FIG. 7 is top, rear and left side perspective view thereof.

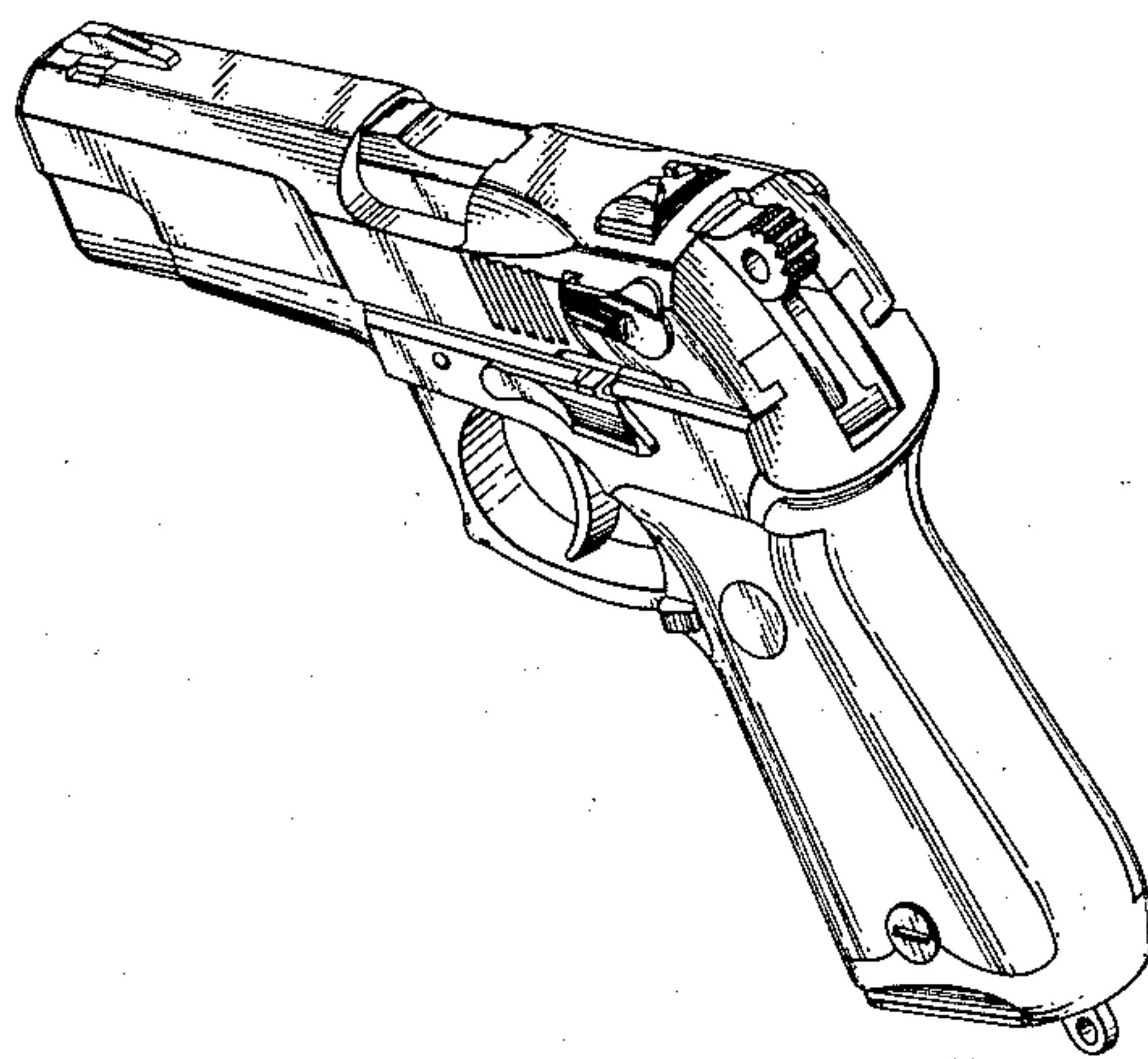

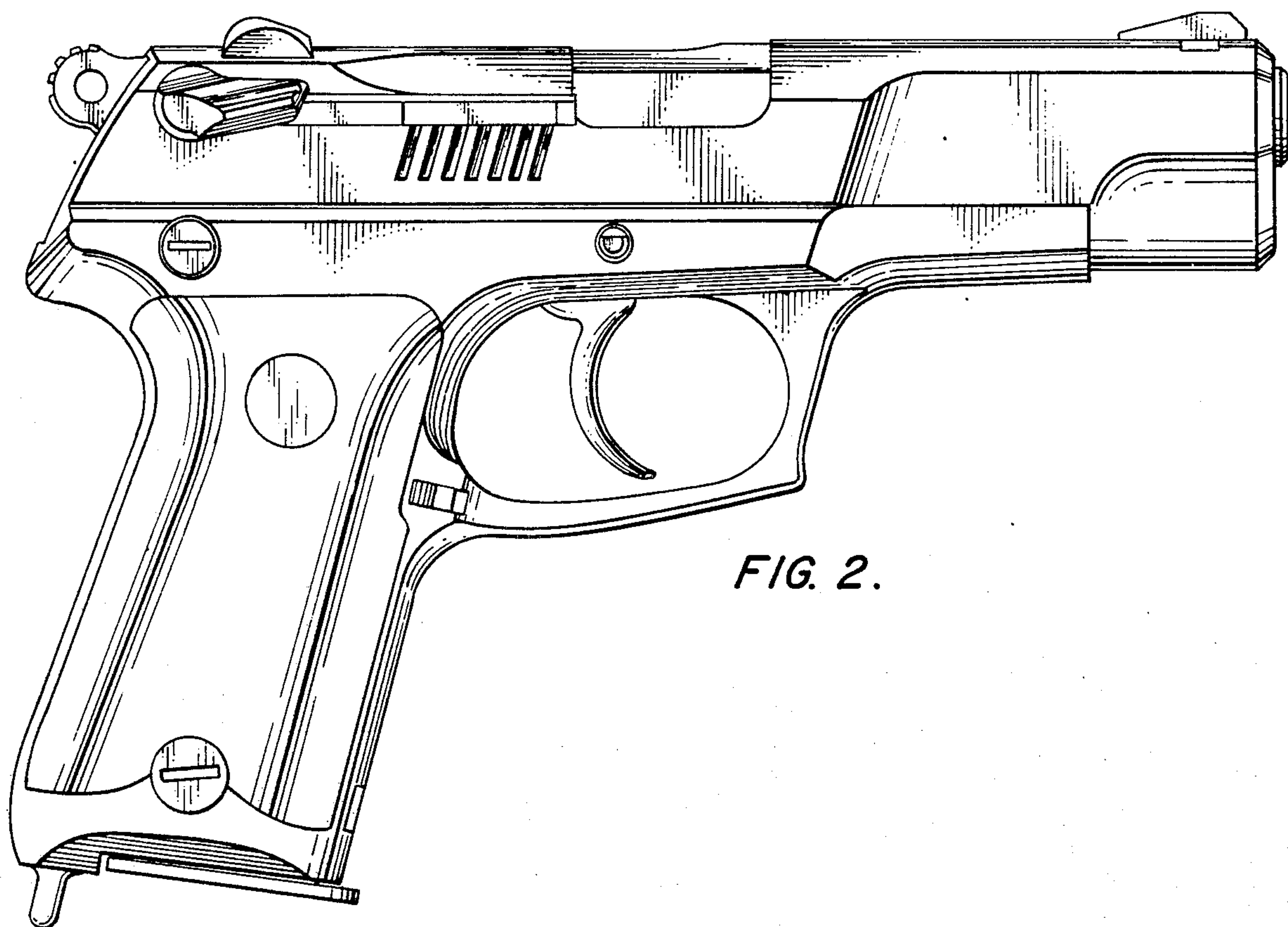
