The ornamental design for a combined memo pad and pen holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined memo pad and pen holder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right end view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof;

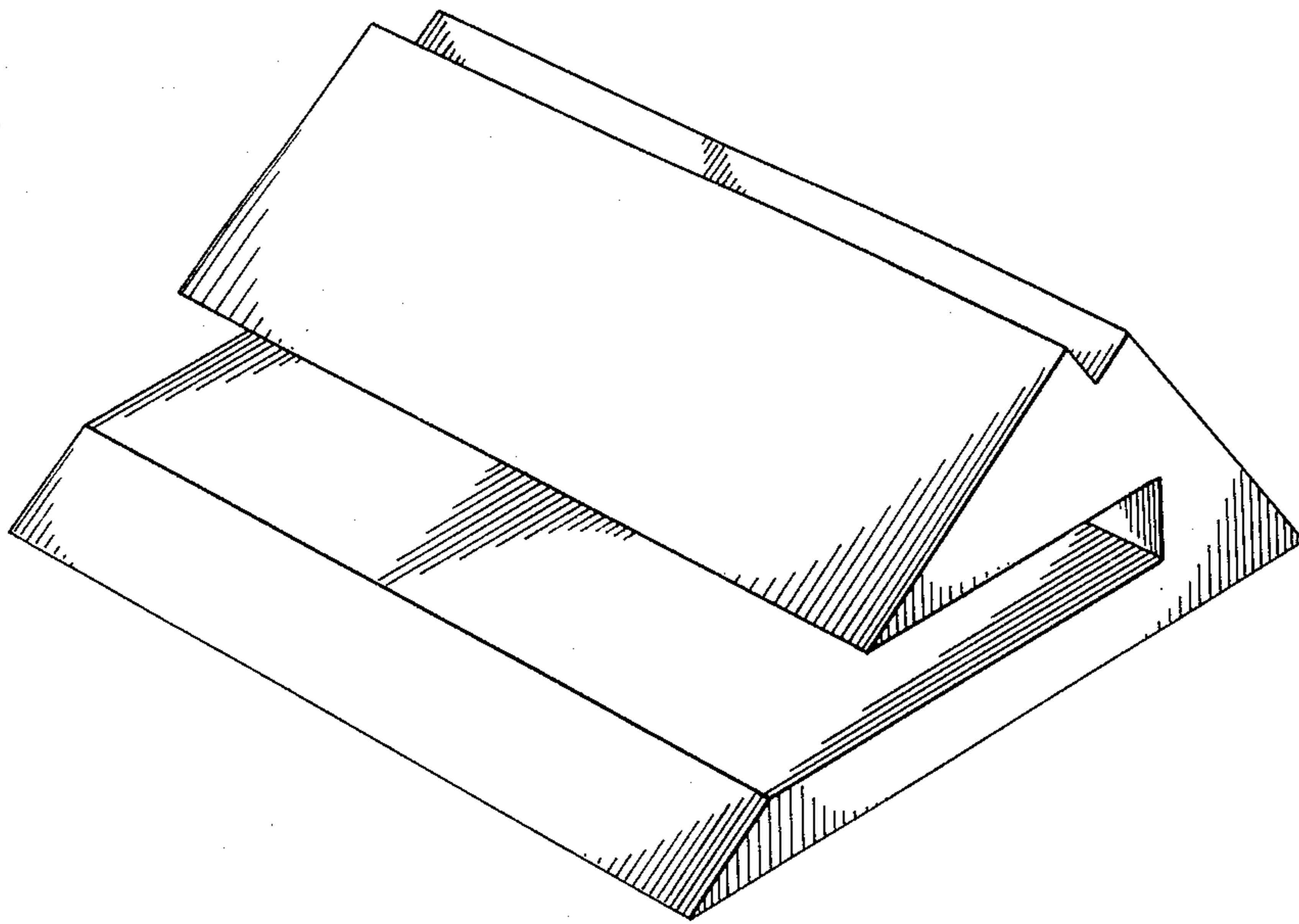
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

The design is shown in full lines. The broken line showing is for informational purposes only.



