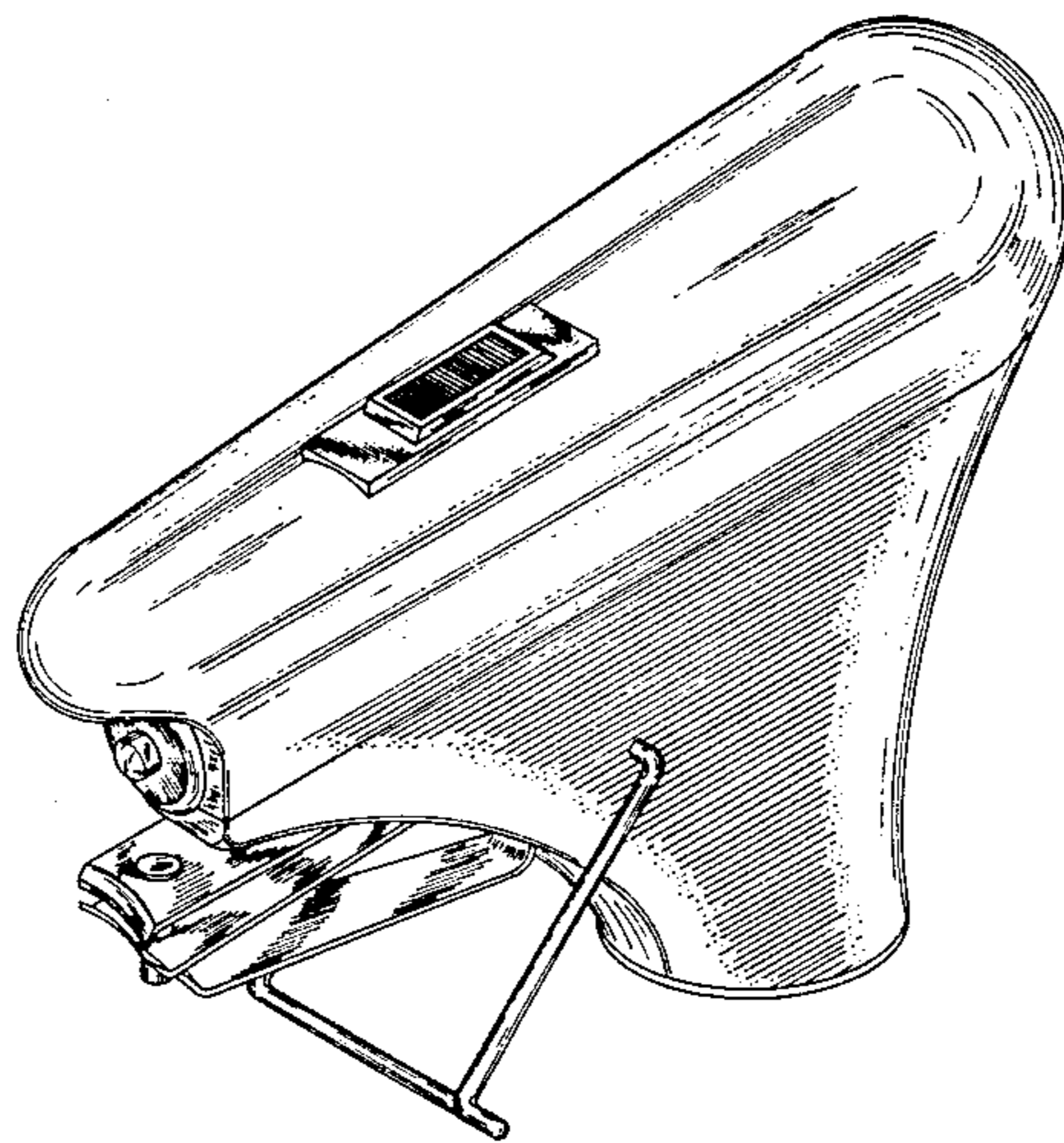

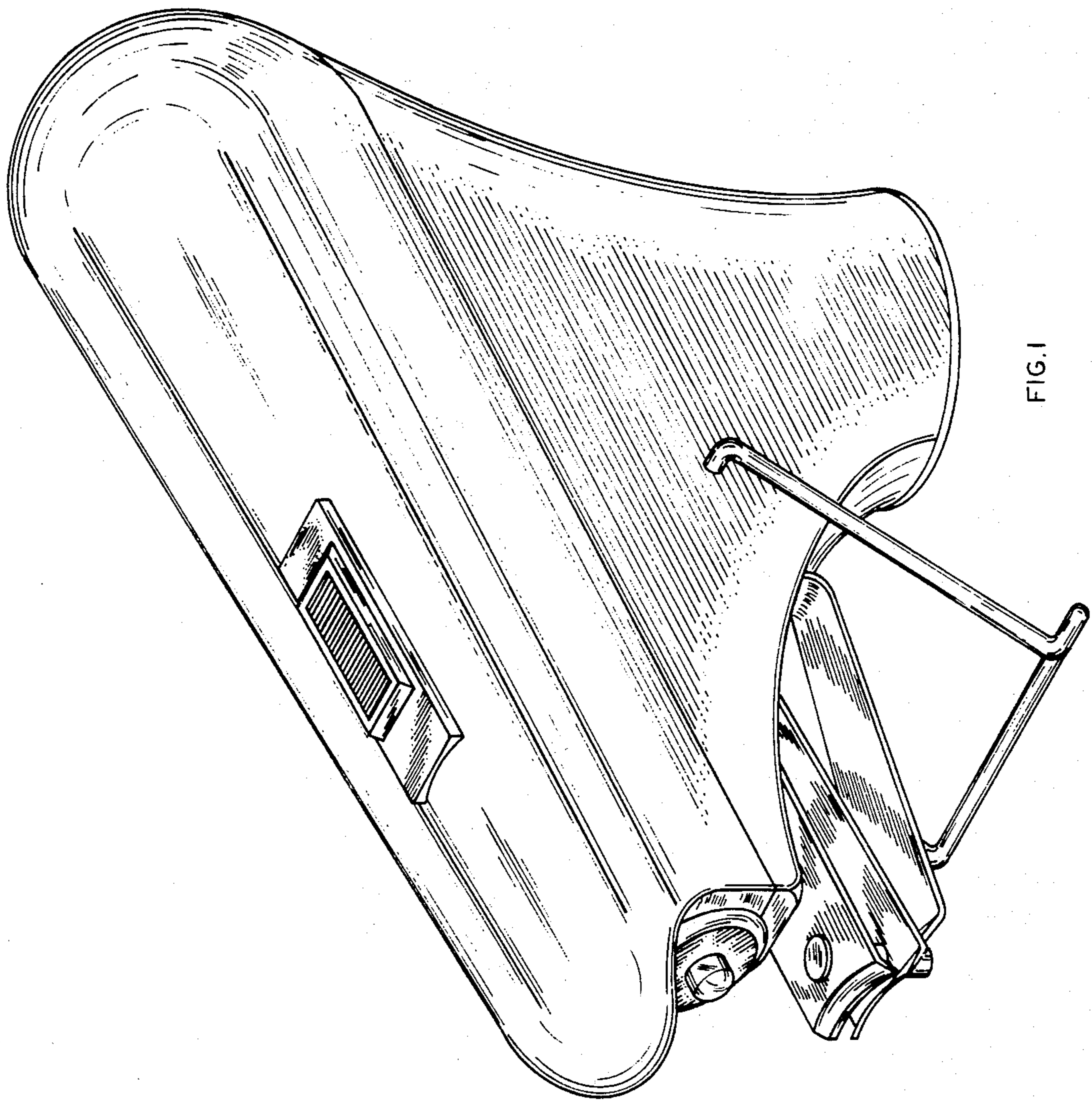
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined fisherman's lamp and clipper, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and side perspective view of a combined fisherman's lamp and clipper showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.