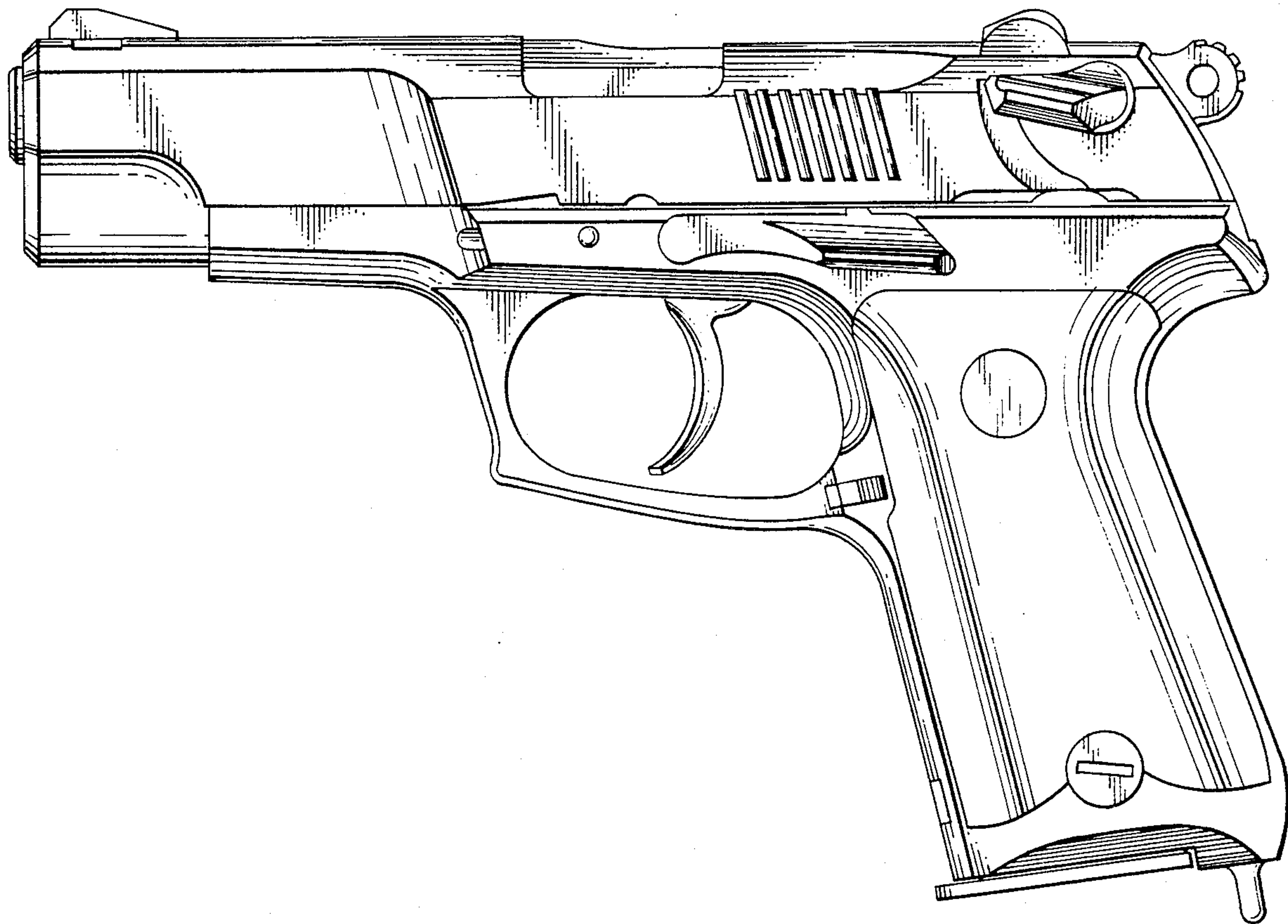

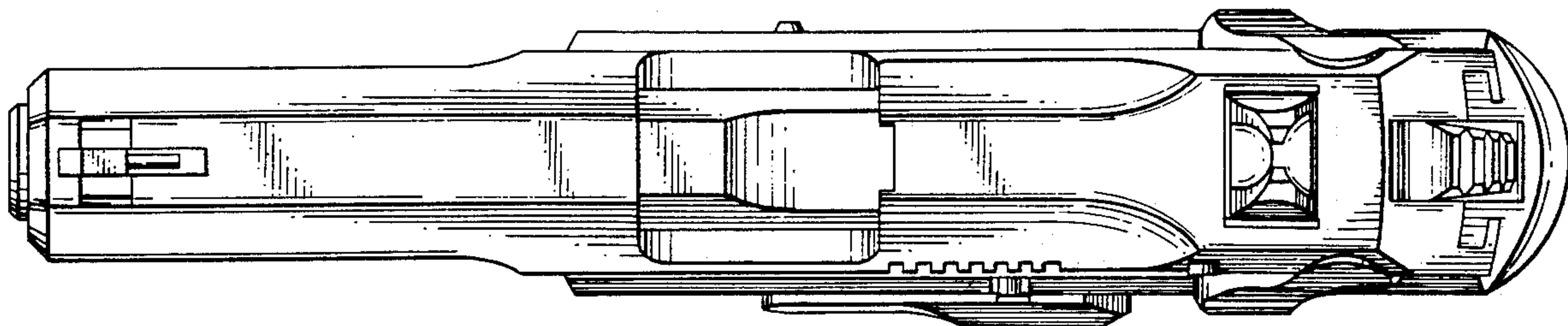