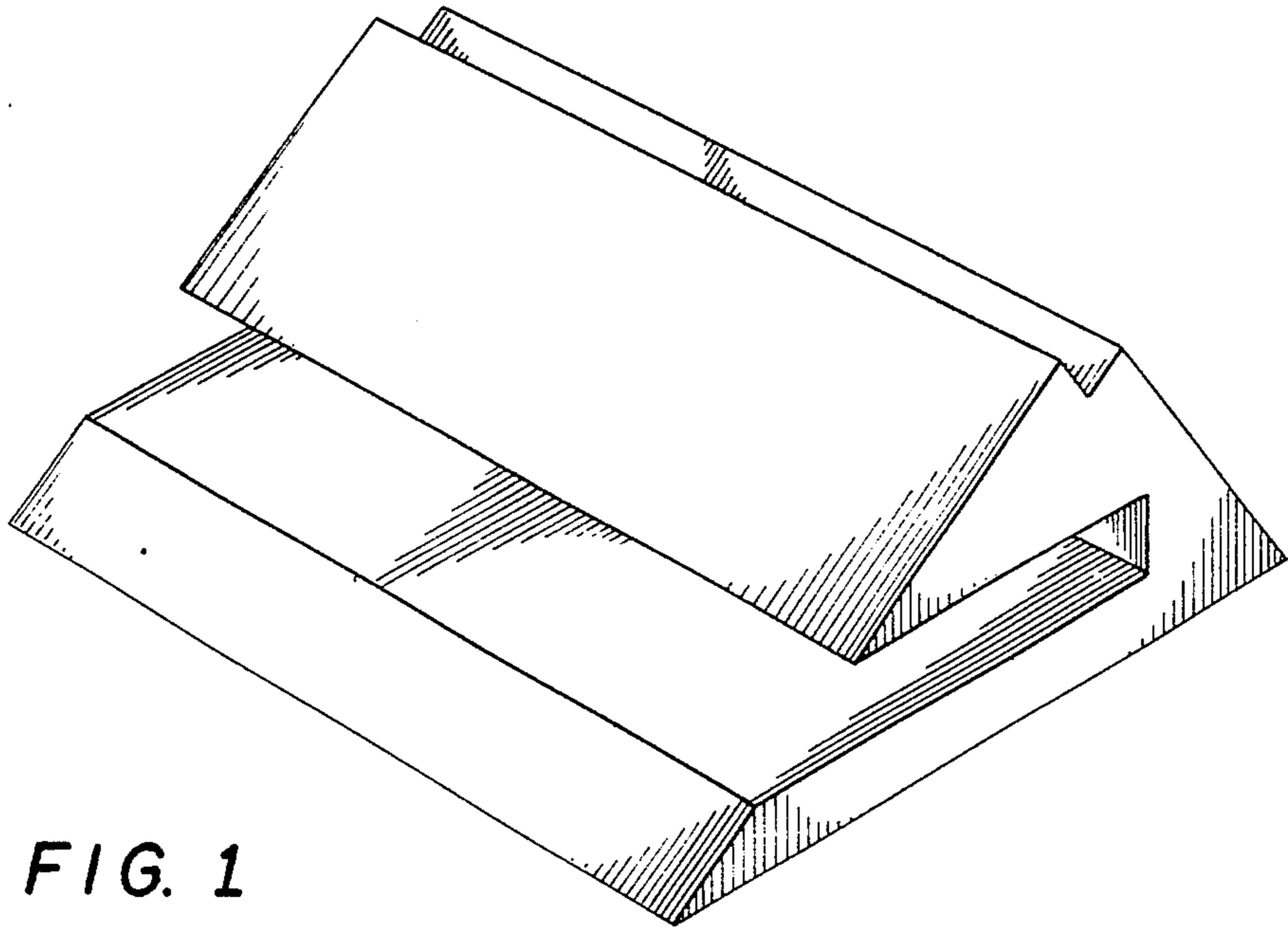

