The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the top, front and left side of a first embodiment of a chair showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right side being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

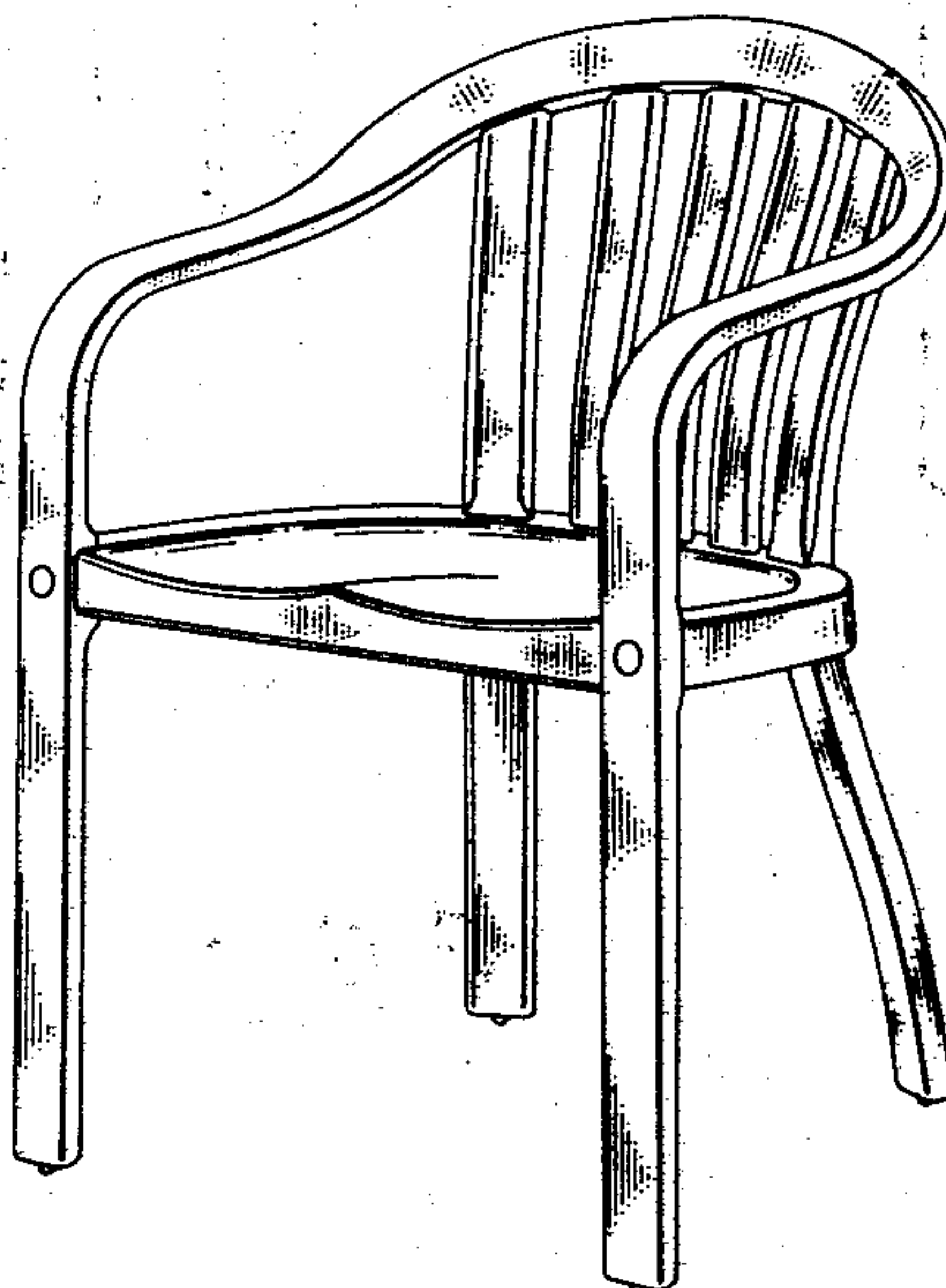
FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view of a chair showing another embodiment of my new design, the right side being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof.



