The ornamental design for a toilet seat, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a toilet seat embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 5.

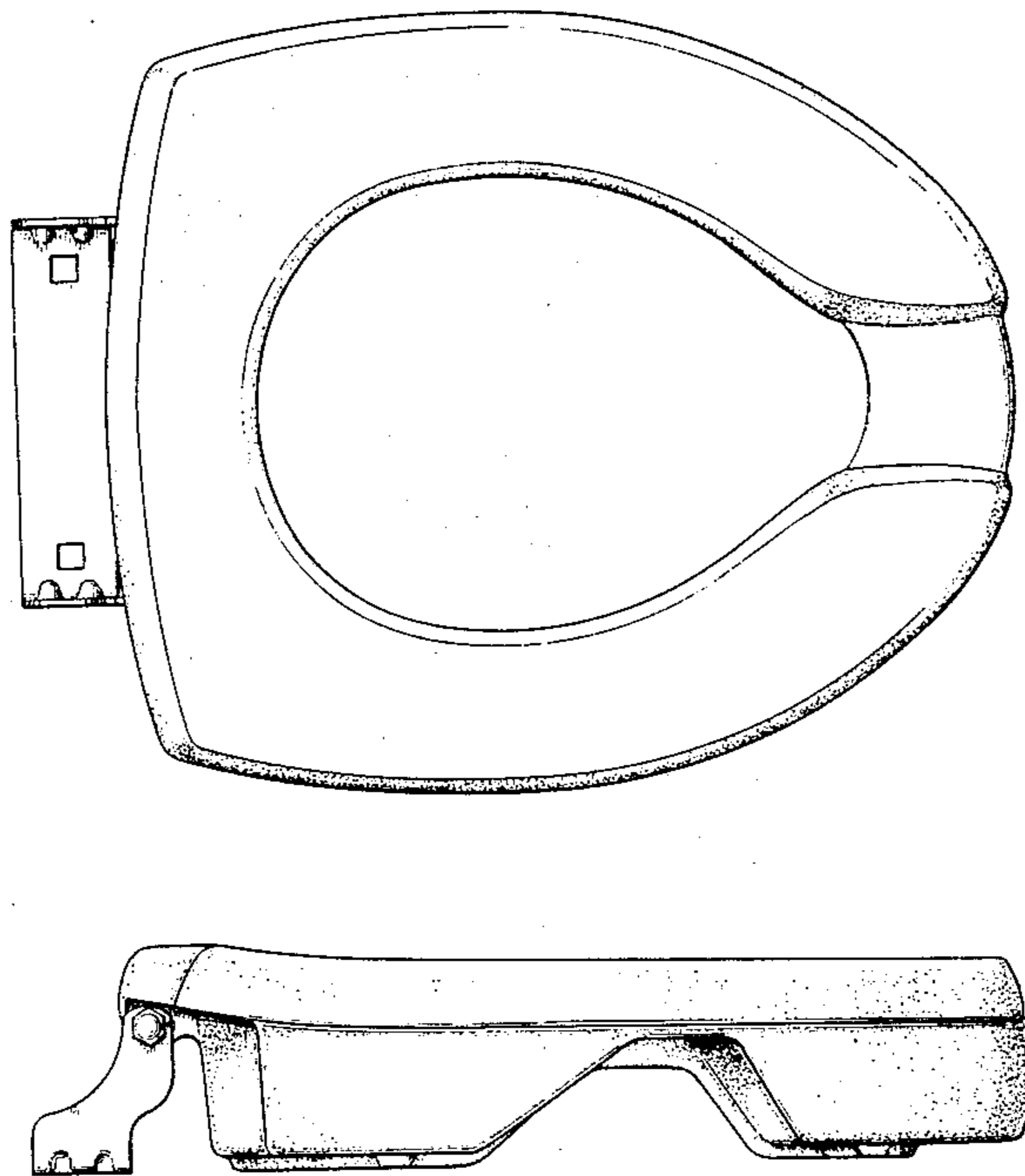