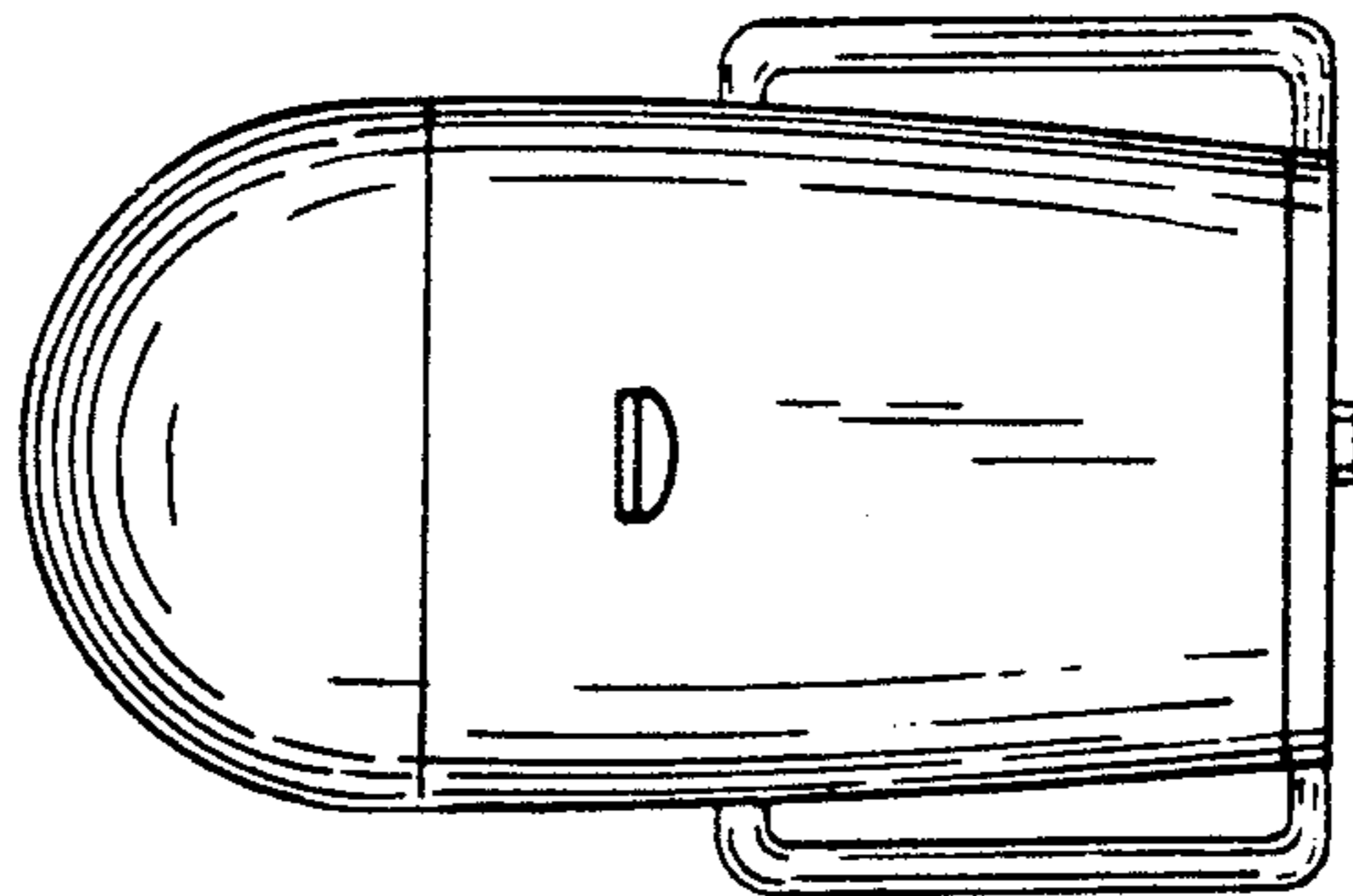

