DESCRIPTION

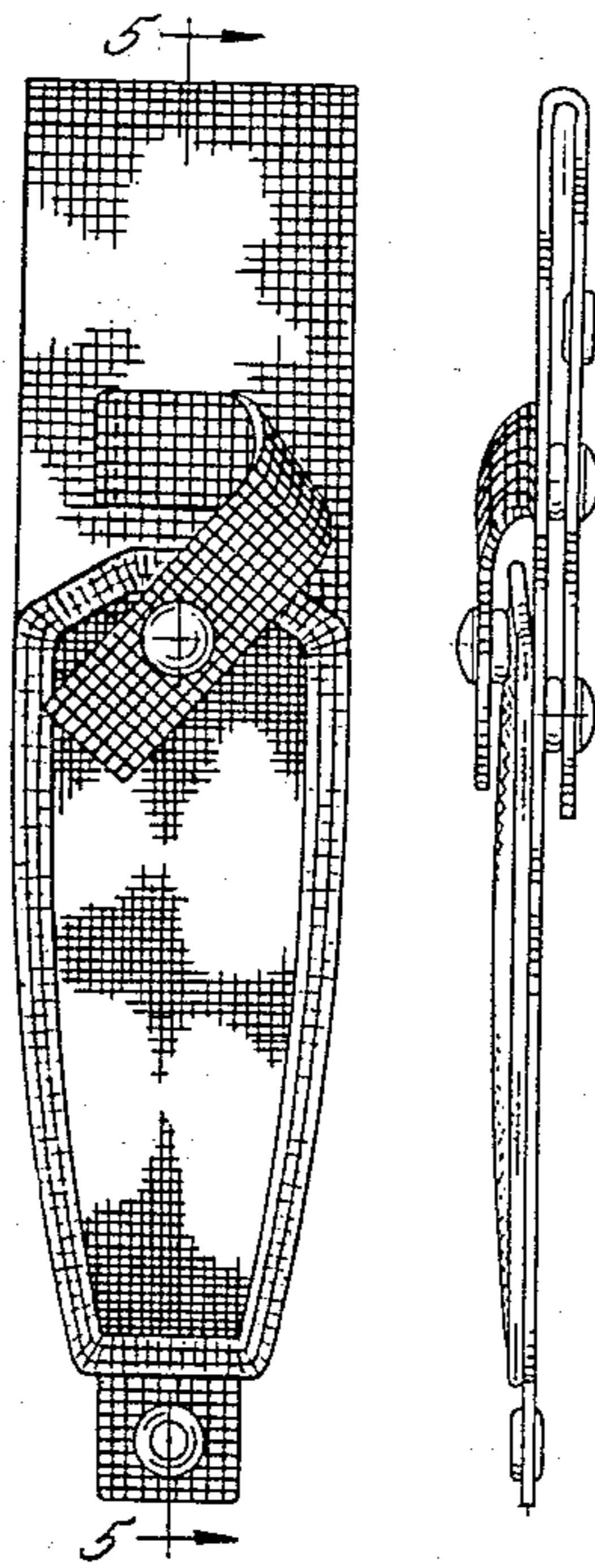
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a sheath showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.



