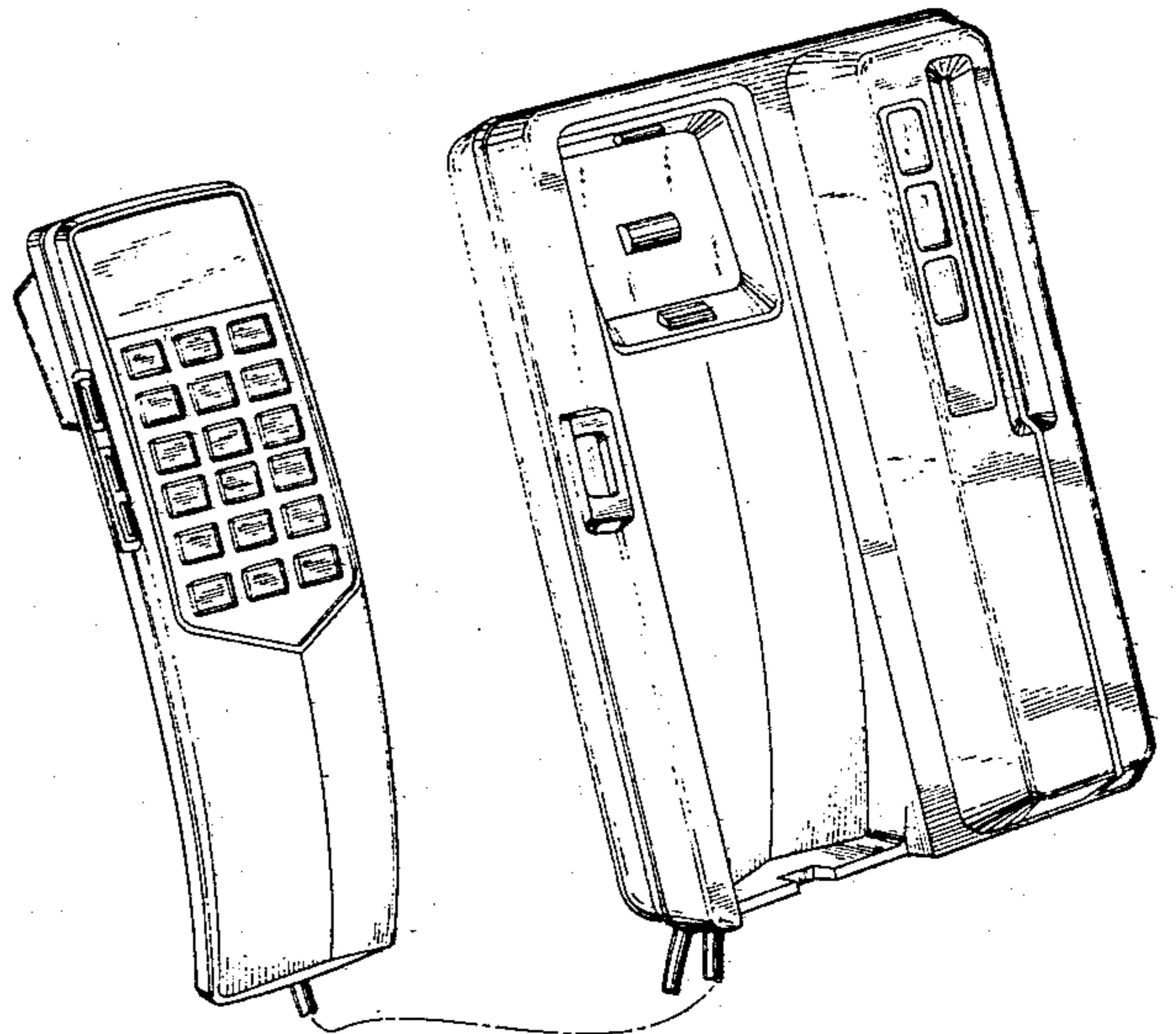
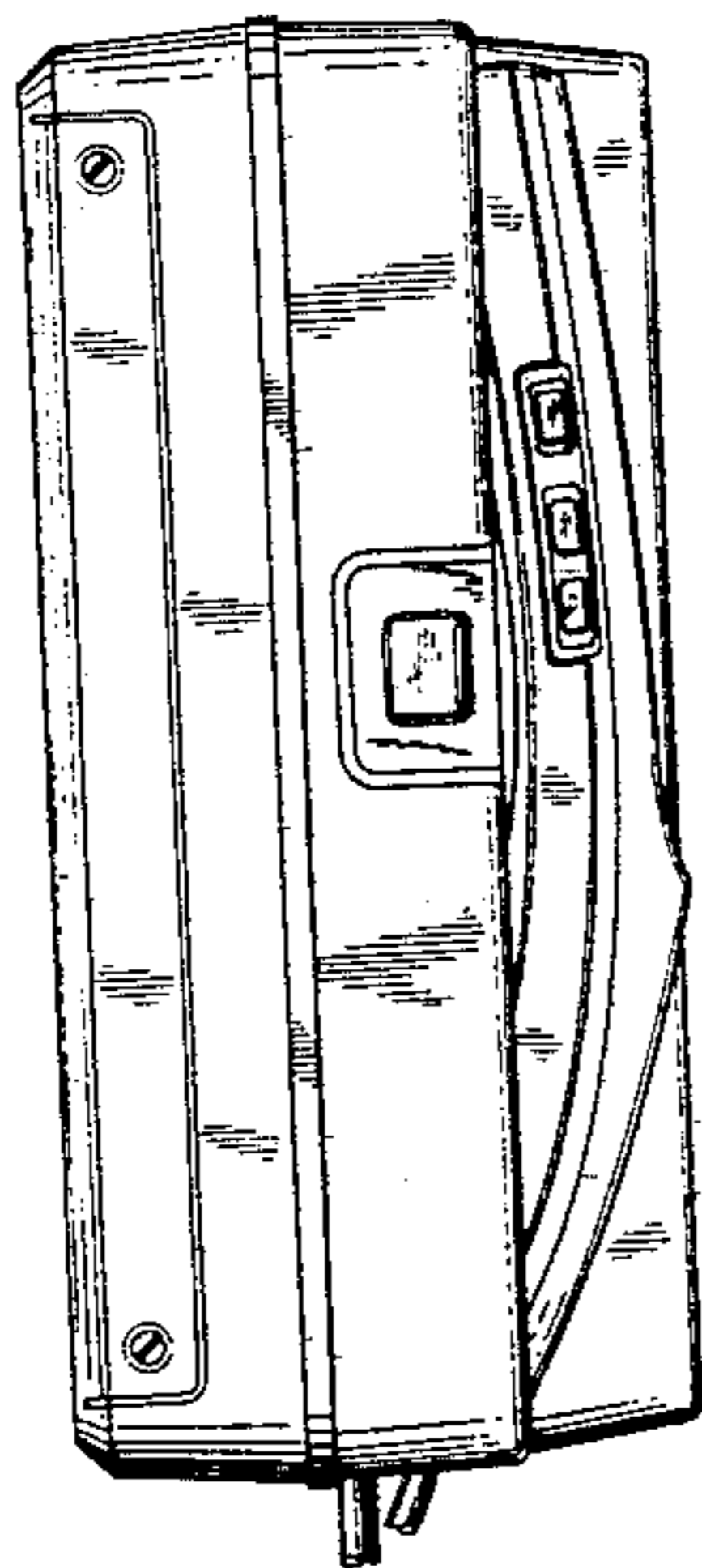

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a credit card handset telephone and stand instrument, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a credit card handset telephone and stand instrument showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof with the handset removed from the stand for clarity of representation.



