The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevated side perspective view of a chair embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is a side plan view thereof which also accurately represents the opposite side view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof.

FIG. 4 is an elevated side perspective view of an alternative embodiment of my new design.

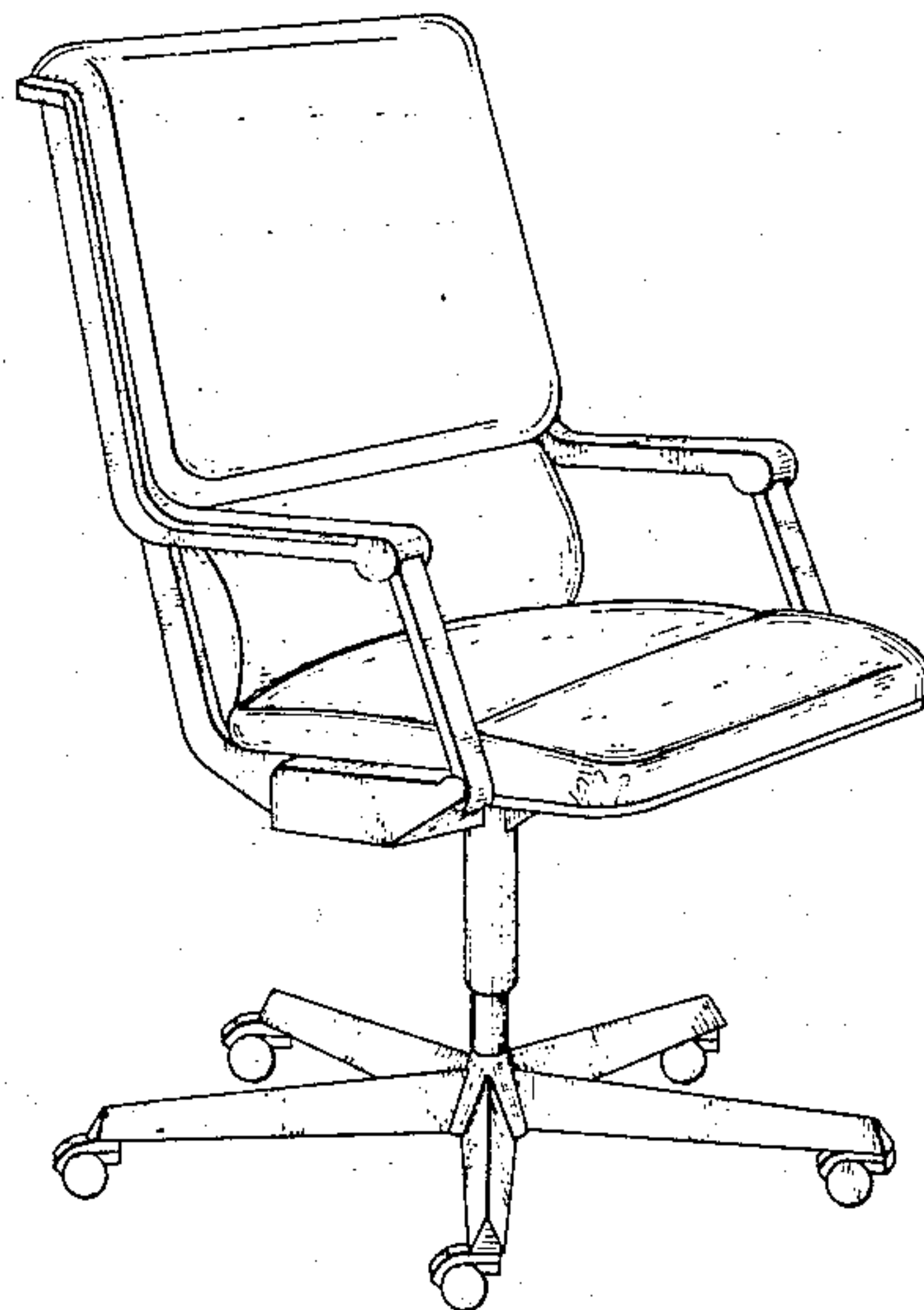

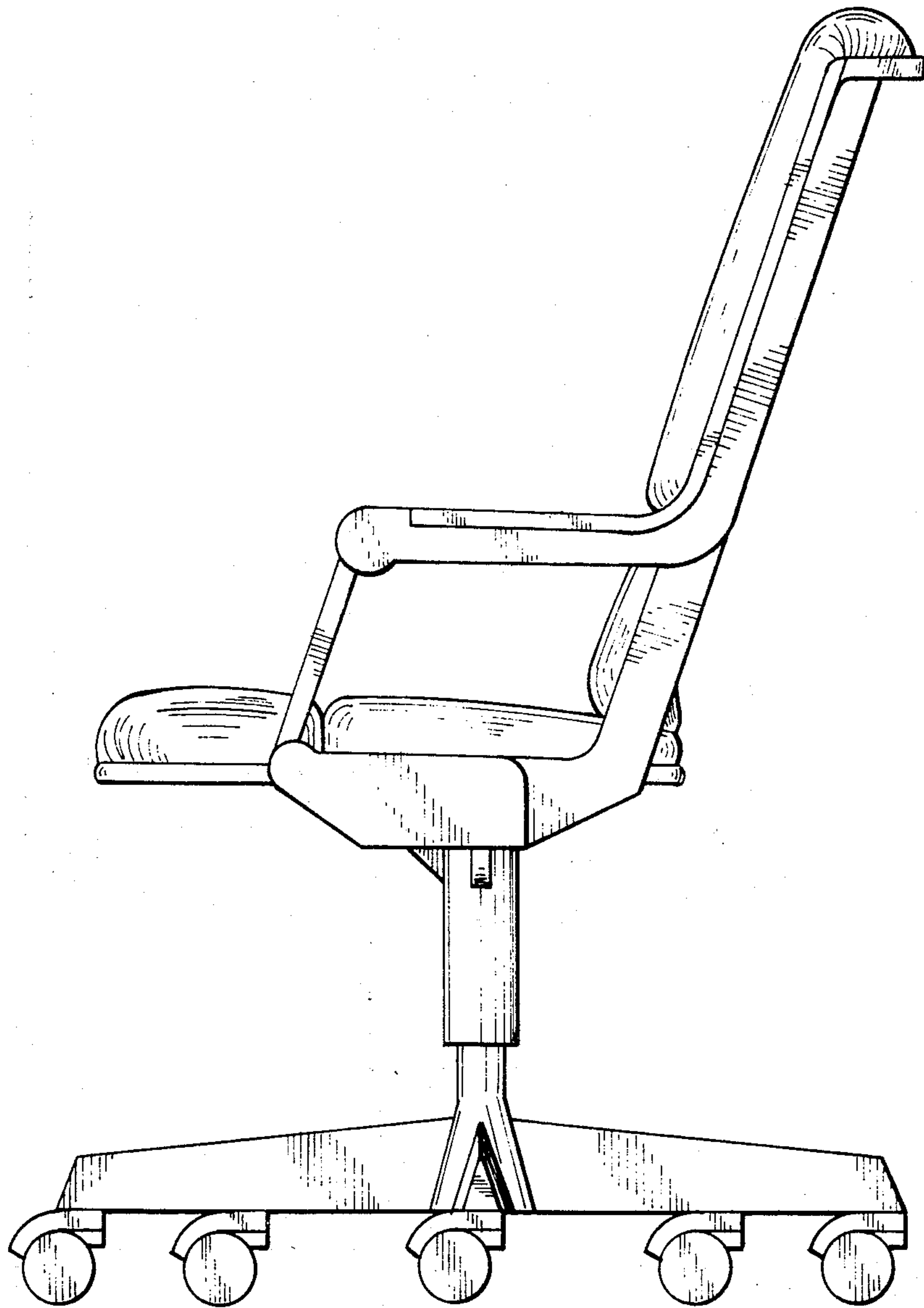

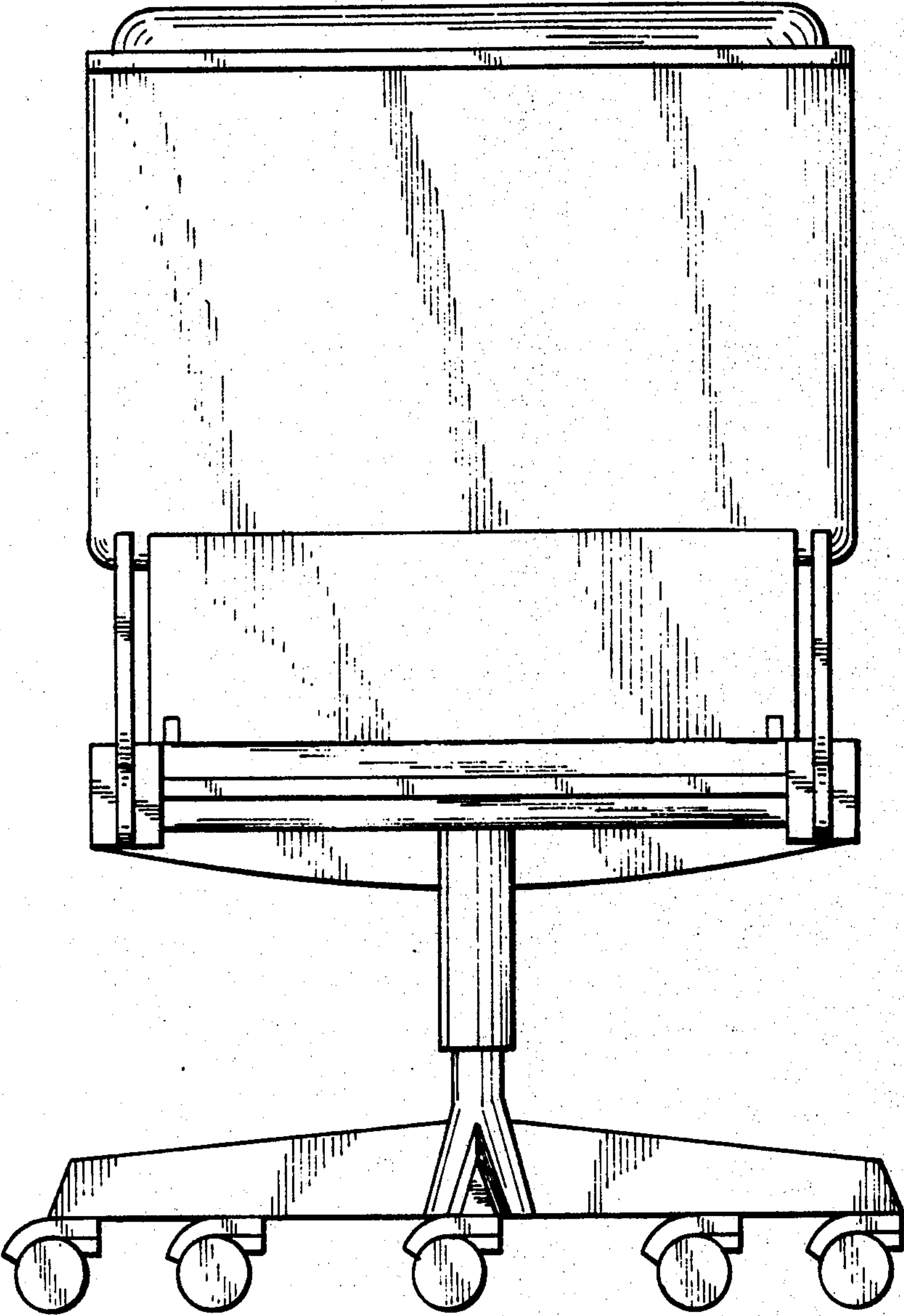
