The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the chair;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation of the chair;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the chair;

FIG. 5 is a side elevation of the chair at an angle perpendicular to the side panel;

FIG. 6 is a side elevation of the chair taken perpendicular to the front or rear elevation;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the chair embodying the new design;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of a chair showing a second embodiment of my design;

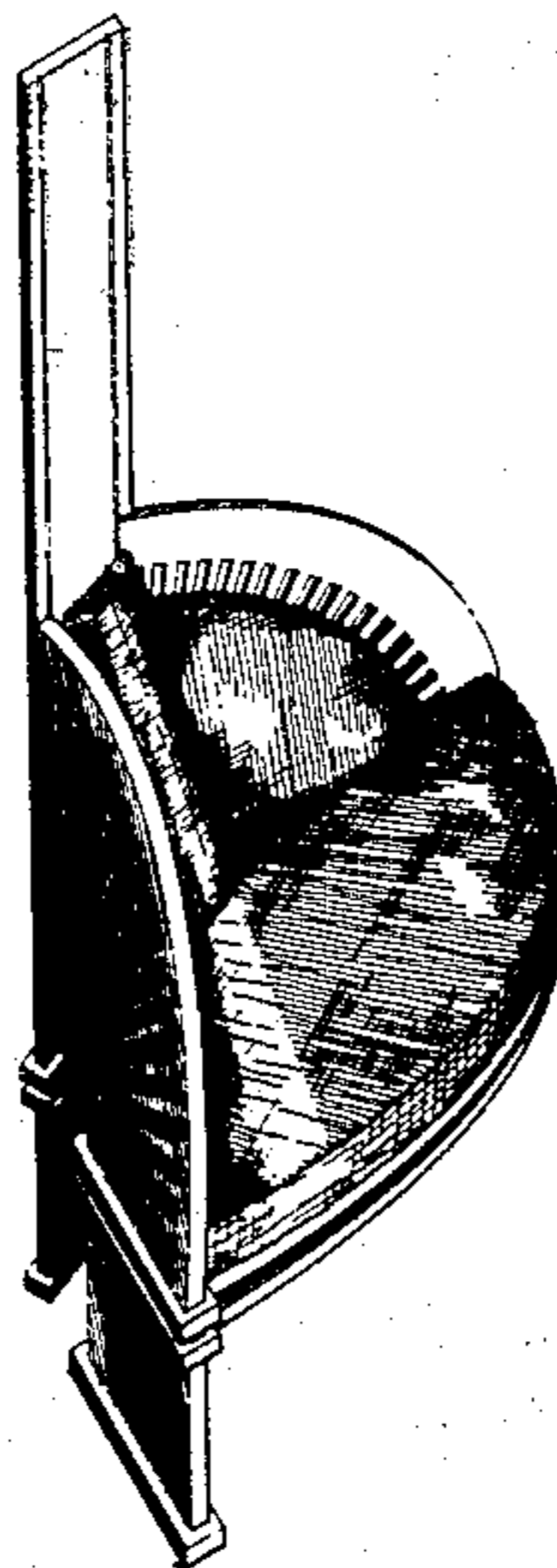
FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of a chair showing a third embodiment of my design;

FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of the FIG. 9 embodiment.



