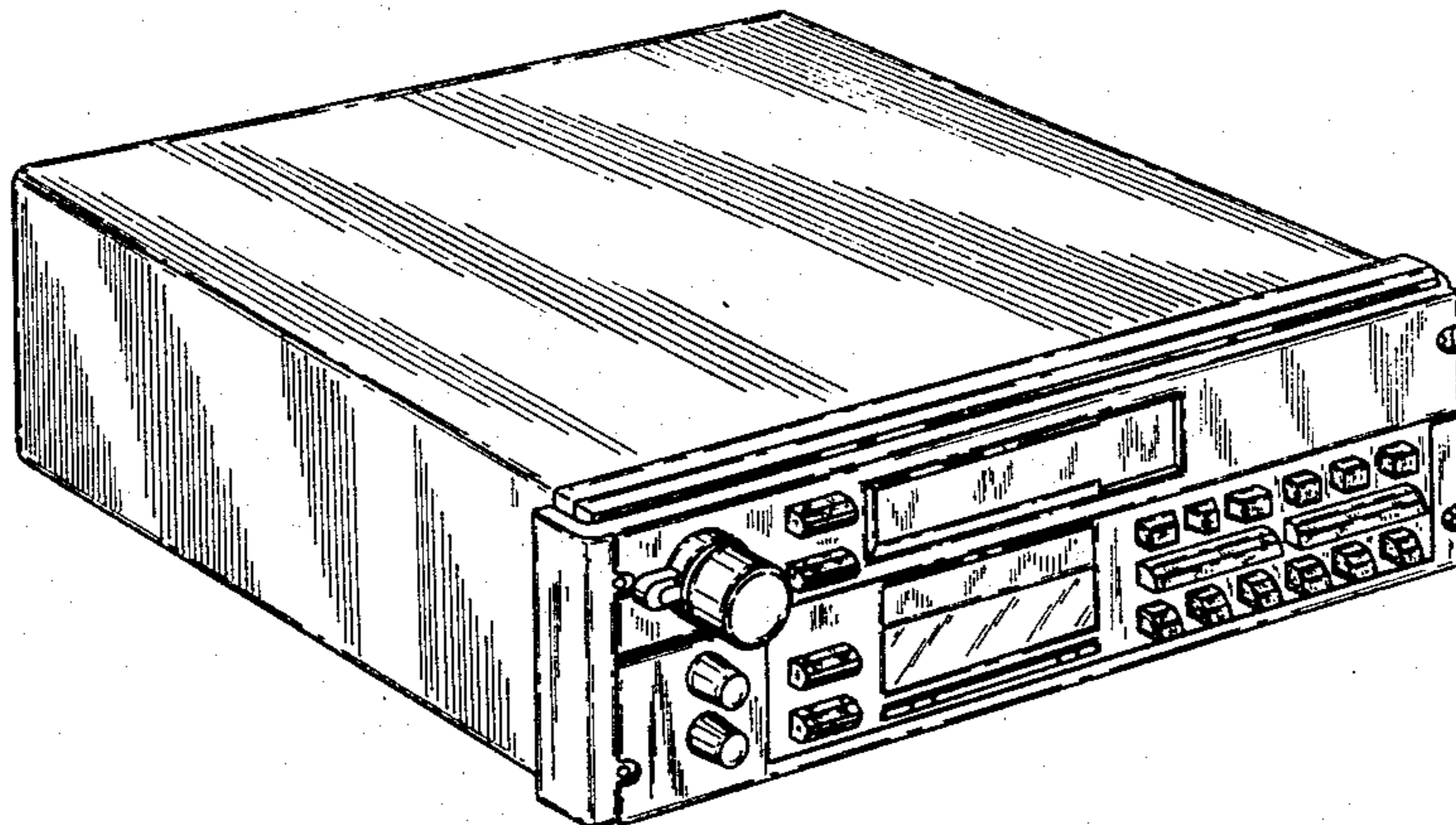

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a combined automobile tape player and radio receiver showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.



