FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

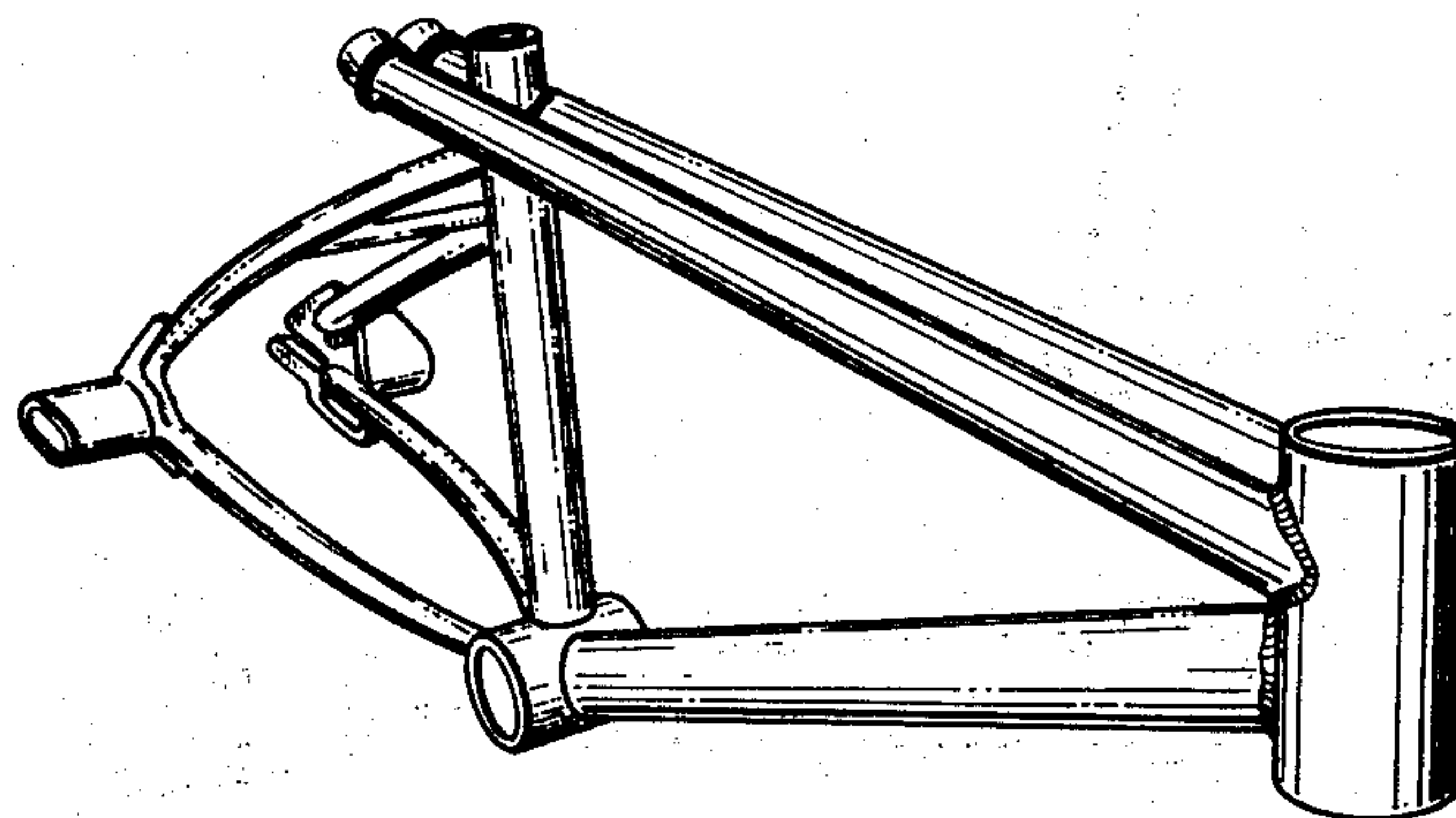
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.



