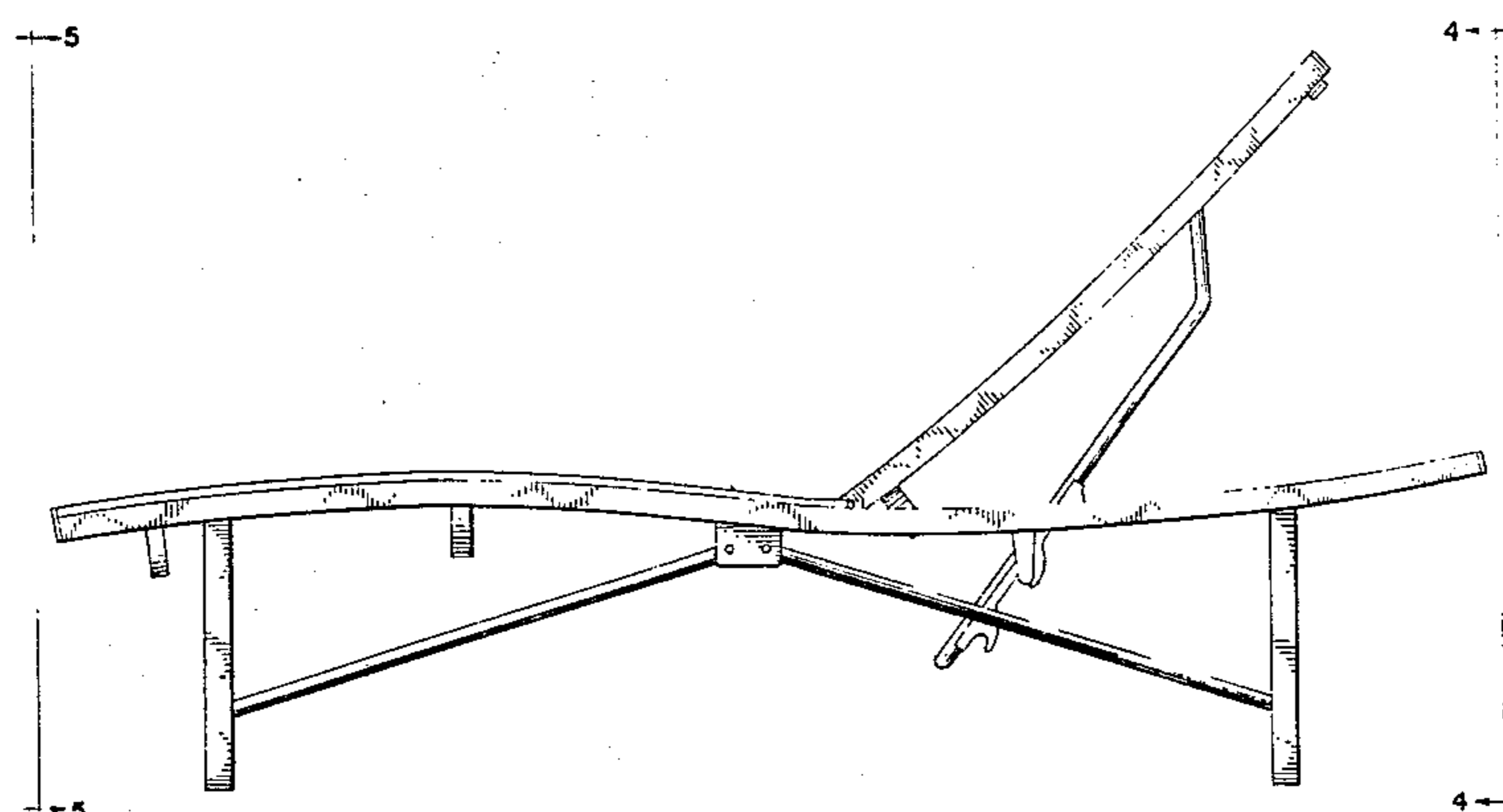

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foldable chaise lounge frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a foldable chaise lounge frame showing my design, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 4 is a rear end elevational view thereof, taken on the line 4—4 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a front, end elevational view thereof, taken on the line 5—5 of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view showing the chaise lounge frame in folded position, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.



