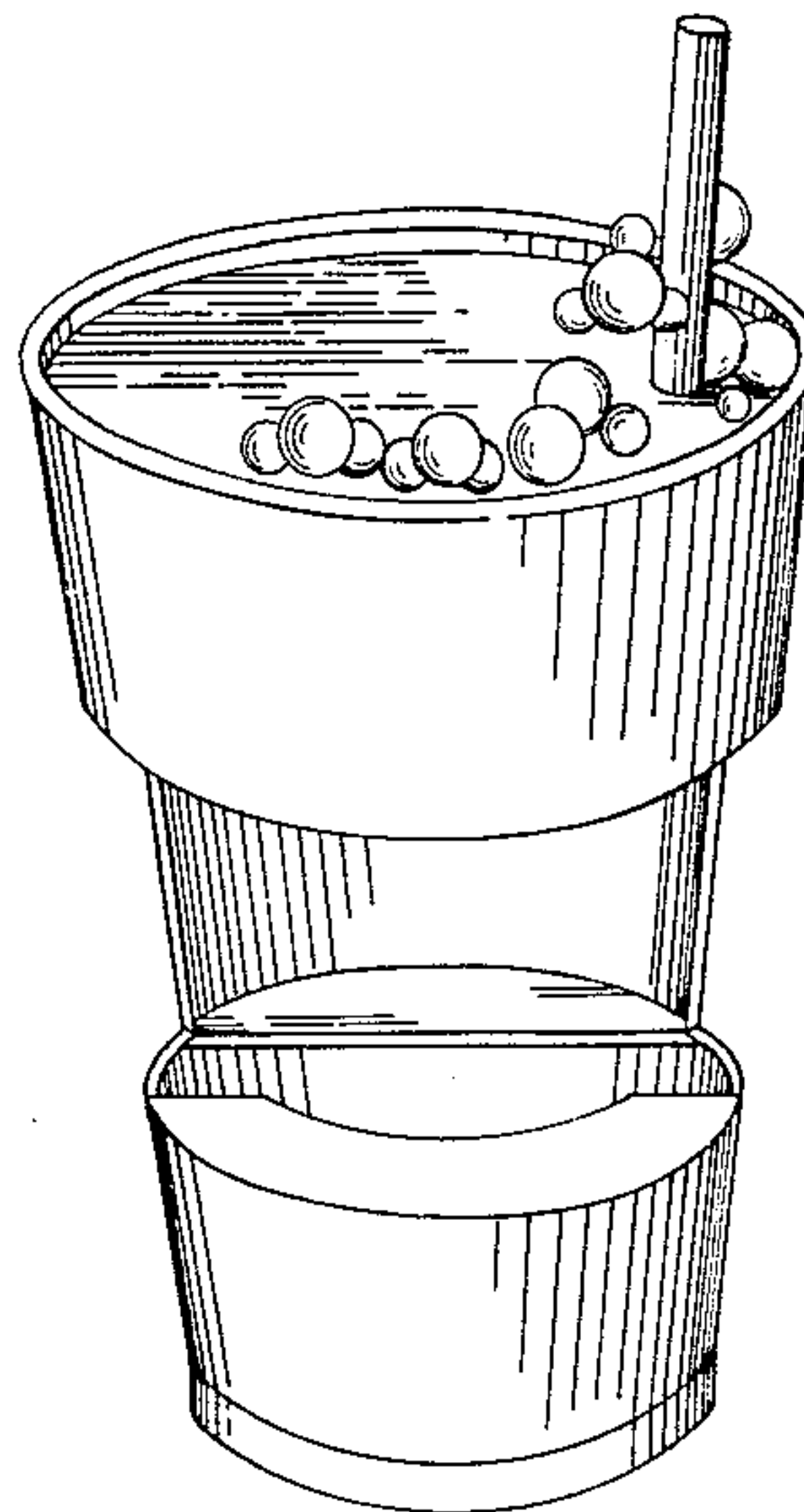

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