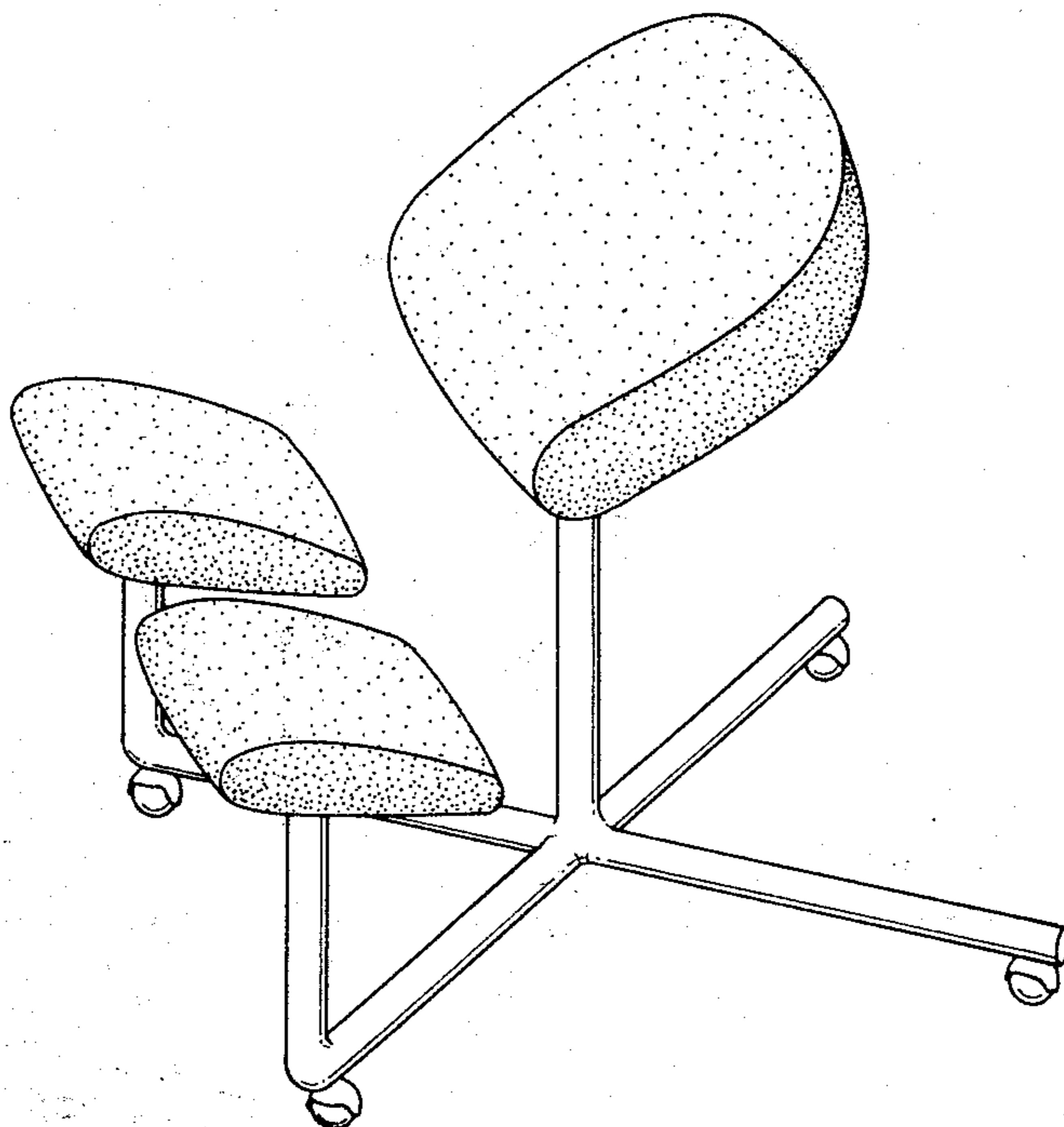

The ornamental design for an orthopedic chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an orthopedic chair taken from above and showing my design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof taken from below; FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of my design taken from above; FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof taken from below; FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment of my design taken from above; and FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view thereof taken from below.