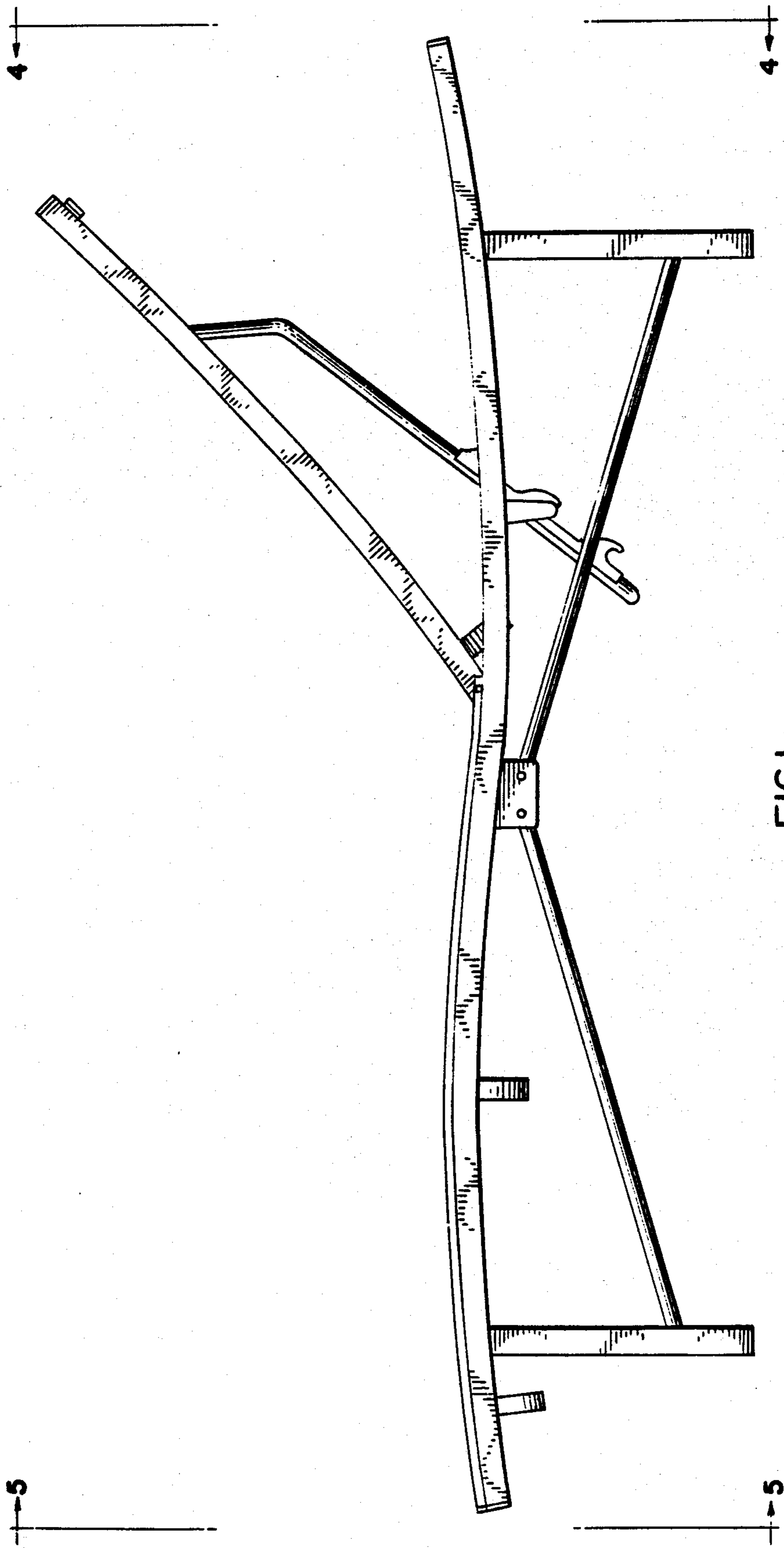

