[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a frame for an adjustable chaise, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a frame for an adjustable chaise, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and