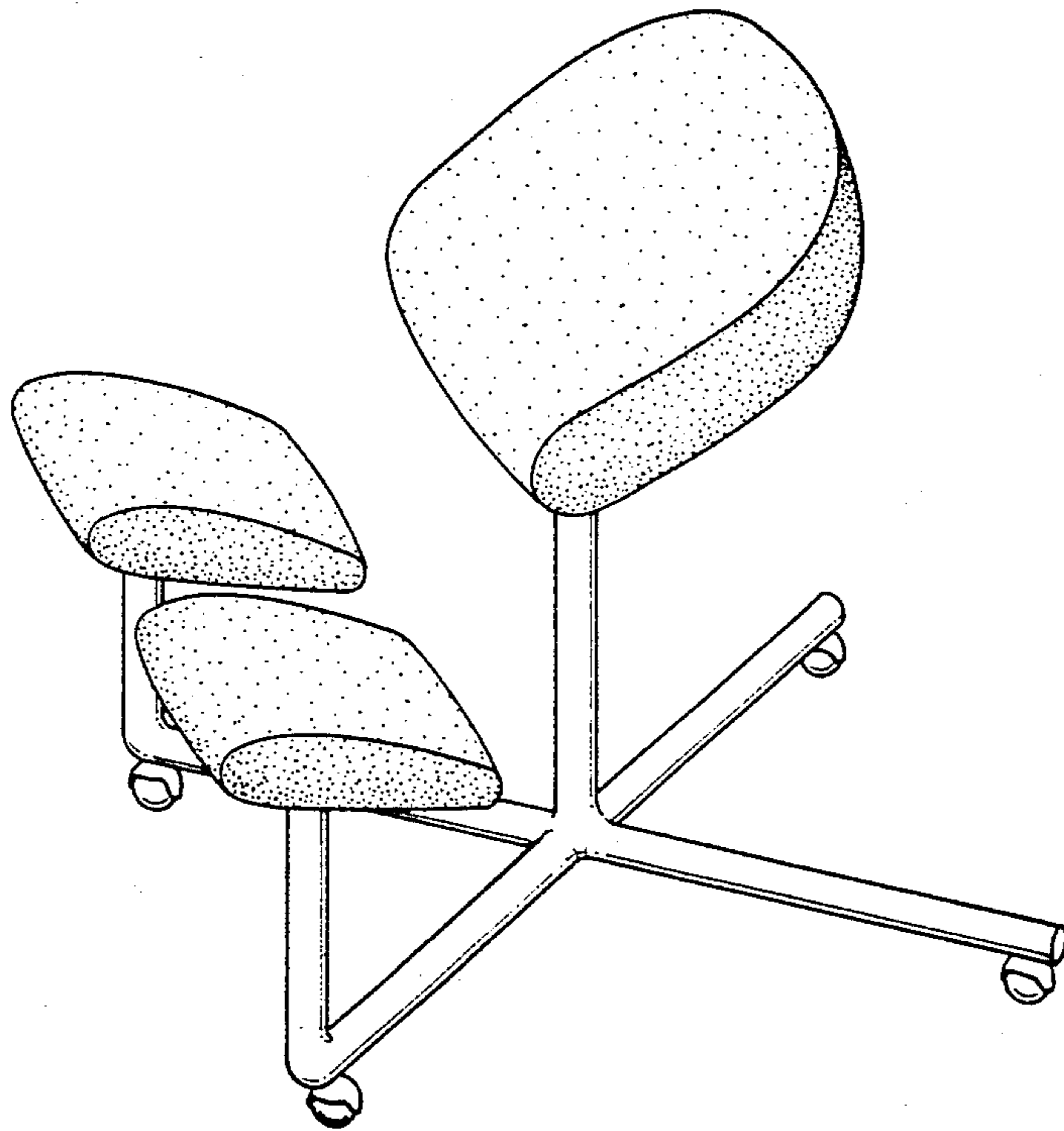

