DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of a combined television receiver and video tape recorder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top-plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

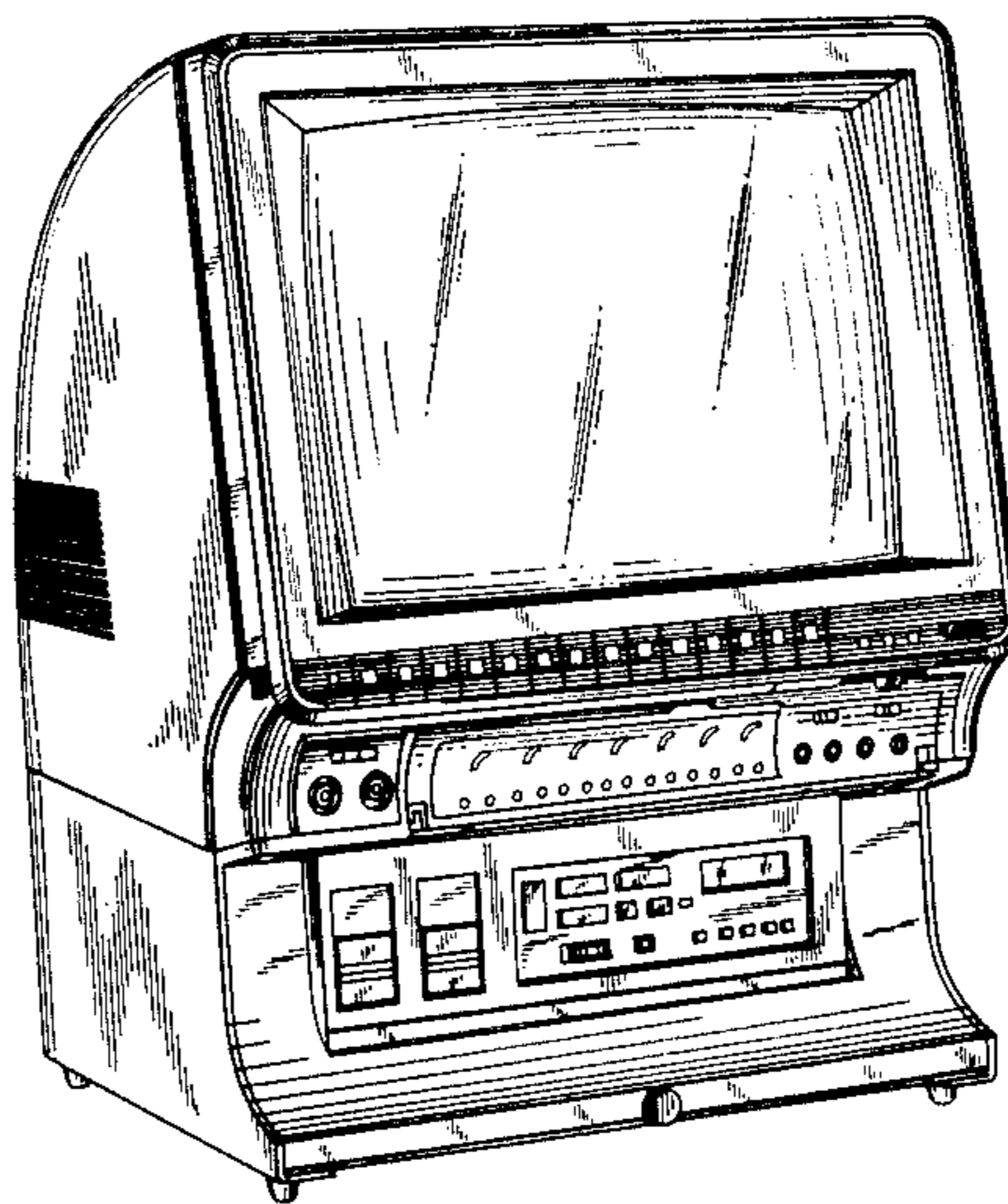

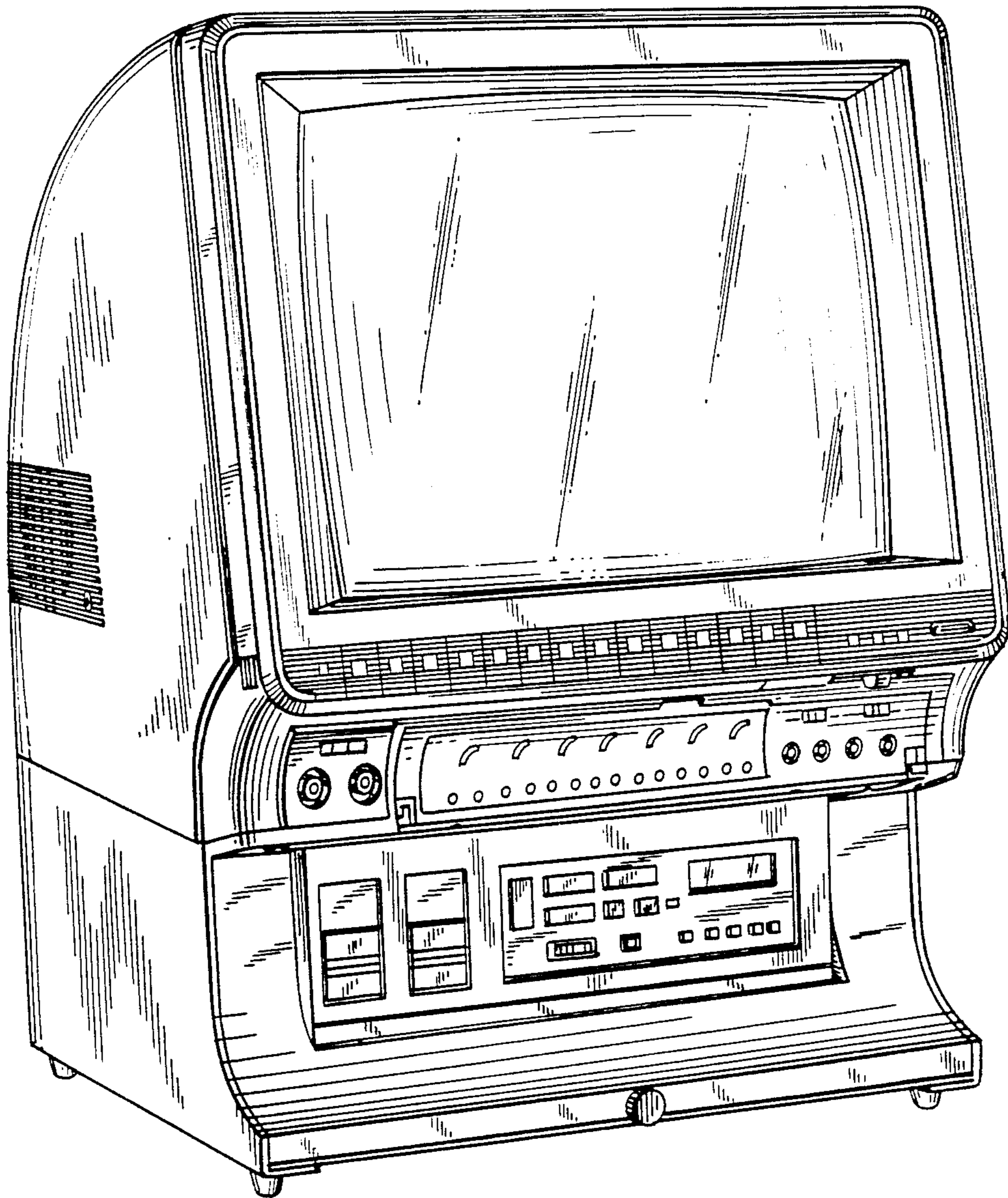