the refreshment stand of my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view (the left side elevation view is substantially similar) thereof;

 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



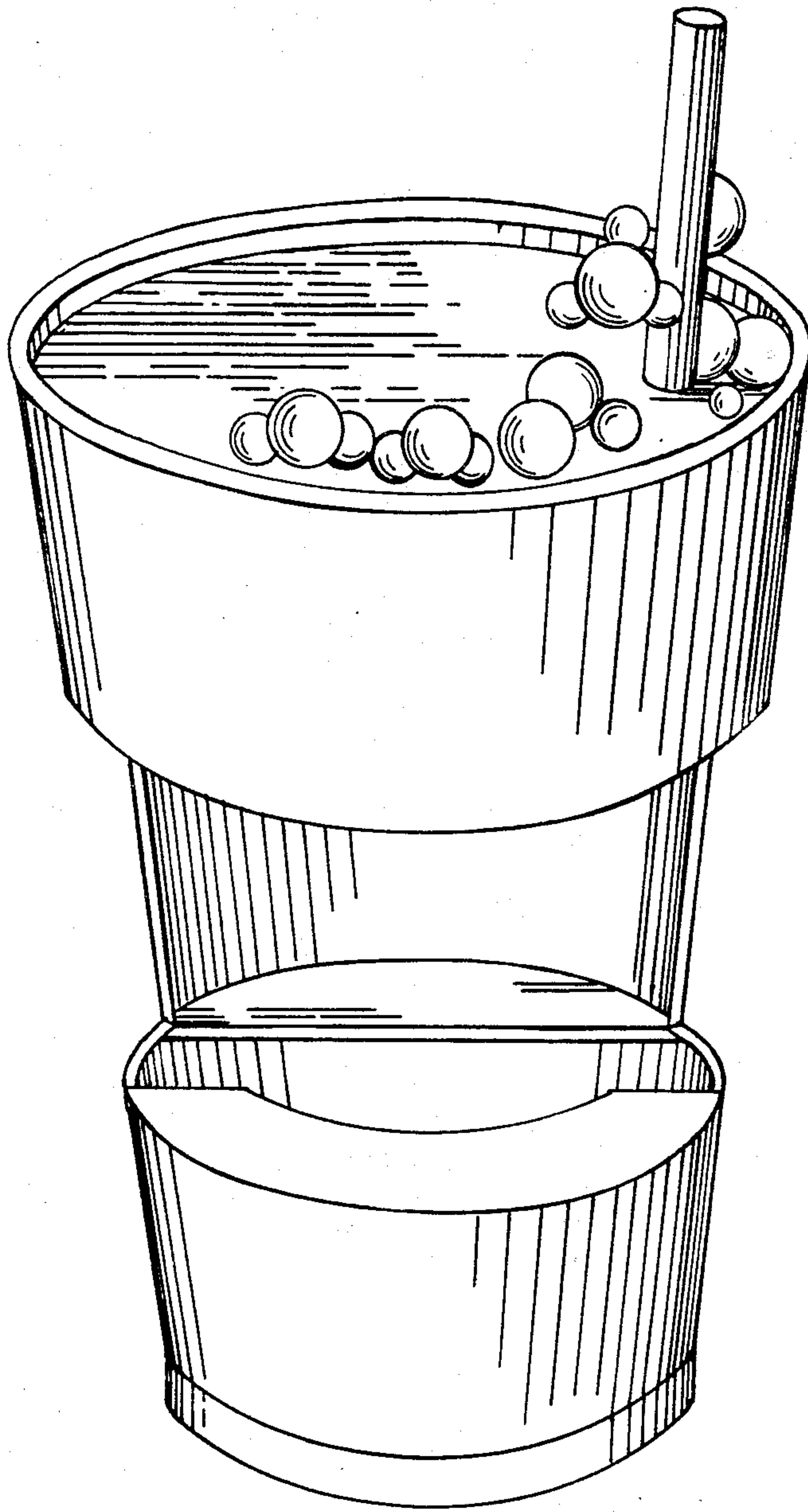

