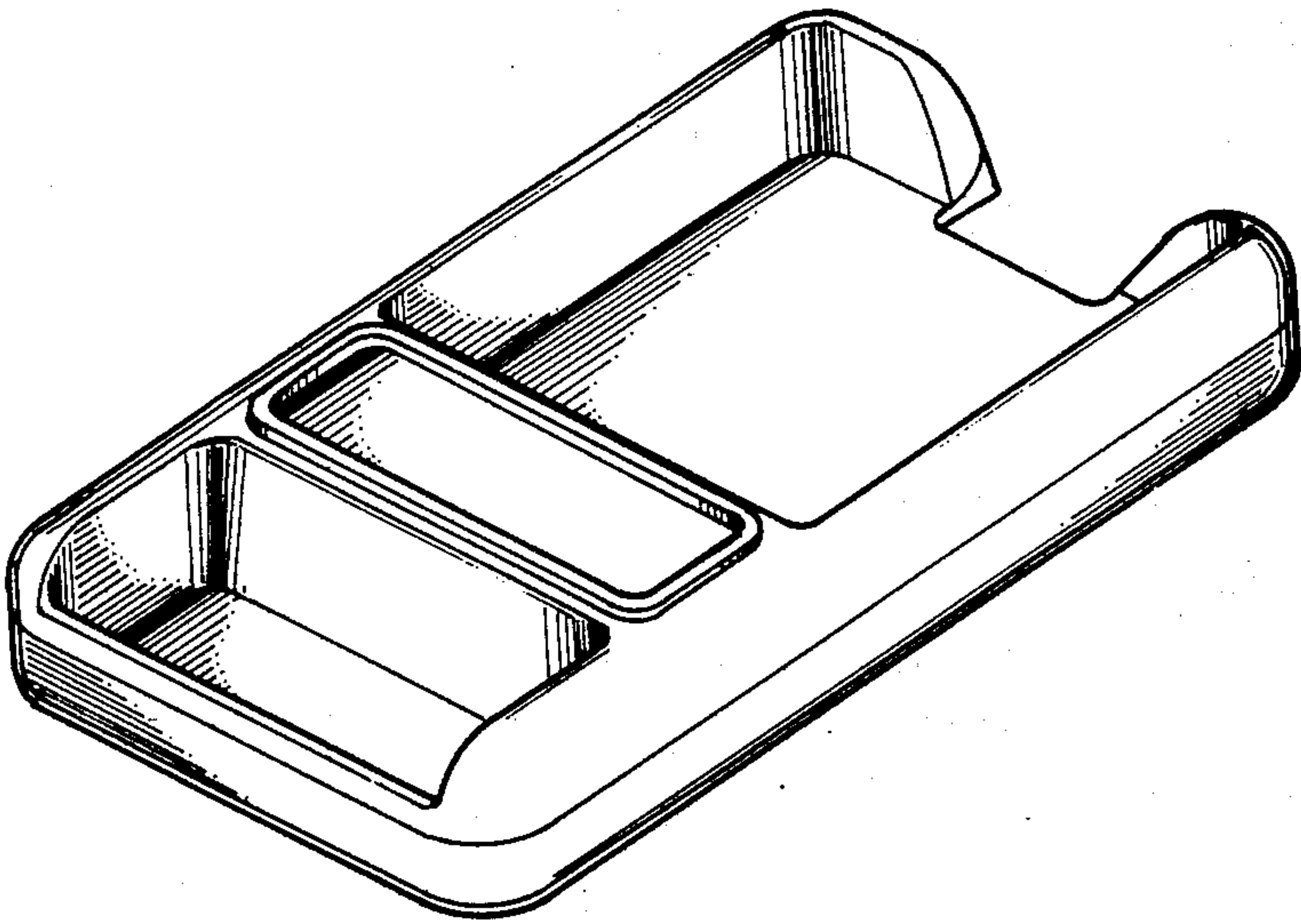

scribed.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stationary stand for  
containing visiting cards and memos showing my new  
design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof, of which  
a right side elevational view would be a mirror image.



