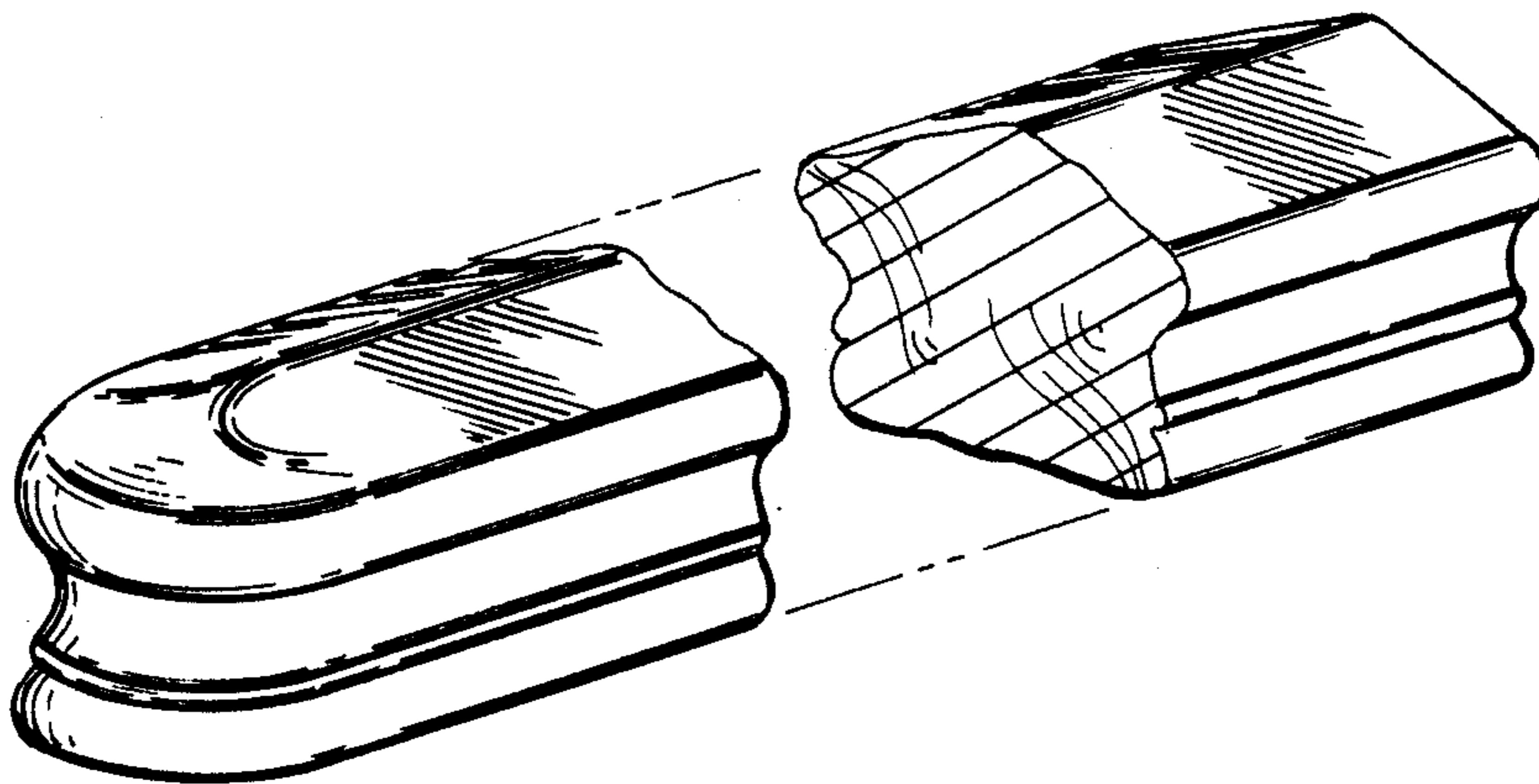

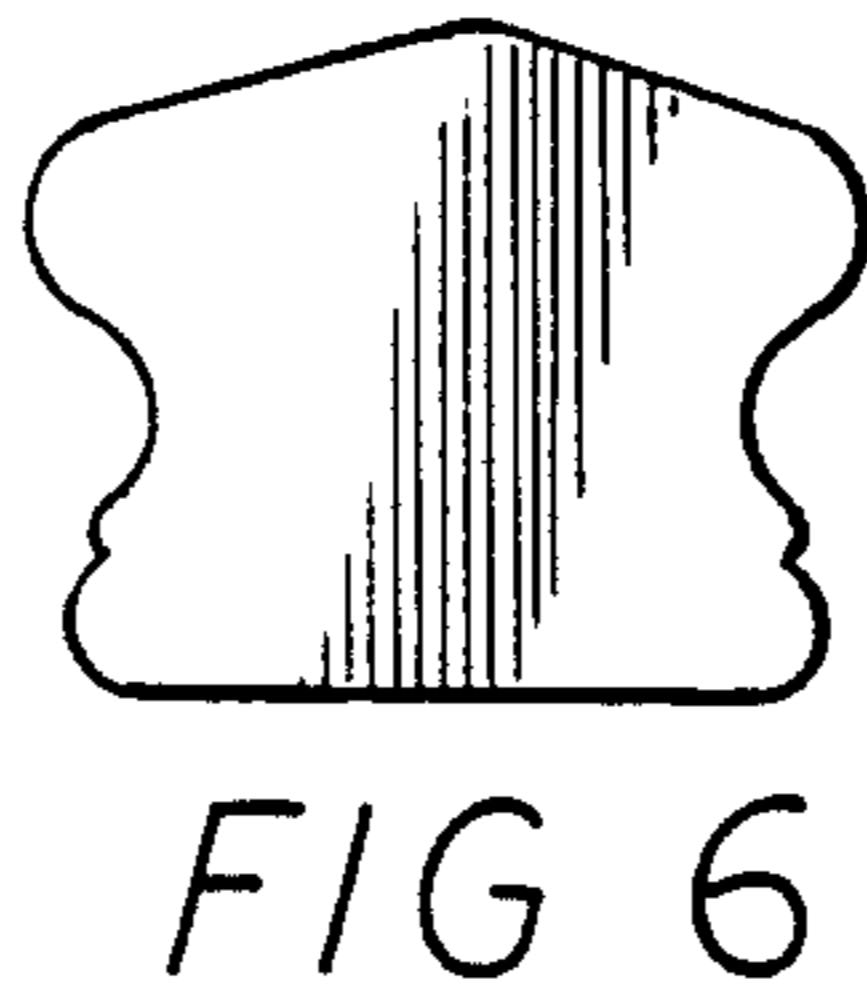
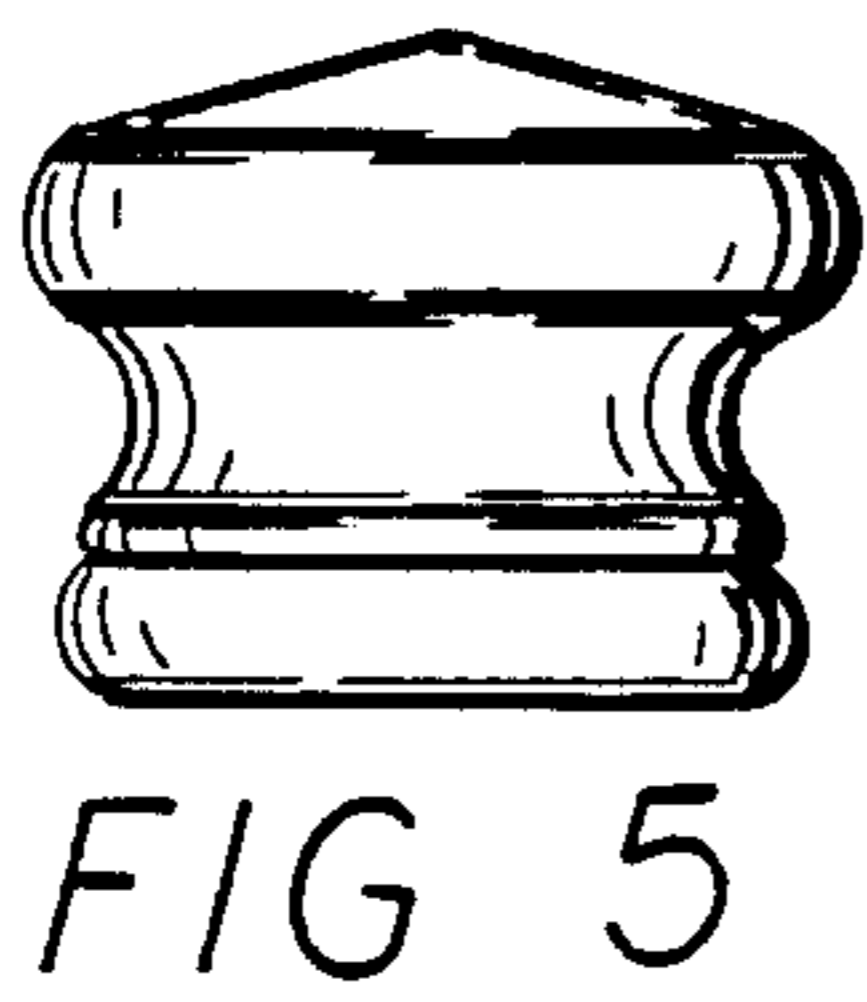
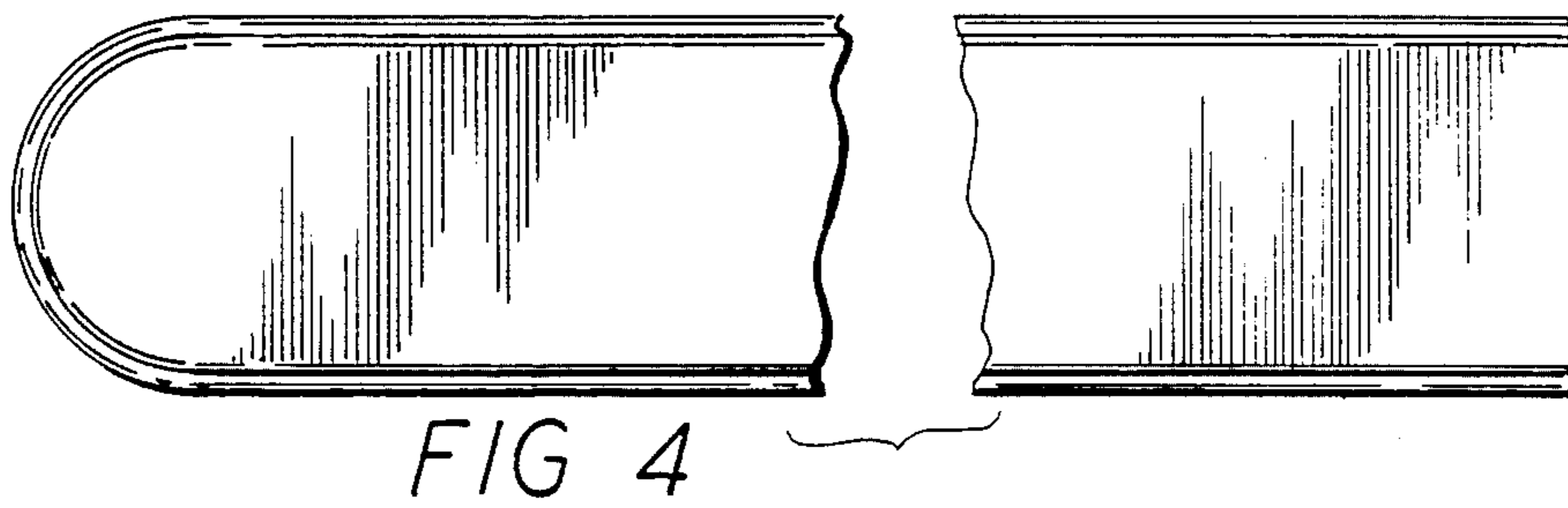
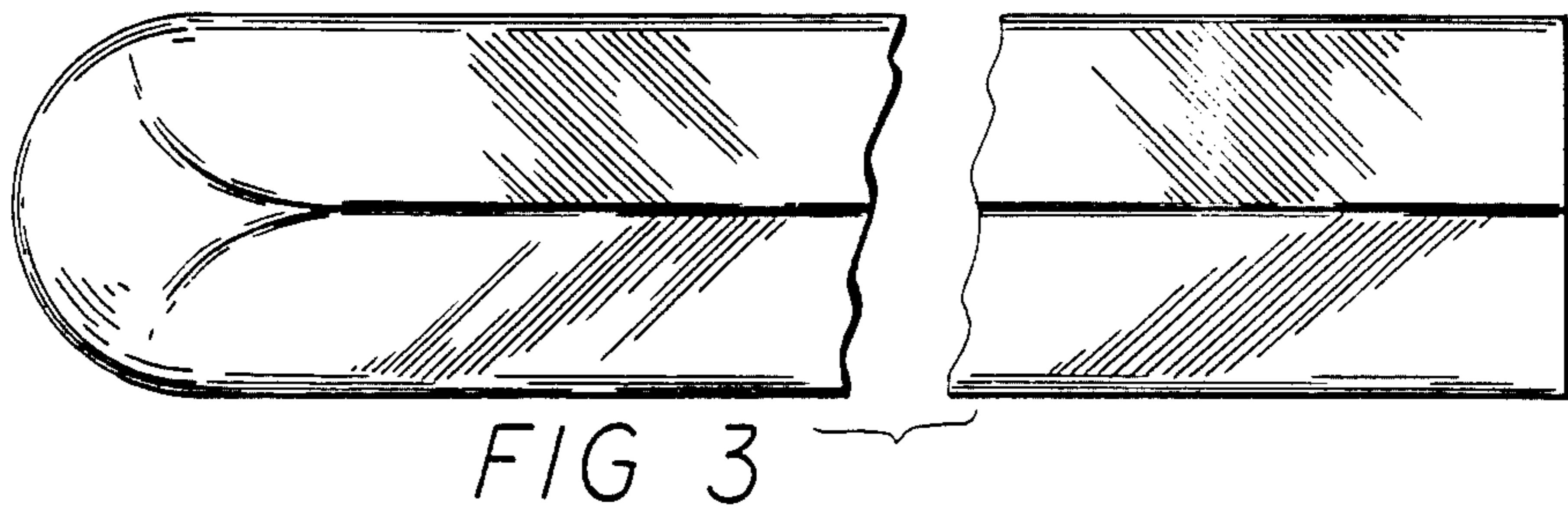
