FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

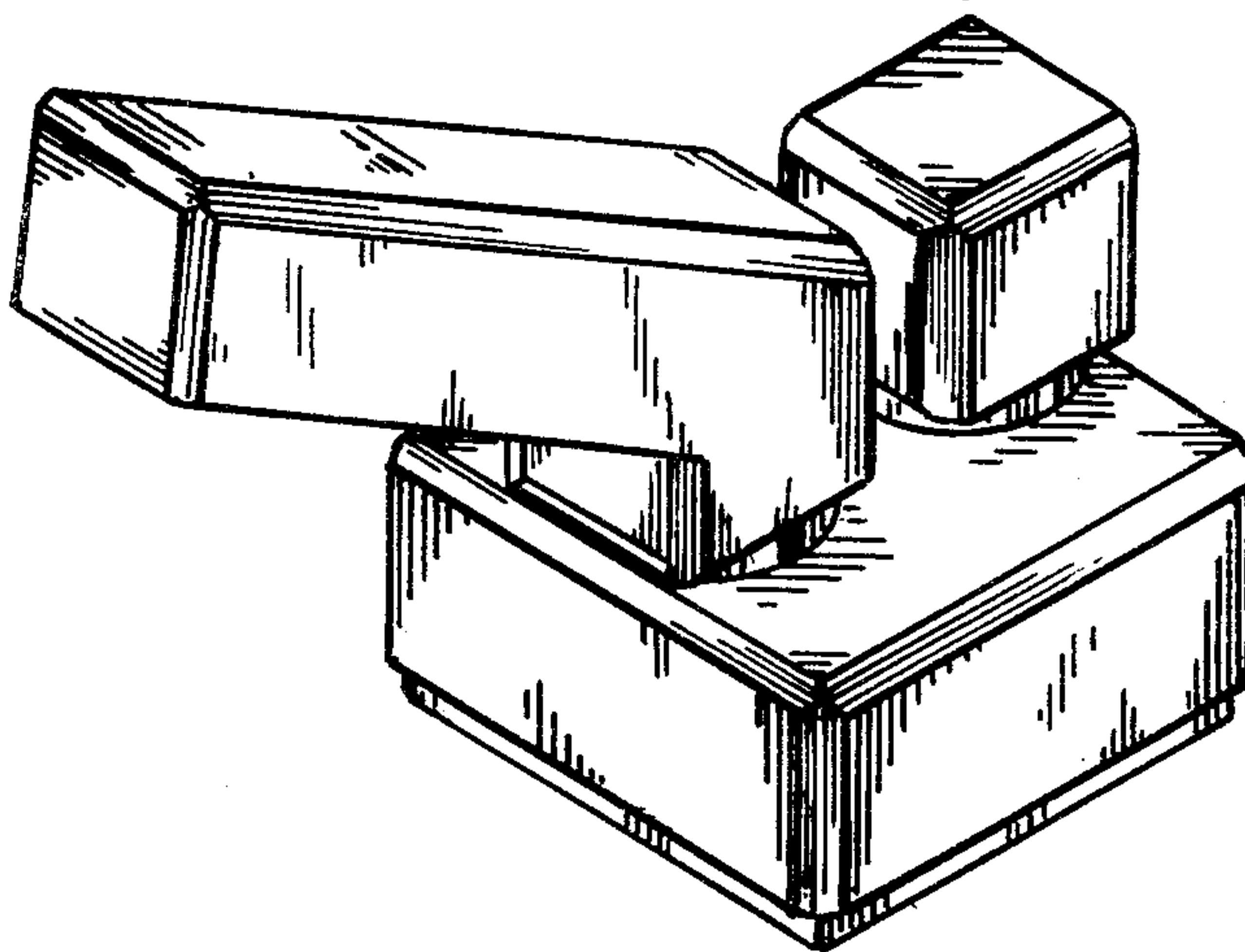
