DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a boat chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof taken from one side, the opposite side appearing as a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

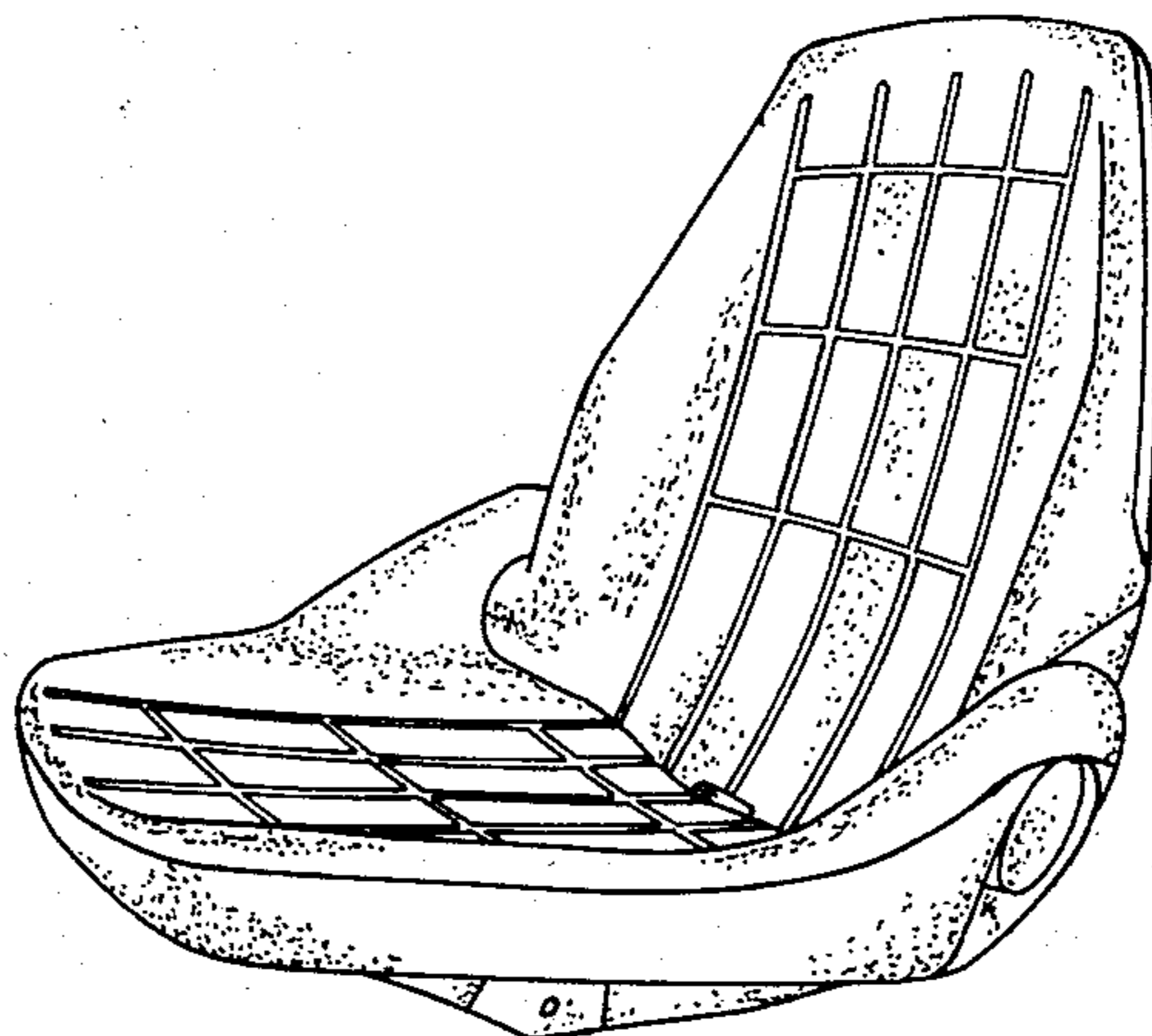

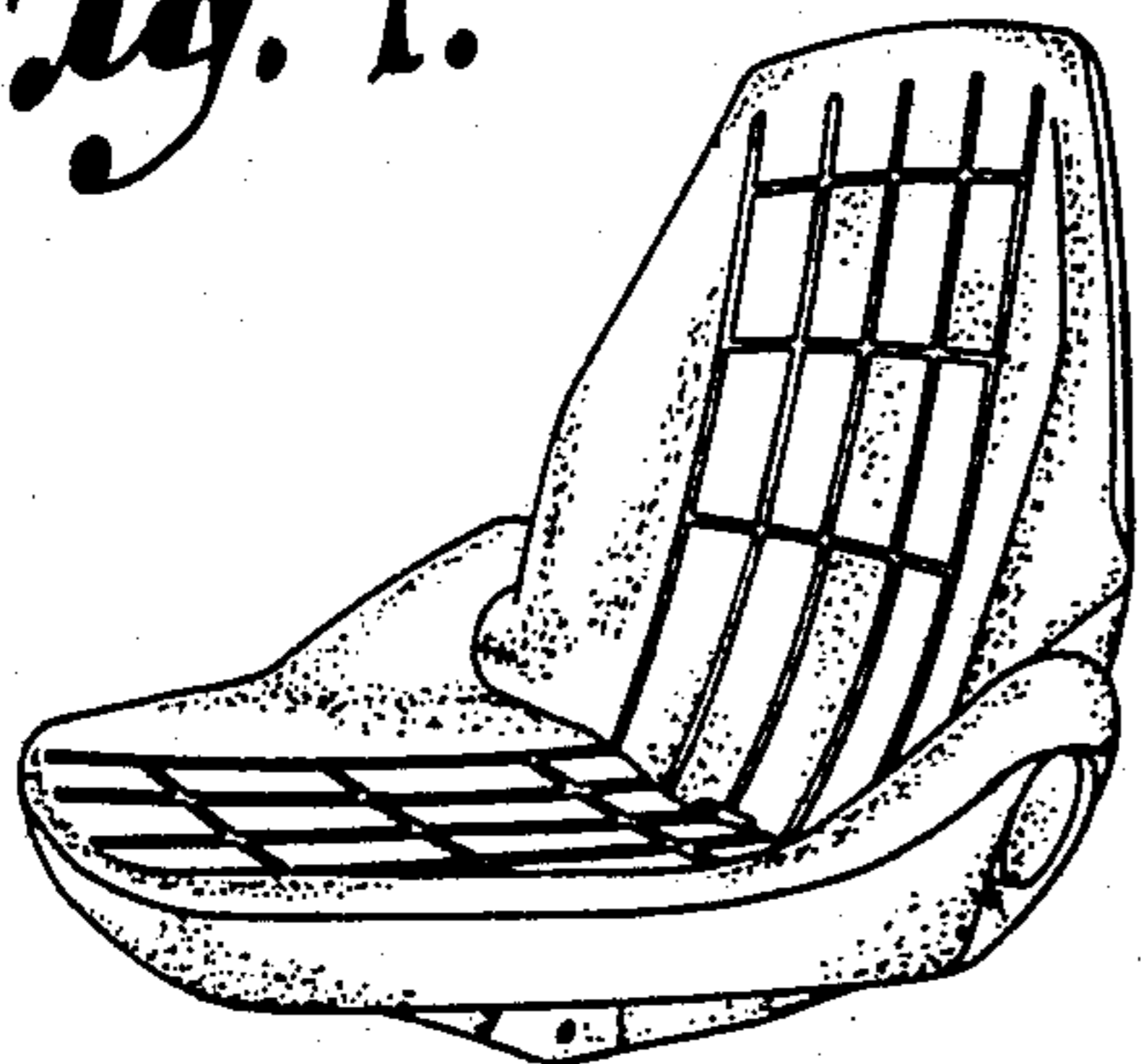

