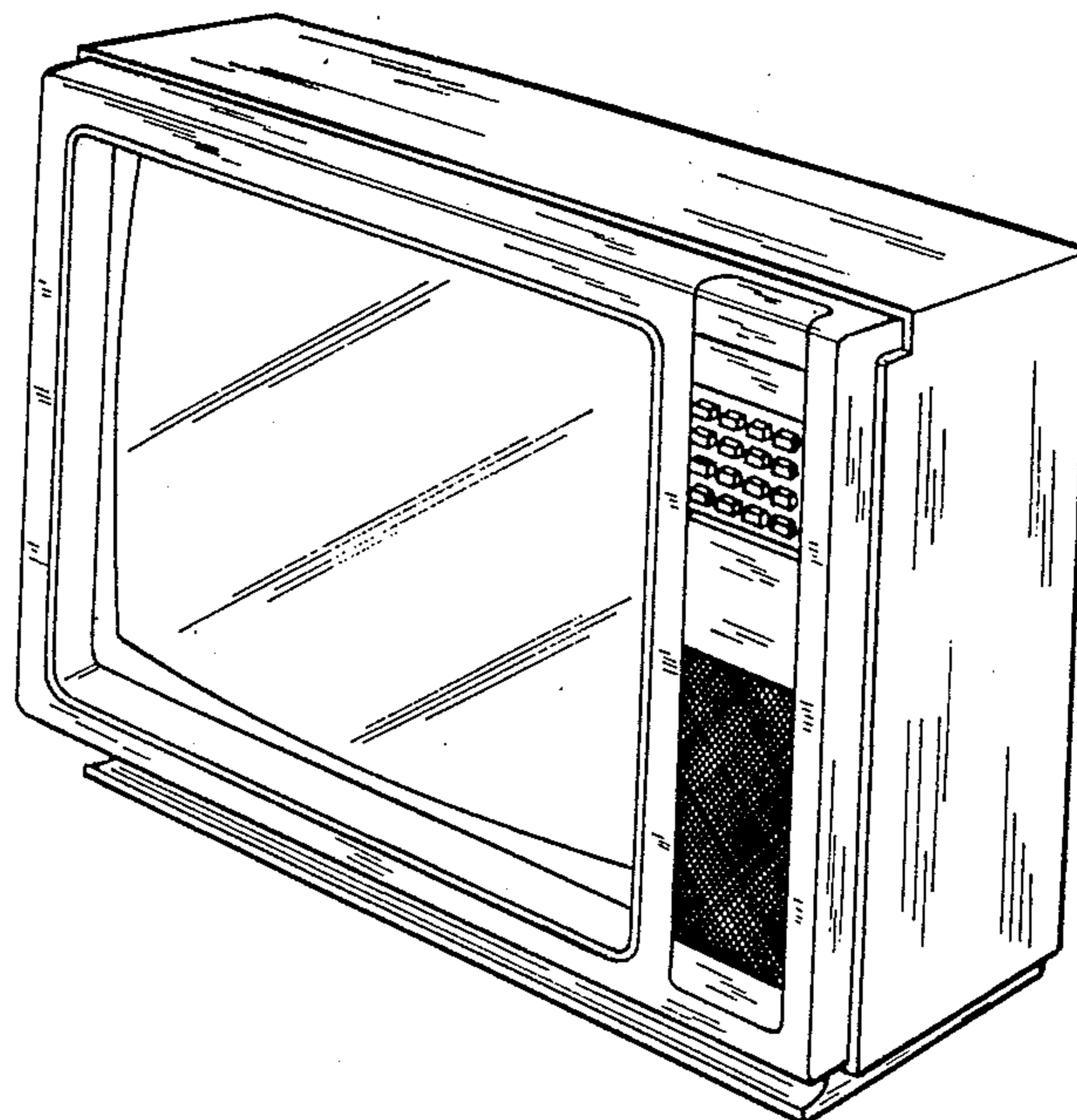

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