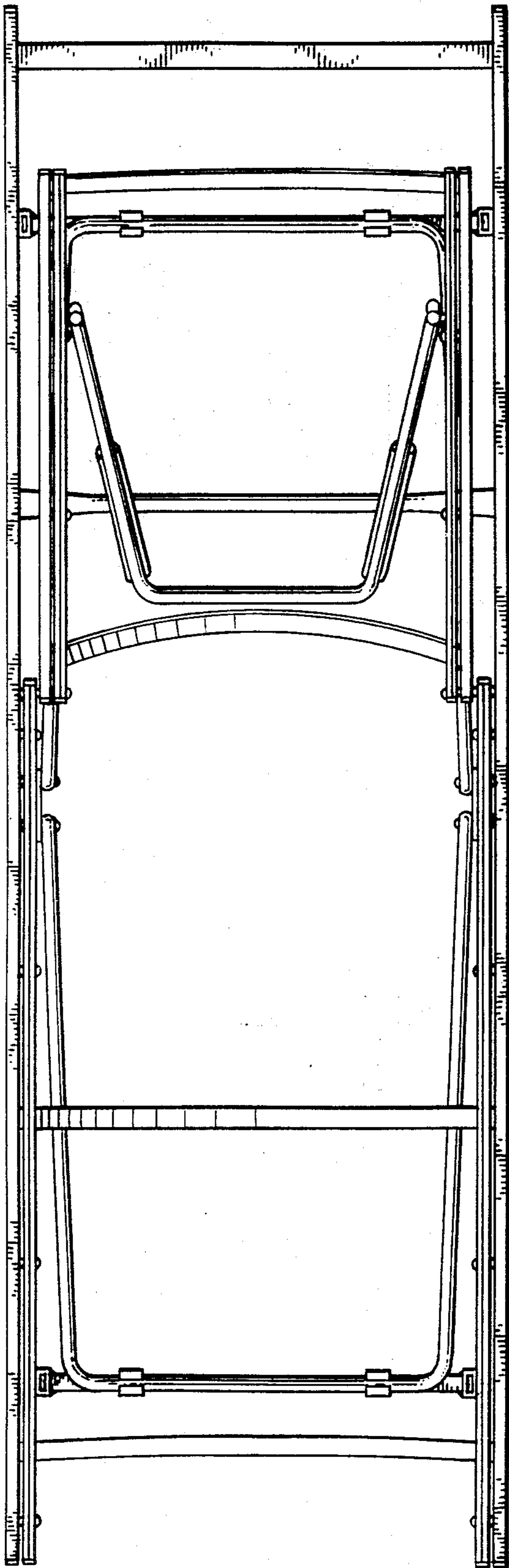
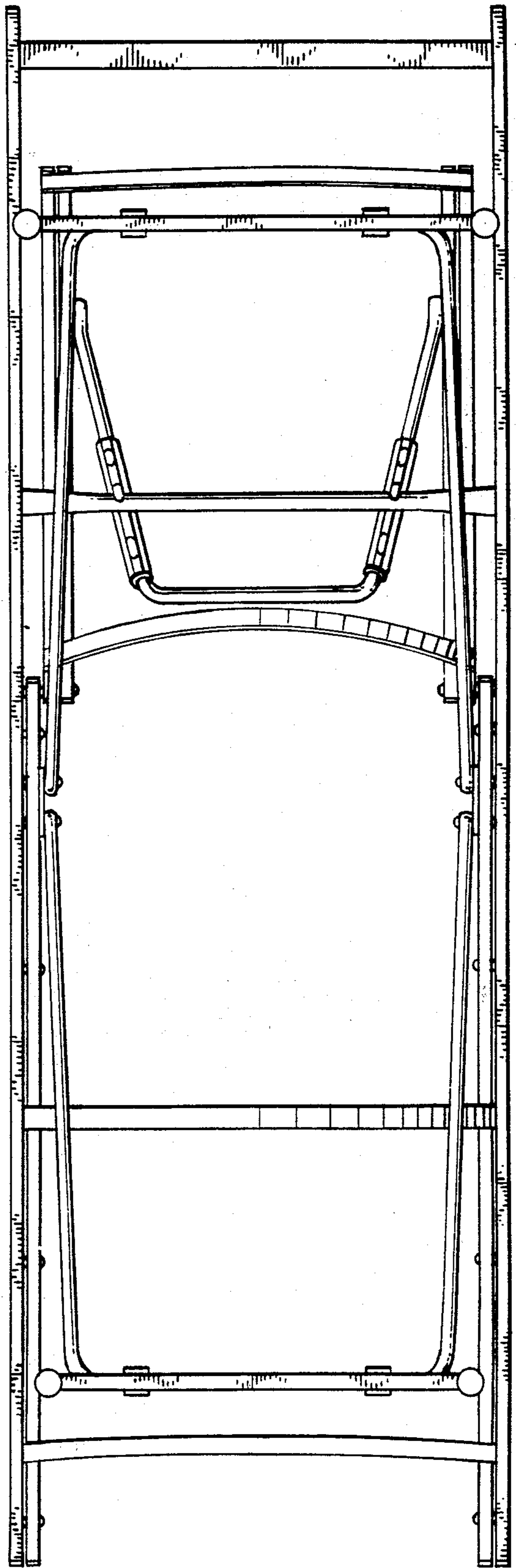

