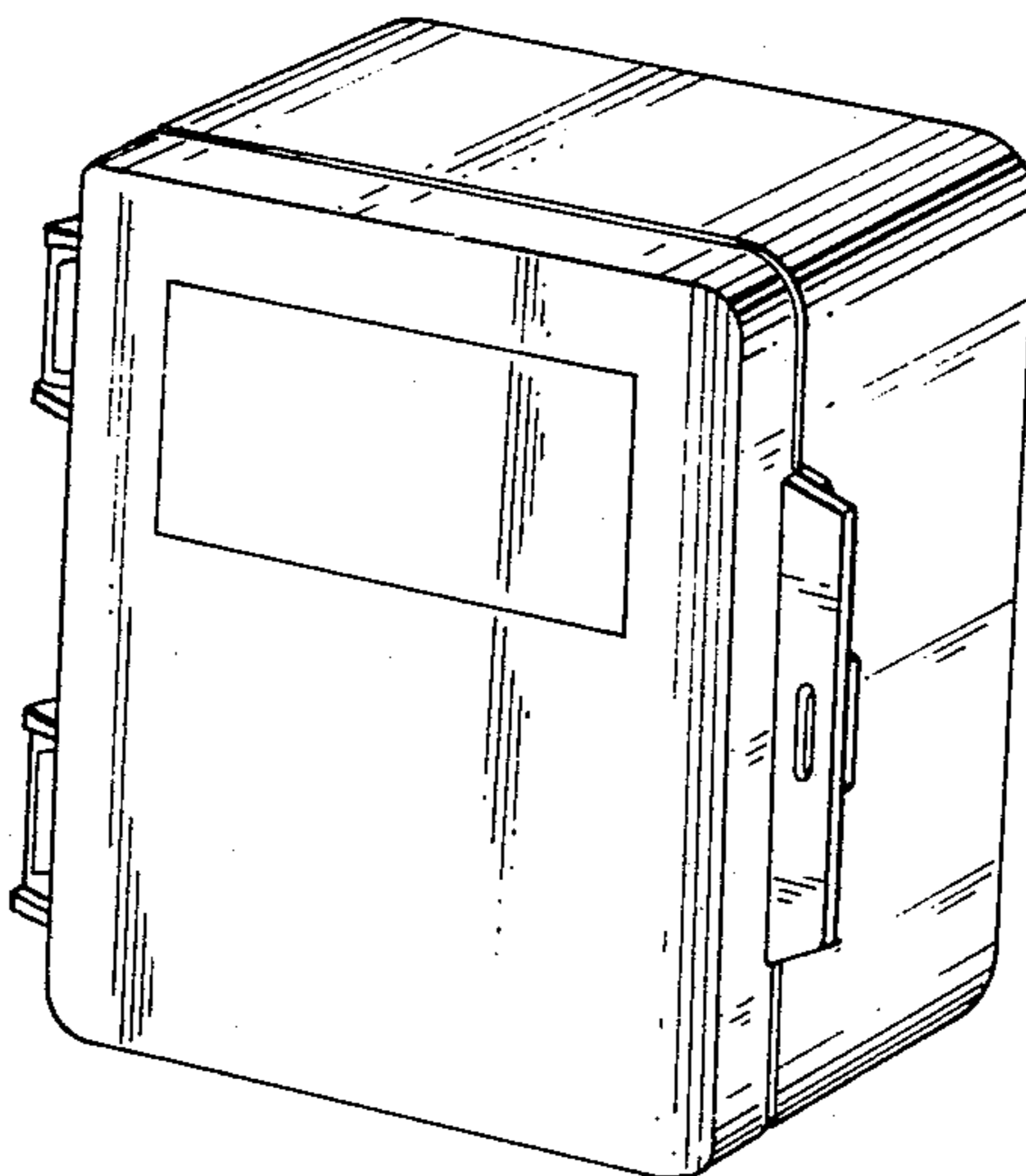

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a protection housing for telecommunication equipment or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a protection housing for telecommunication equipment or the like in a closed position showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 8 is an exploded view thereof with the cap in an open position.