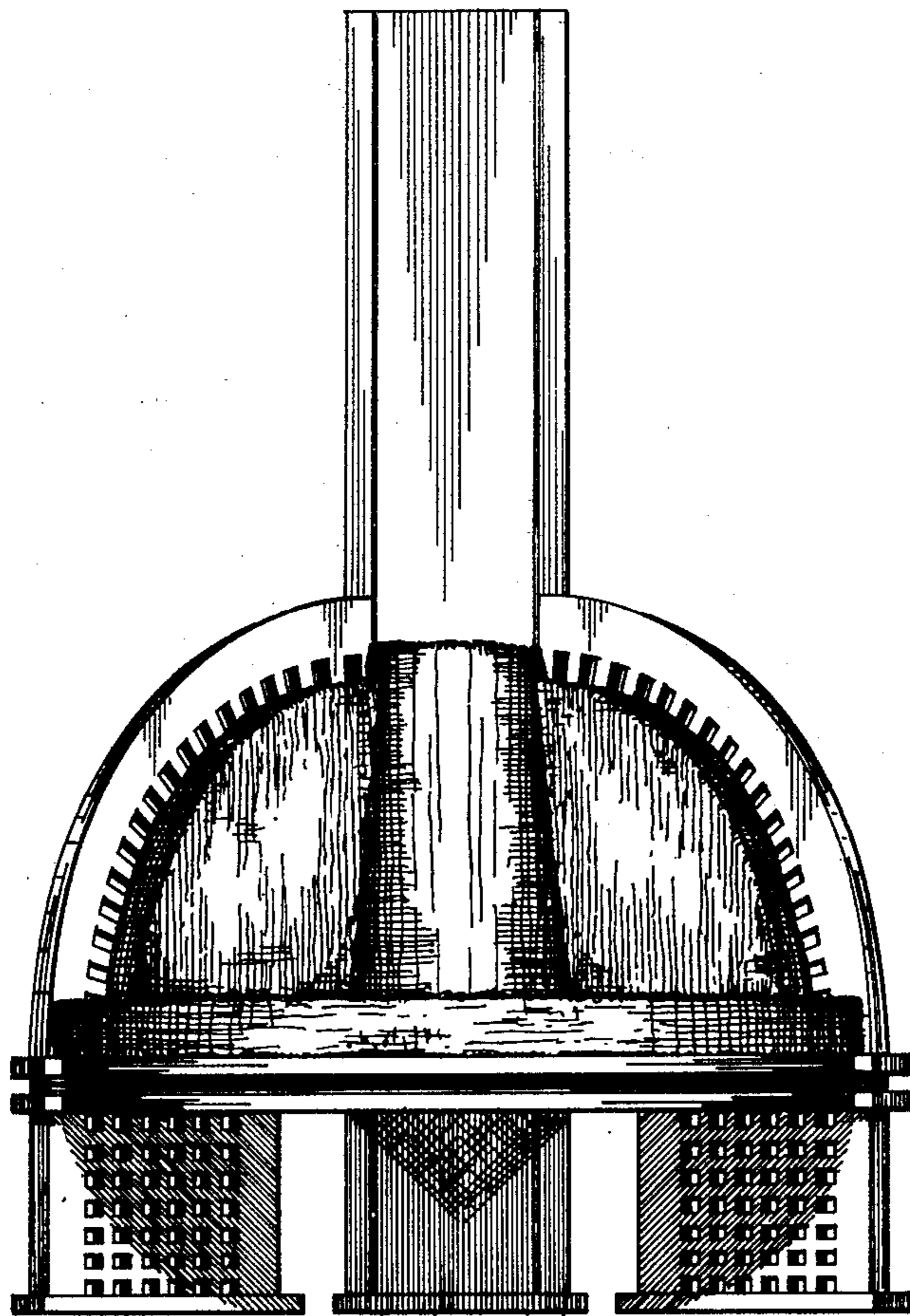

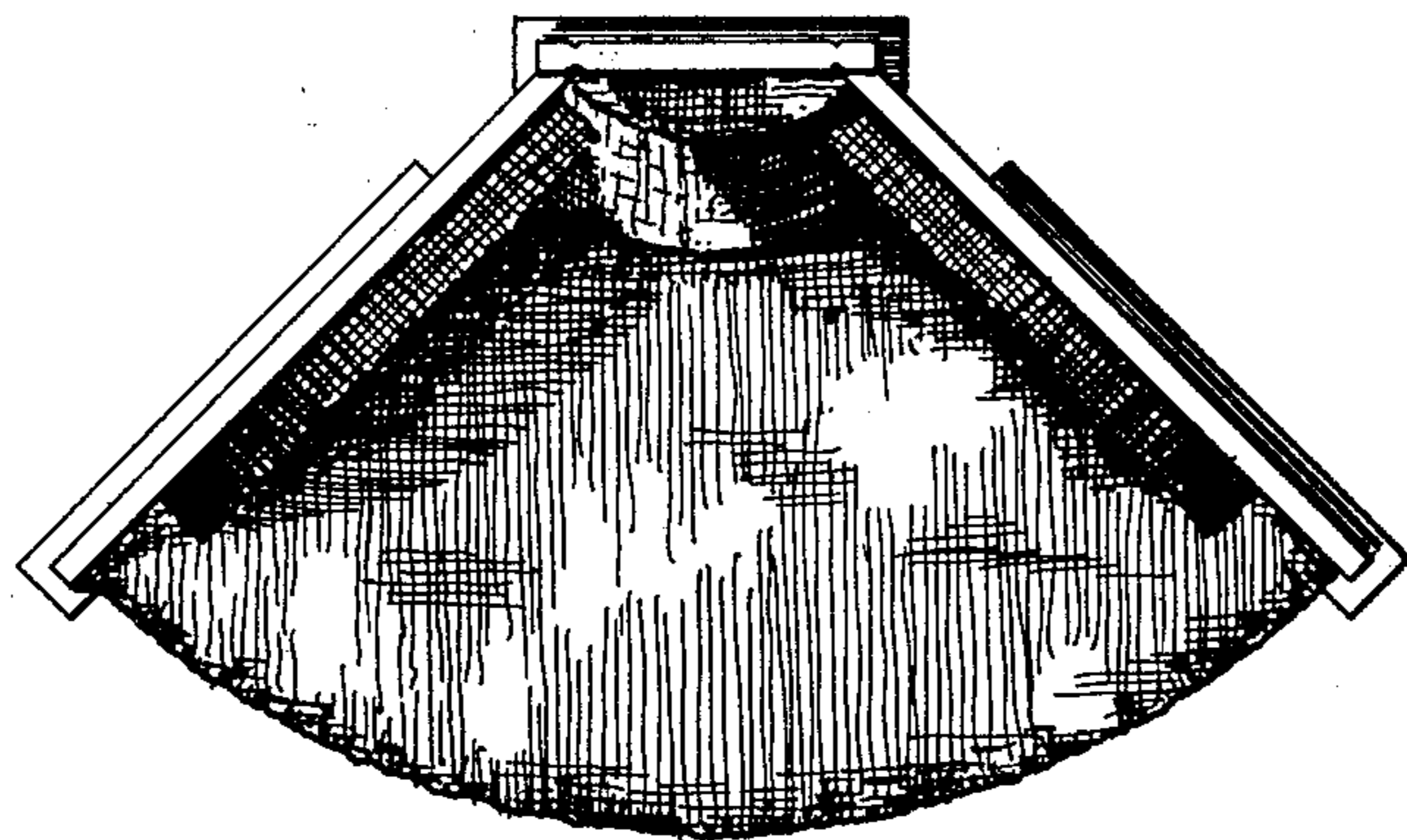

