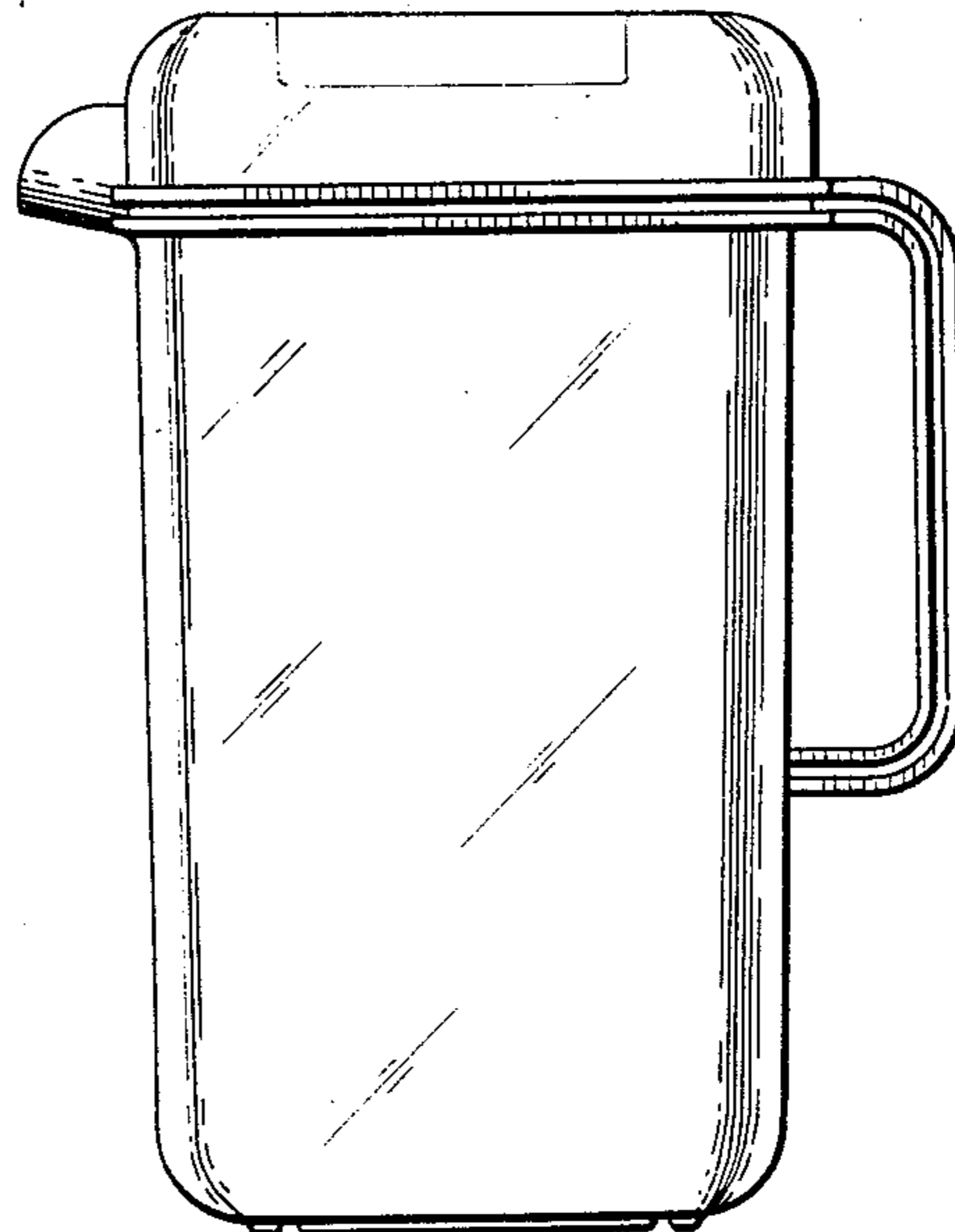
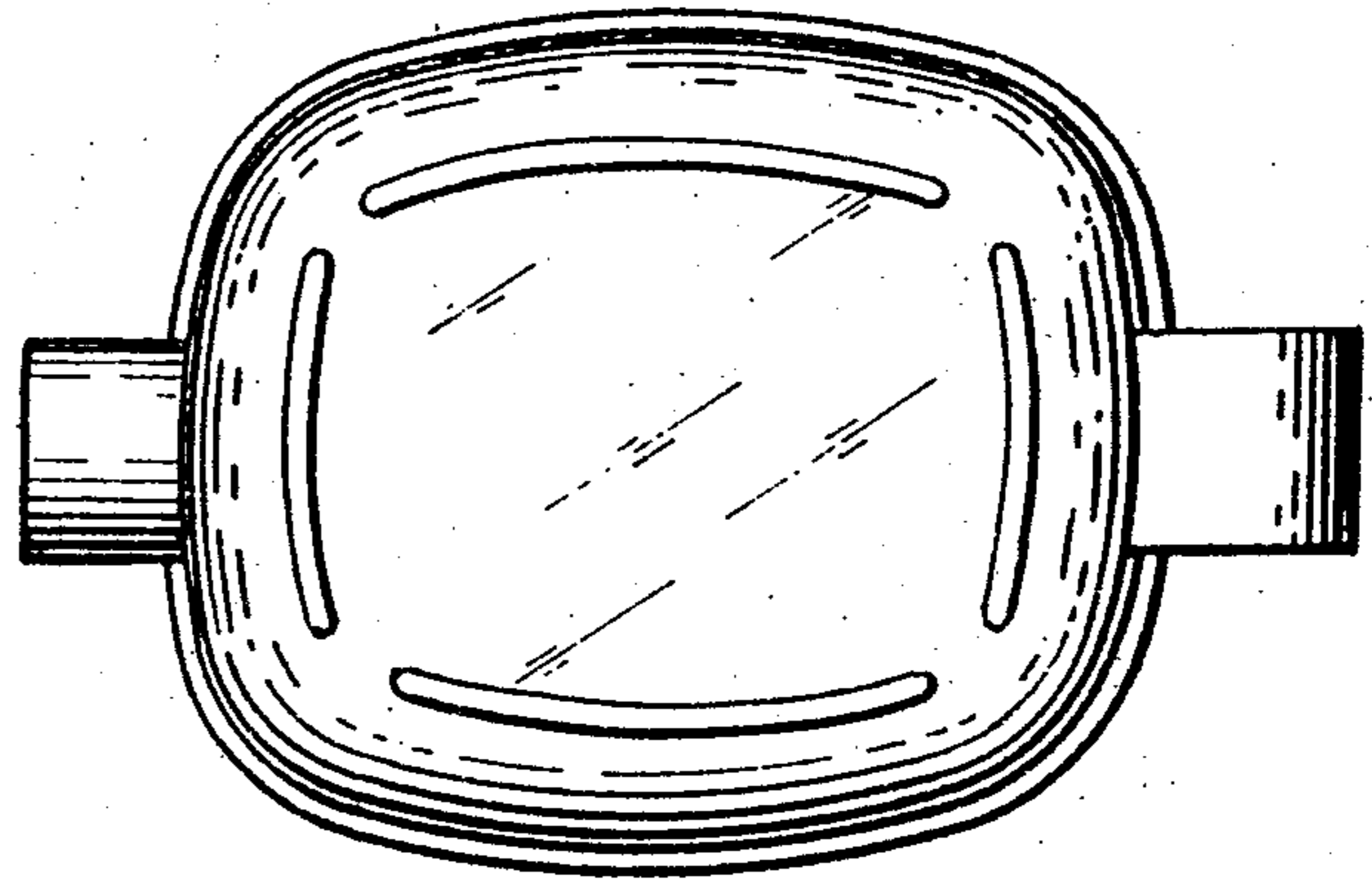
