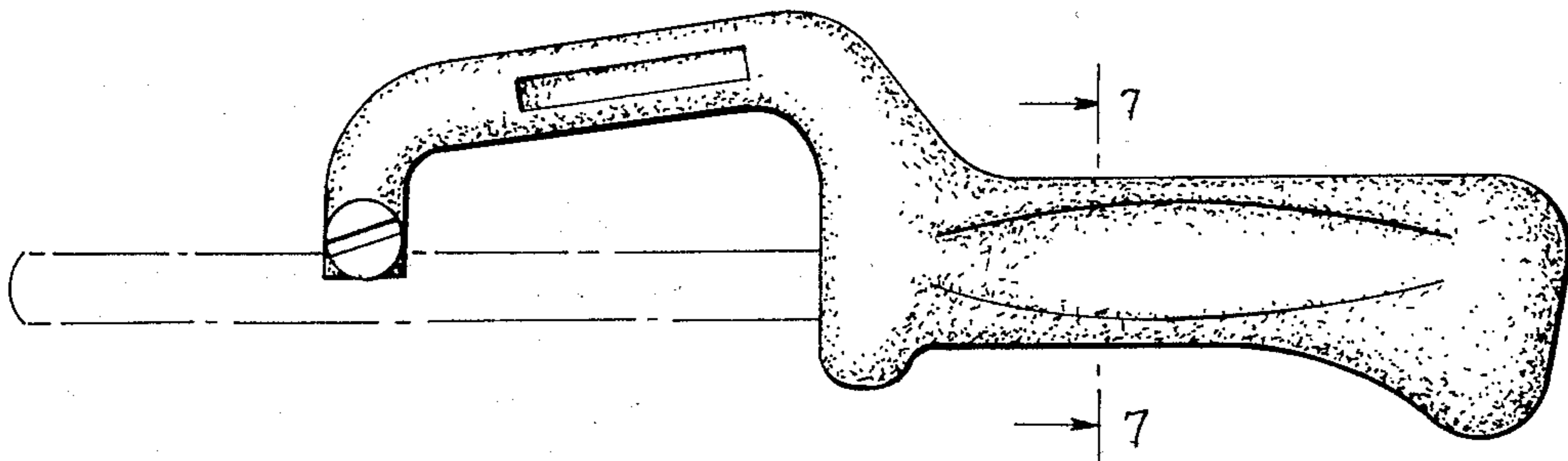

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hacksaw for hand use, