[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jewelry rack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the jewelry rack showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary front elevational view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being the elimination of one of the lower support boxes;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of one of the lower support boxes.

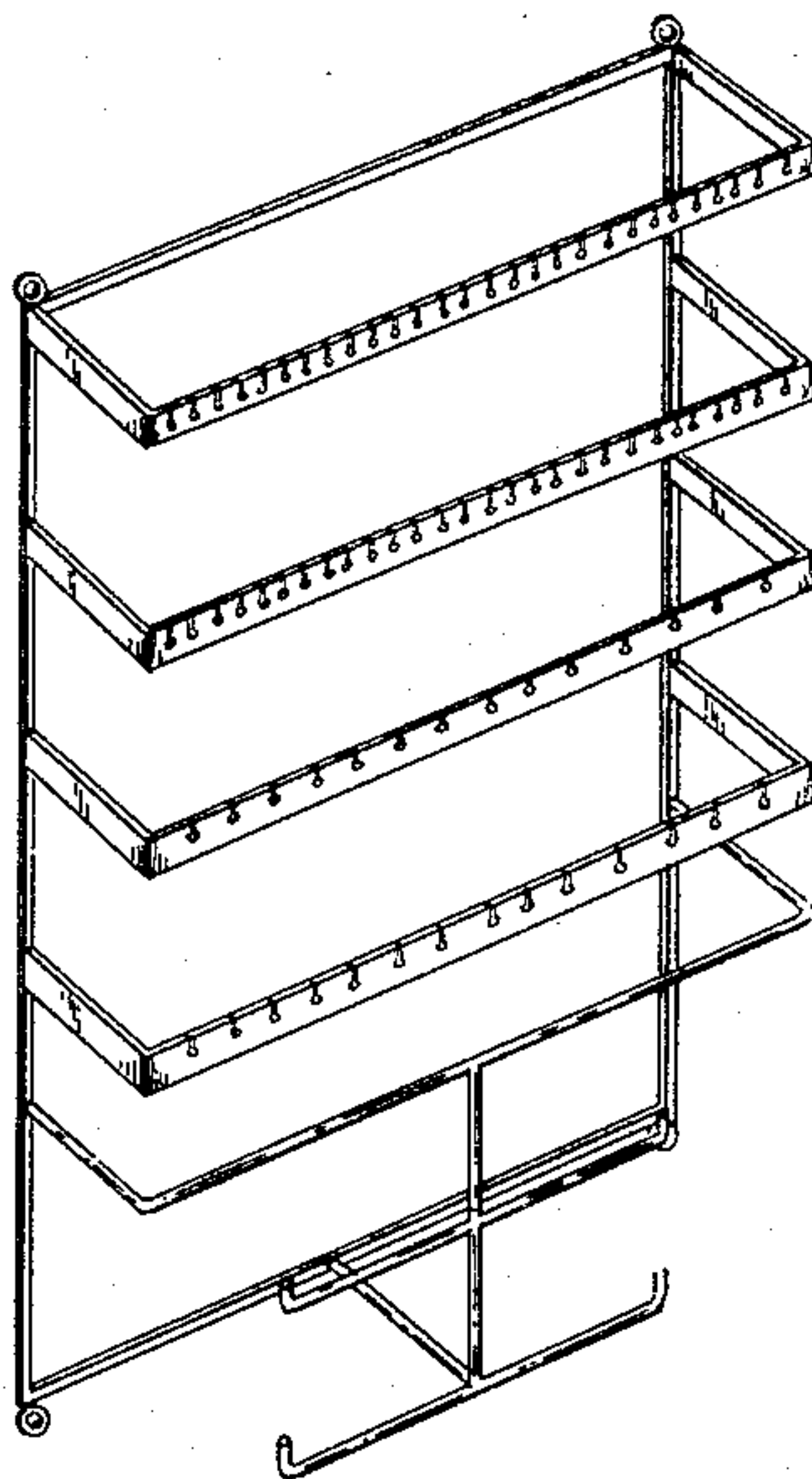

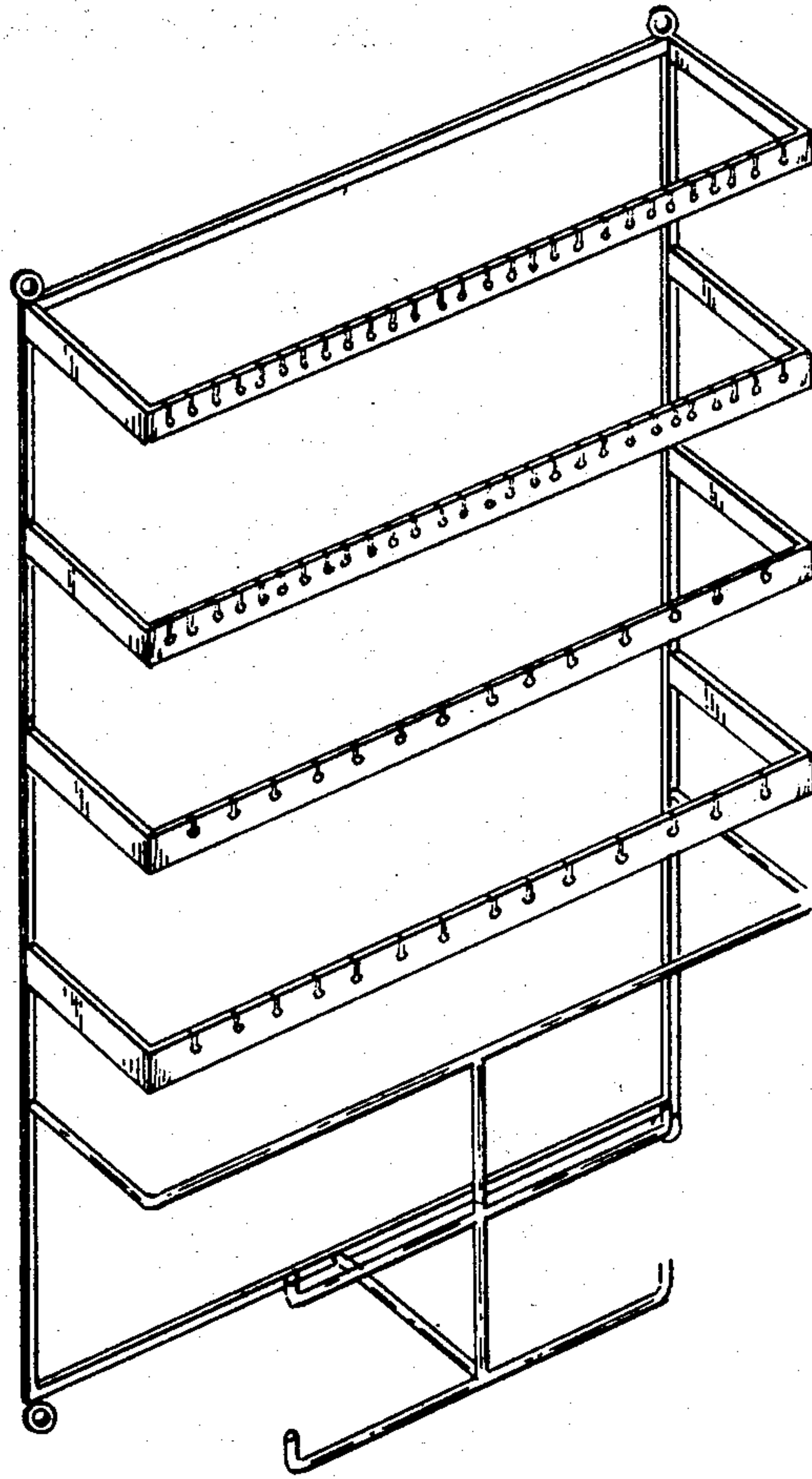

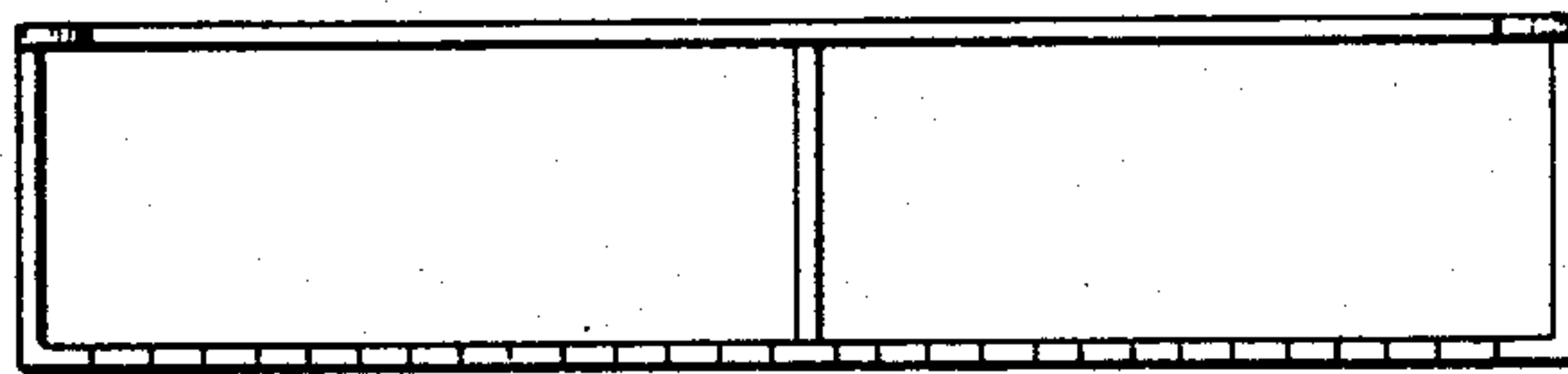
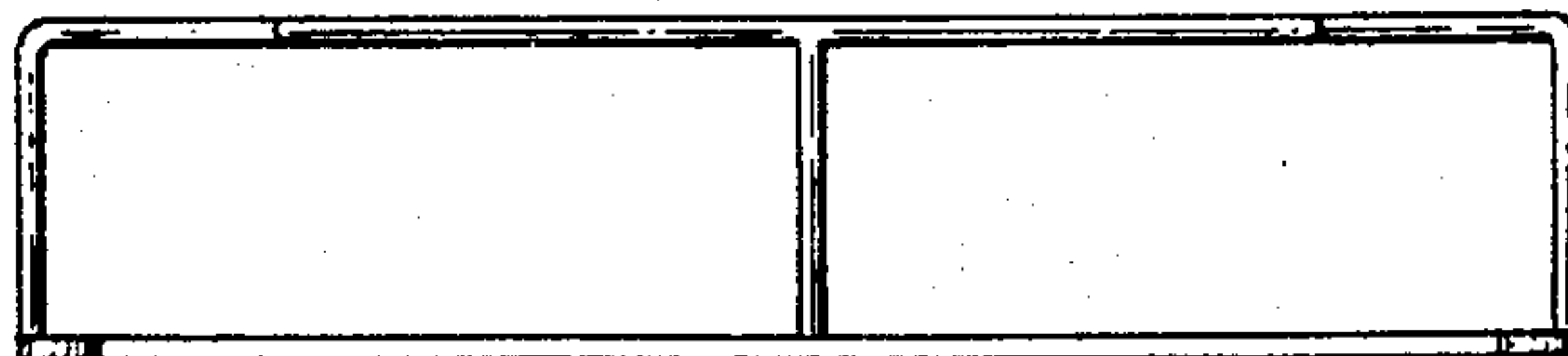

