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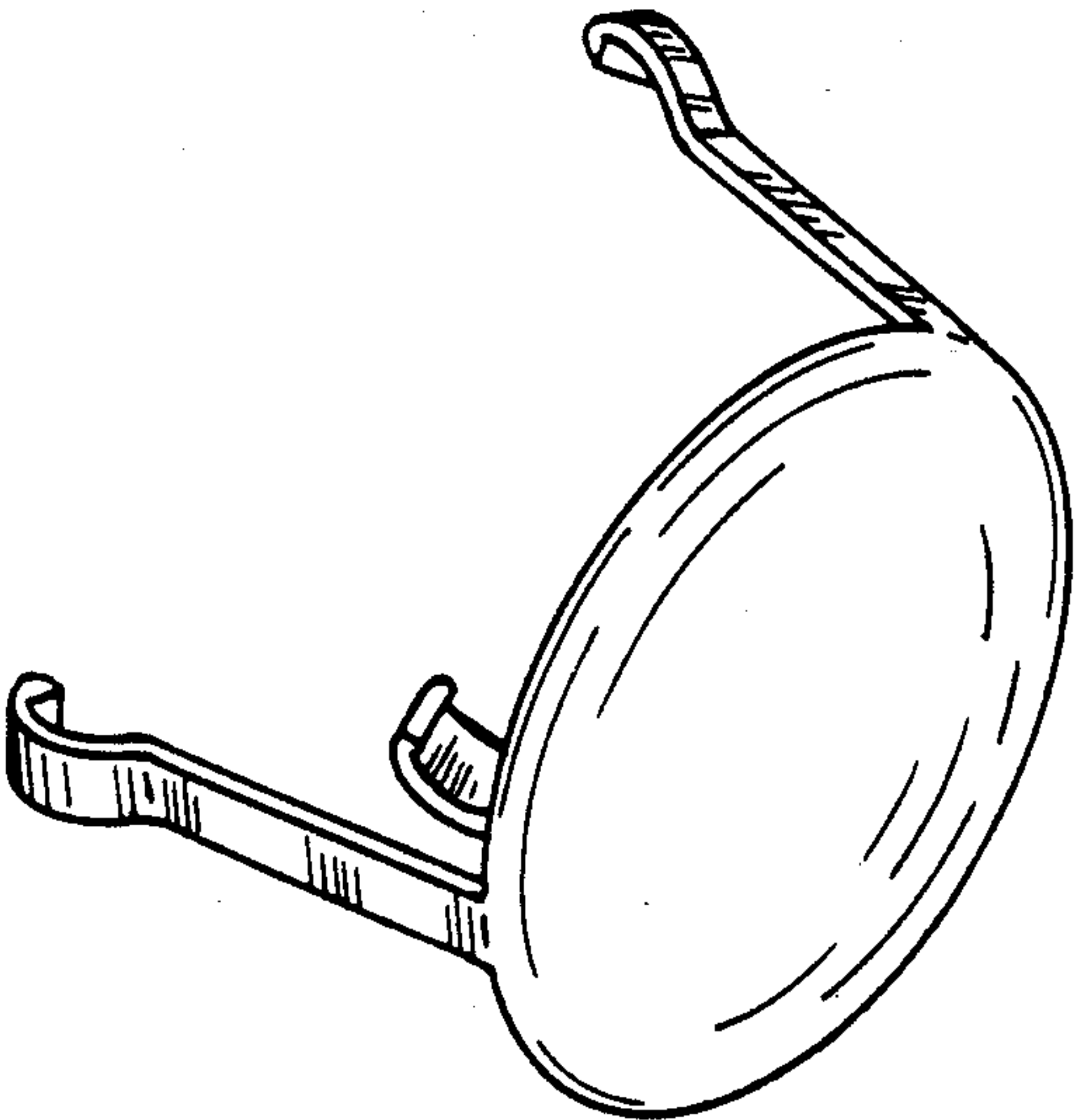

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a thermostat magnifier showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 2.



