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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a watch dial, substantially as  
shown.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a plan view of a watch dial, or similar  
article, showing my new design.

The two concentric circles formed by broken lines  
represent one conventional type of minute track and

case, hands and other surface indicia are for illustrated