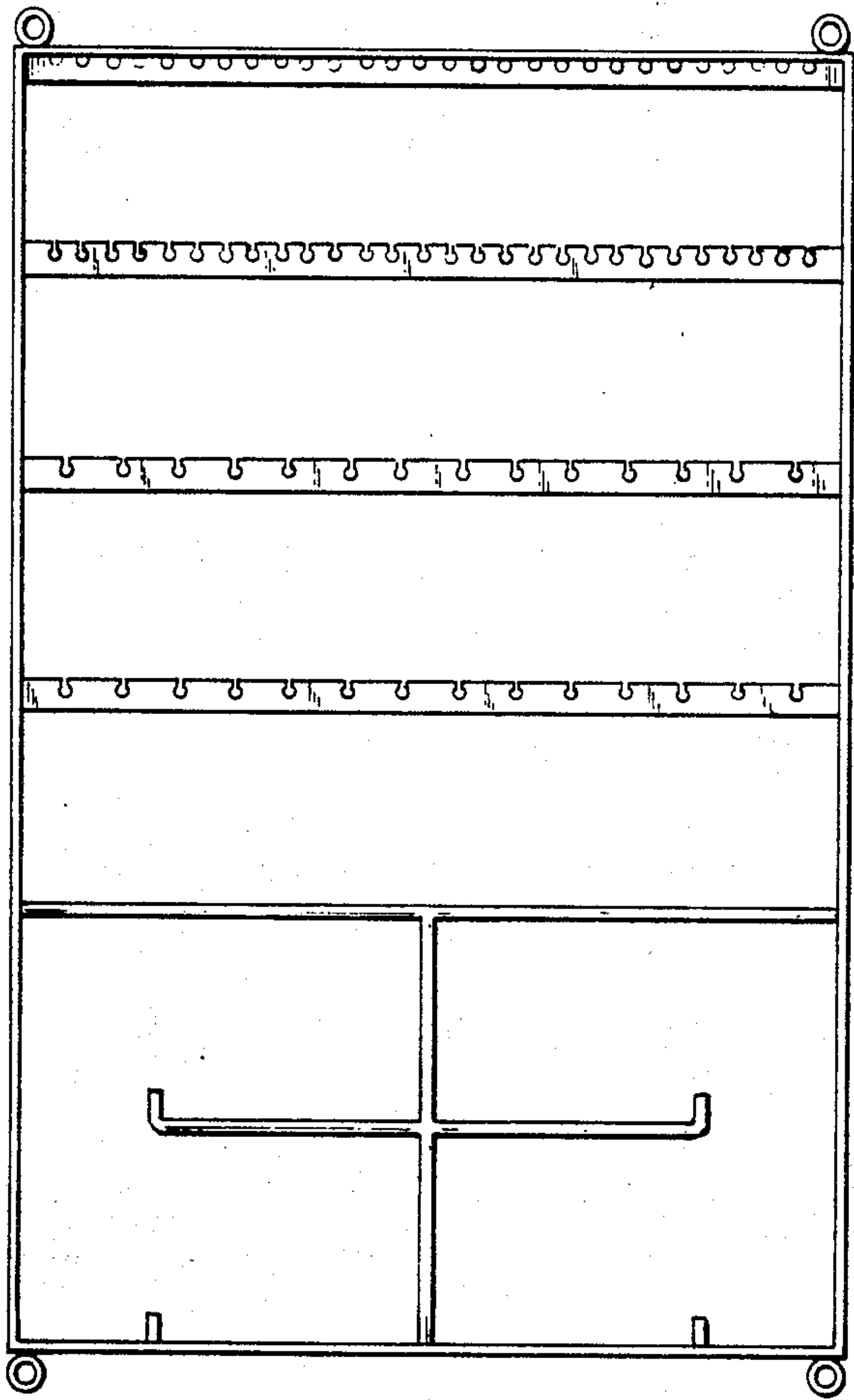

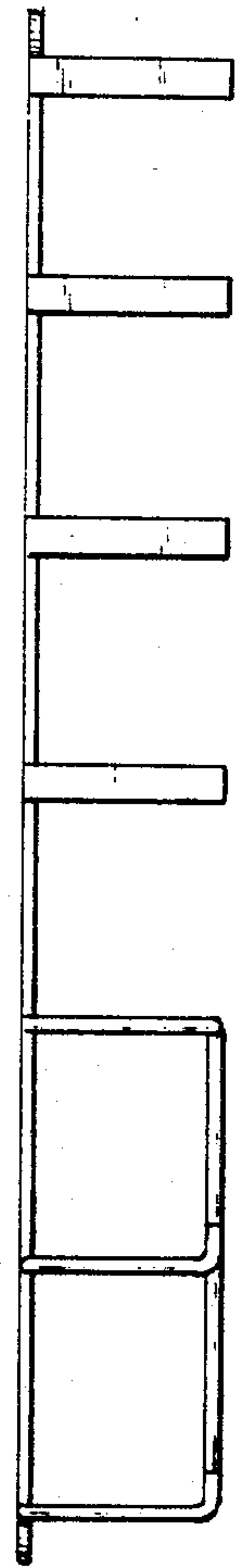

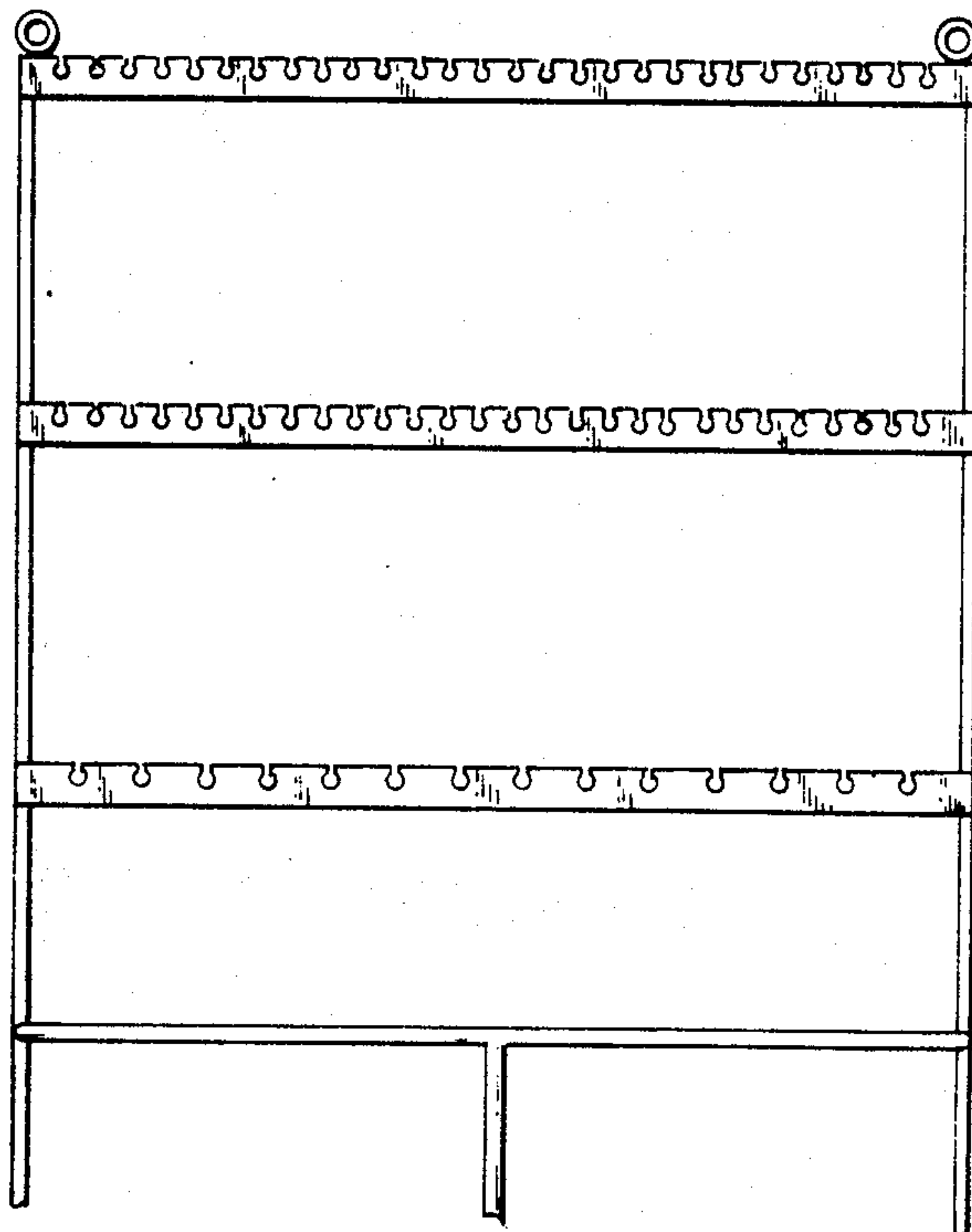
