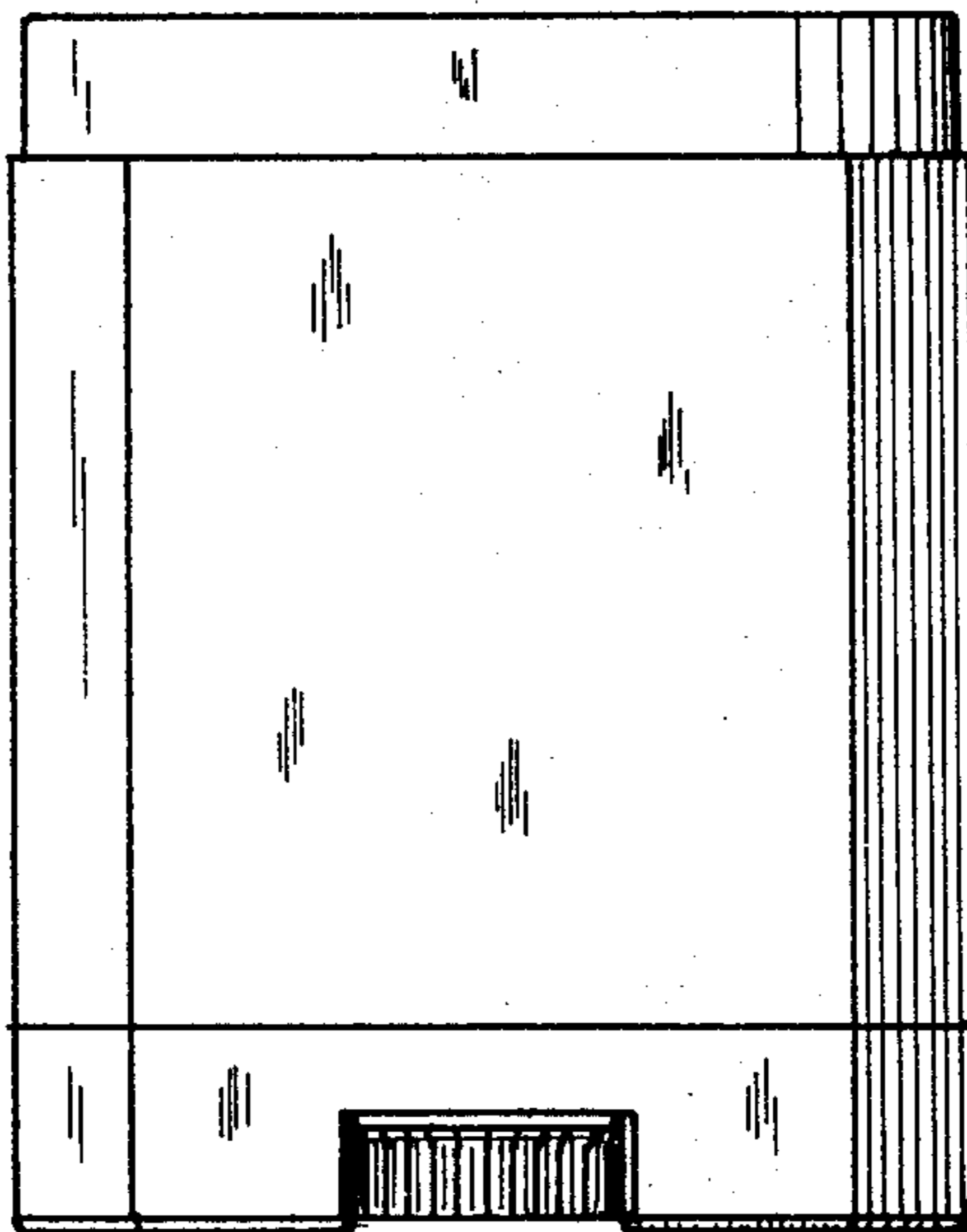

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a dispensing container for a solid stick product, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dispensing container for a solid stick product showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the reverse view being identical to the front;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, looking from the right side, the left side being identical to the right; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view.