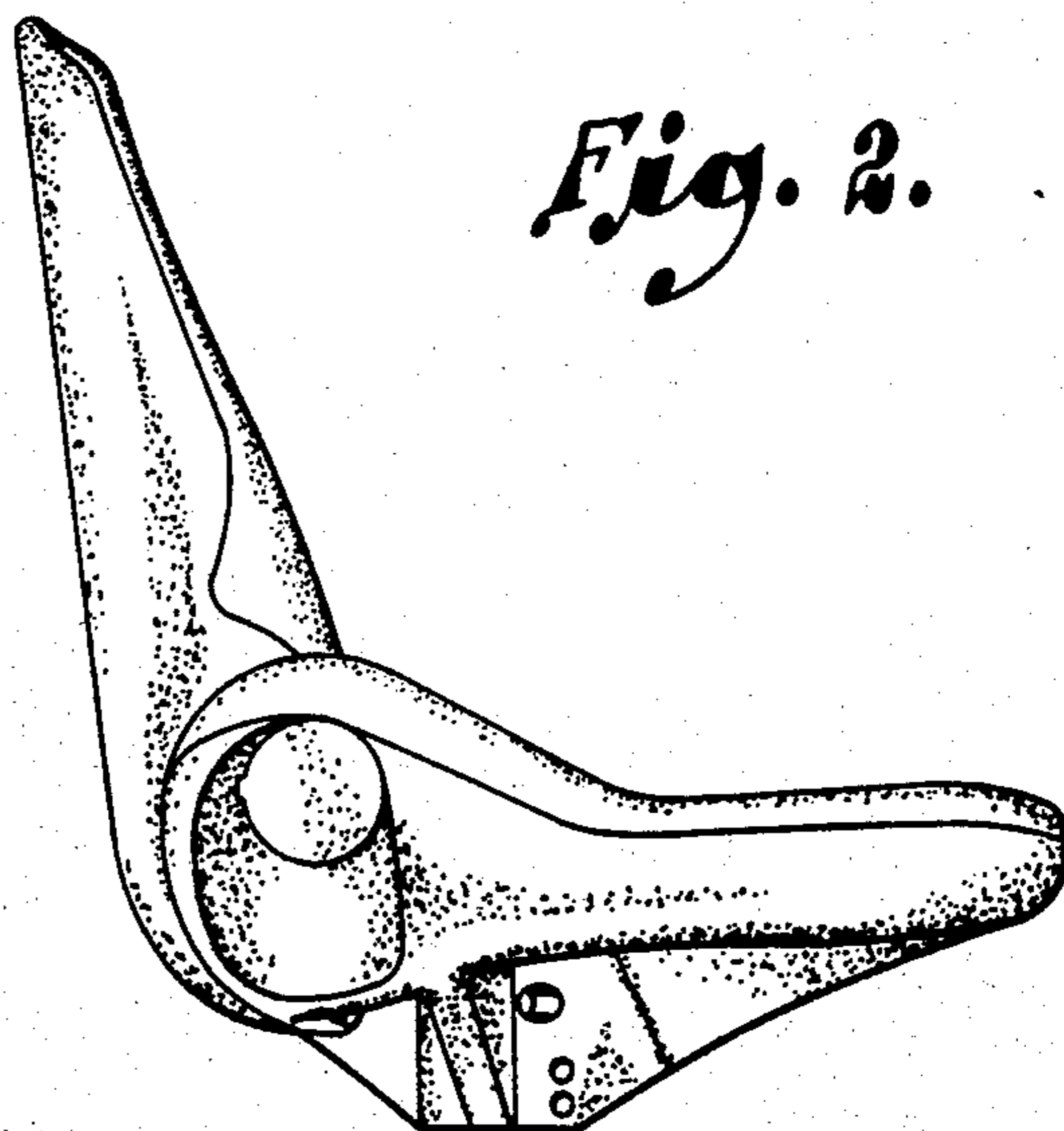

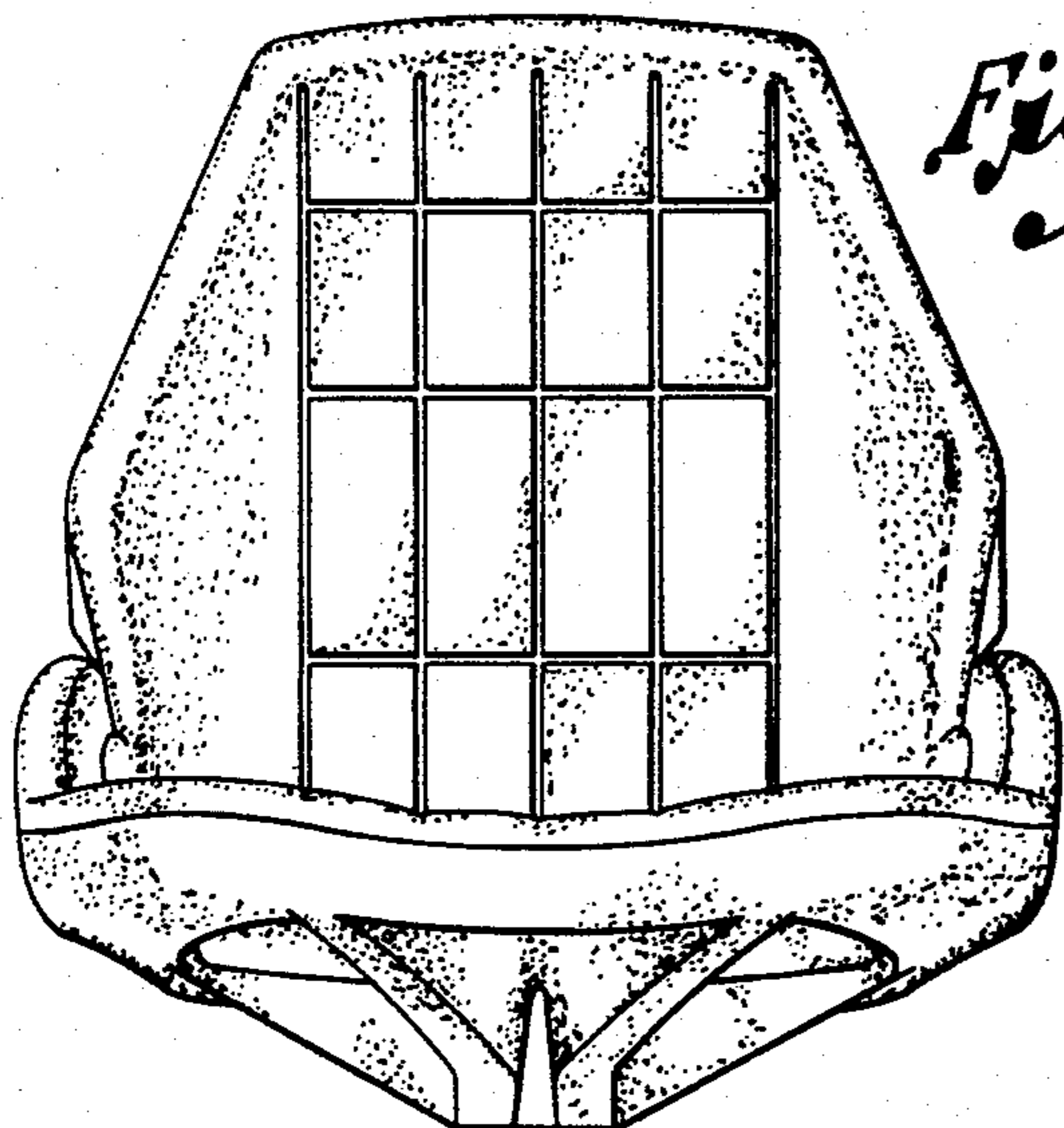