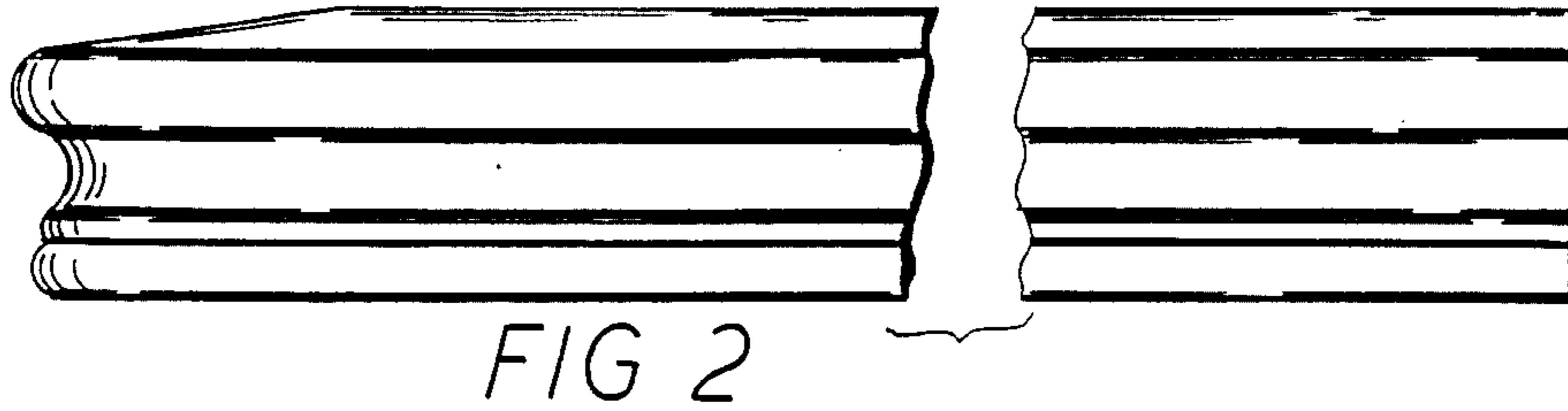
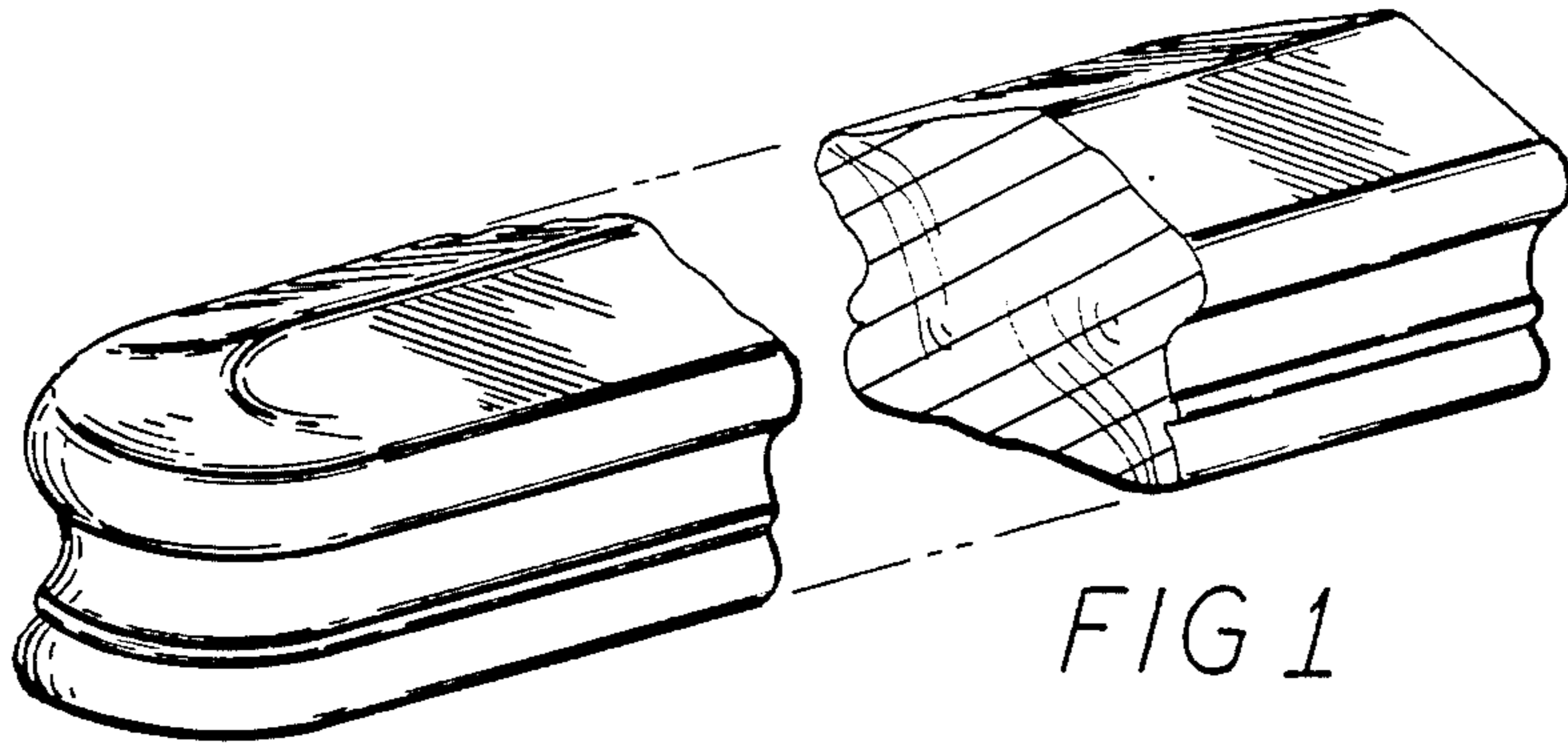
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hand rail, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a hand rail showing my new design, shown broken to denote a hand rail of indeterminate length; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a hand rail showing my new design, shown broken to denote a hand rail of indeterminate length; FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of this second embodiment; FIG. 9 is a top plan view of this second embodiment; FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of this second embodiment; FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of this second embodiment; FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of this second embodiment.