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

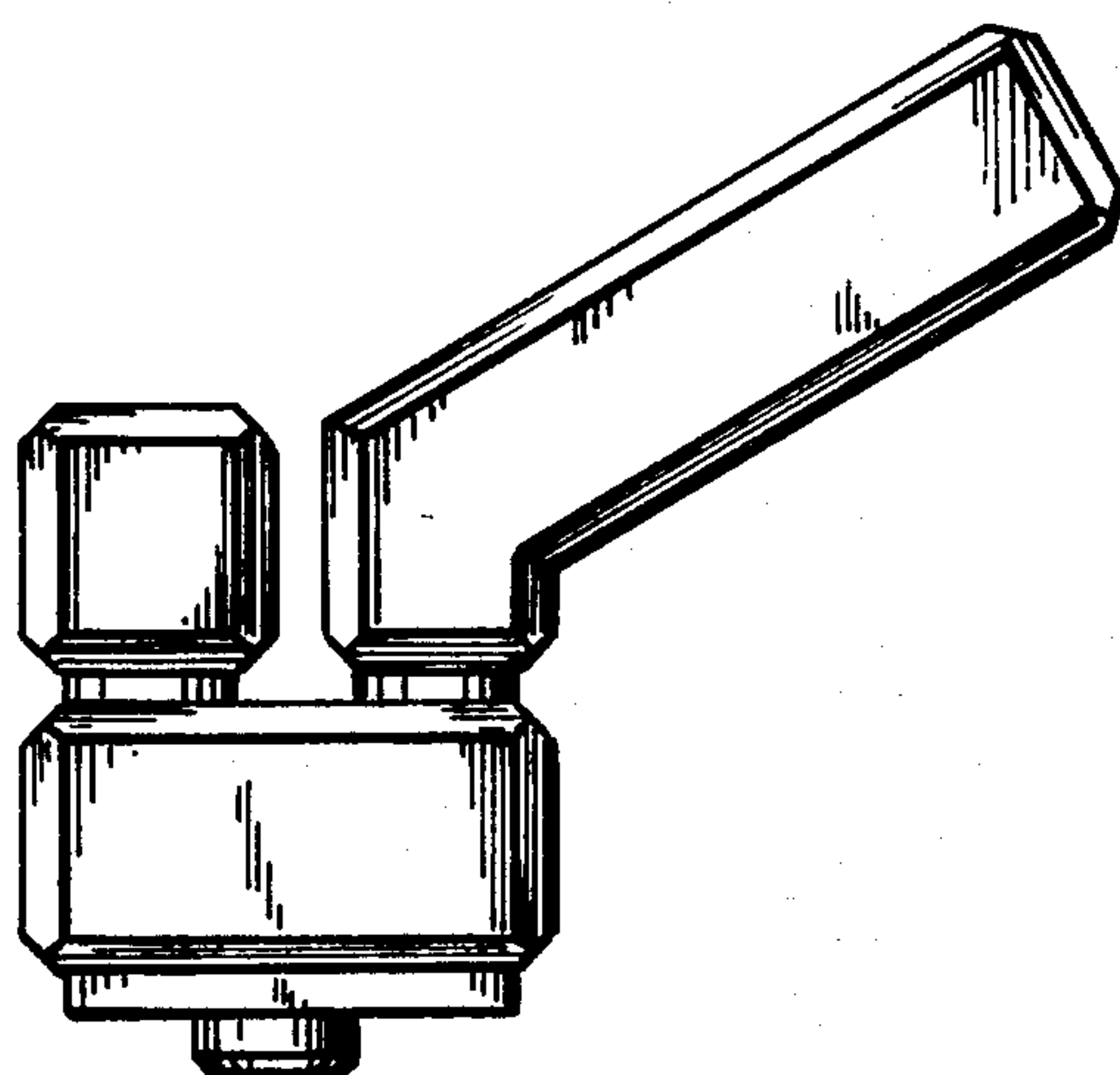