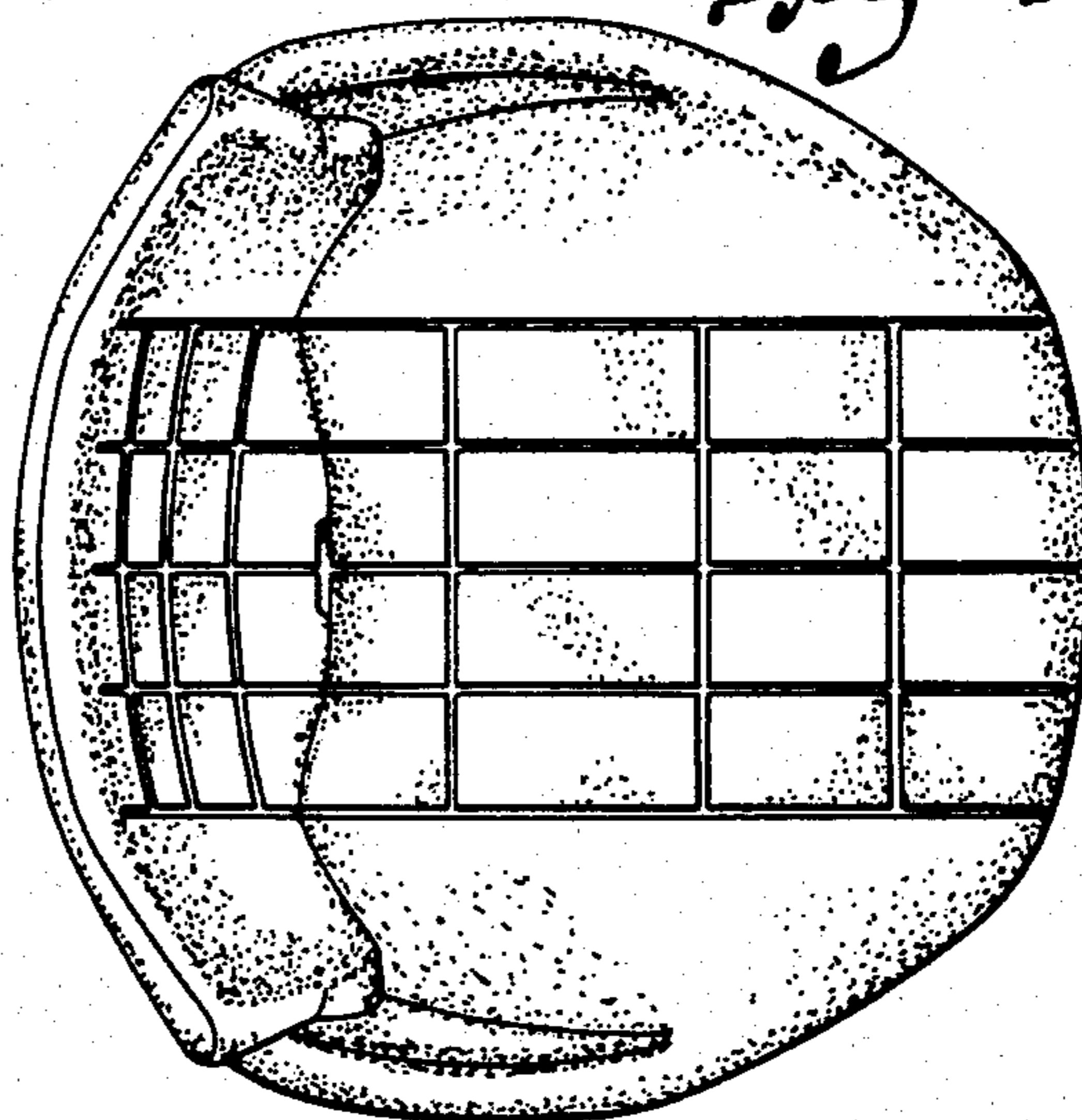

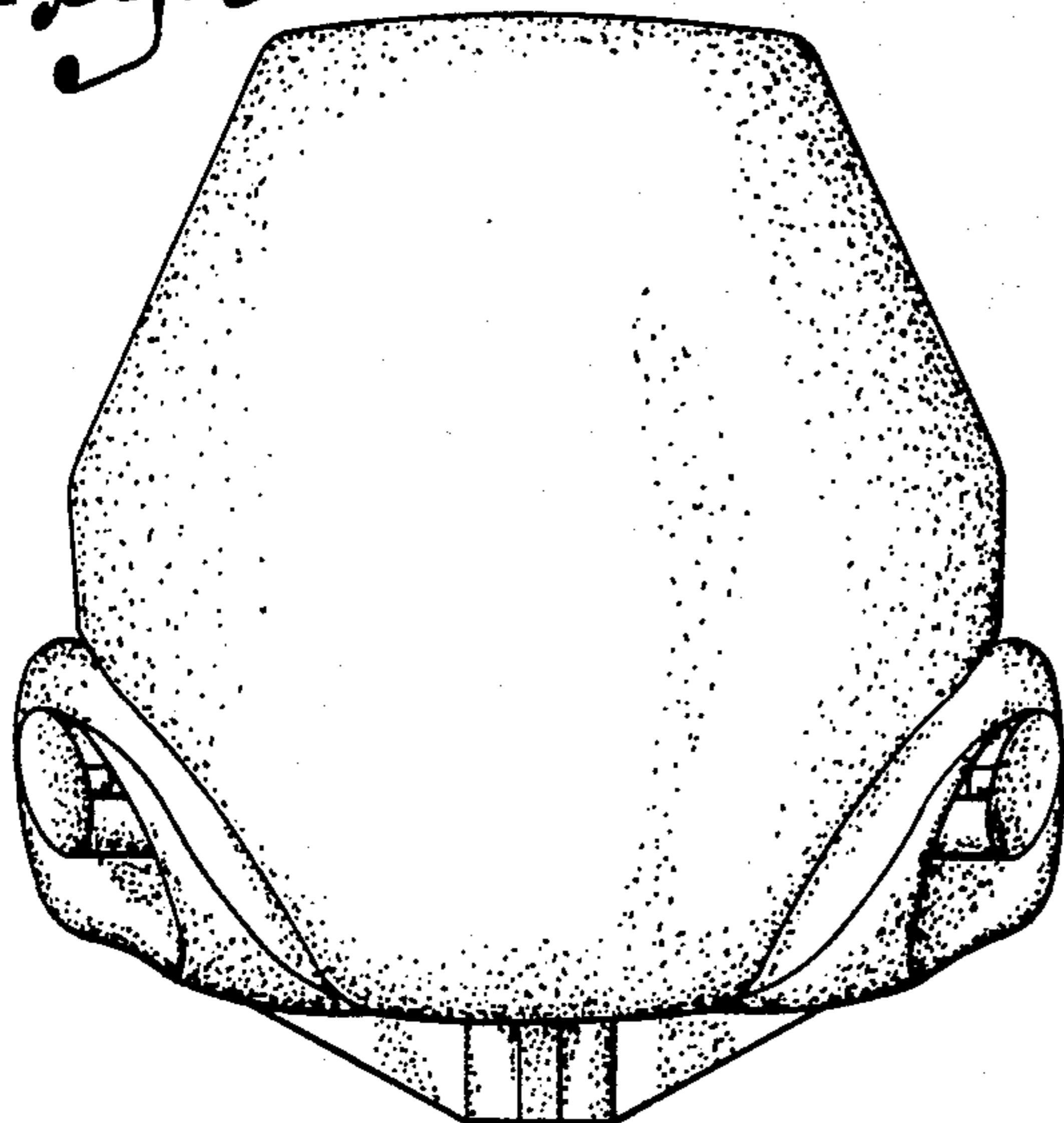