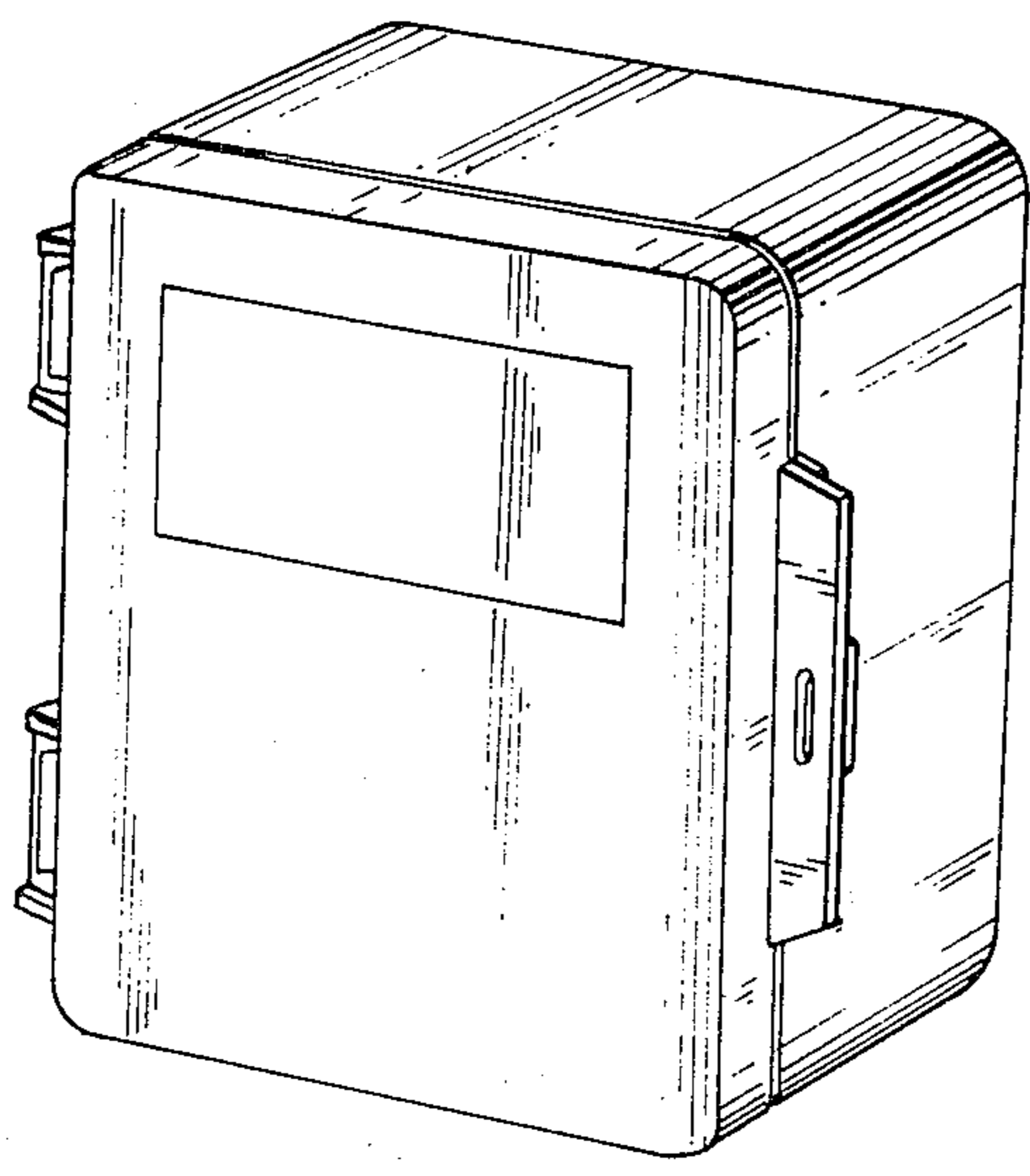

