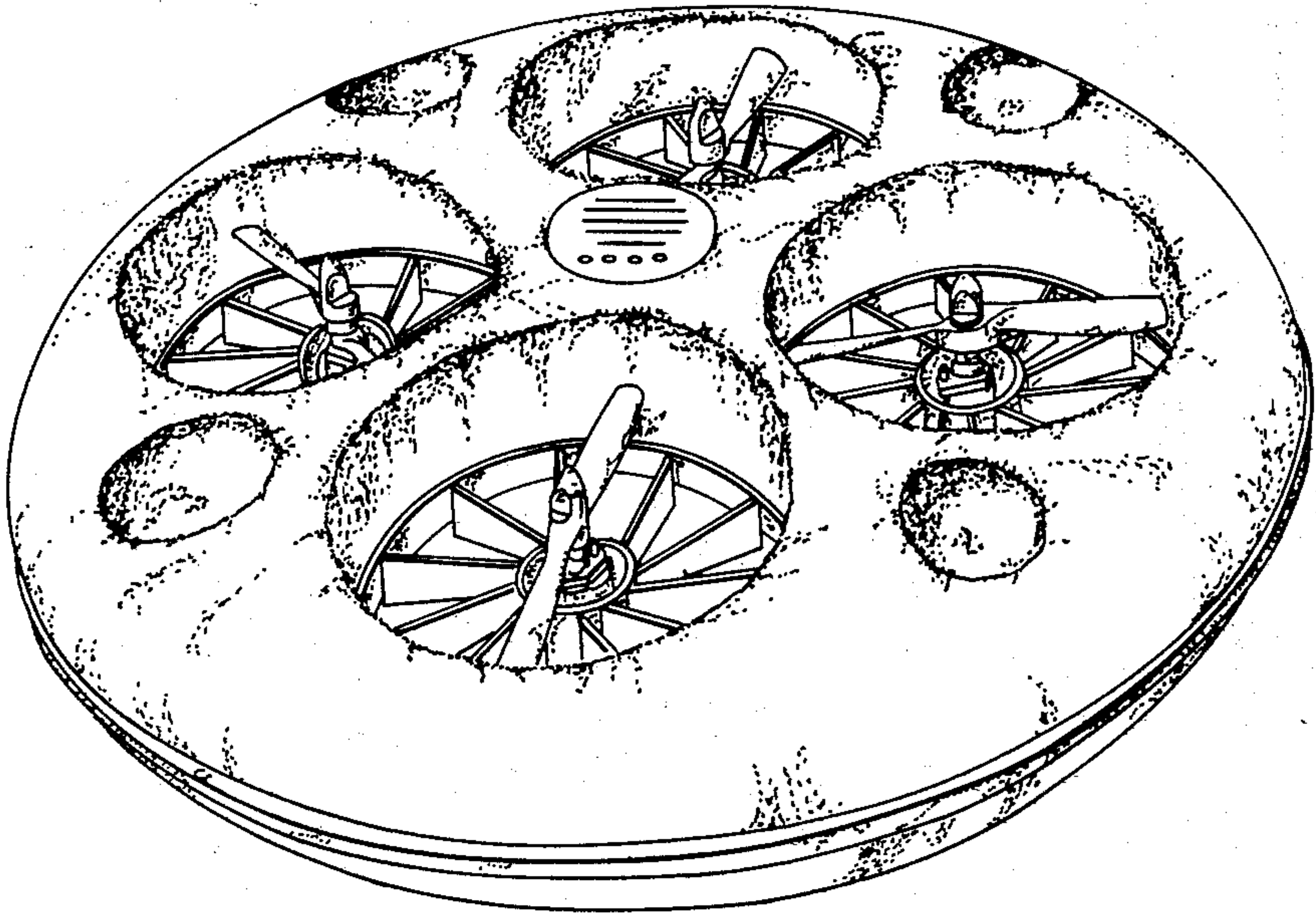

FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof on a larger scale, looking from one side and above.