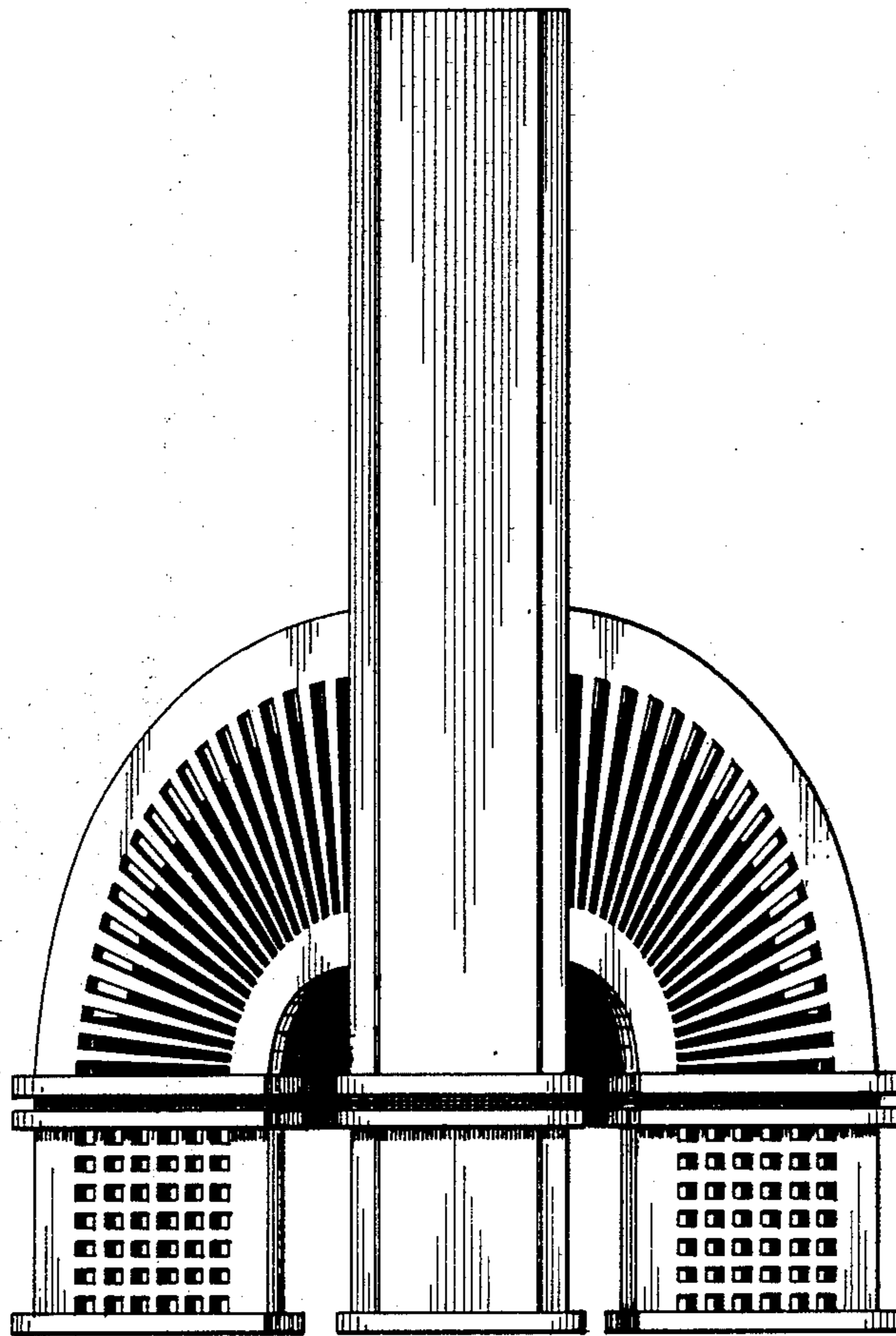

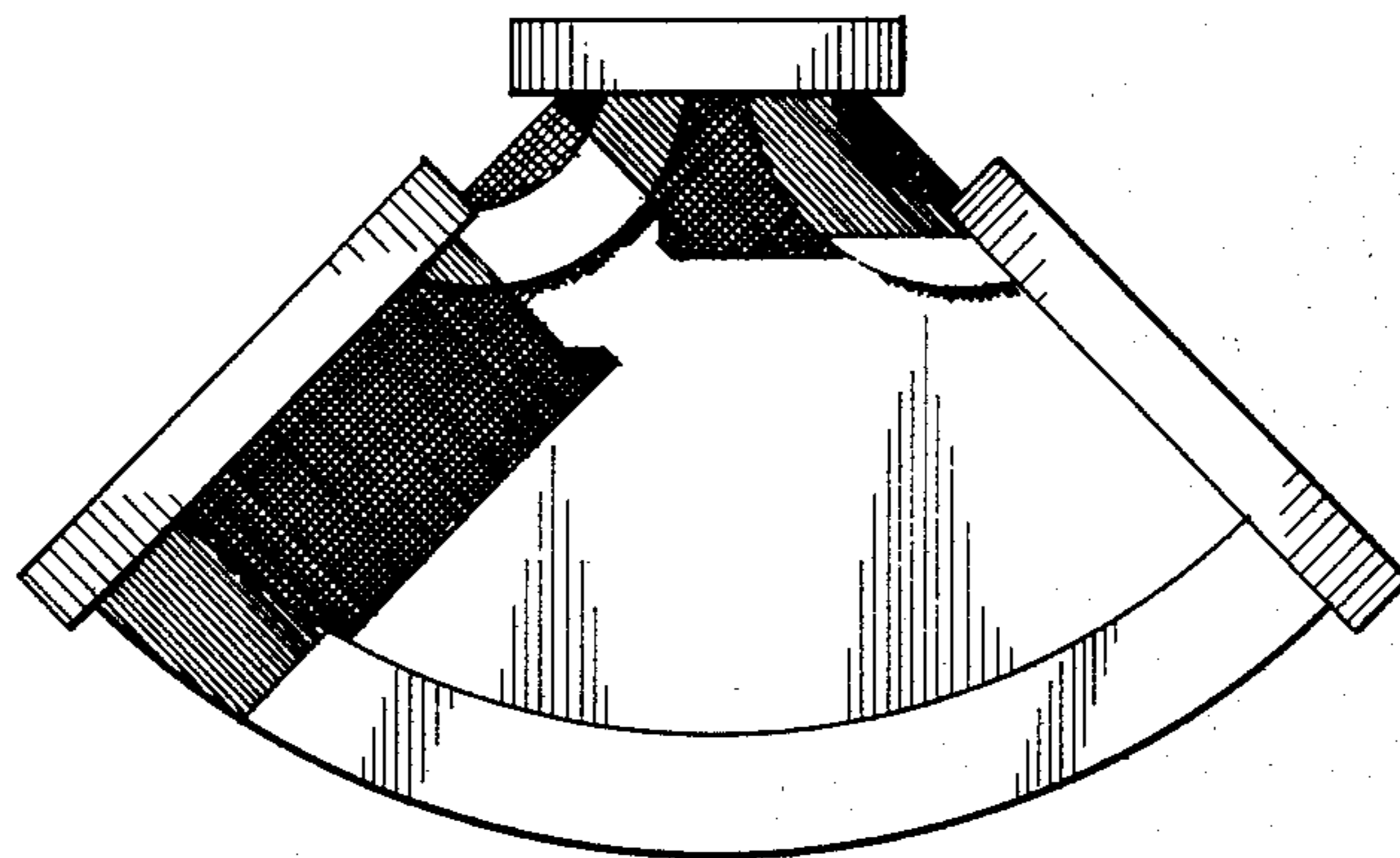