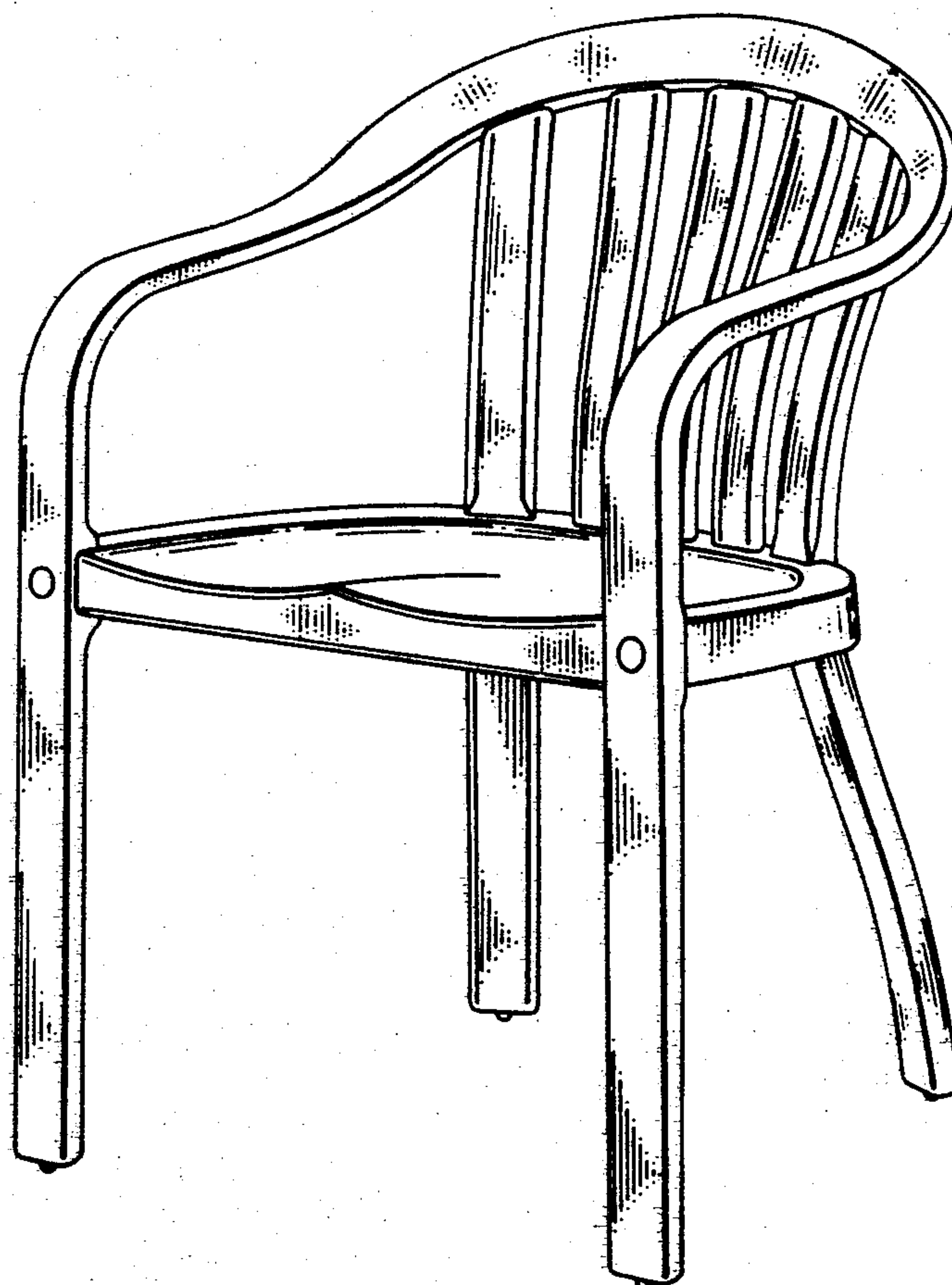