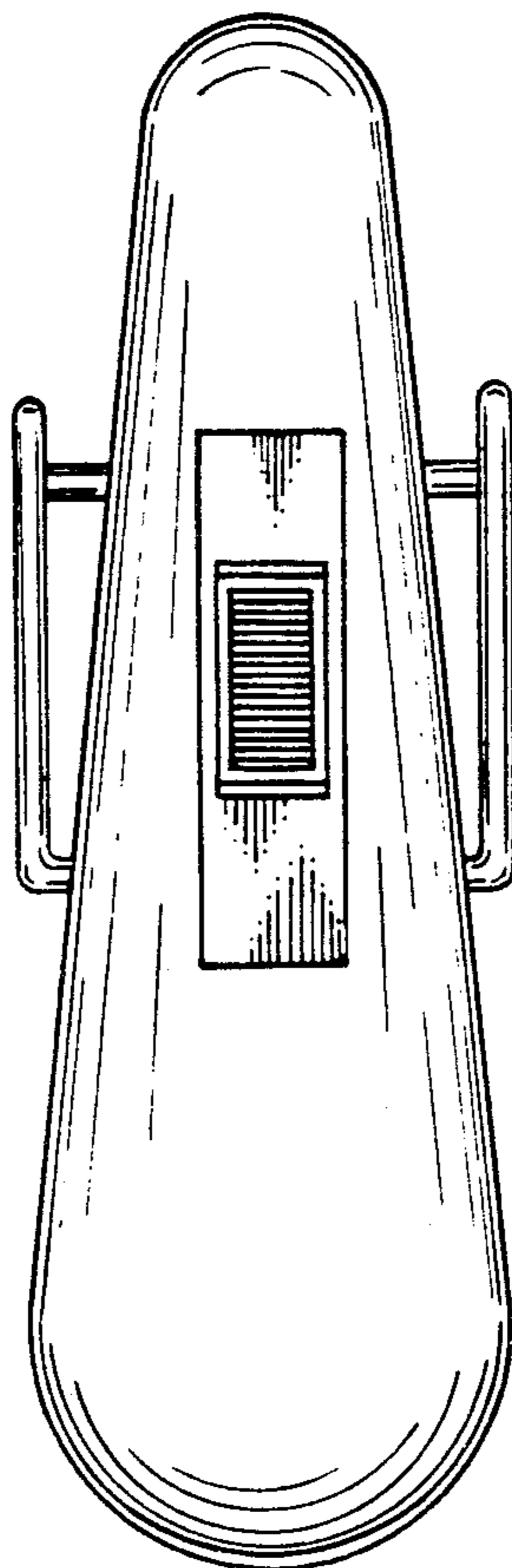

