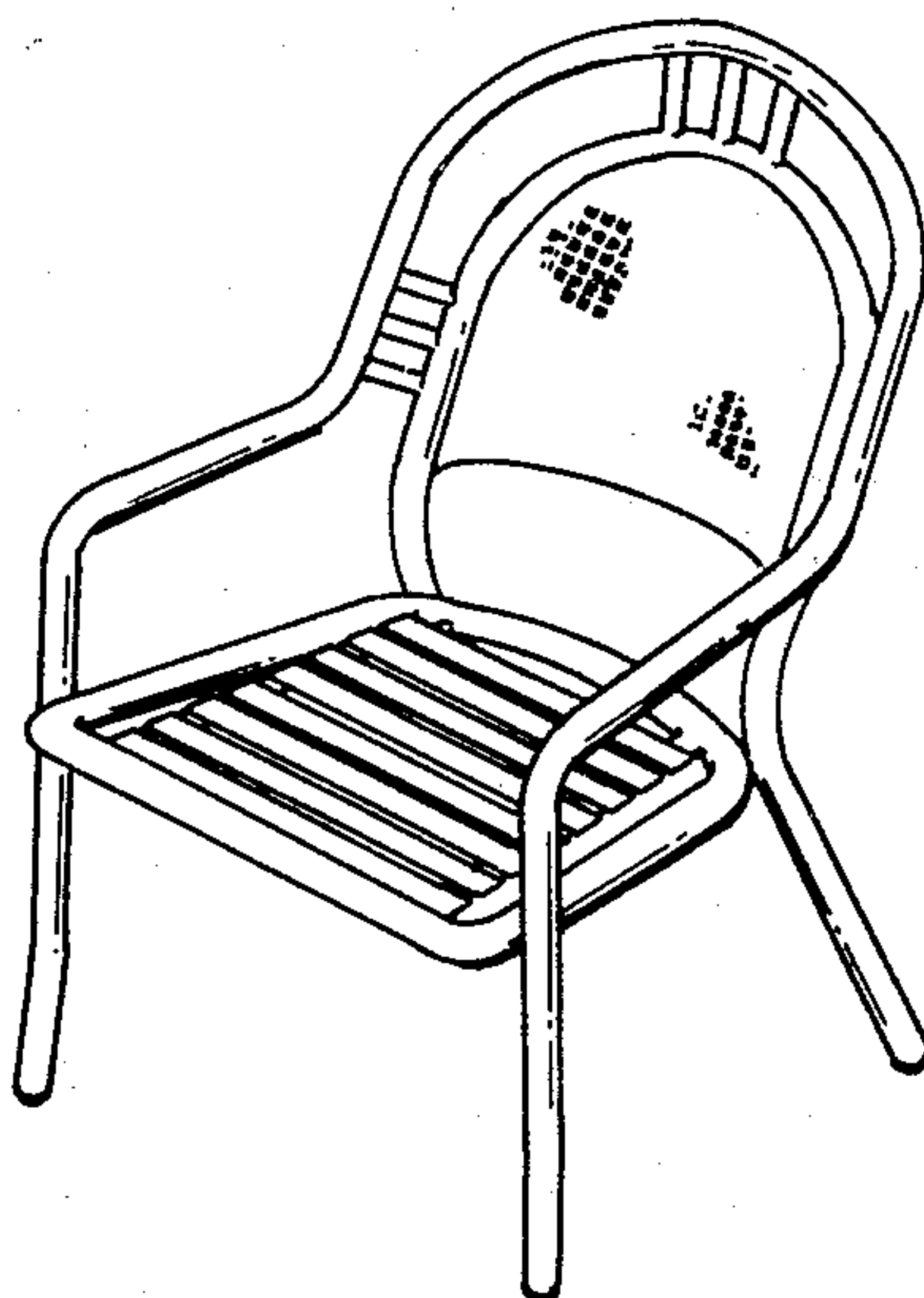

The ornamental design for a chair frame or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a chair frame or similar article showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 4 is a left side perspective view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view; and
FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view thereof.



