The ornamental design for a combined light and speaker housing for an emergency vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined light and speaker housing for an emergency vehicle showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the end opposite that shown in FIG. 2.

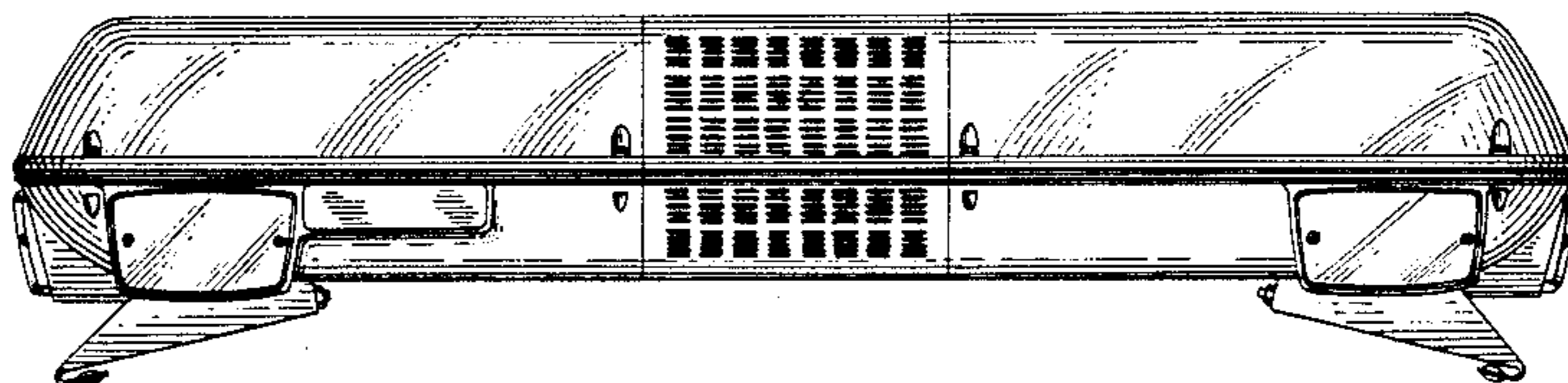

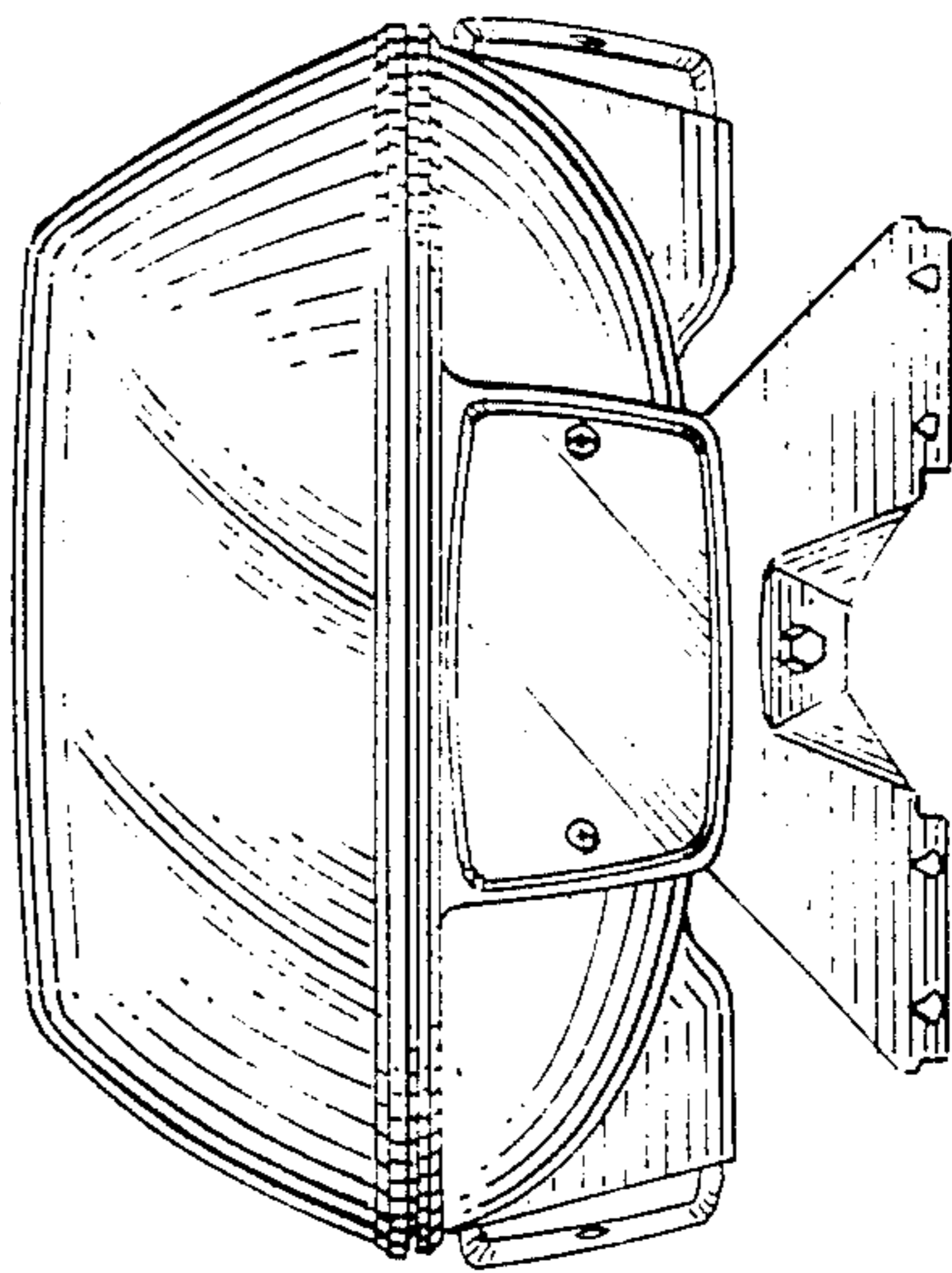
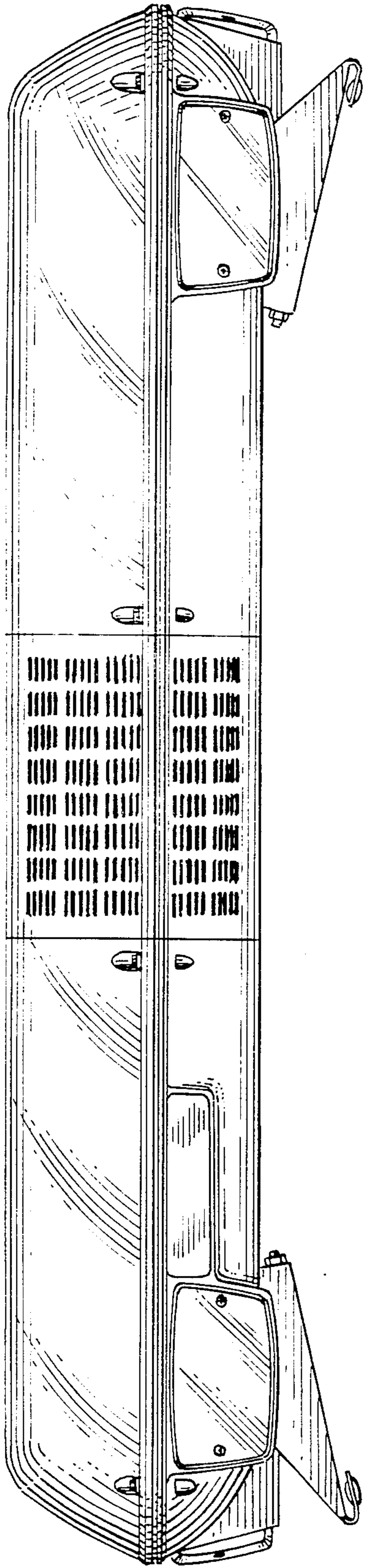