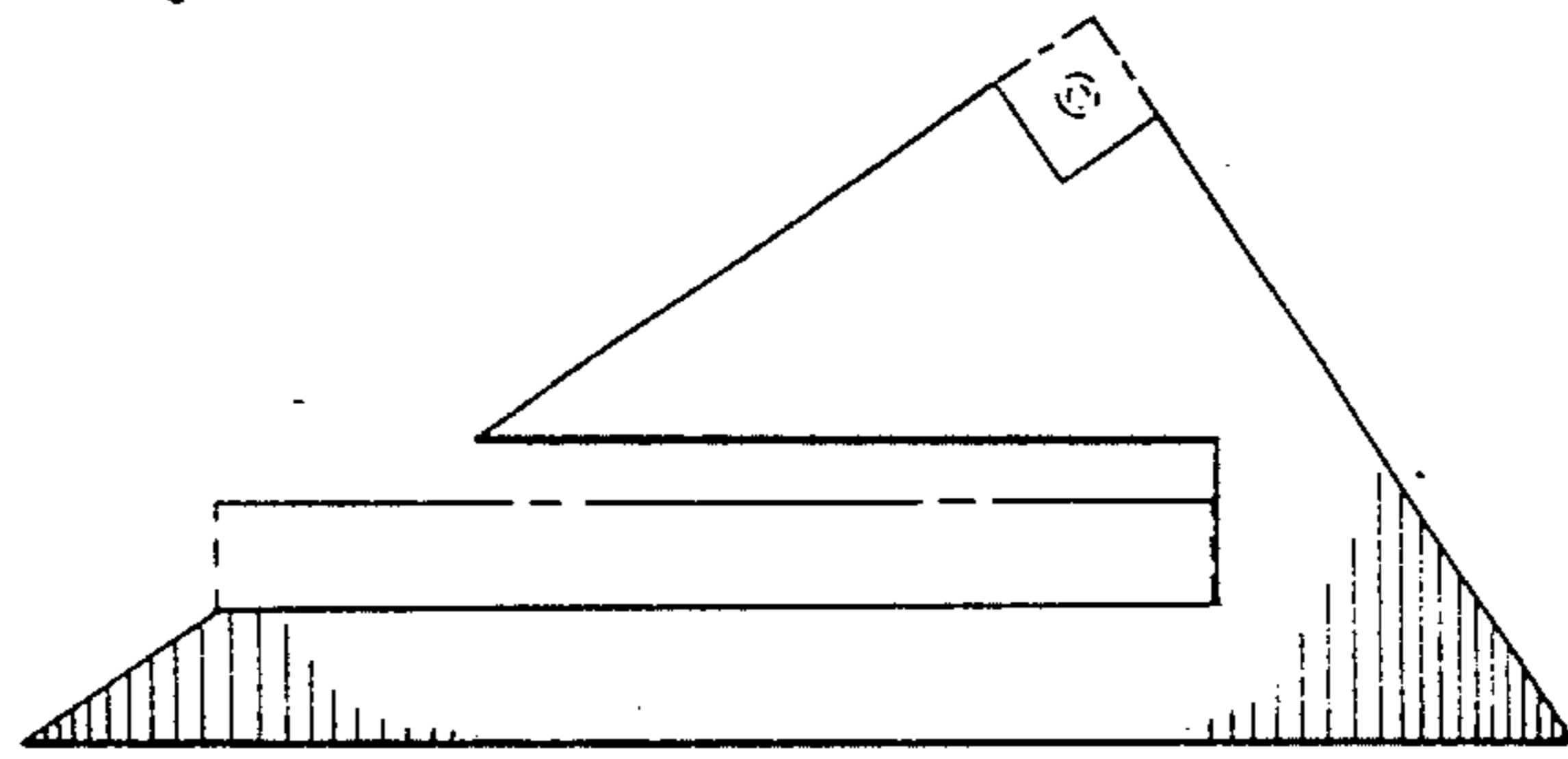