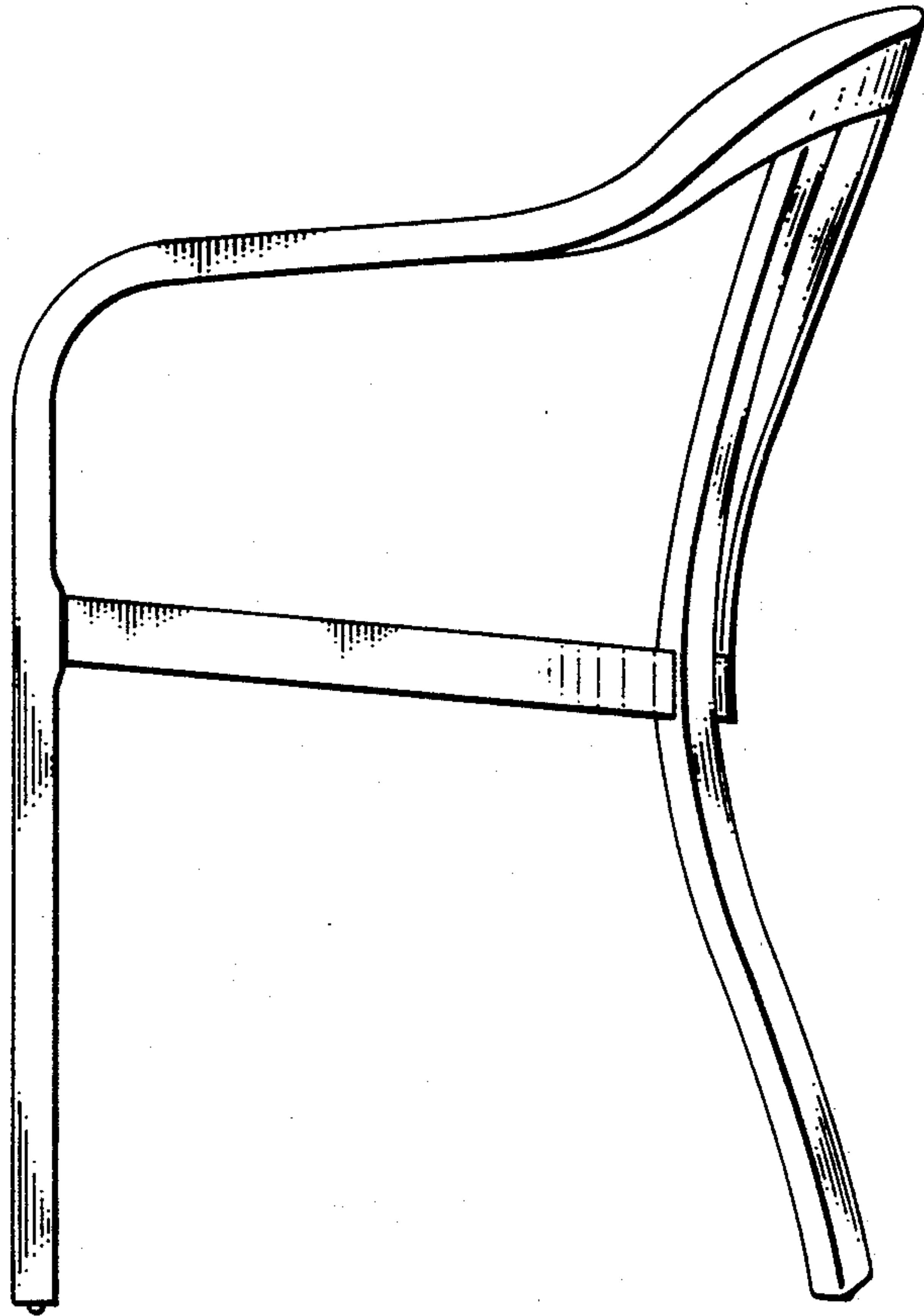
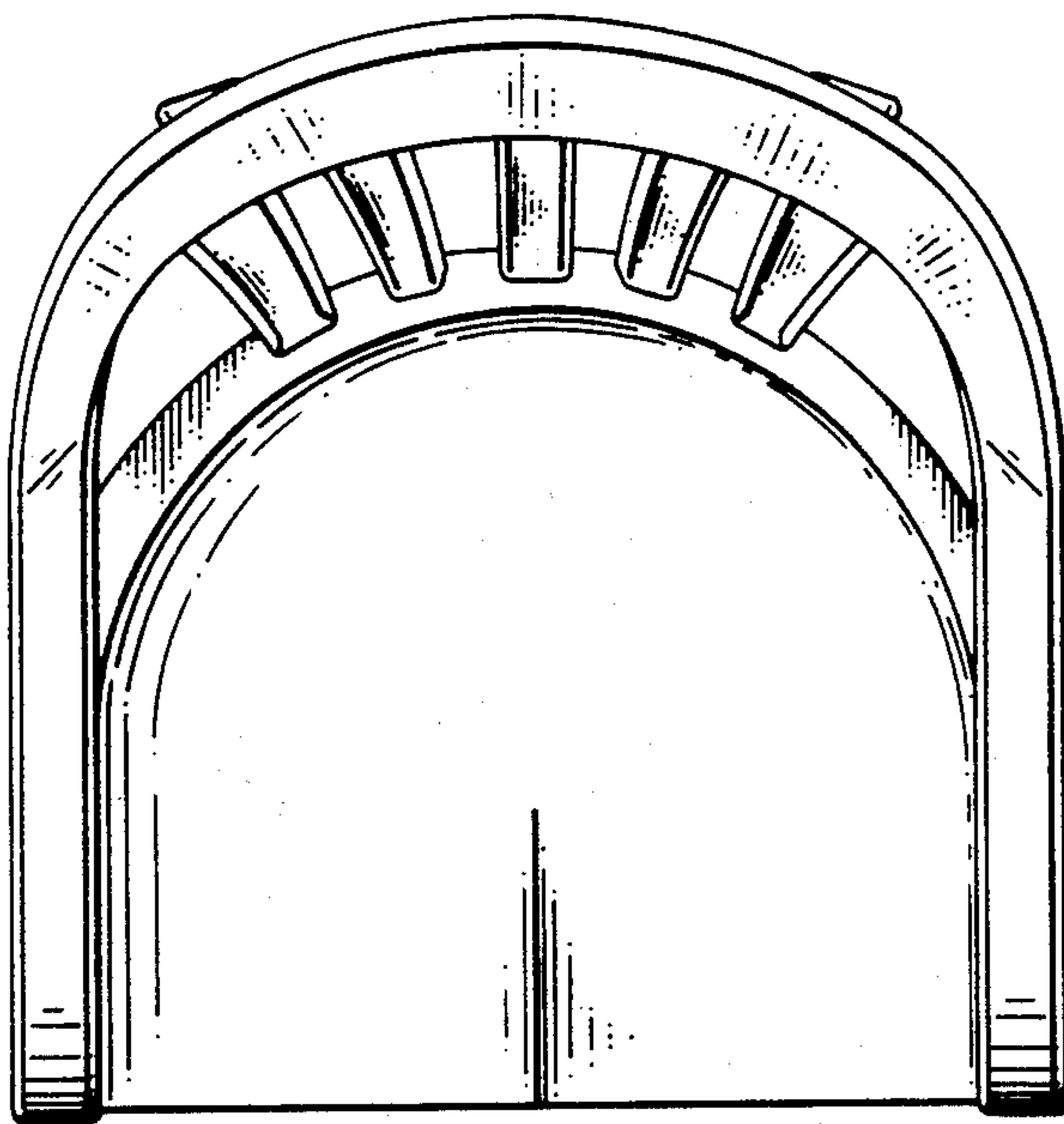