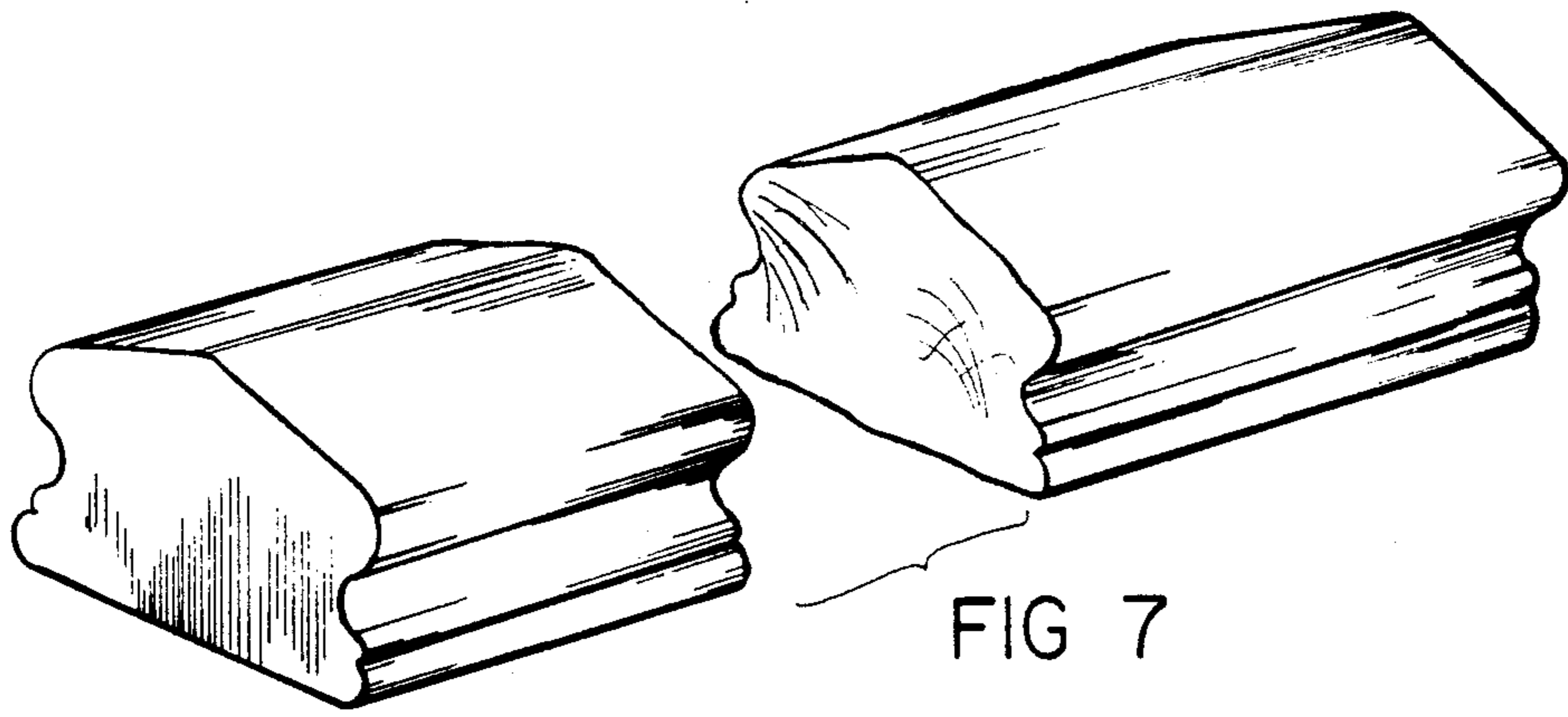

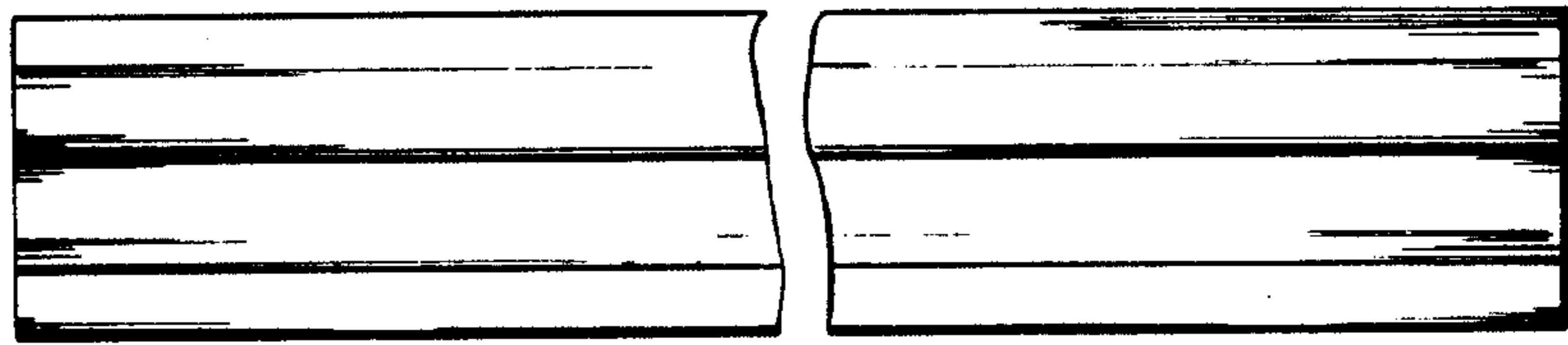