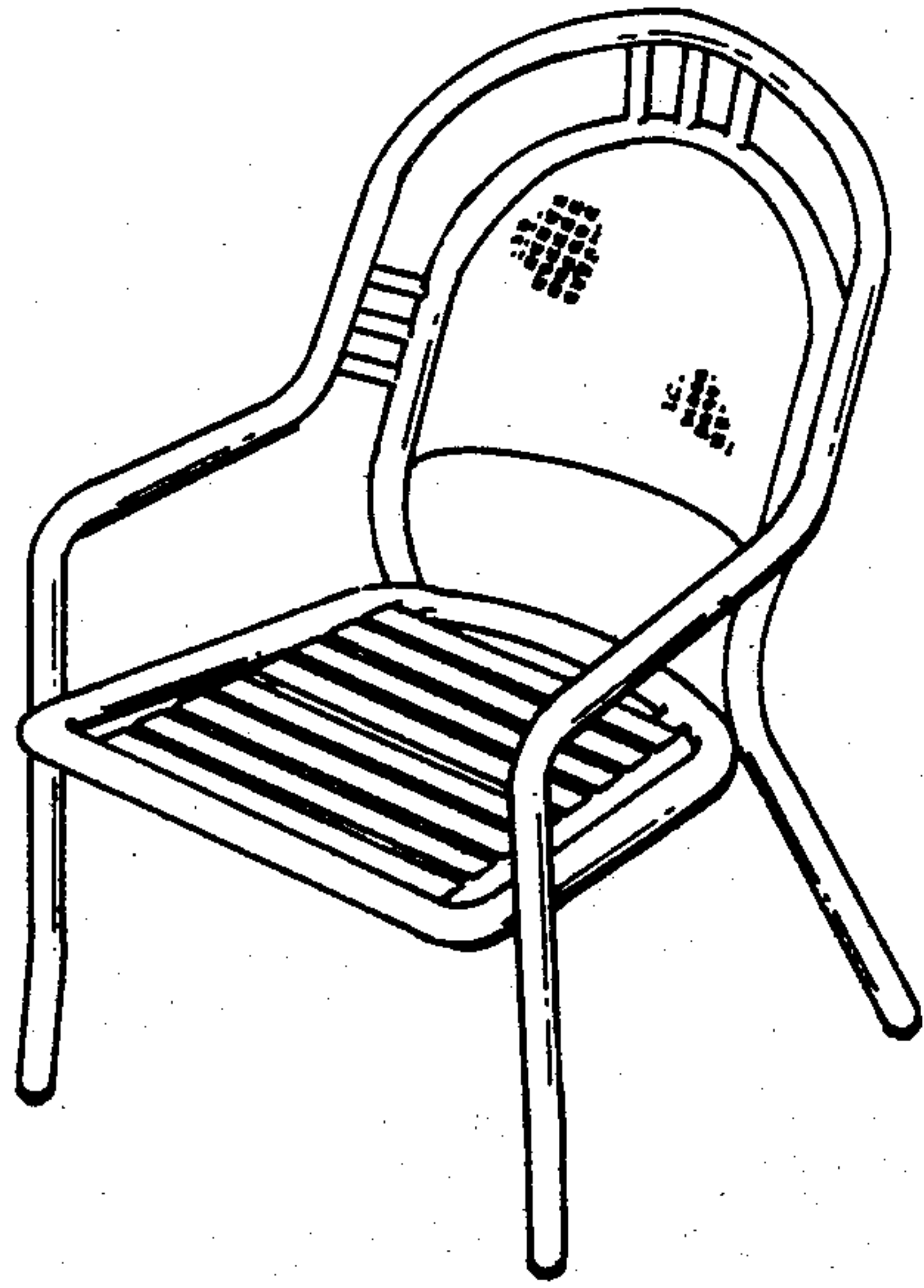

