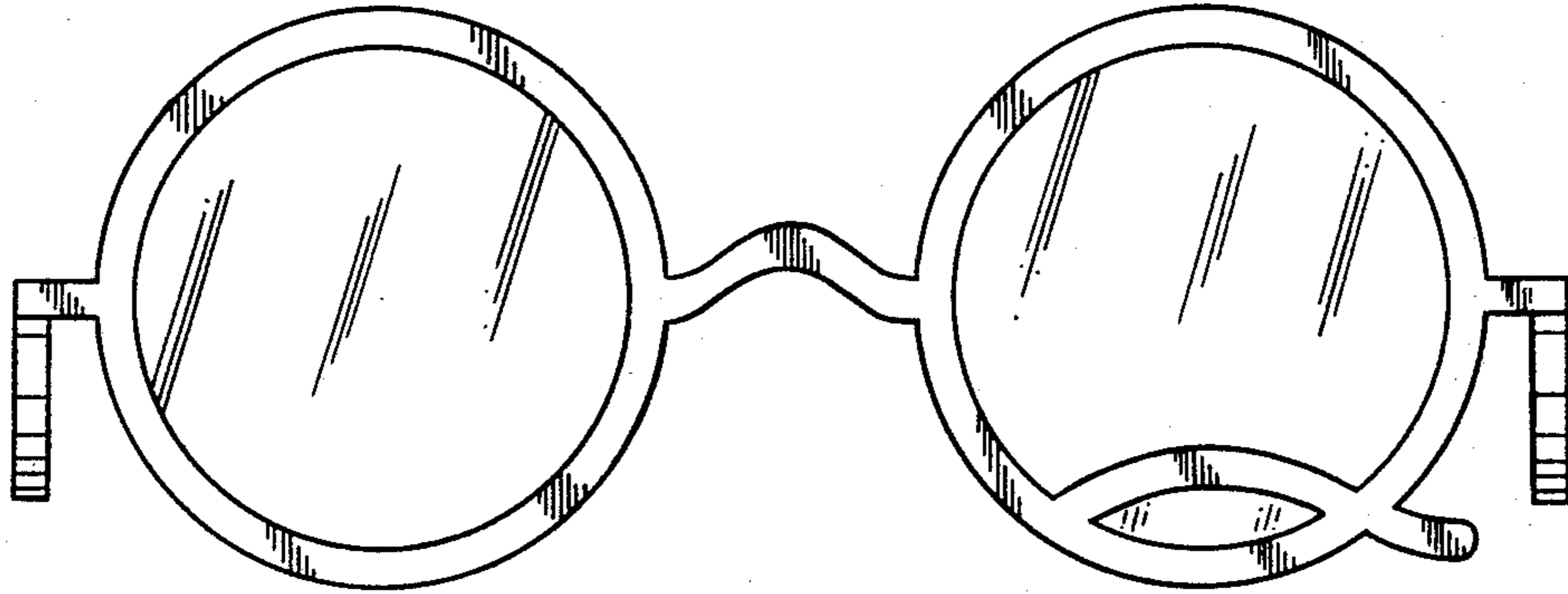

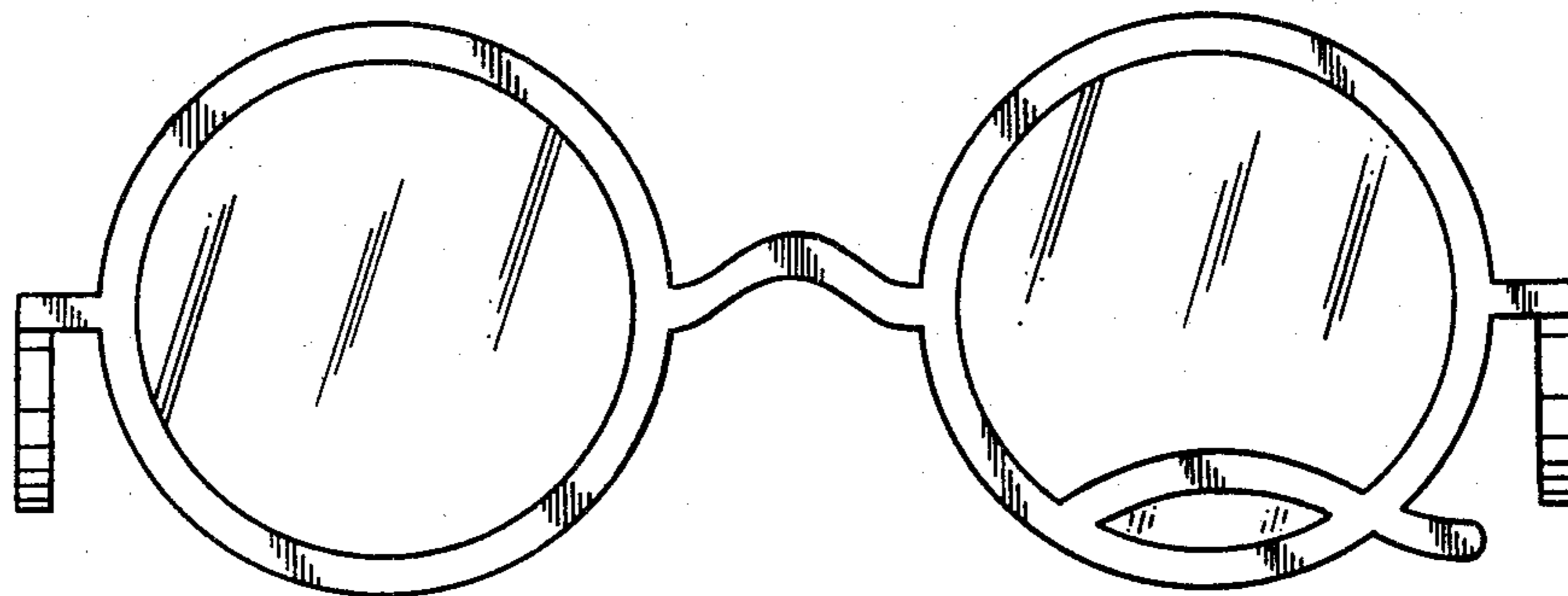