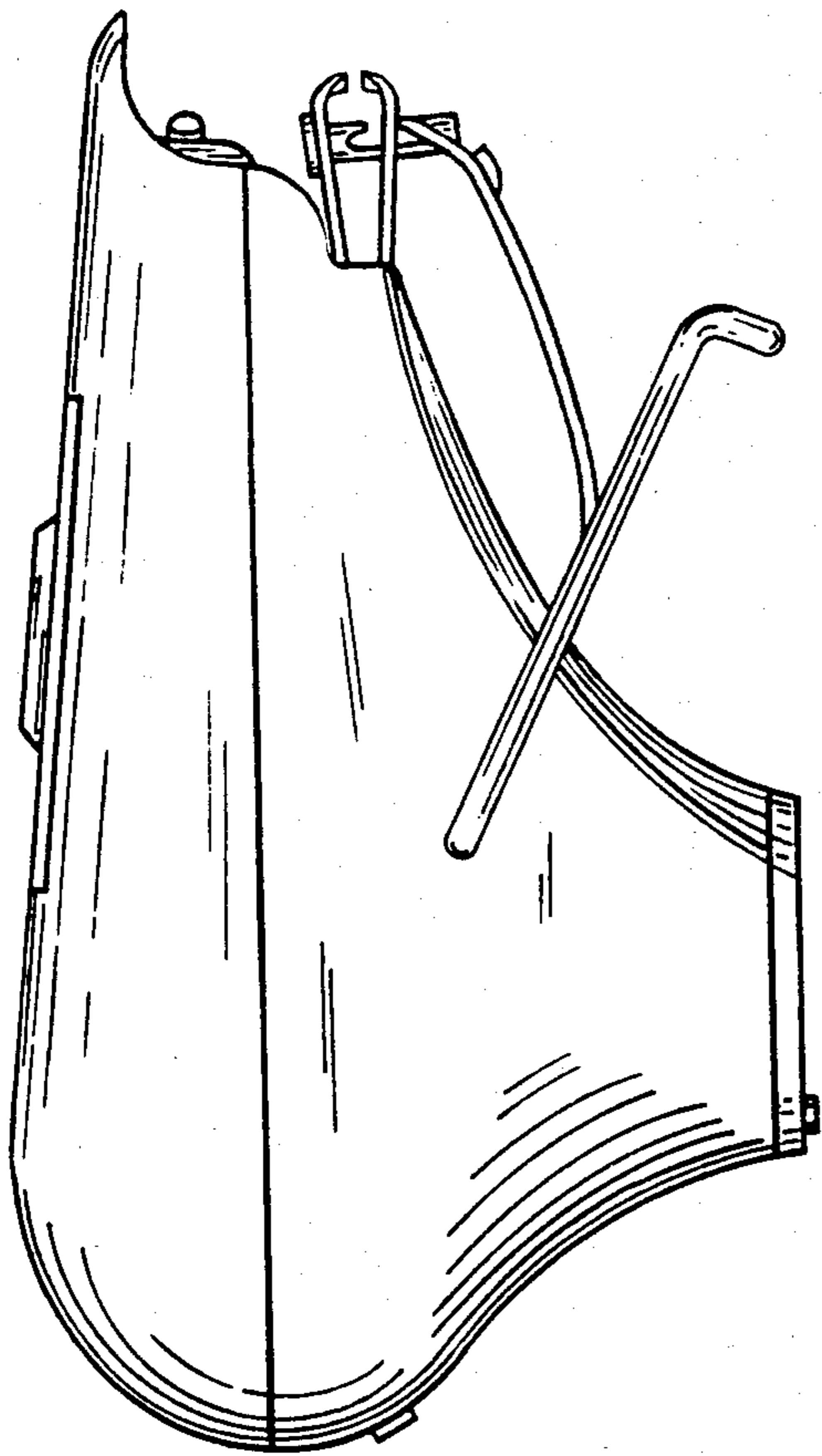

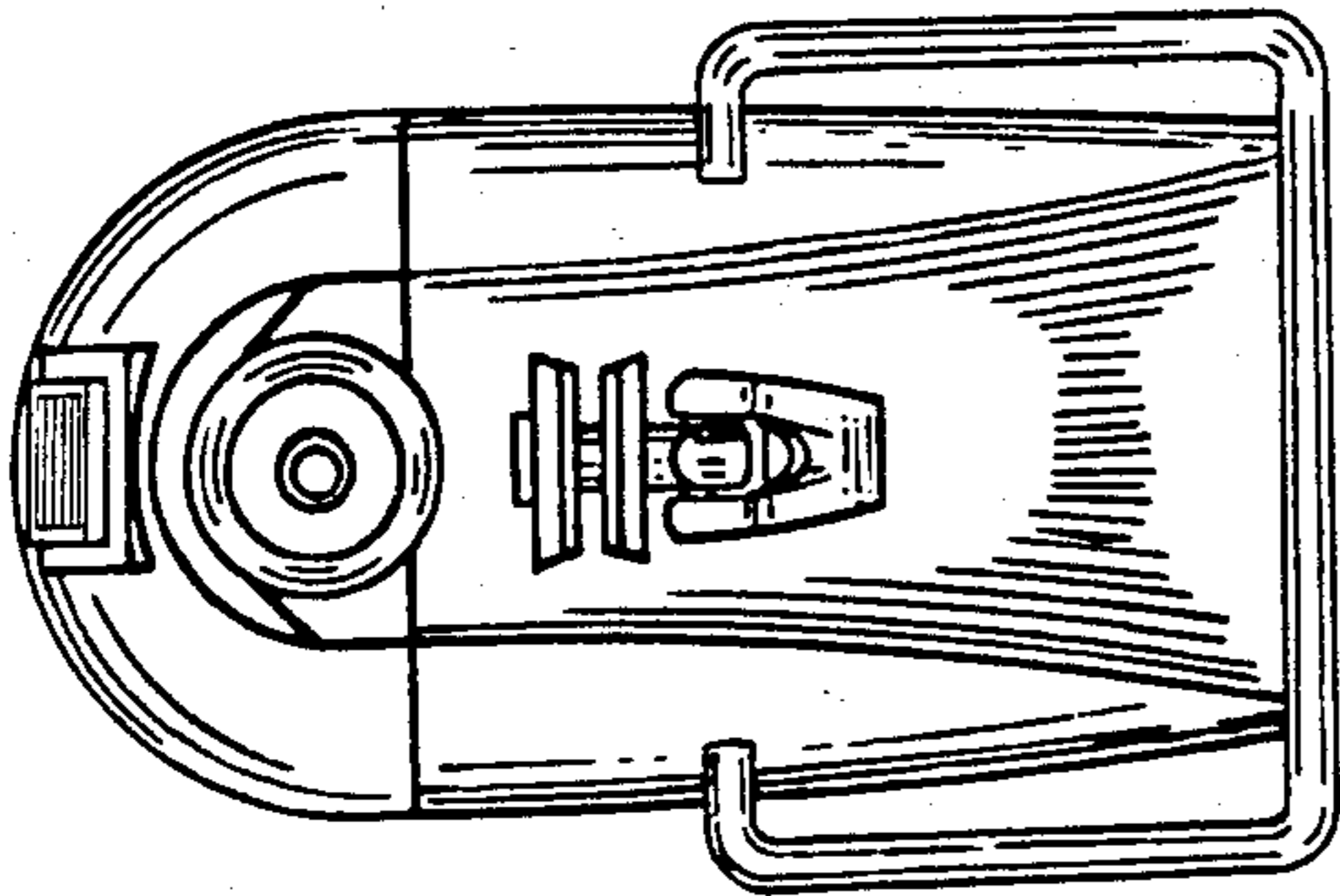