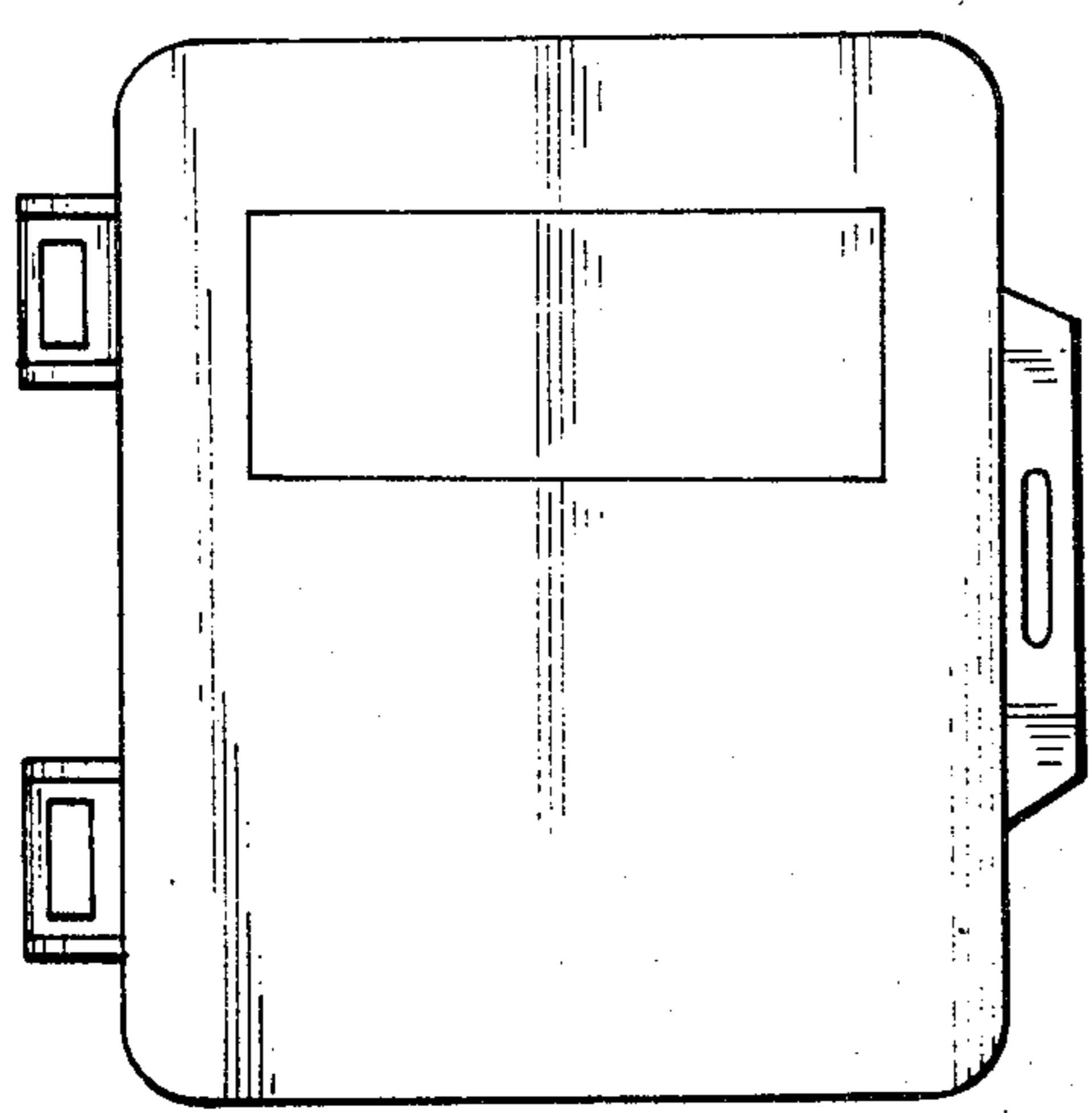