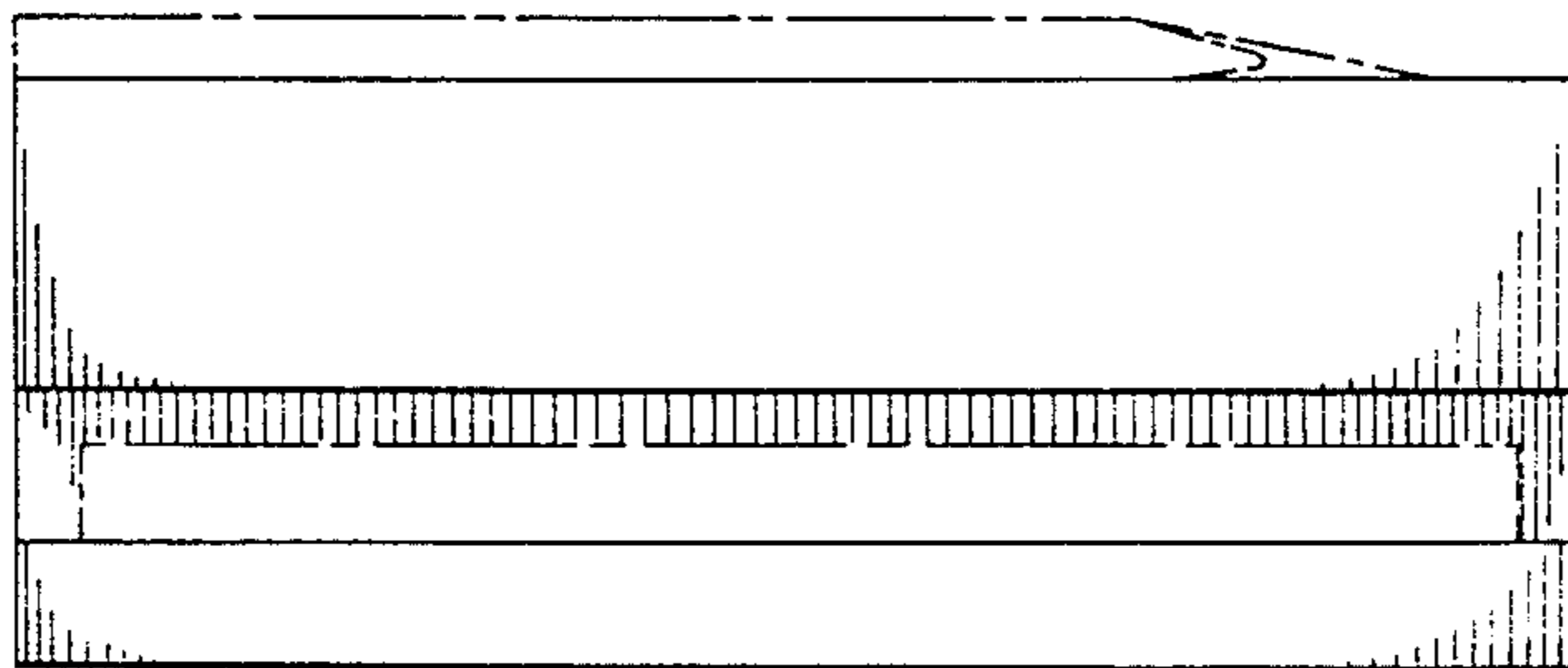

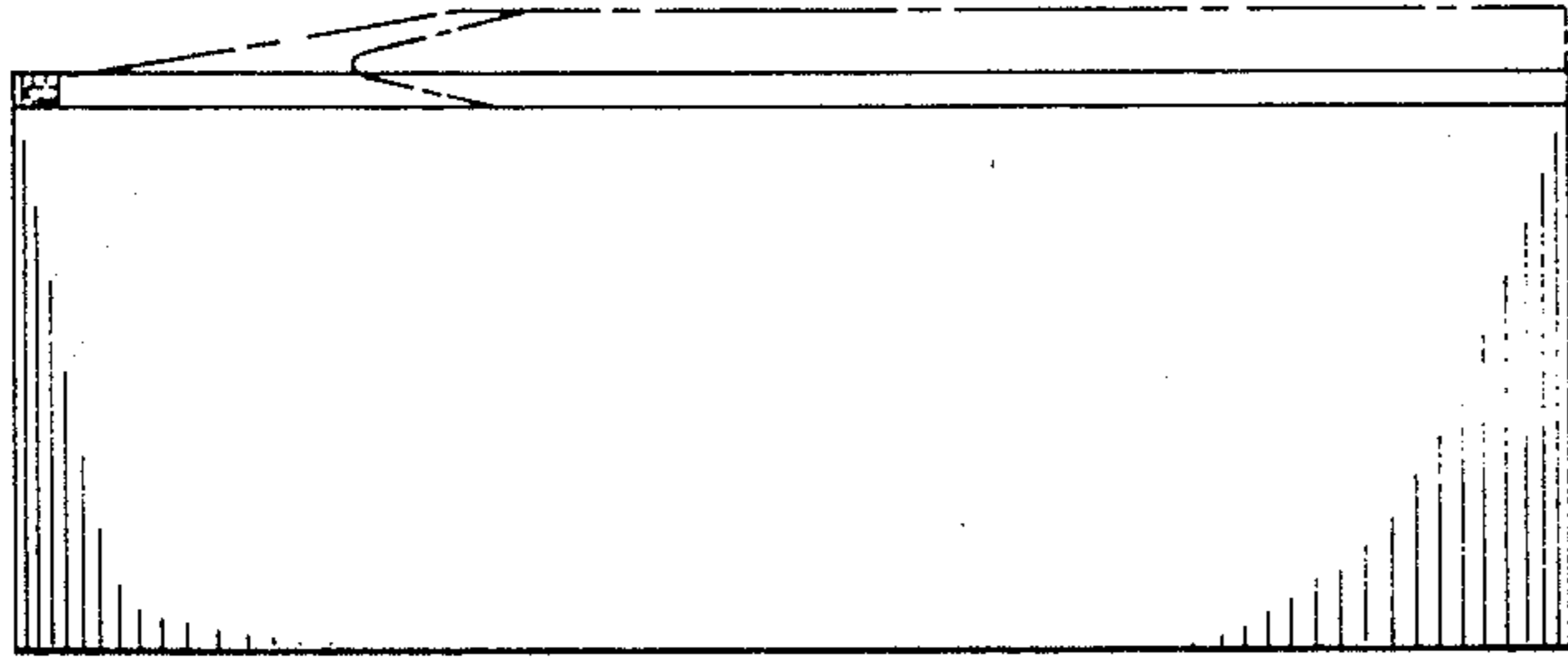