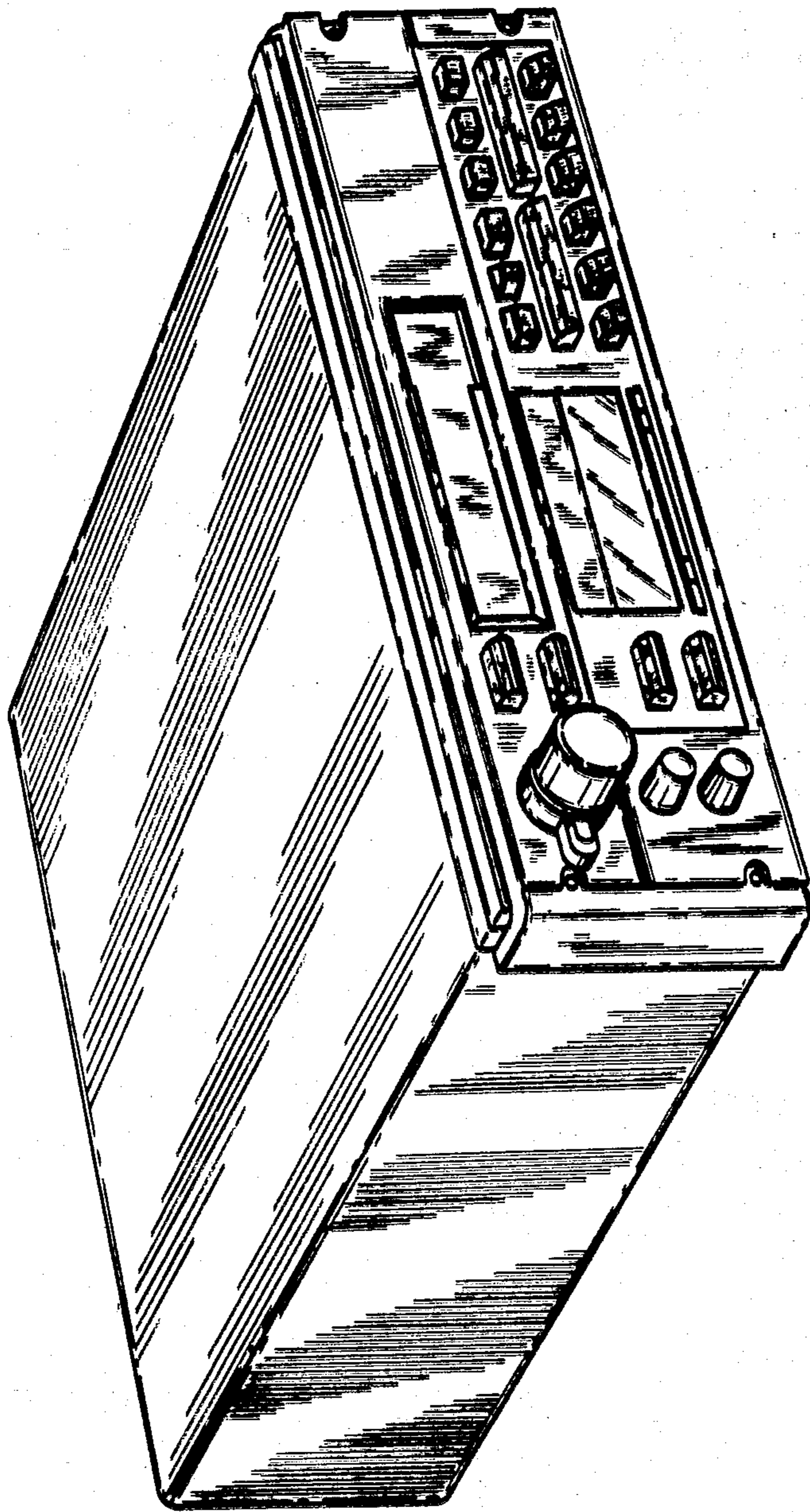