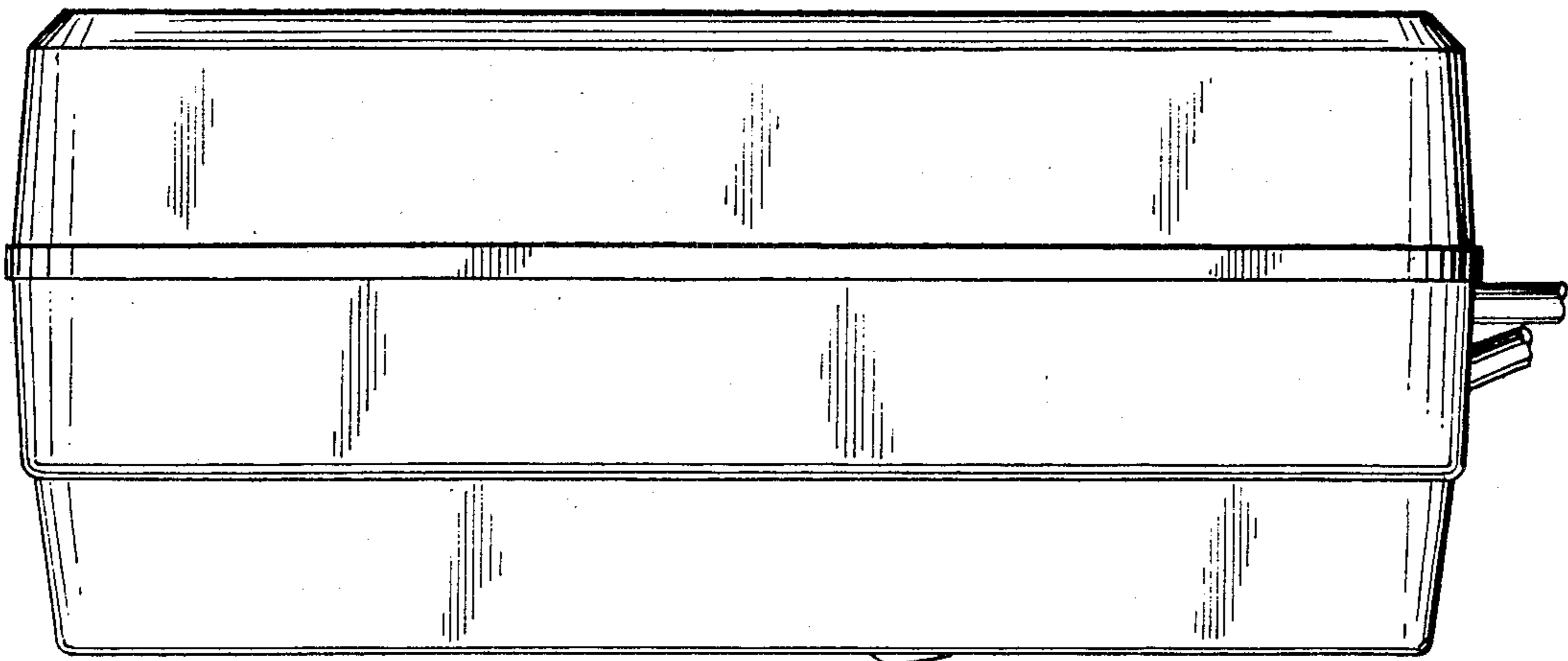

