FIG. 2 is a side view of my new design.

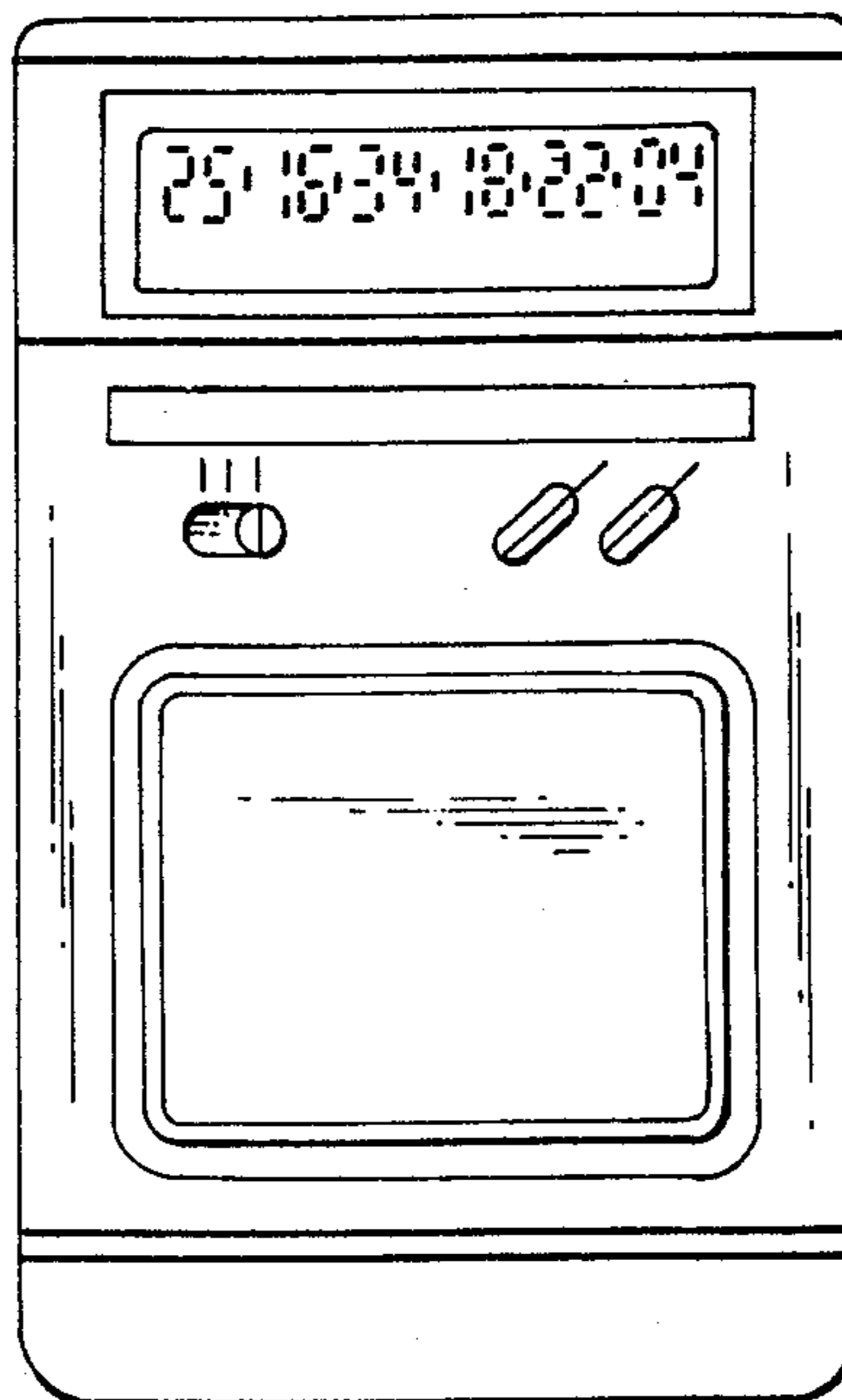
FIG. 3 is a front view of my new design.

The electronic numerals as shown are representative.