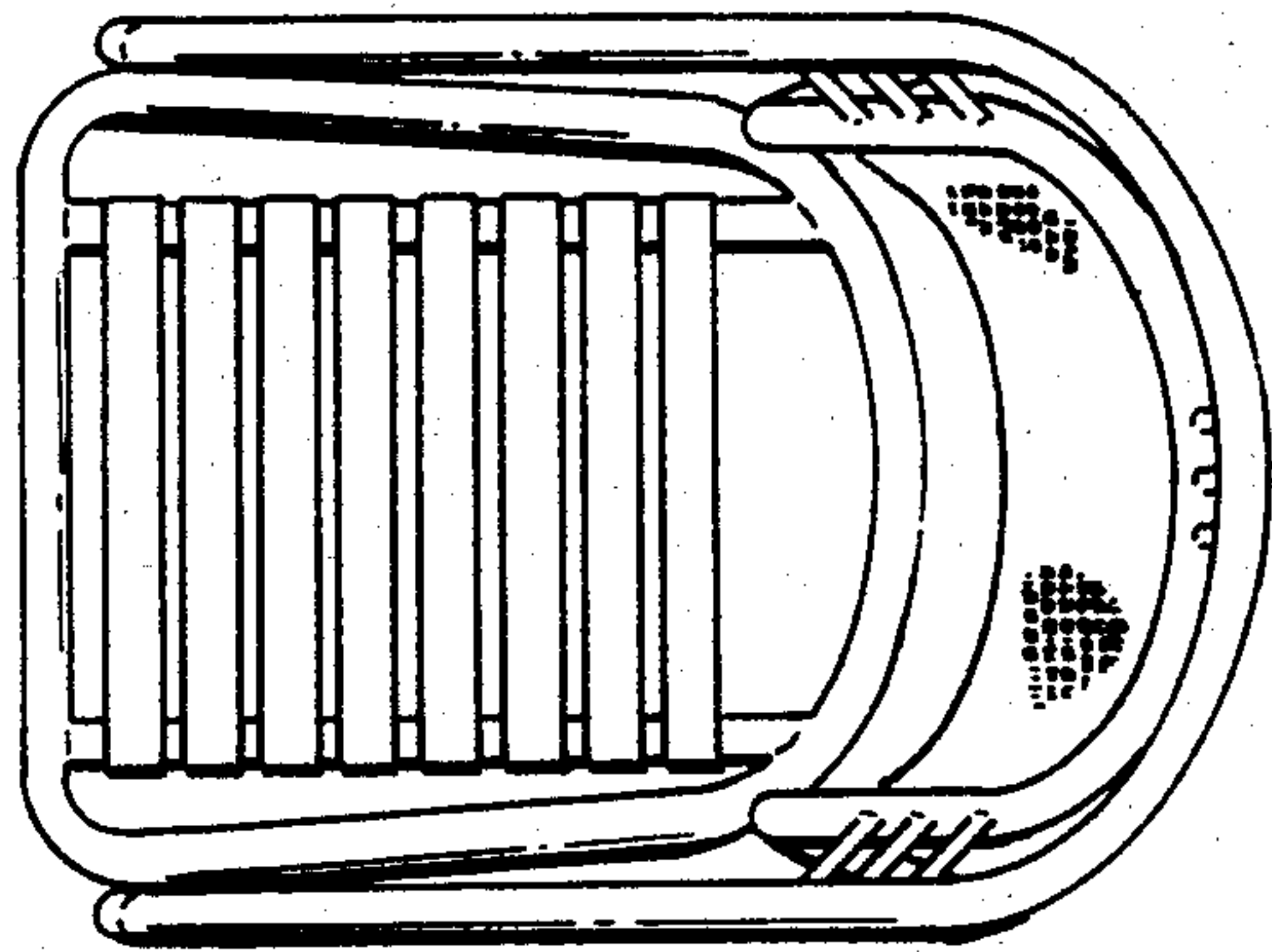