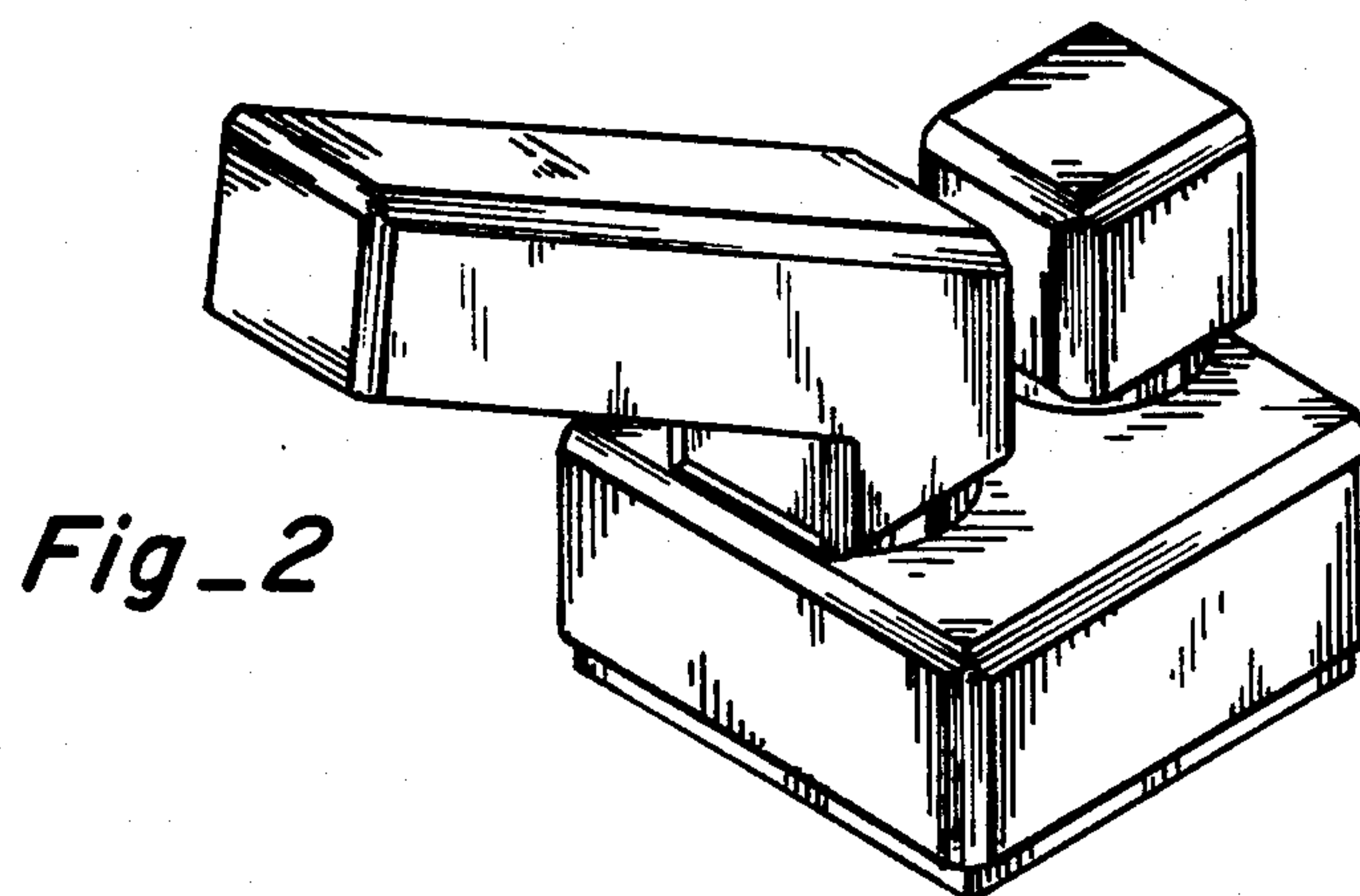
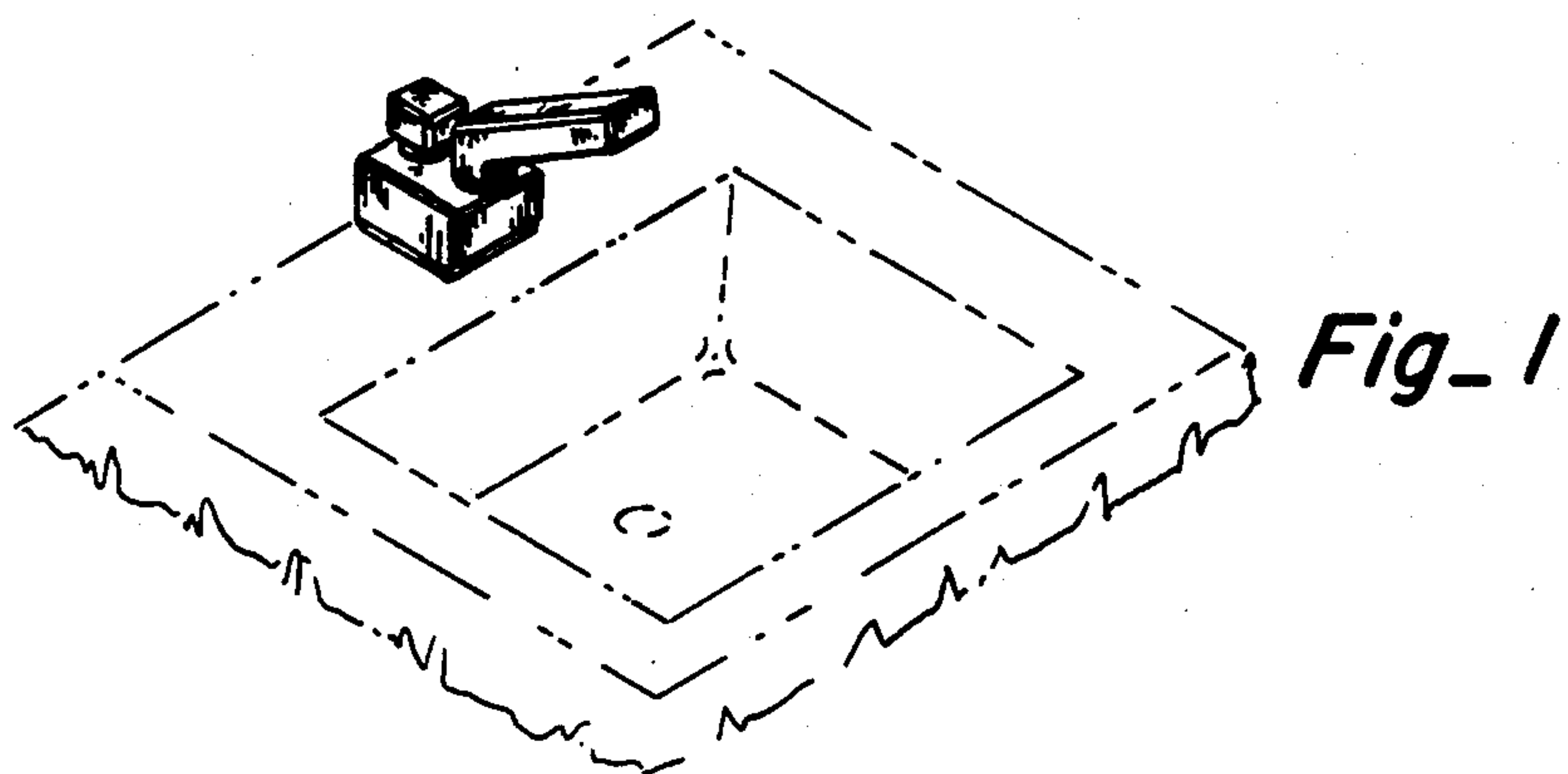
