DESCRIPTION

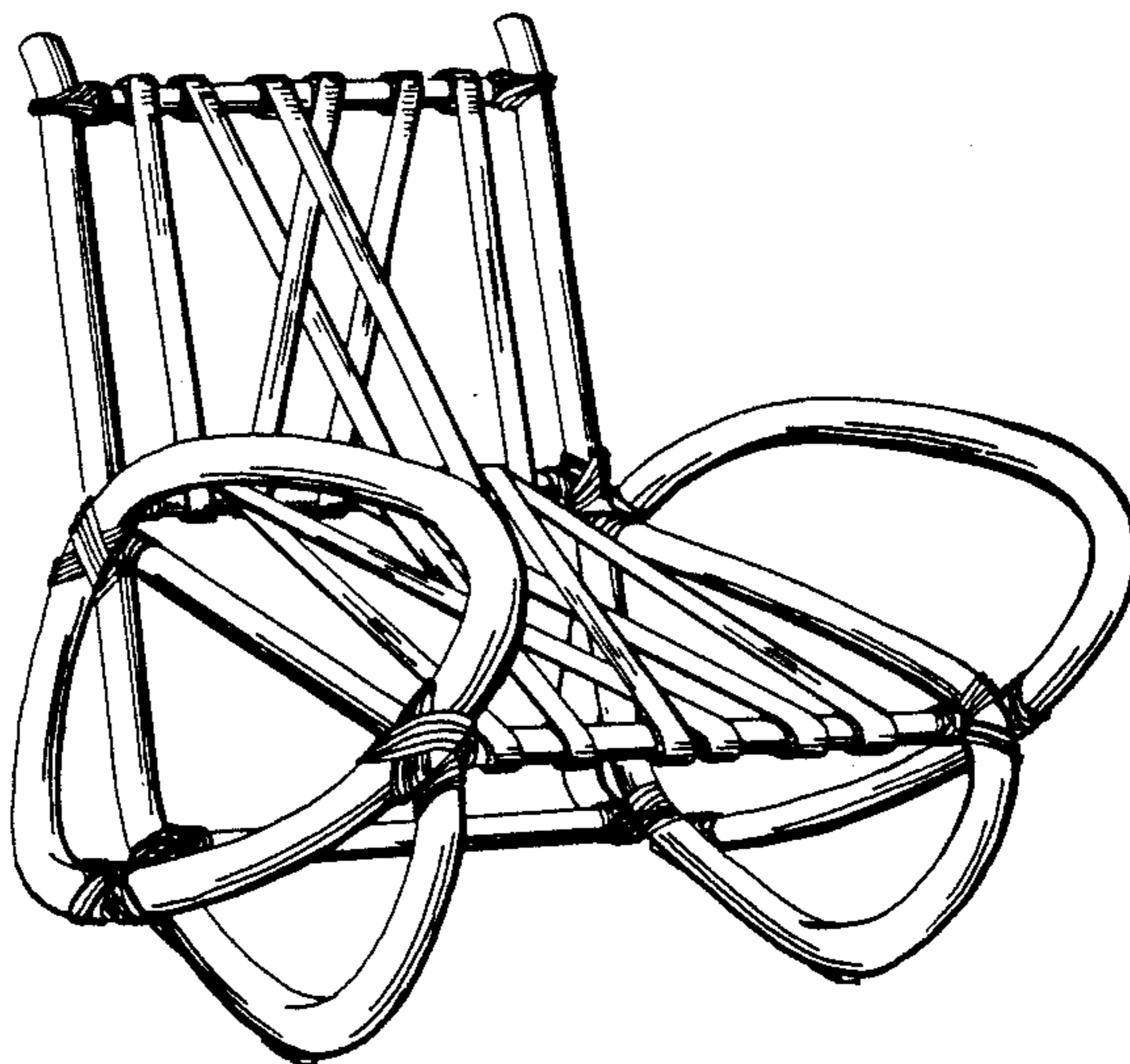
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing our design;

The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2.