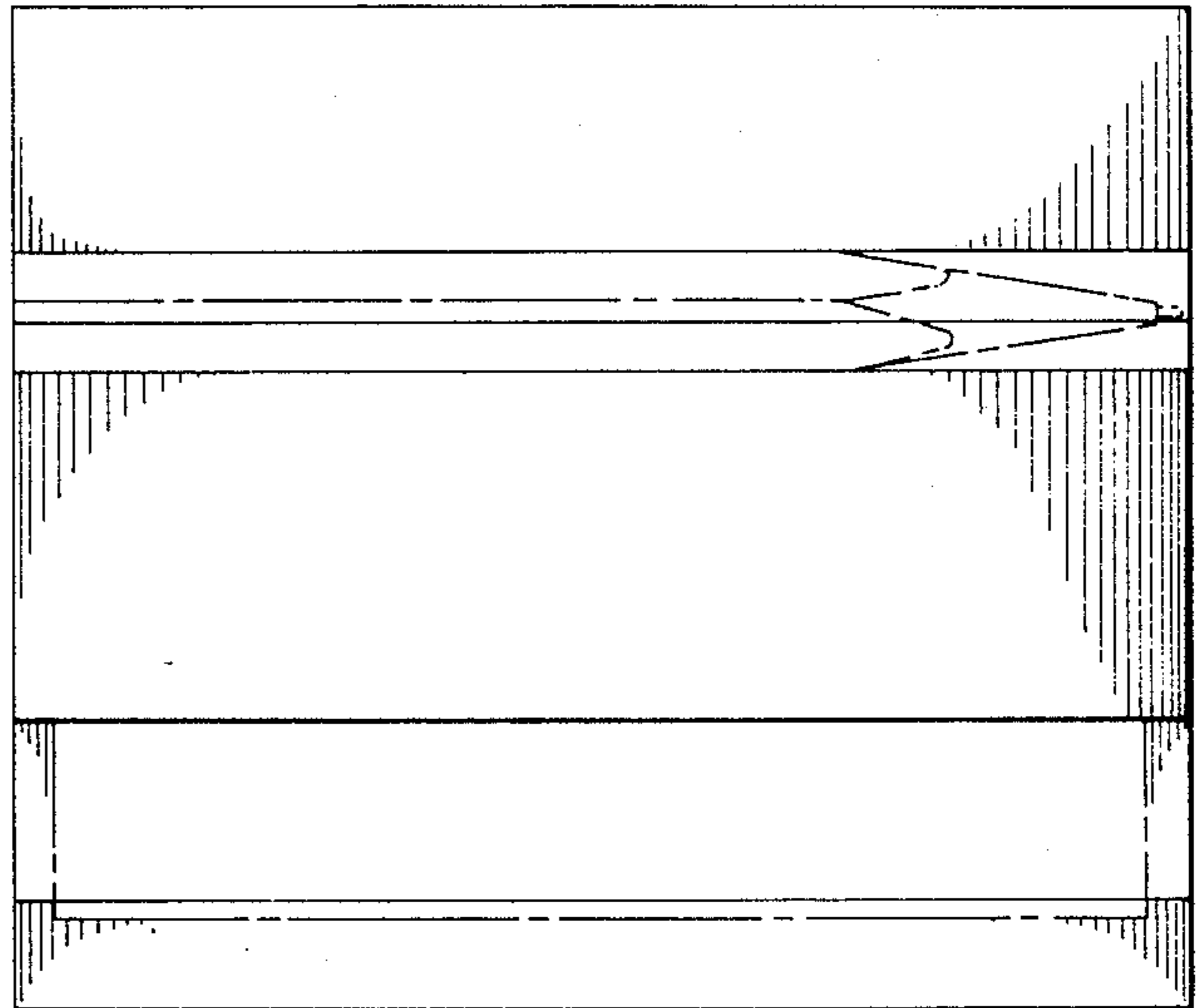

