The ornamental design for a housing for a wall mount telephone set, as shown and described.

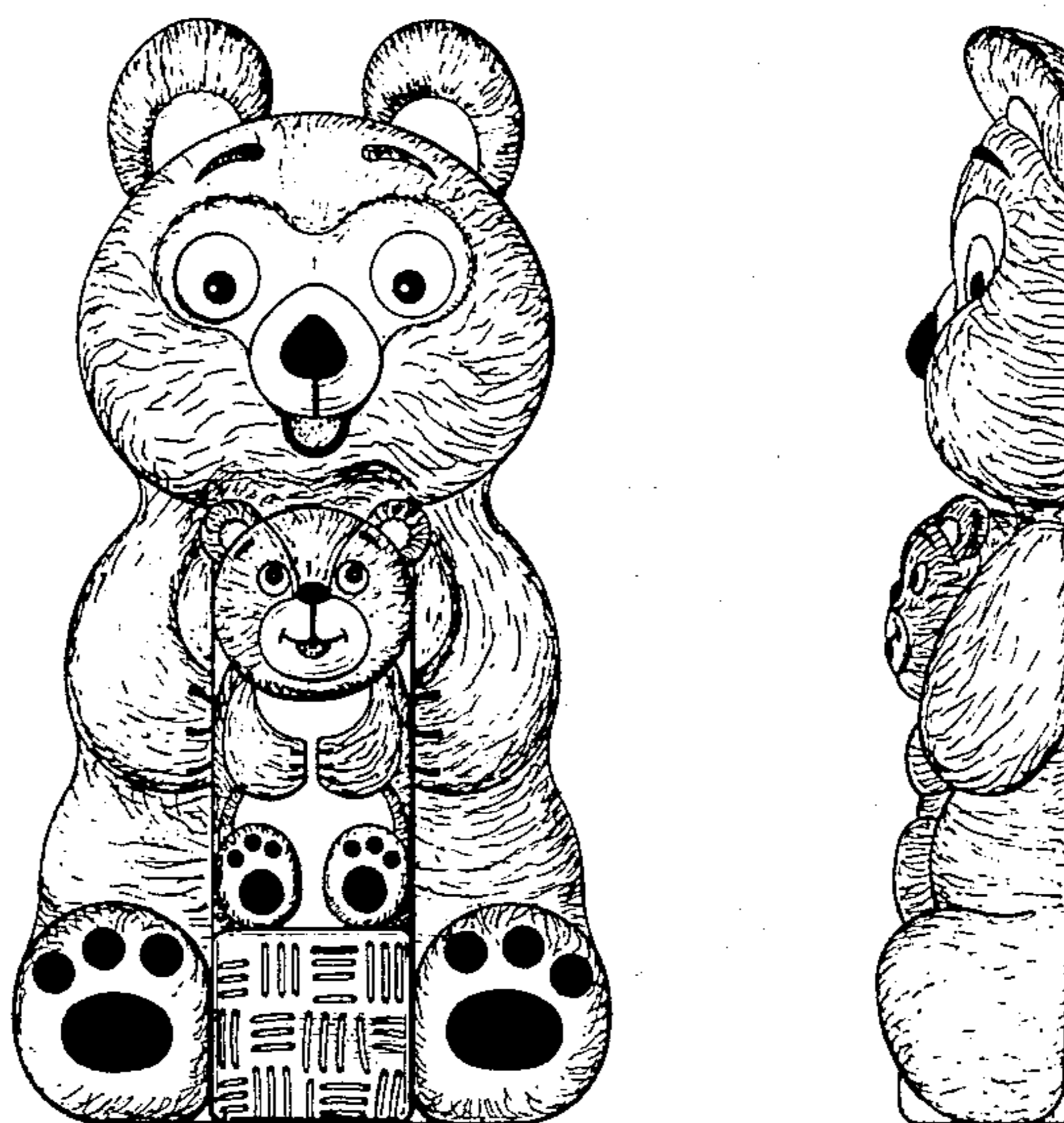