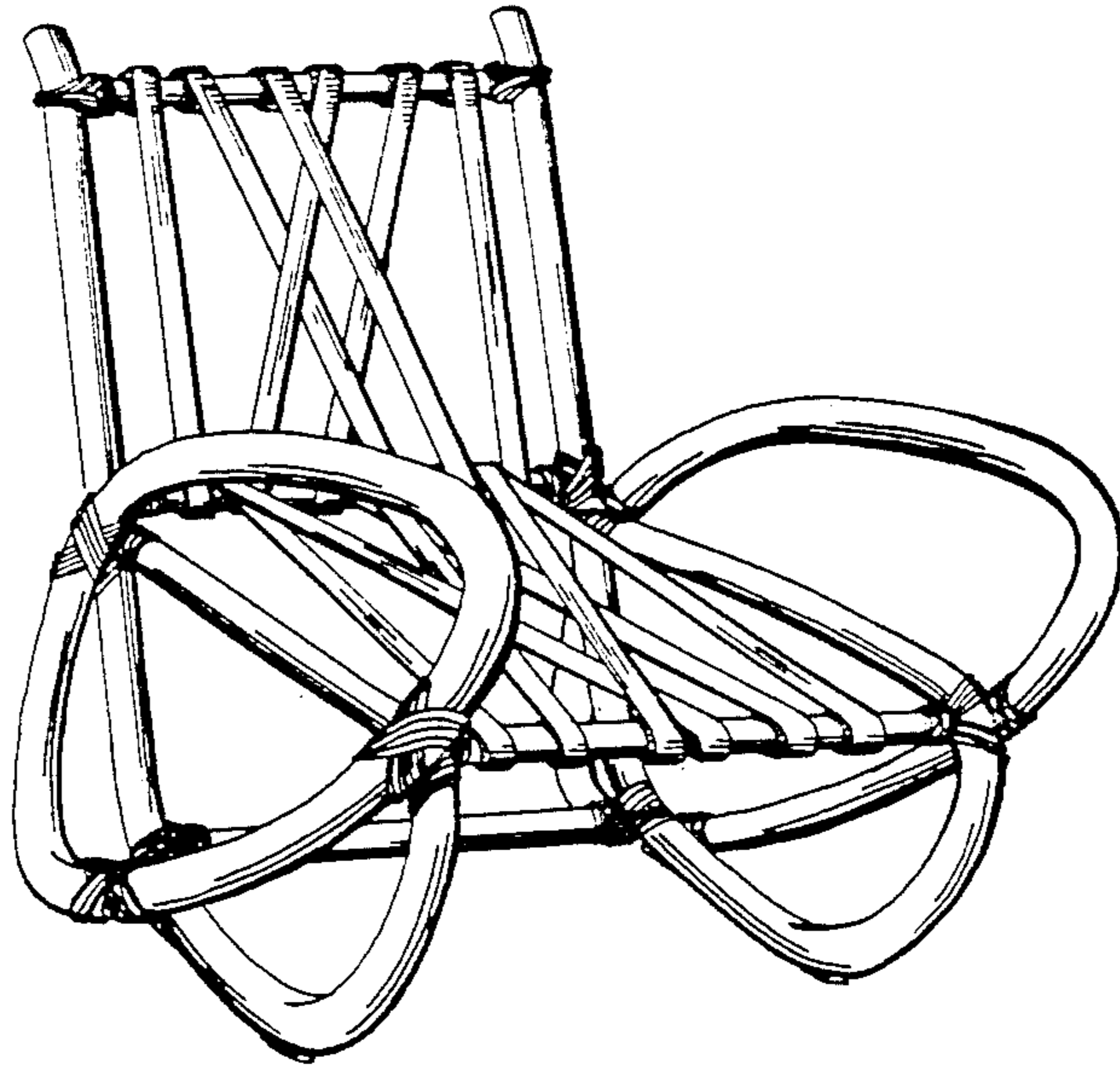