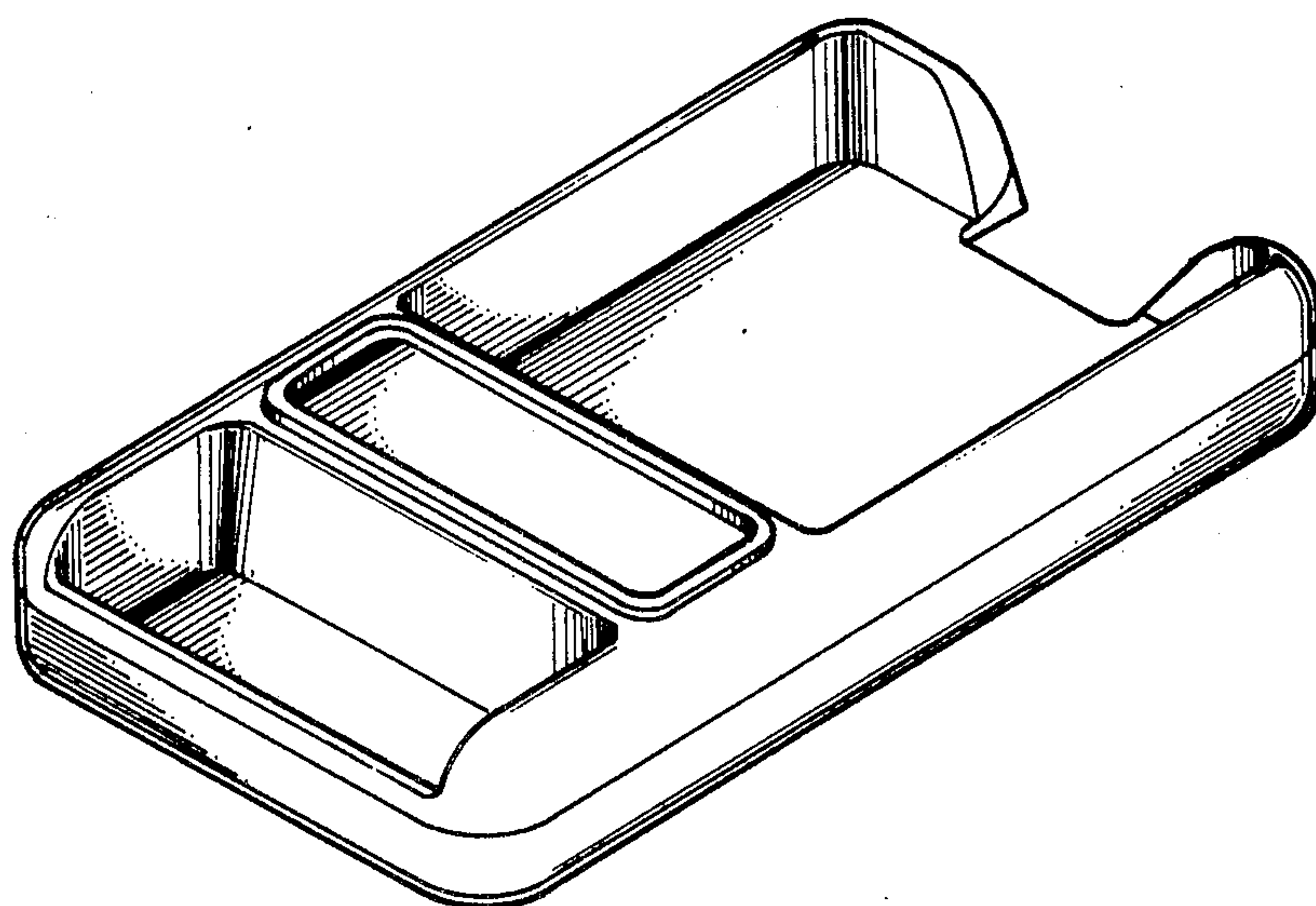