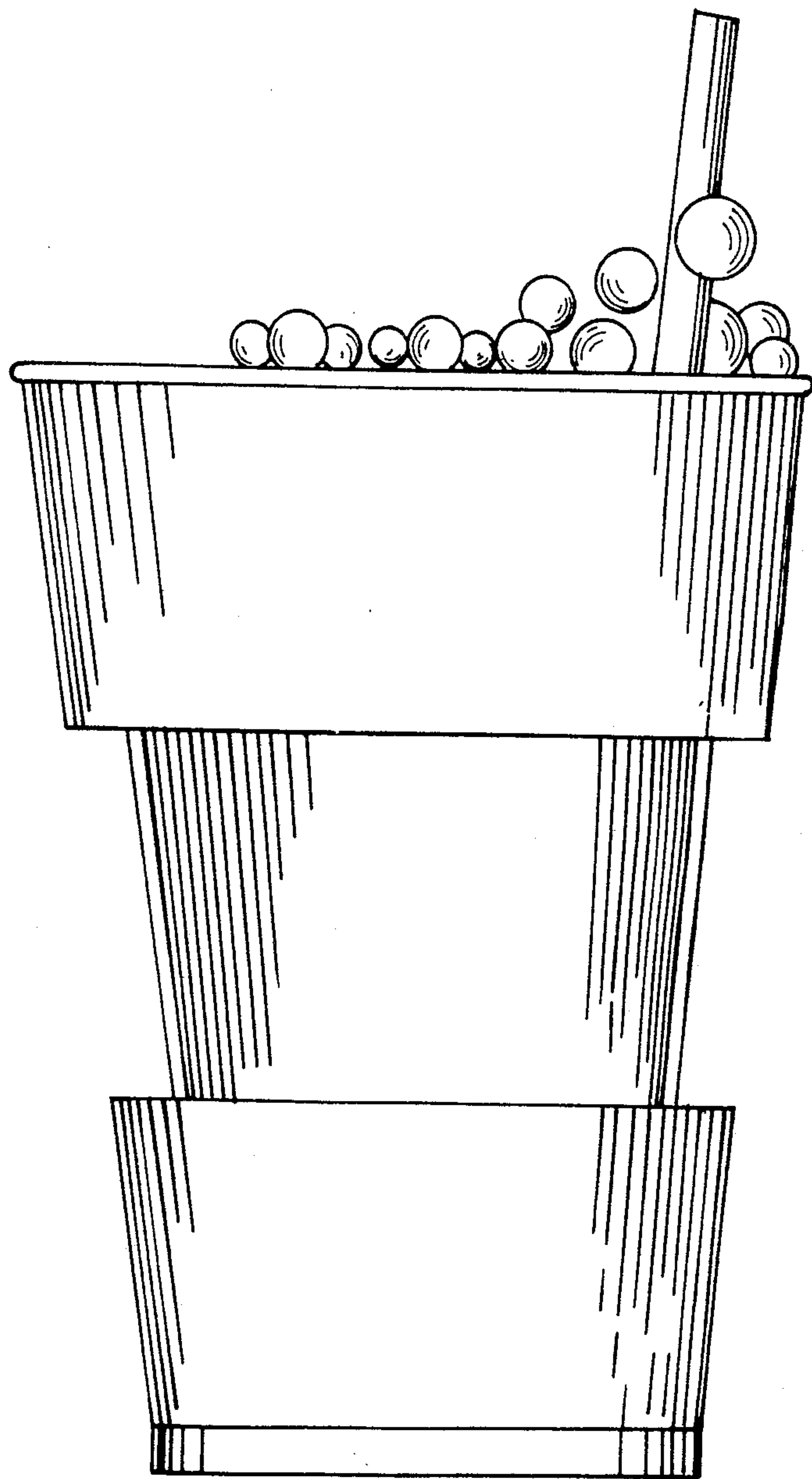

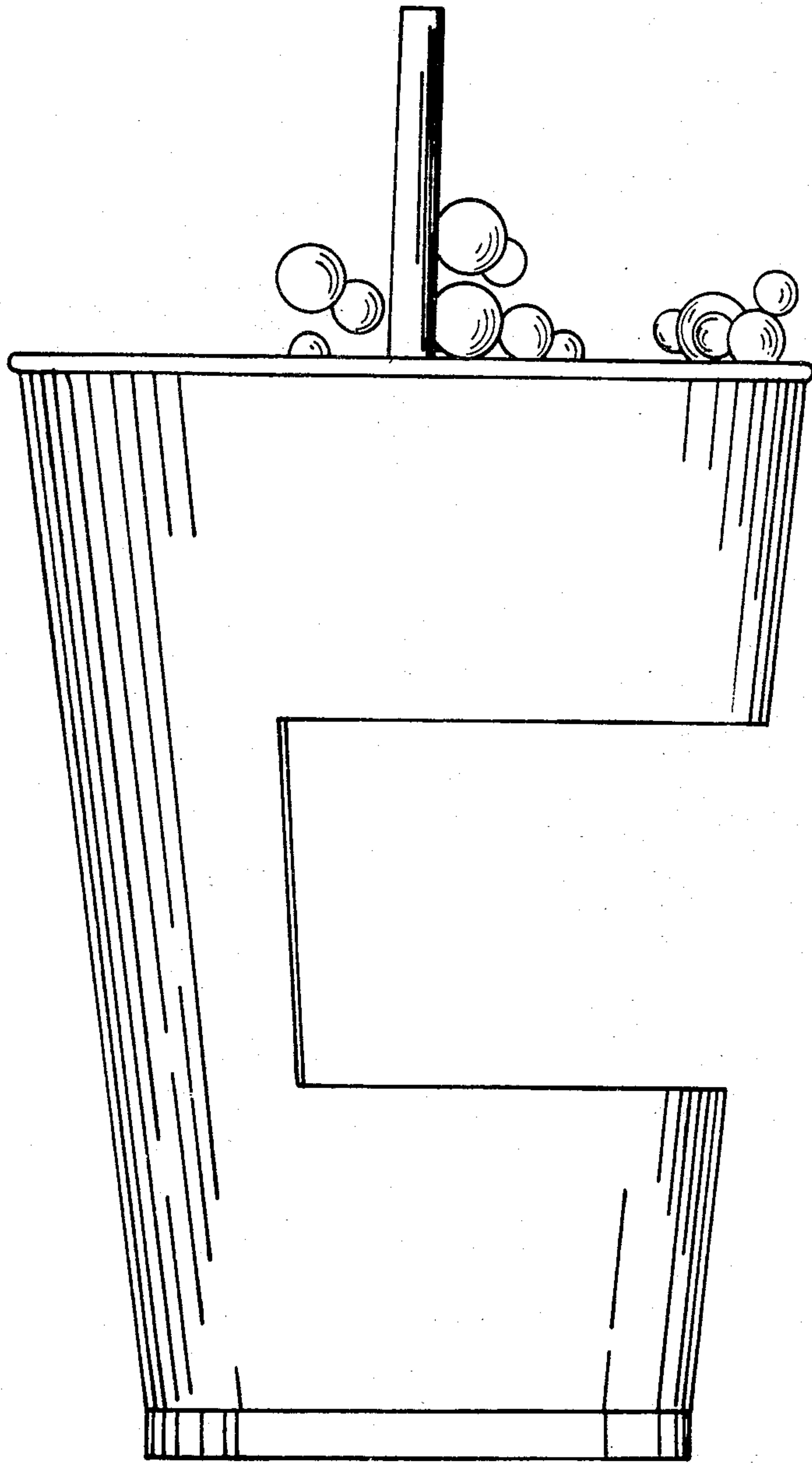