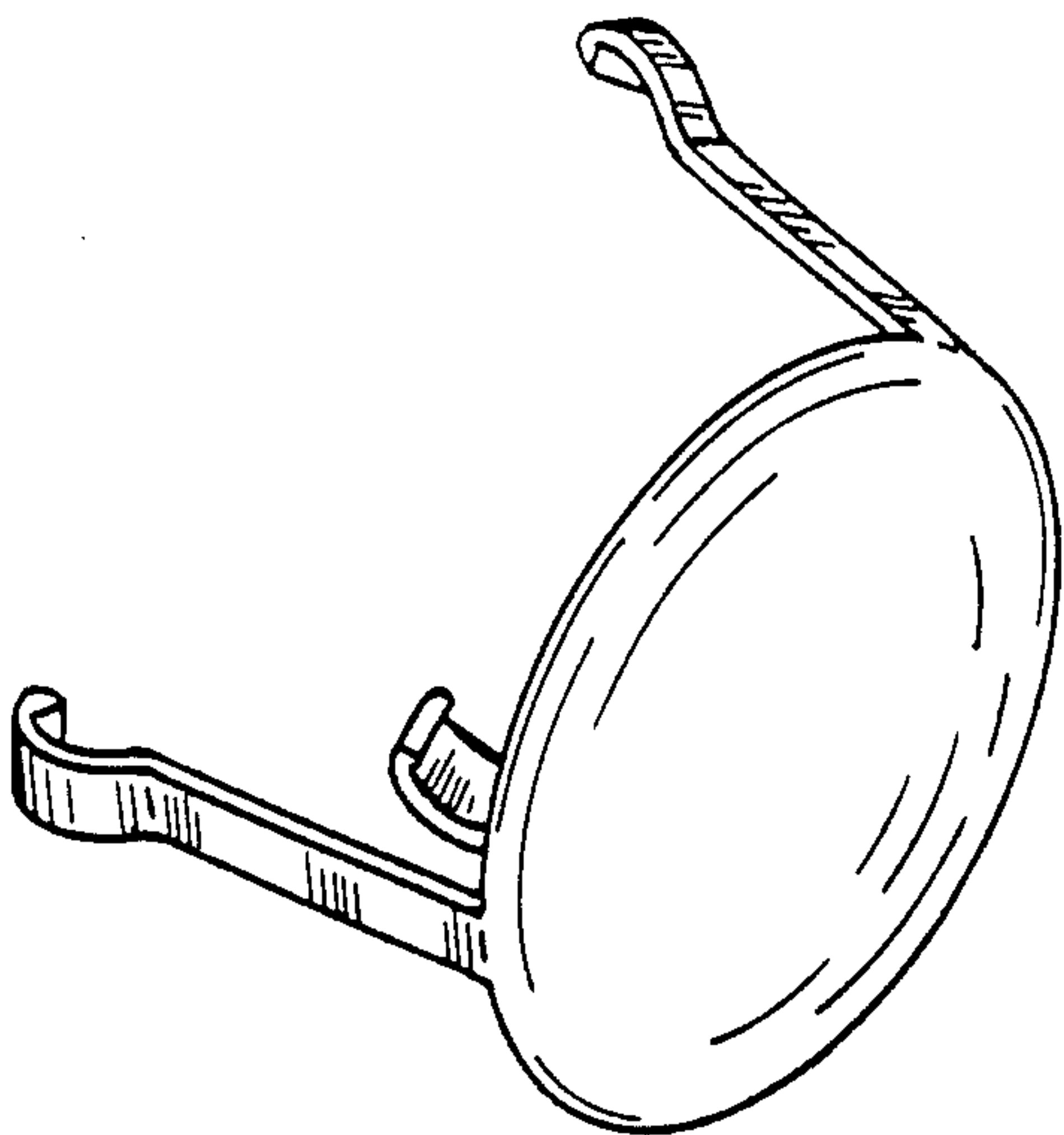