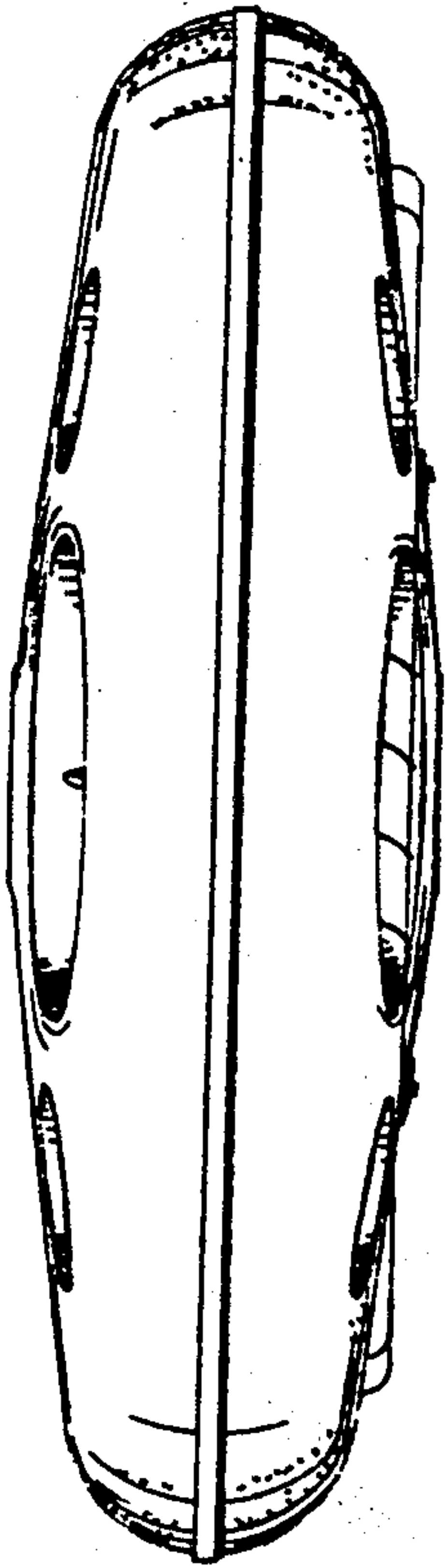