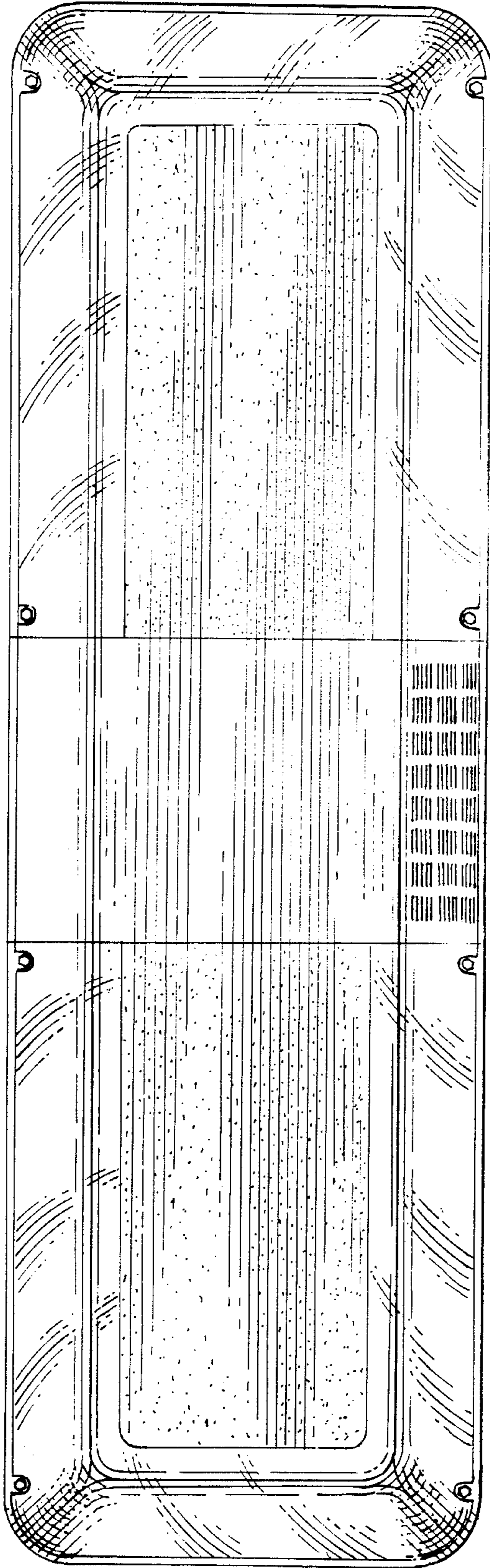

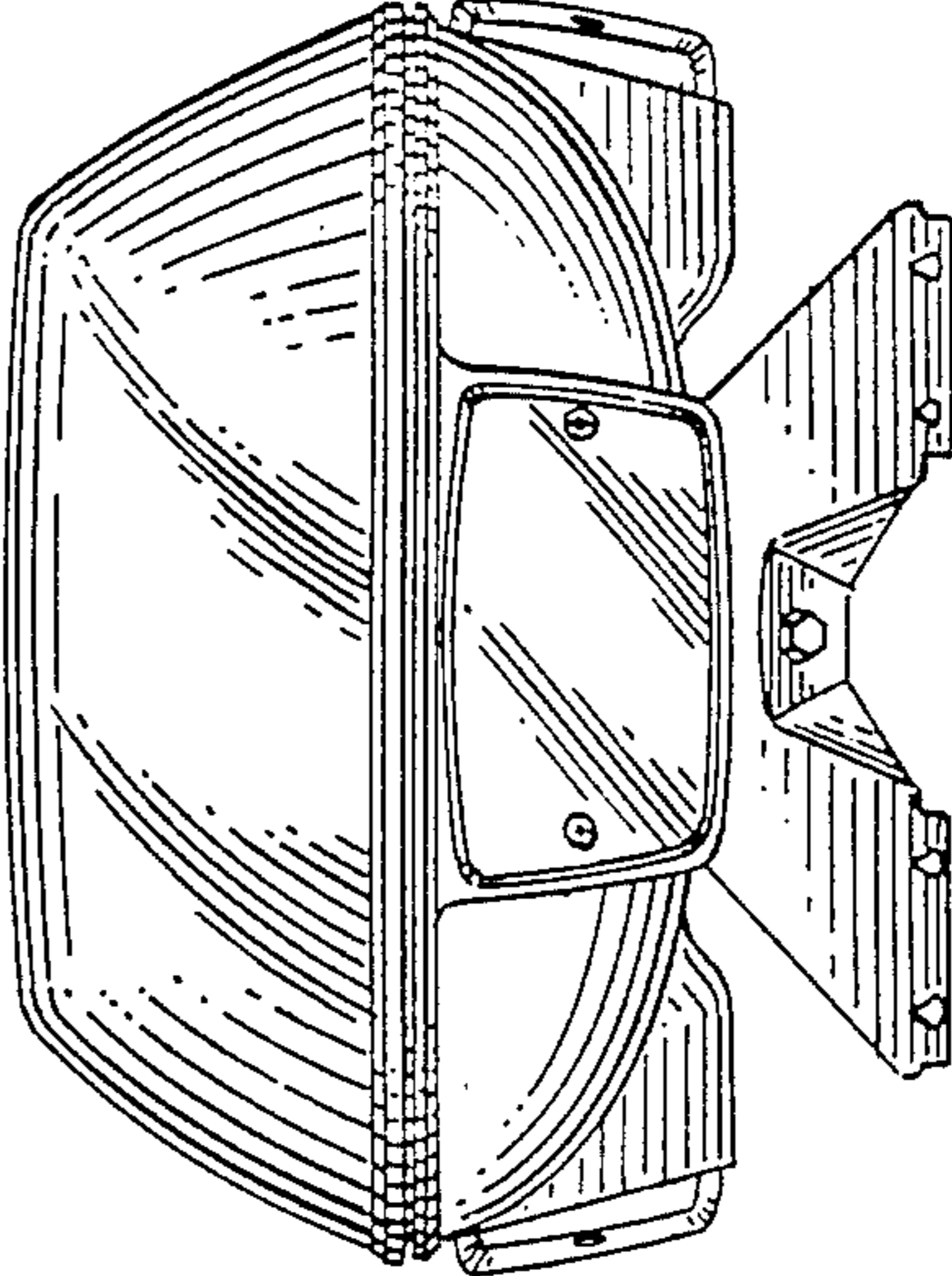
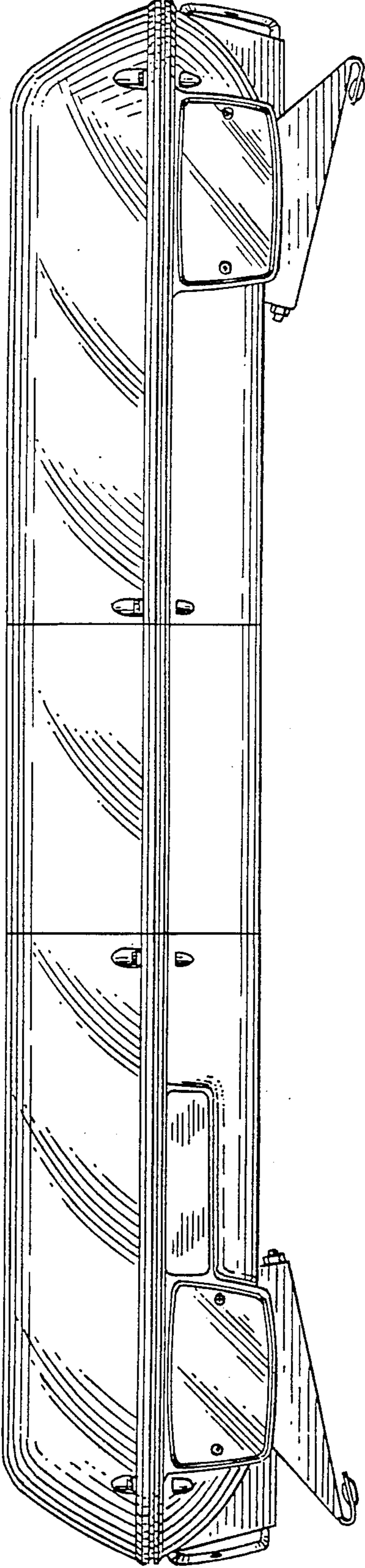
