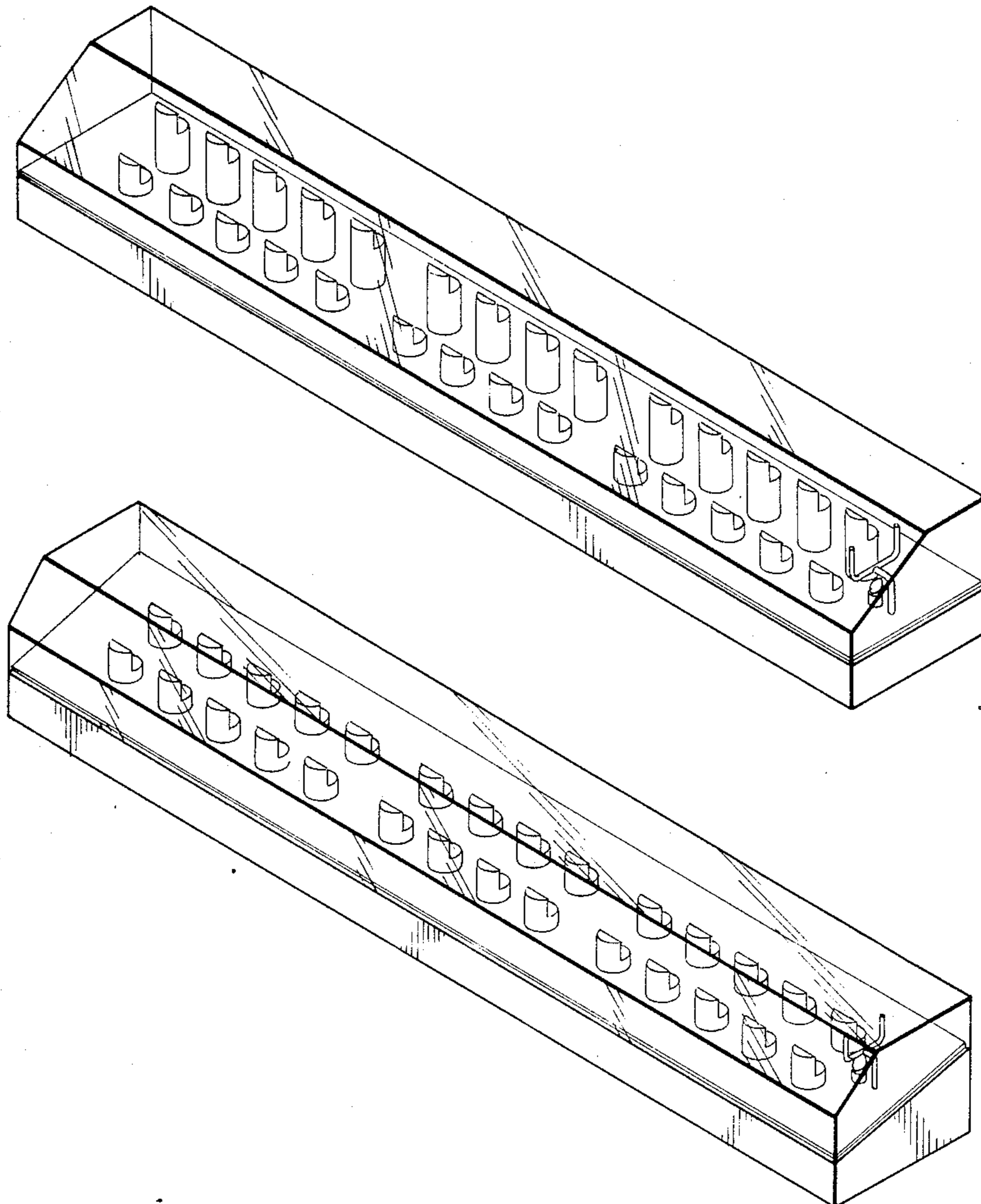

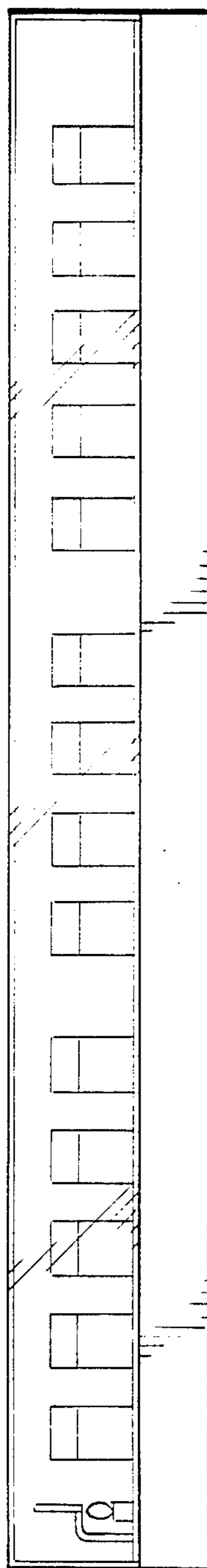