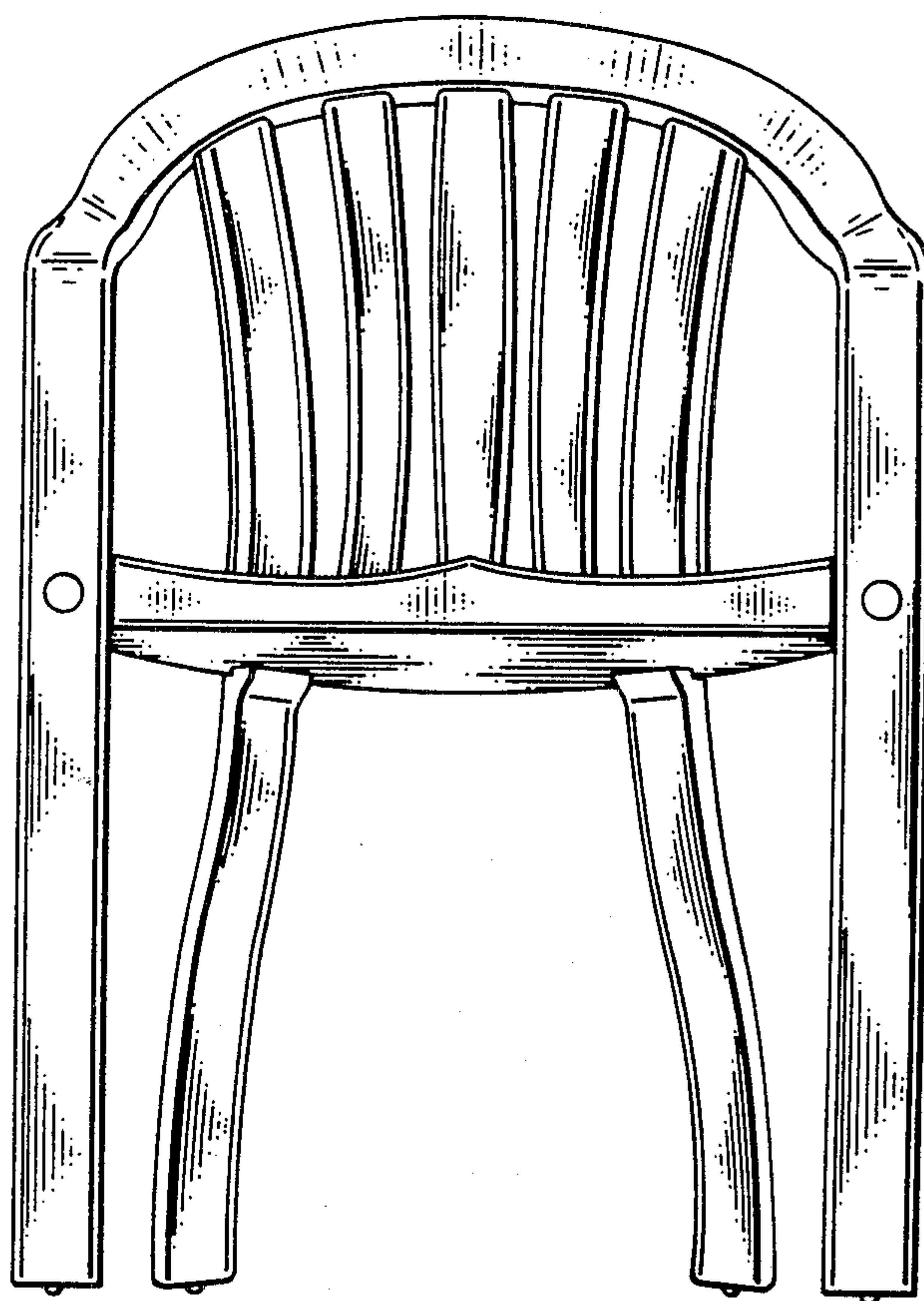