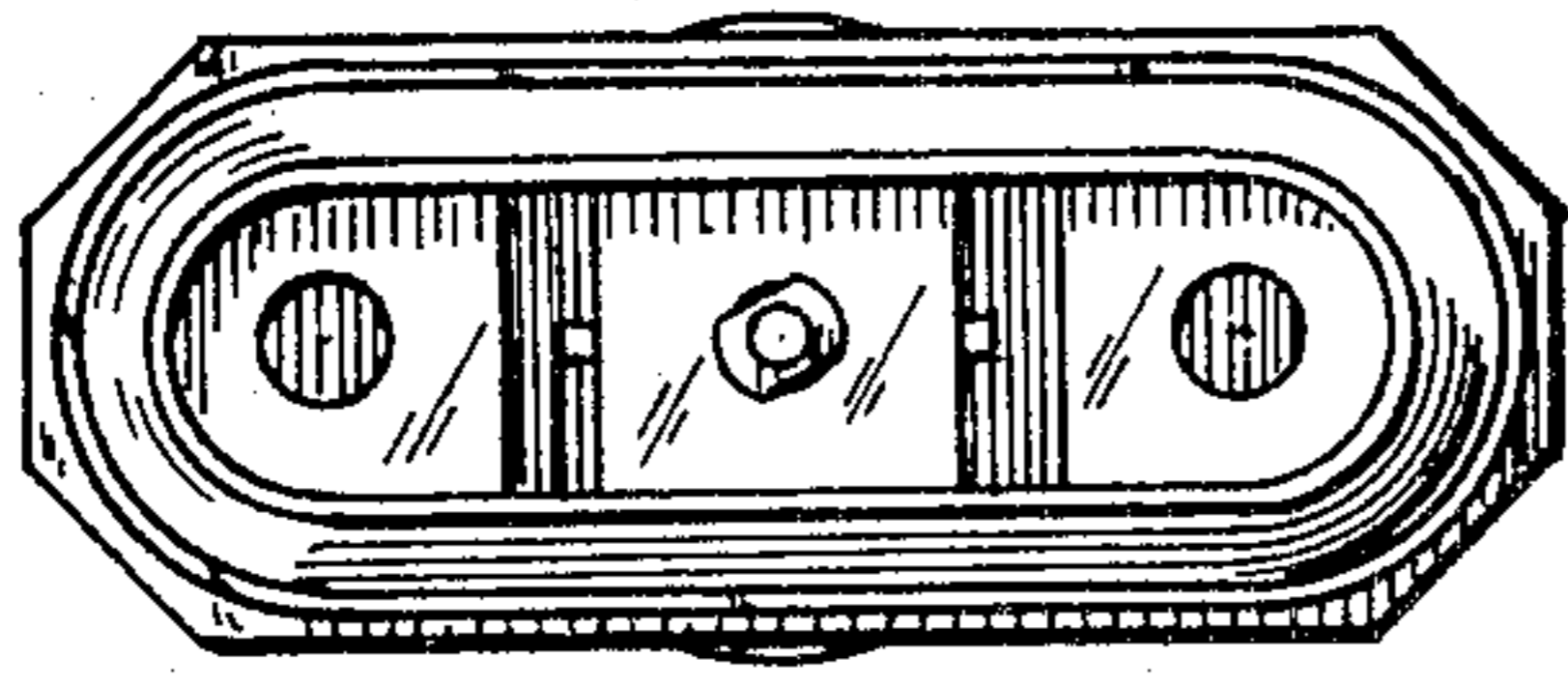