The ornamental design for a pair of eyeglasses, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

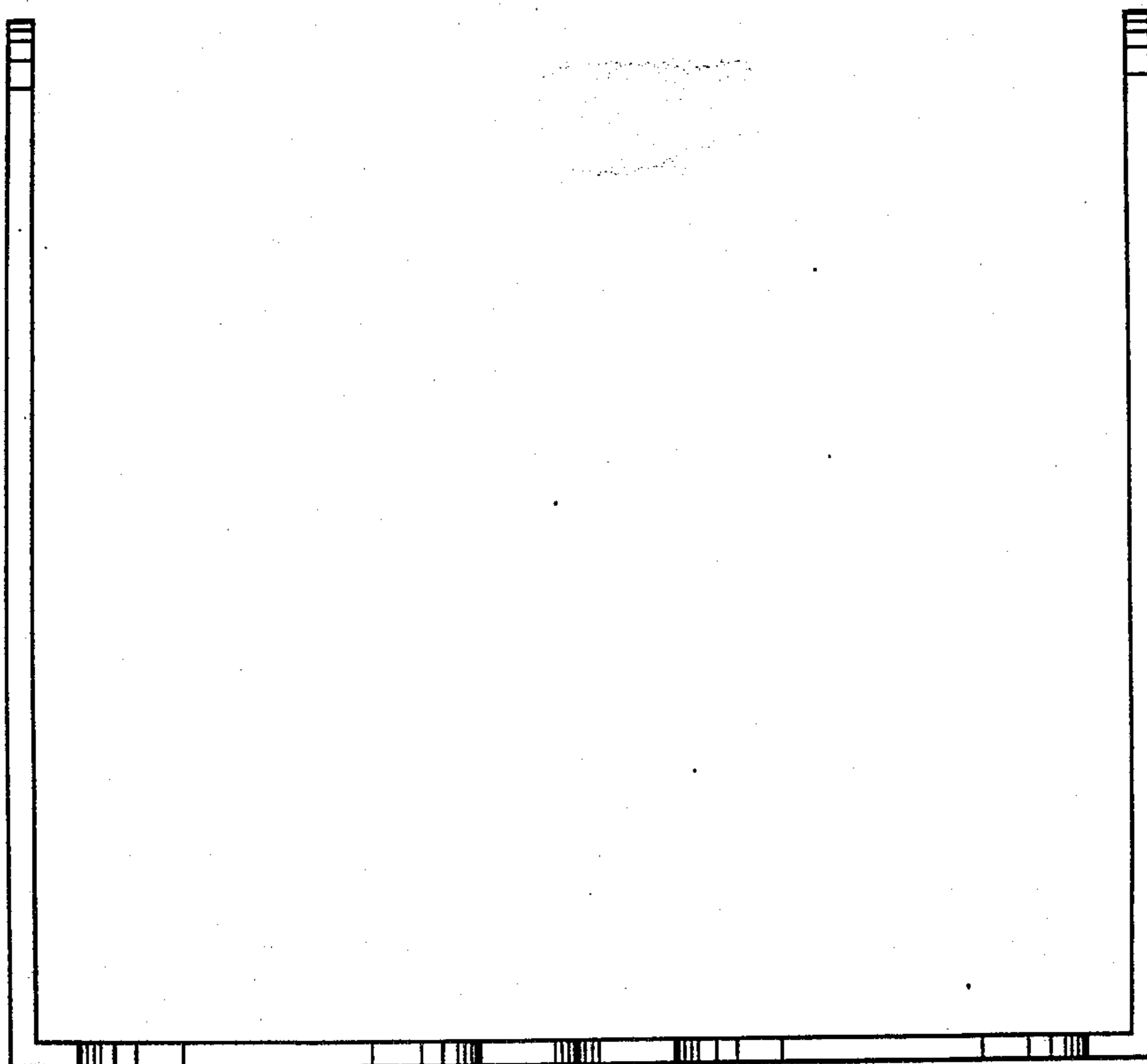