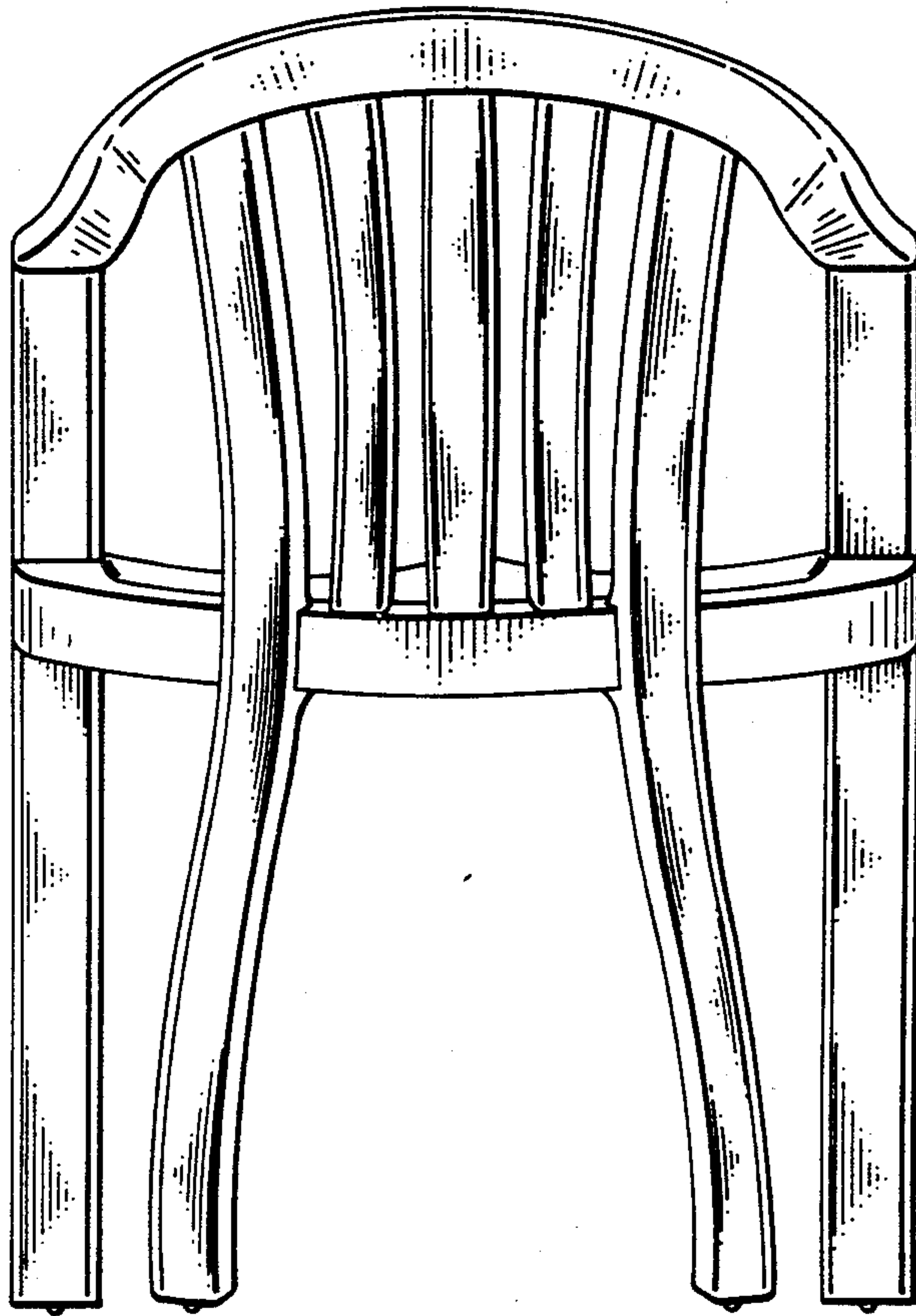

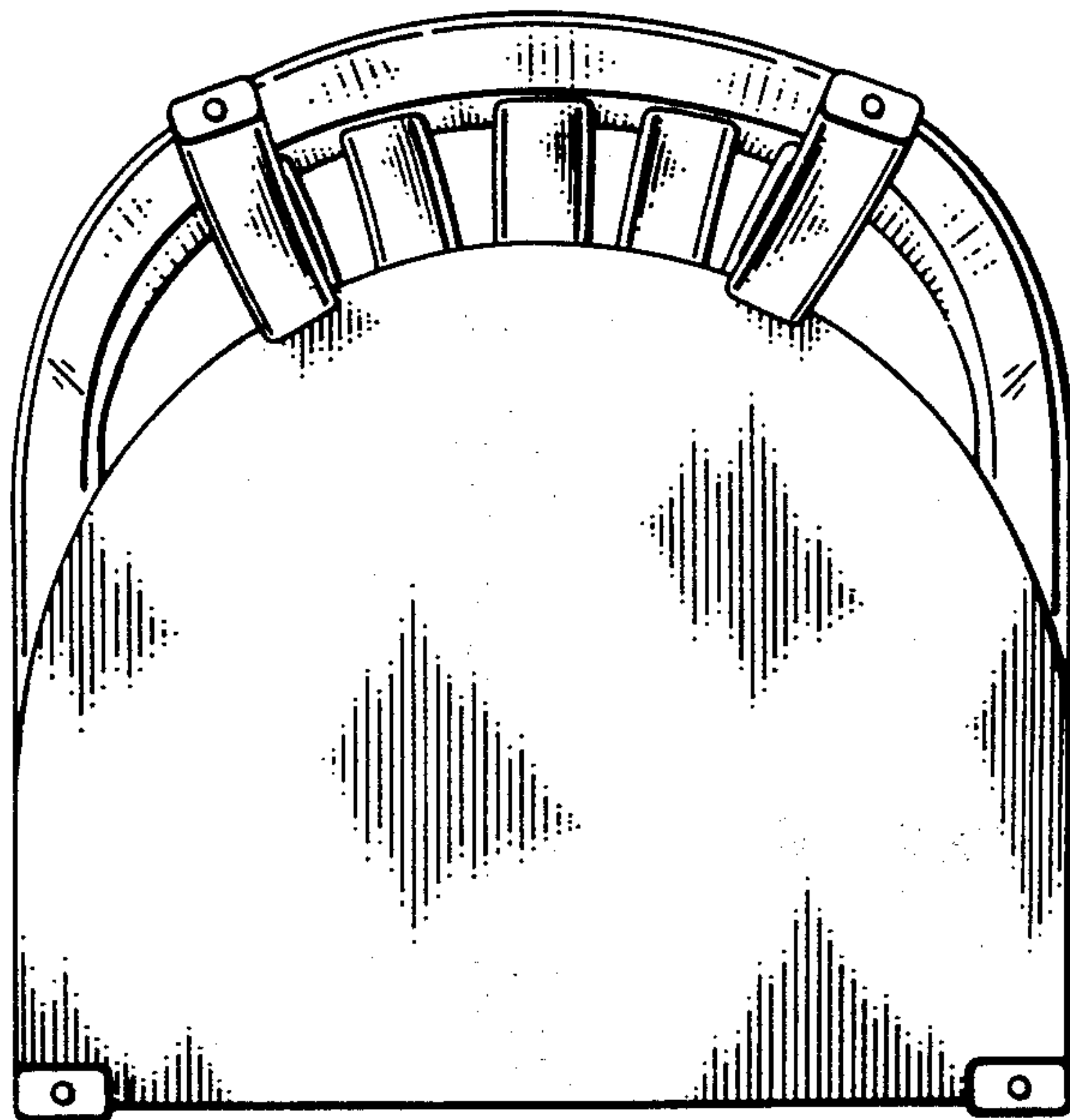