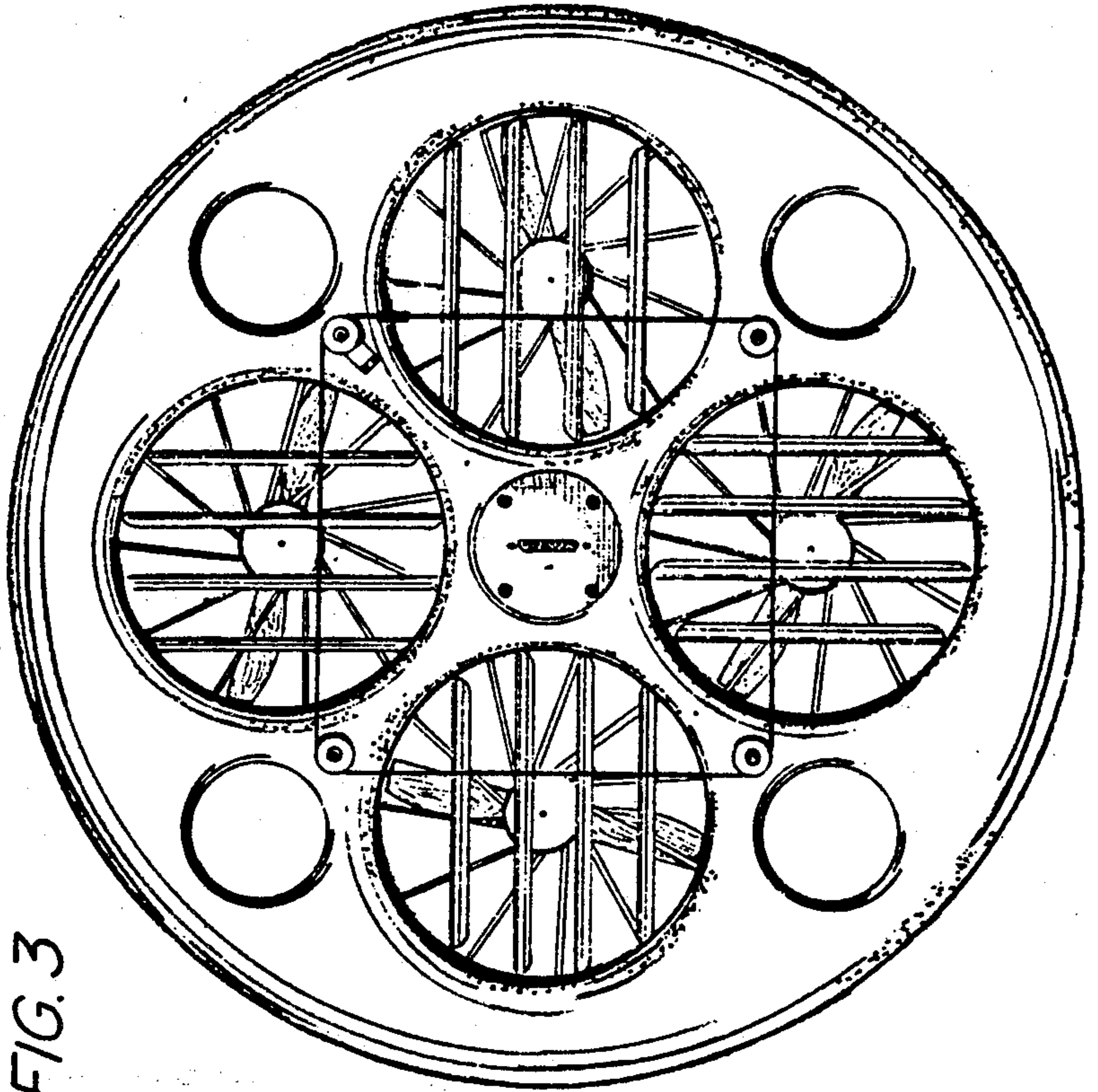

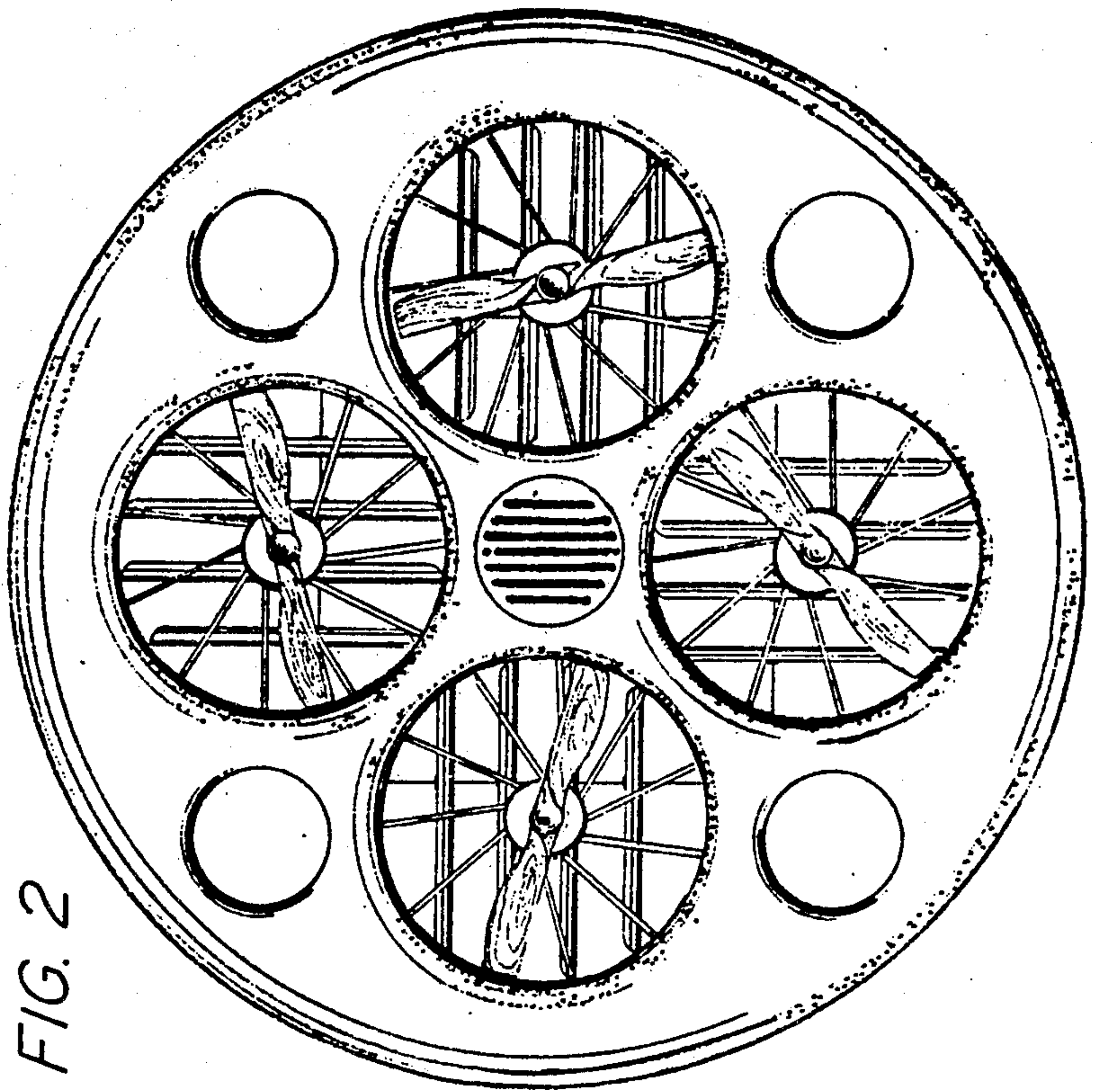