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the hacksaw for hand use showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 1 and showing the central, concave portion of the handle only.
 The saw blade is shown in FIGS. 1, 2, 5 and 6 in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



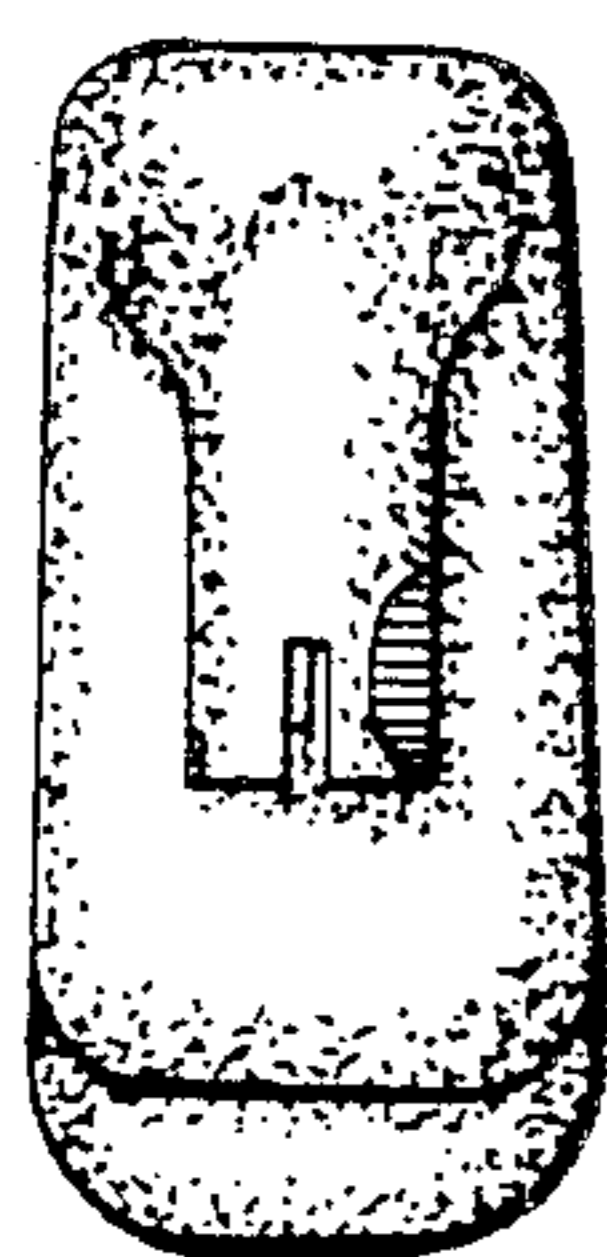
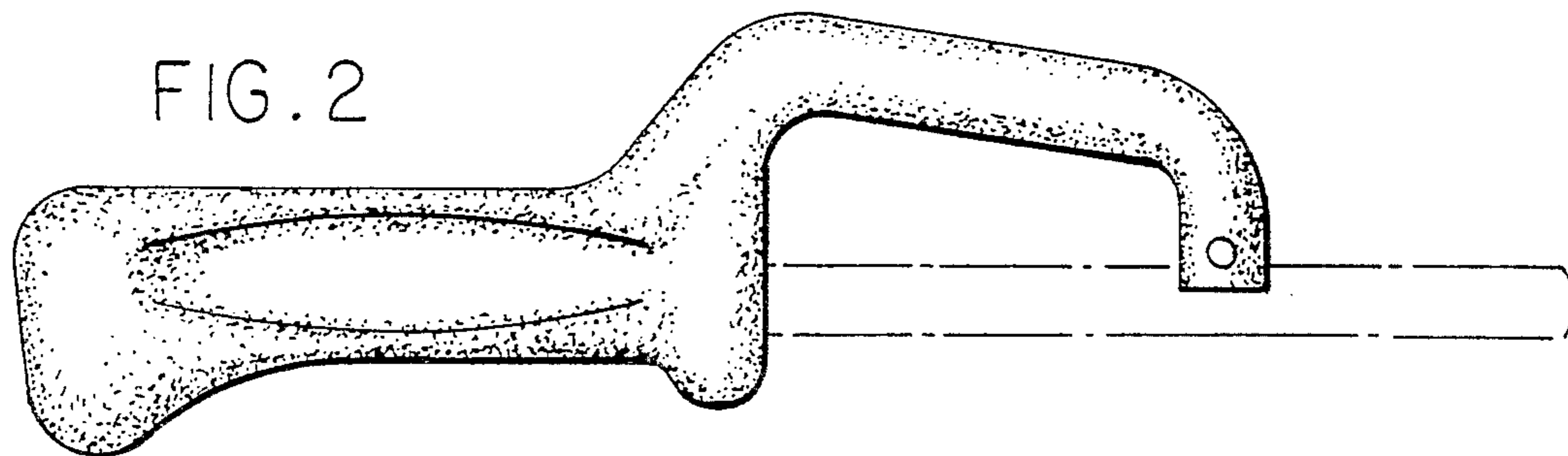
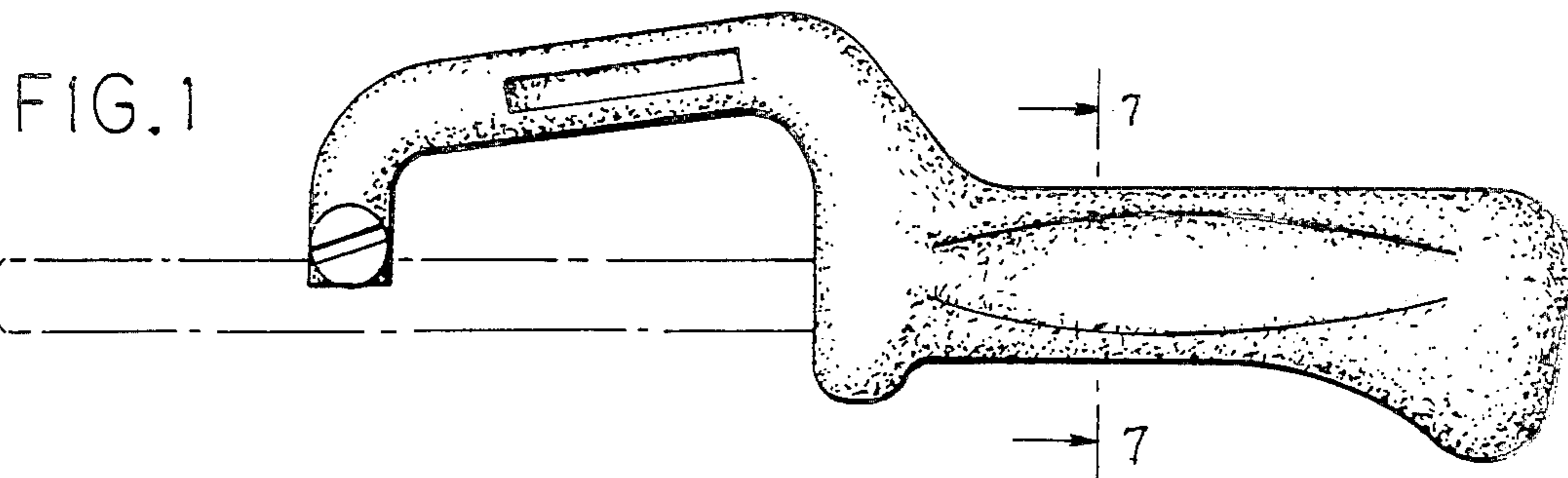

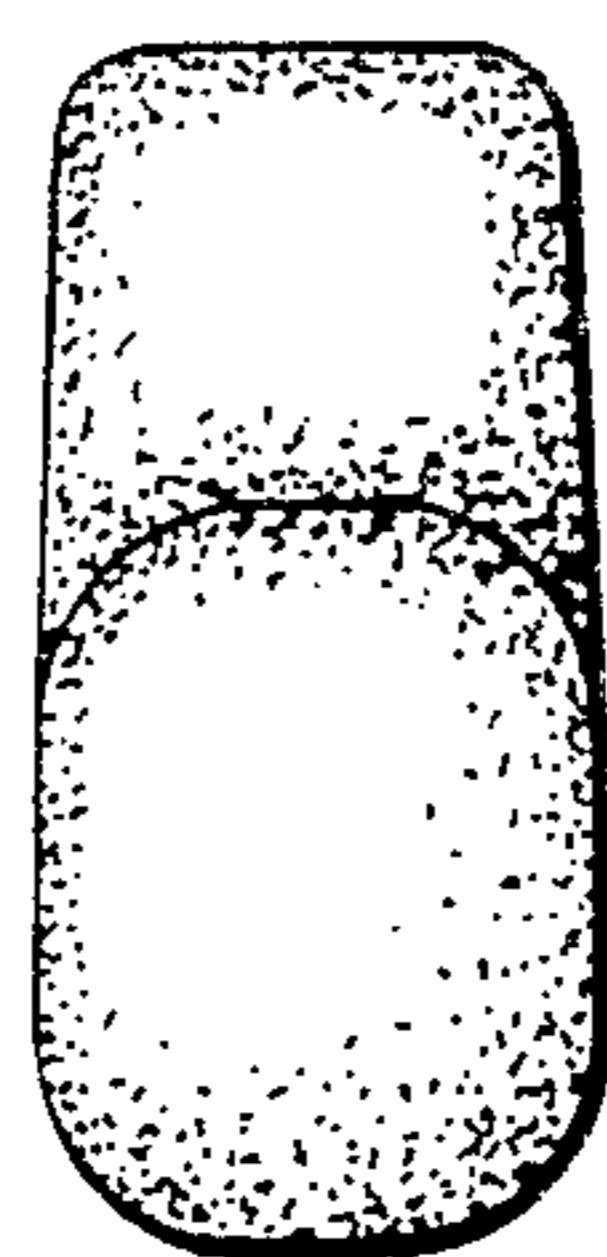