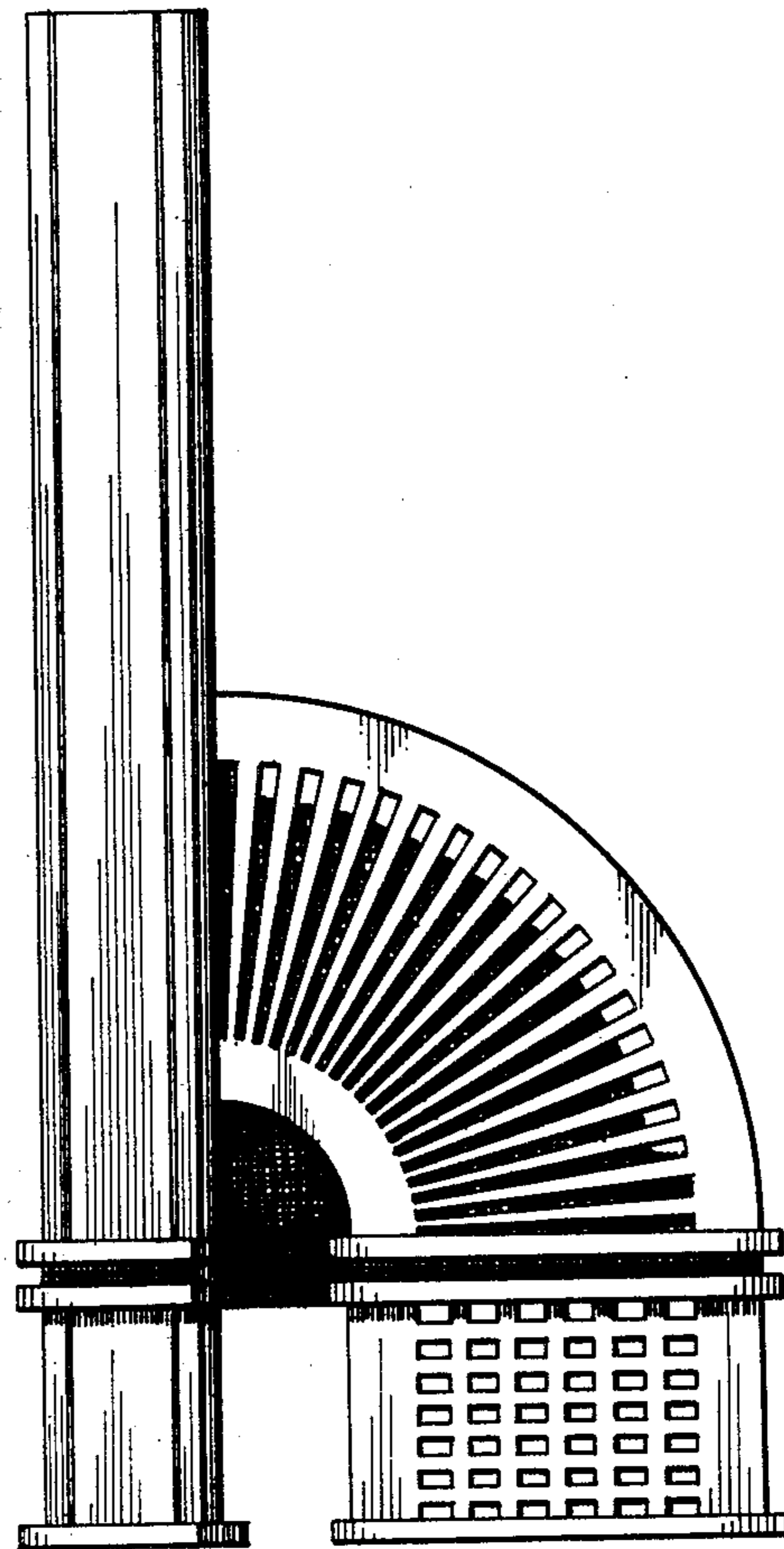

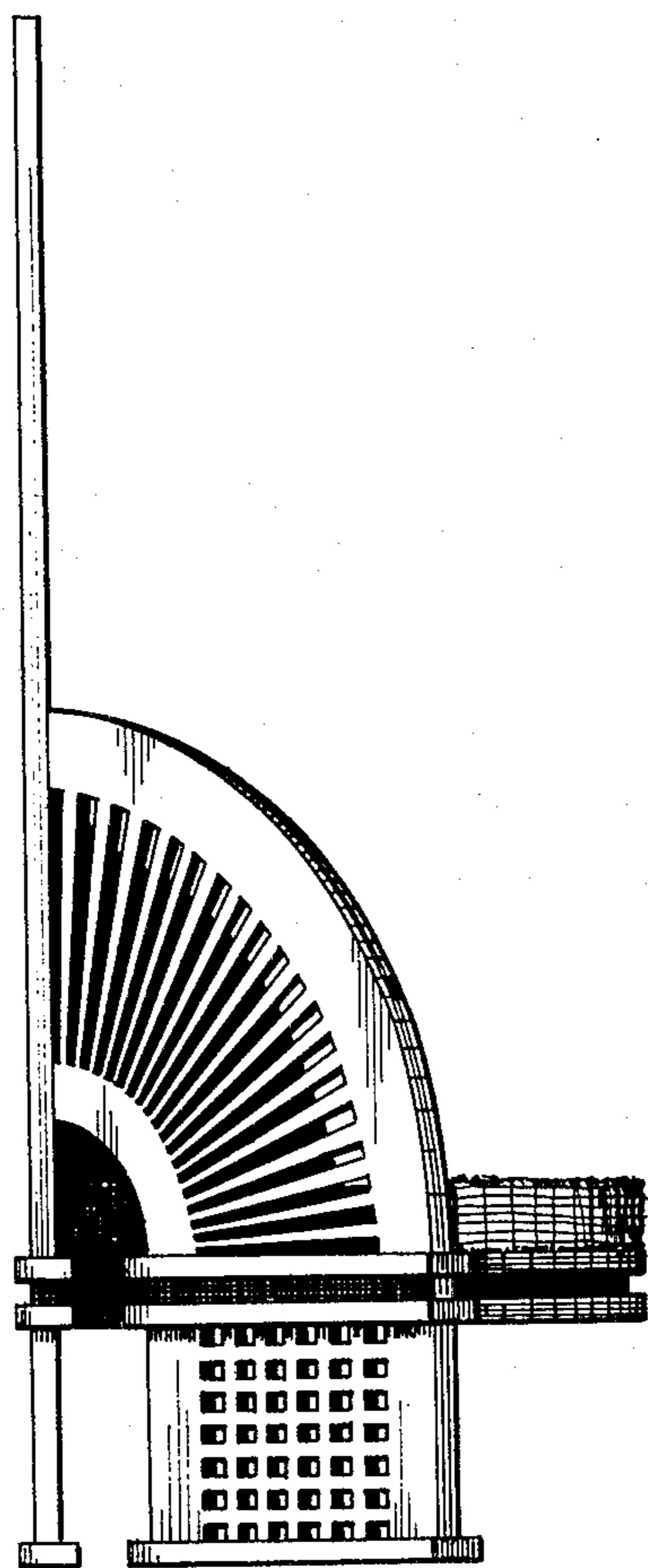