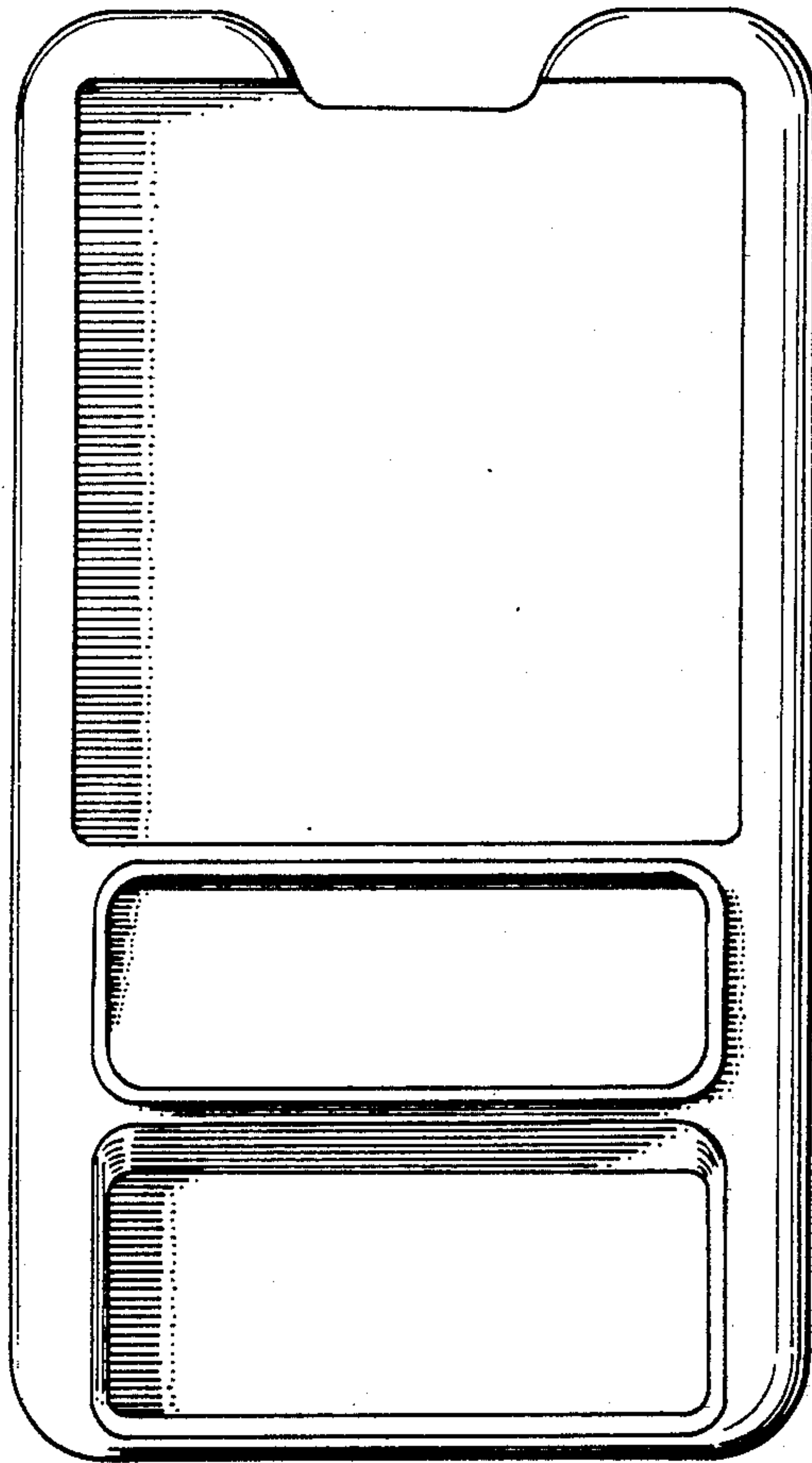

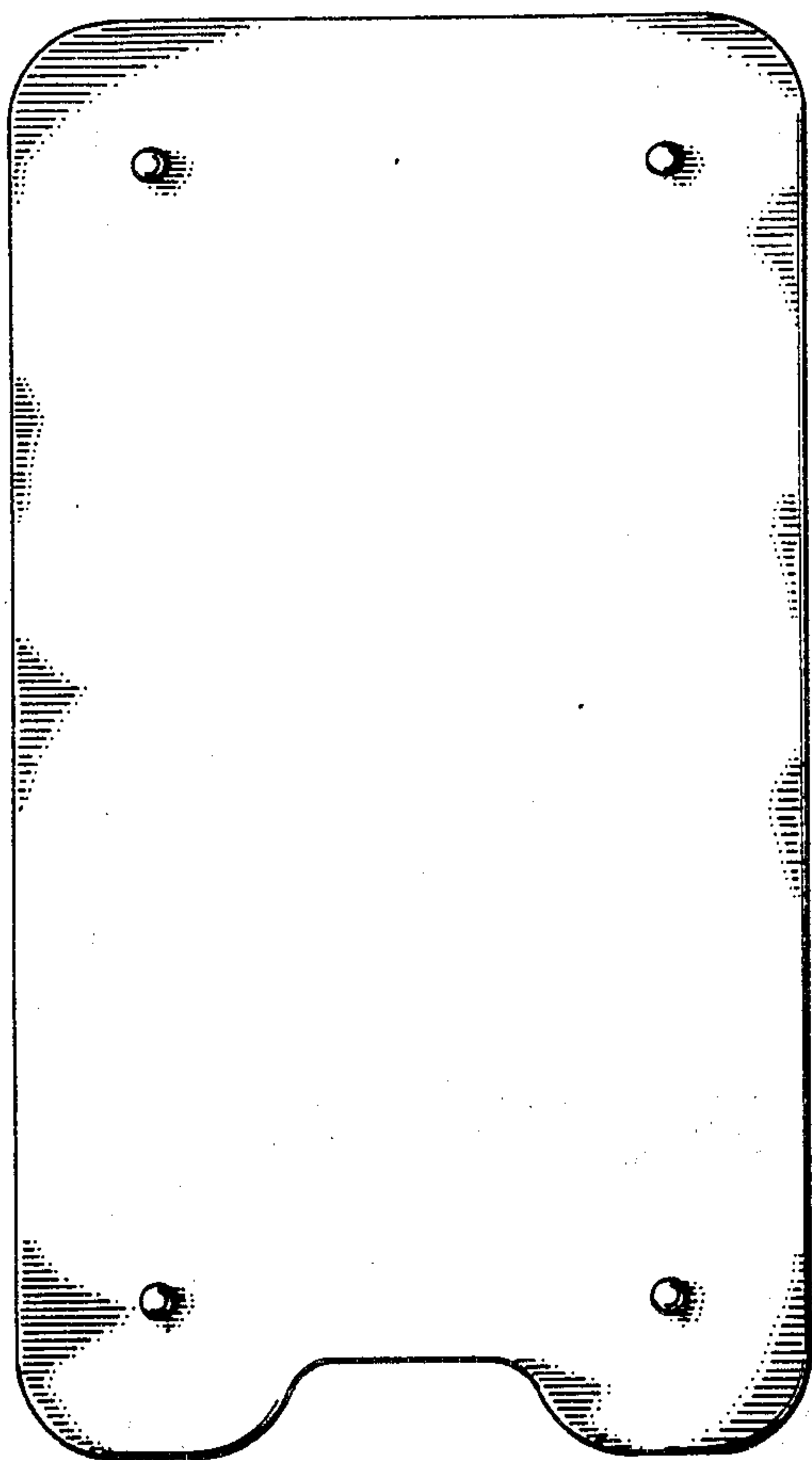

