The ornamental design for a handle, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the handle showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof, the bottom being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof, the rear being concave following the curve shown in FIG. 2 and unornamented.

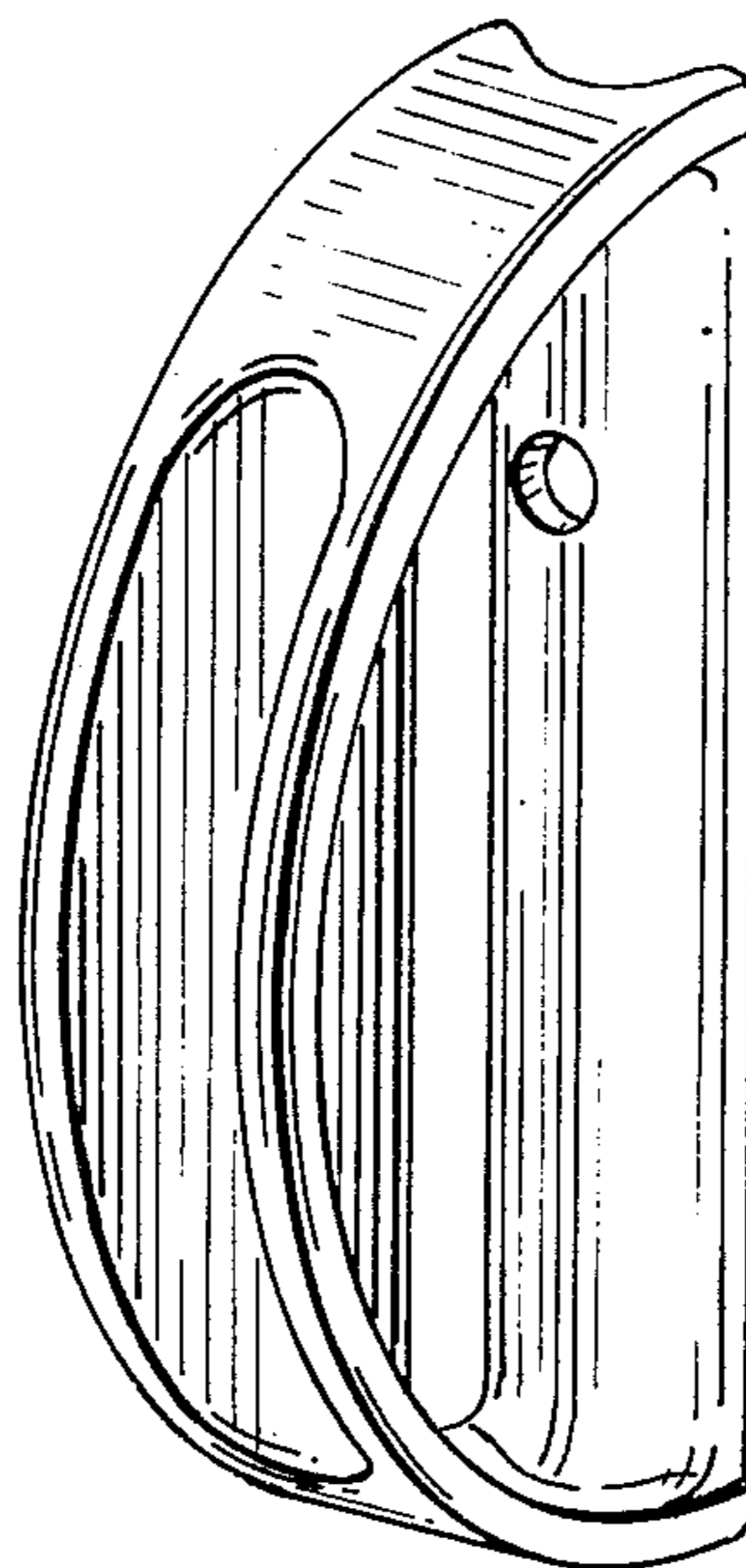

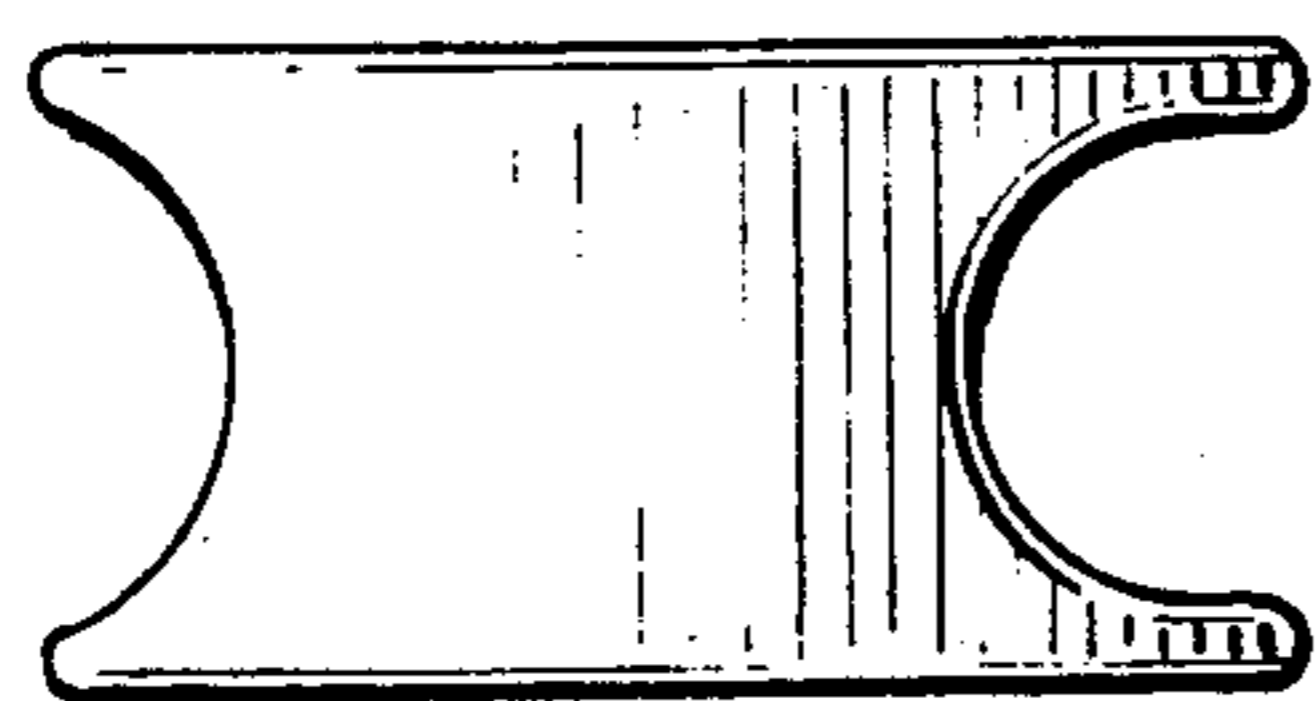