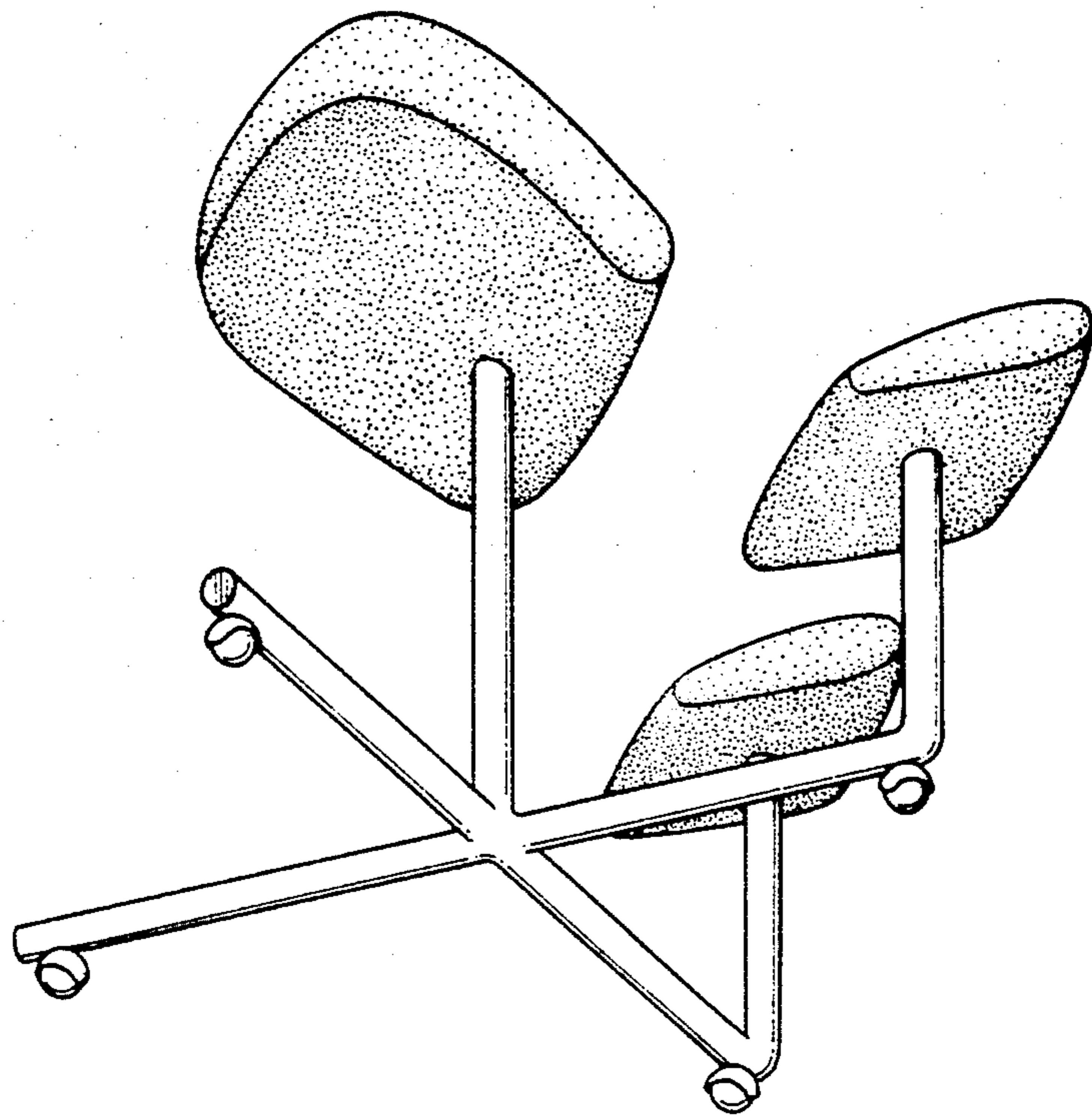