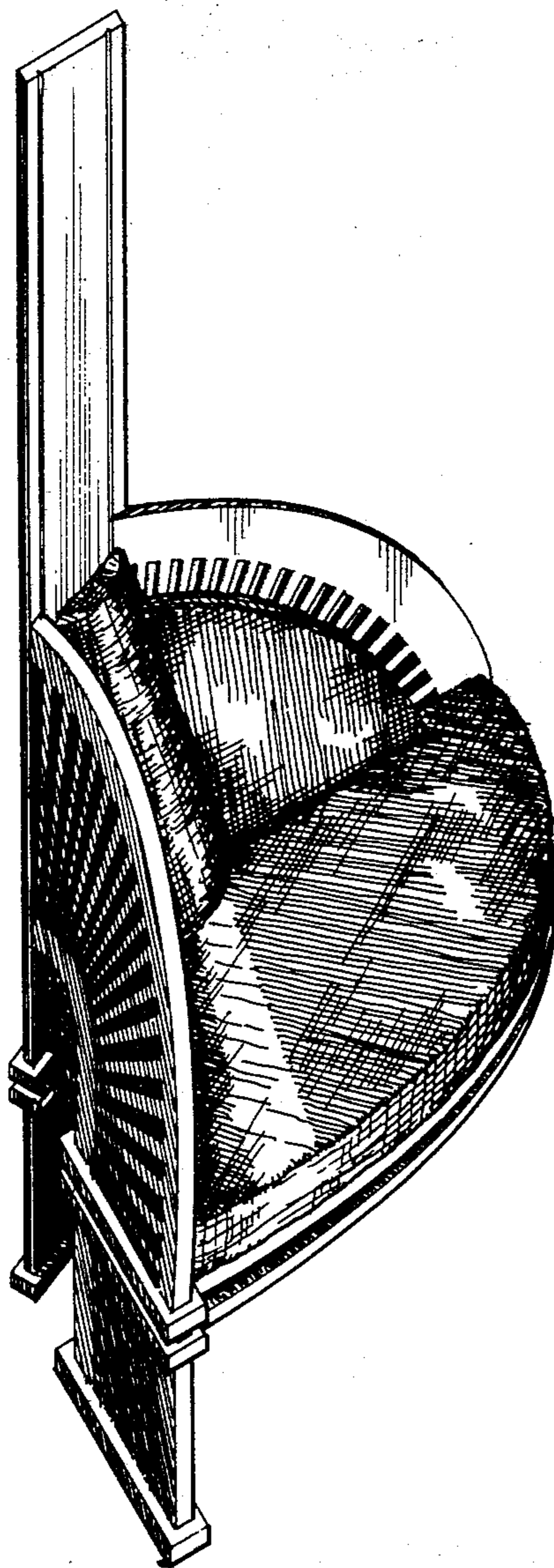