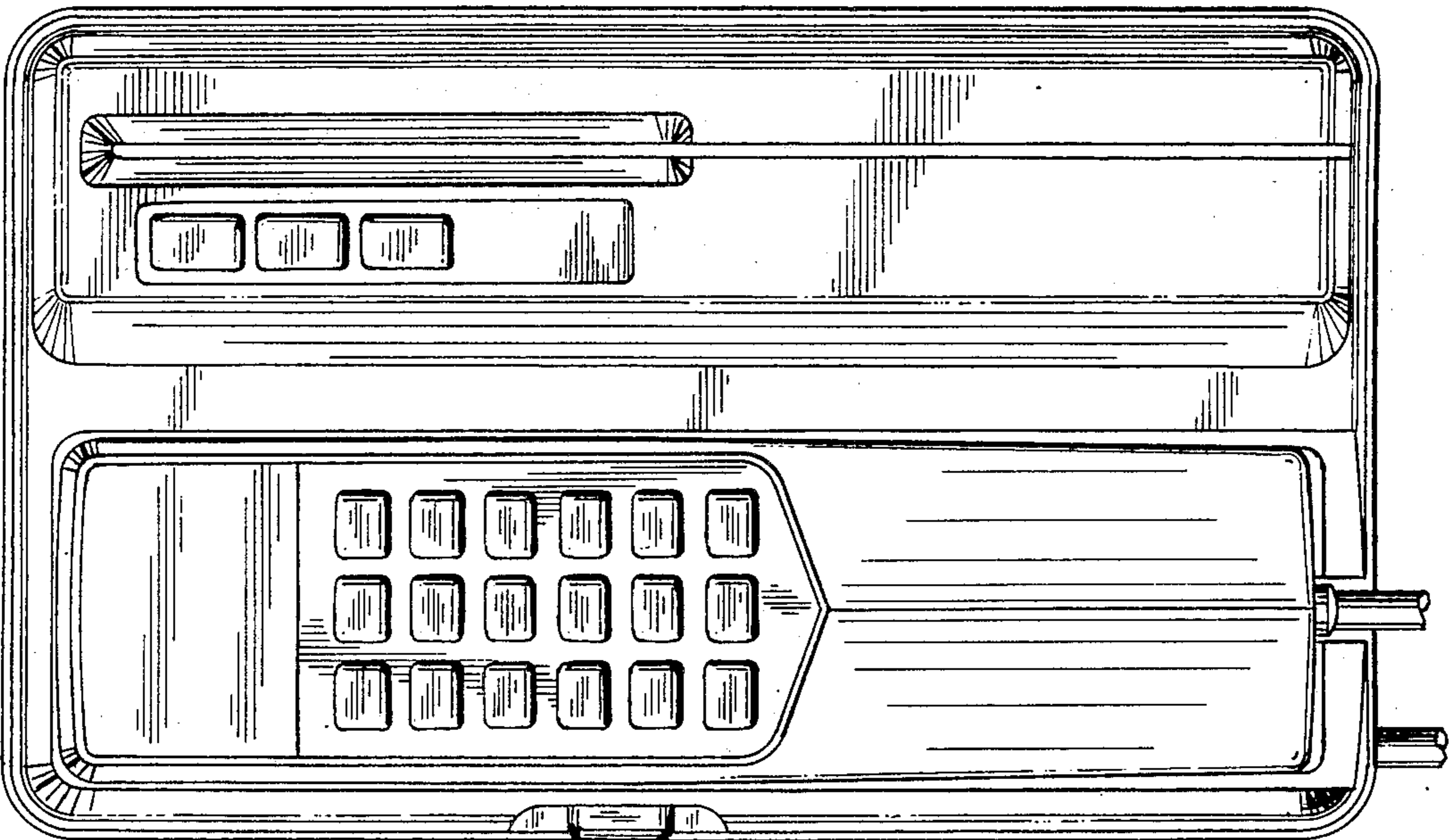