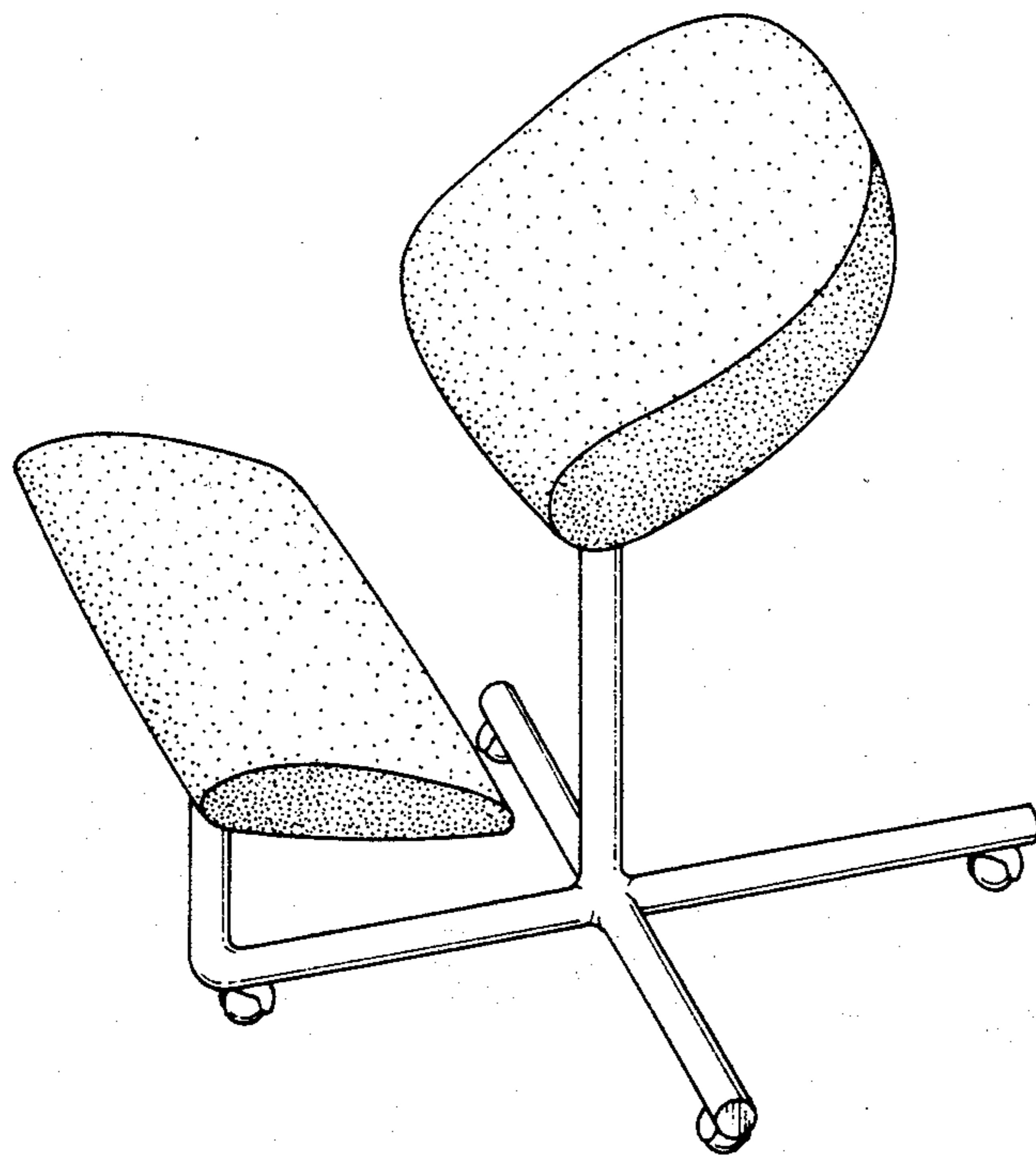