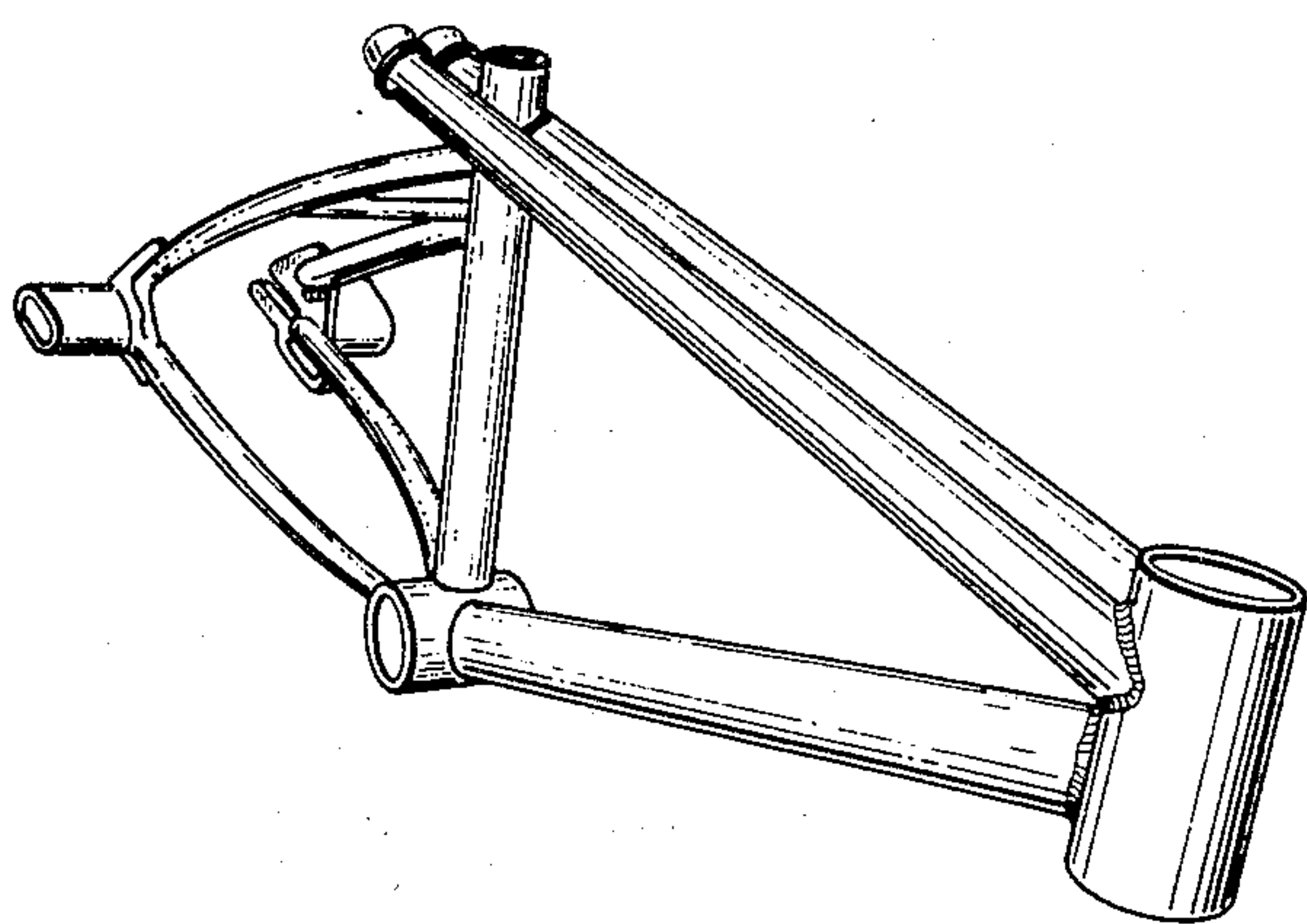