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and

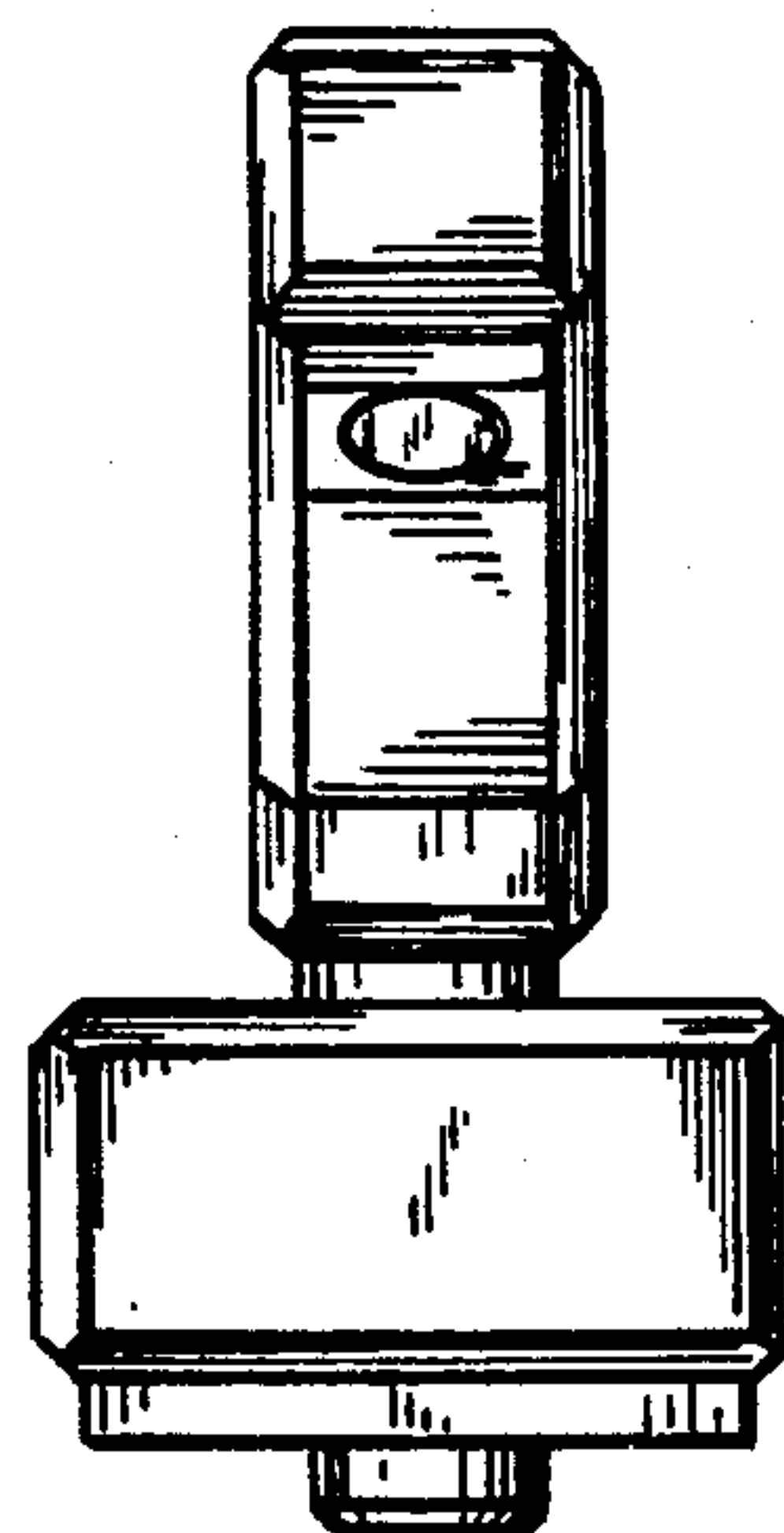