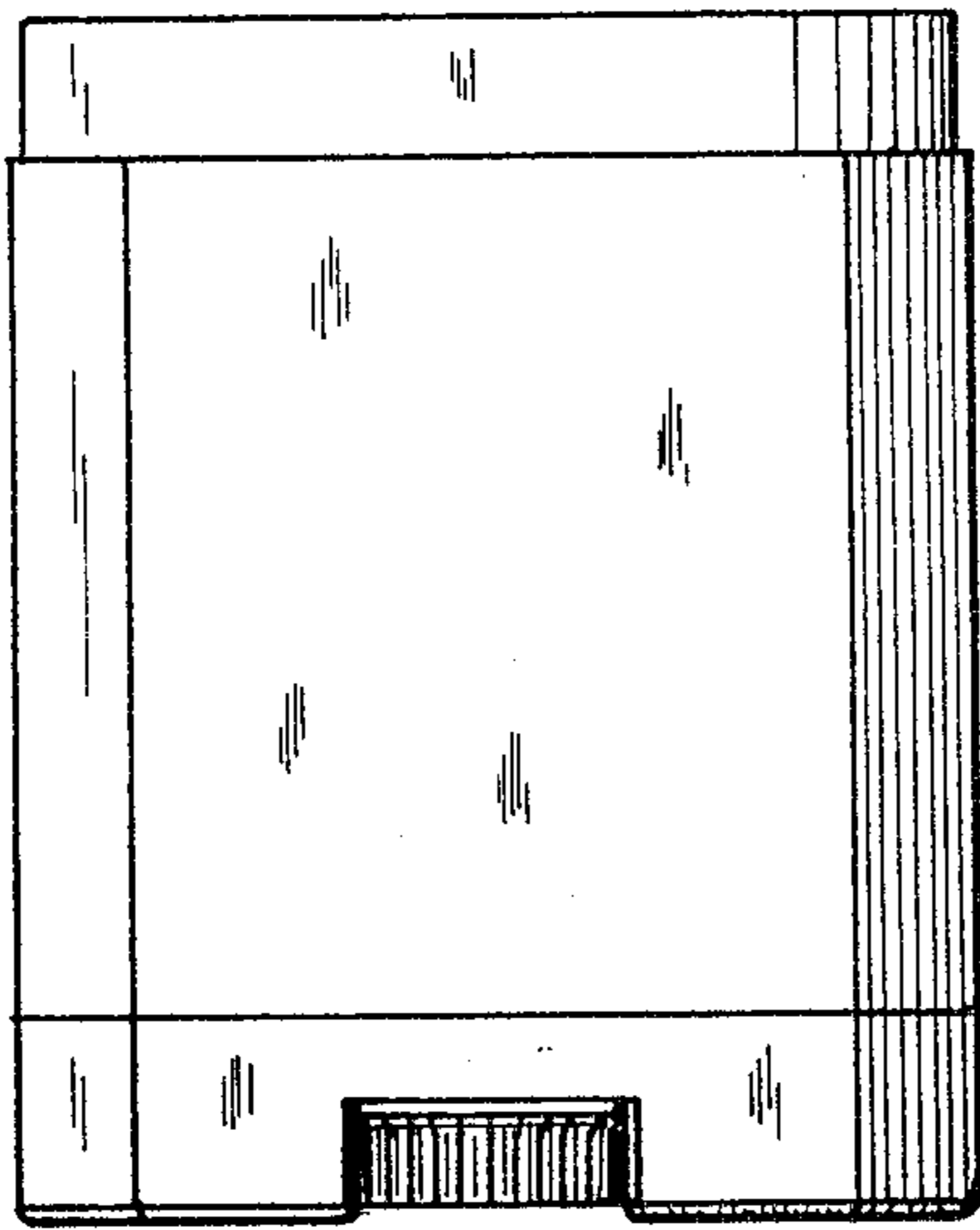

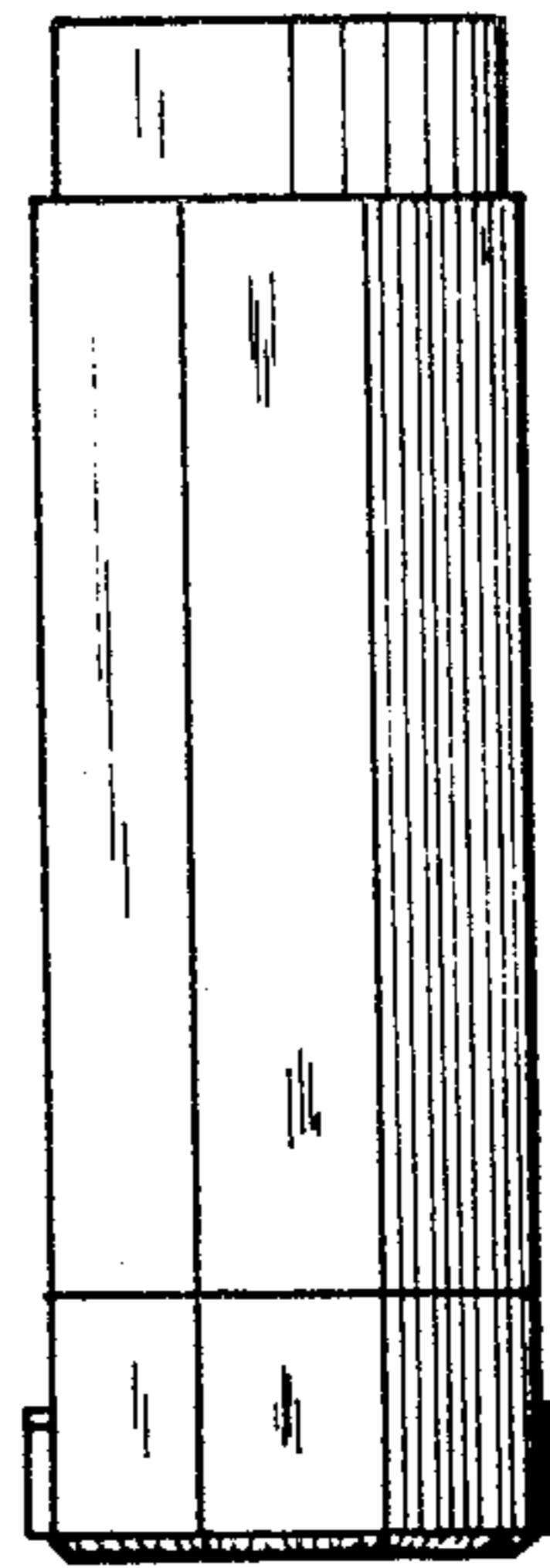