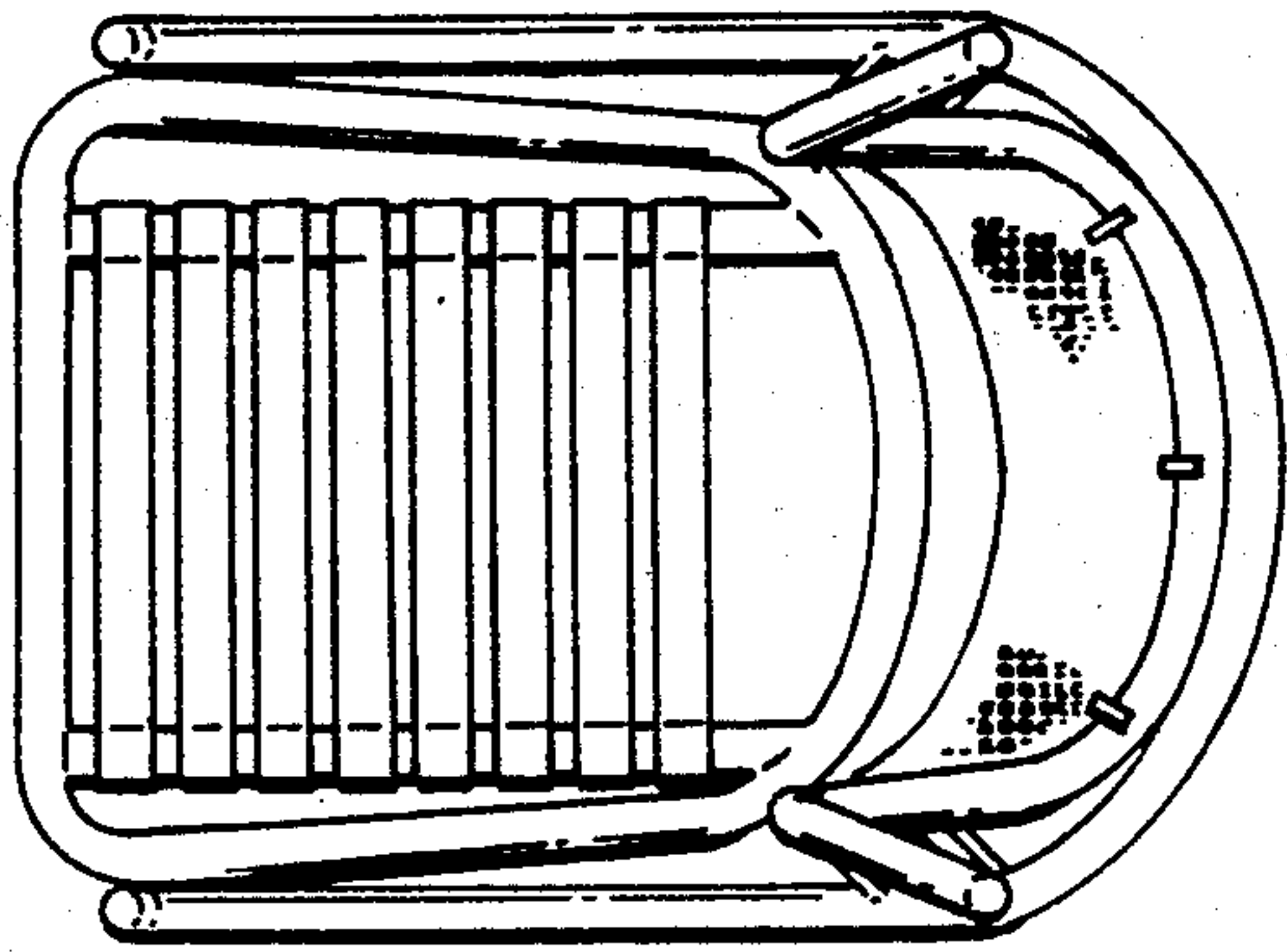