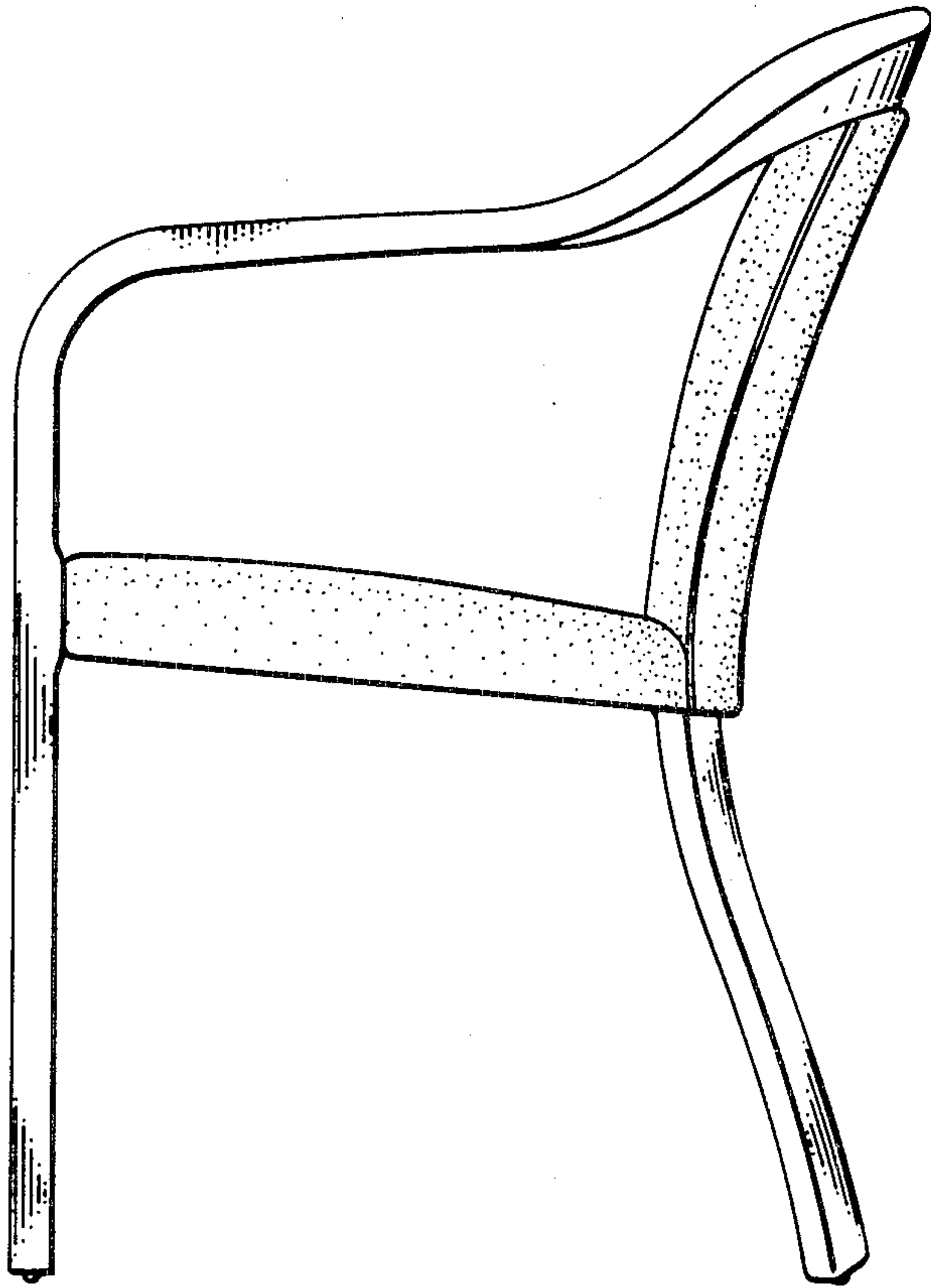