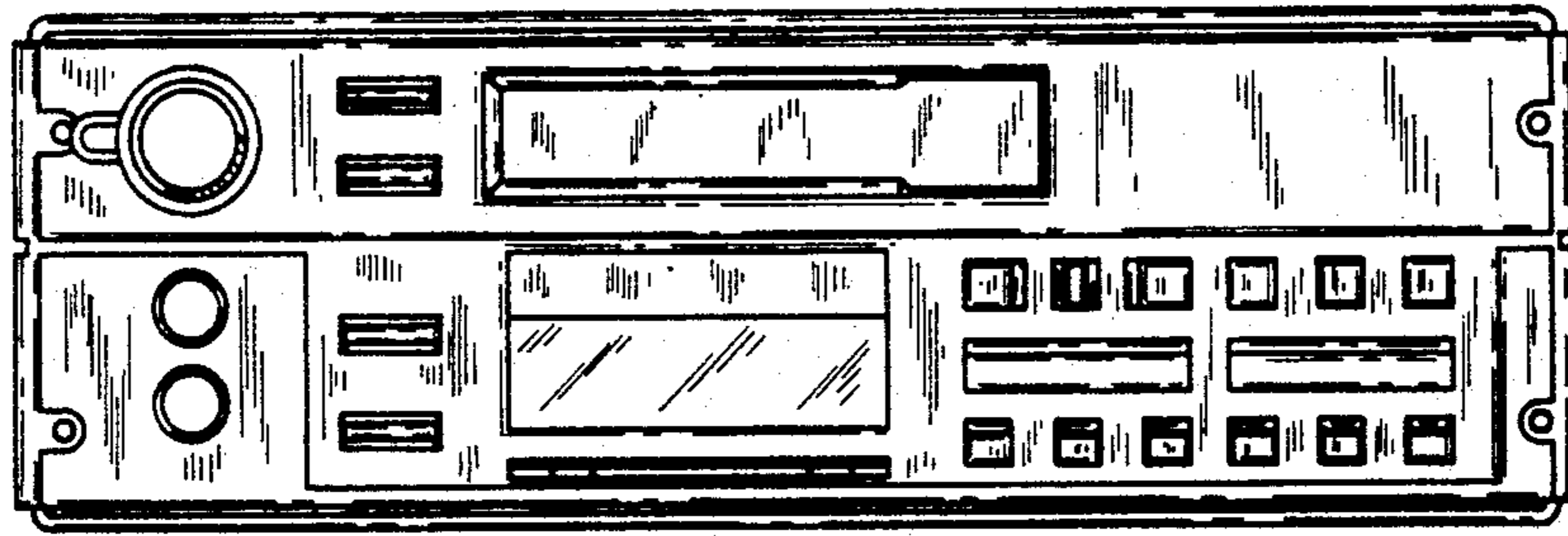