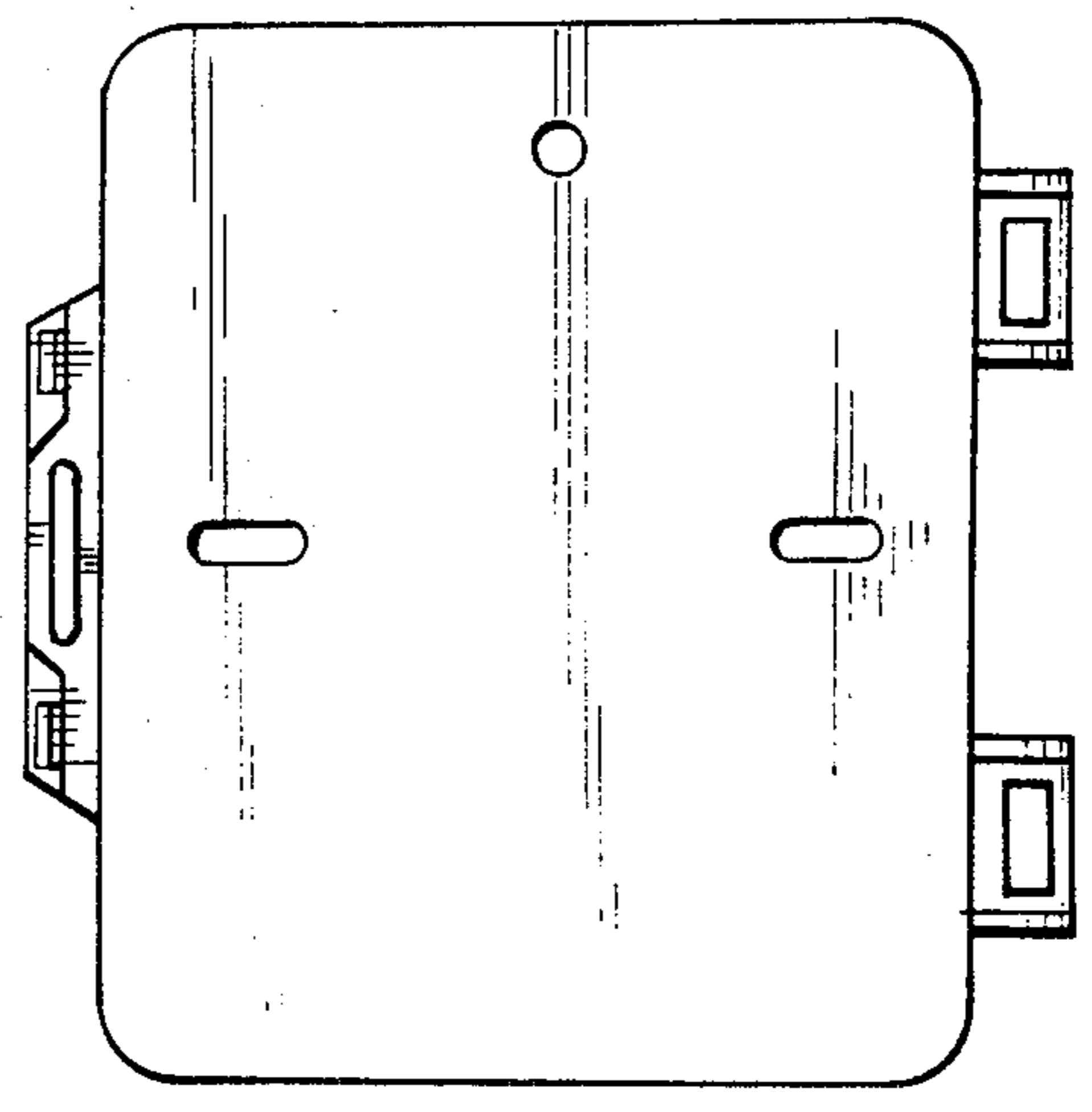