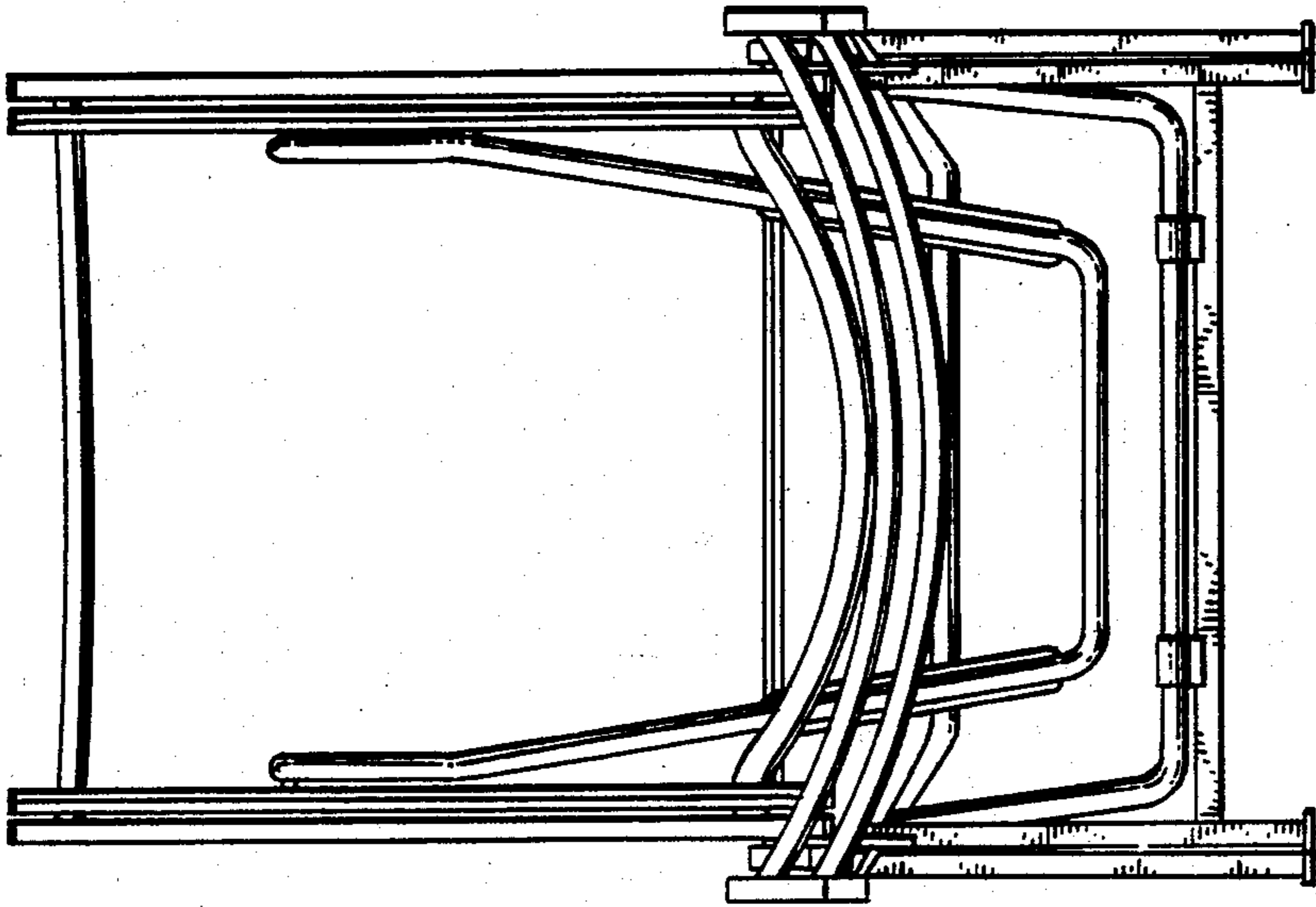

