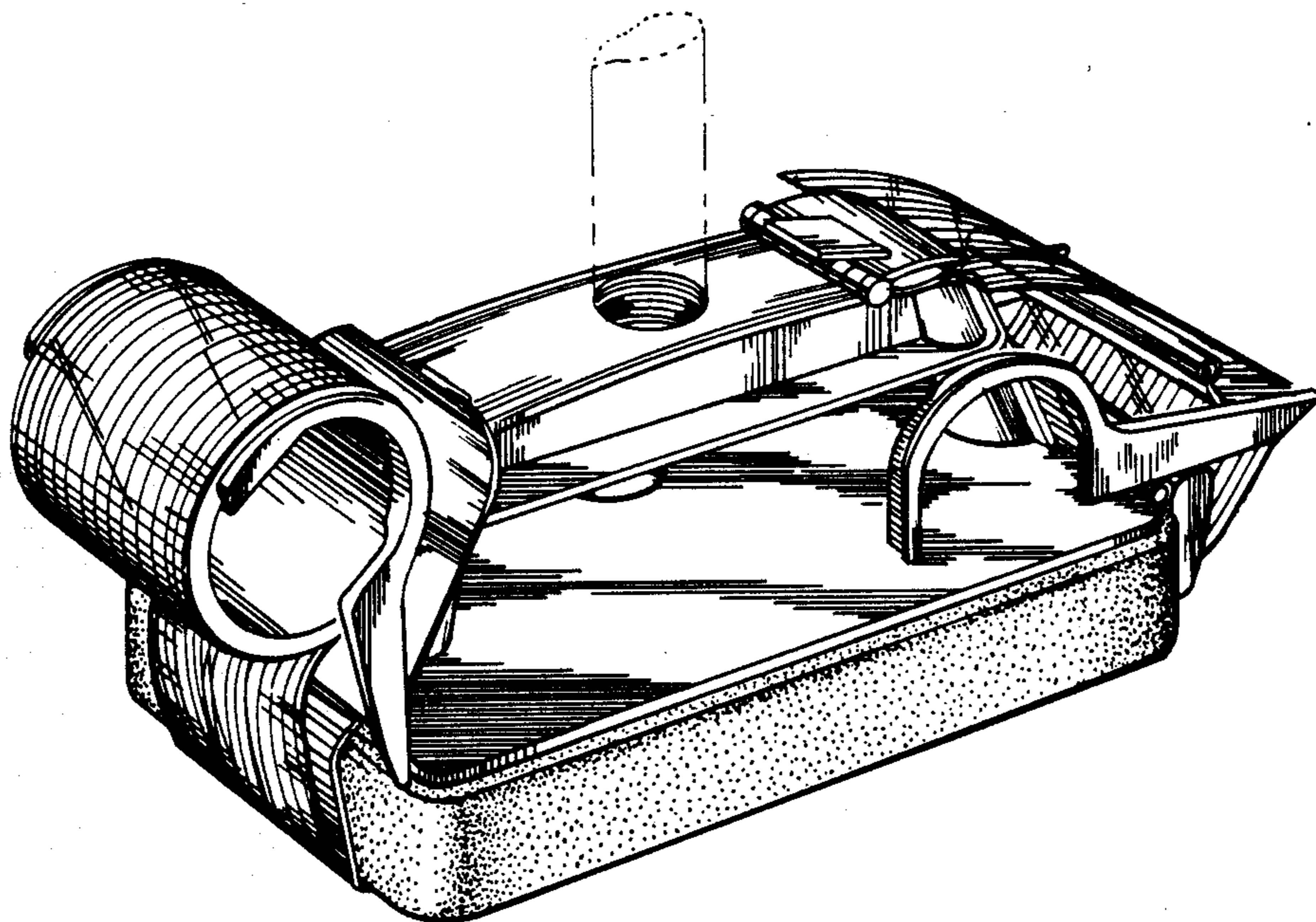

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a head for an