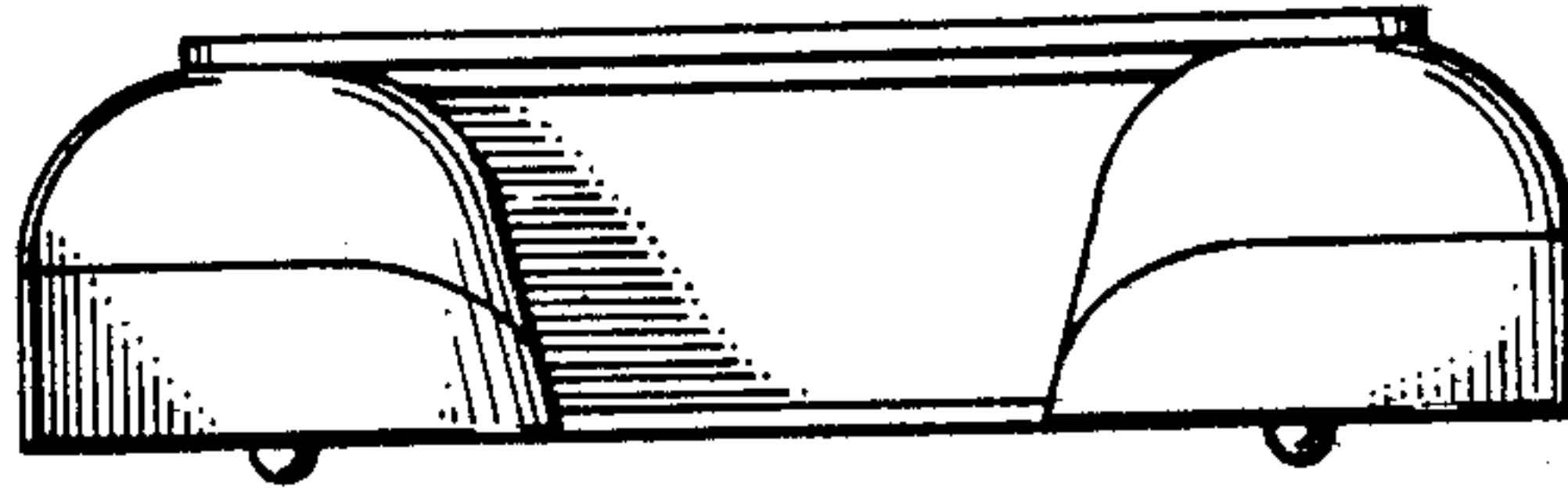

