[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a coin roll opener, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a coin roll opener, showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view of one end, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a fragmentary sectional view thereof on an enlarged scale taken on line 7—7 in FIG. 3; and  
 FIG. 8 is a fragmentary sectional view thereof on an enlarged scale taken on line 8—8 in FIG. 3.  
 The coin roll shown in broken line in FIG. 2 is included to show the environment and forms no part of the design.
