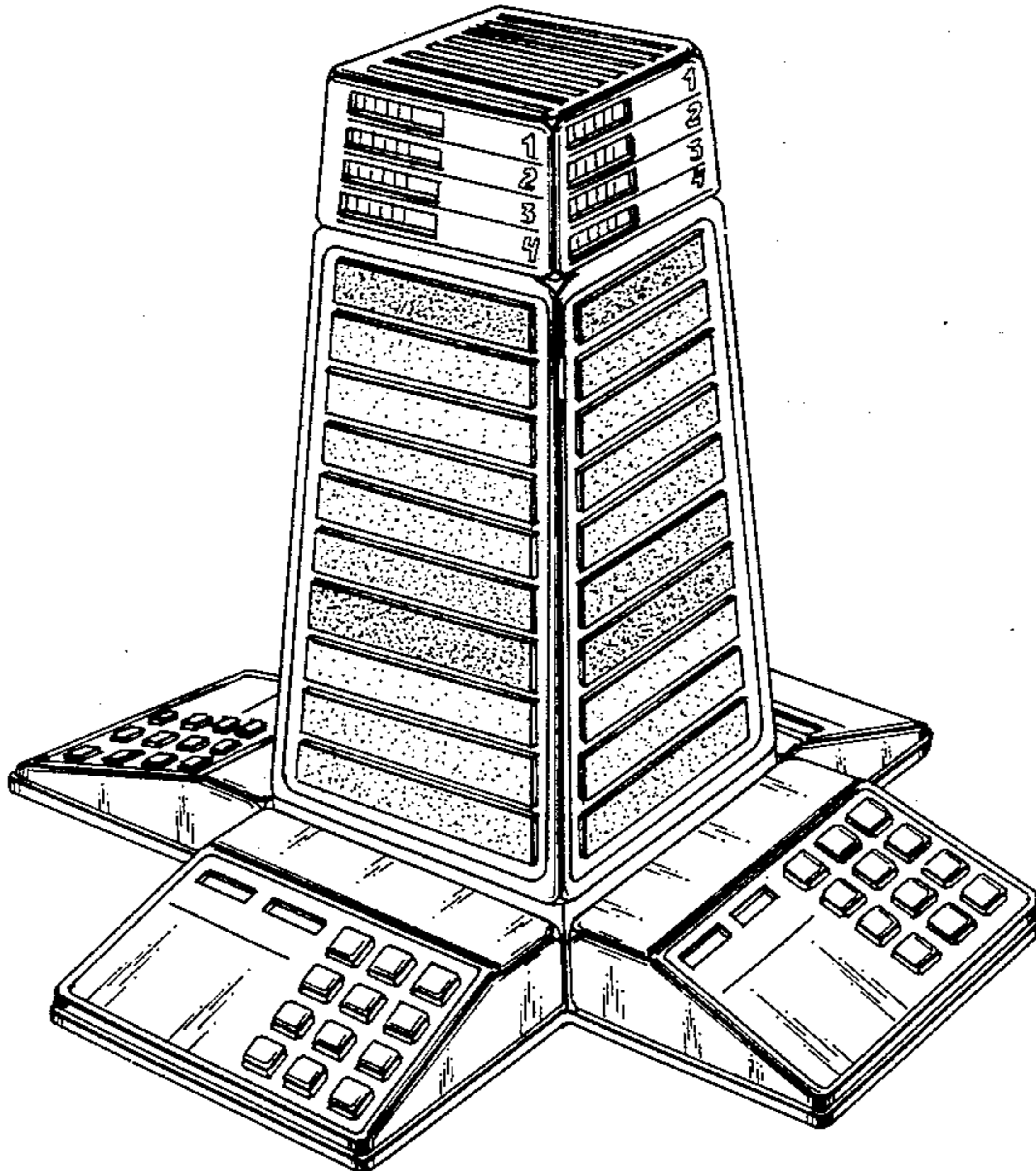

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic game machine with integral timer, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the electronic game machine with integral timer showing my new design, all sides of the machine being identical;
FIG. 2 is bottom plan view thereof on a reduced scale;
FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof with the keyboards in the game playing position, all sides of the machine being identical.