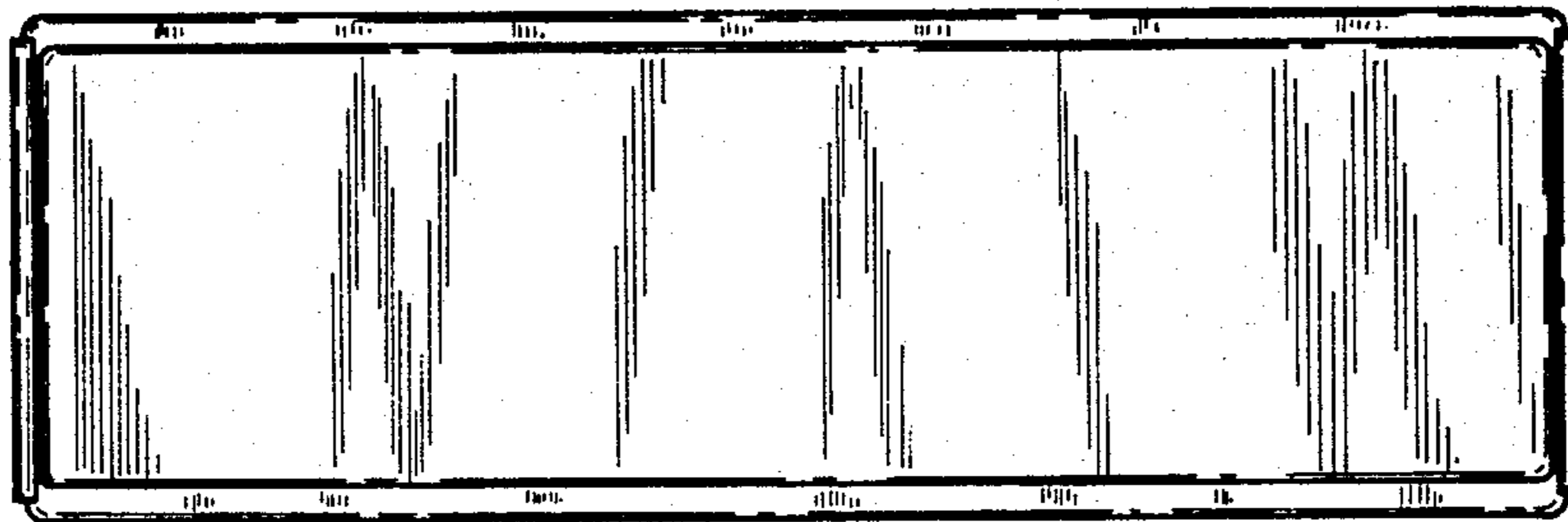