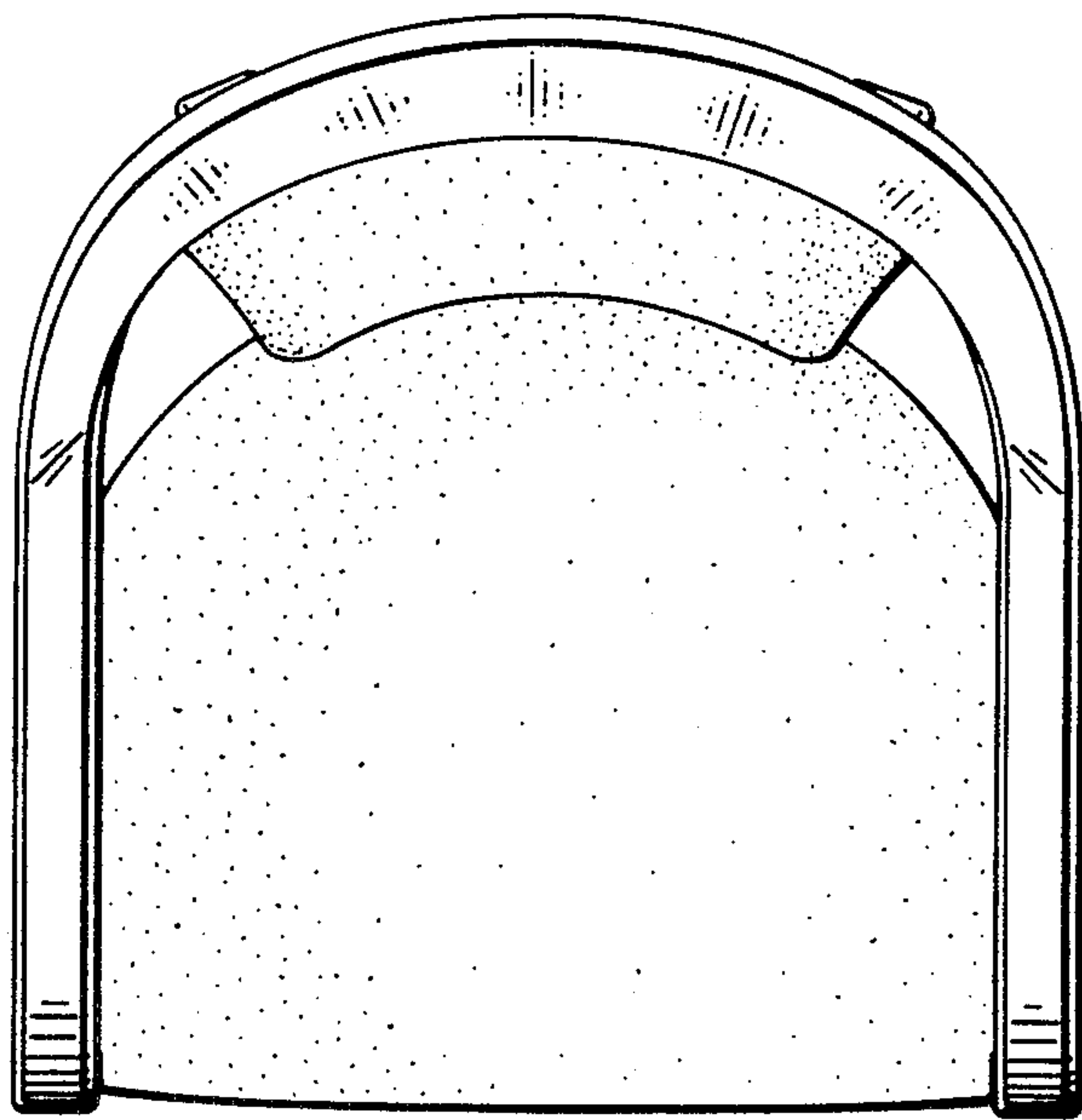

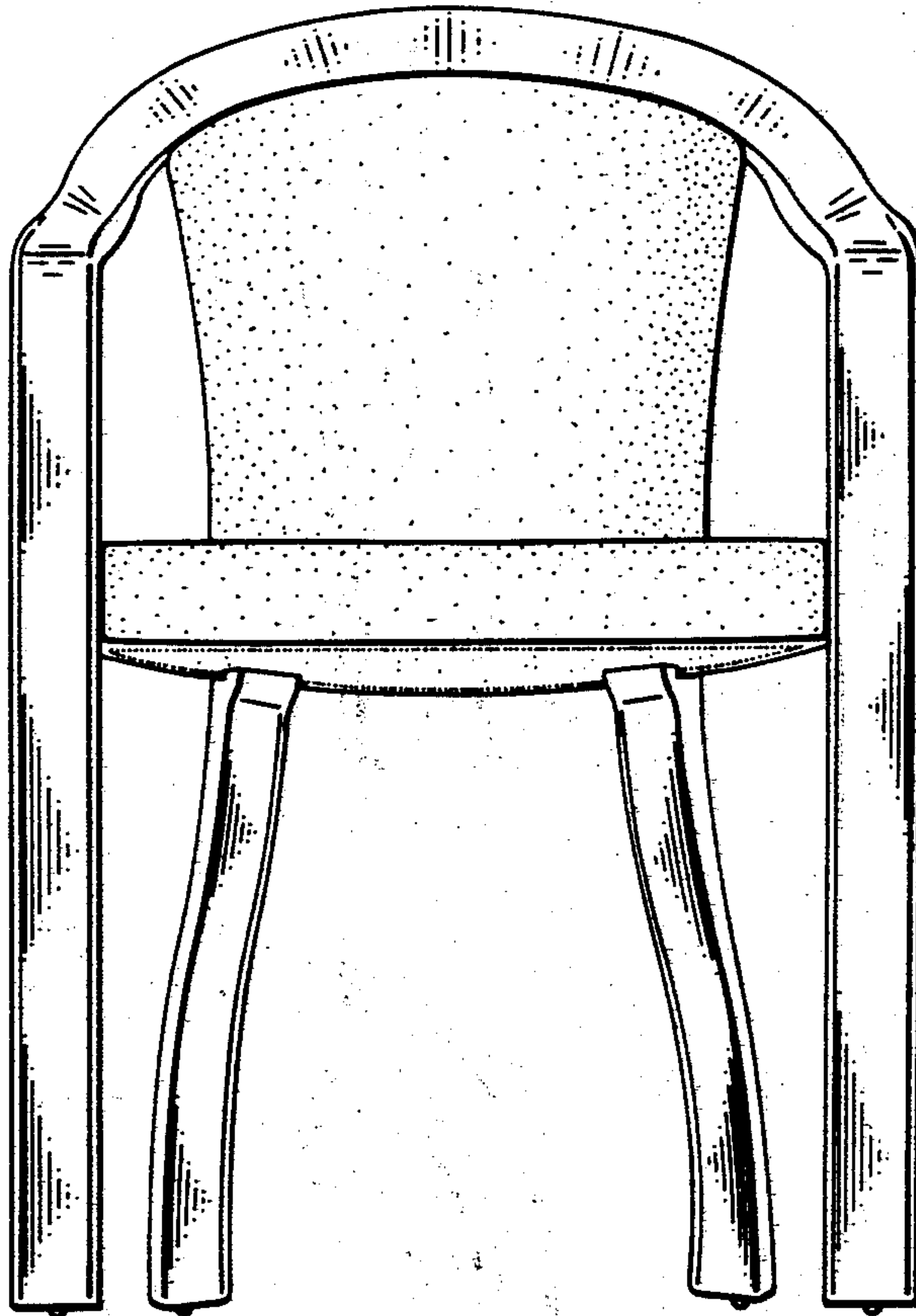

