[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of toilet seat cover, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toilet seat cover showing my new design; and  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The fragmentary broken line representation of a toilet in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.

It is to be understood that the fabric is continuous throughout the area indicated in FIGS. 1 and 2.

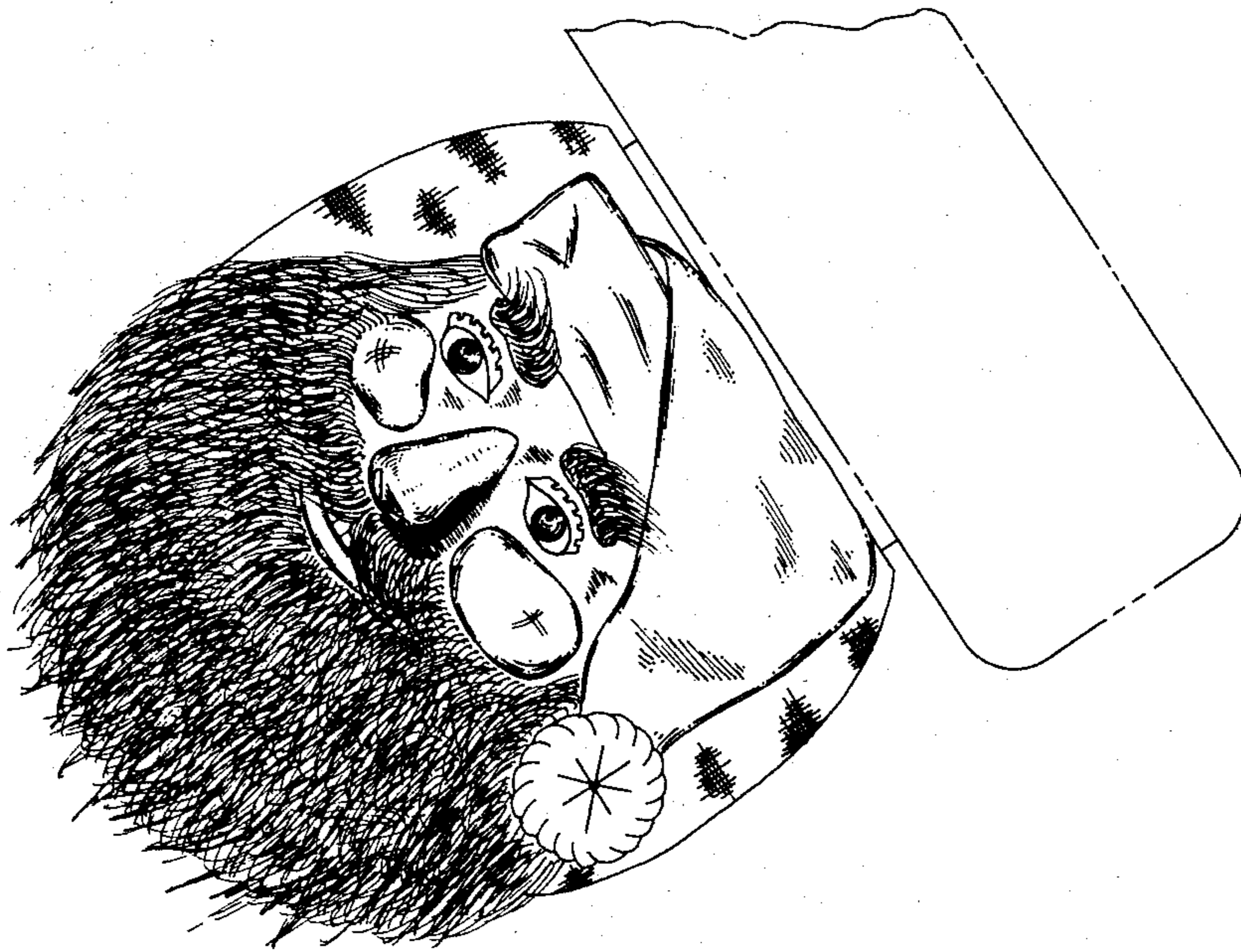

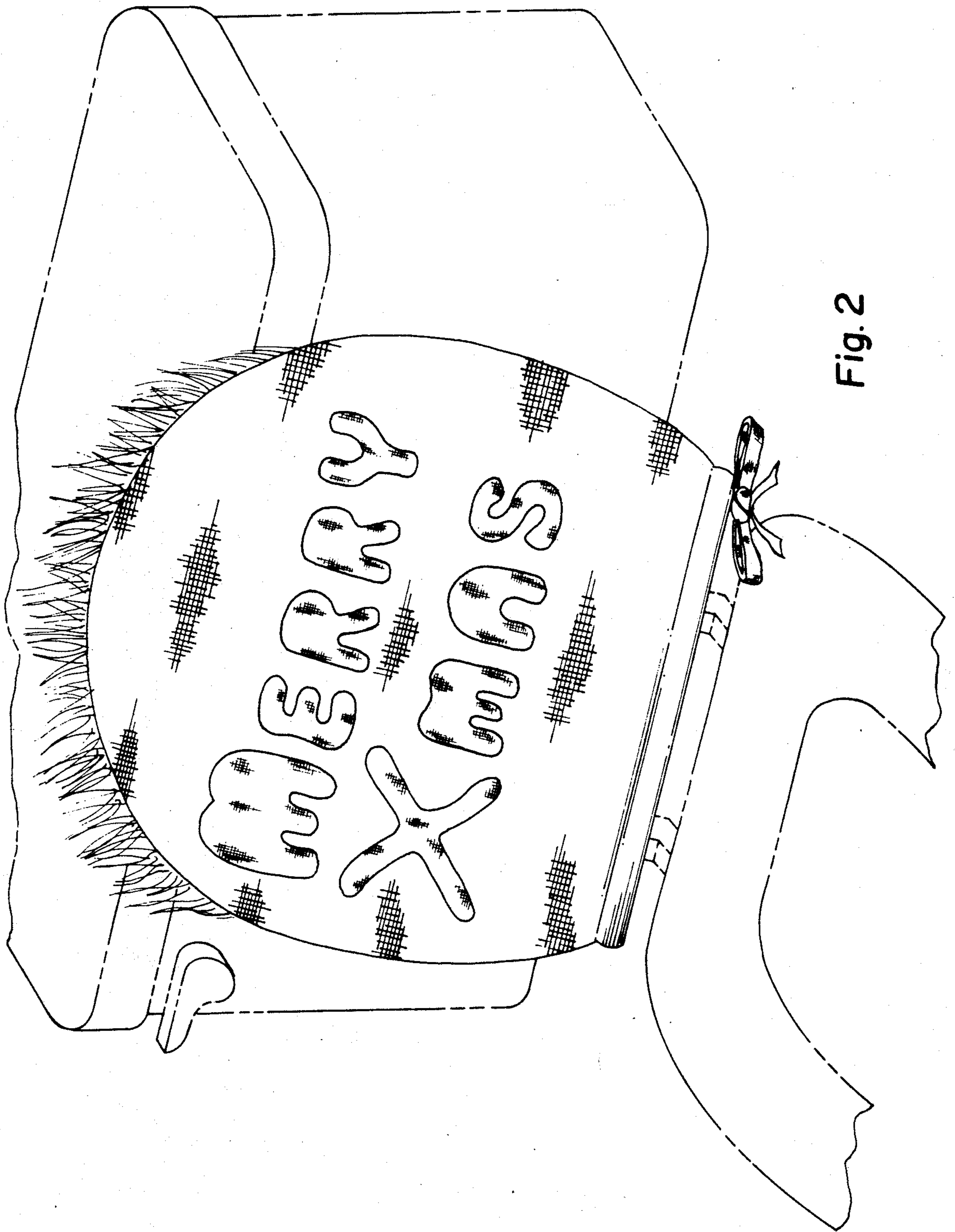