a television receiver showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; (left side elevational view is symmetrical about the right side elevational view)
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



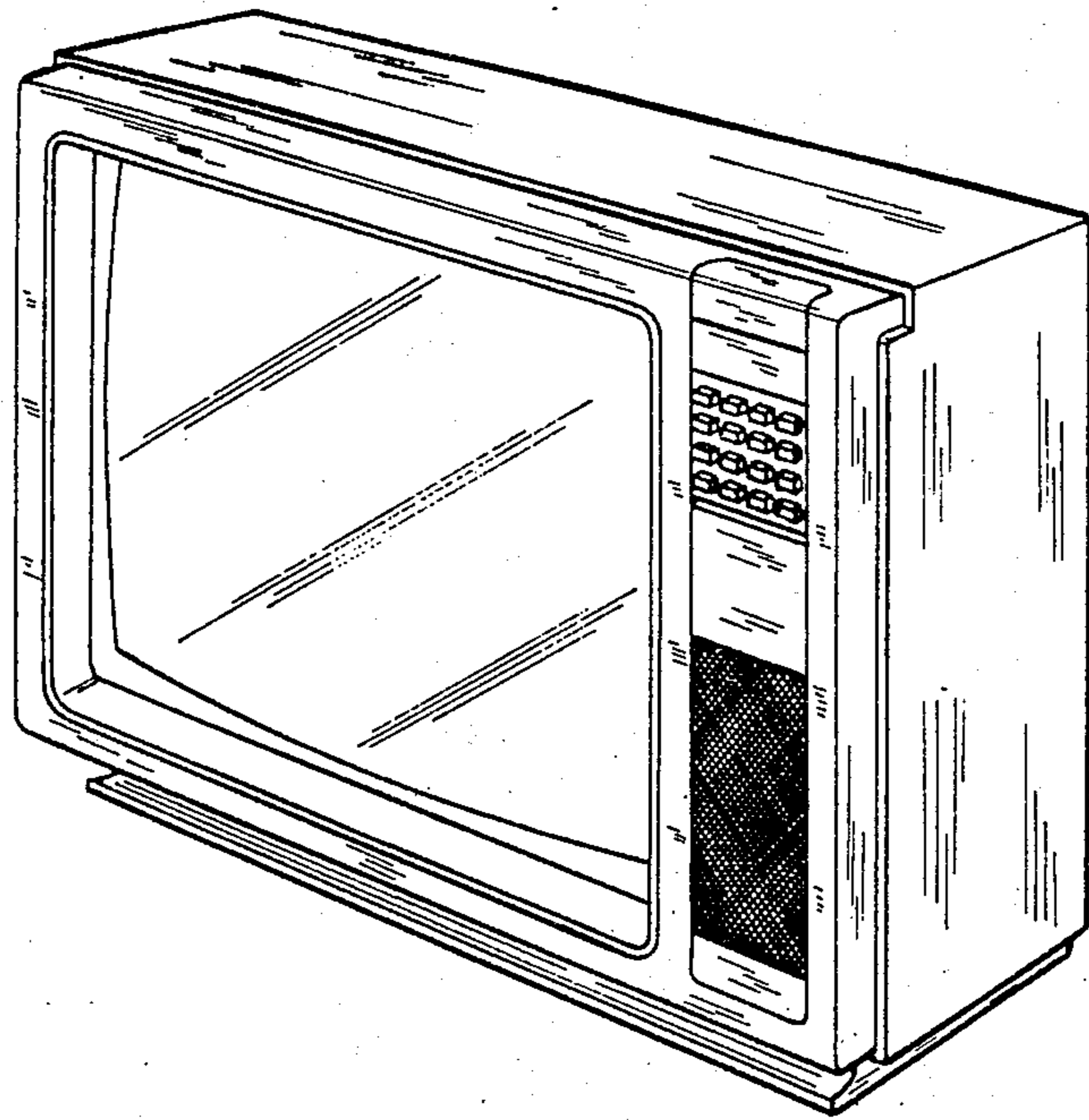

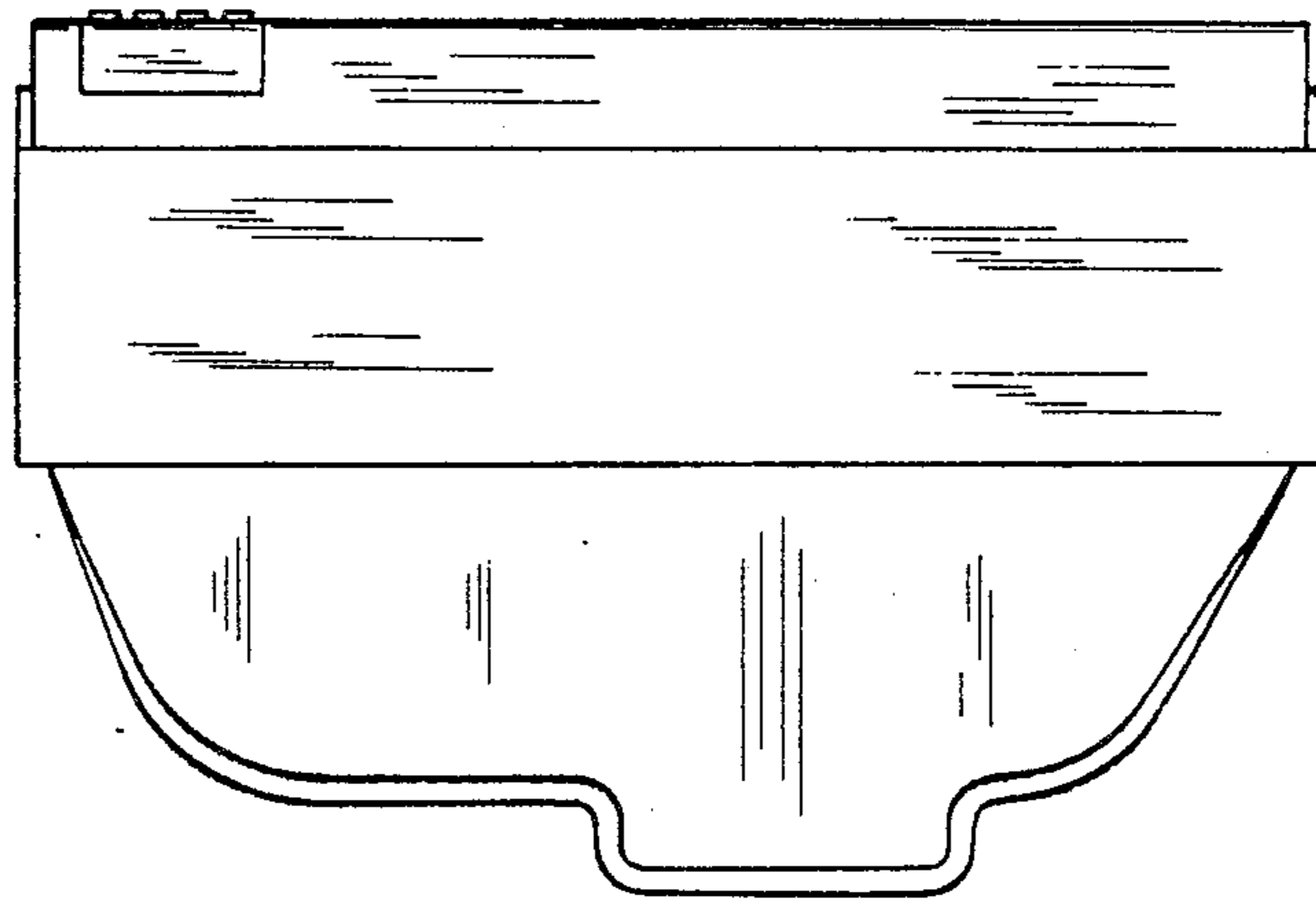