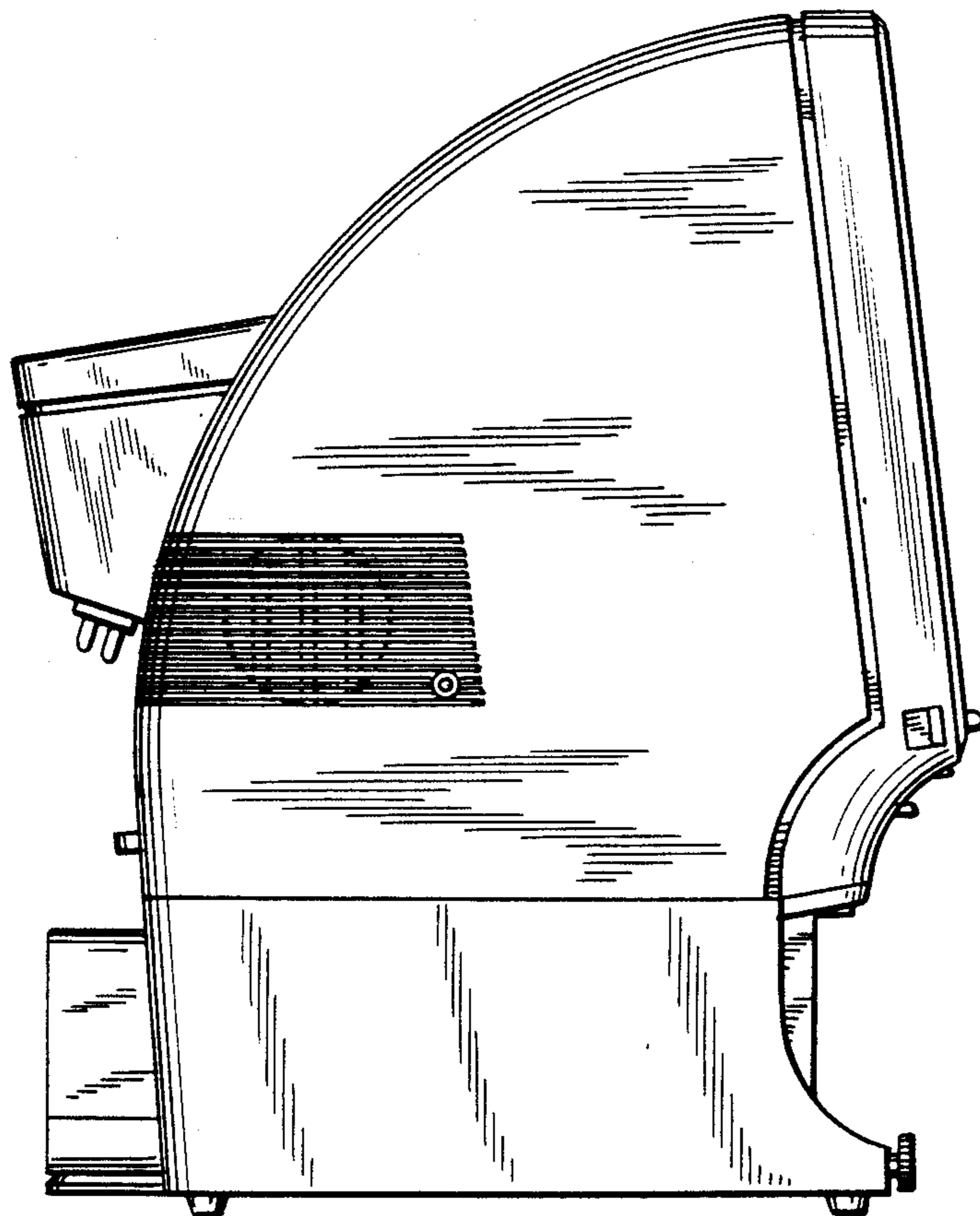
