The ornamental design for a cap for writing instruments, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cap for writing instruments showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The matter shown in broken lines is environmental structure which forms no part of the design.

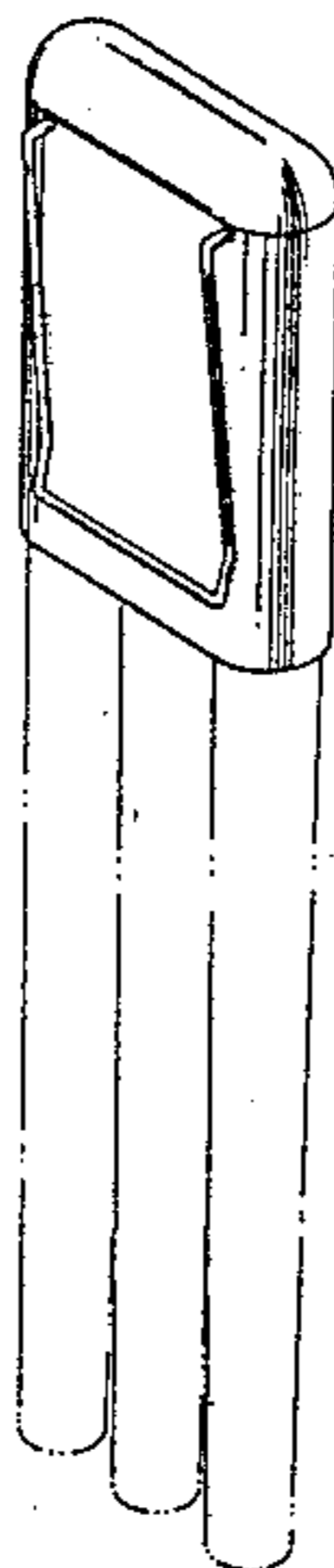

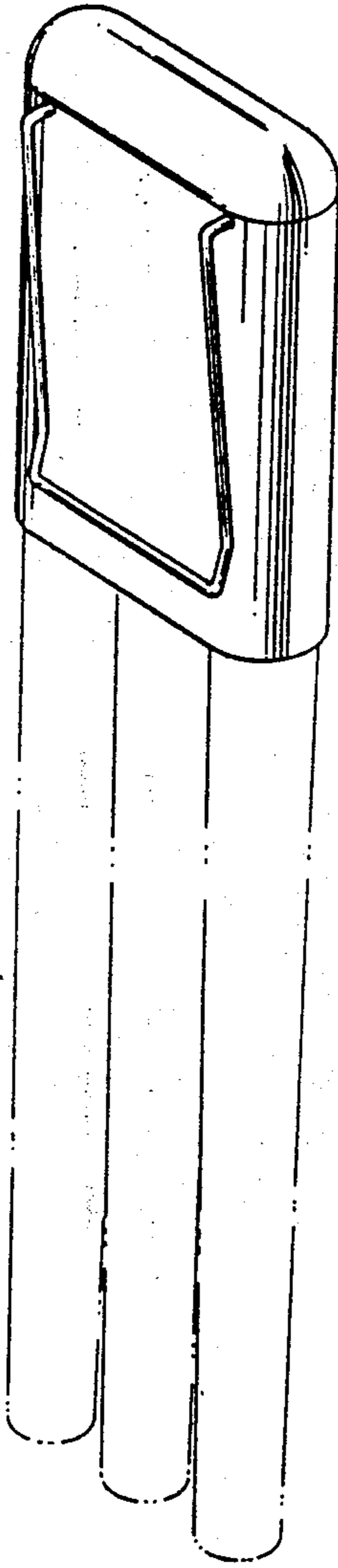

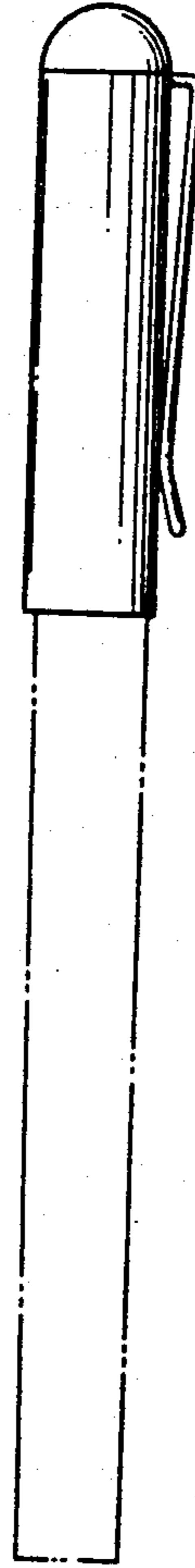