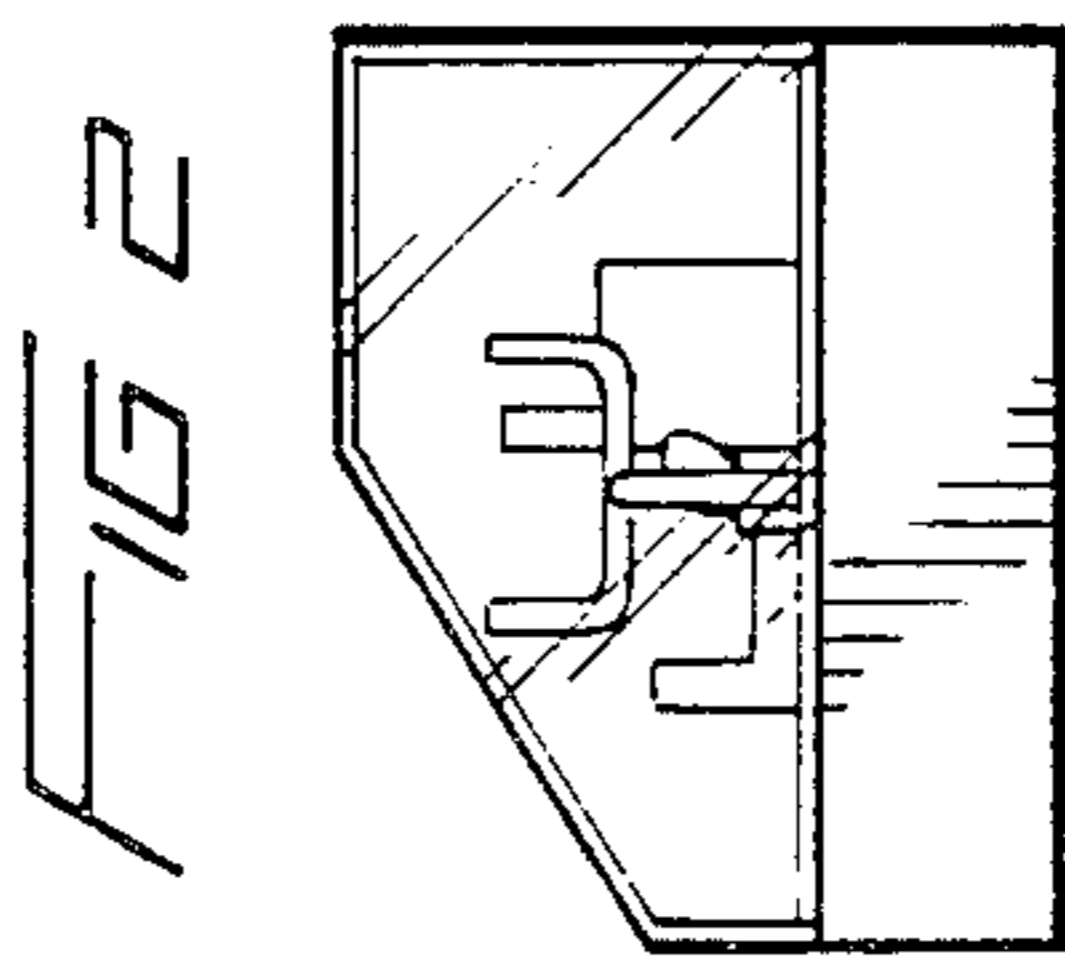