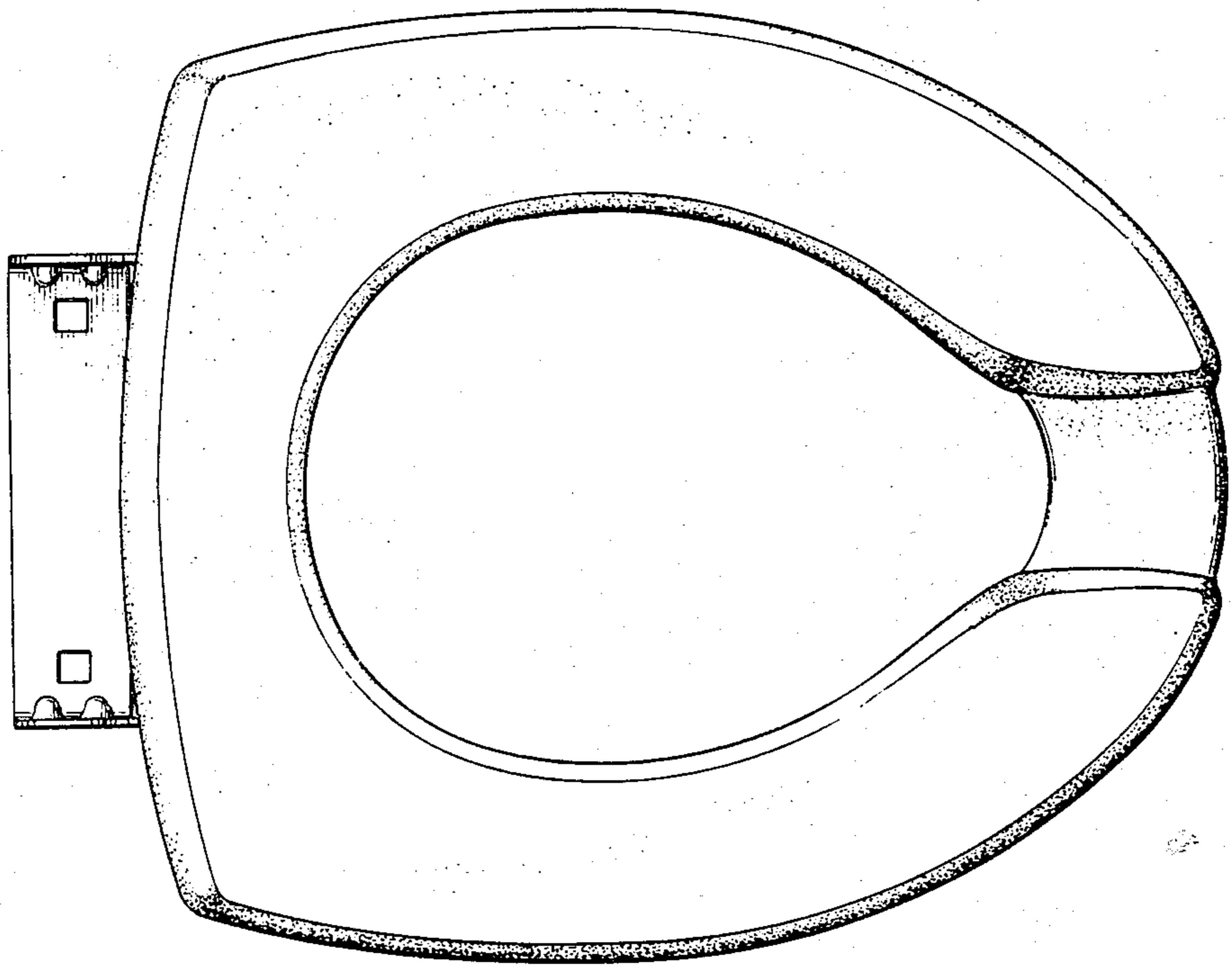

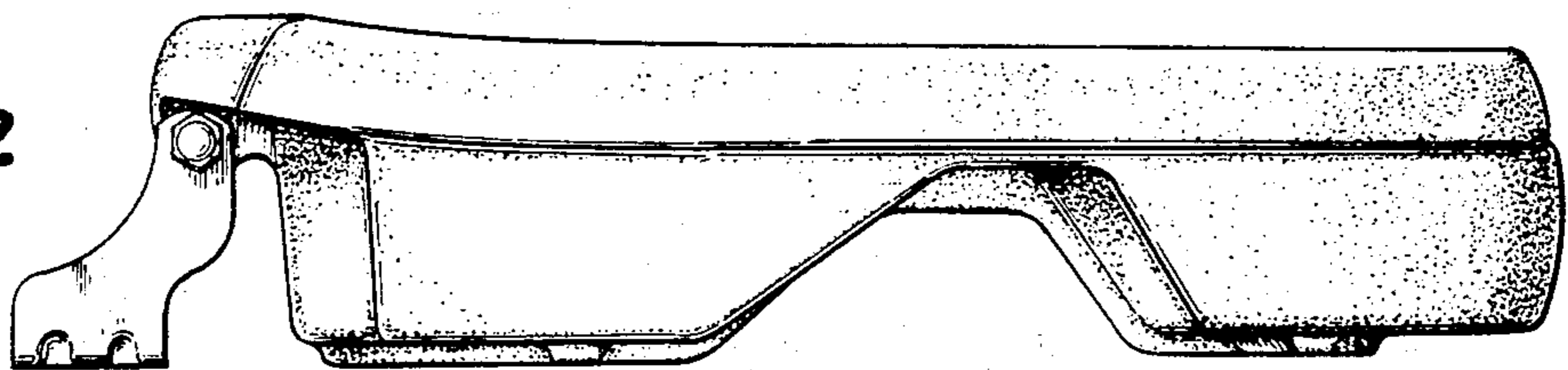