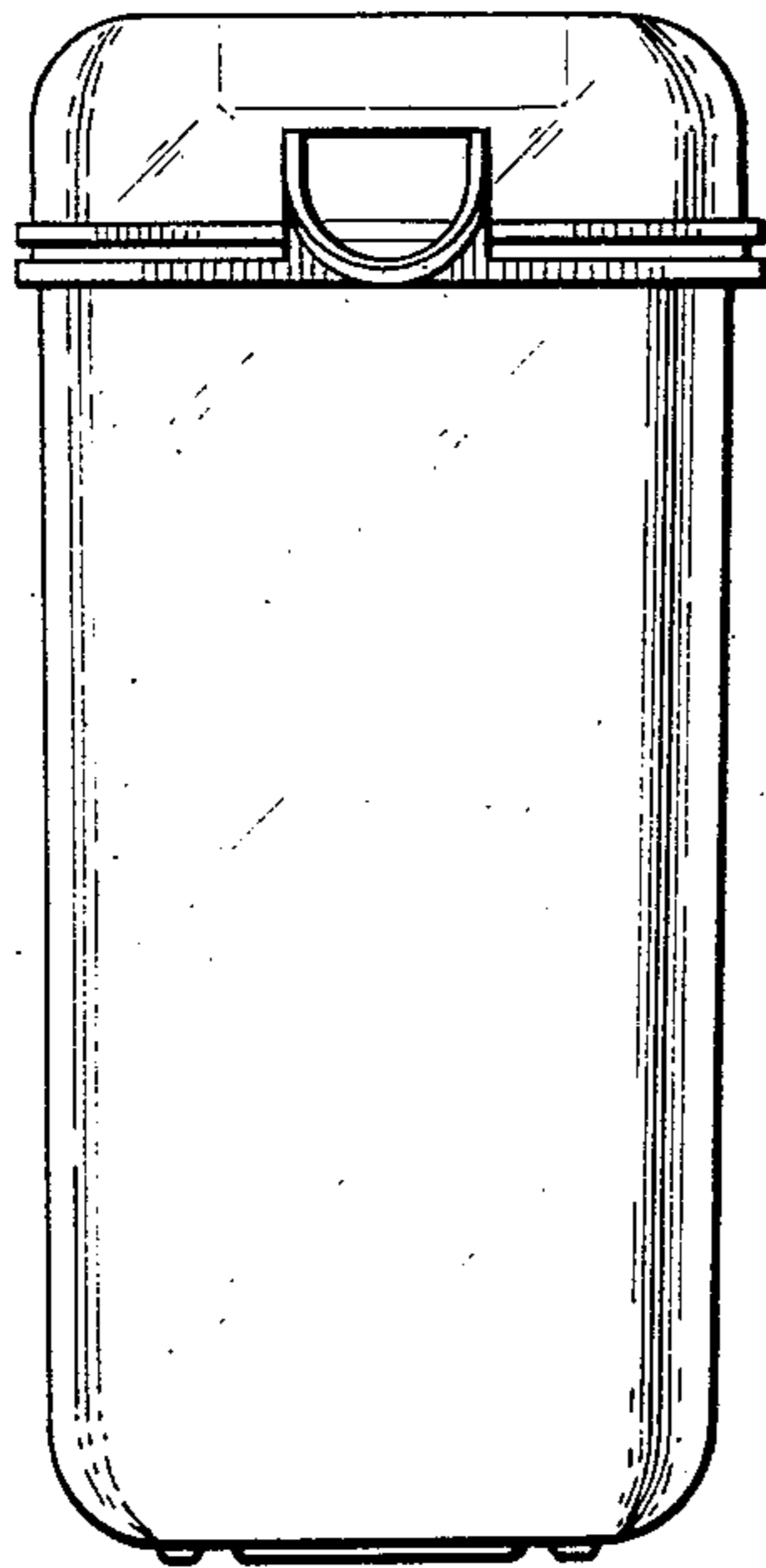

The ornamental design for