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The fragmentary broken line representation of a lavatory and cabinet in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.

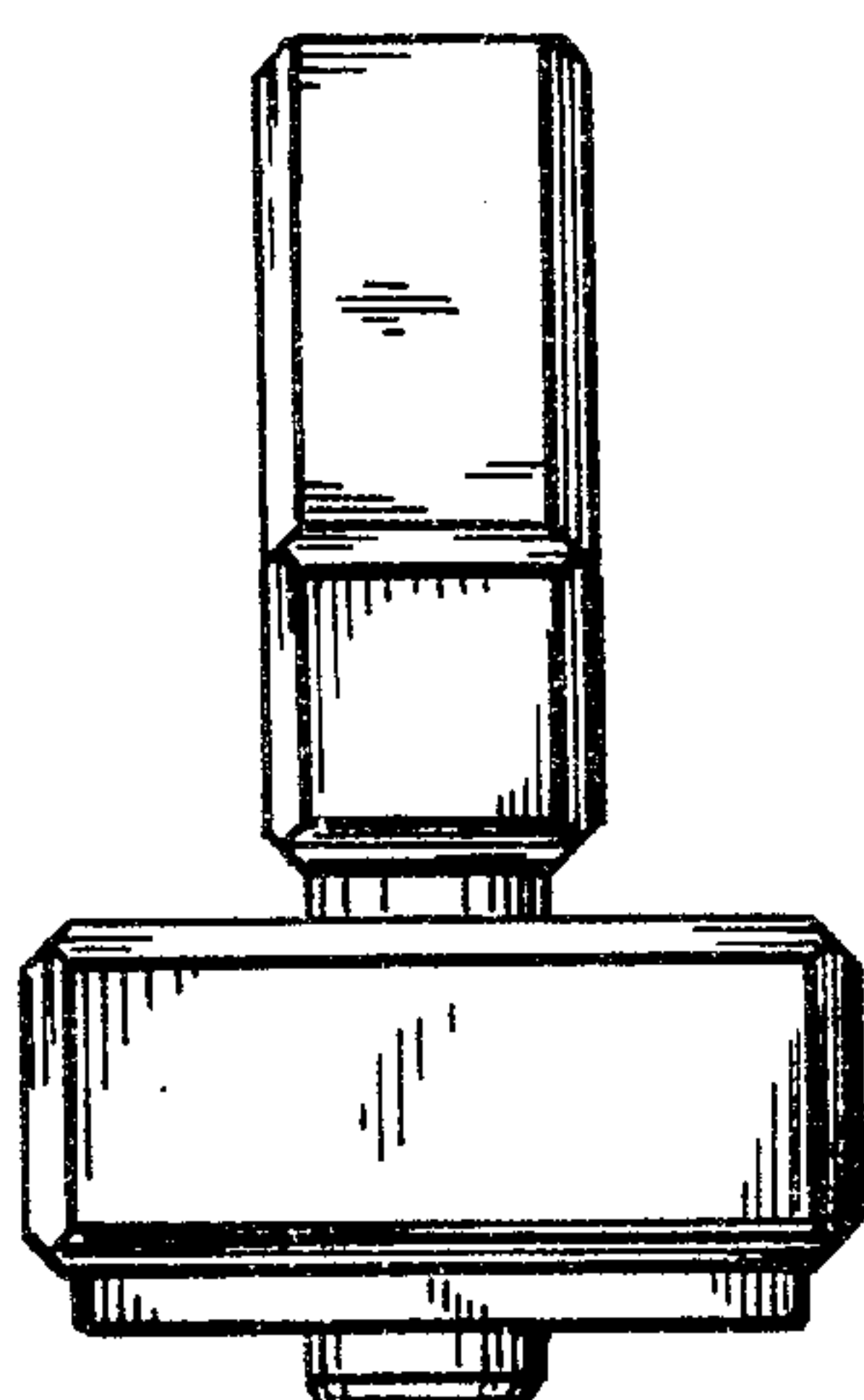




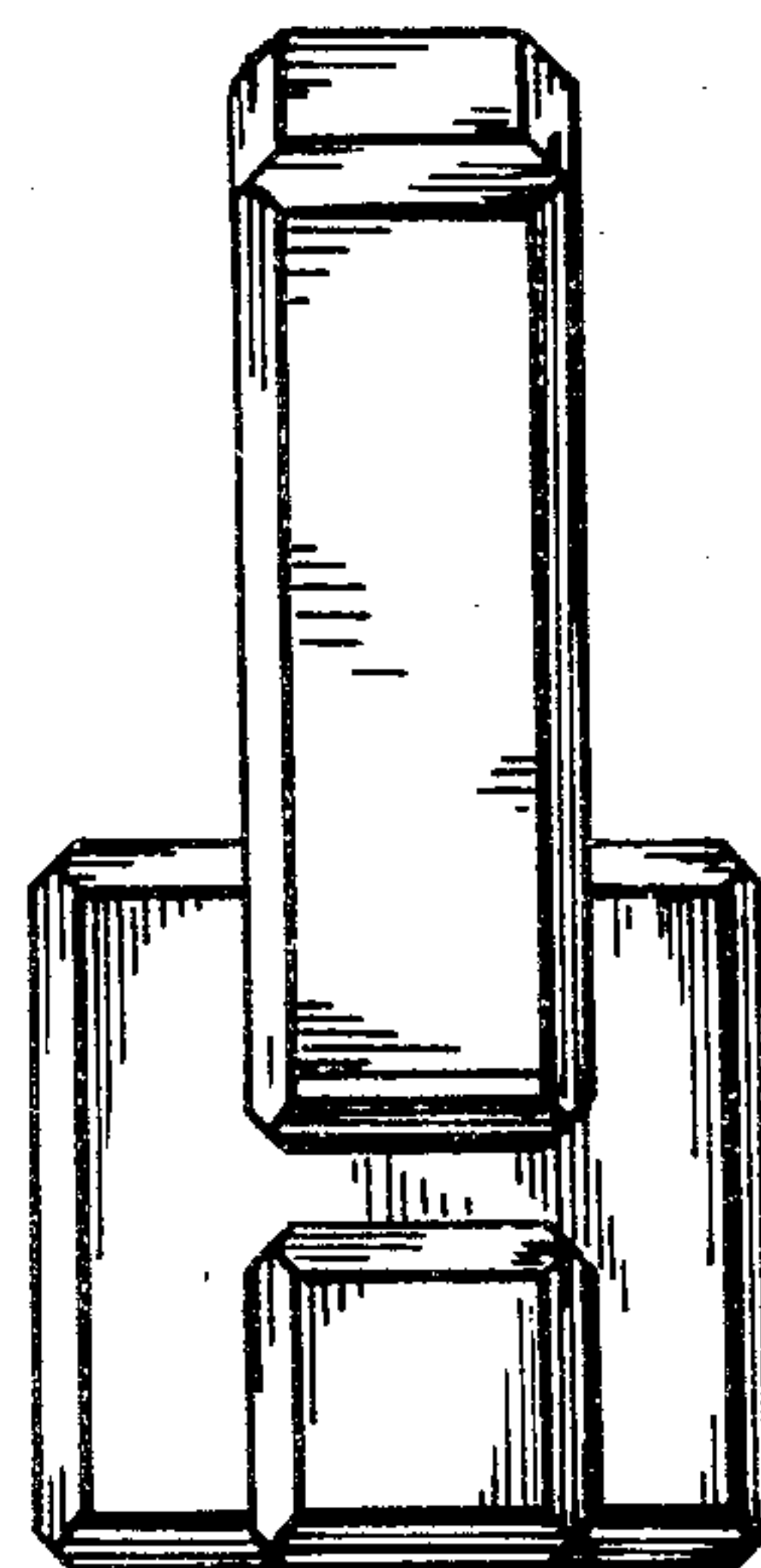