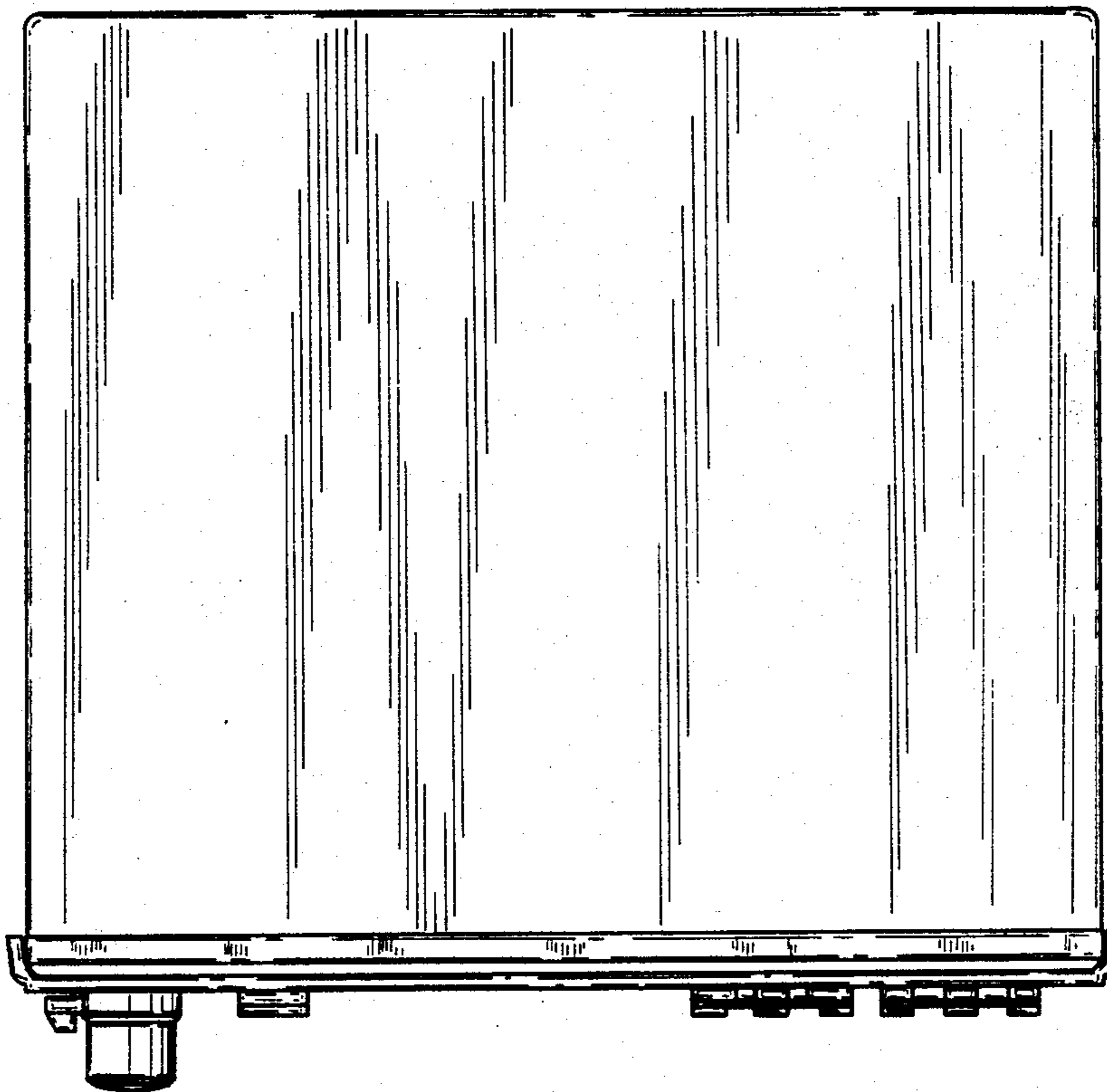

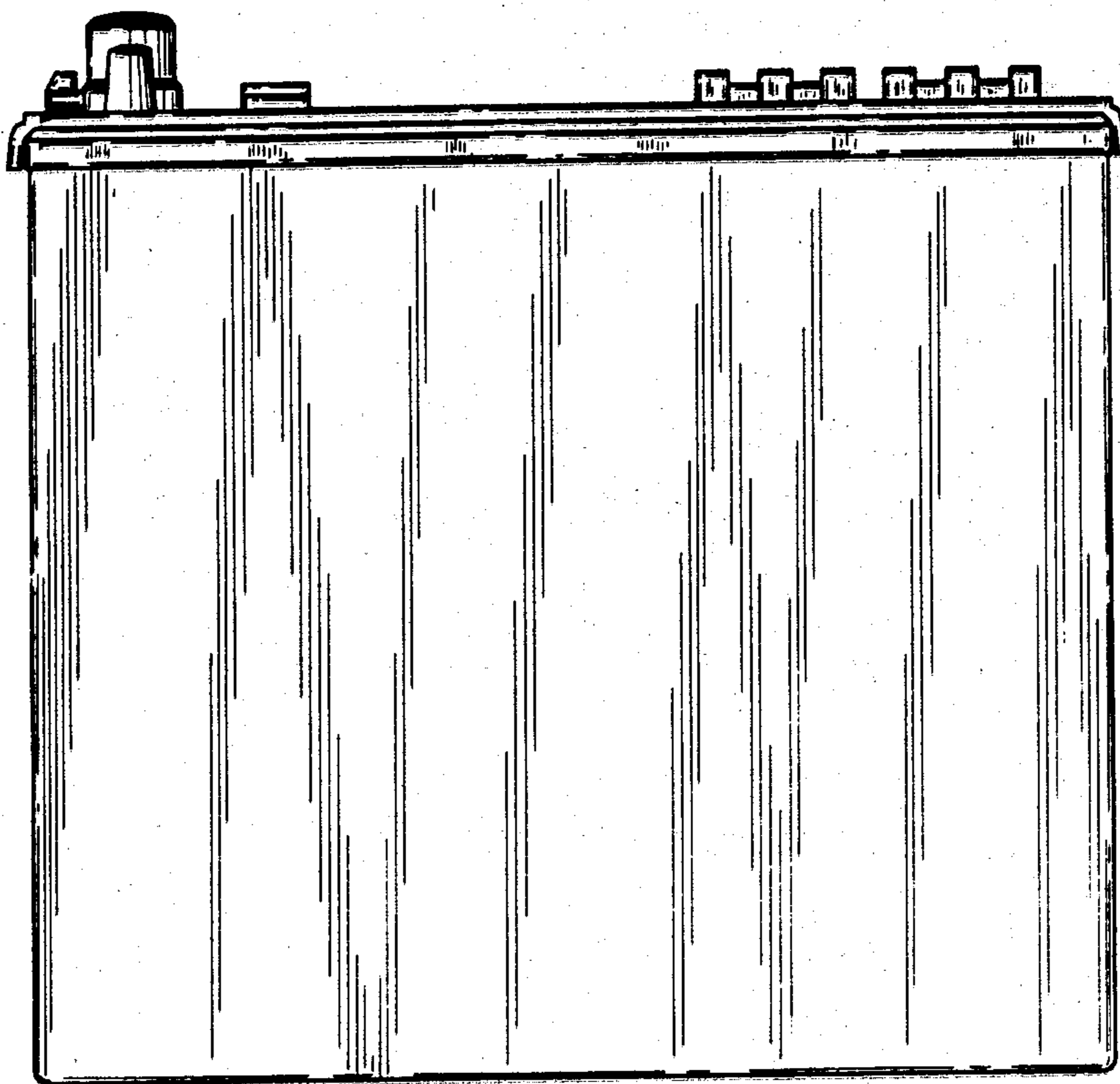

