DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a frame for an adjustable chaise, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and
 FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 1.