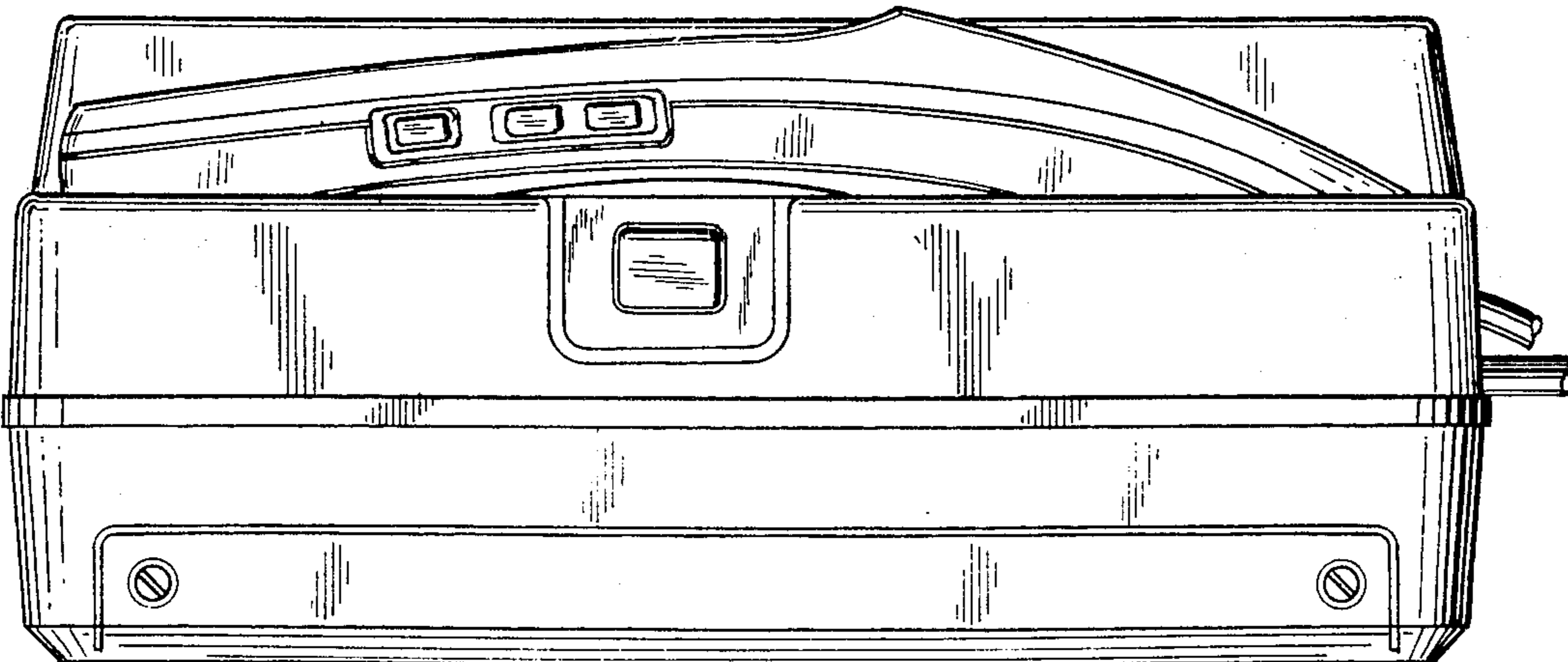

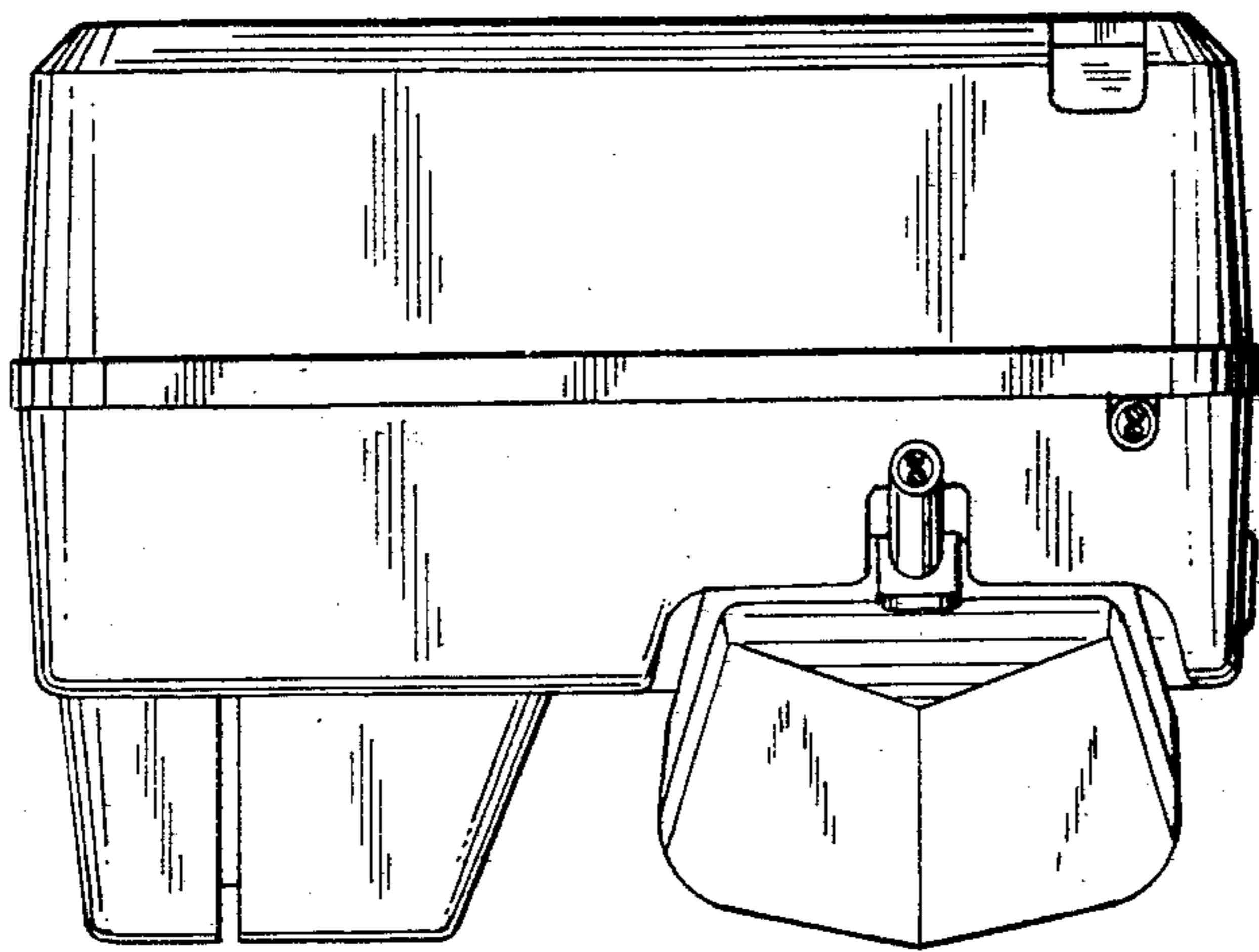