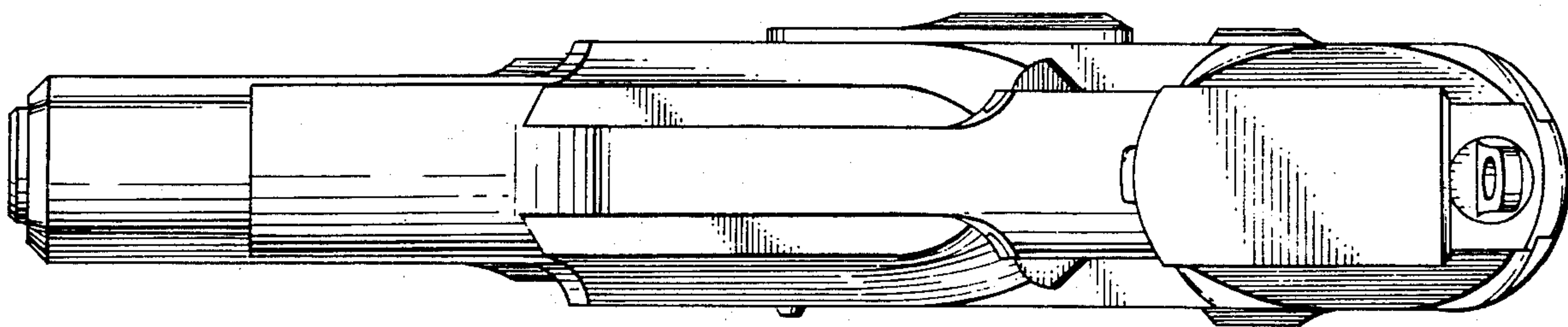