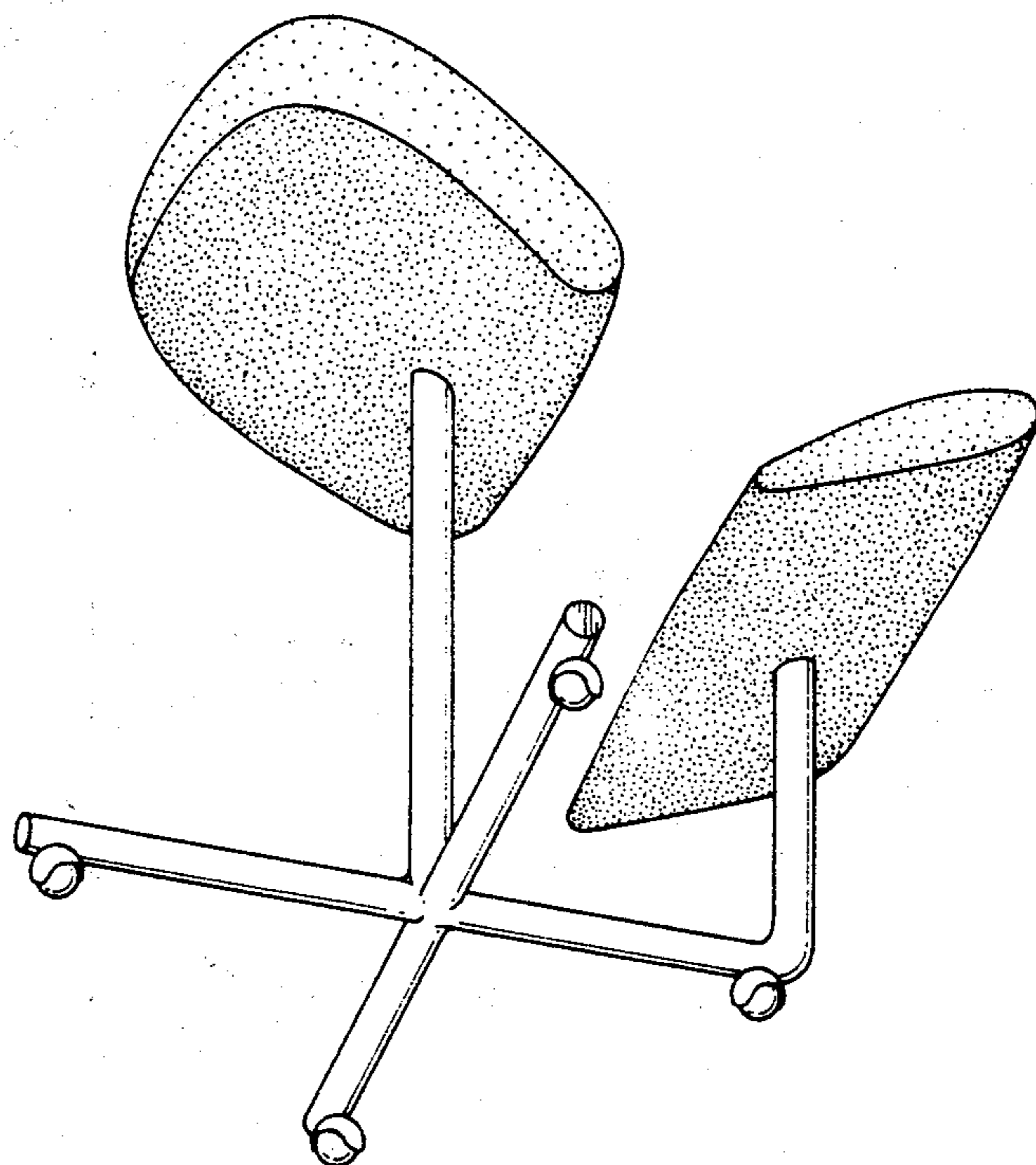