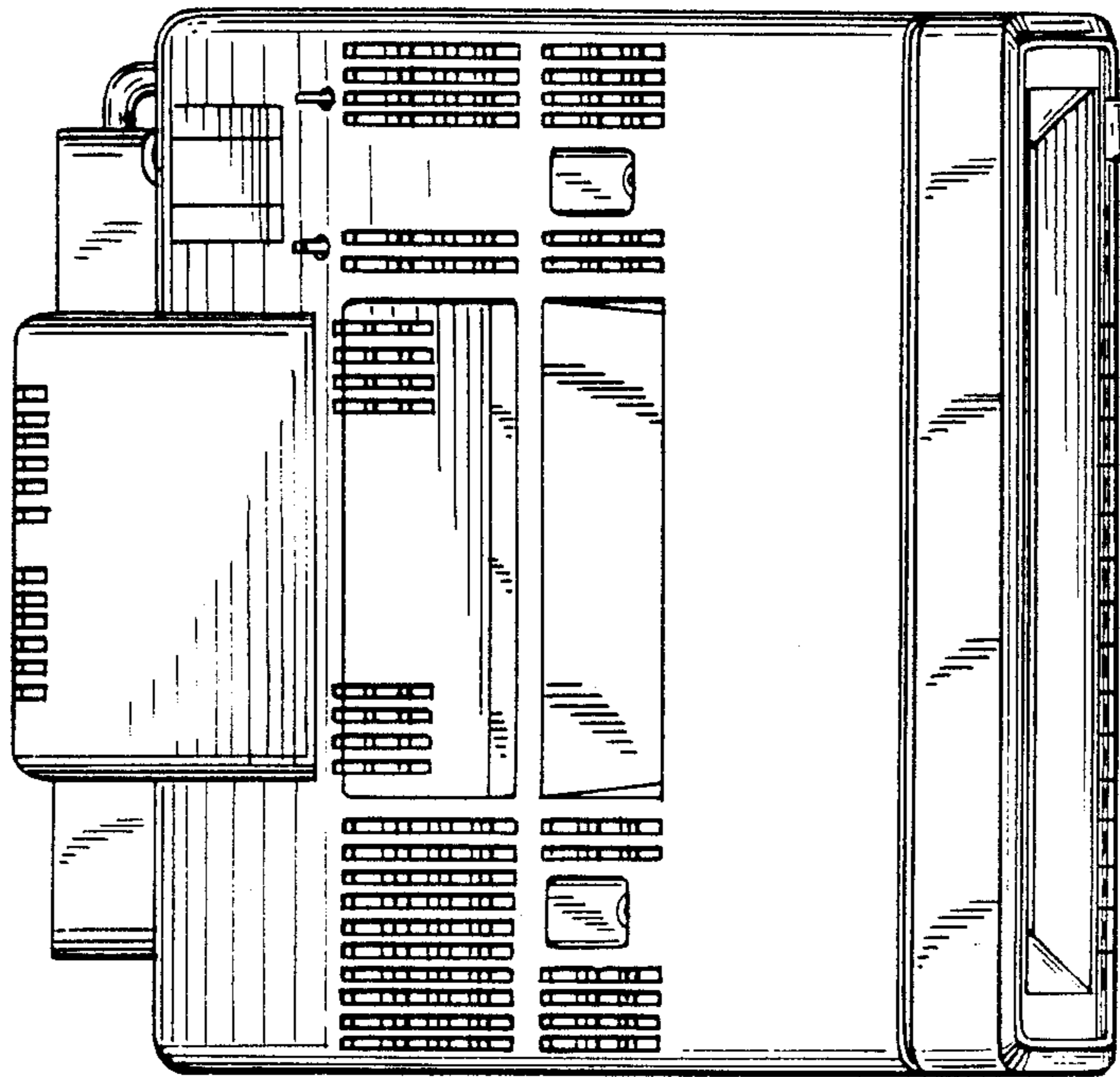

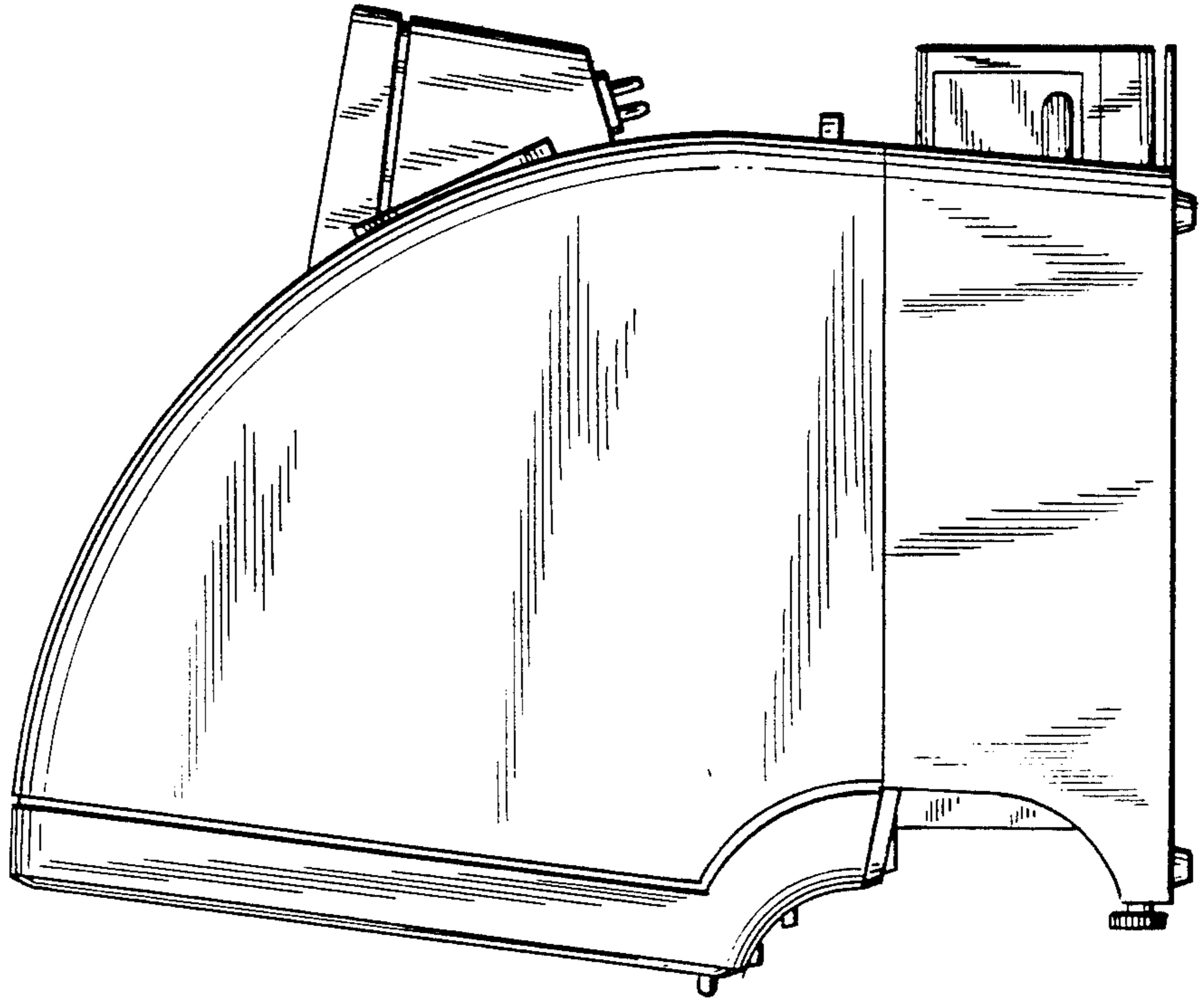