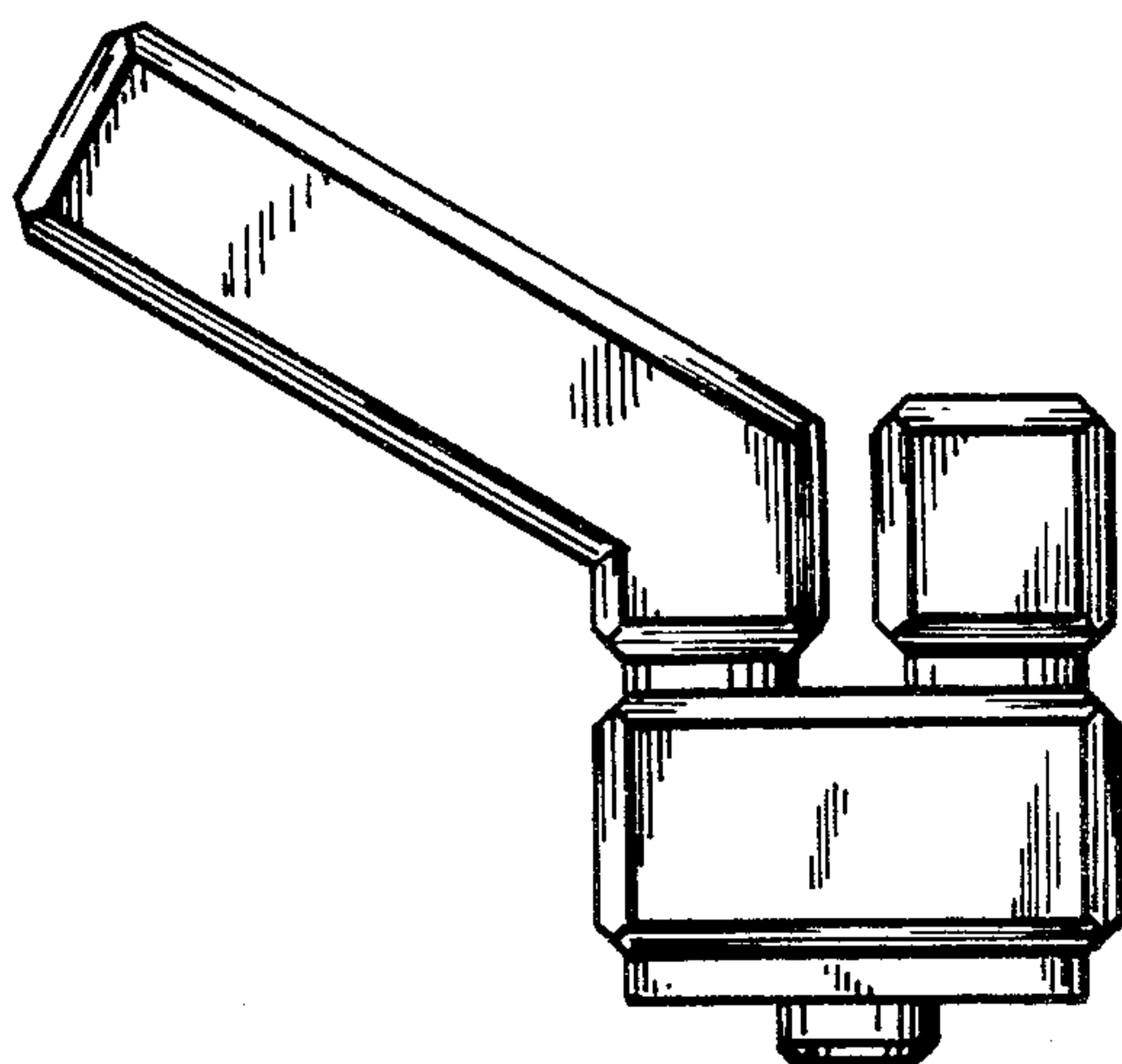

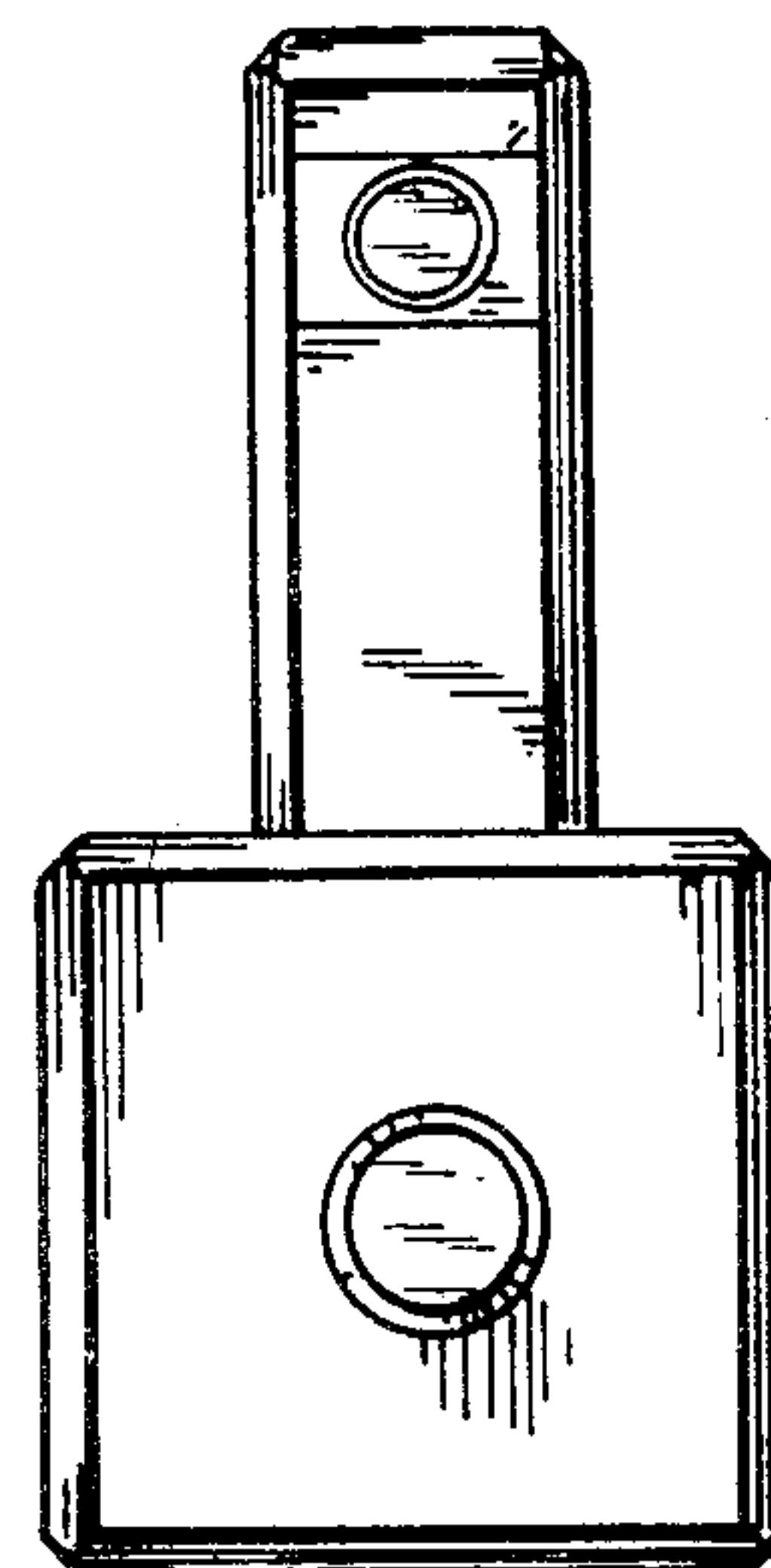