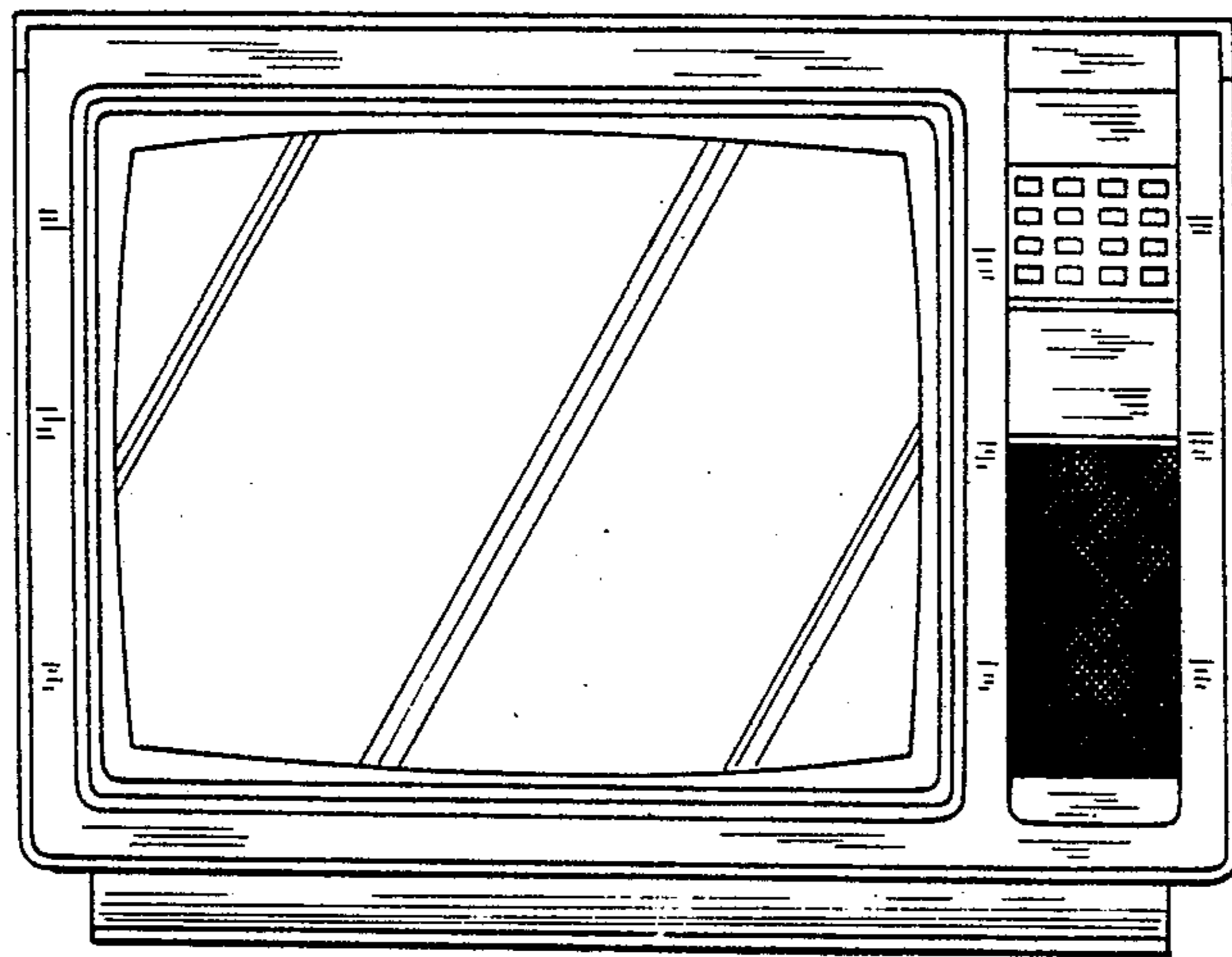

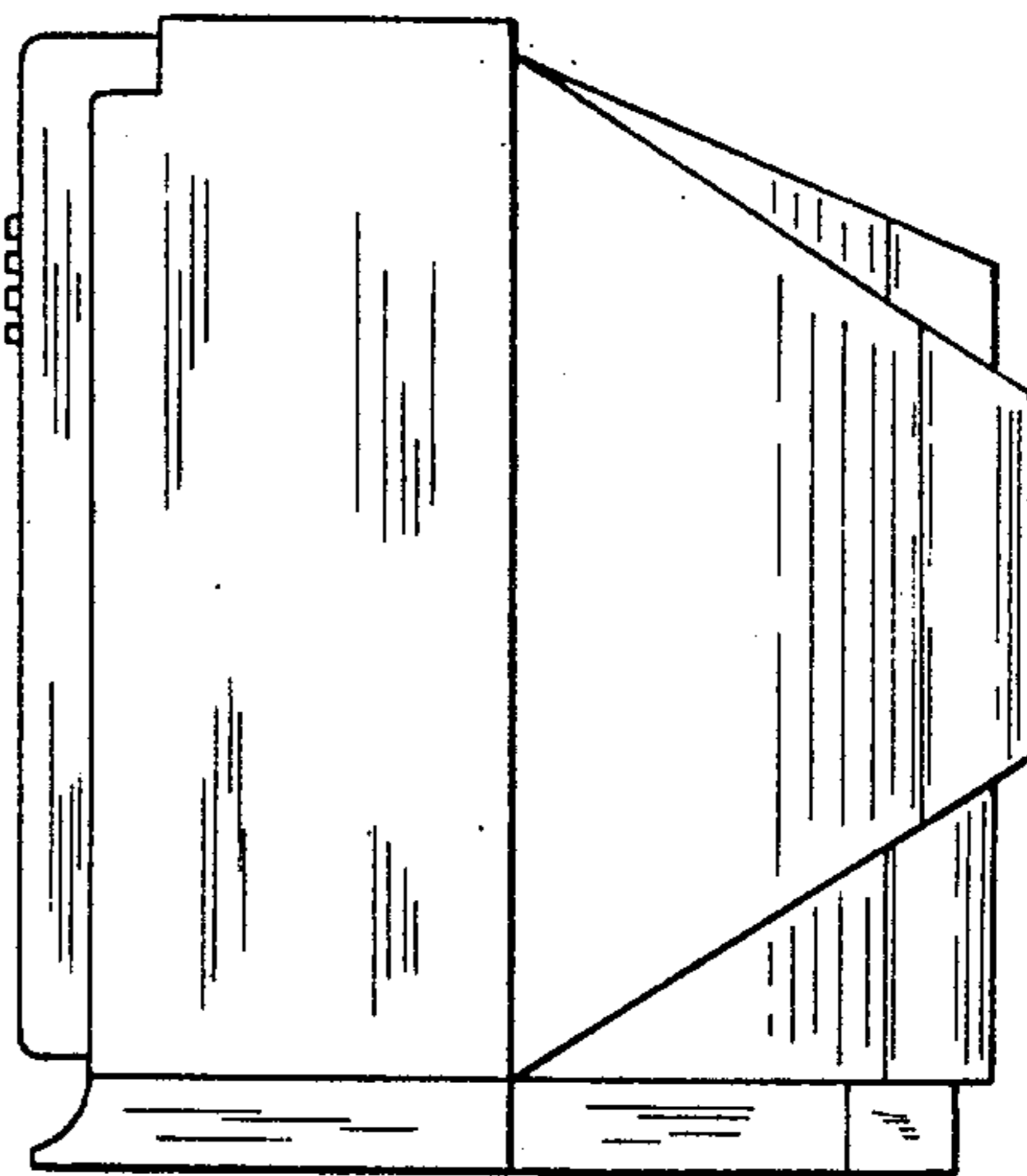