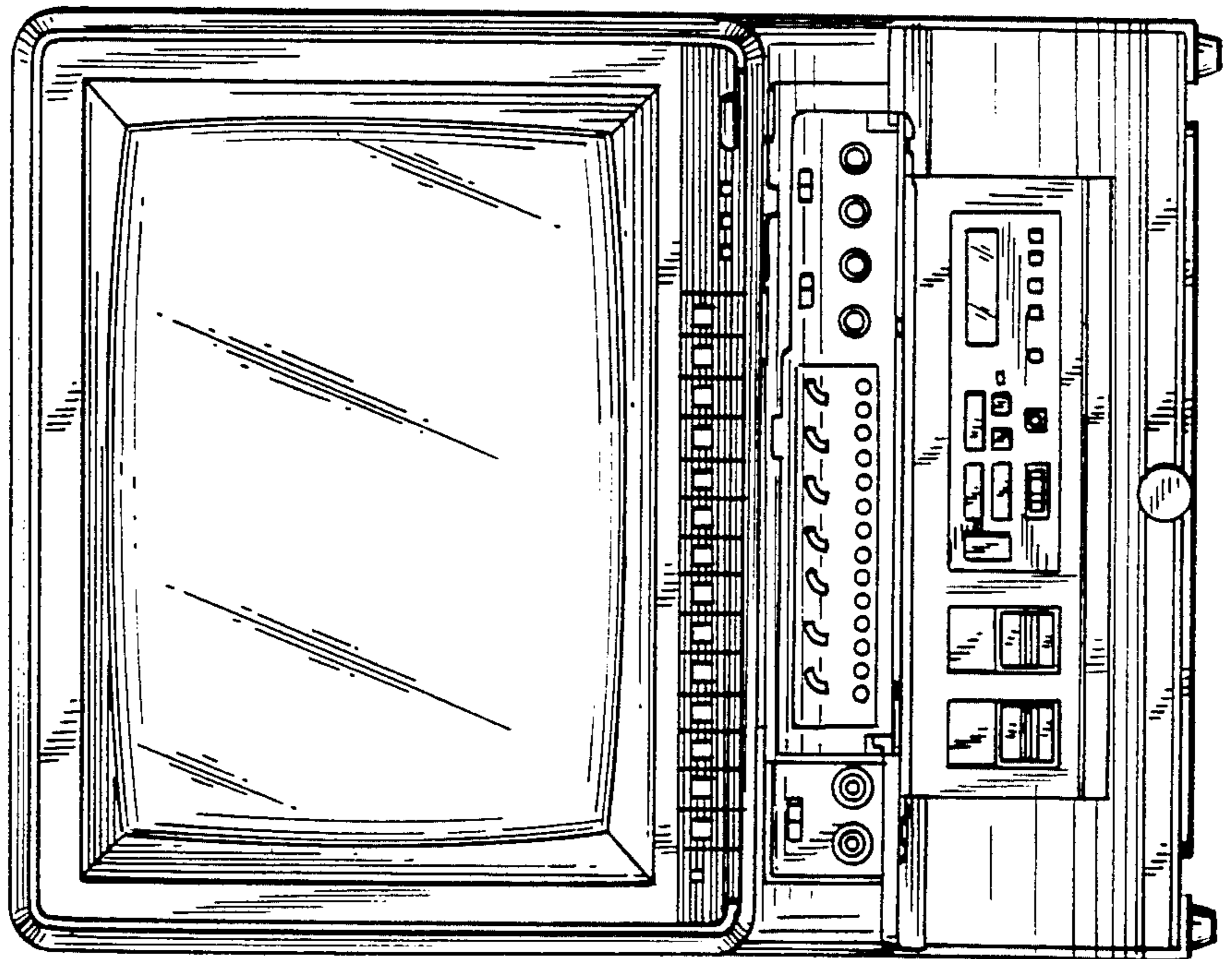

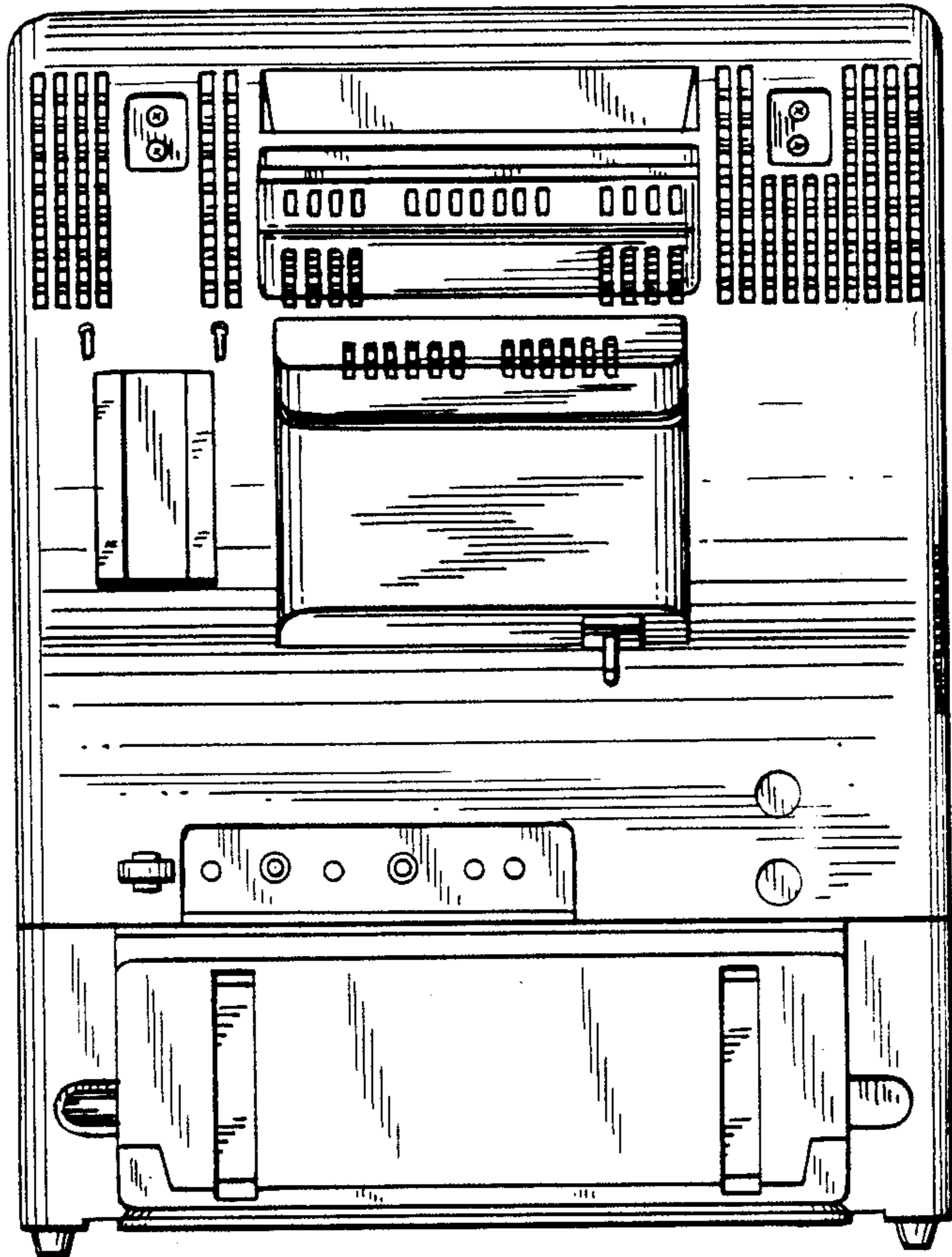