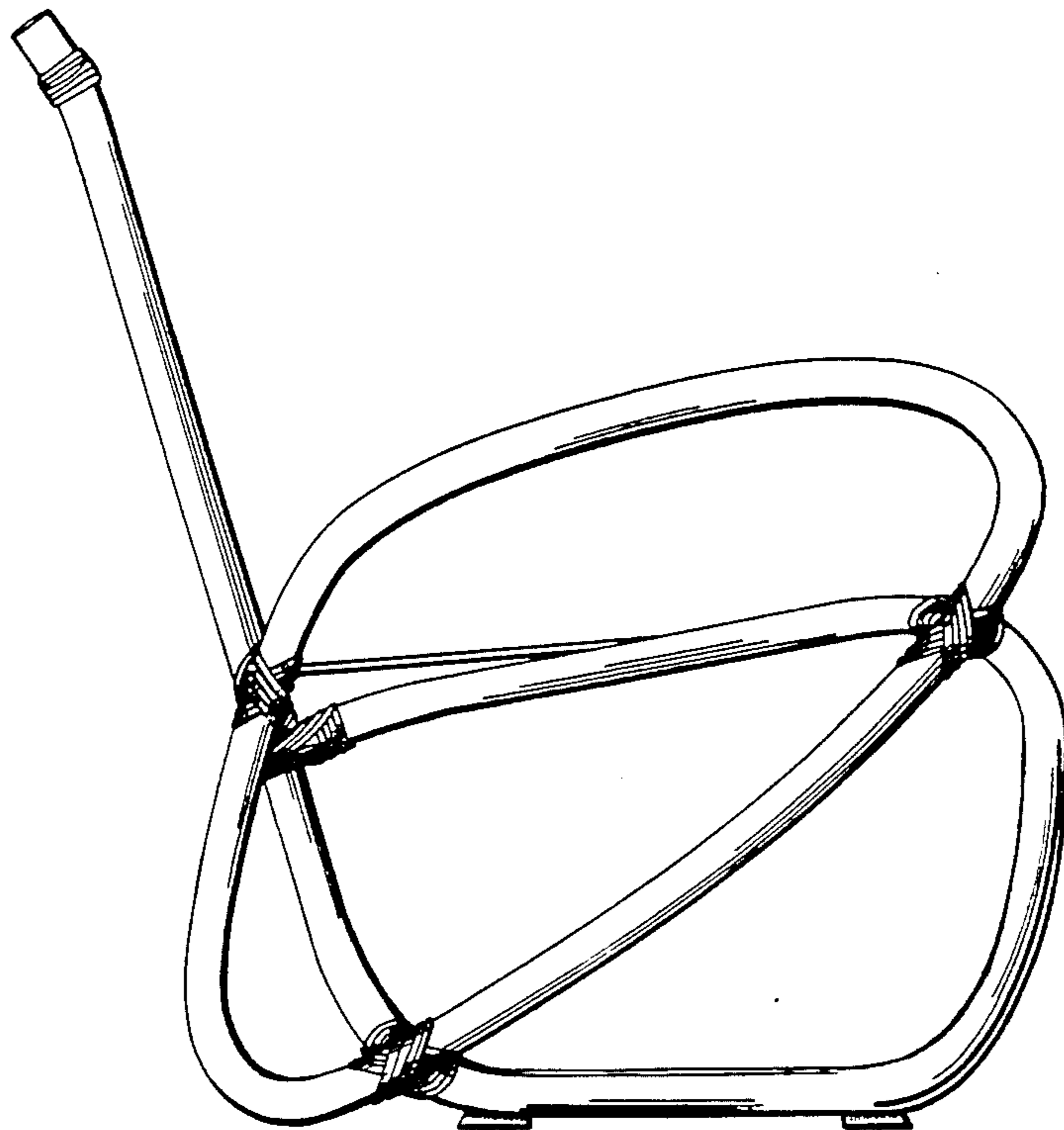

