The ornamental design for a oil lamp wick holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an oil lamp wick holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevation view thereof on an enlarged scale.
The broken line representation of a bottle and flame in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.



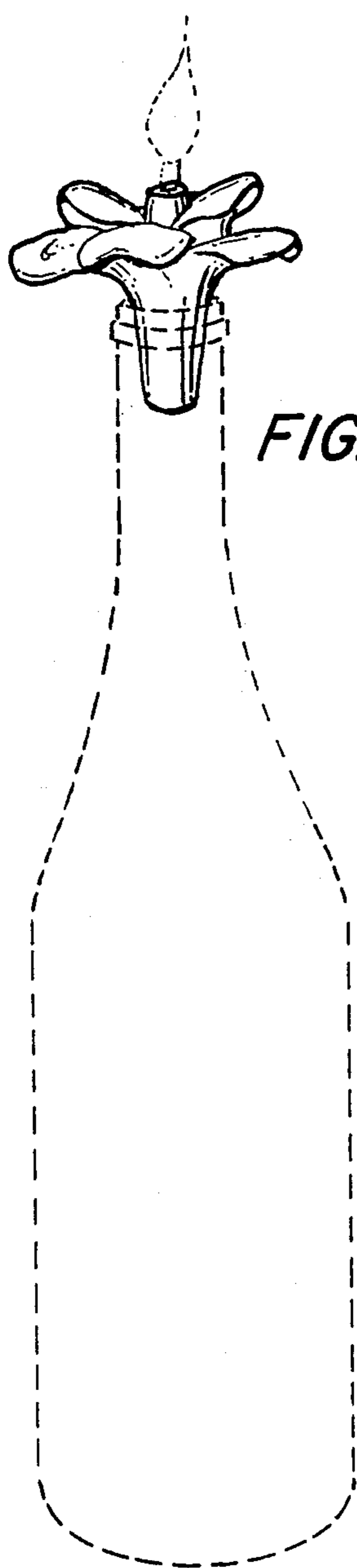

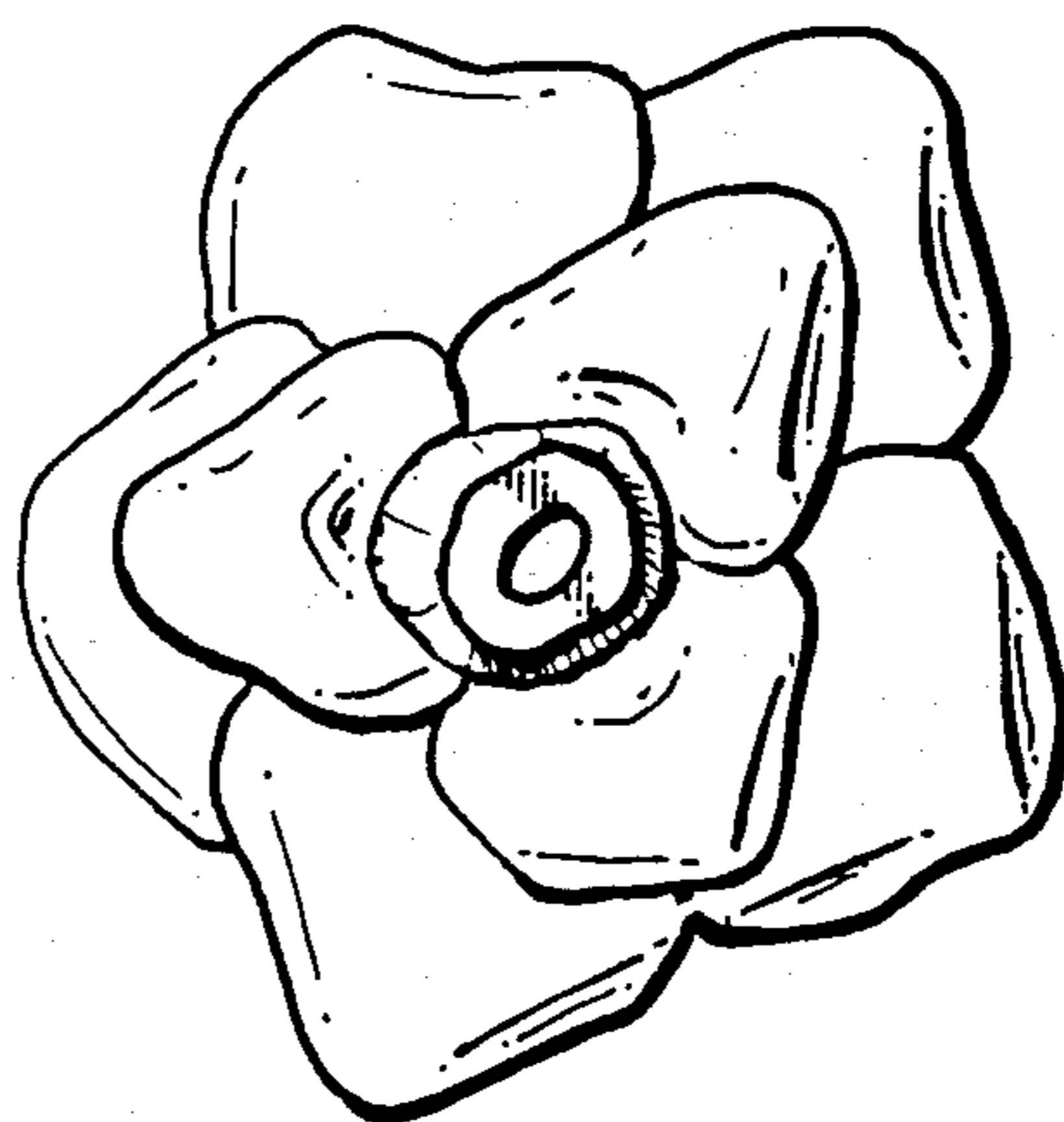