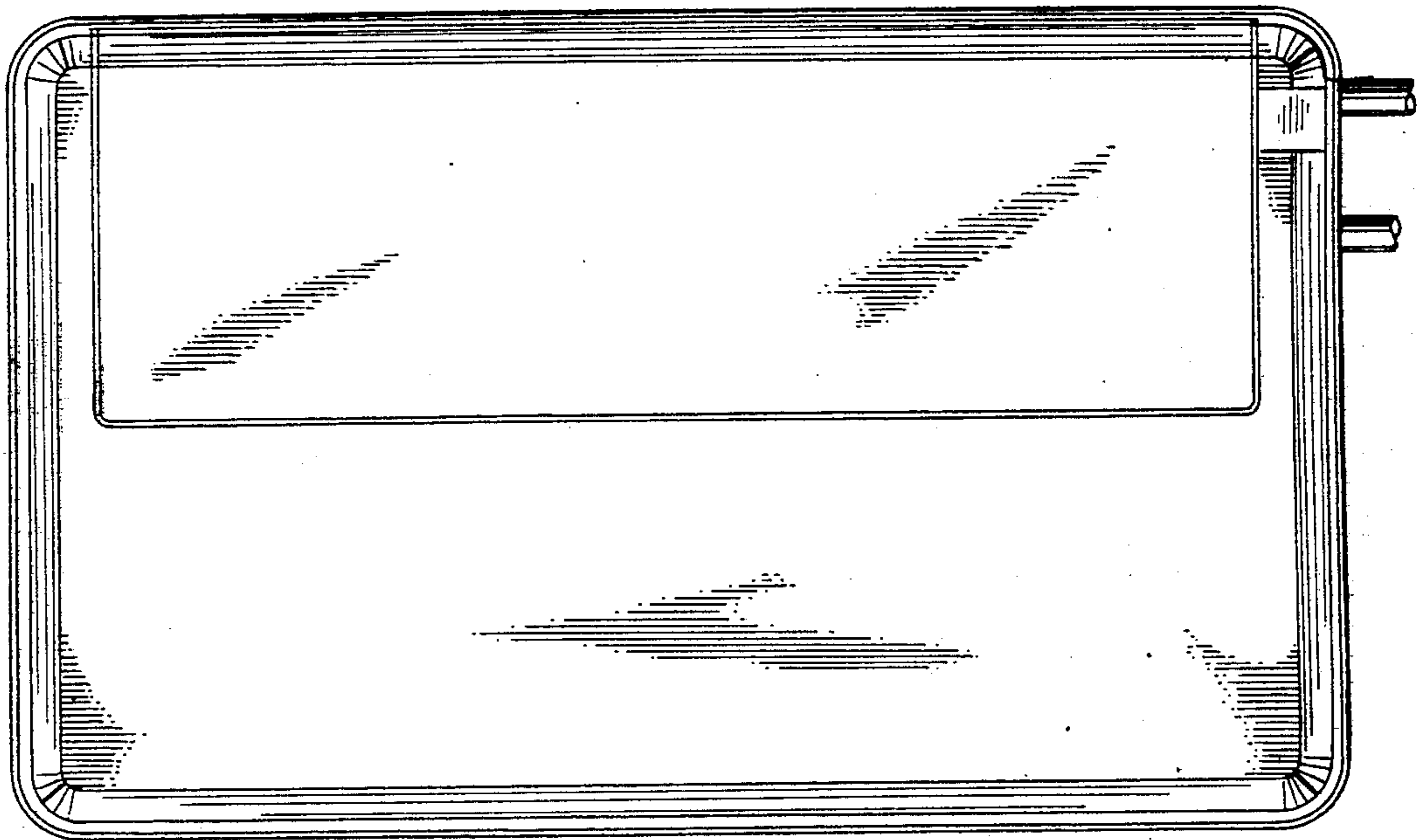