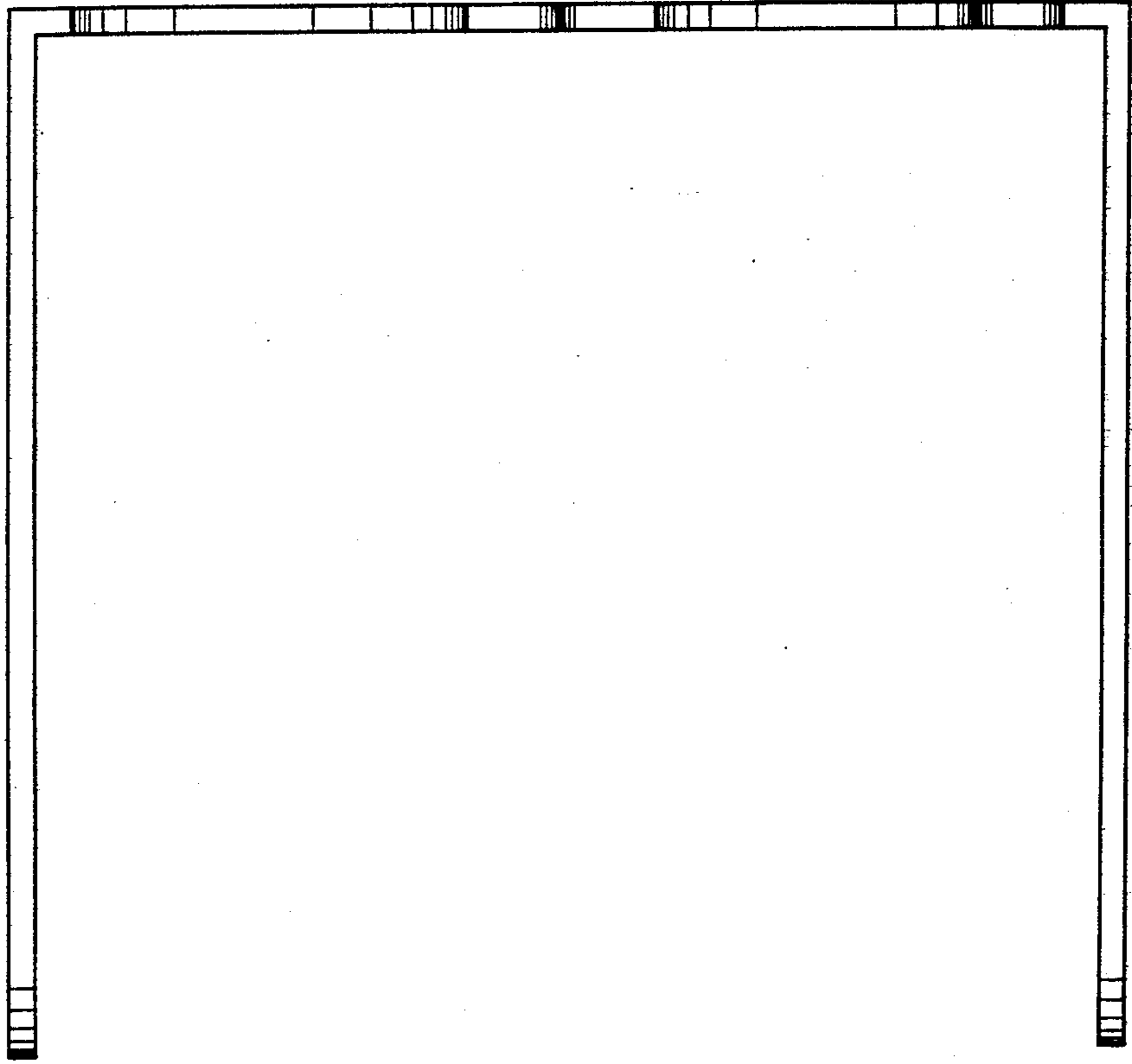

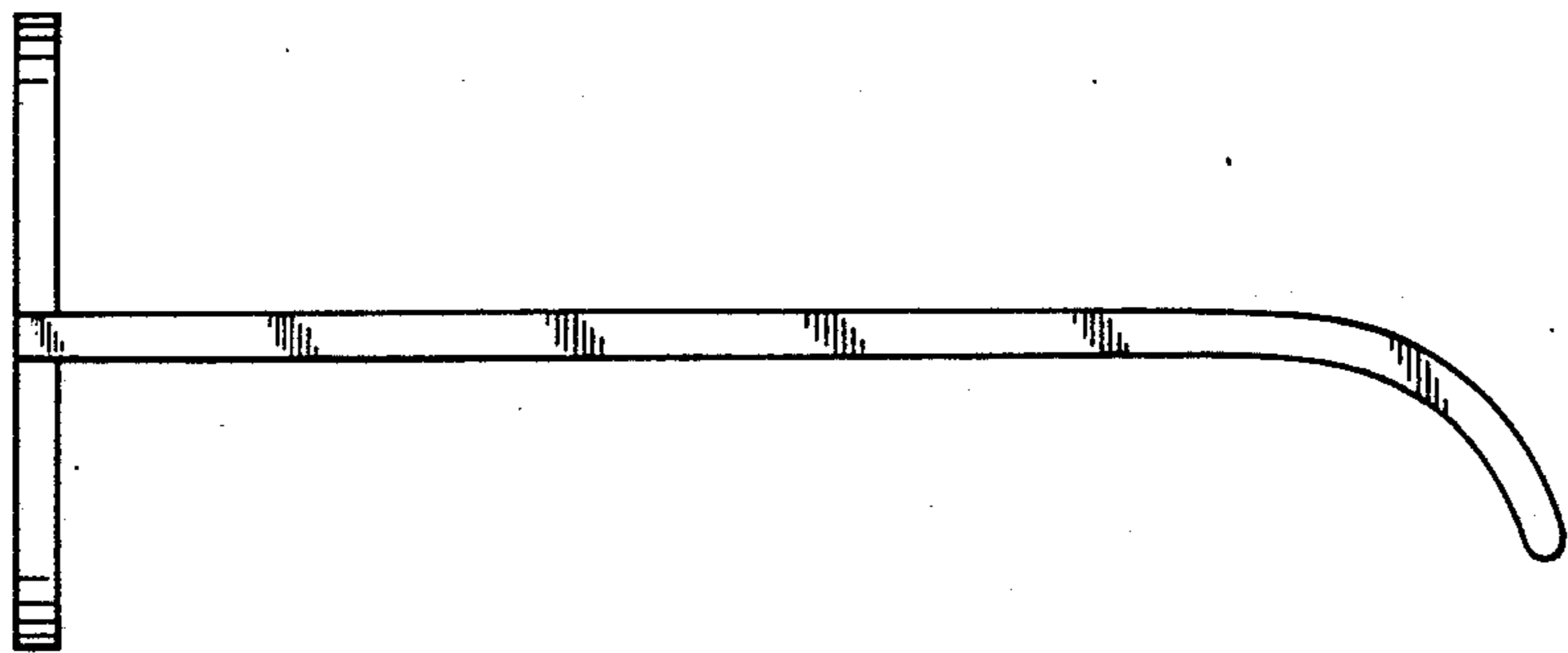