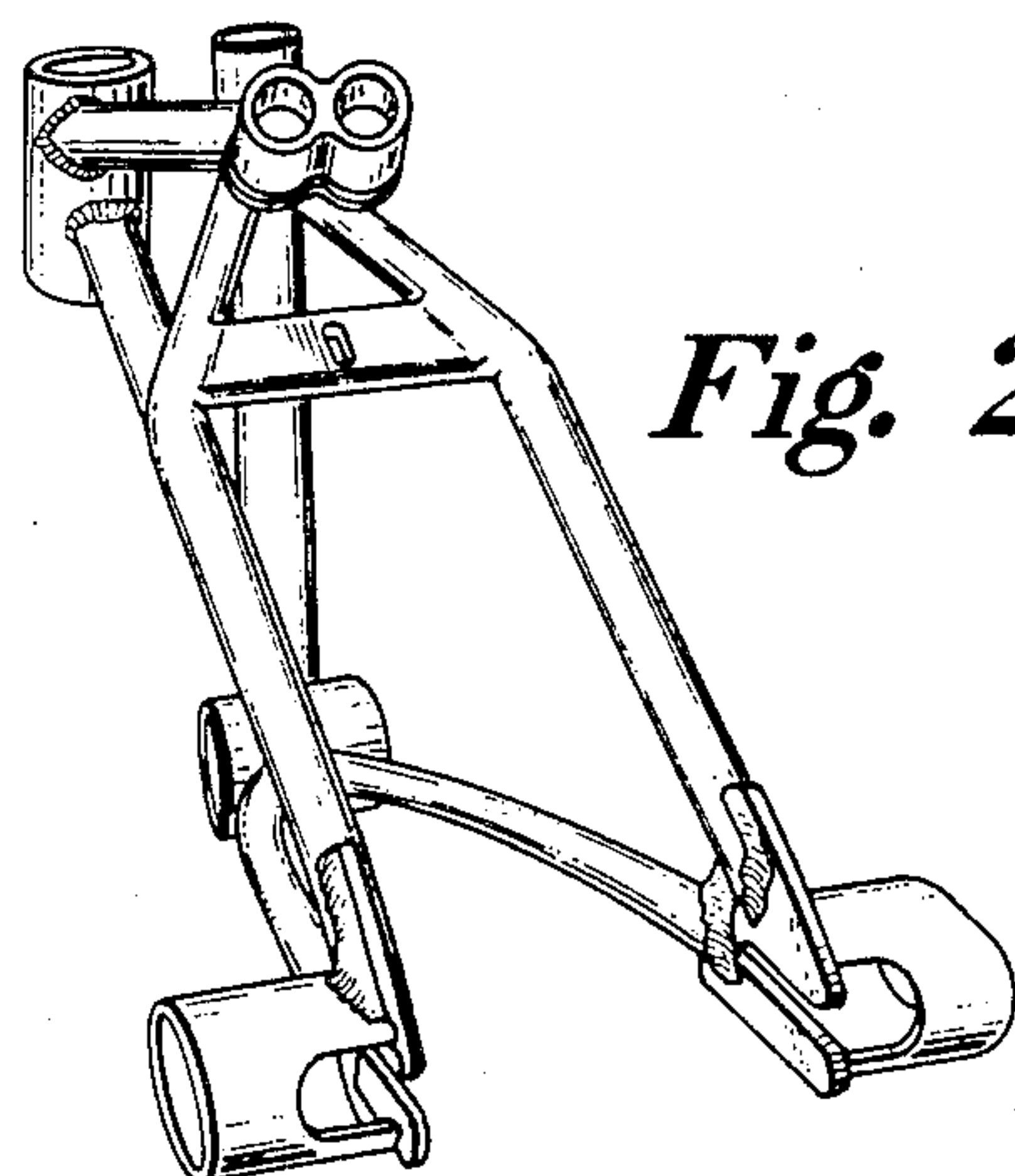

