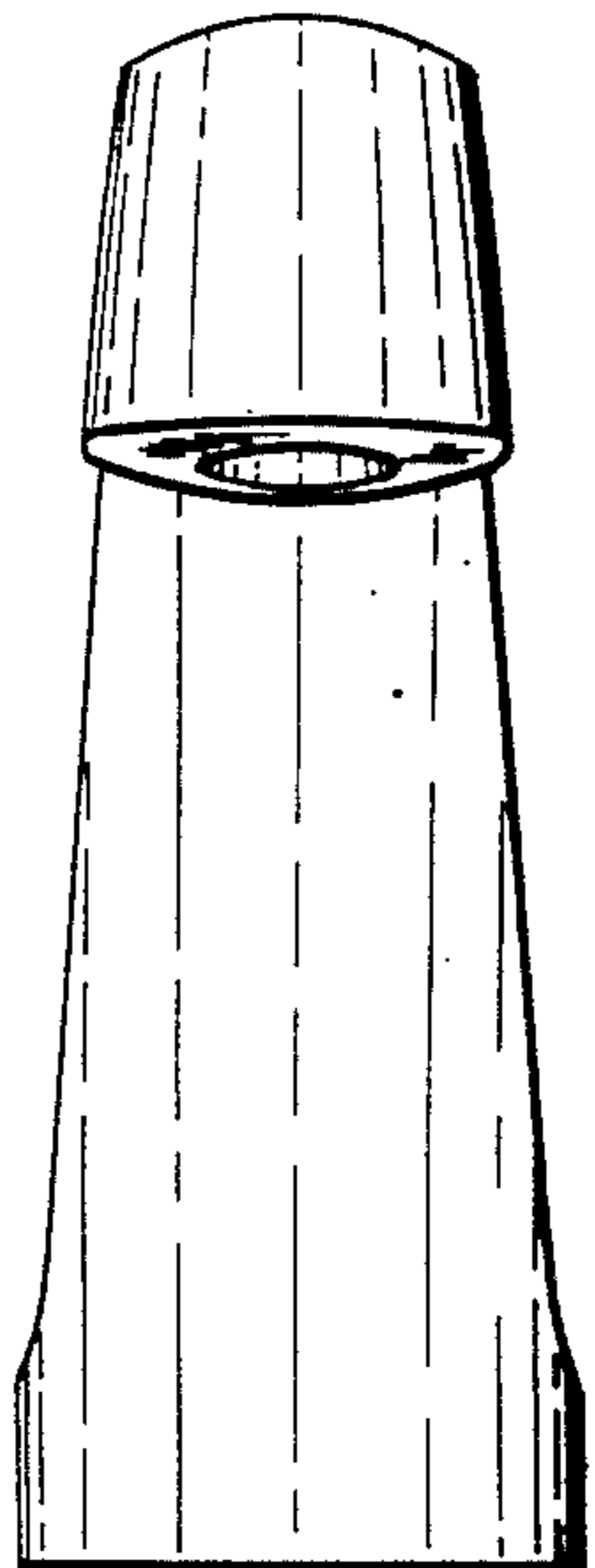

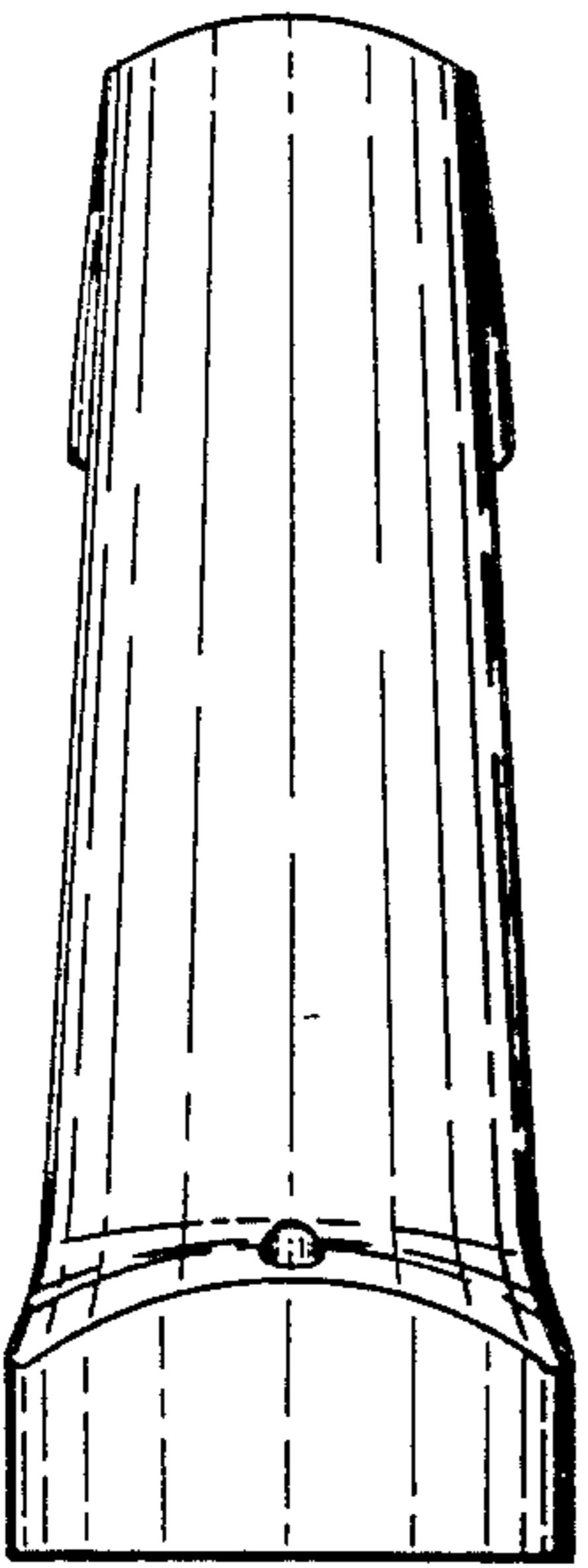