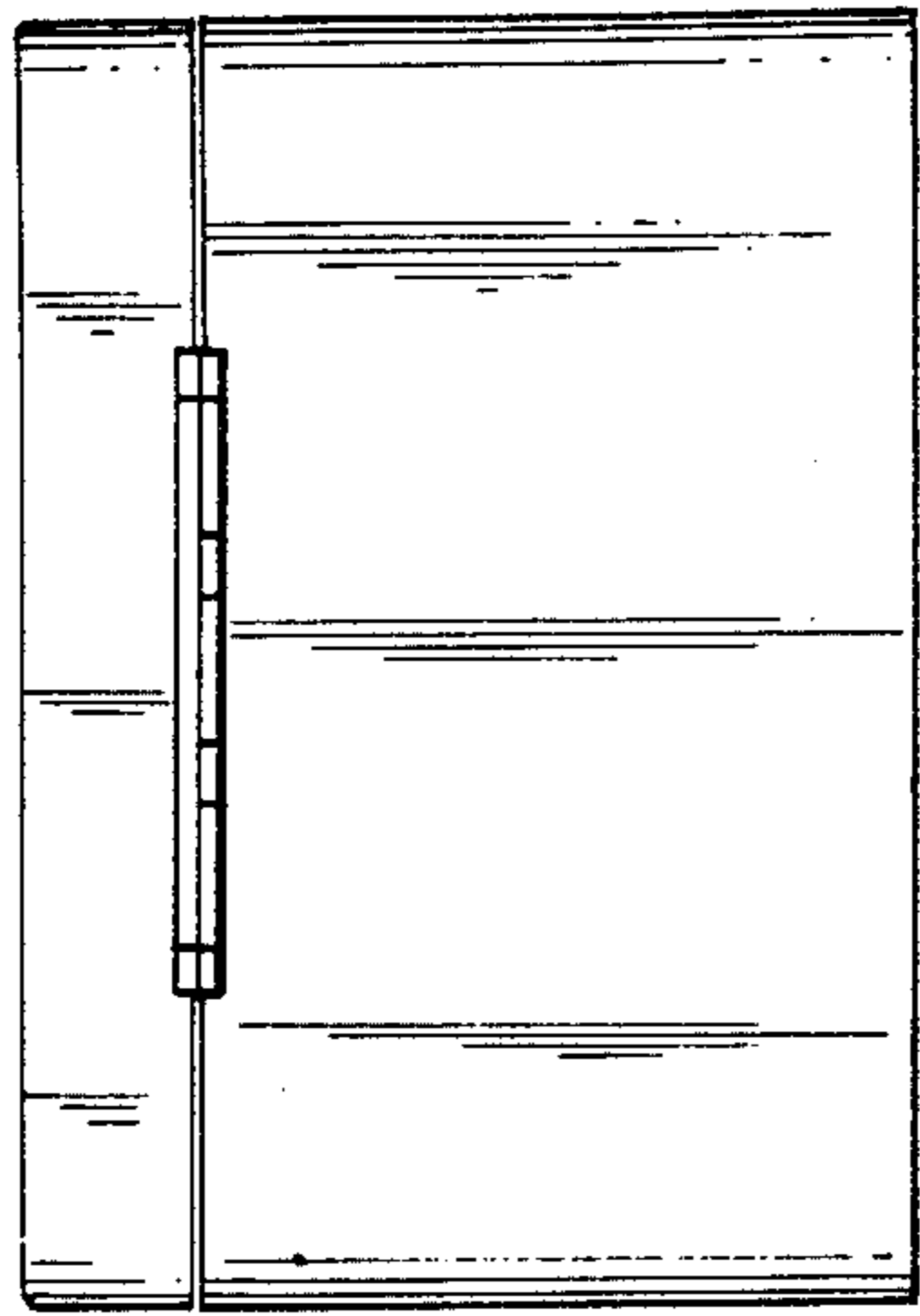

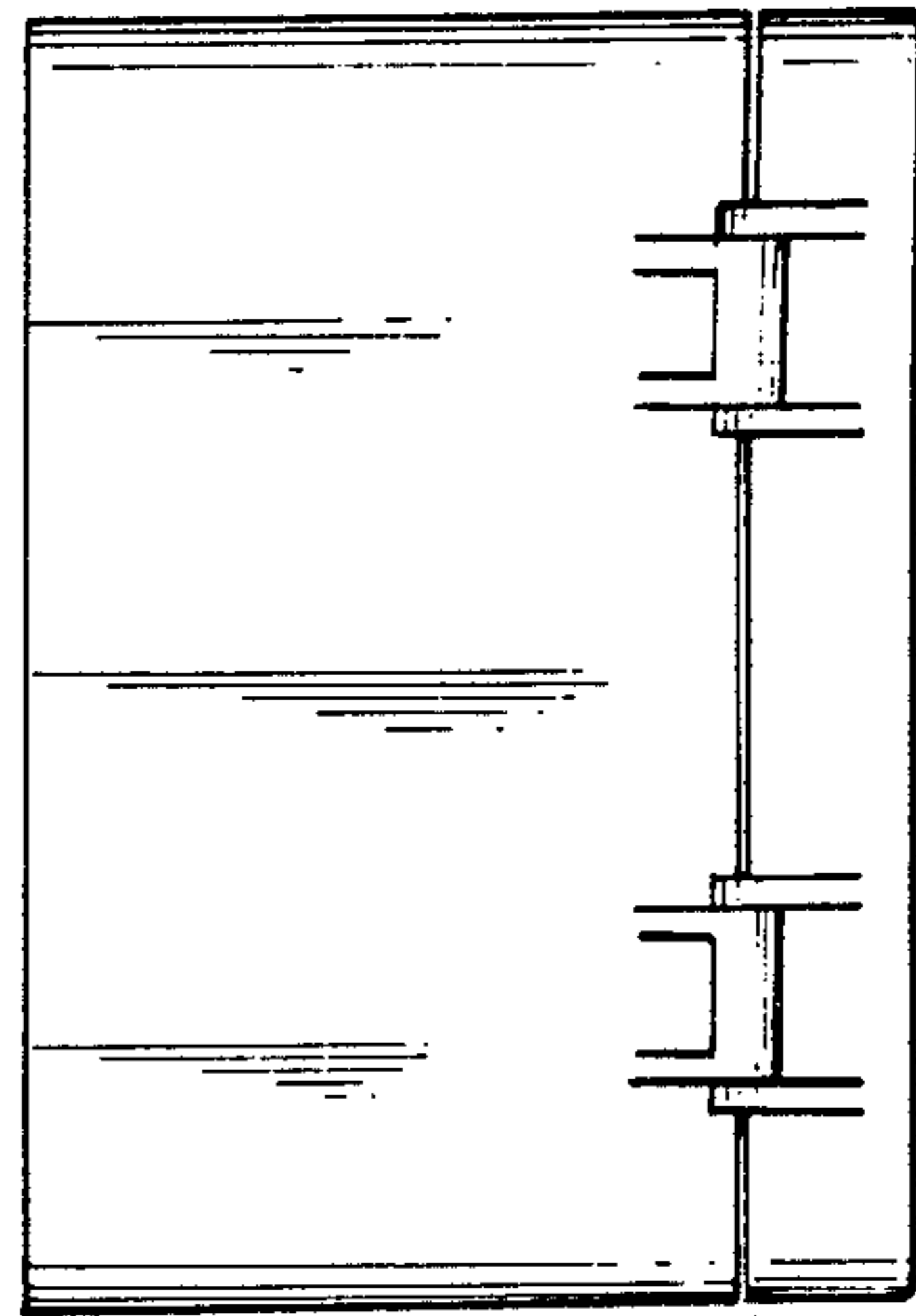