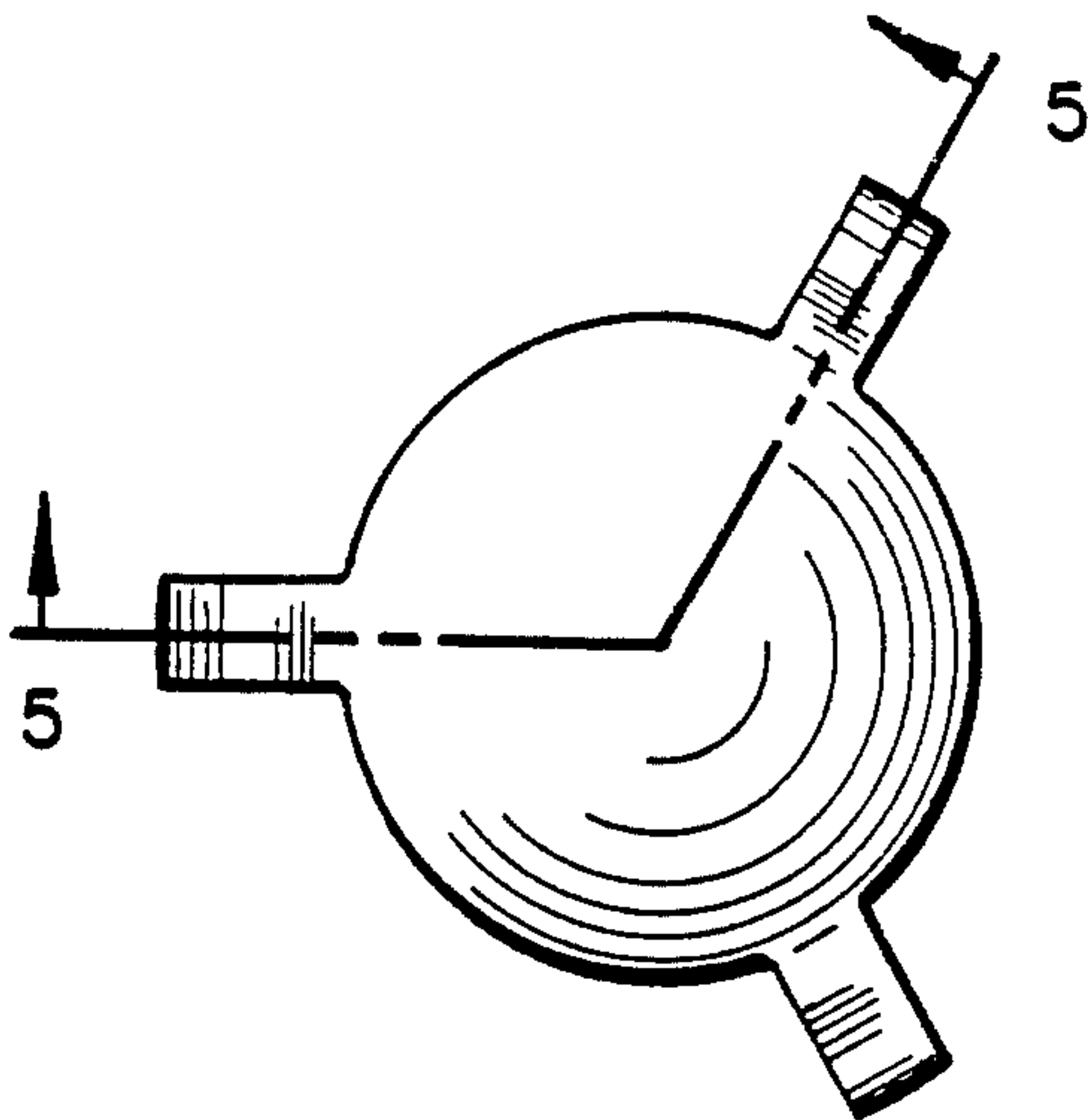