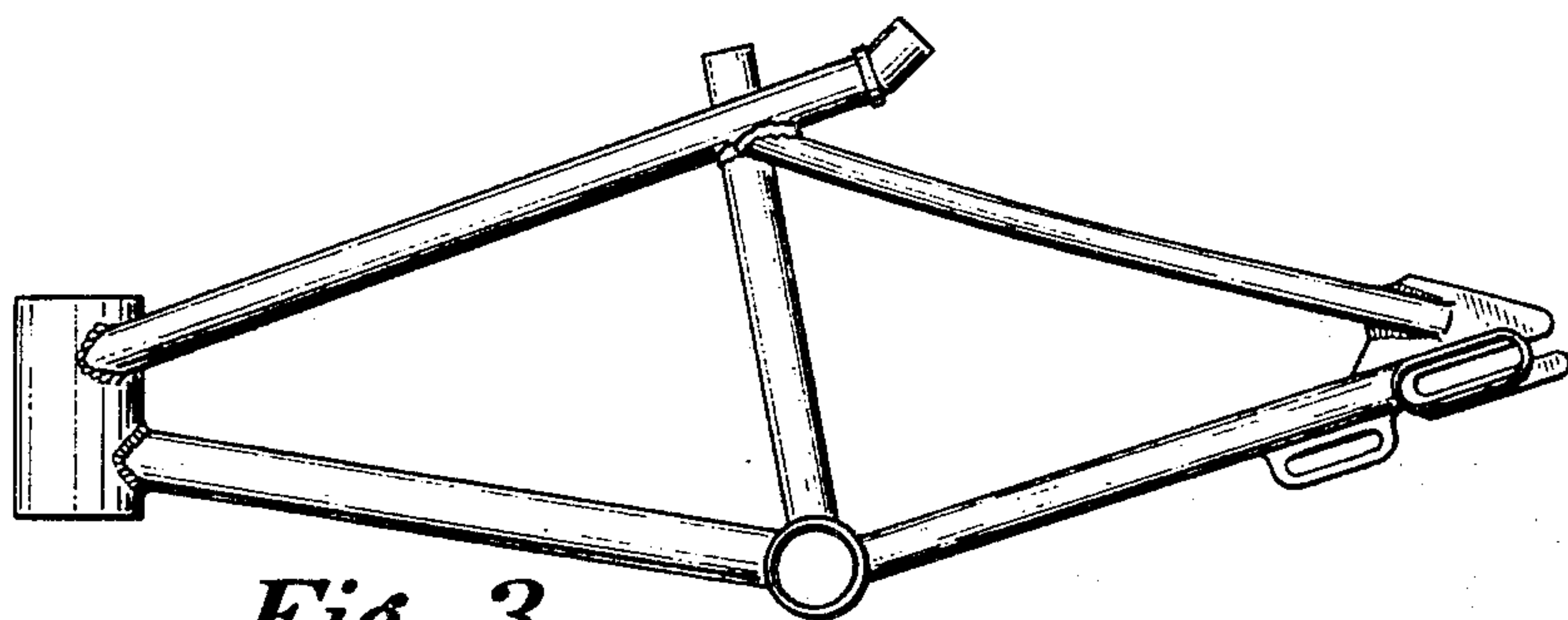