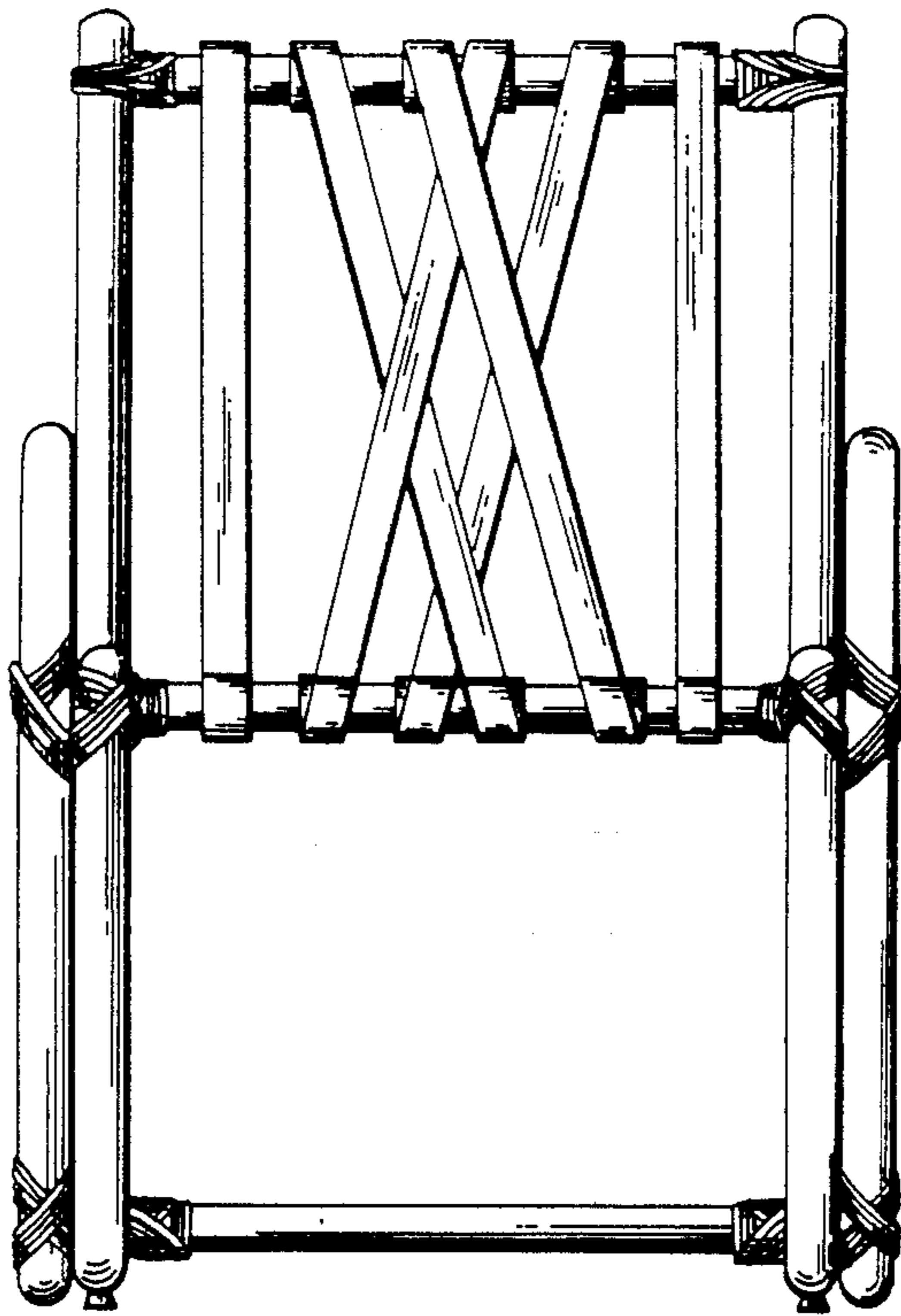