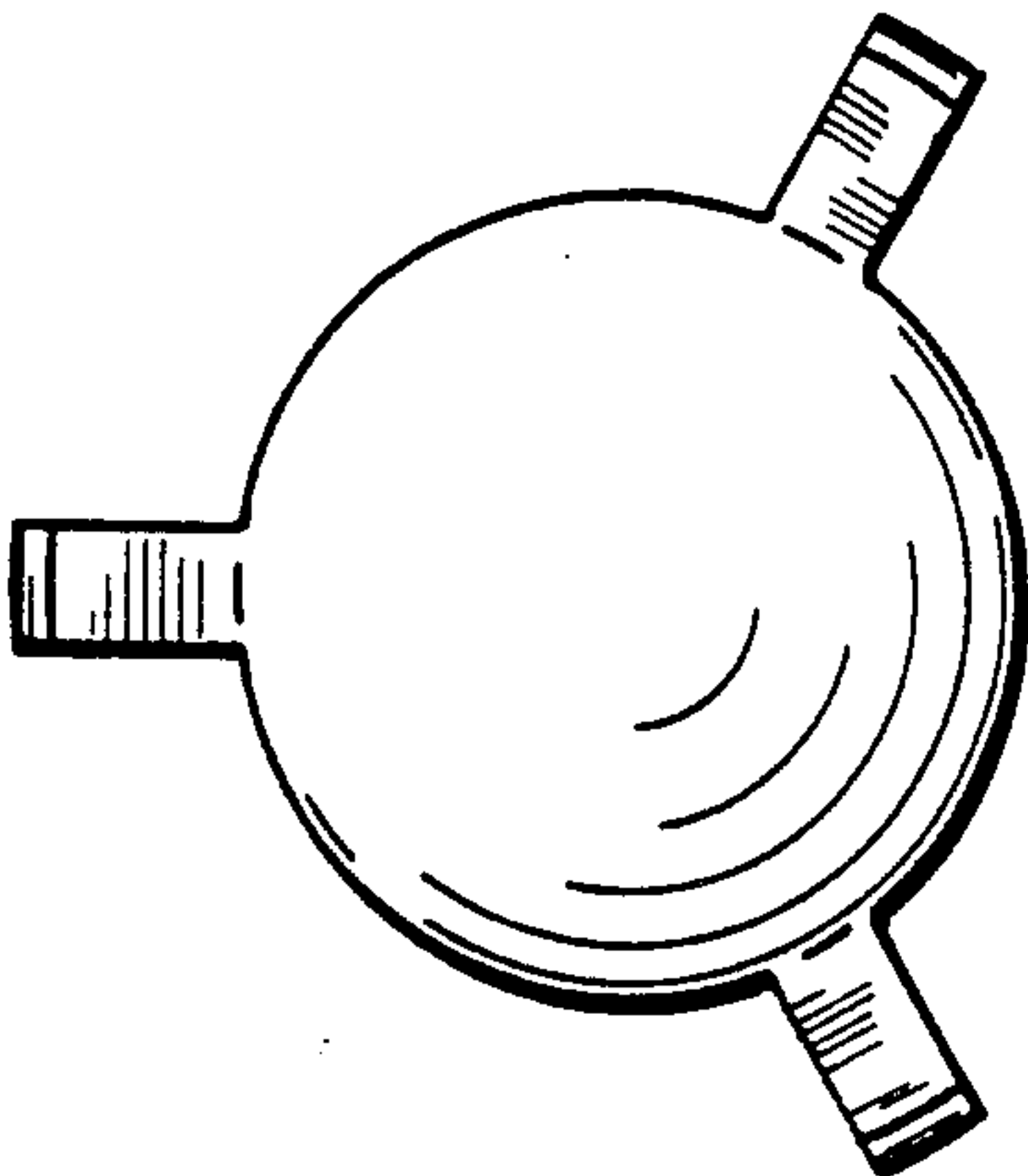