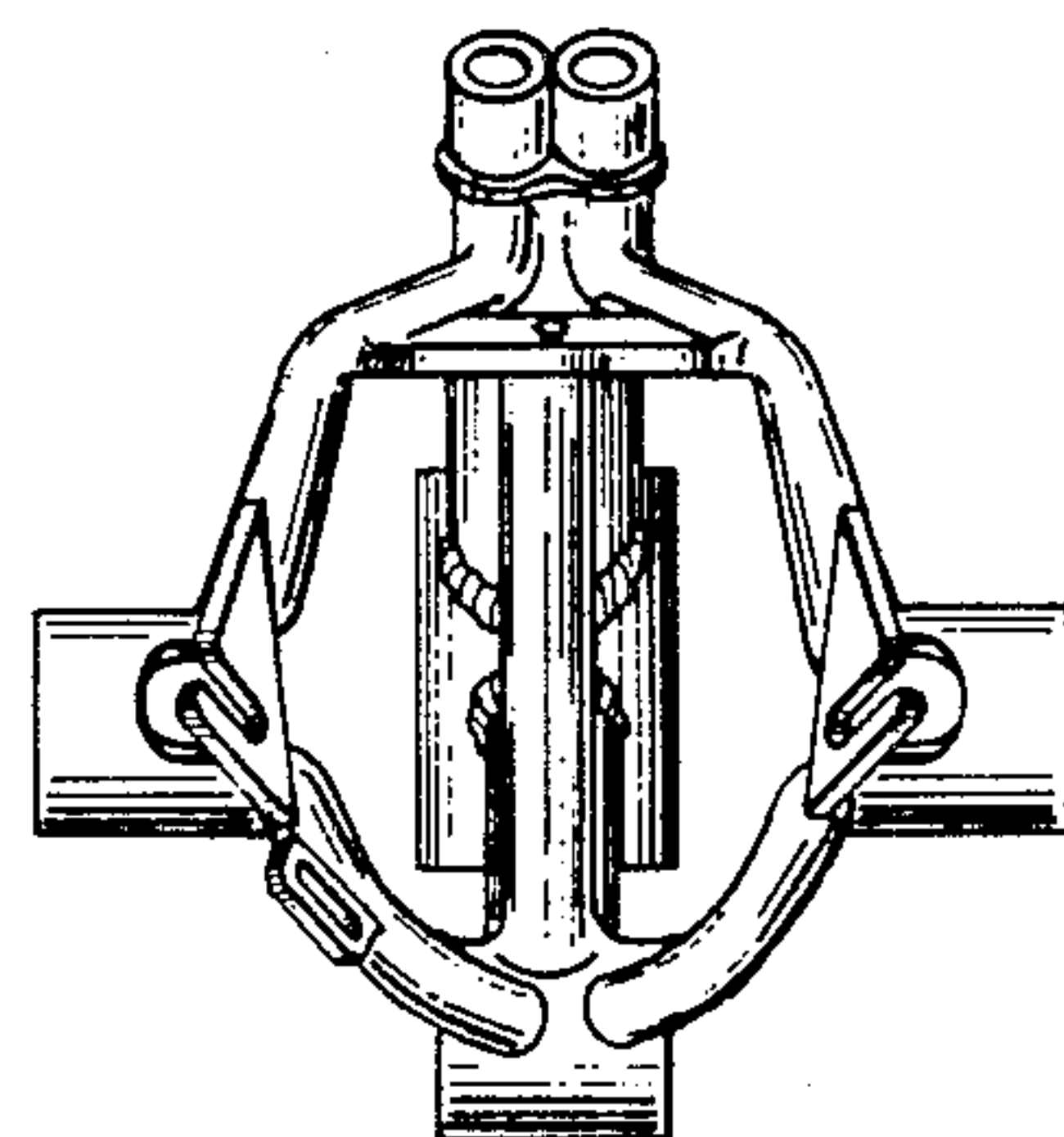

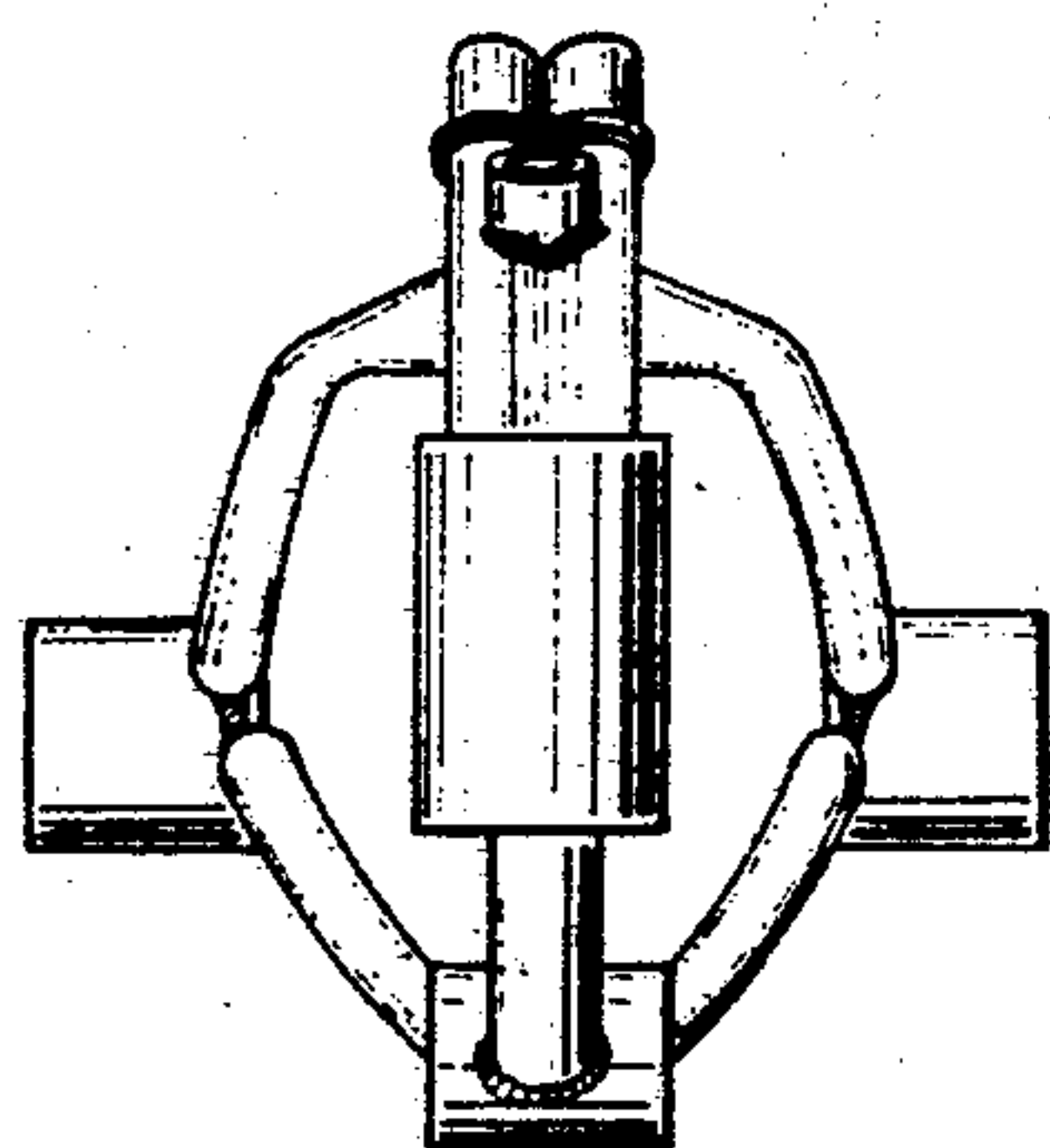