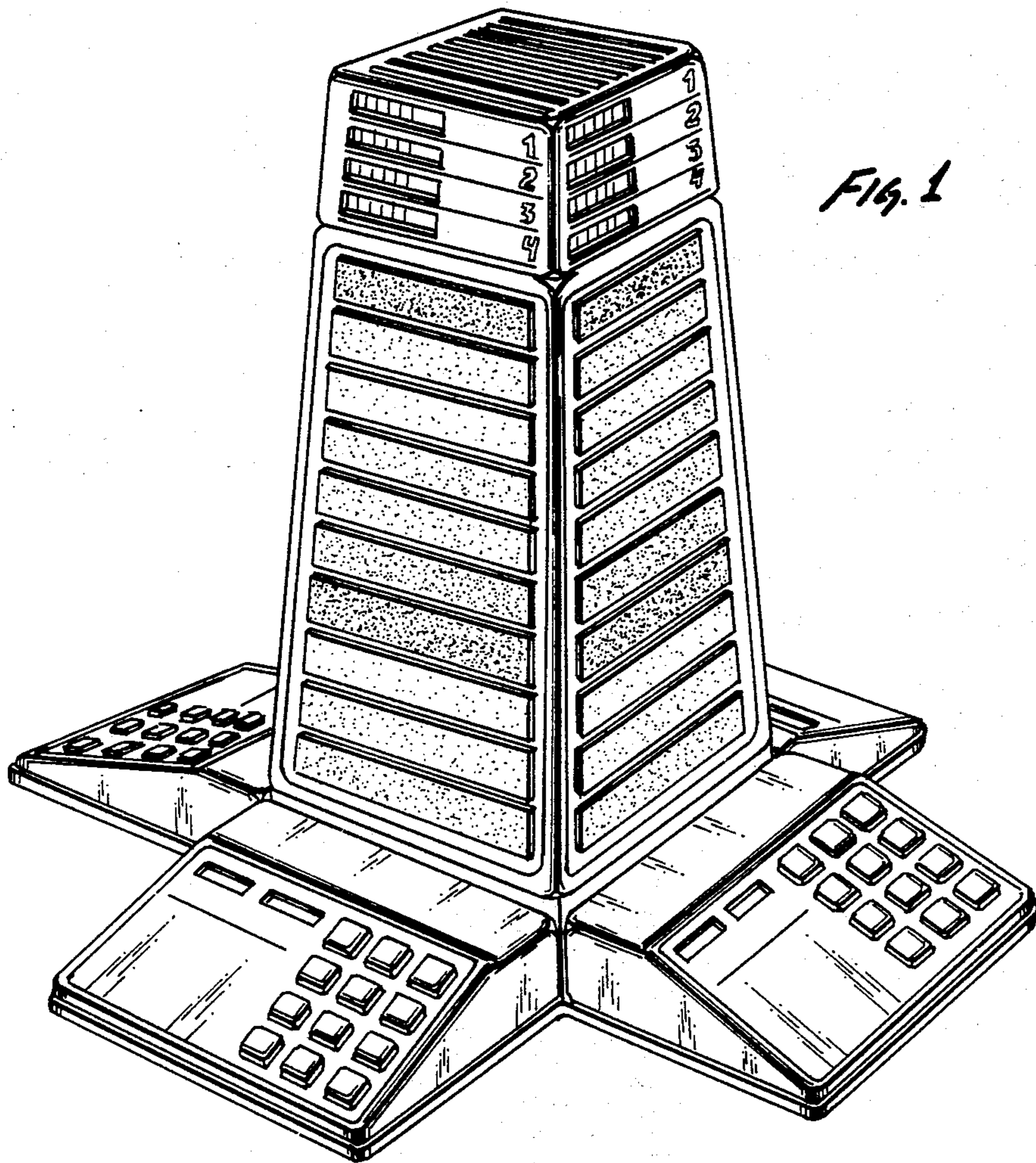