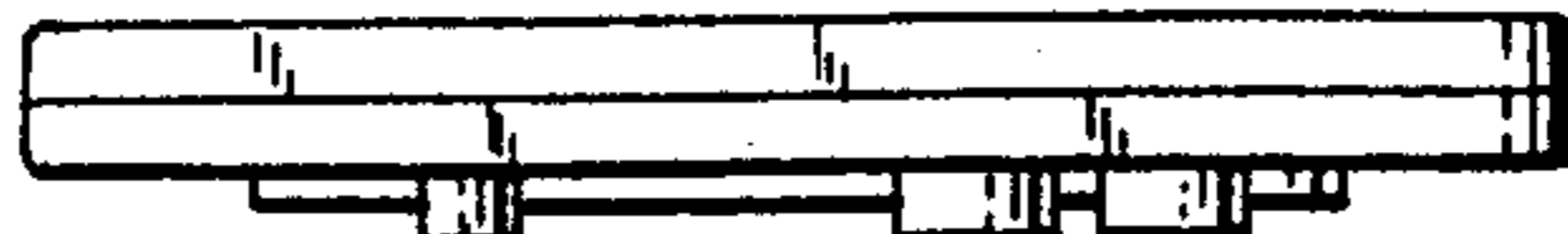

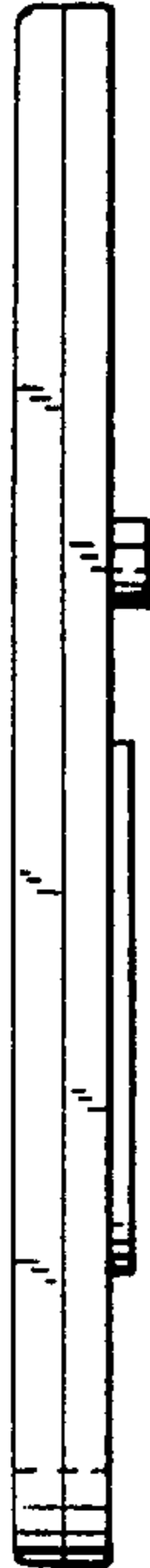