a pitcher, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pitcher showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the other side being a mirror image of this side;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



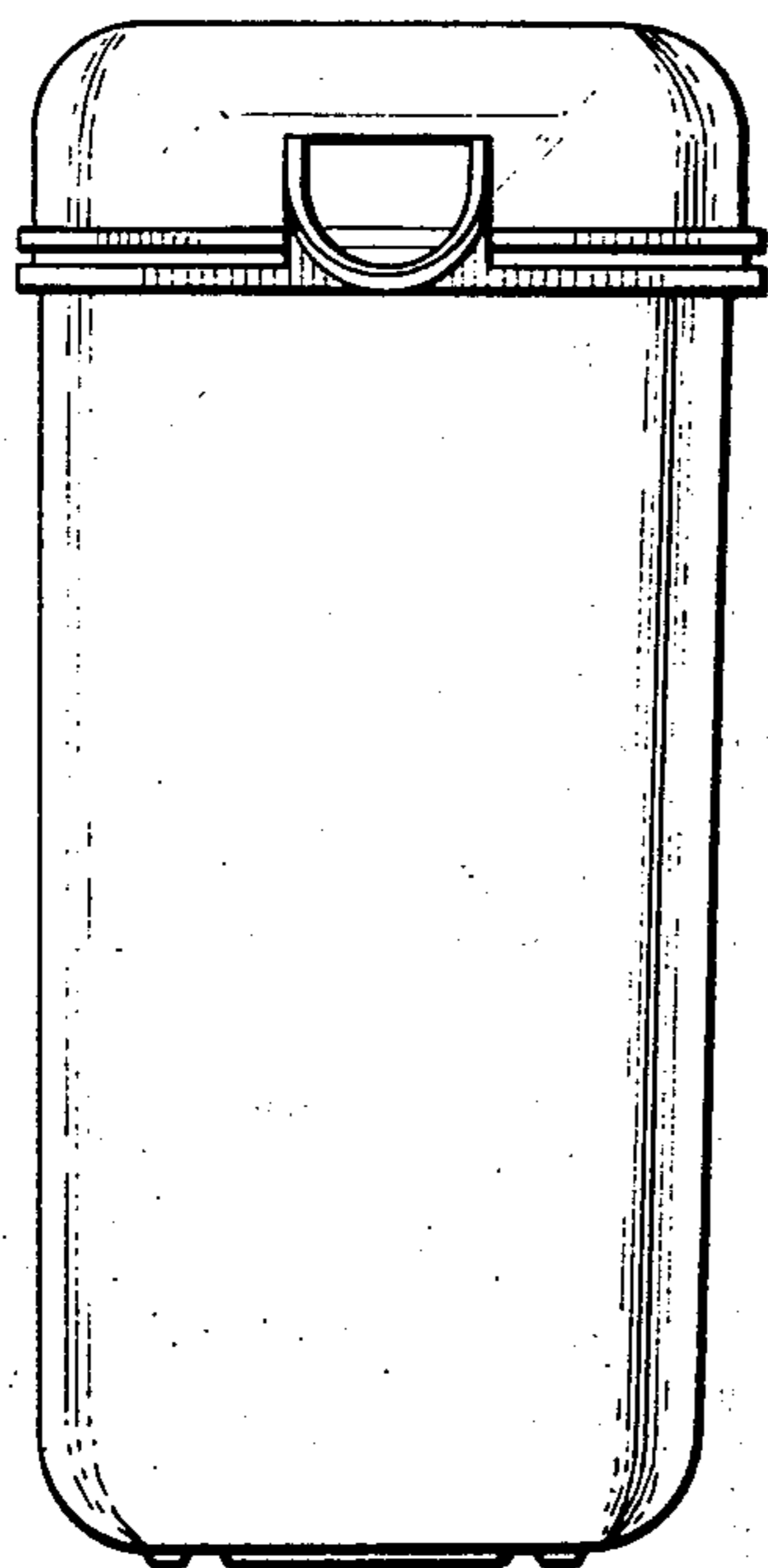

