[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for the track light extension arm, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a fragmentary top perspective view of the track light extension arm showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof as seen along line 2—2 in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a fragmentary bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a fragmentary elevational view of the side opposite the side shown in FIG. 2; FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively left and right end elevational views thereof; FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 1.

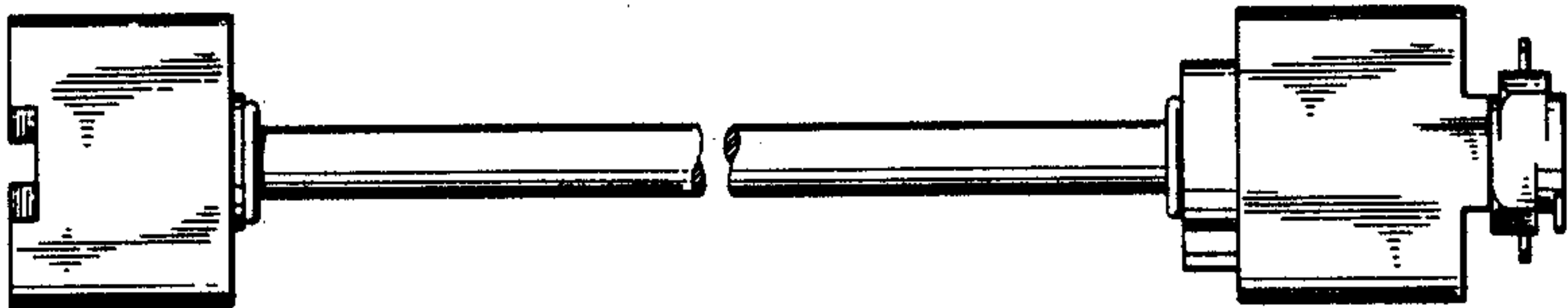

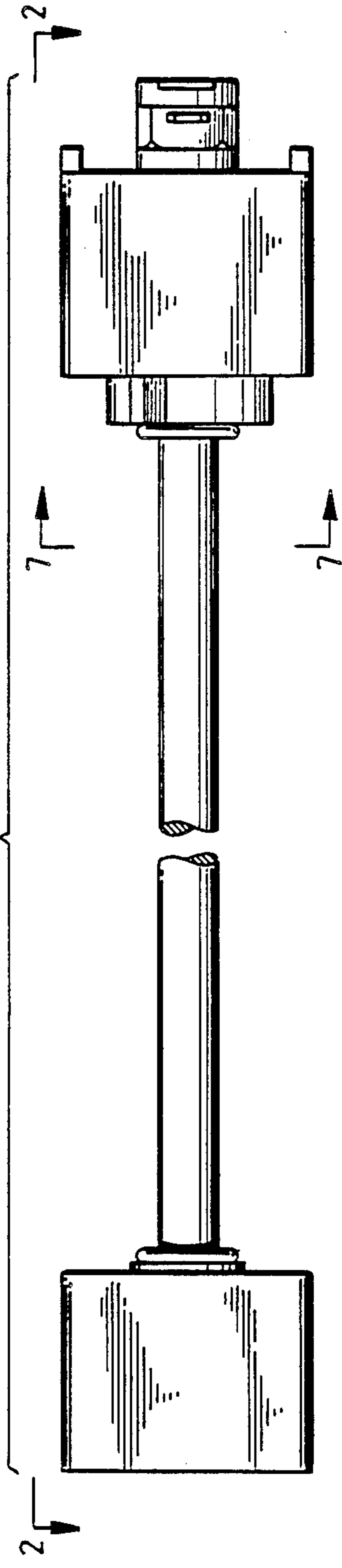

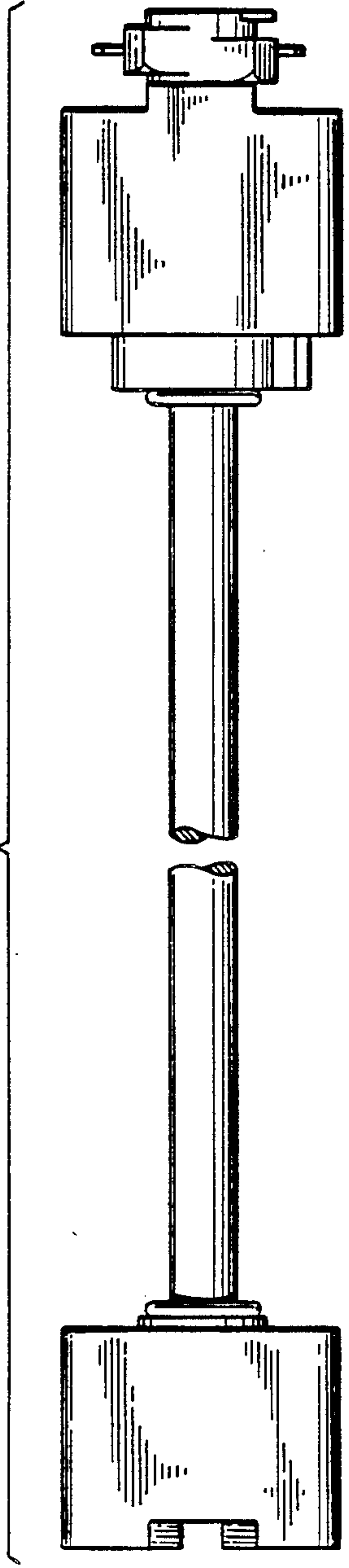

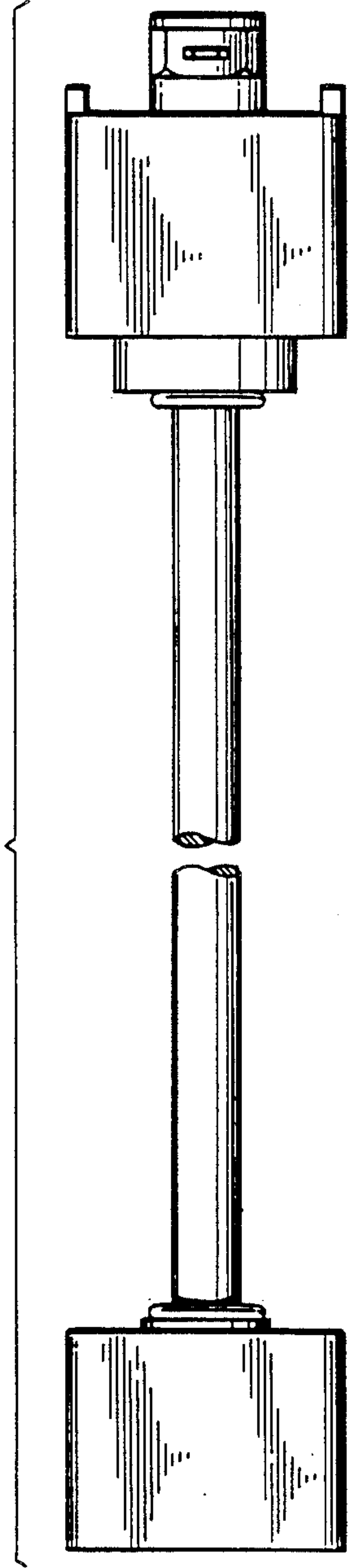

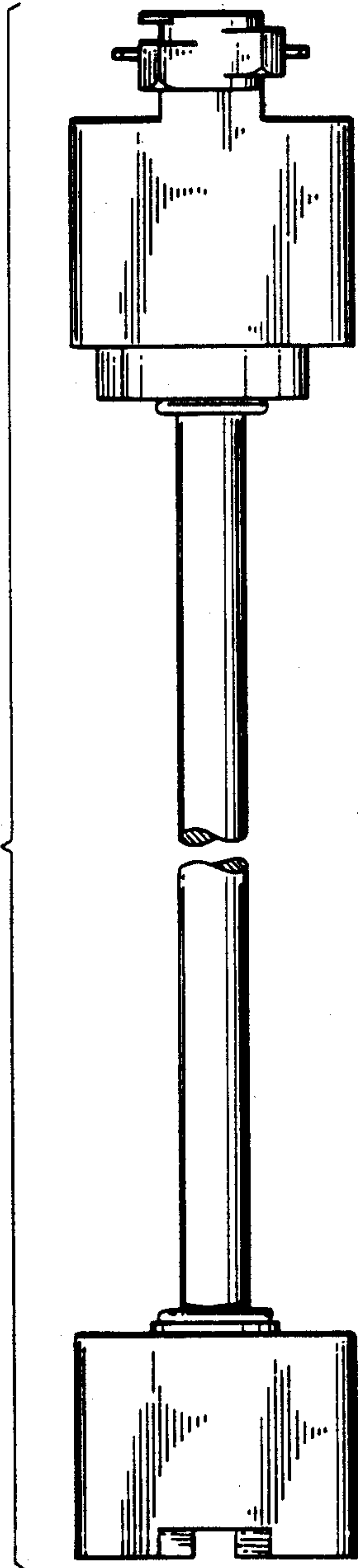

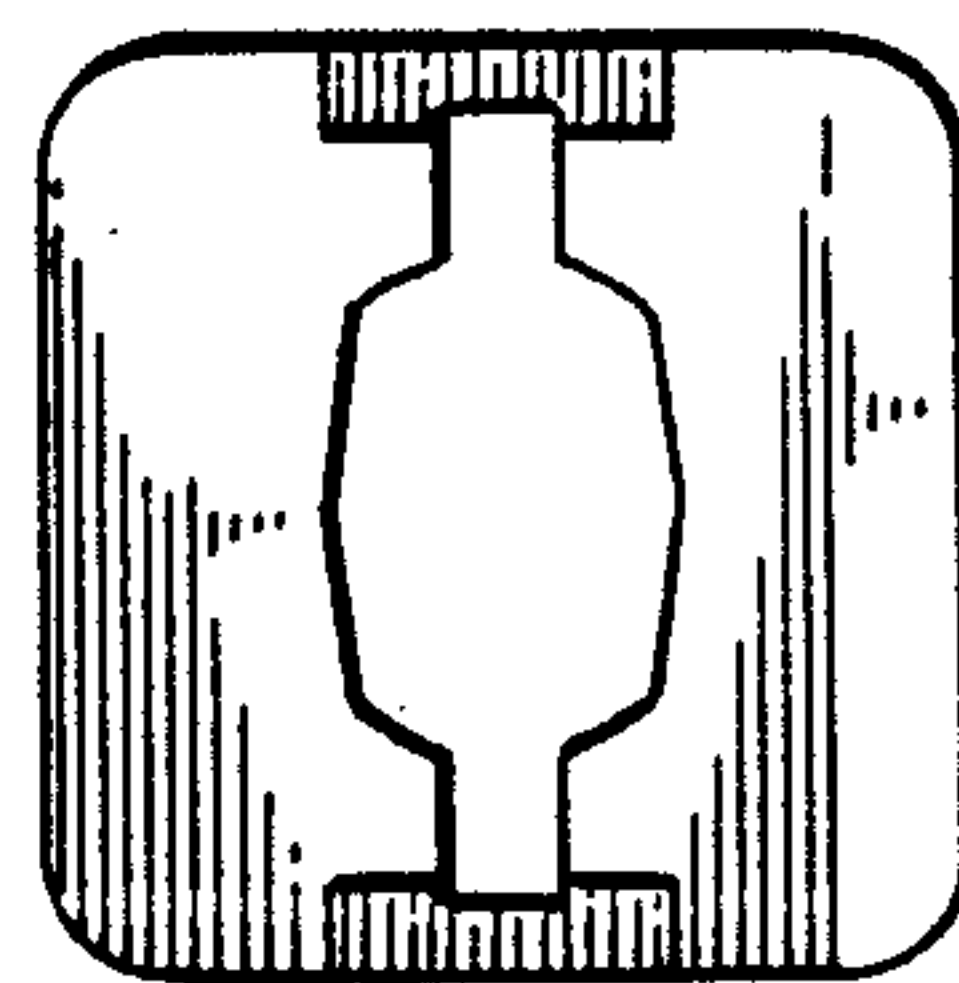

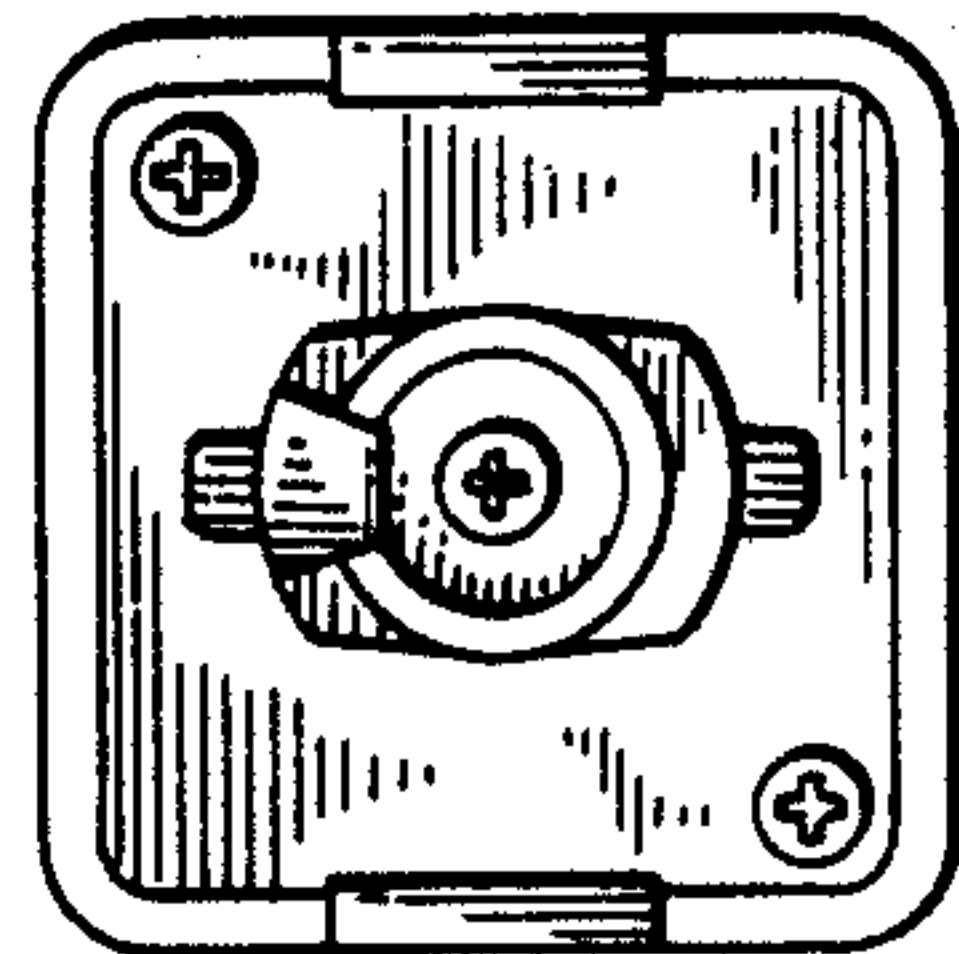