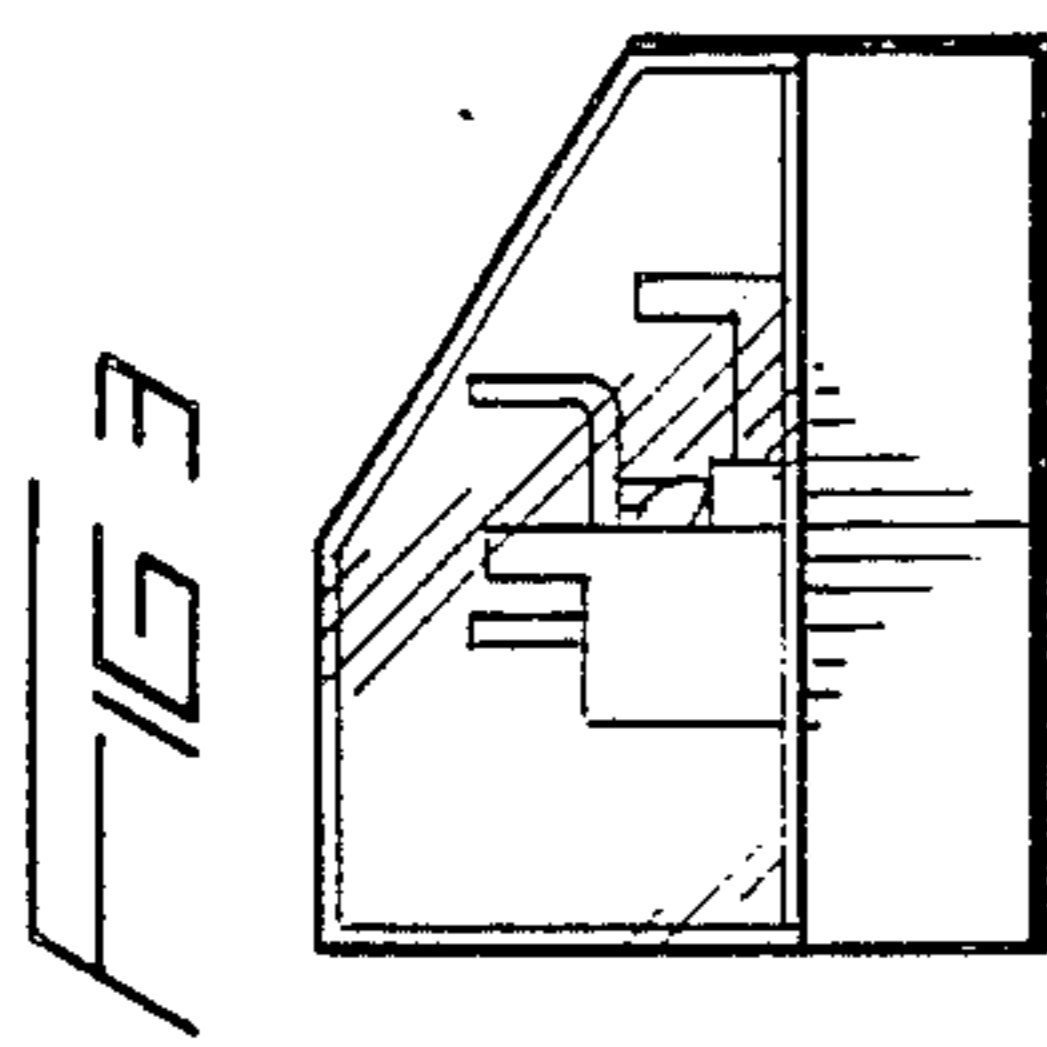
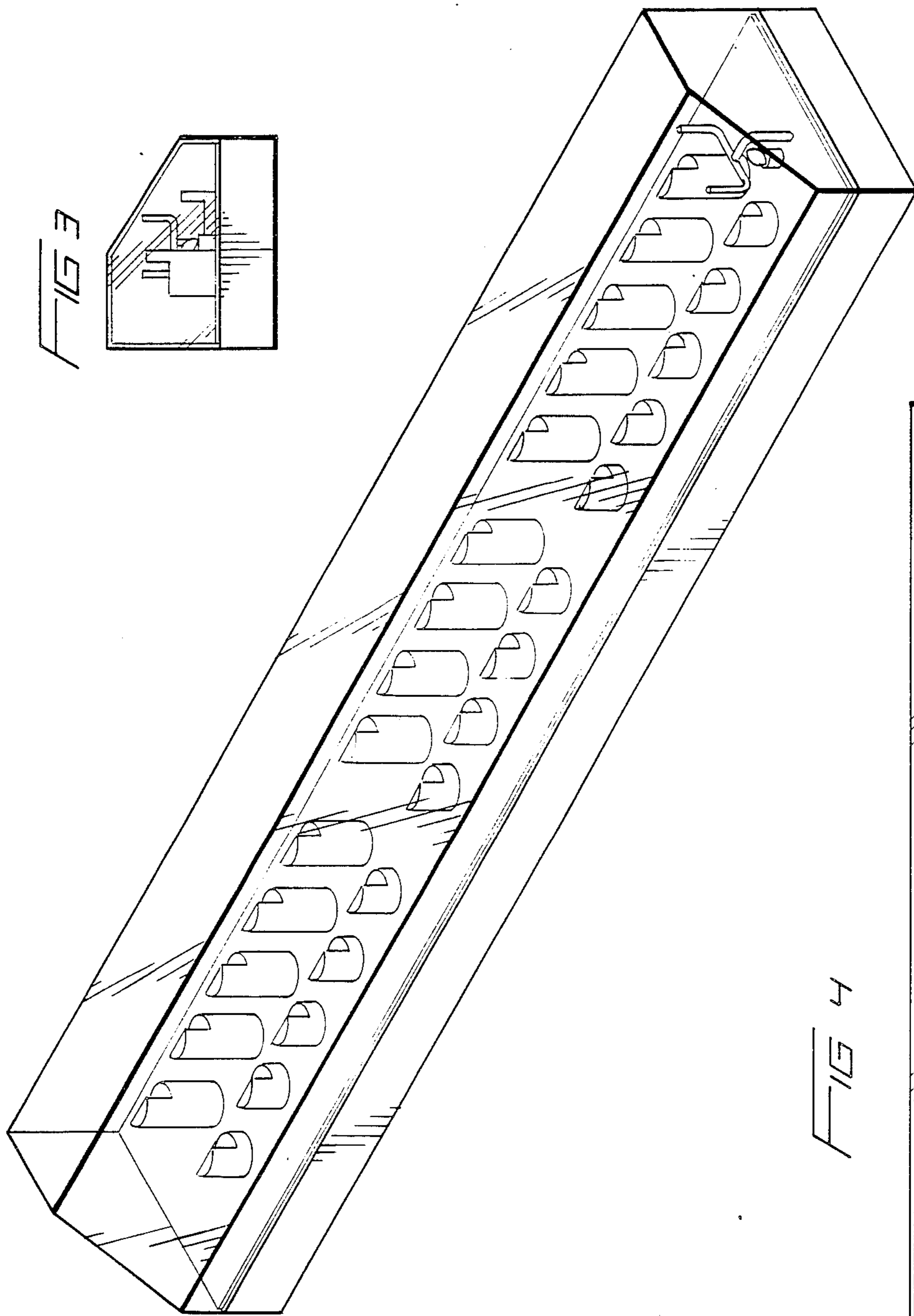

The bottom plan view of both embodiments is flat and unornamented.