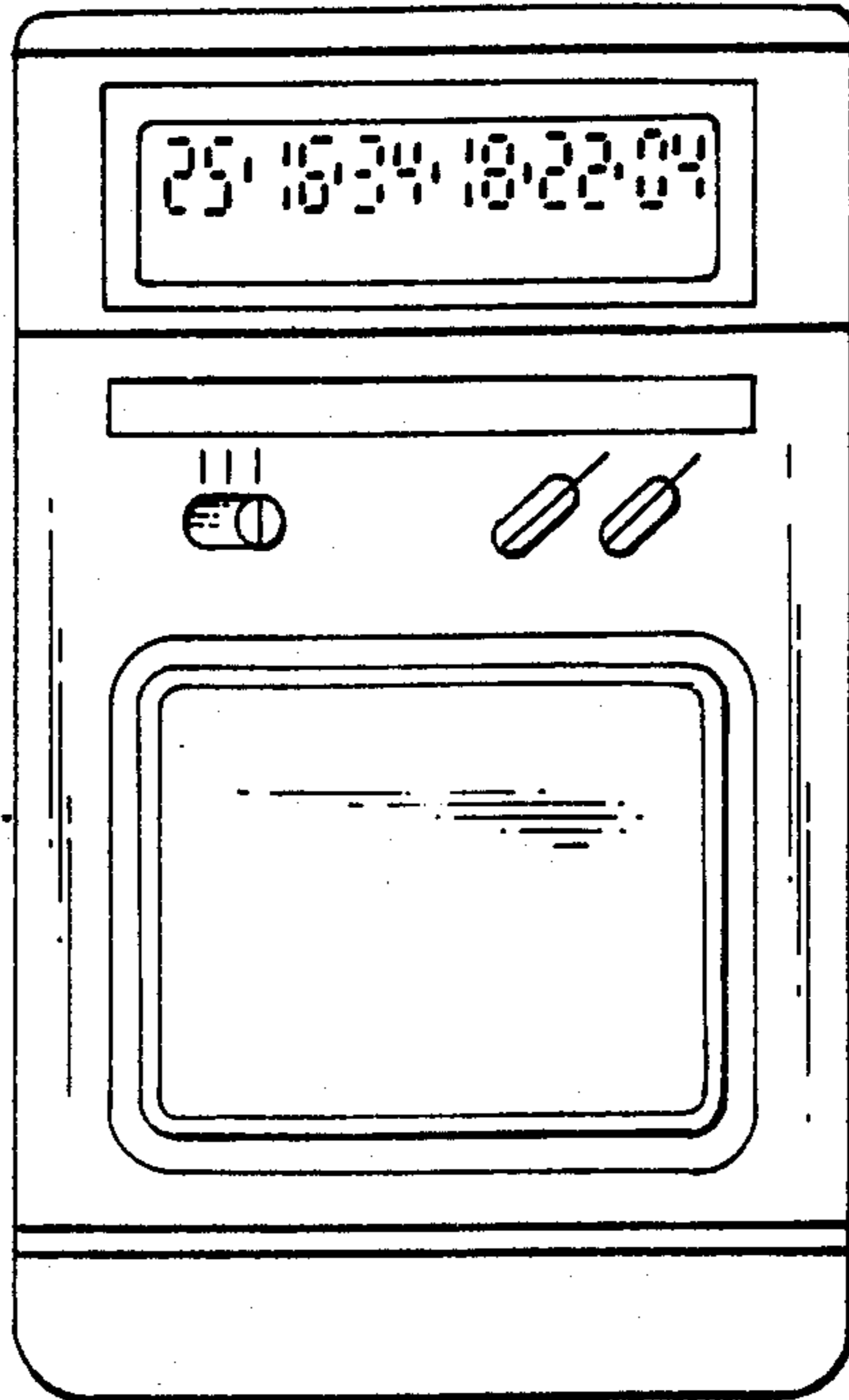

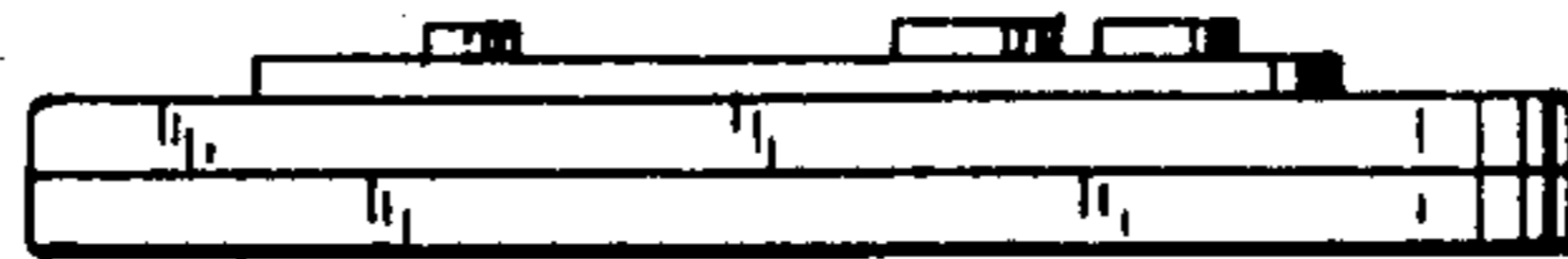

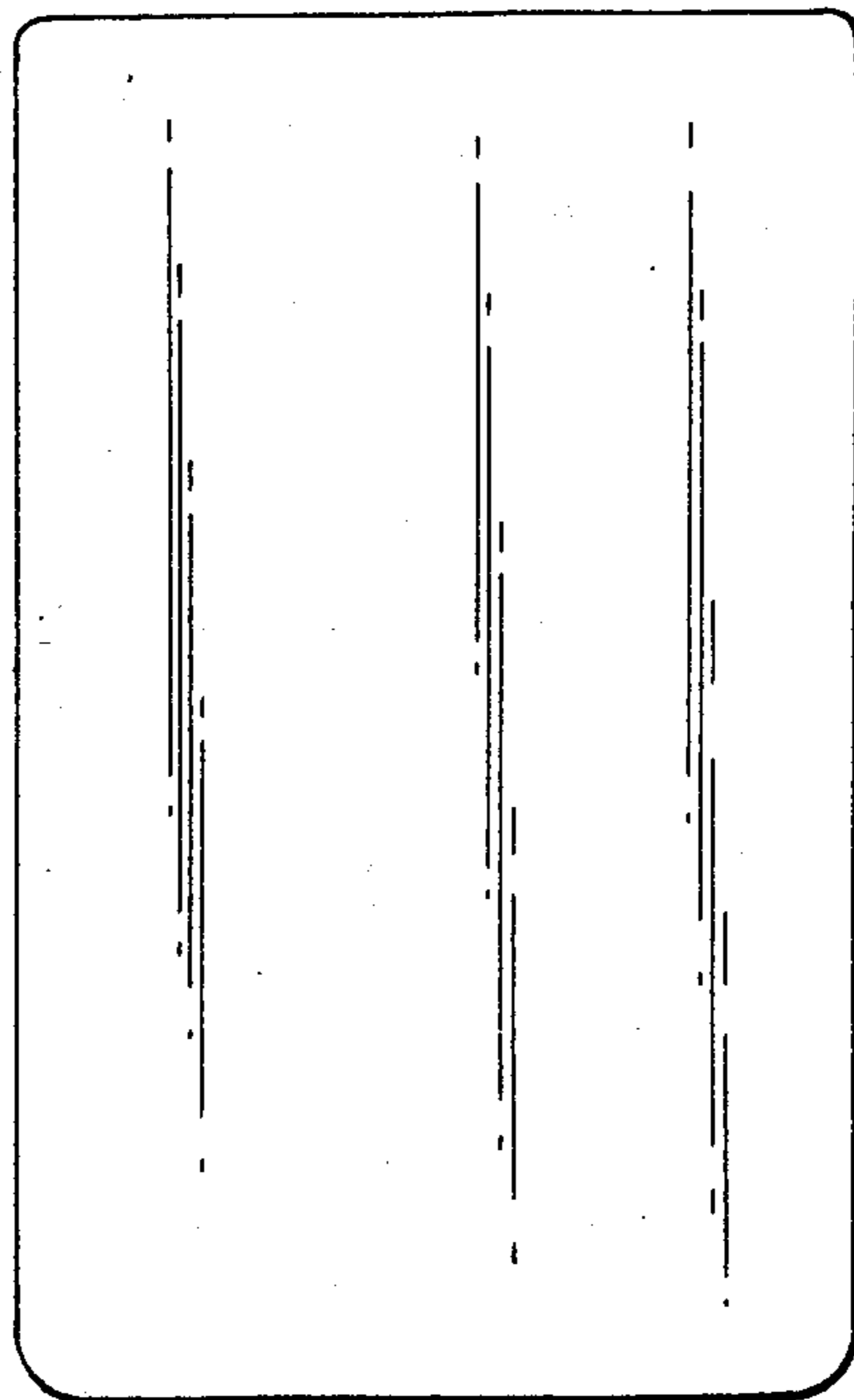