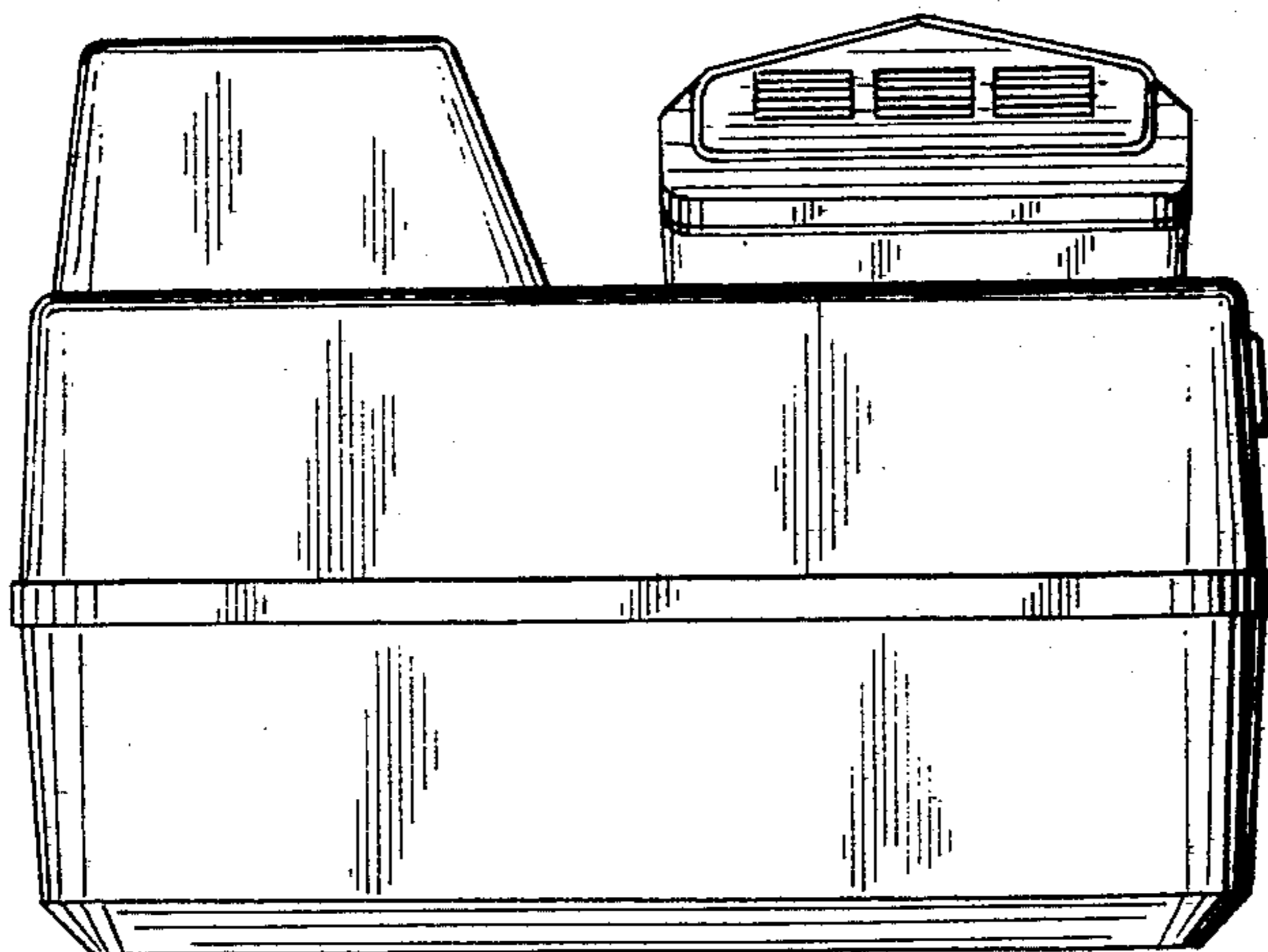