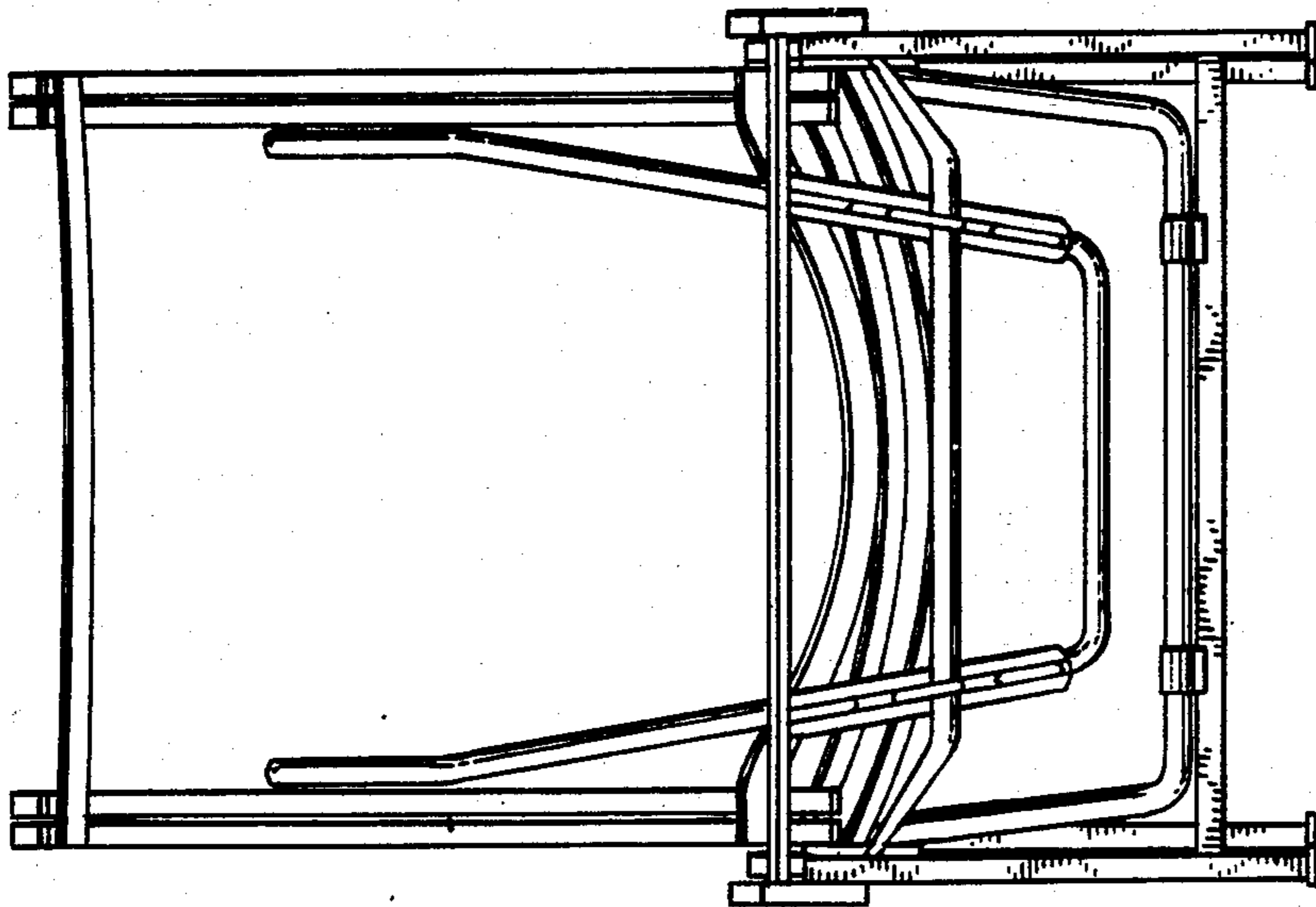

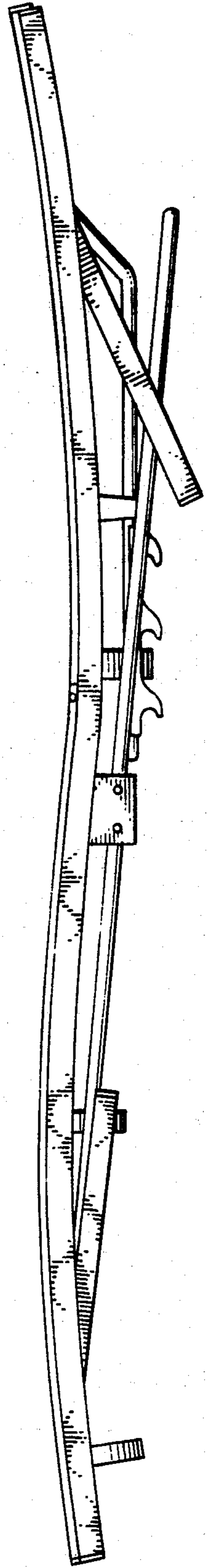