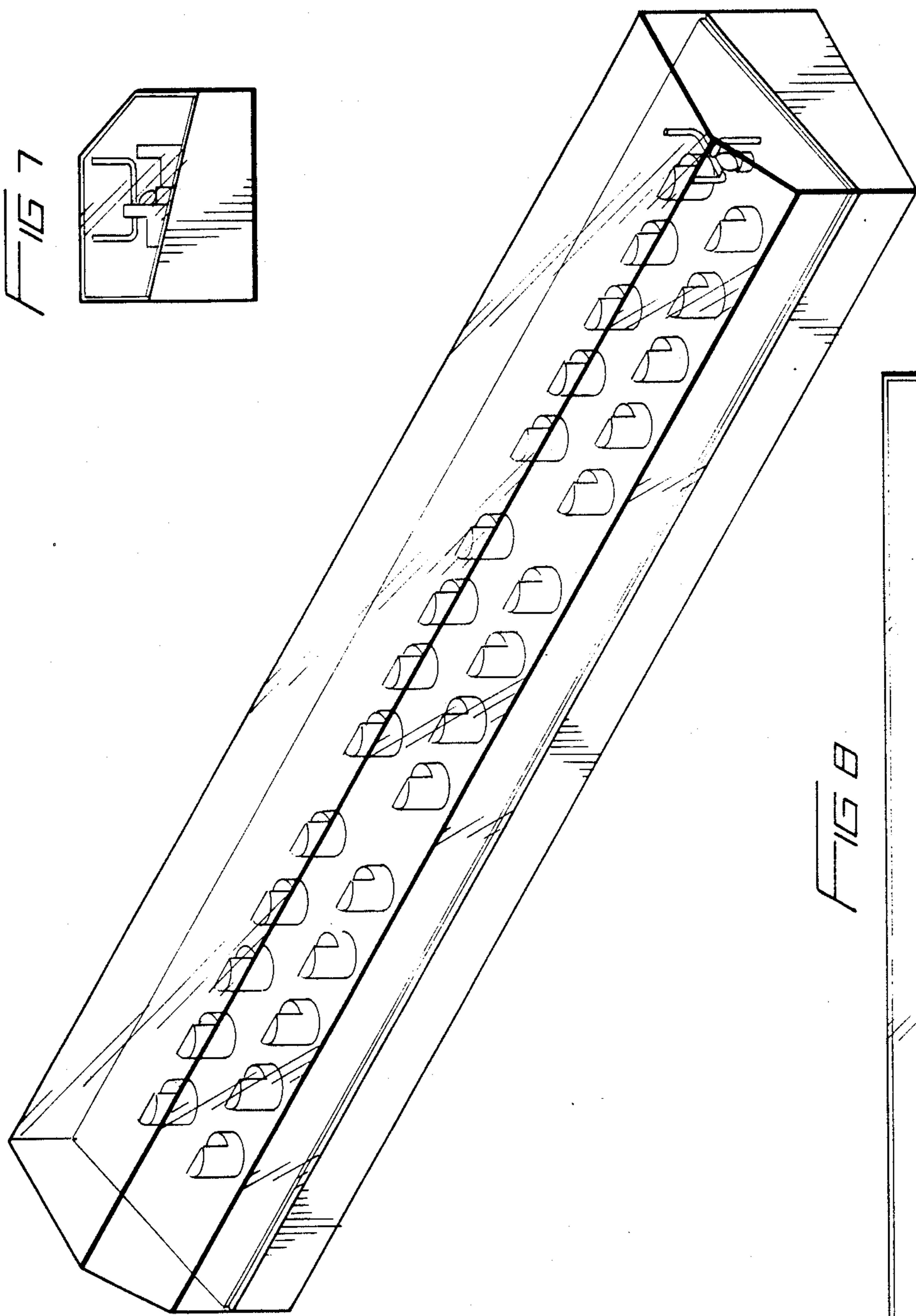