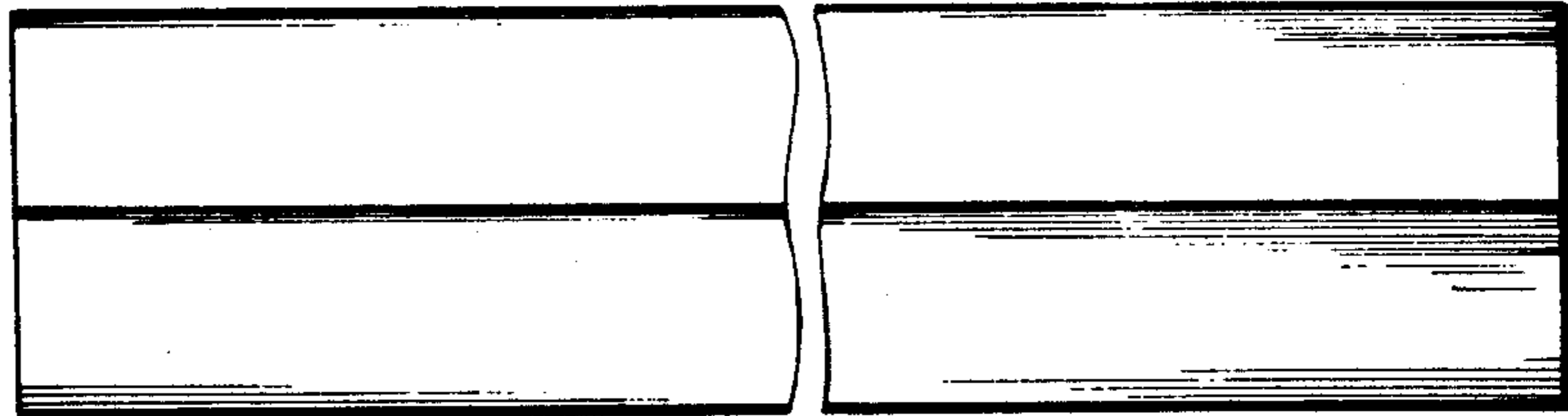

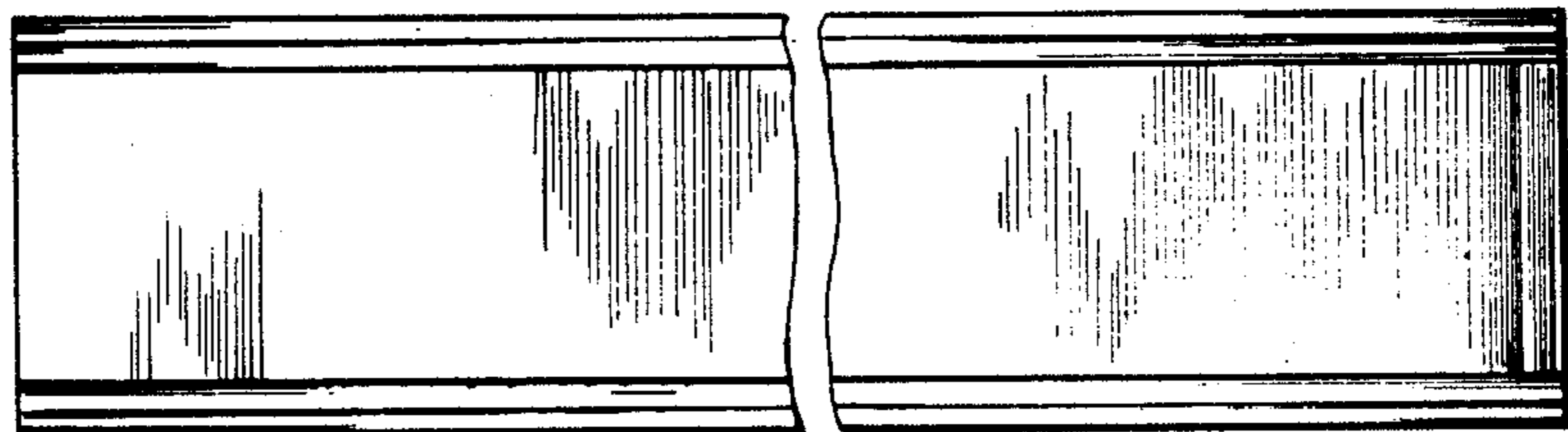