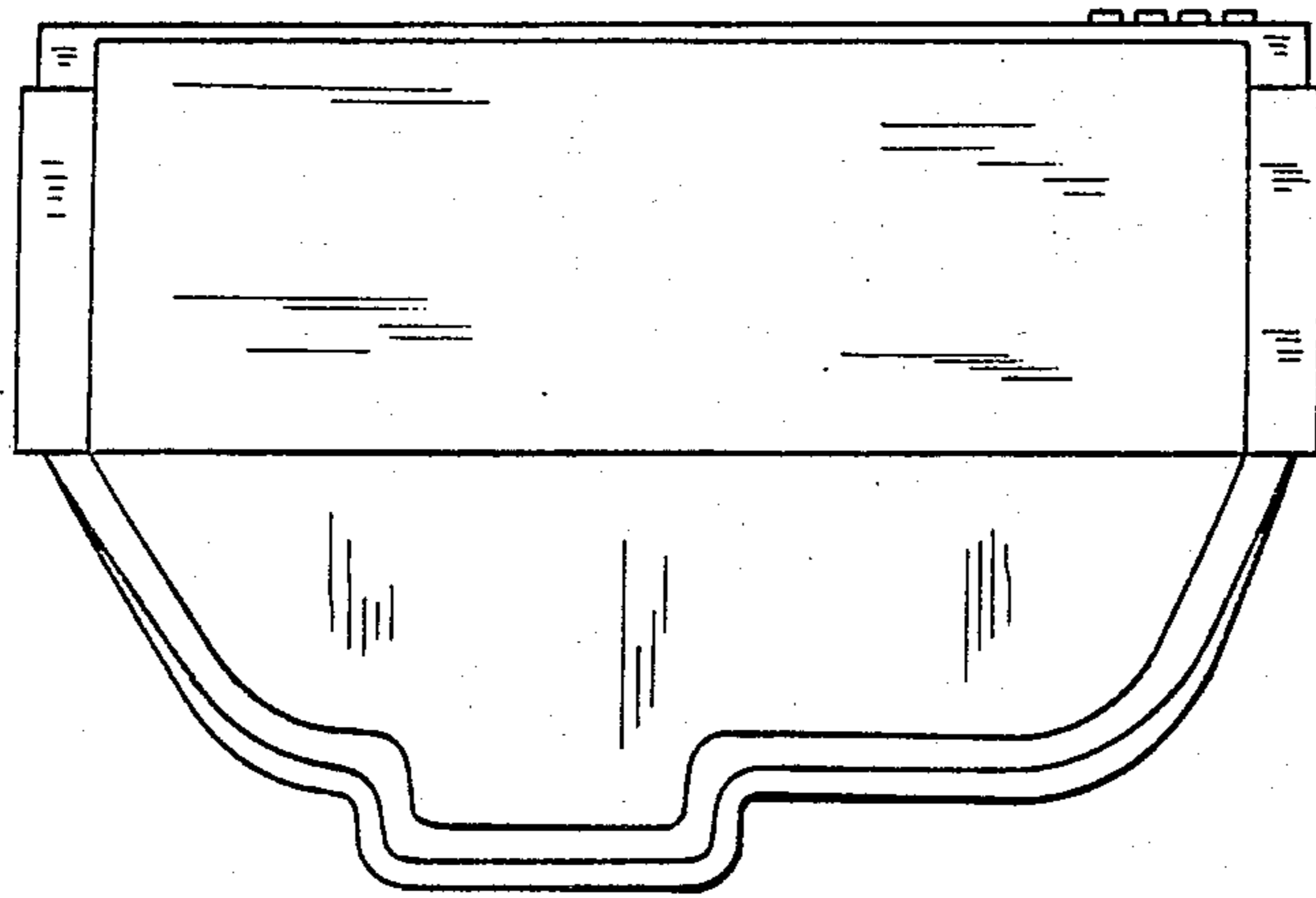

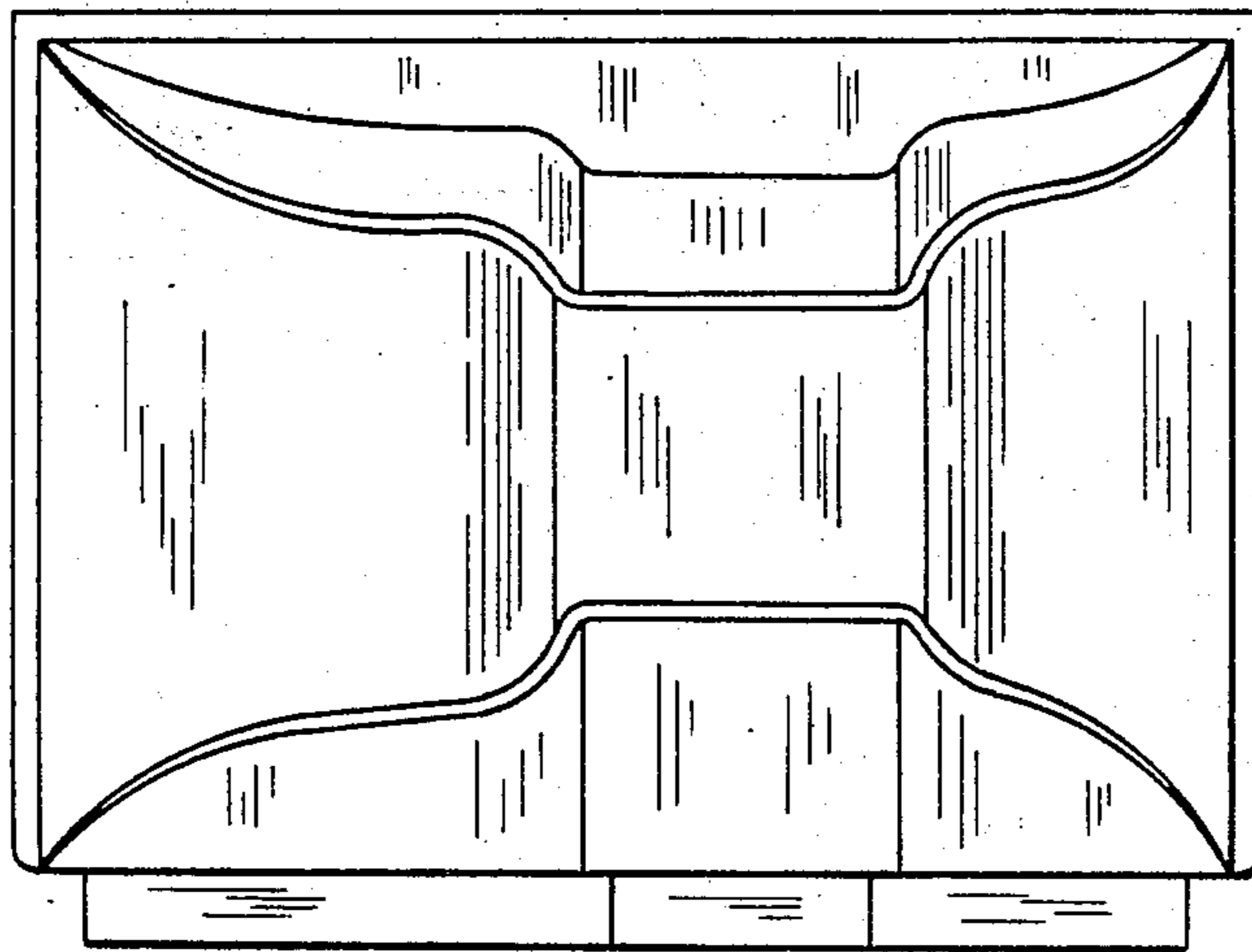