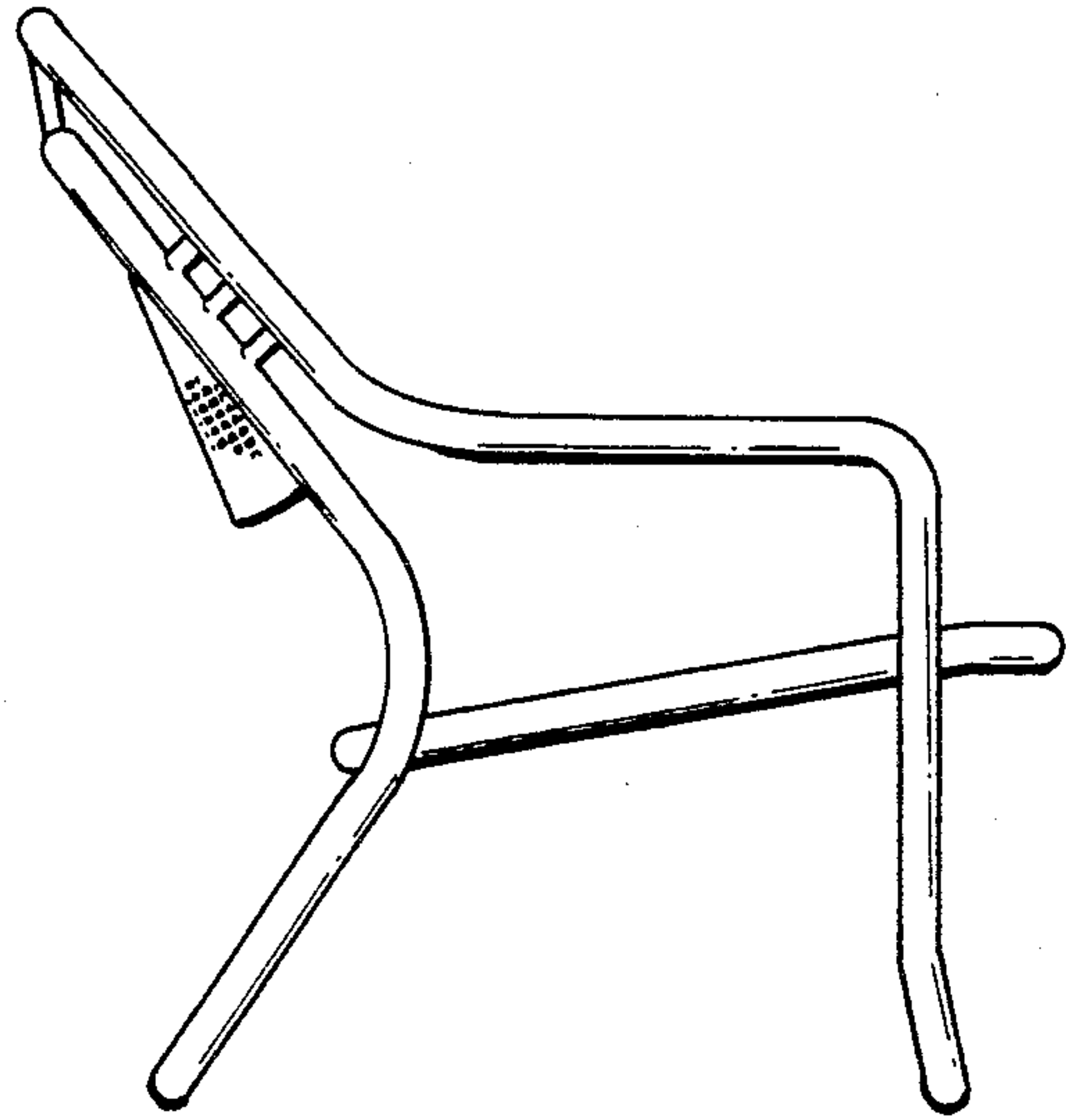