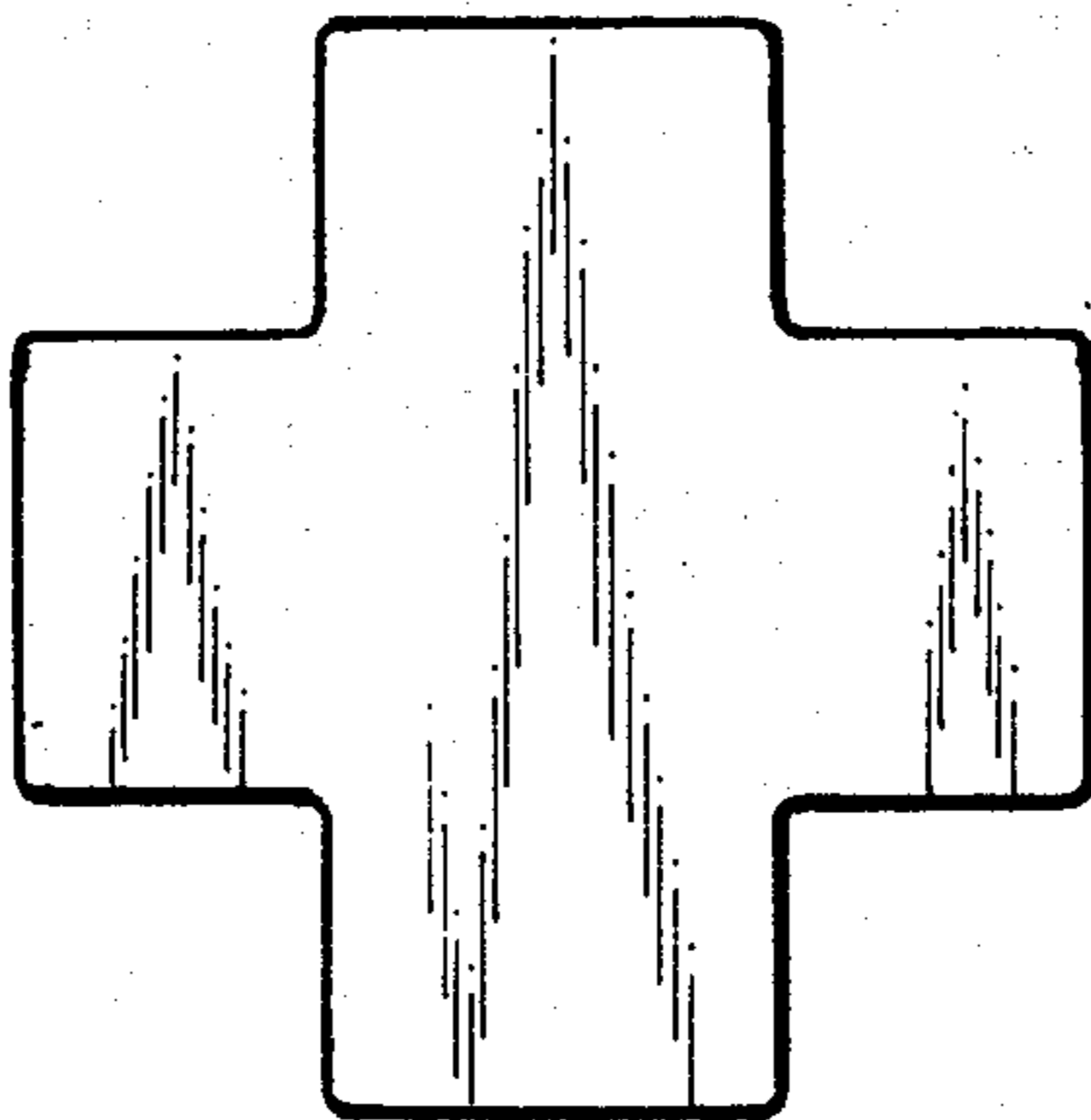