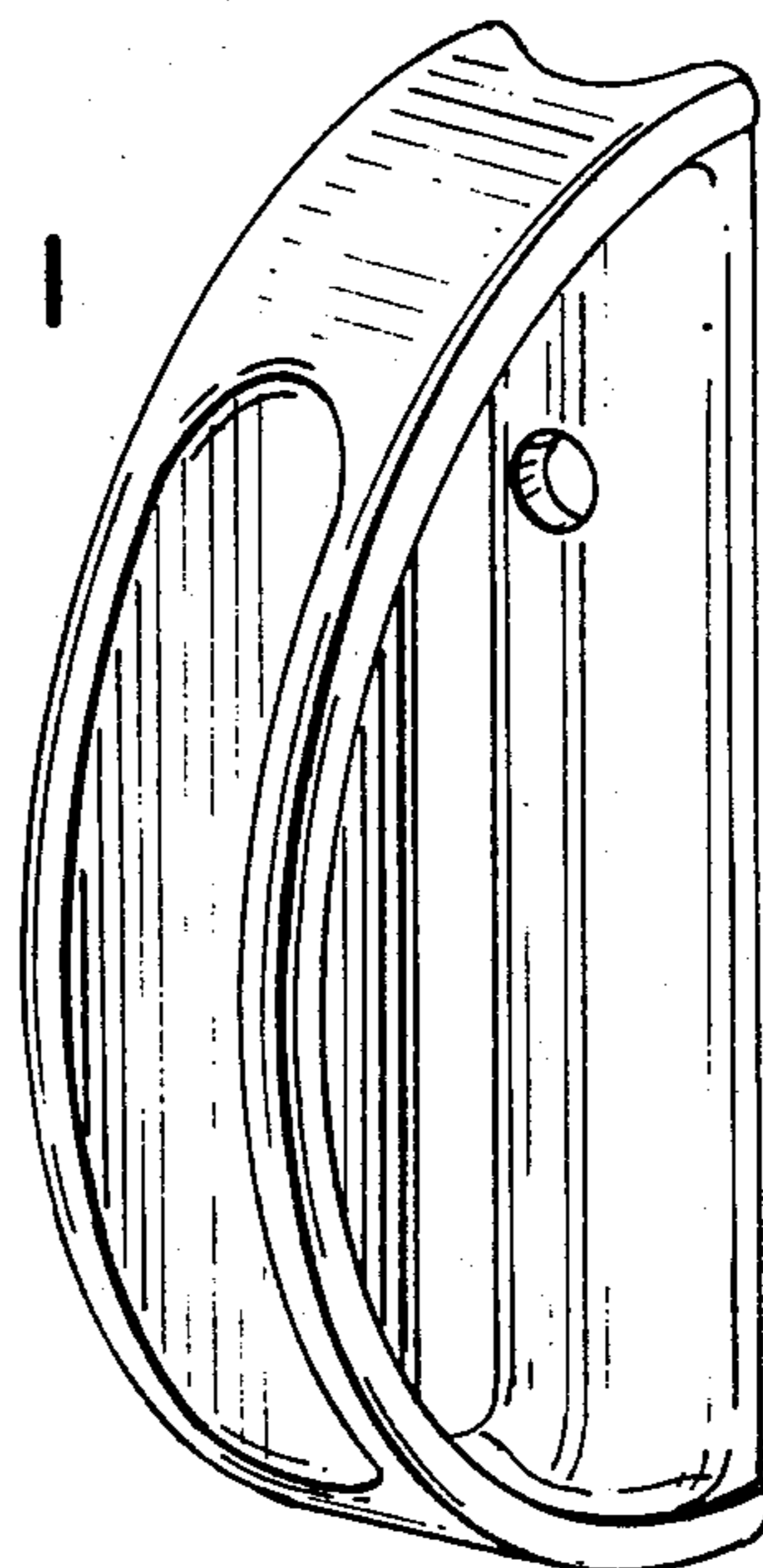

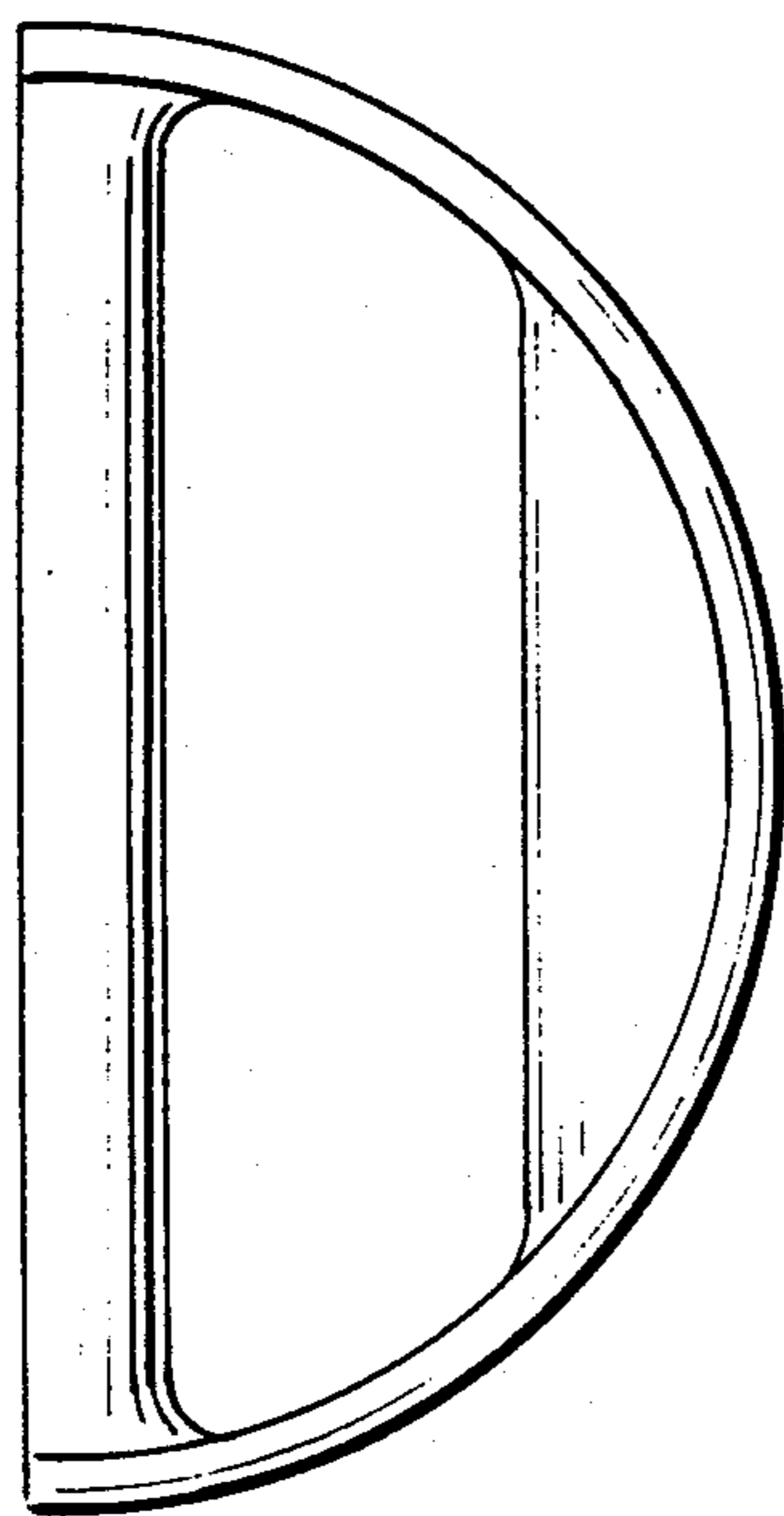

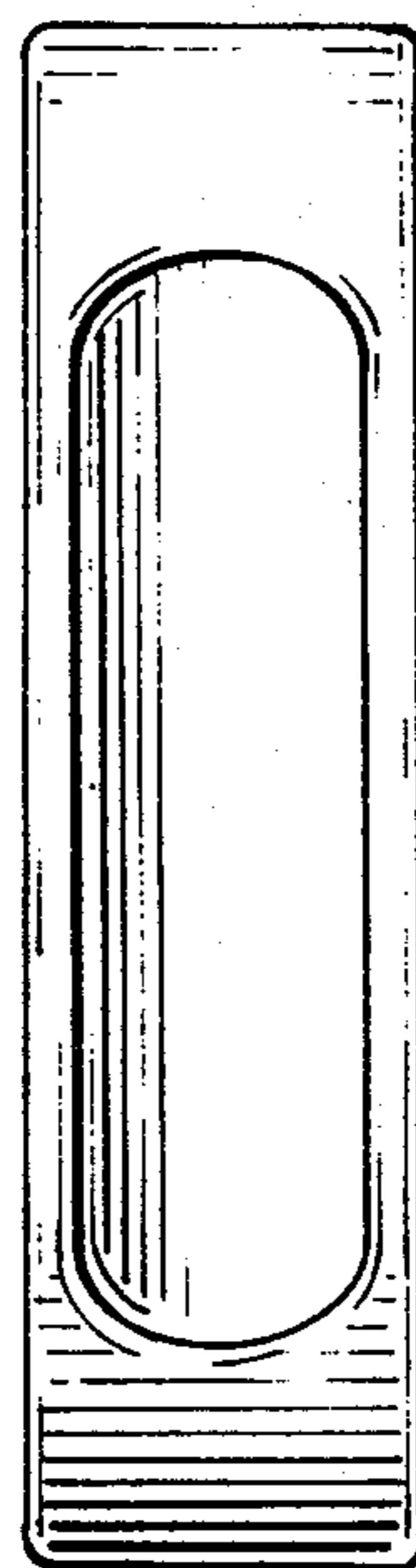