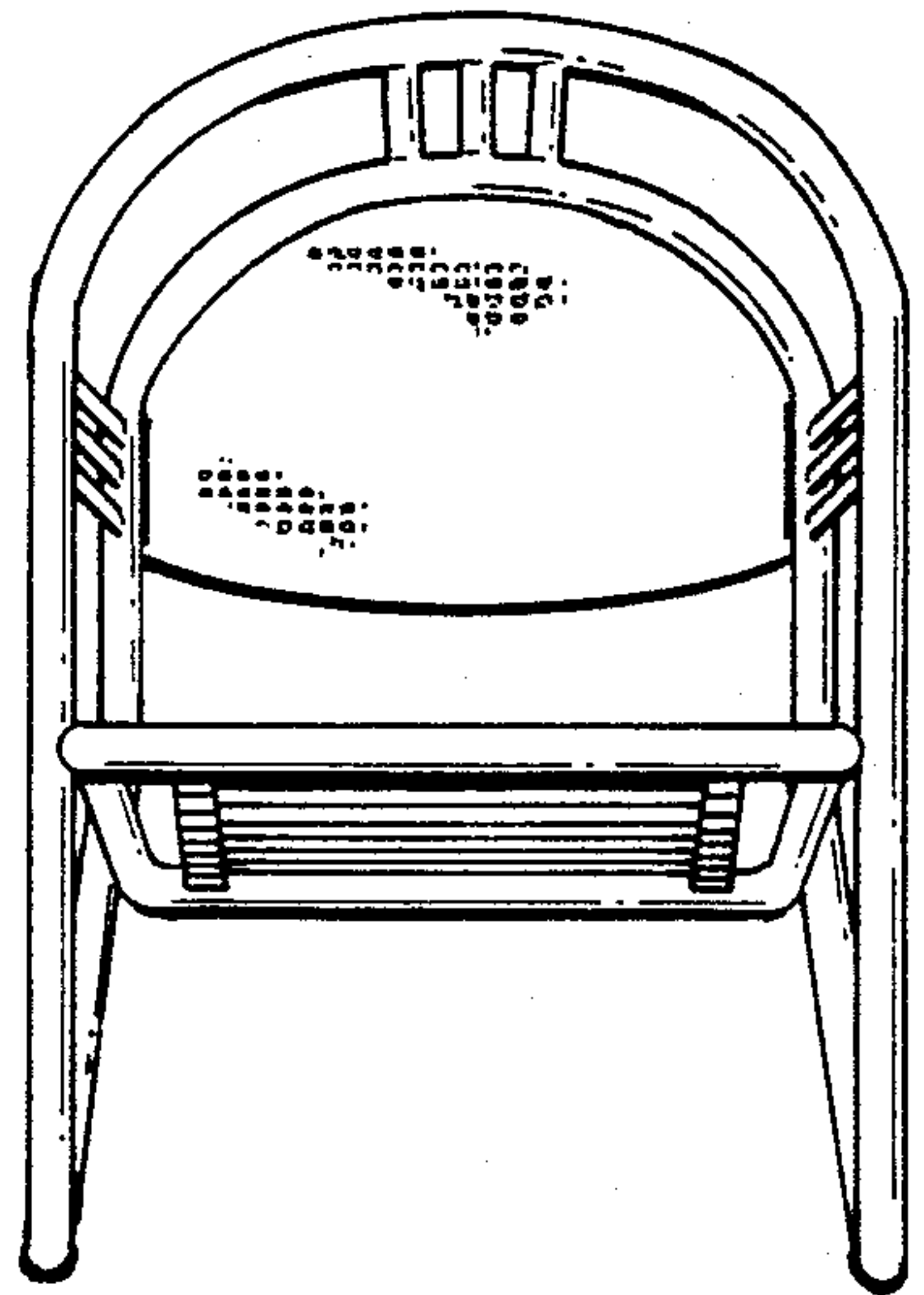