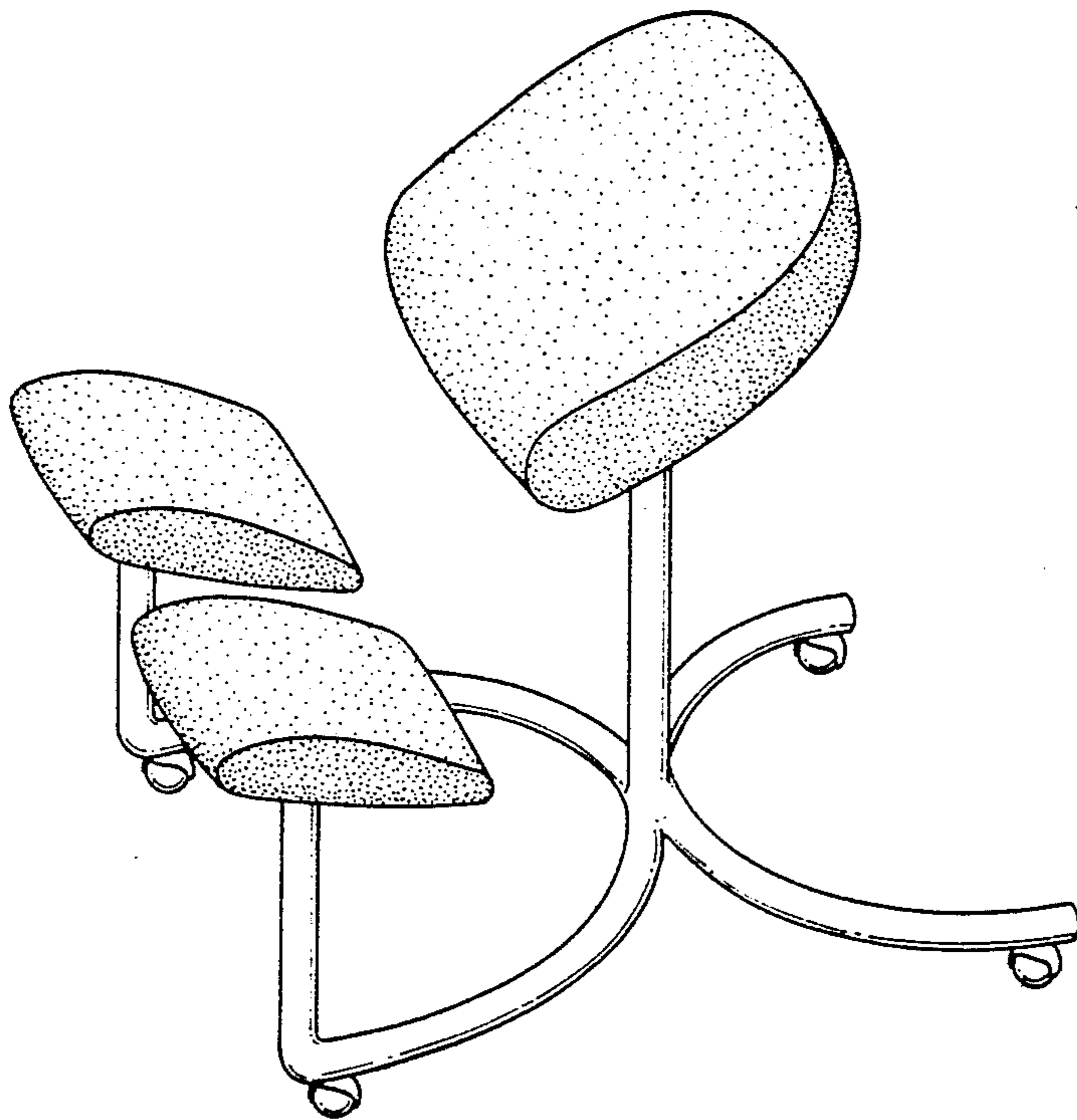