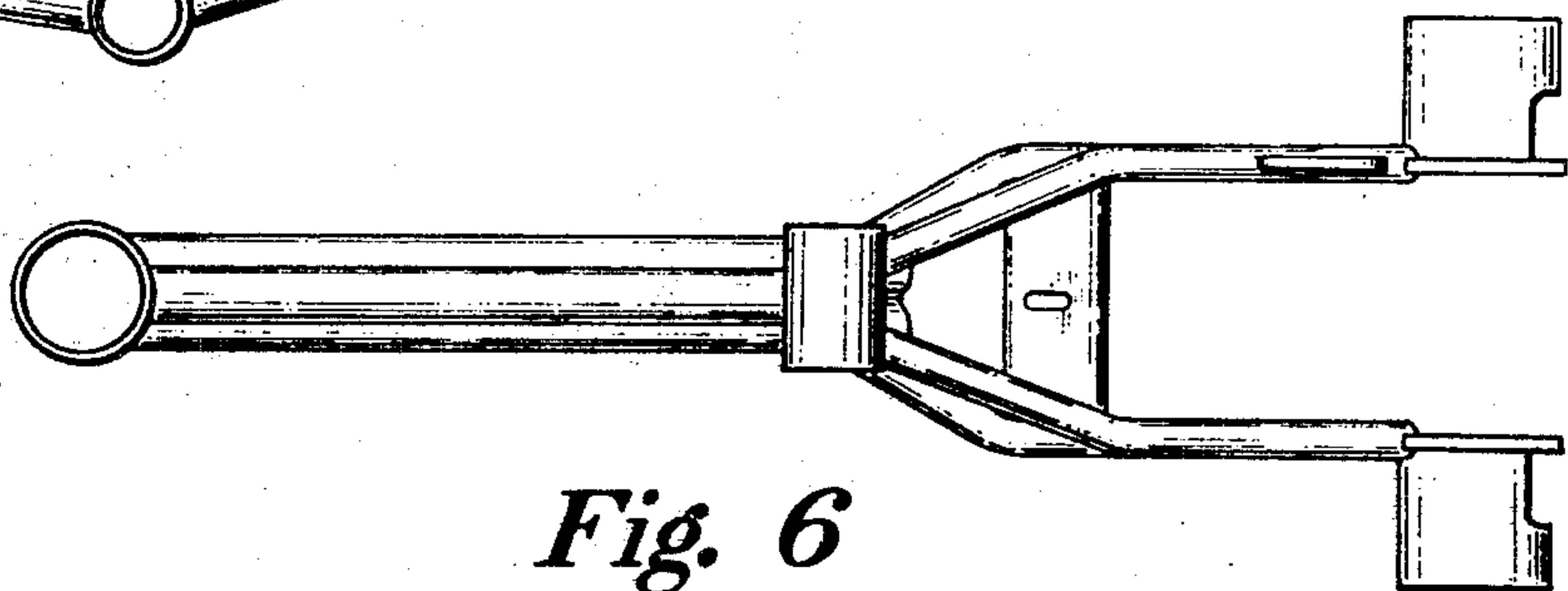