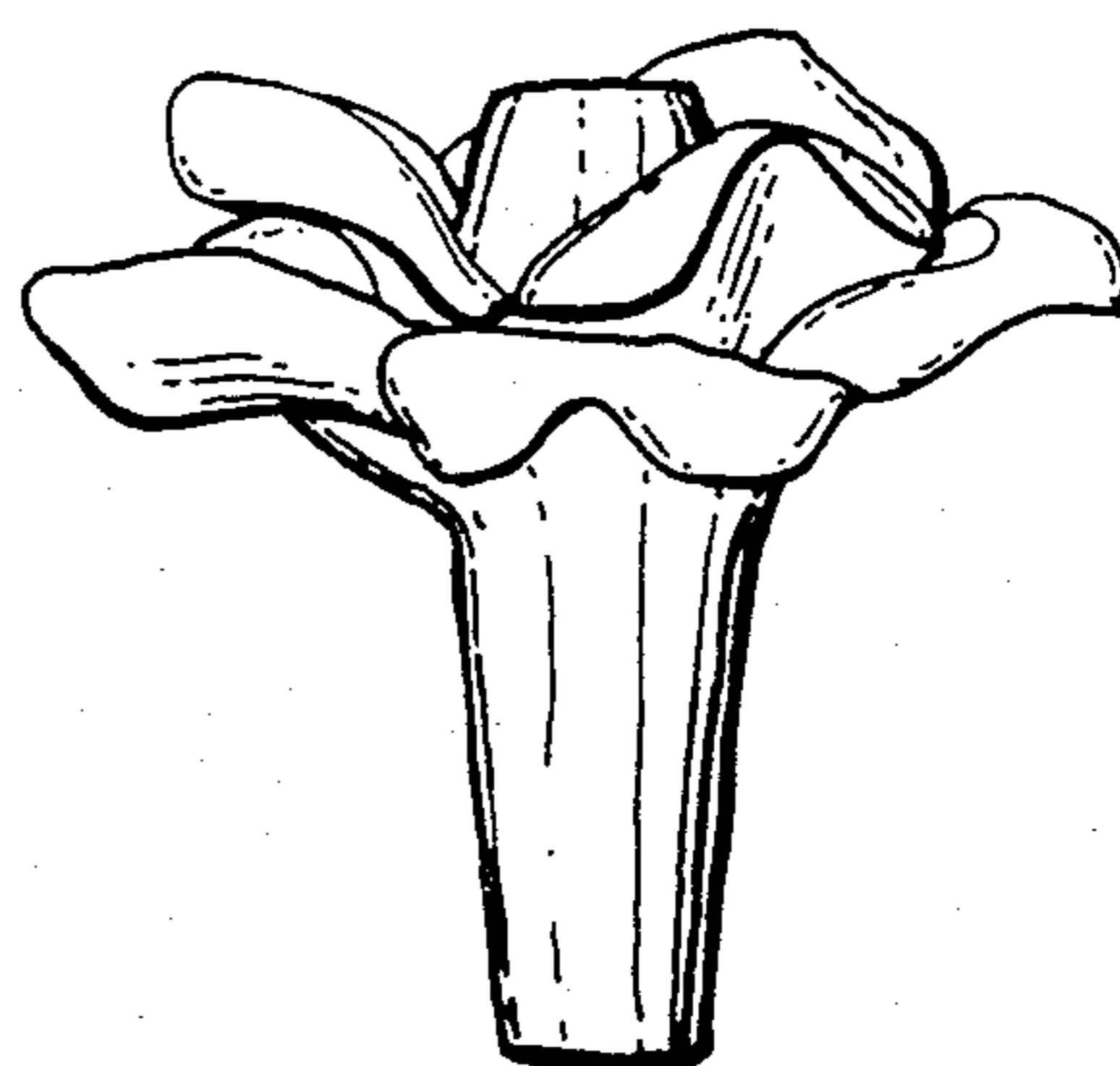

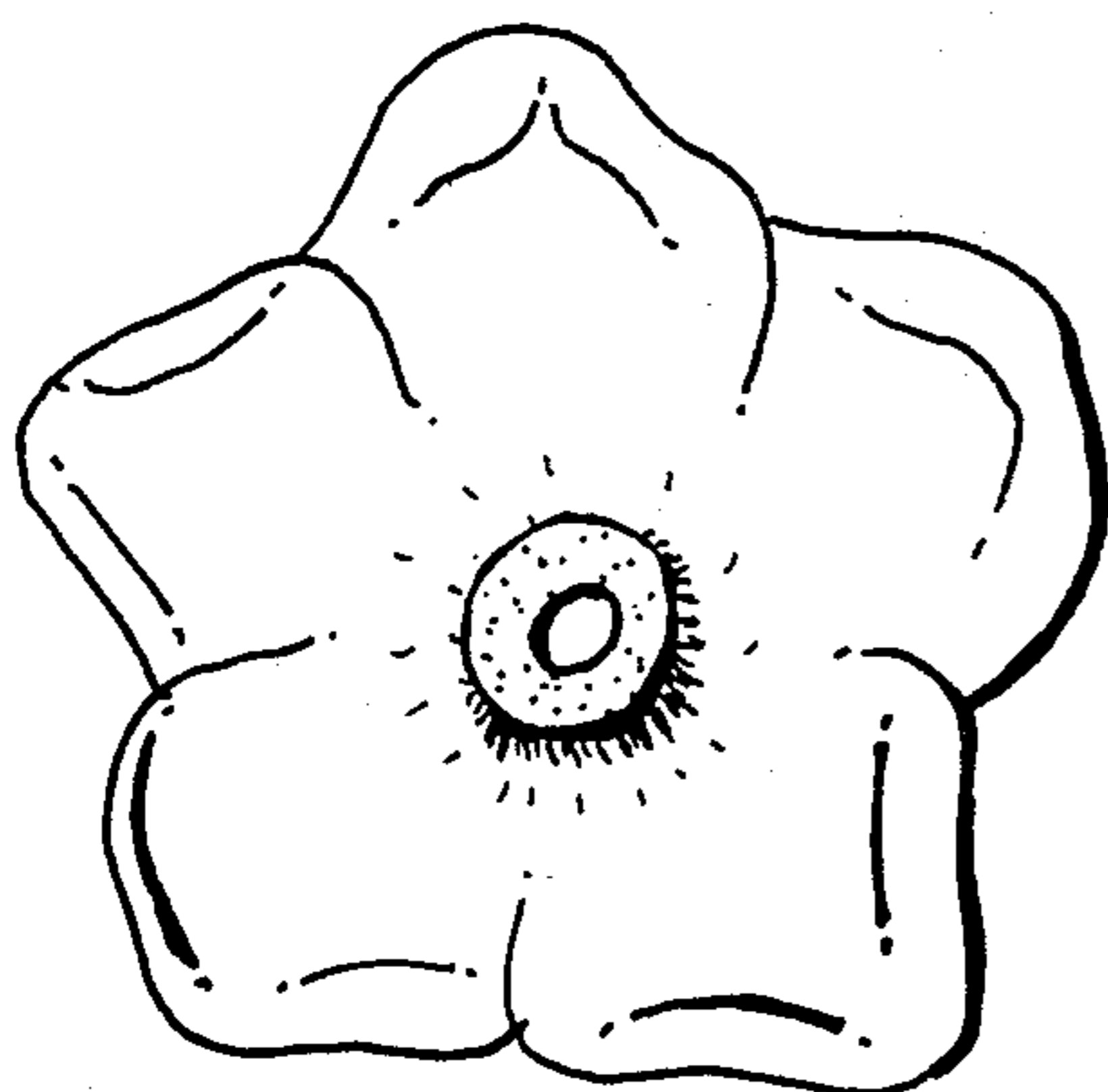

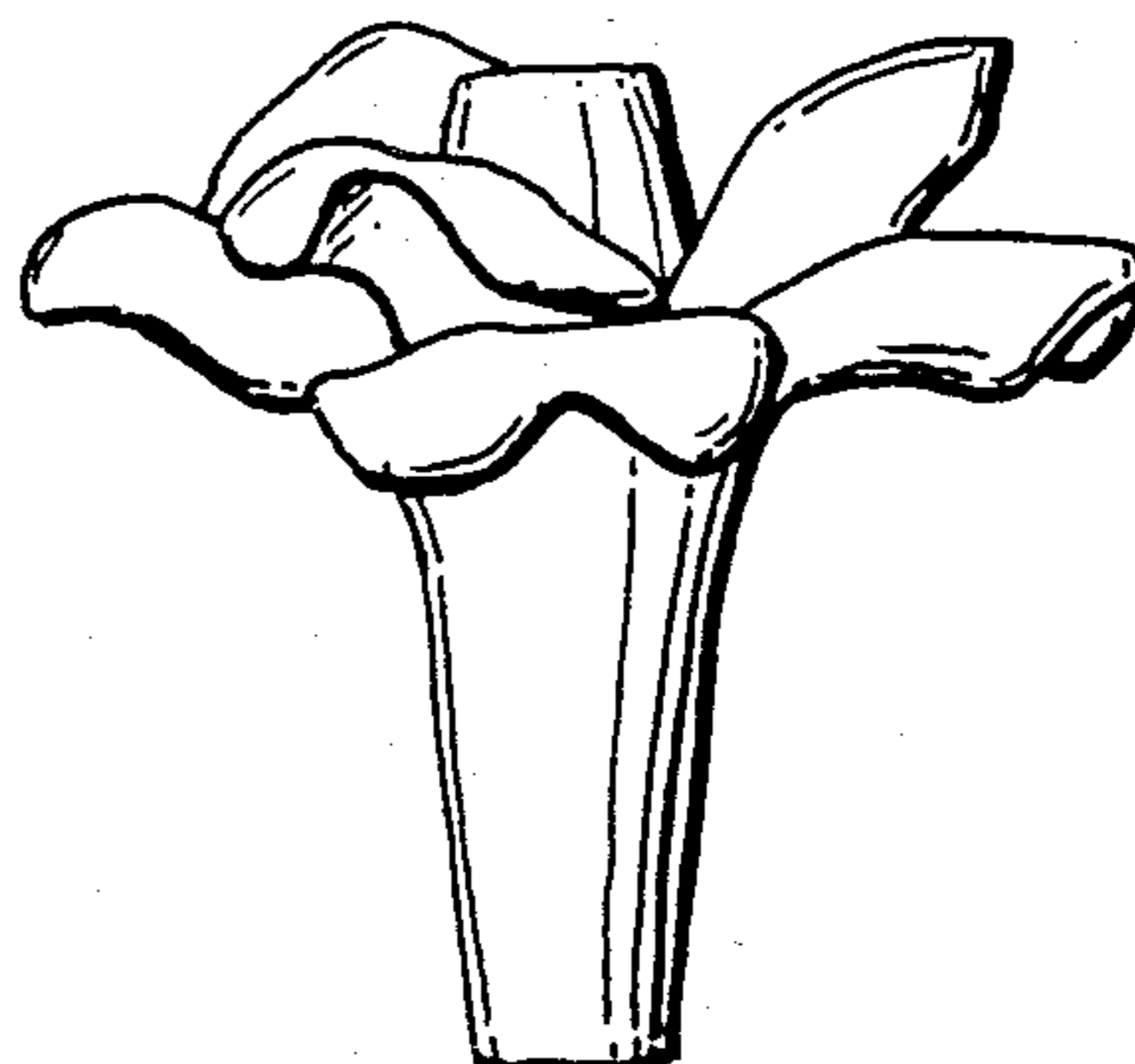