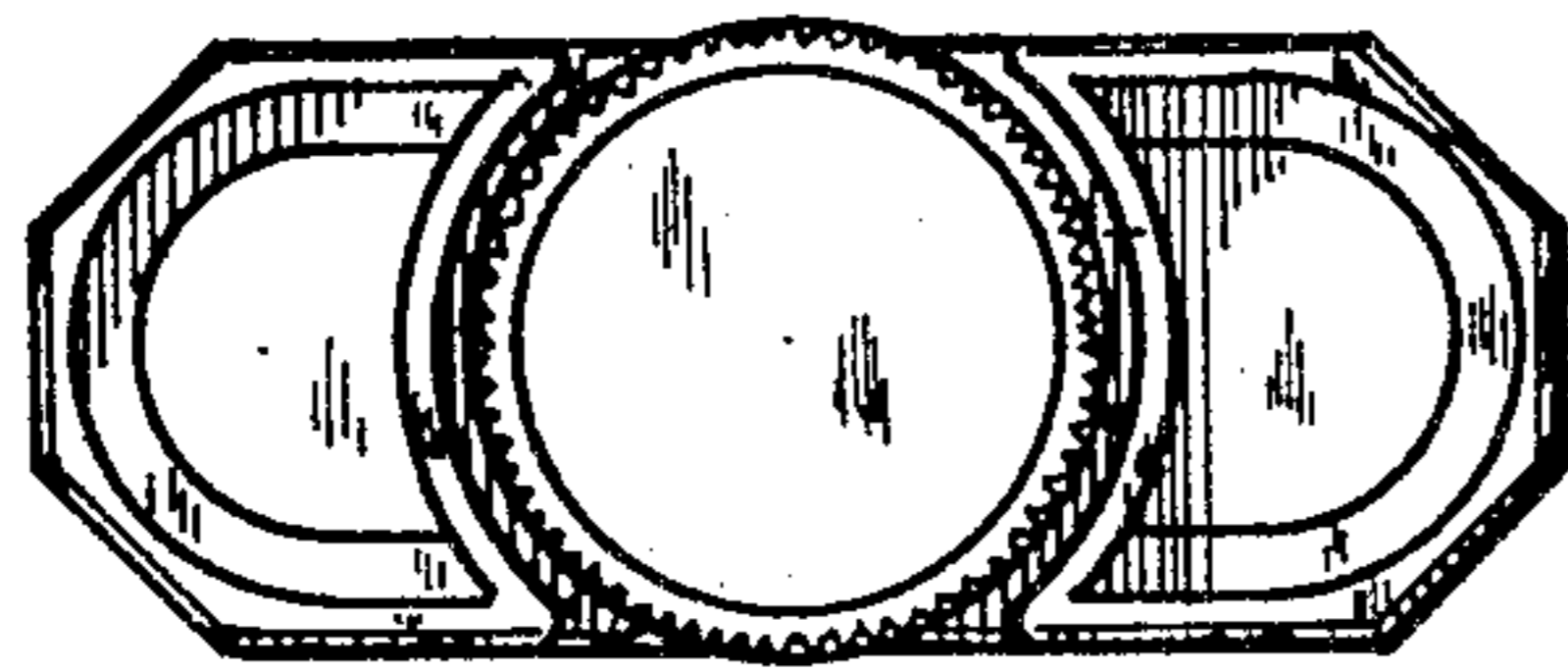