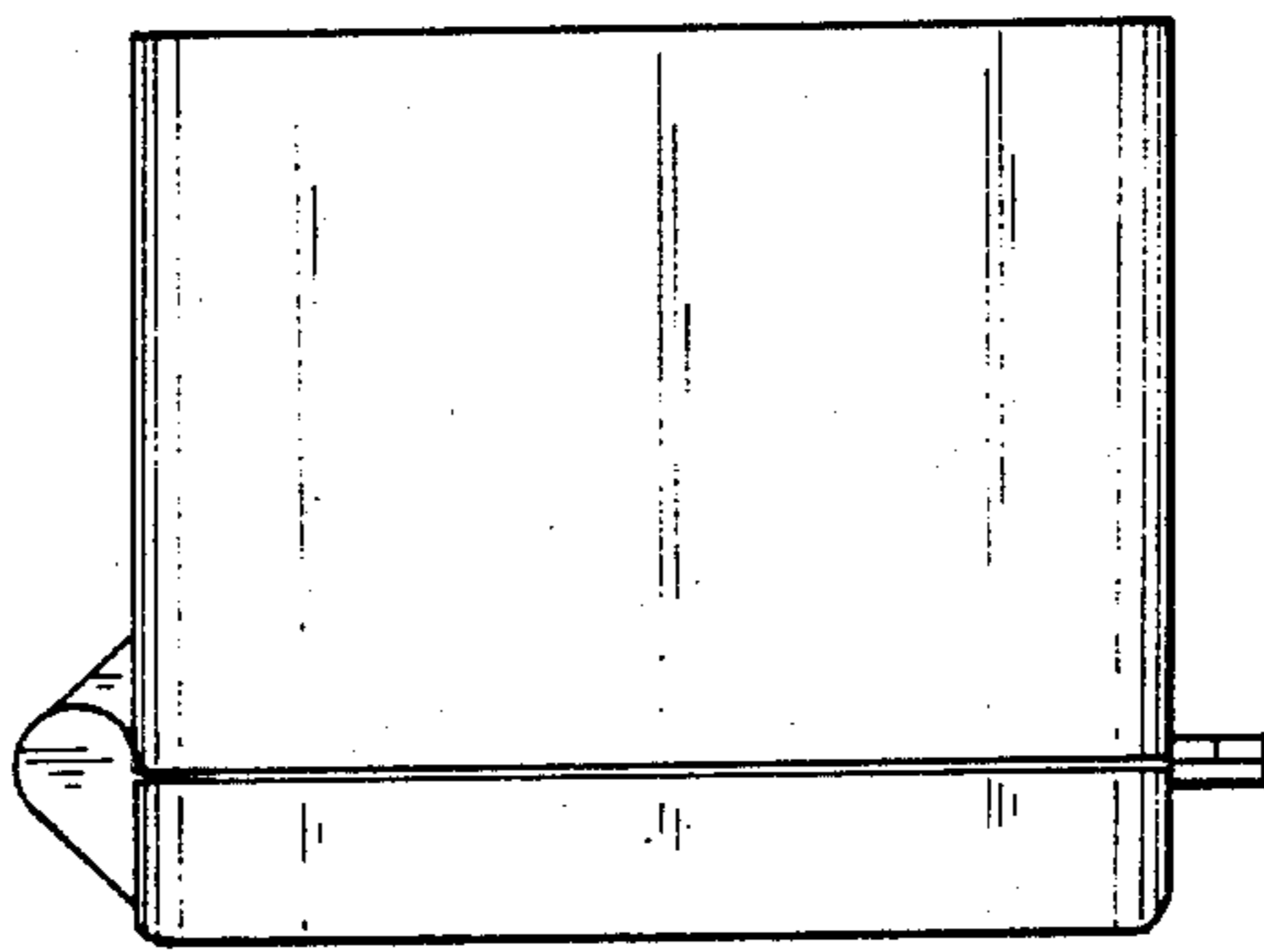