adhesive tape cleaner, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a head for an adhesive tape cleaner showing my new design, the handle shown in broken lines is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof the opposite side being a mirror image; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



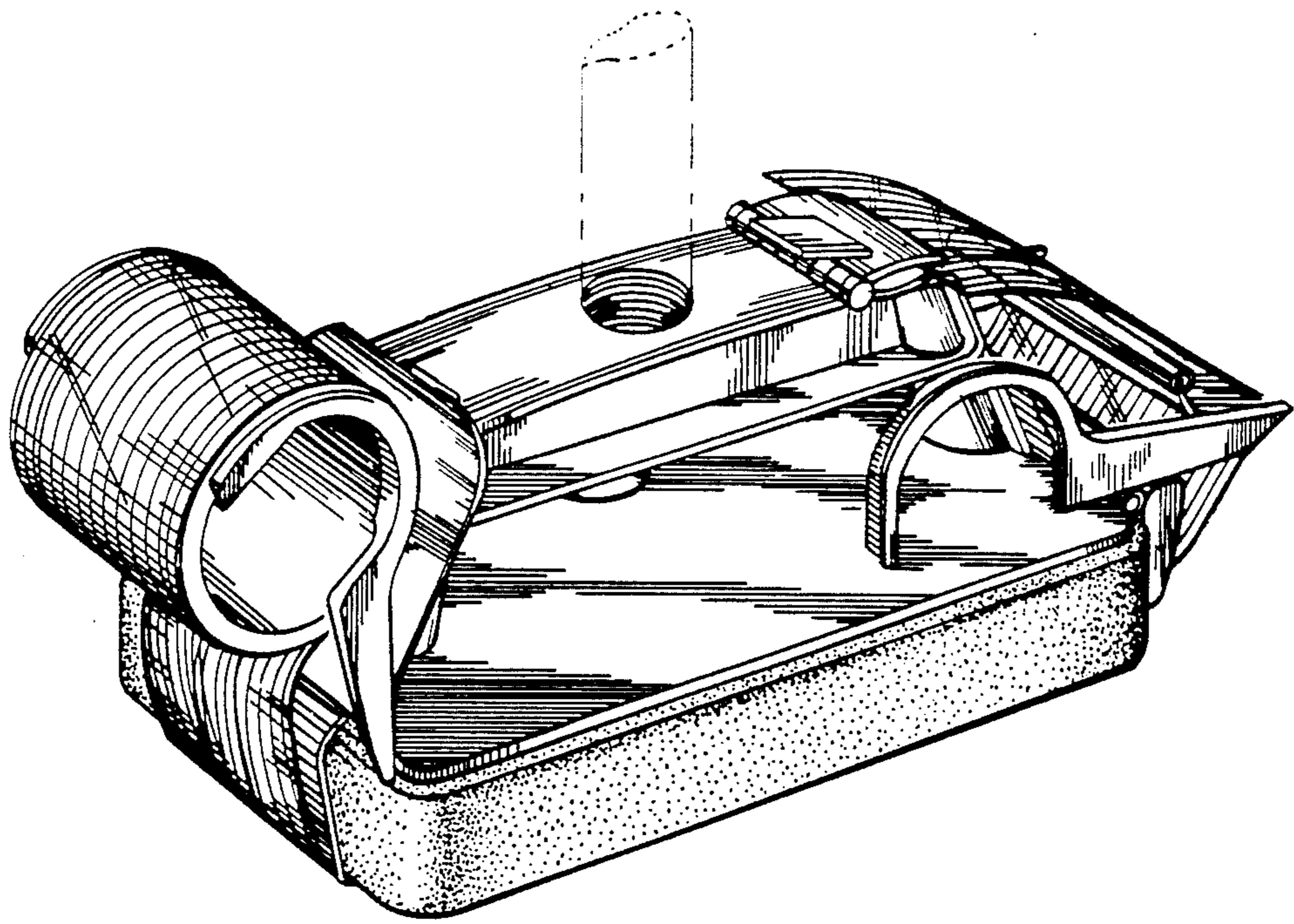