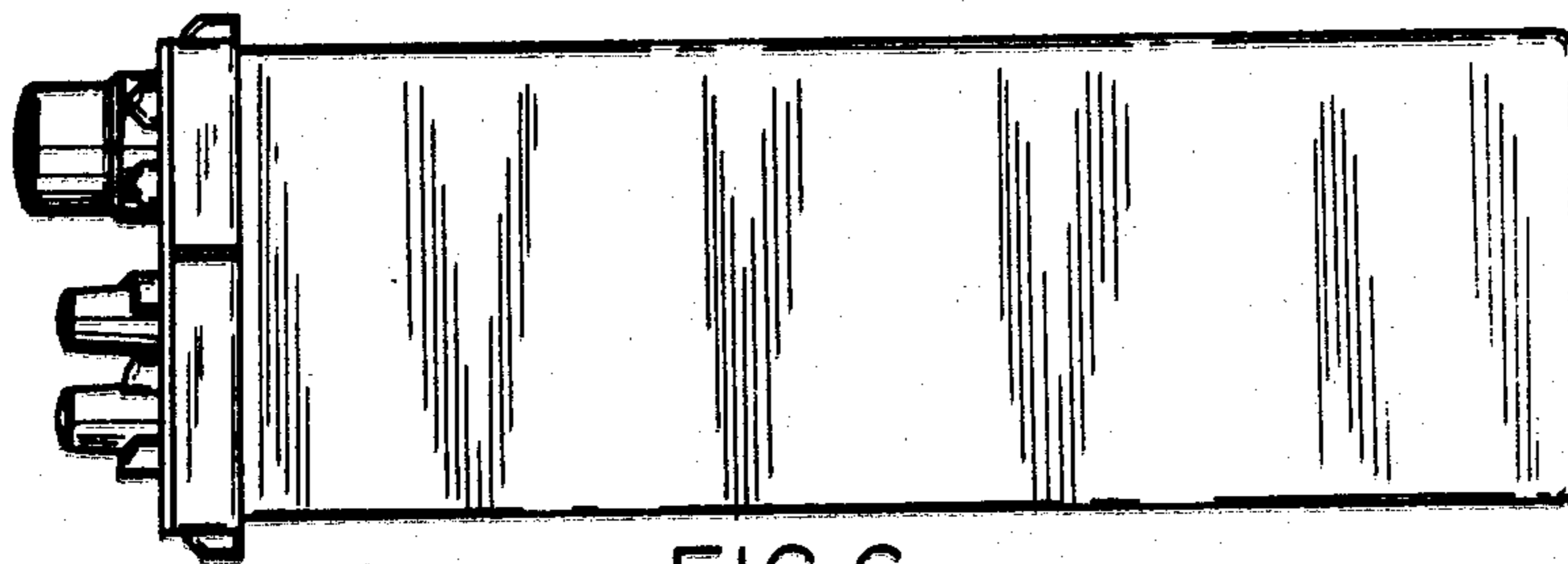