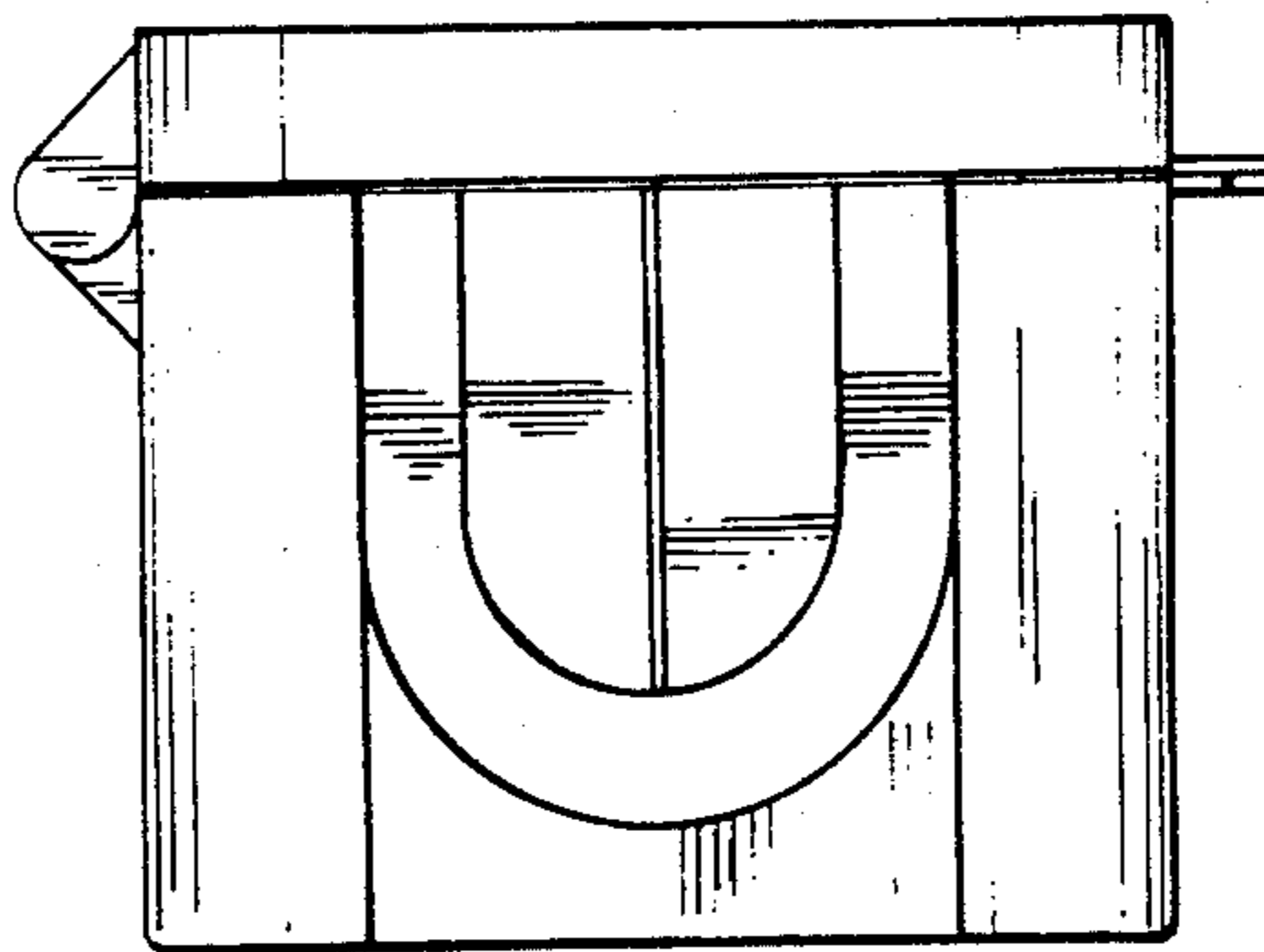