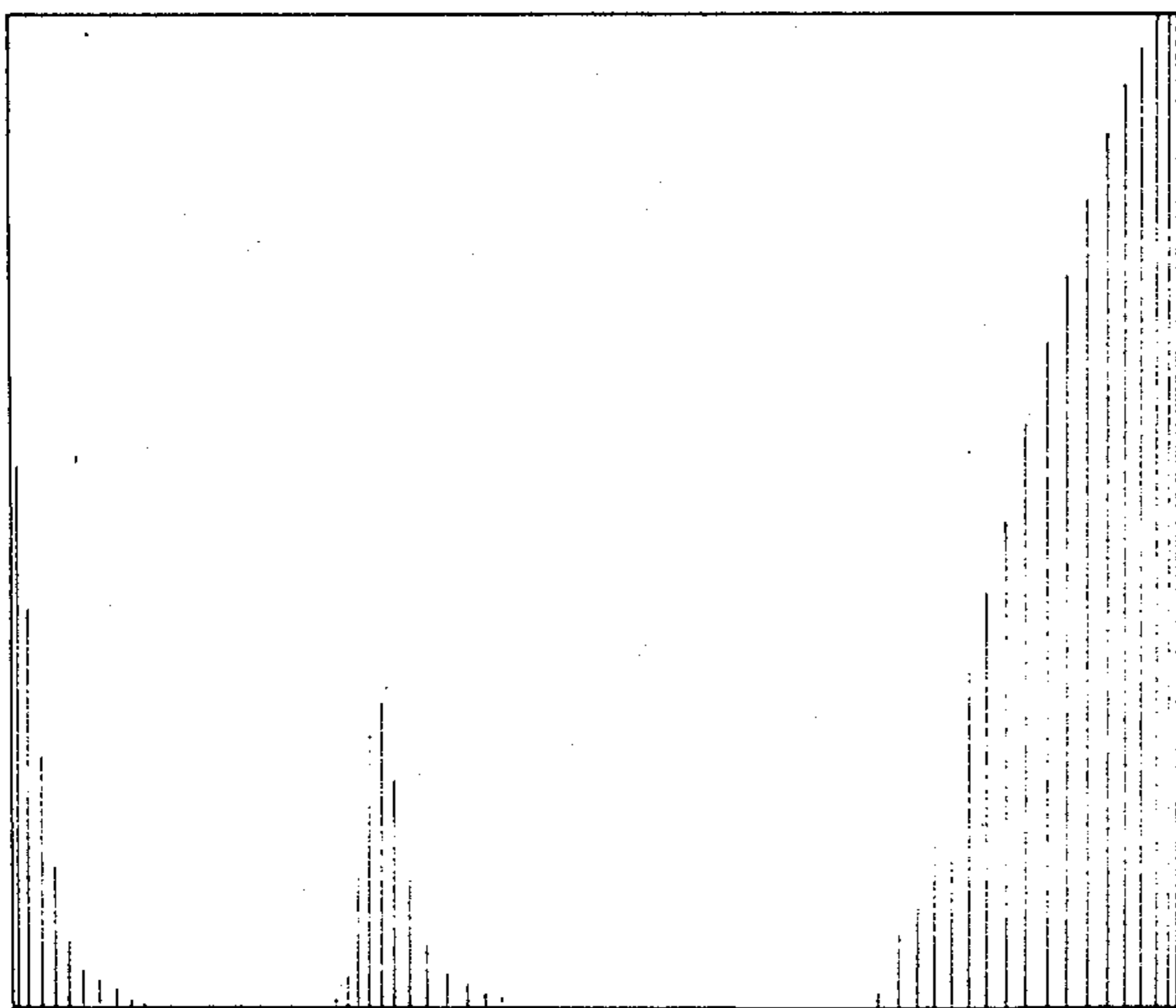