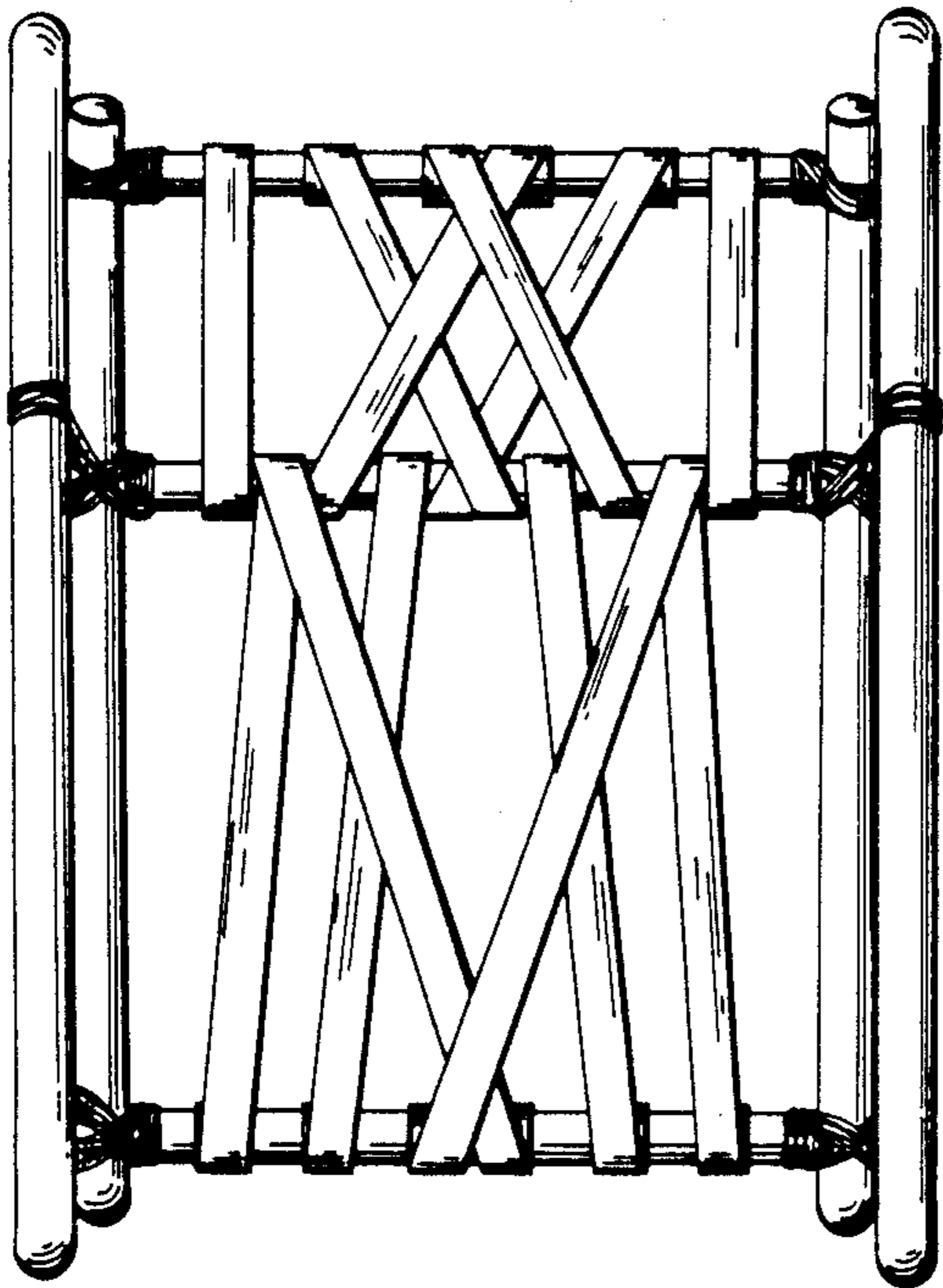