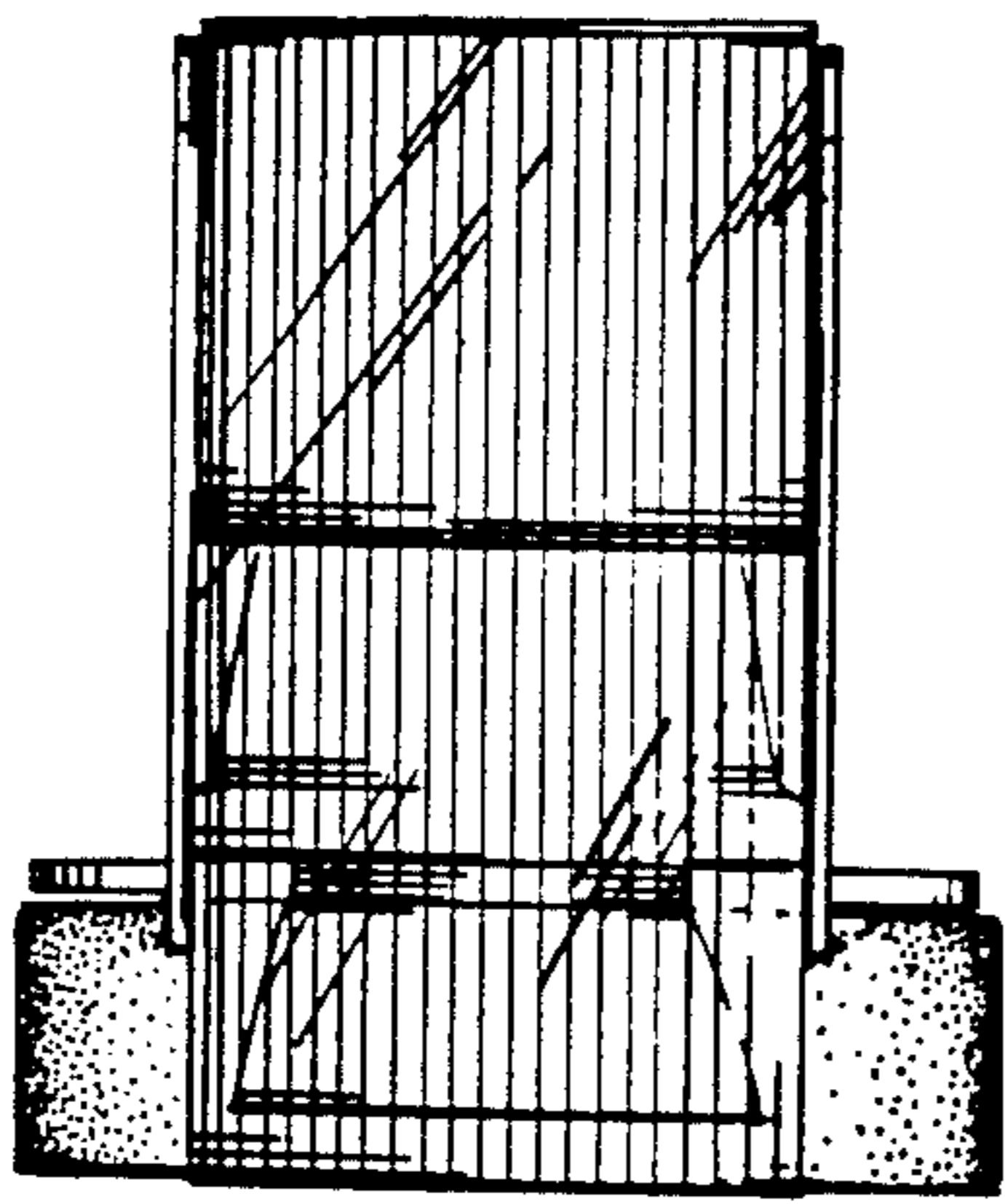

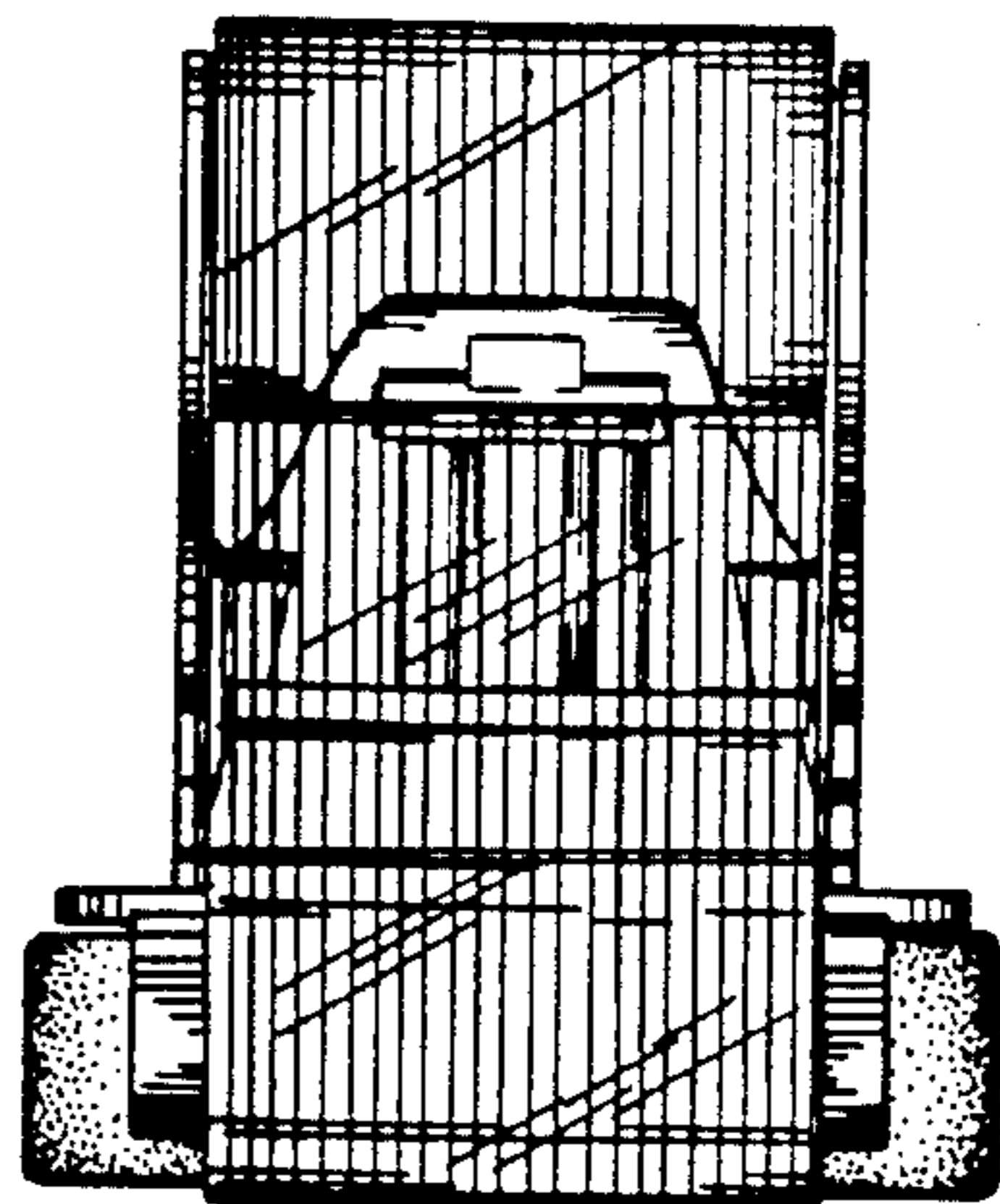