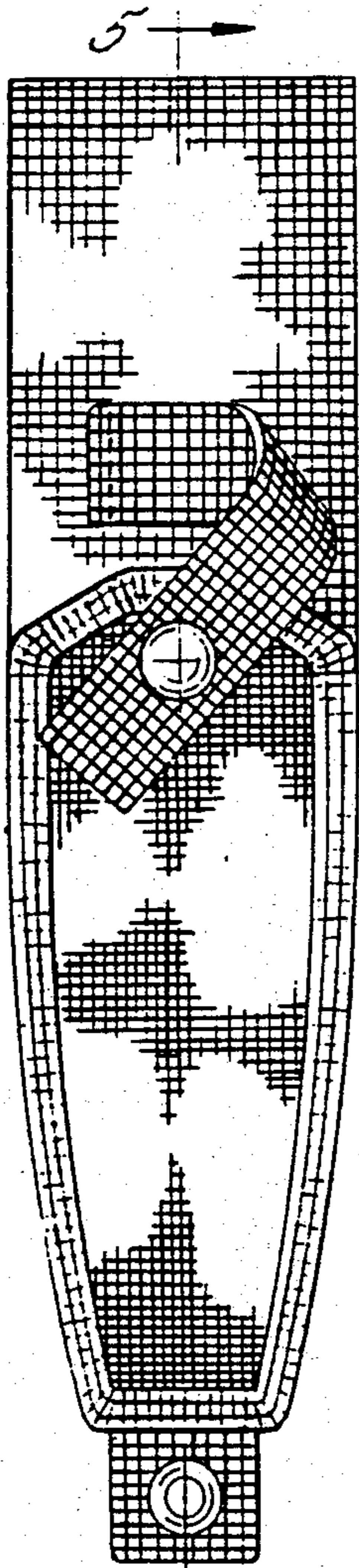

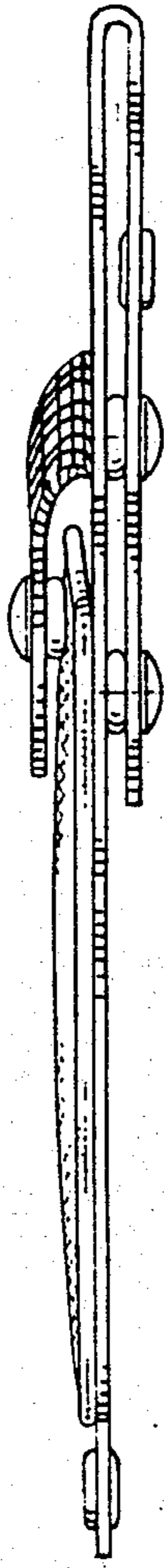

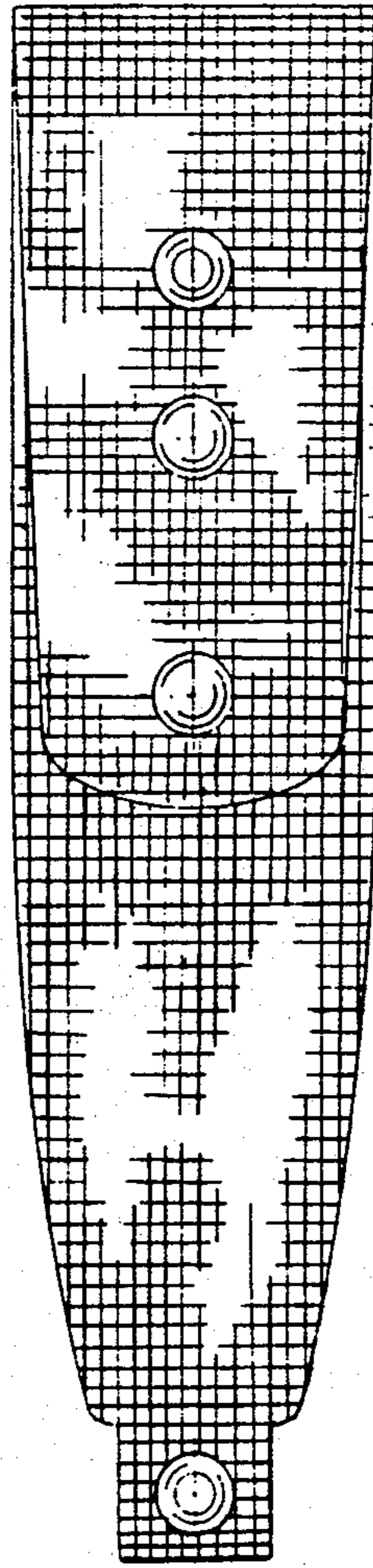

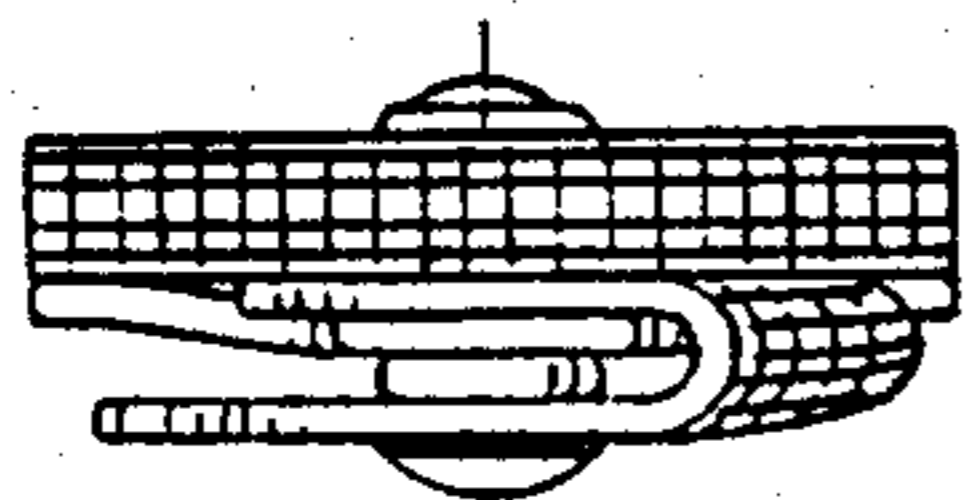

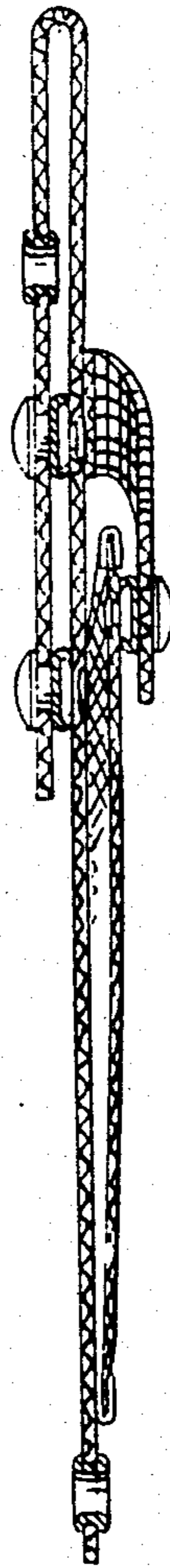