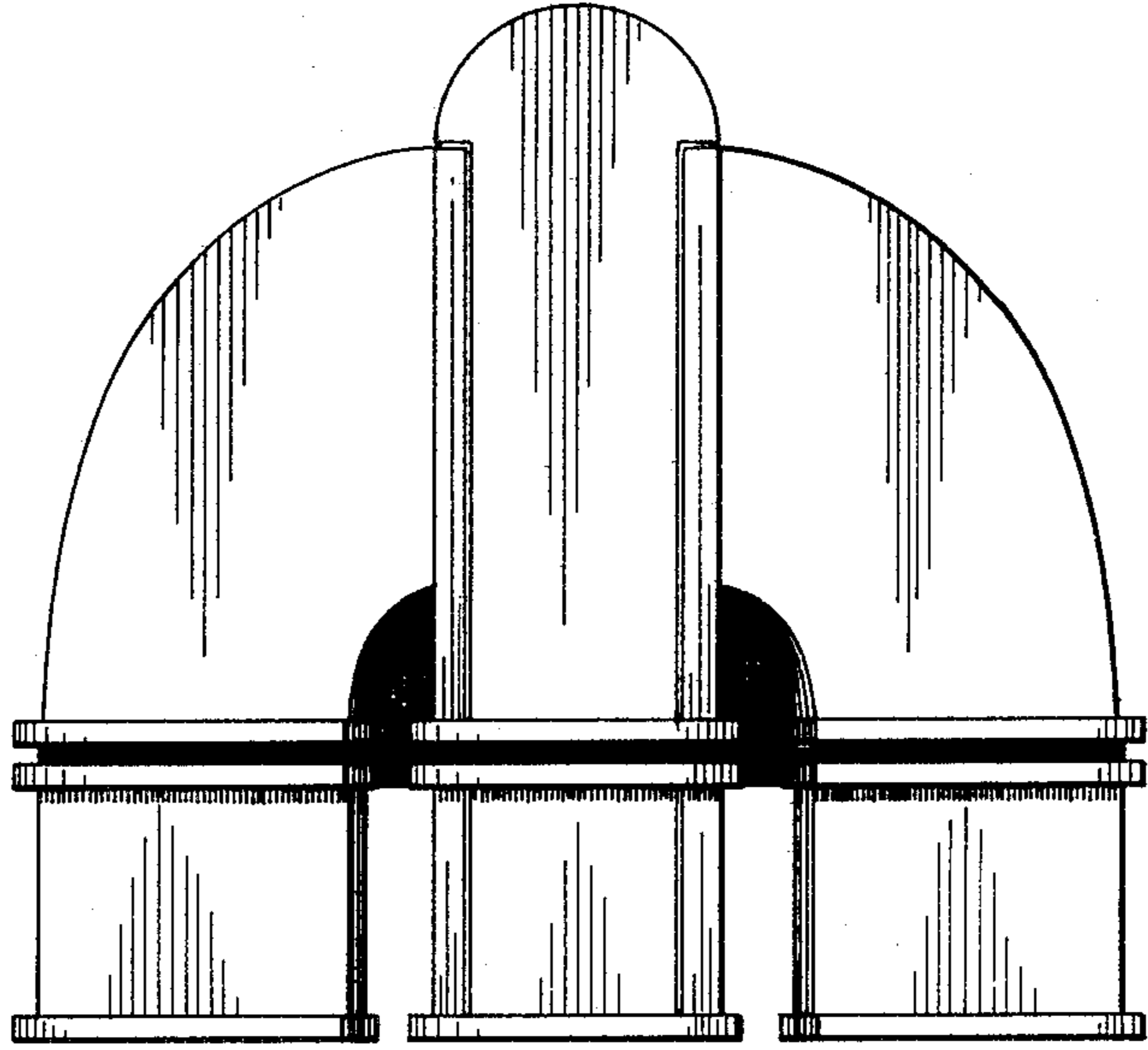

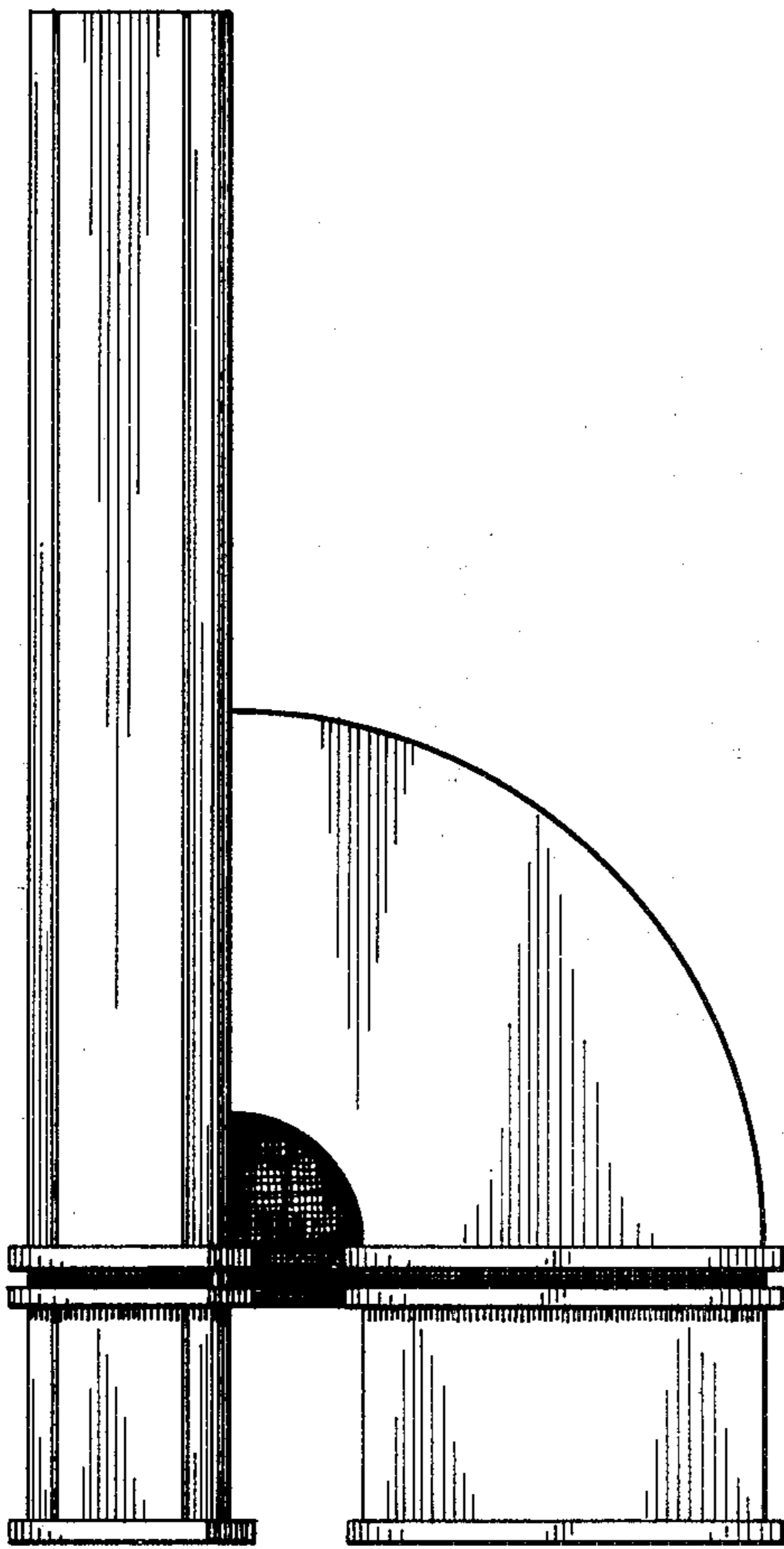