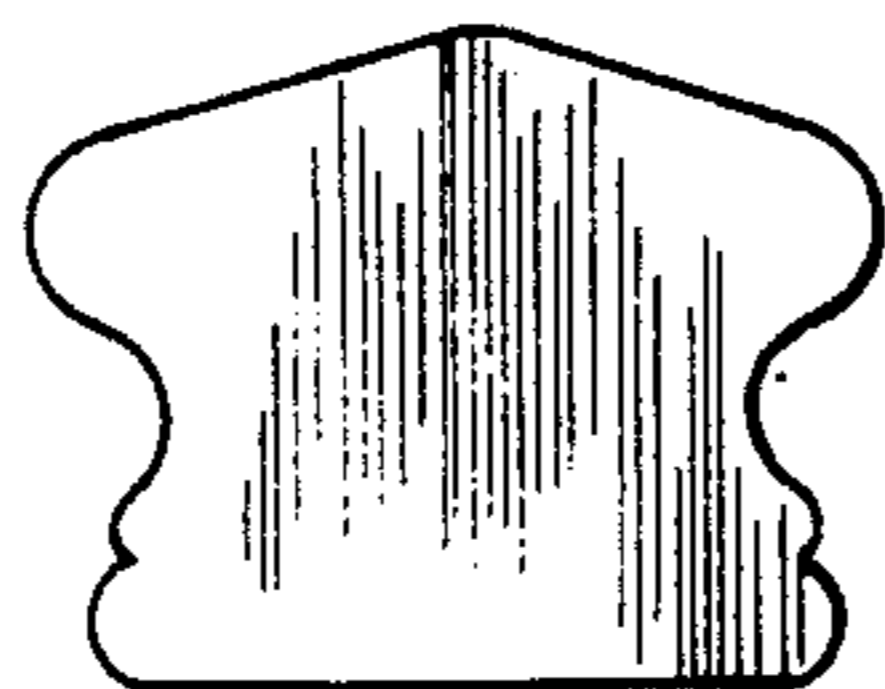

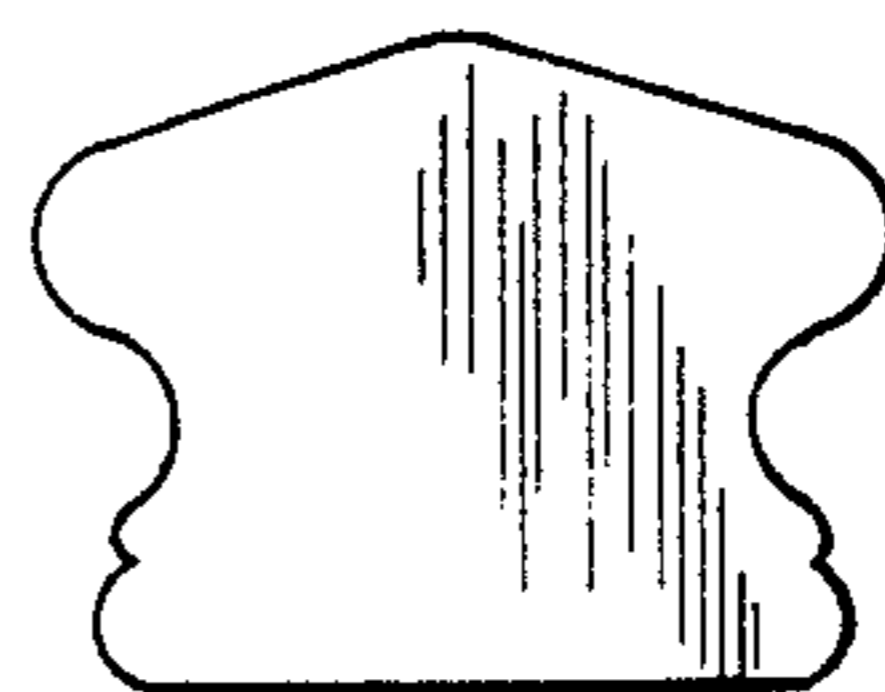