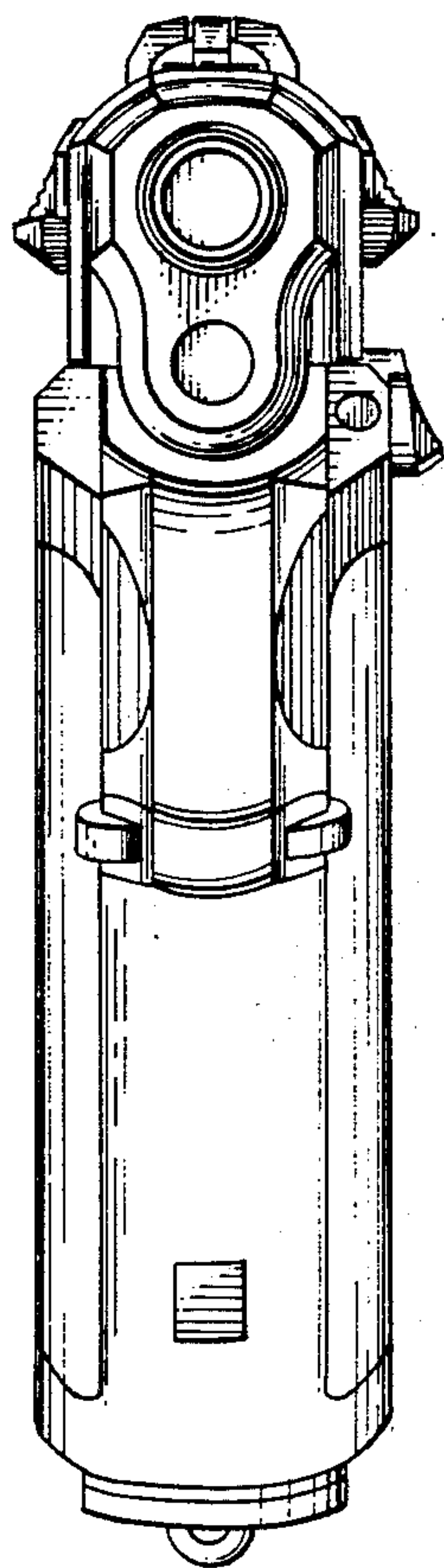

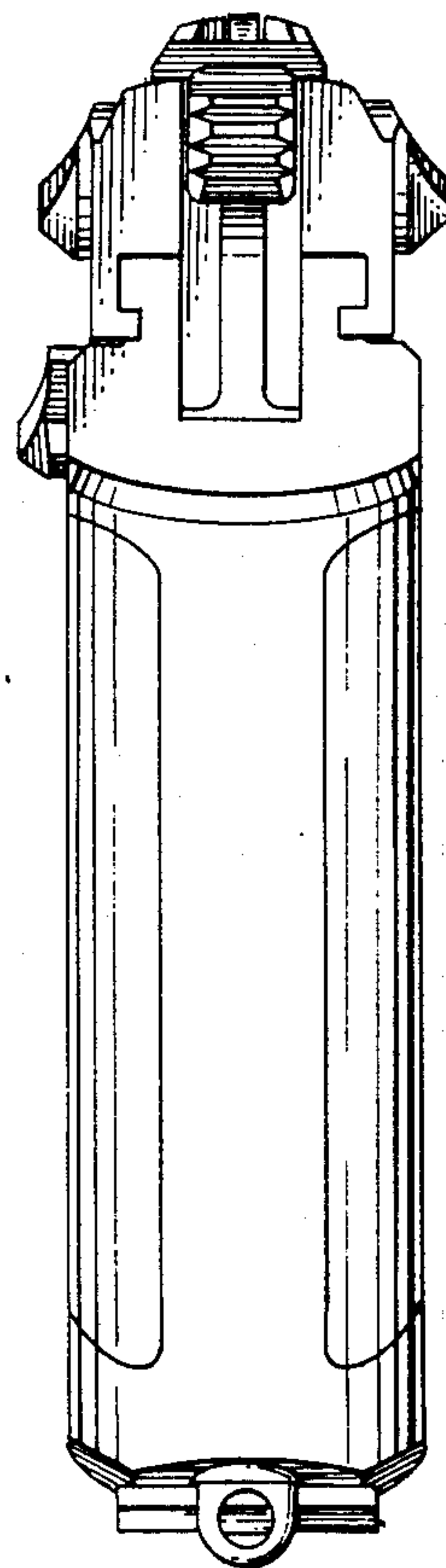