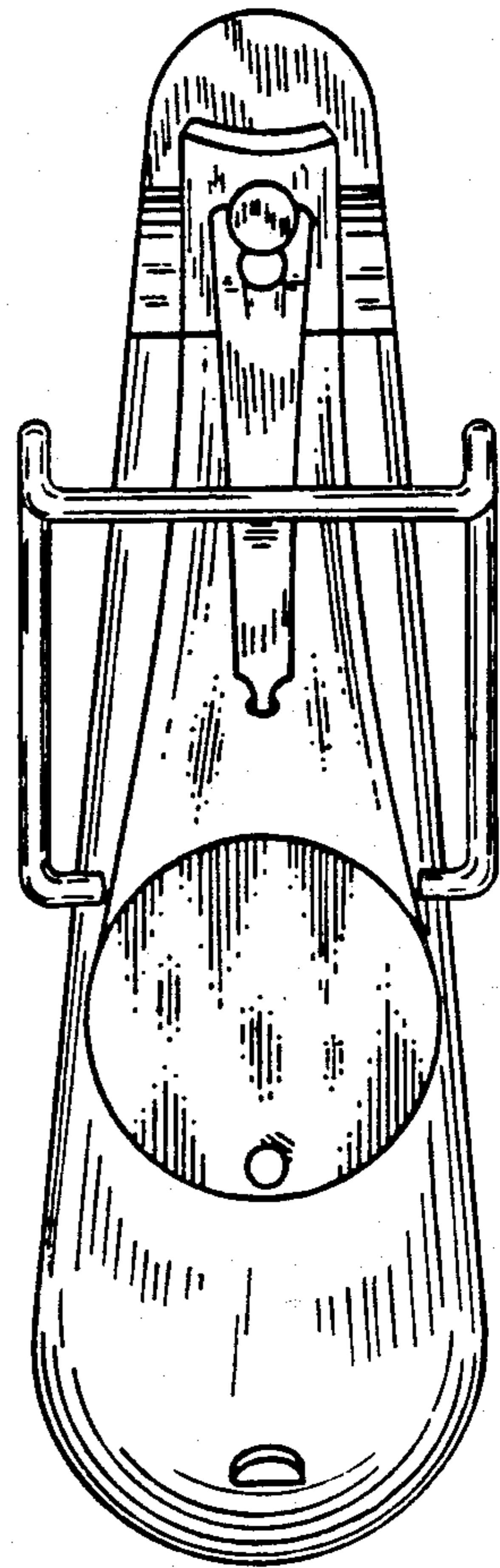