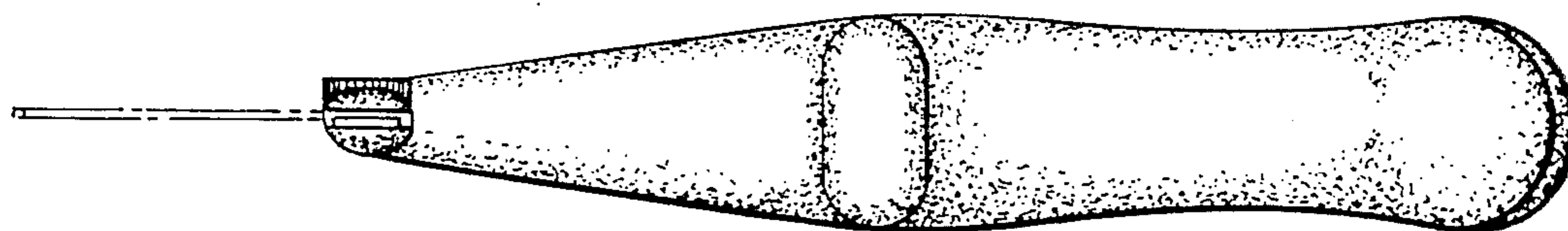
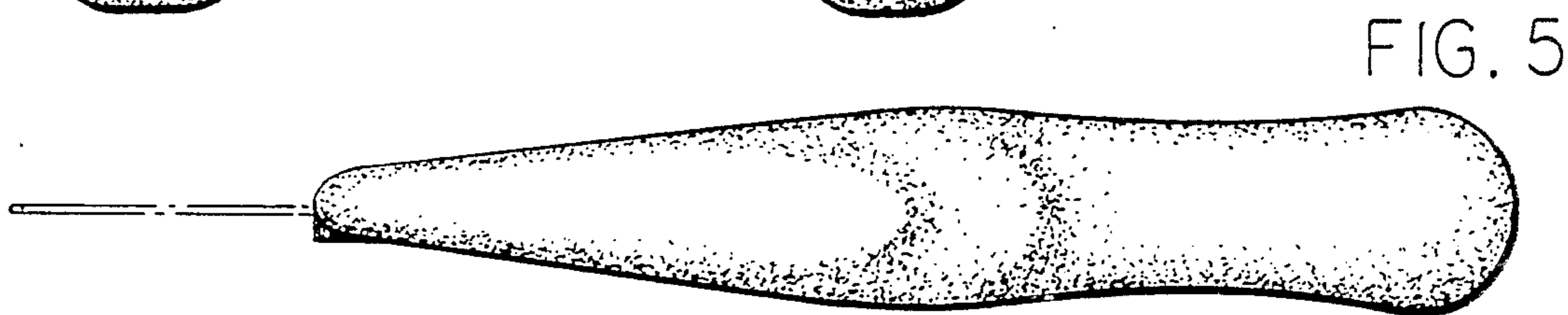

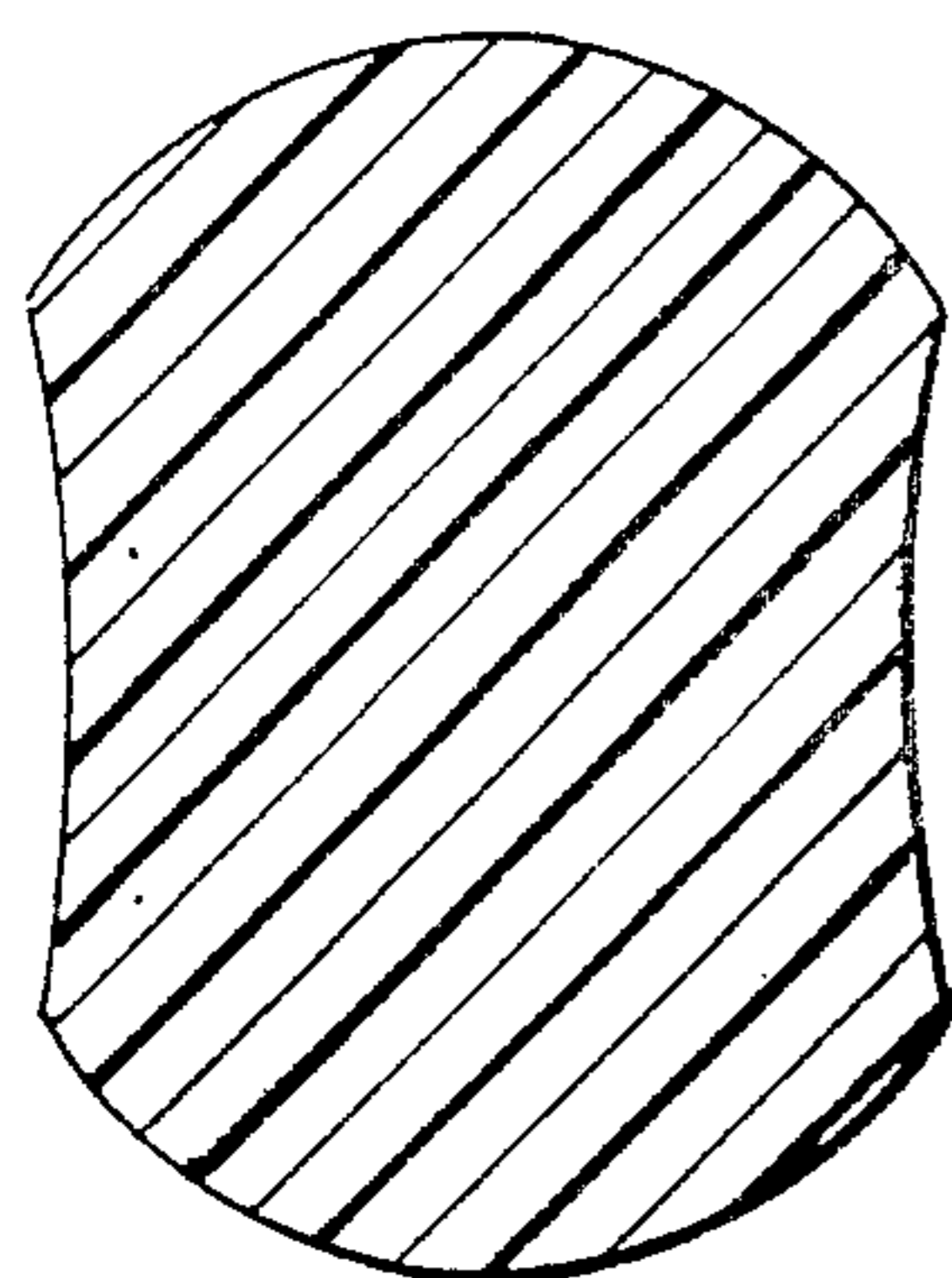