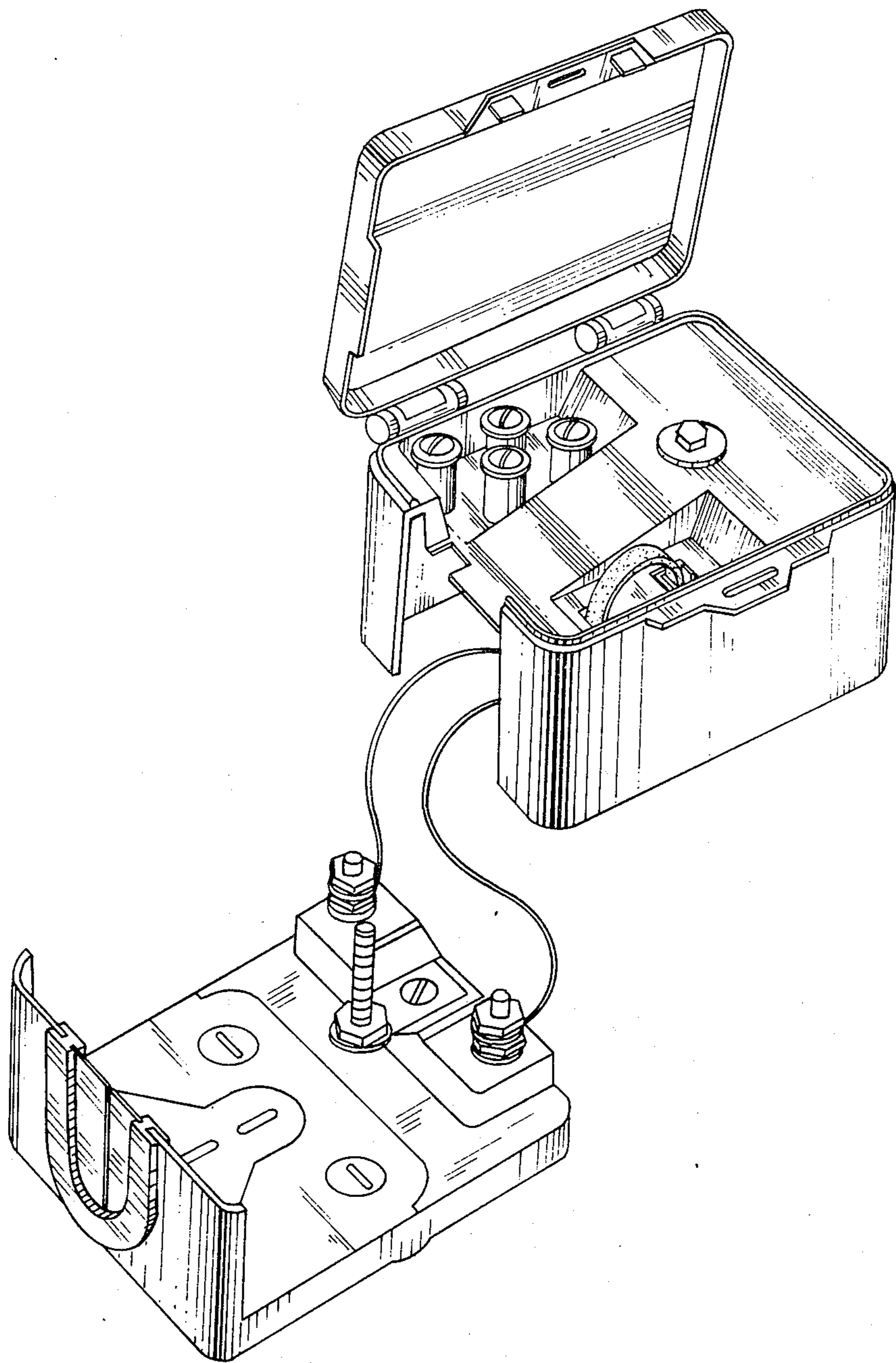