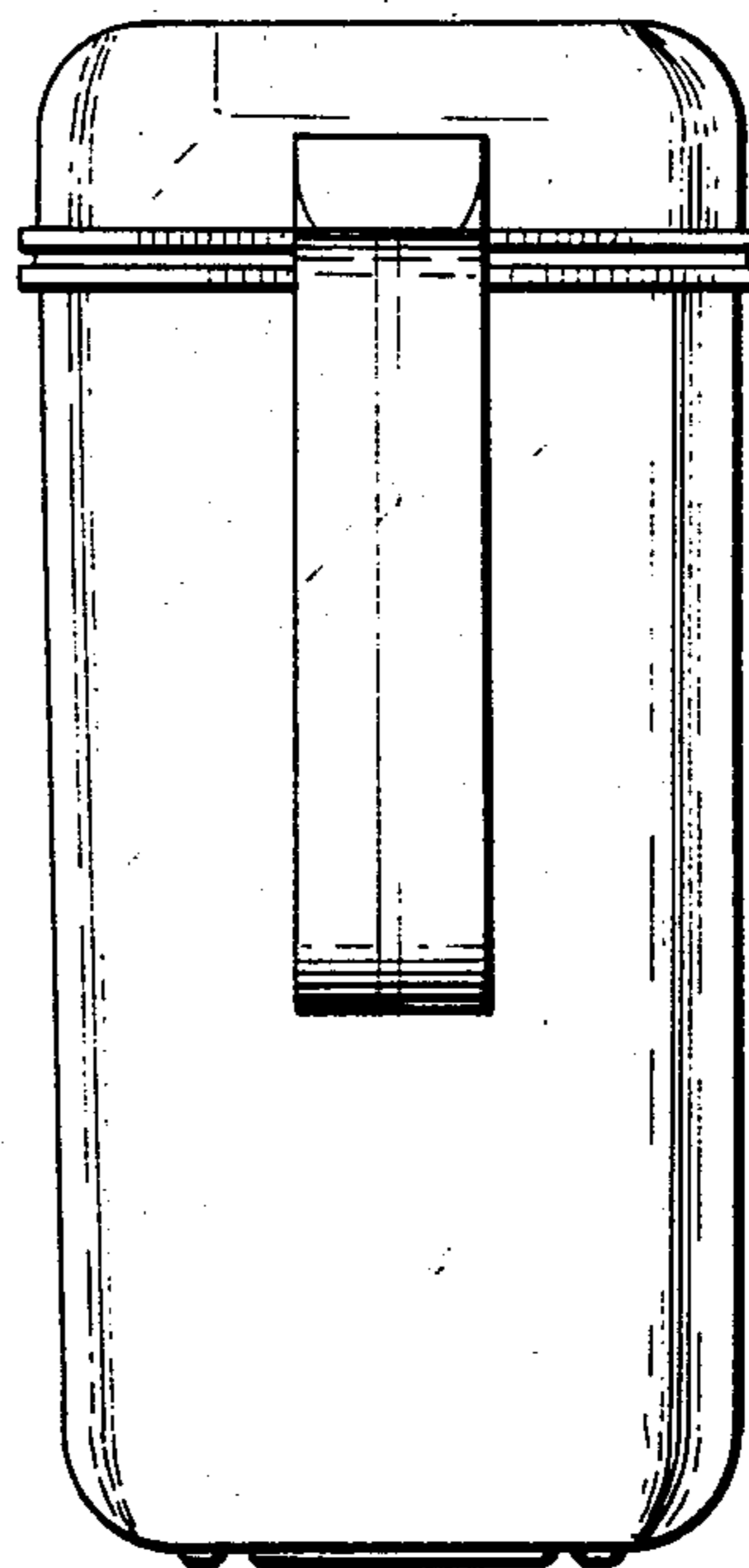

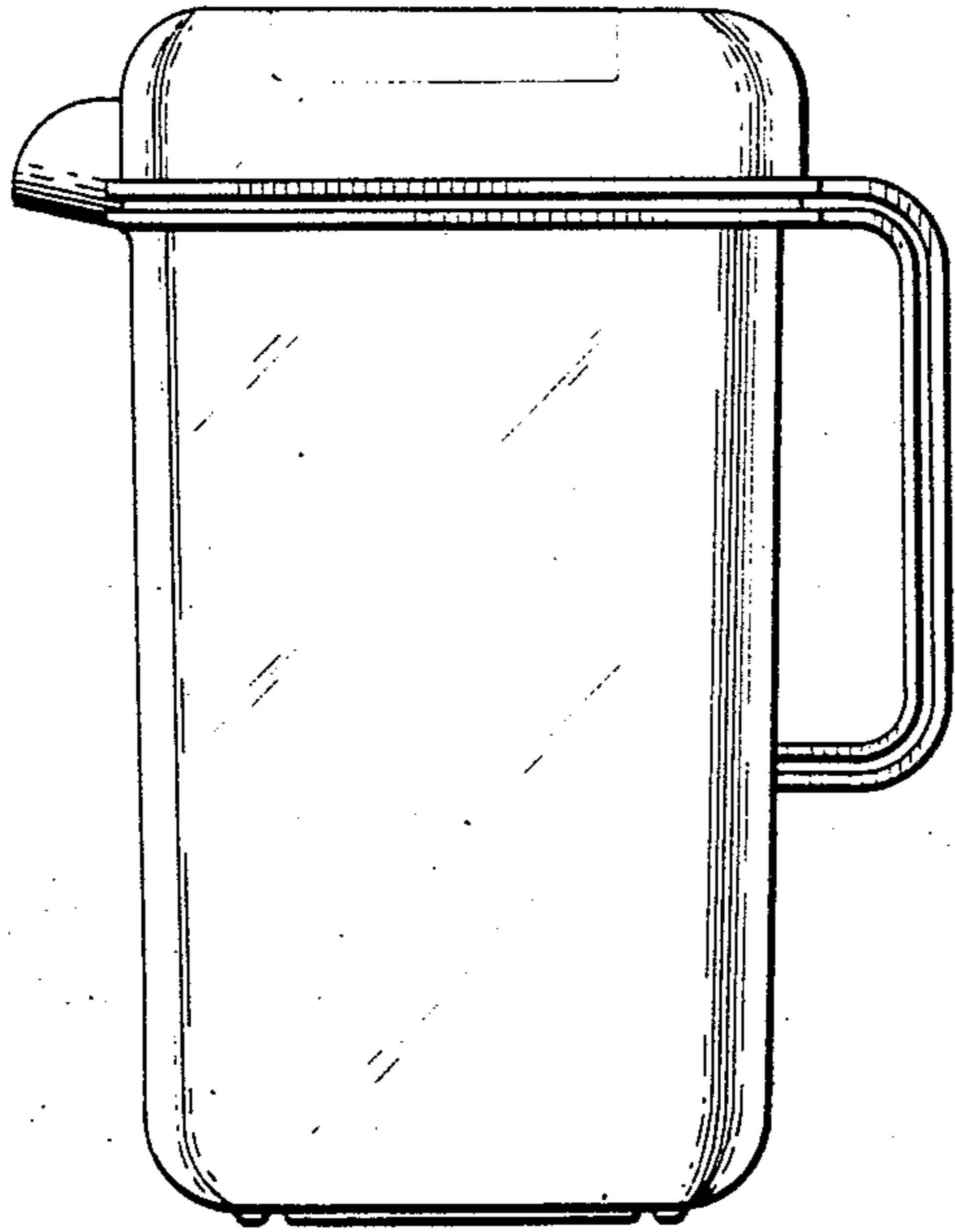