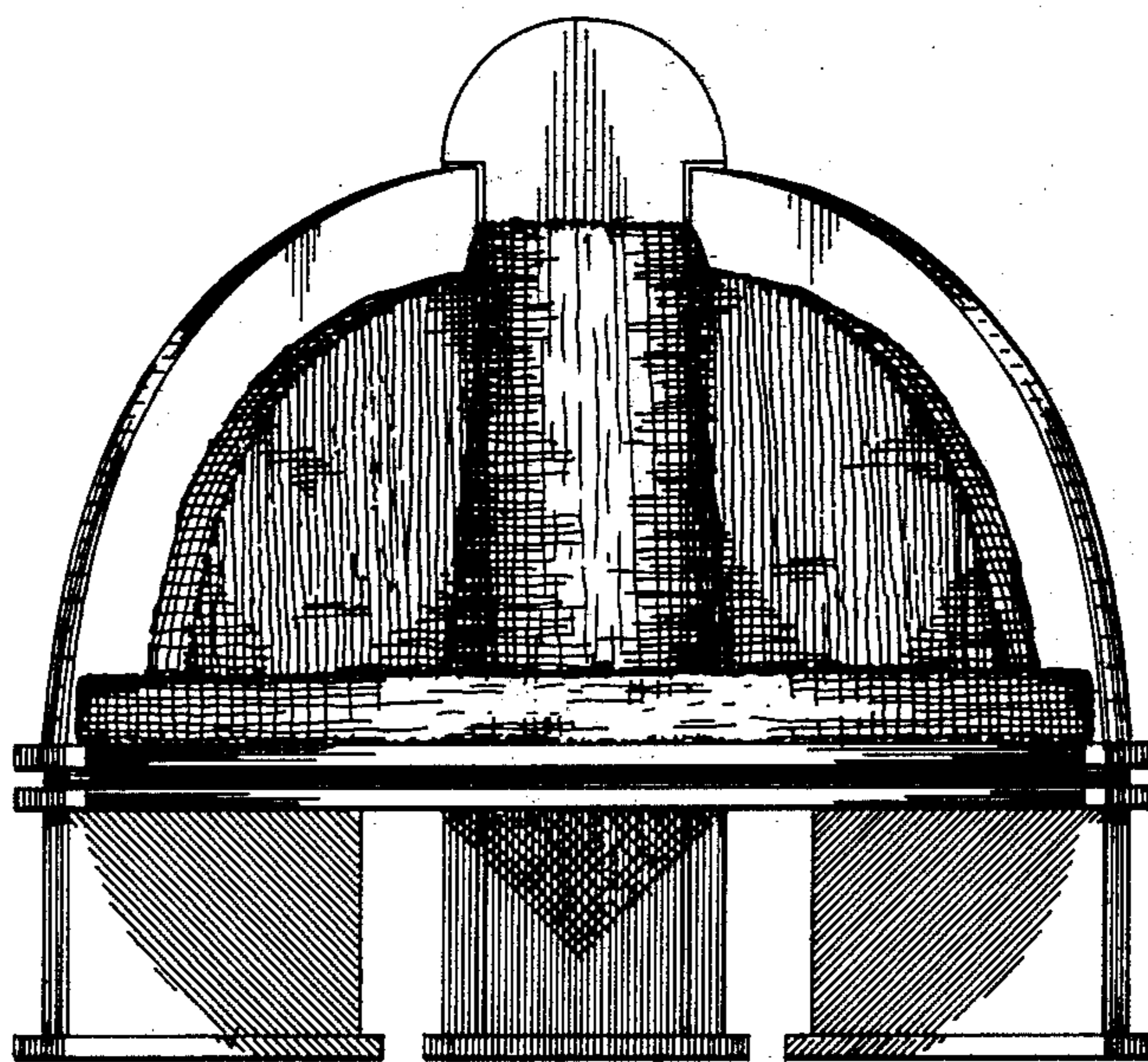

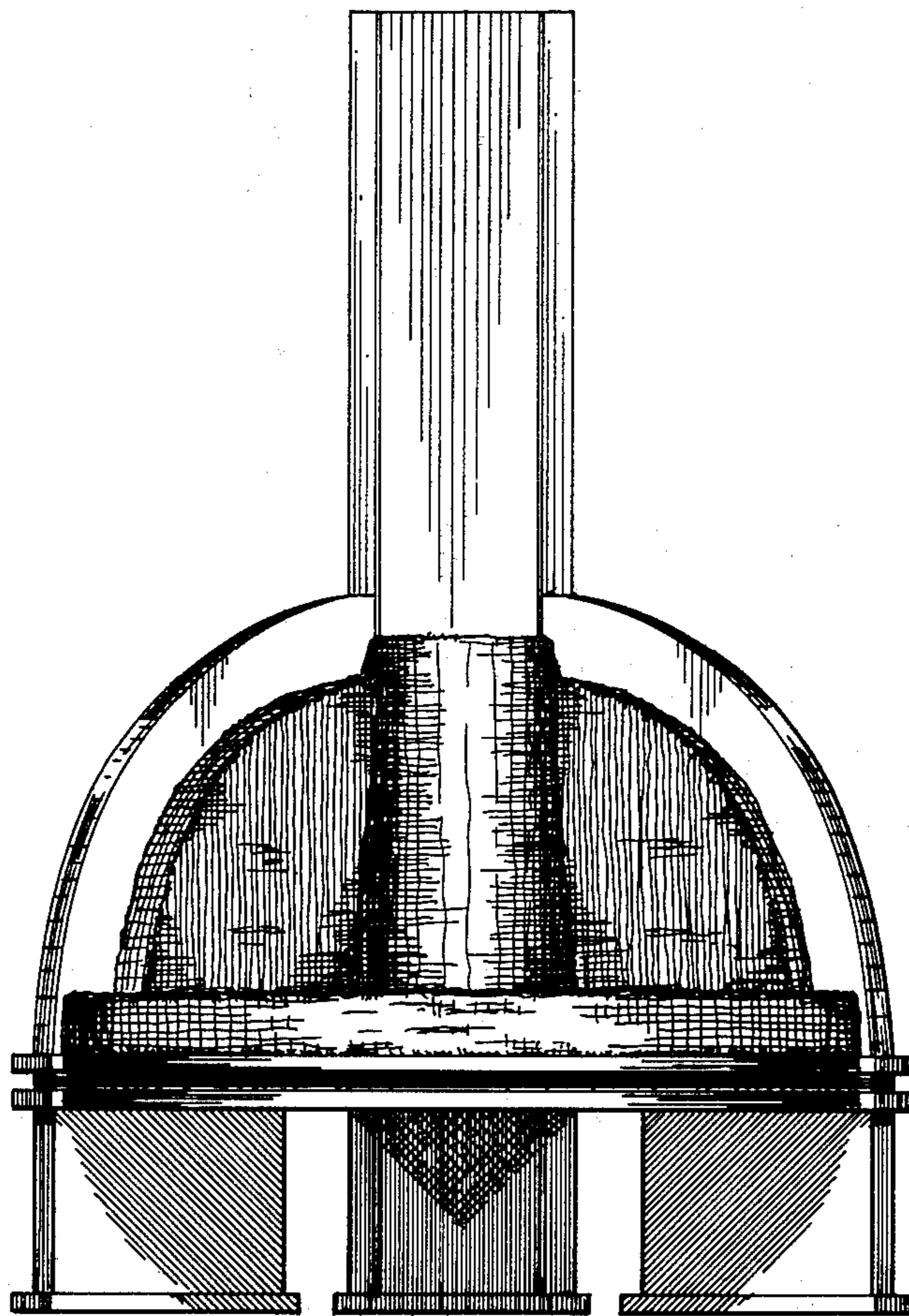