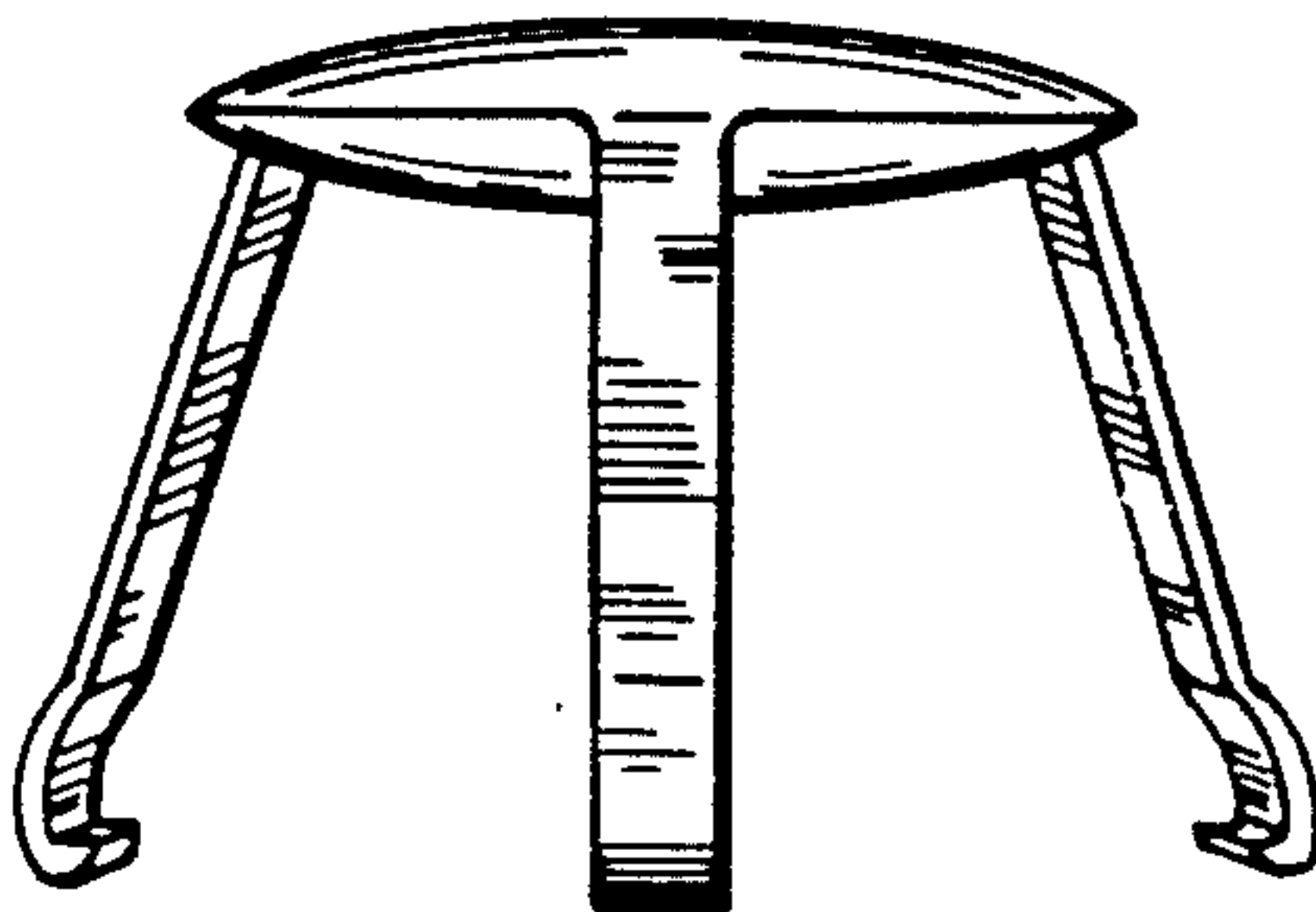