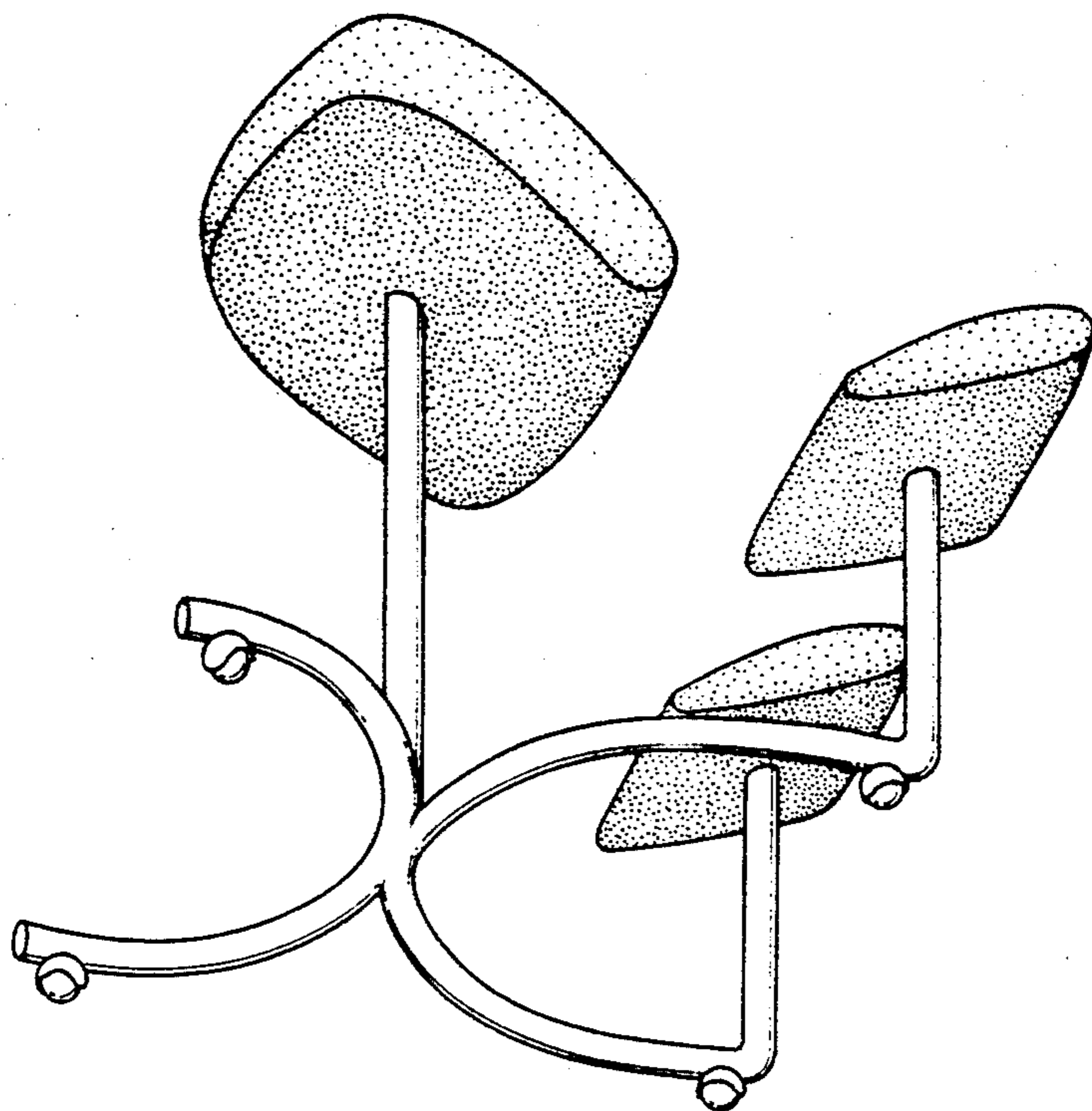