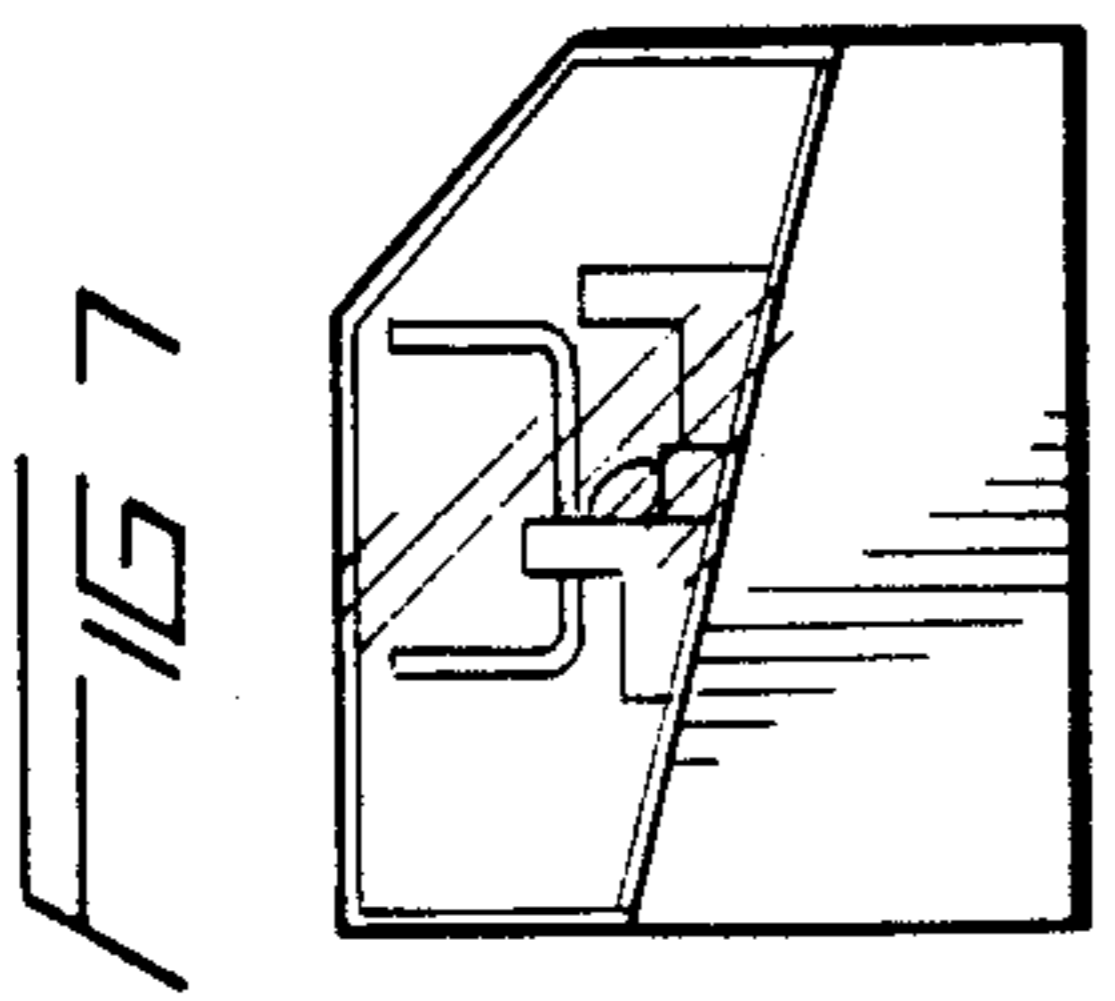

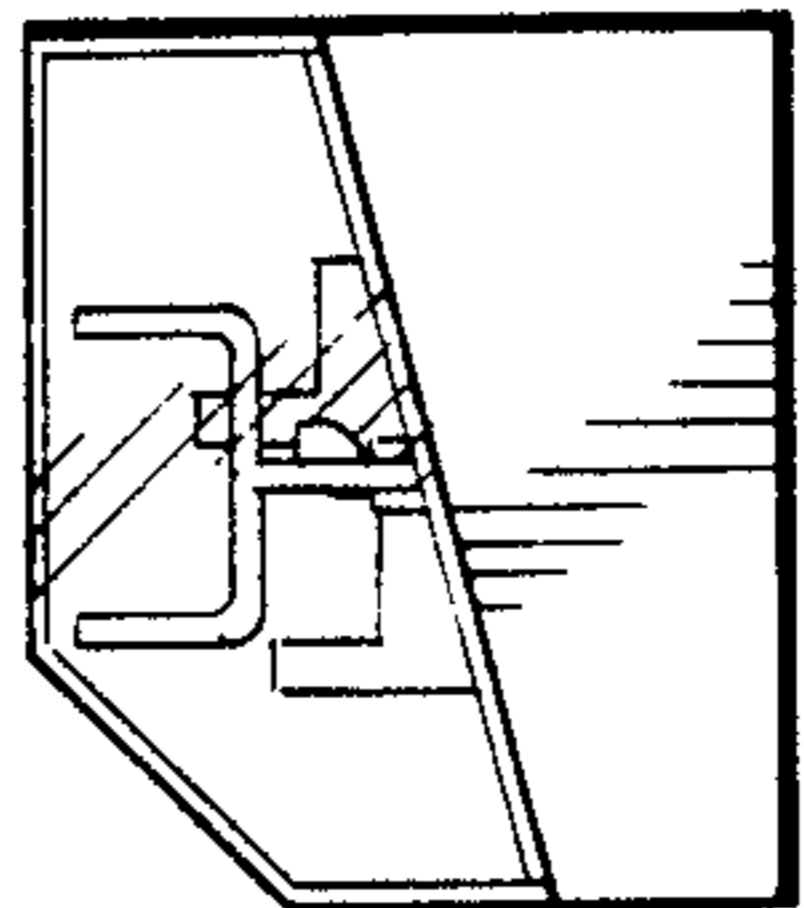

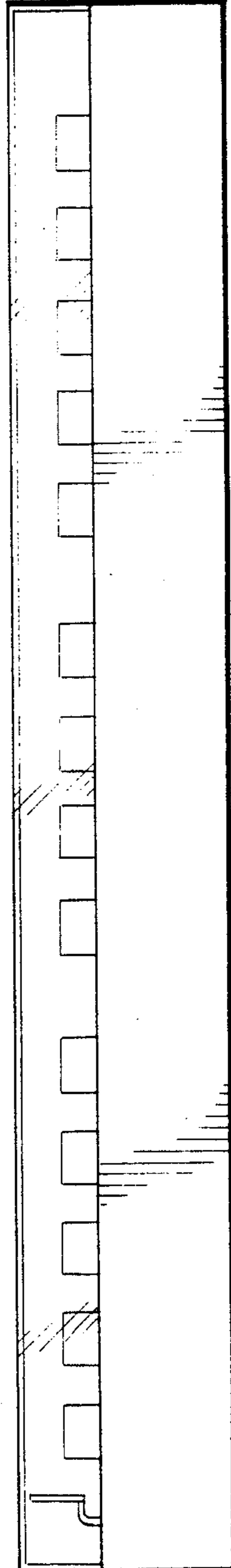