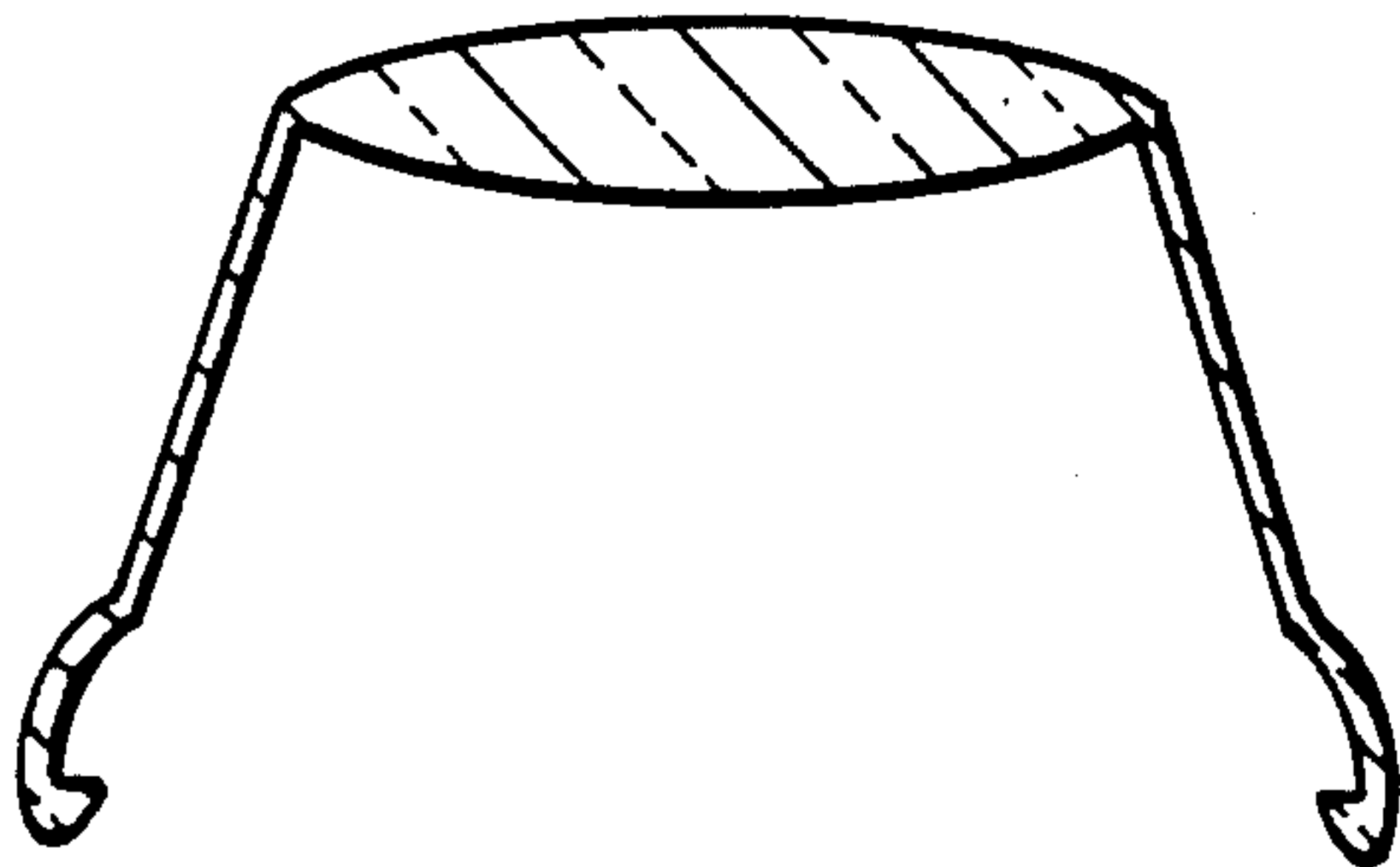