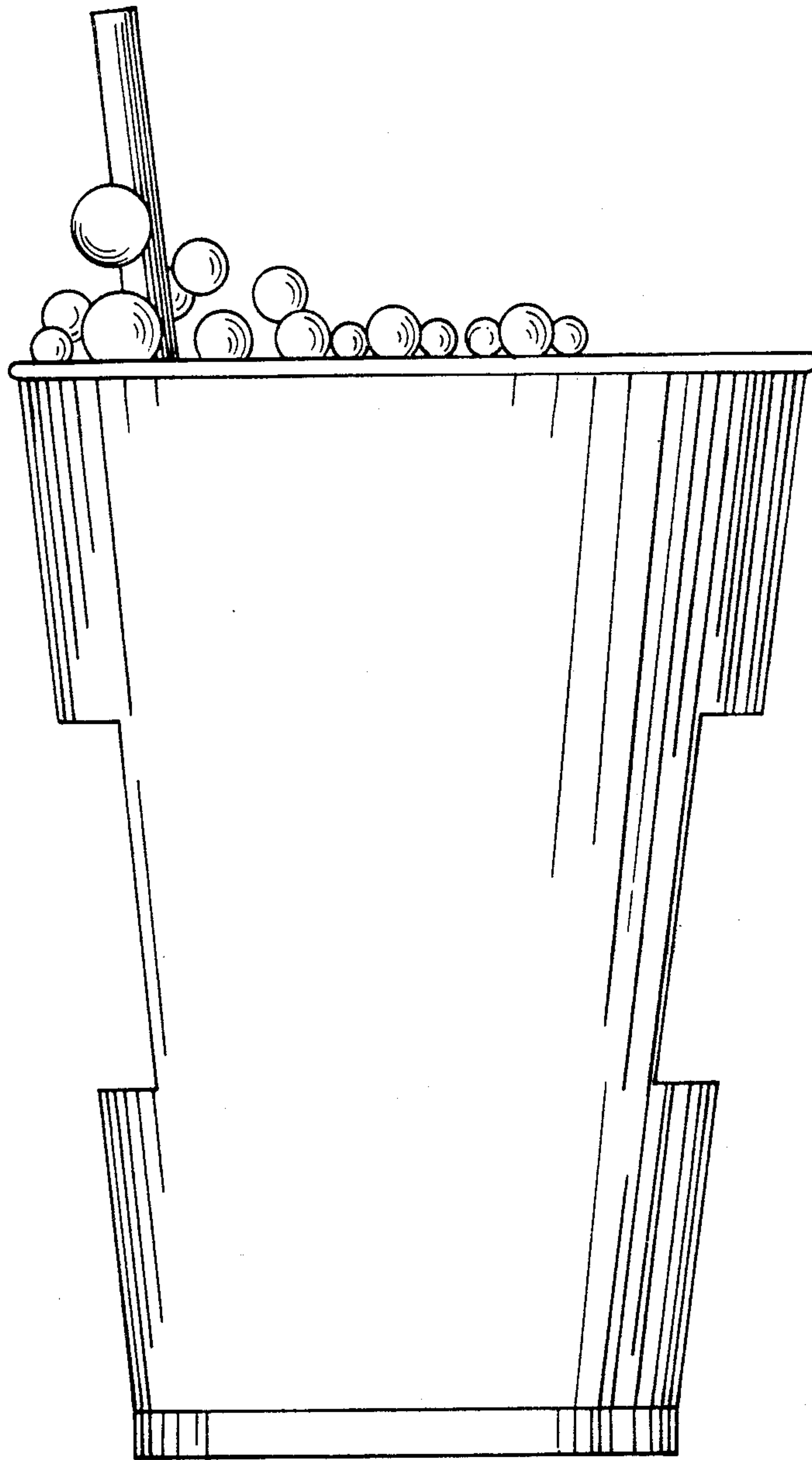

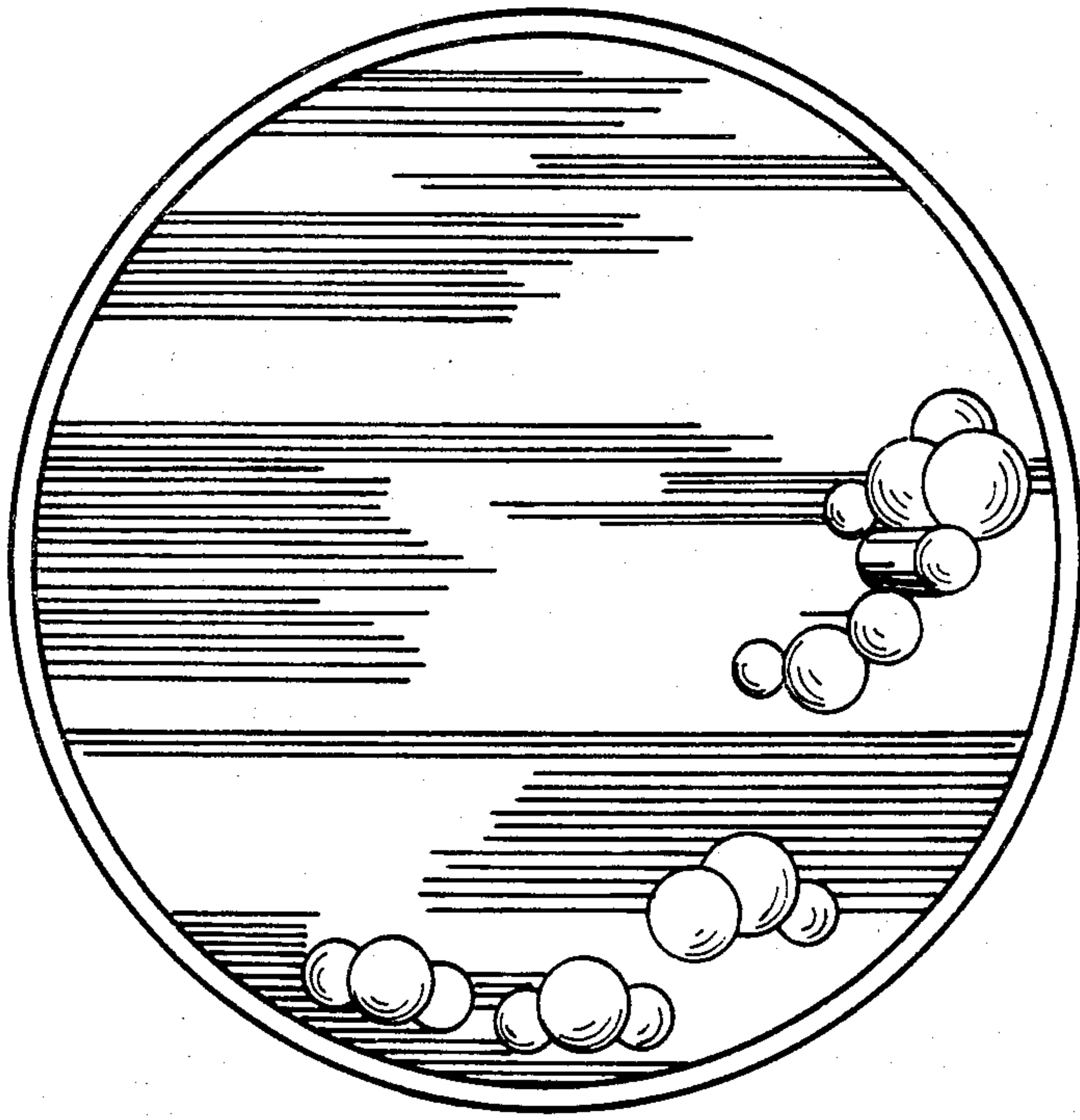