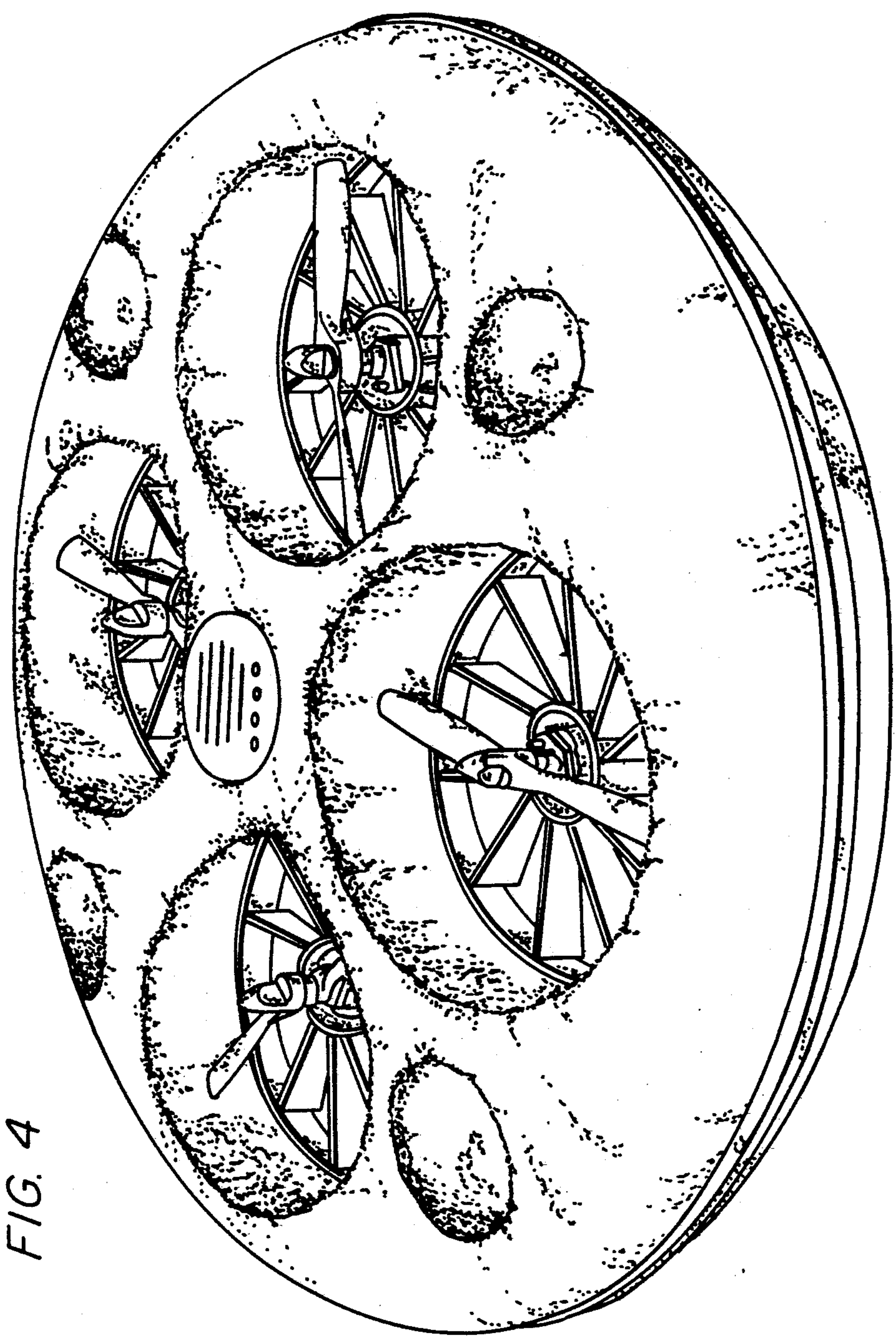