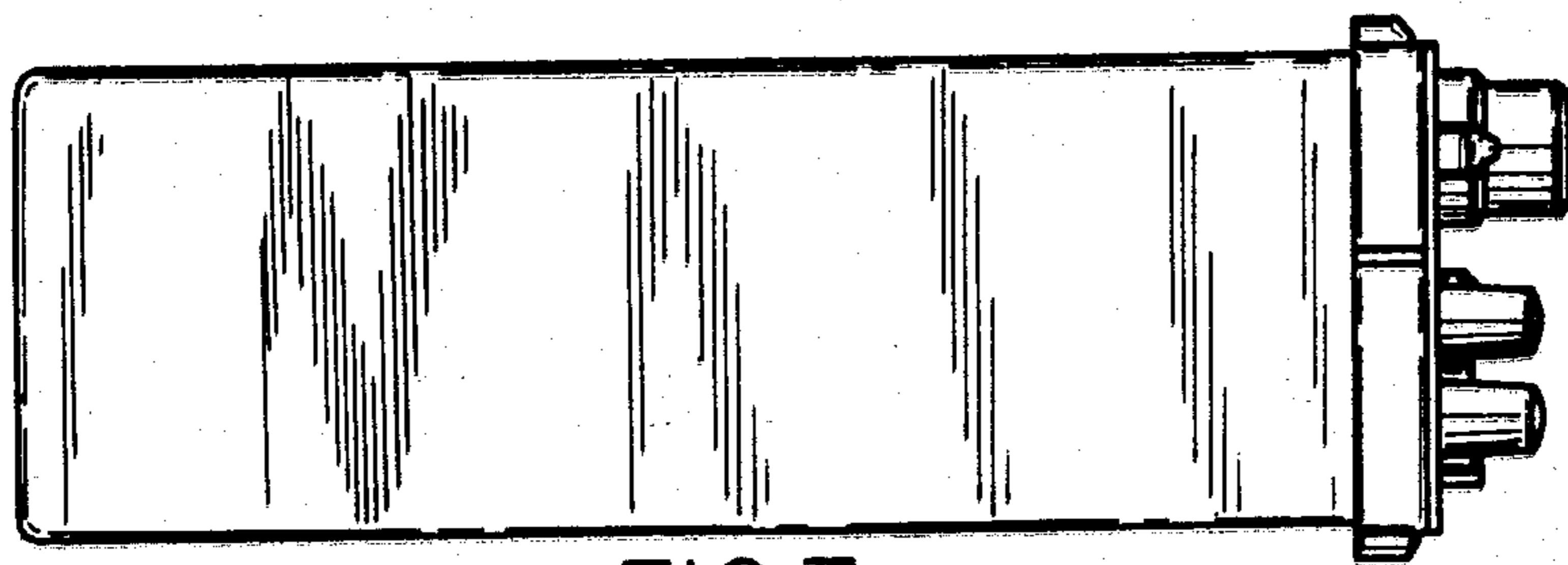