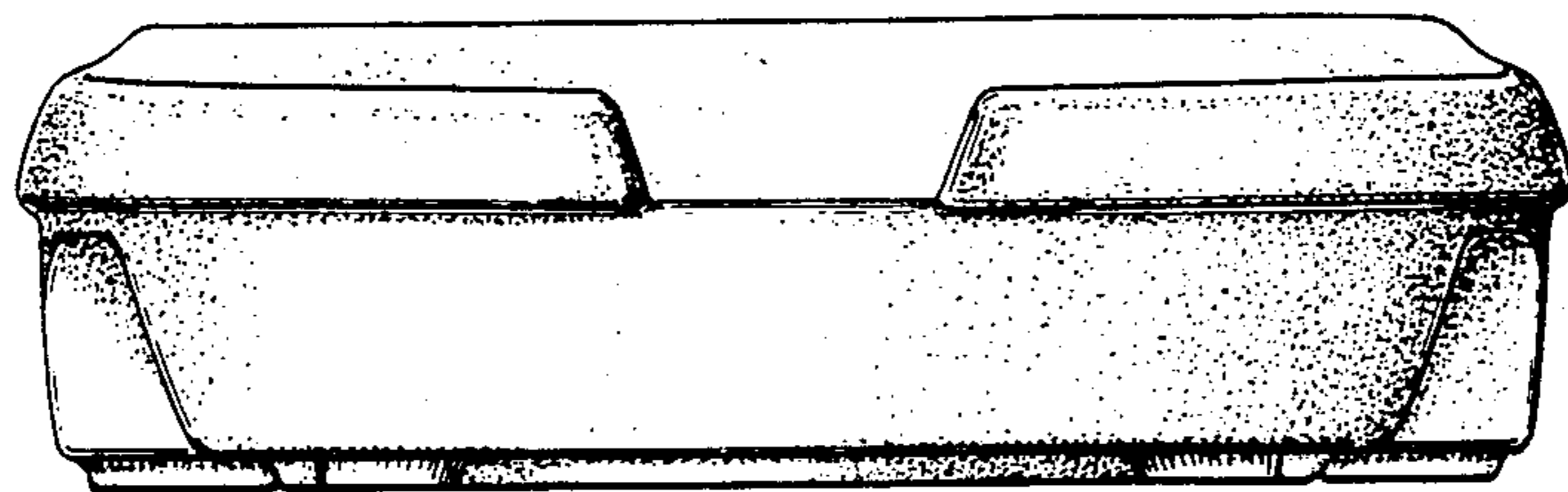

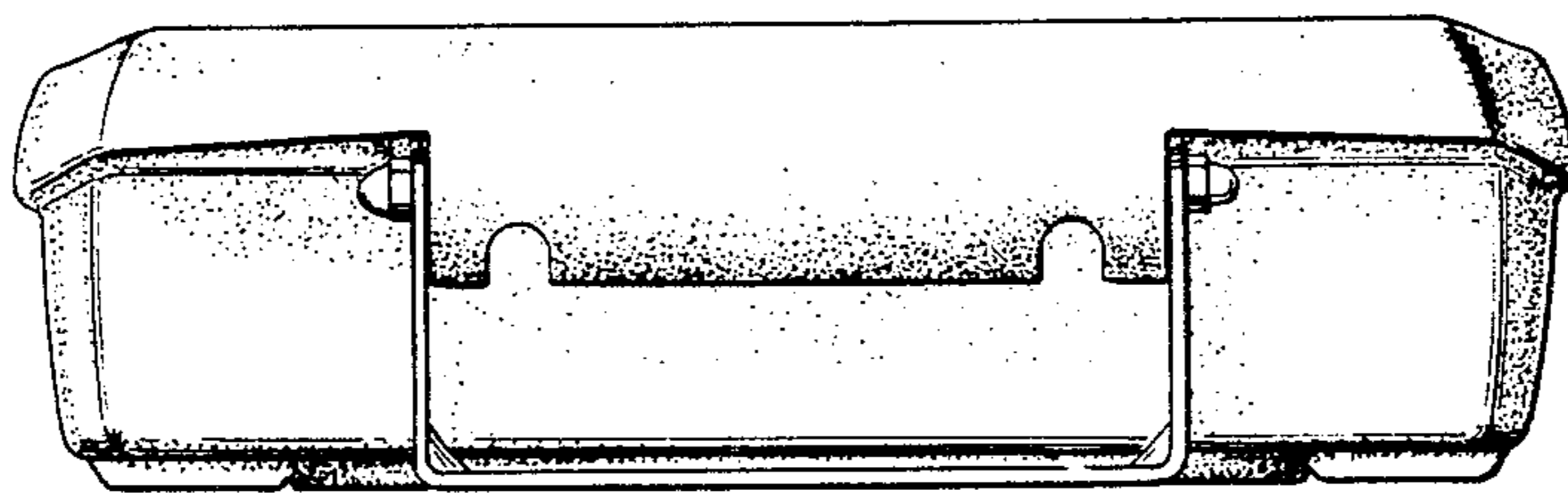

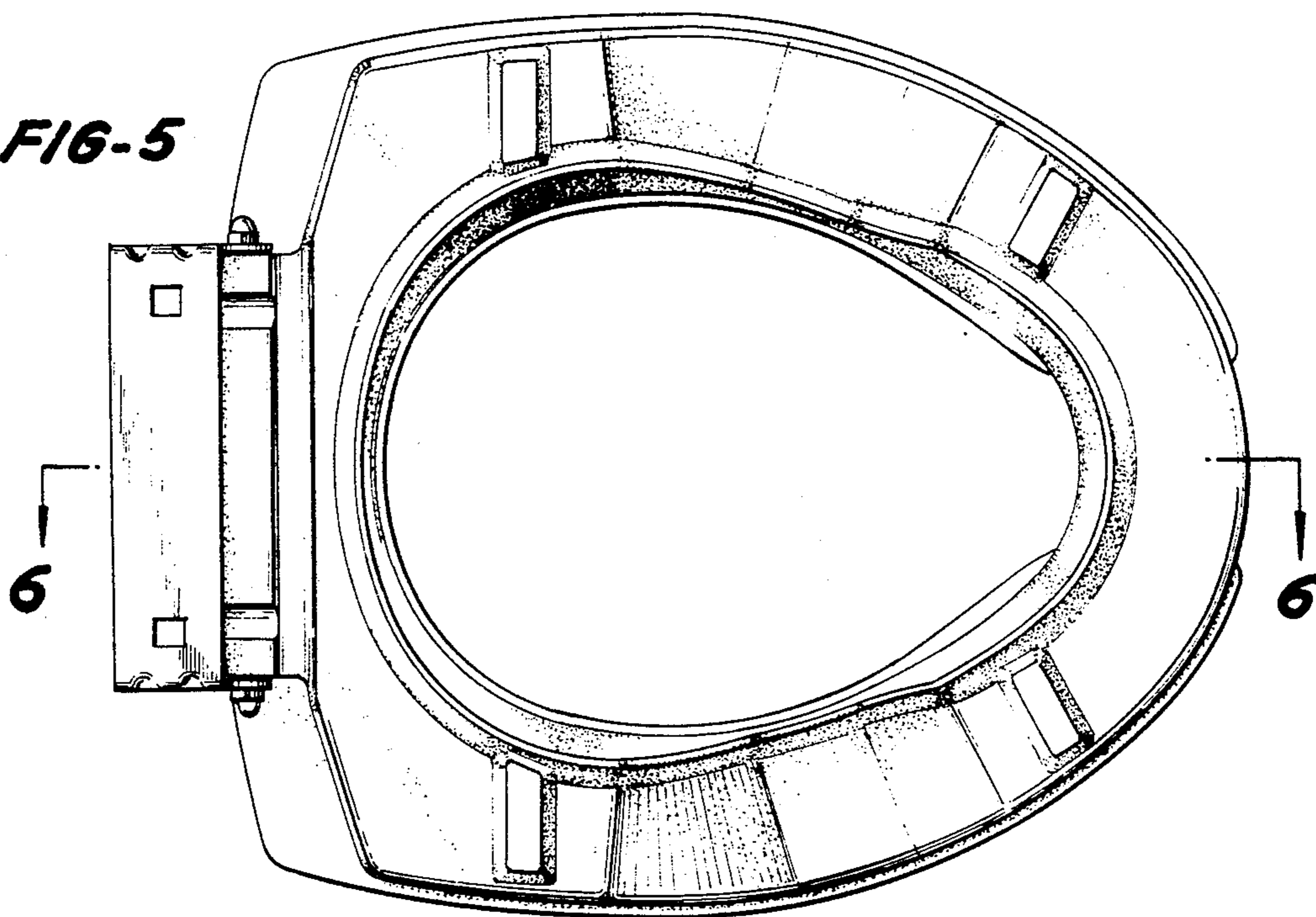