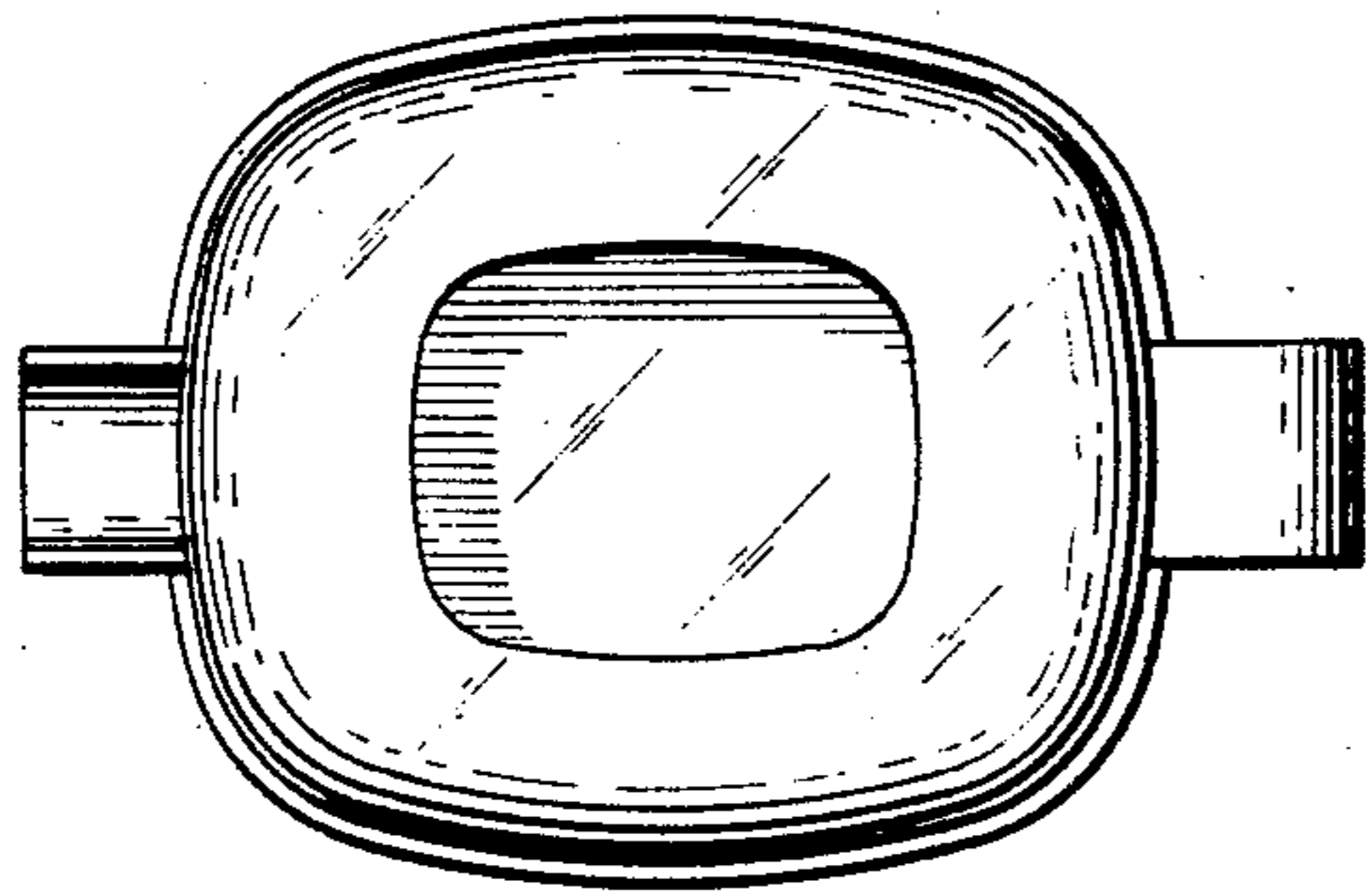

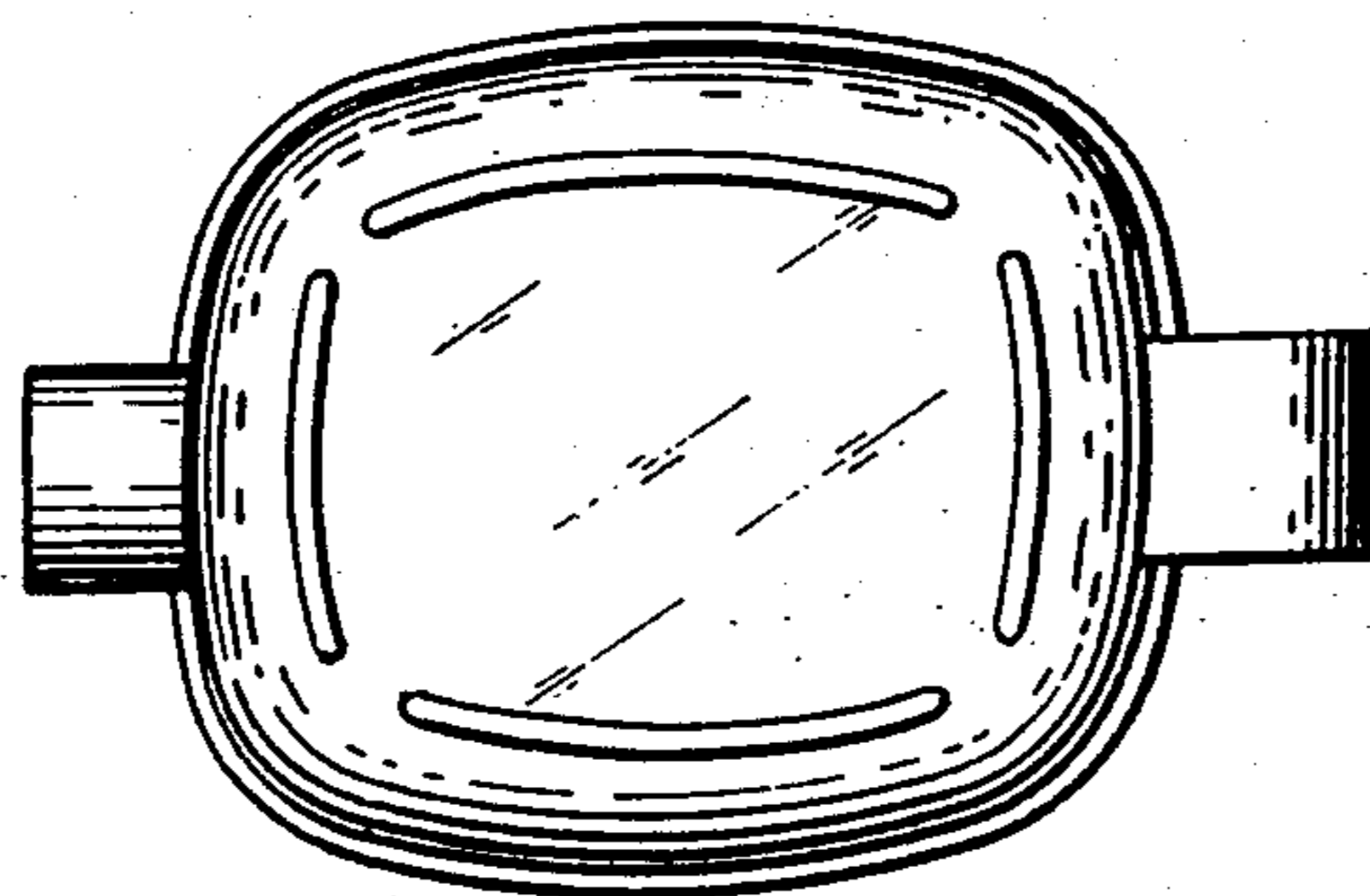