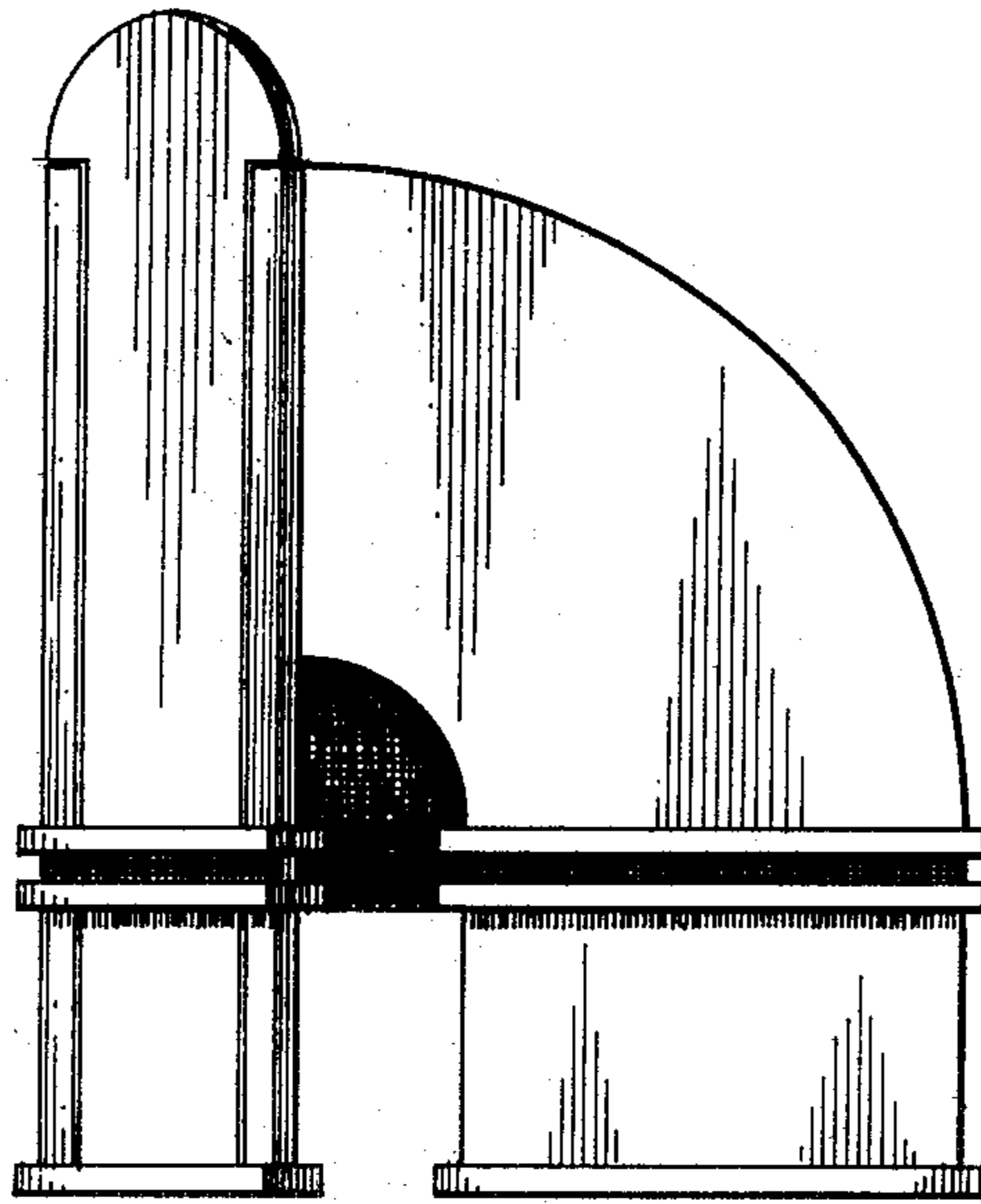

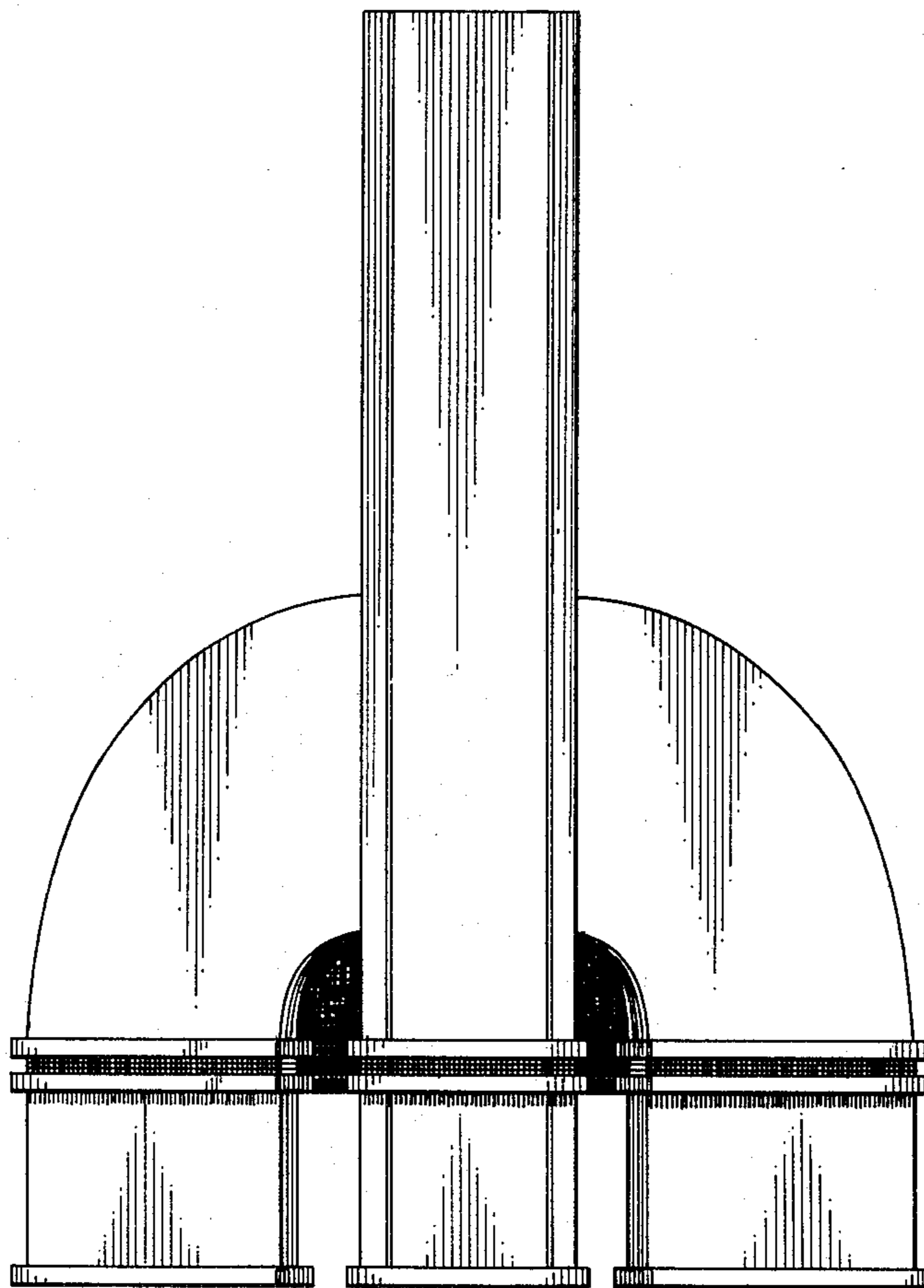