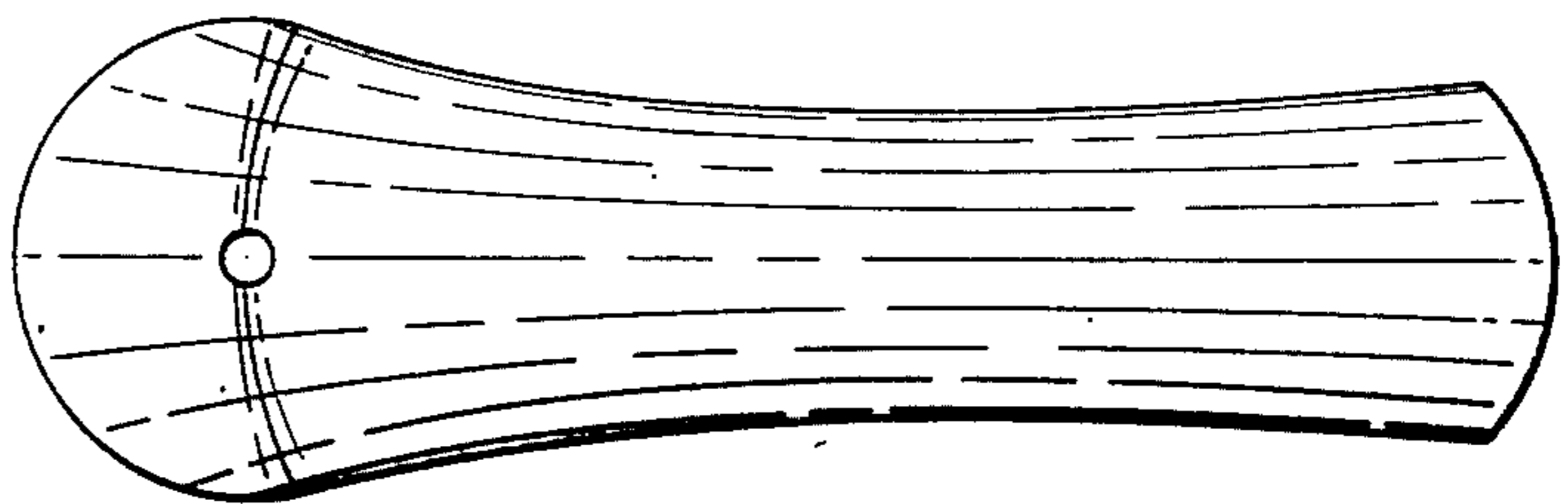

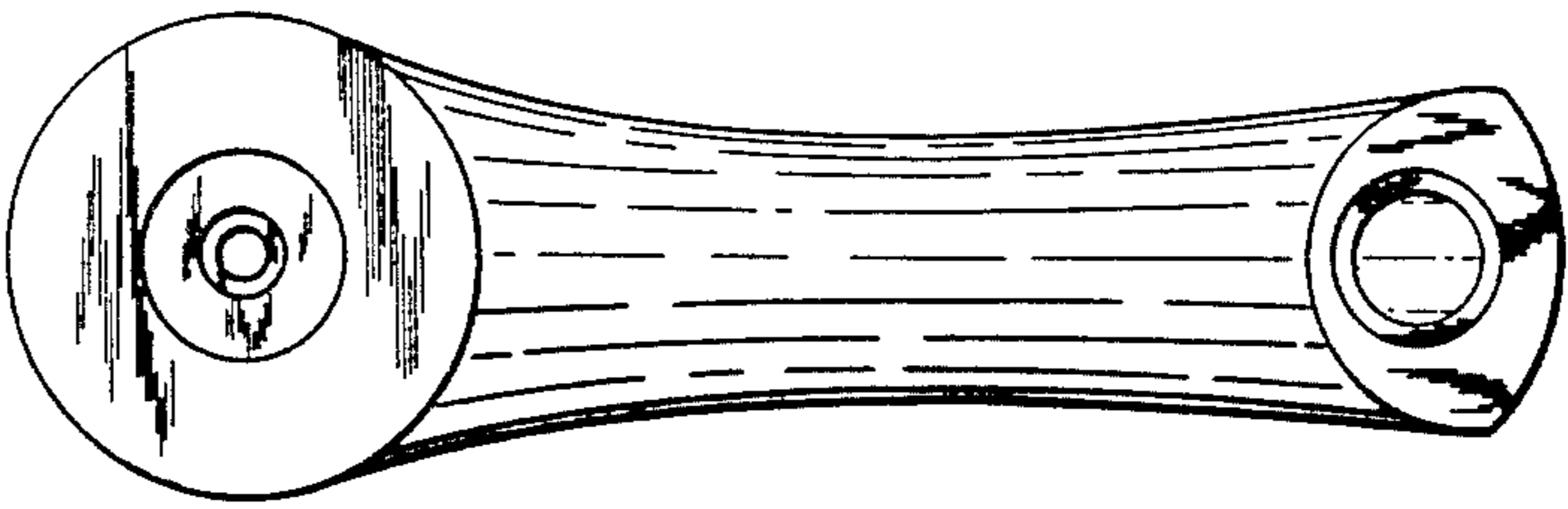