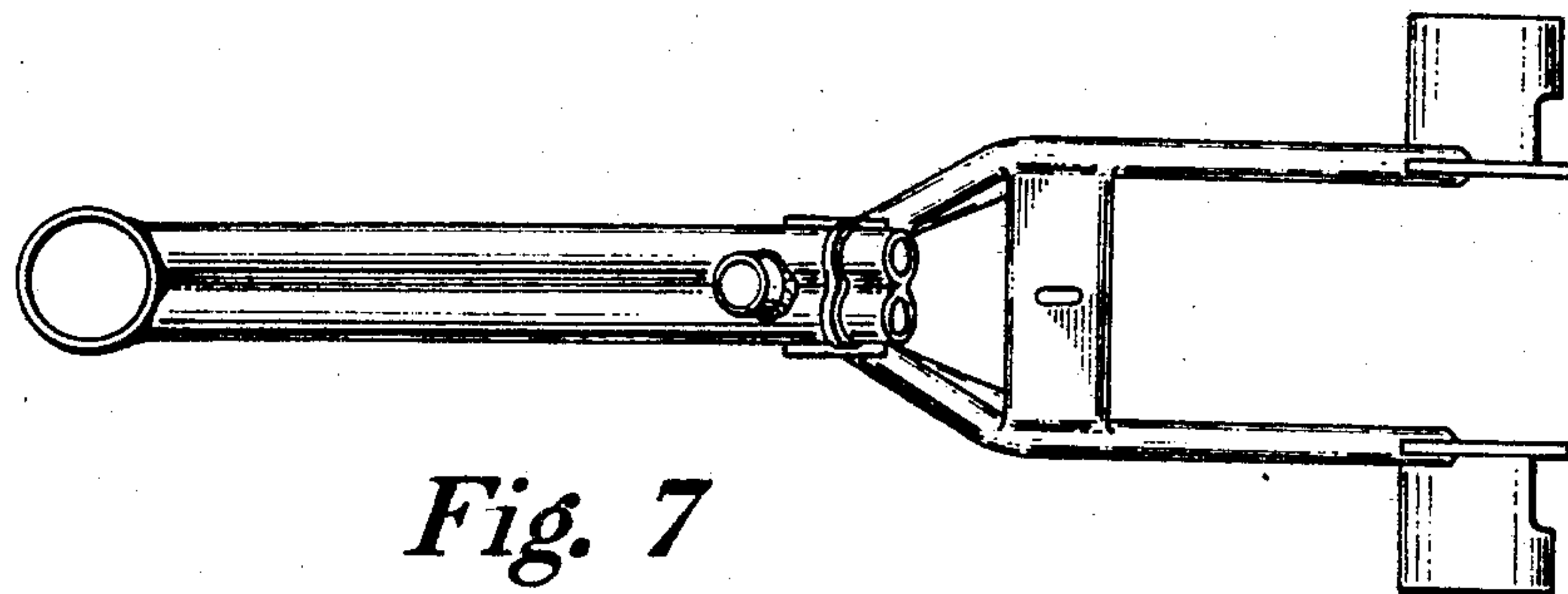
