[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a silk screen stencil decoration for a plate or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a top plan view of my new design for a silk screen stencil decoration for a plate or similar article, the fragmentary broken line showing of a plate being illustrative of environmental structure only. The stencil decoration is of no substantial thickness.