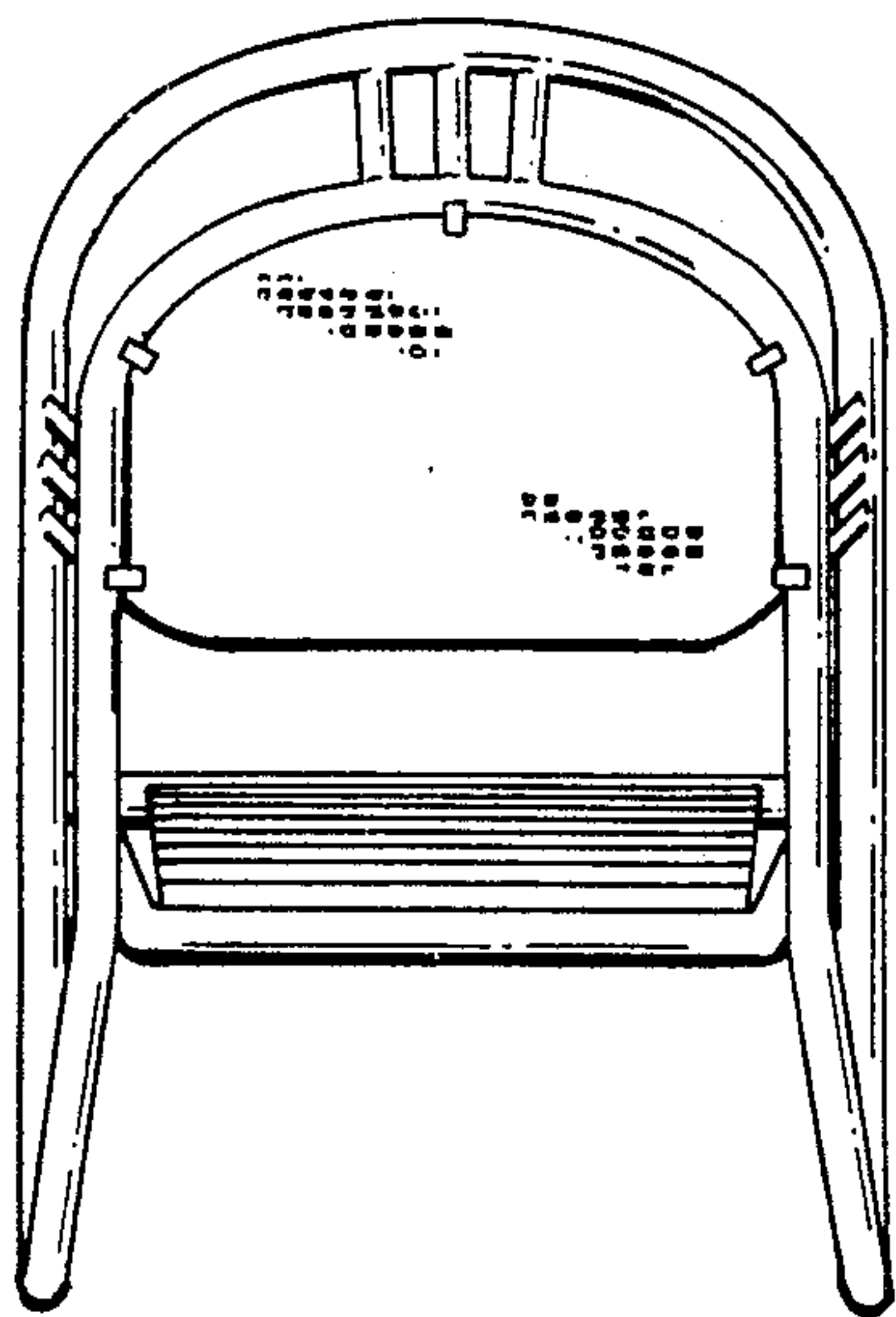