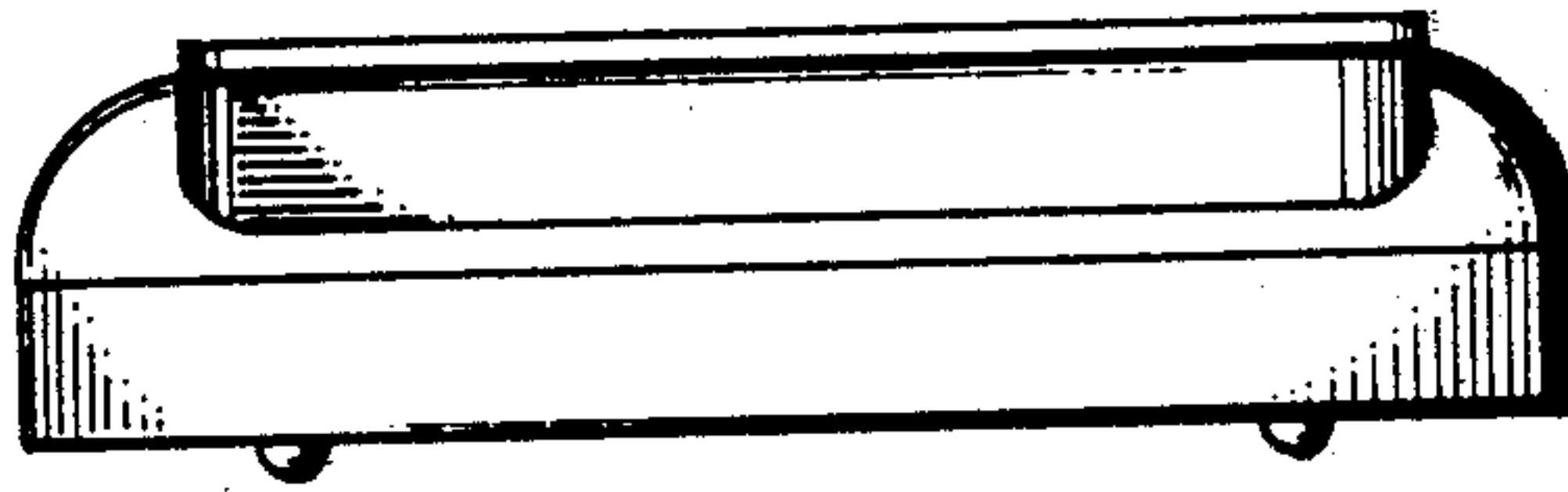

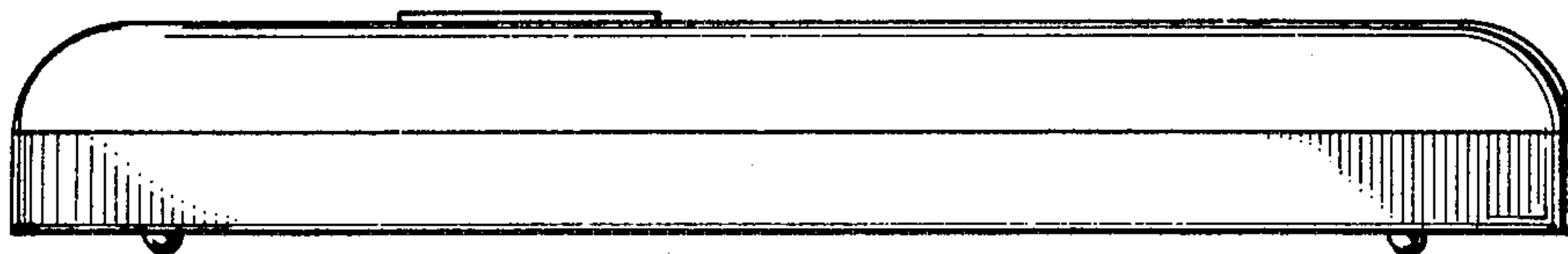