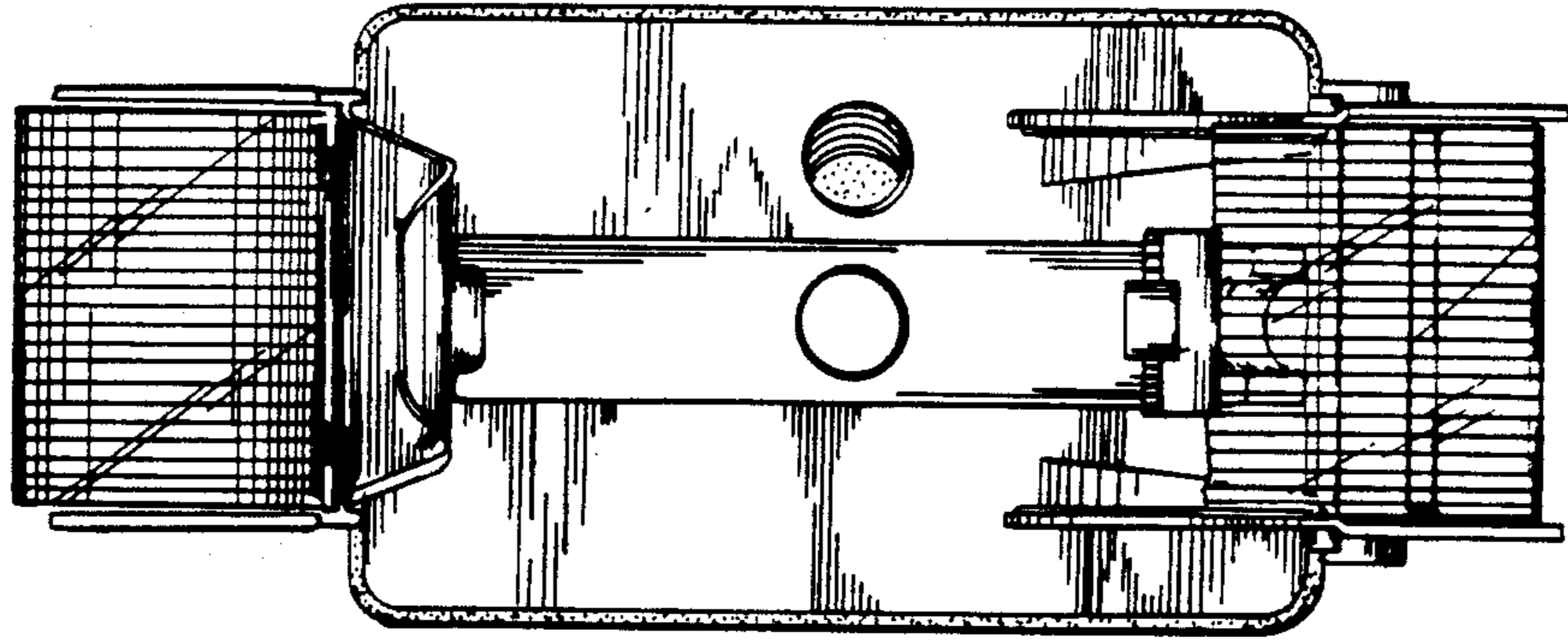

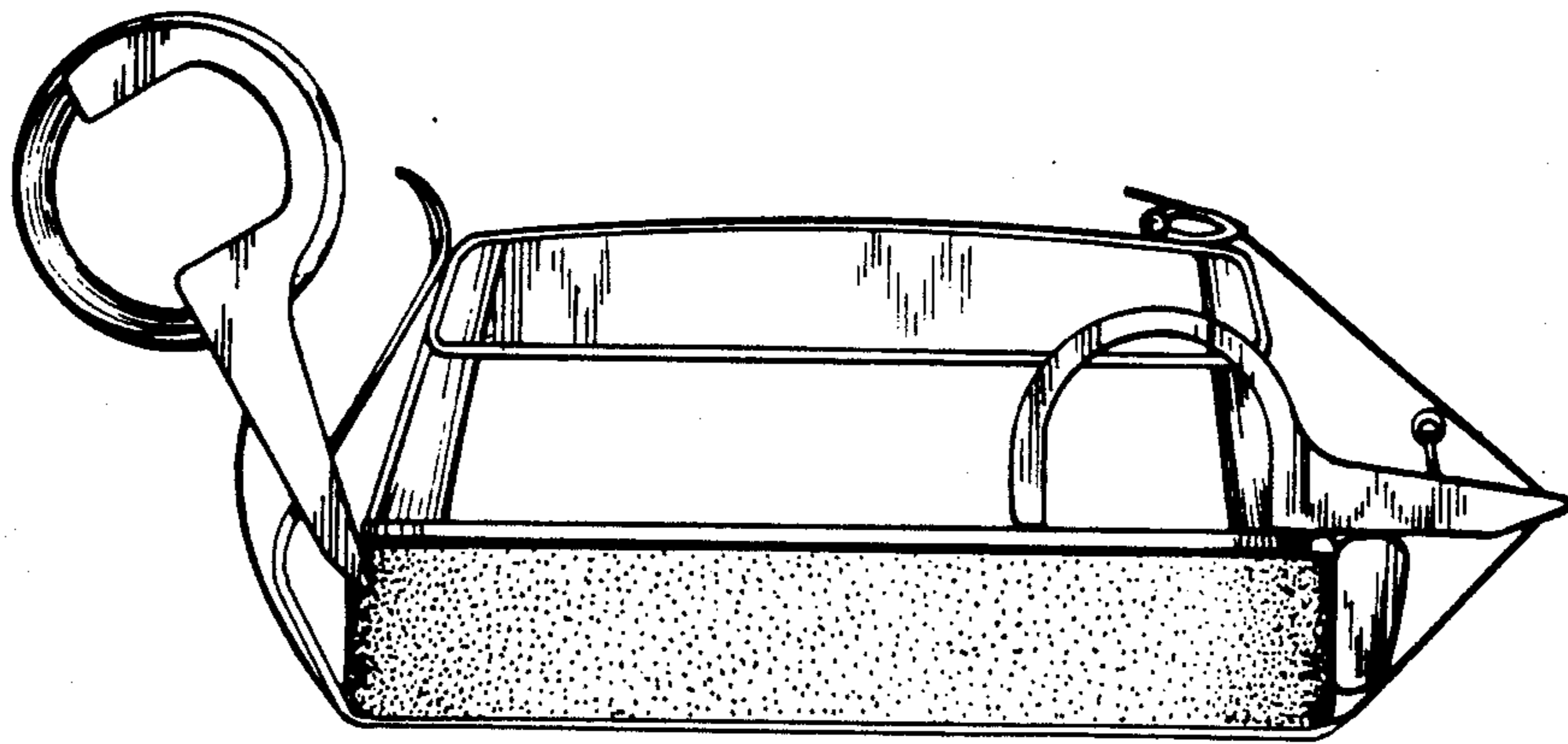

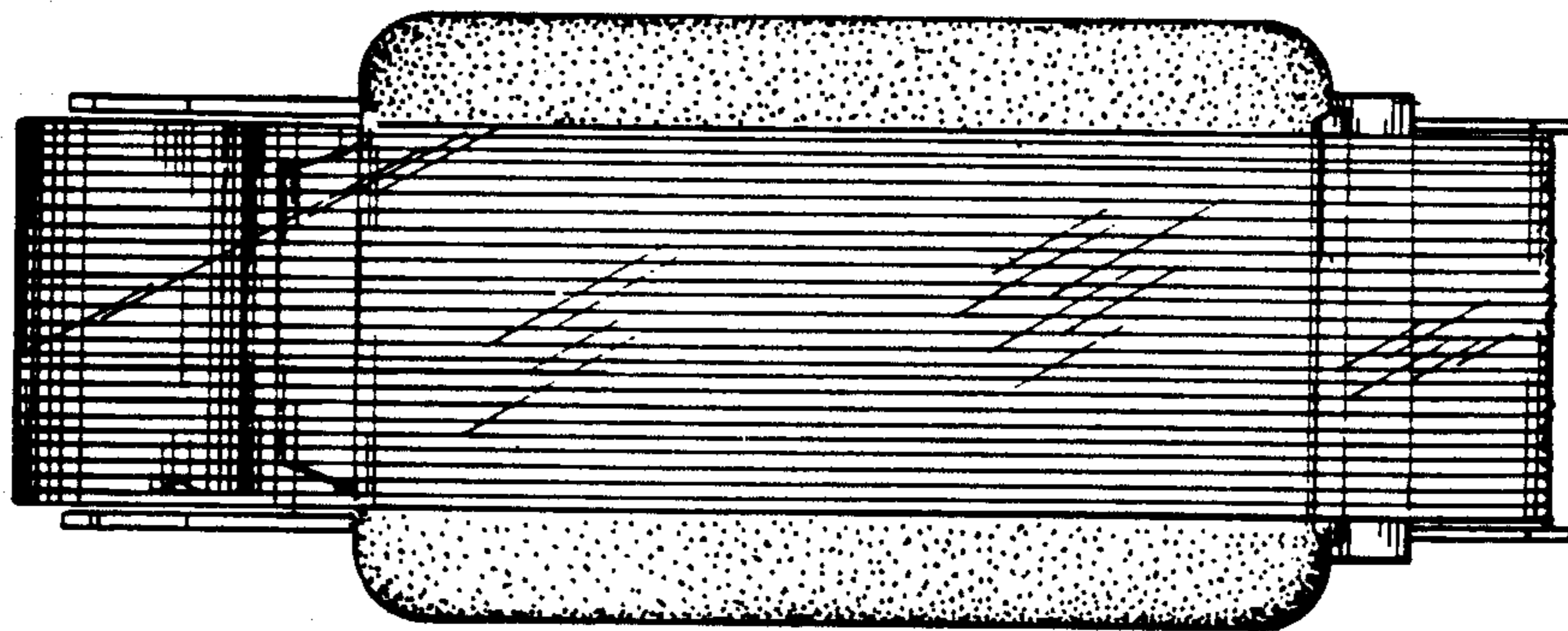