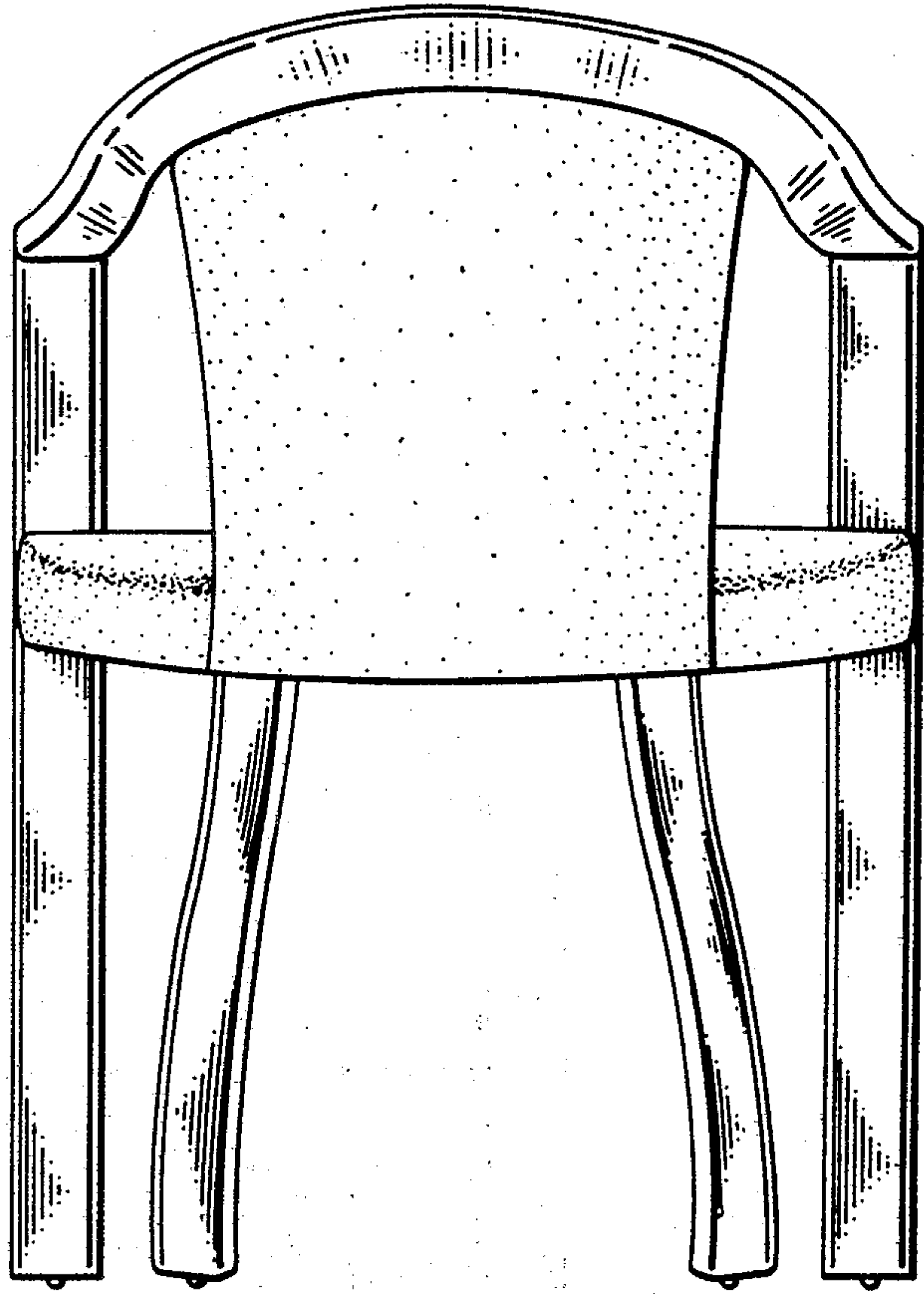
